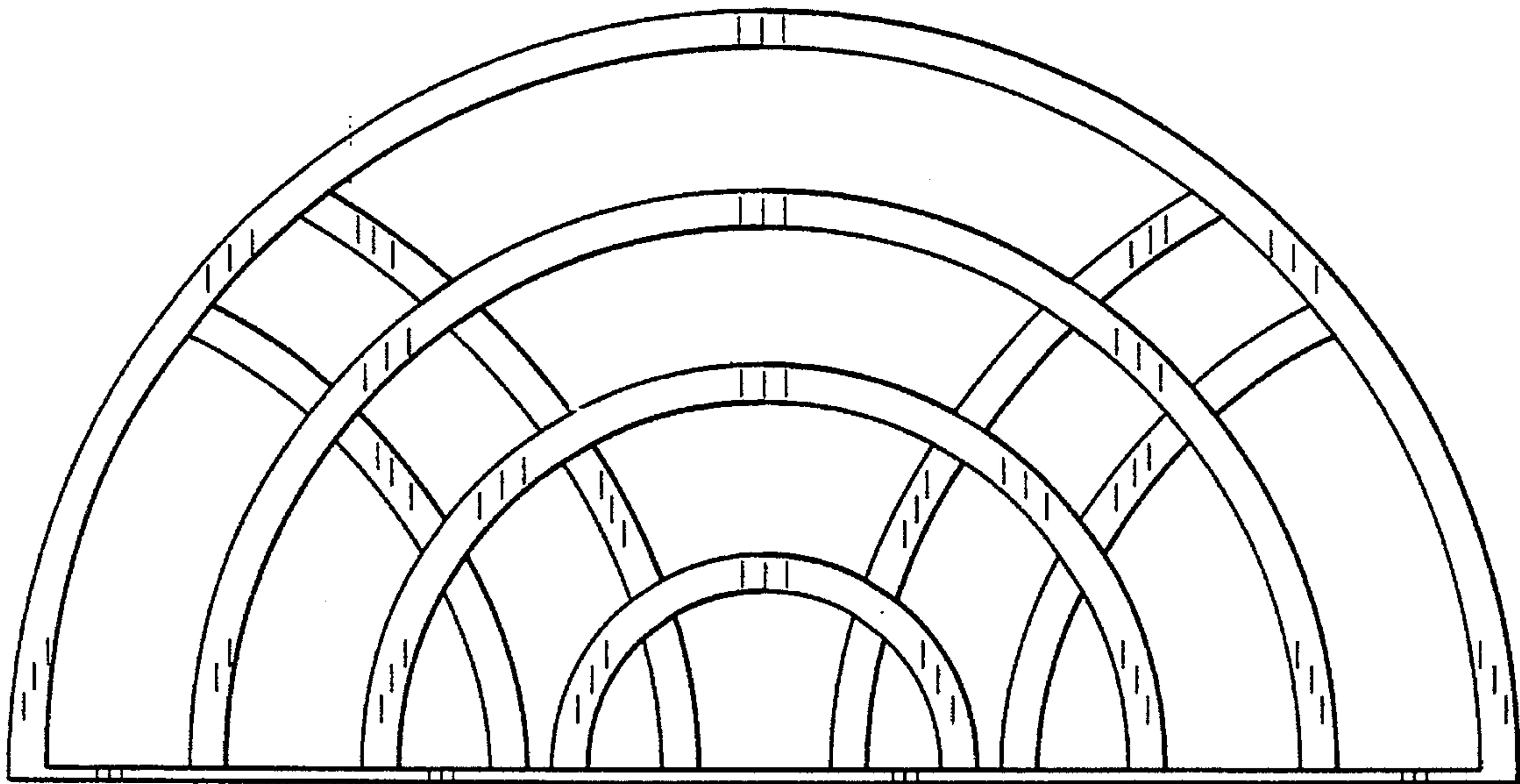
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for endboard, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an endboard showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of my new design;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of FIG. 4, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 6 is a top view of FIG. 4.

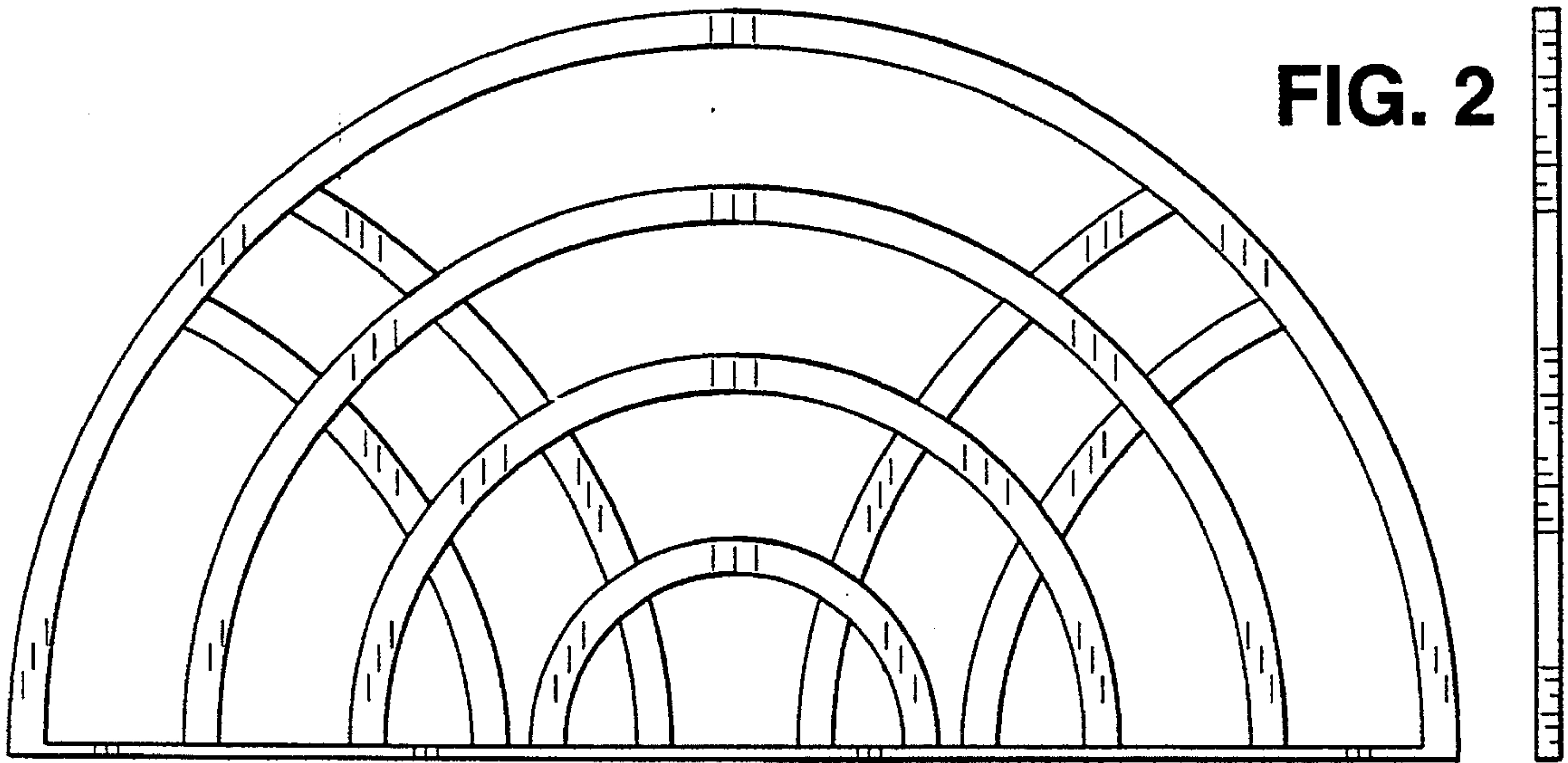

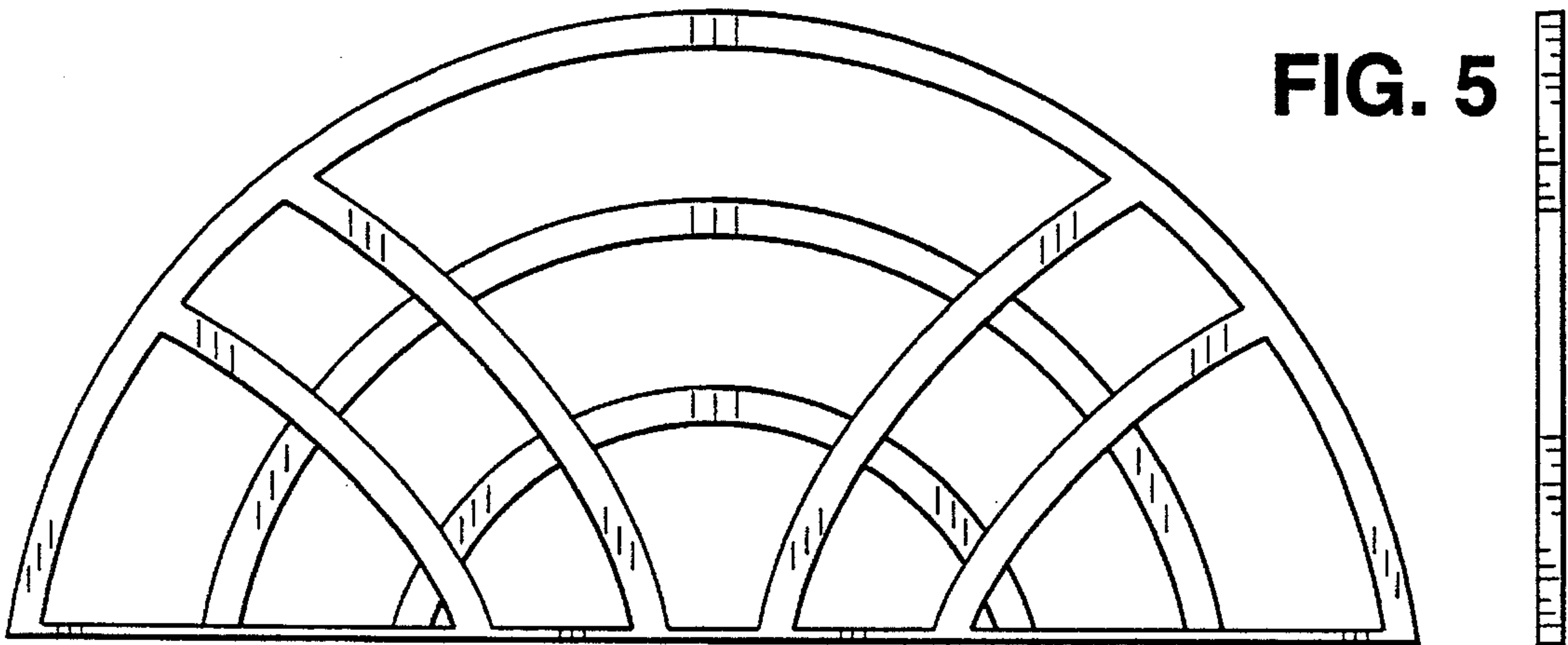
