FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof;

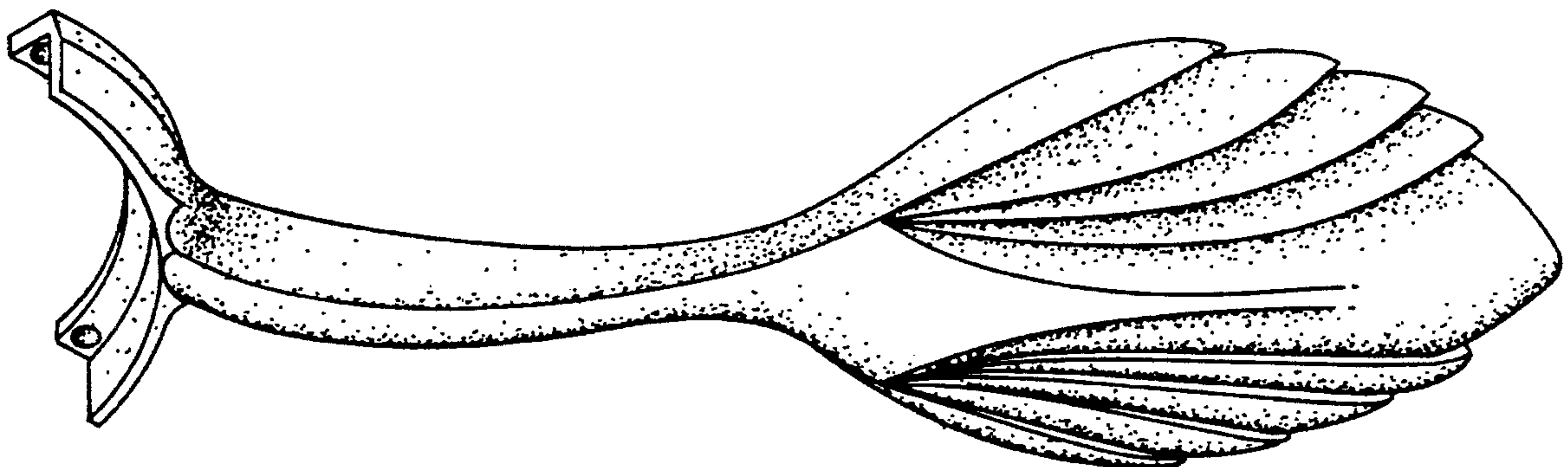
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

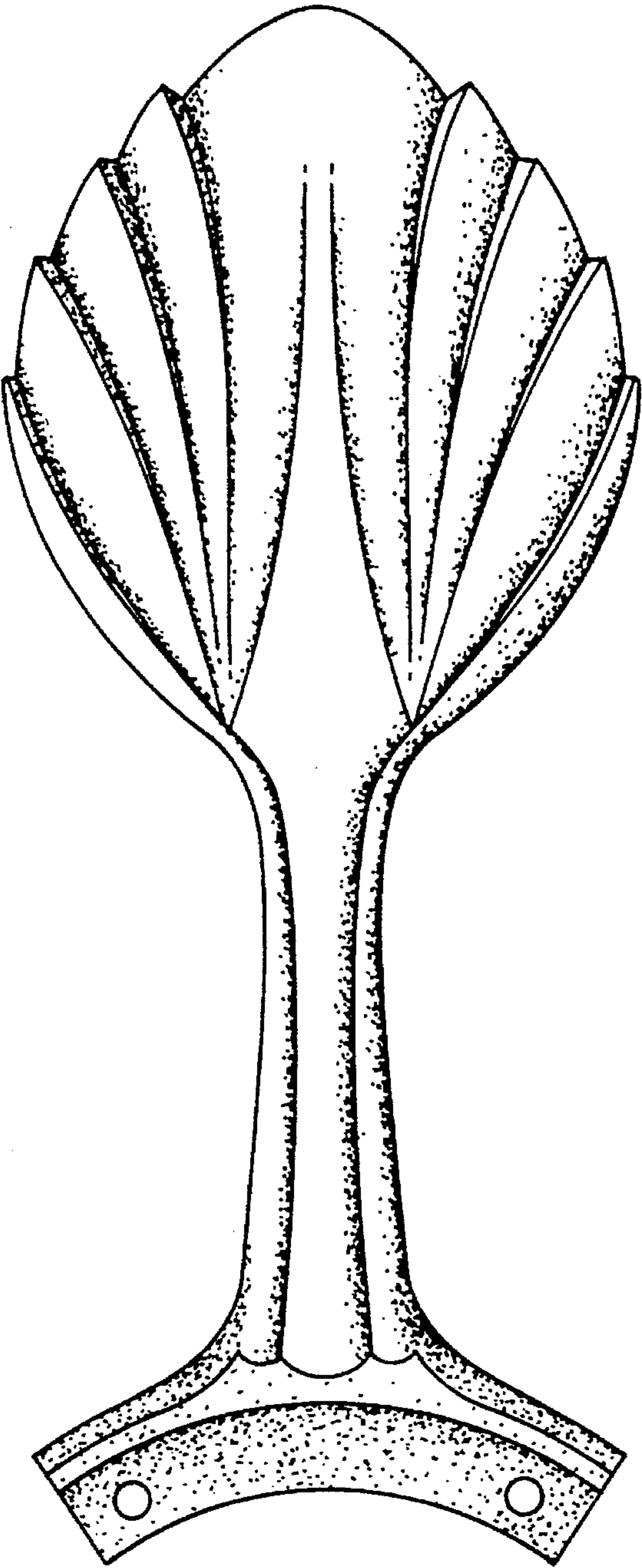
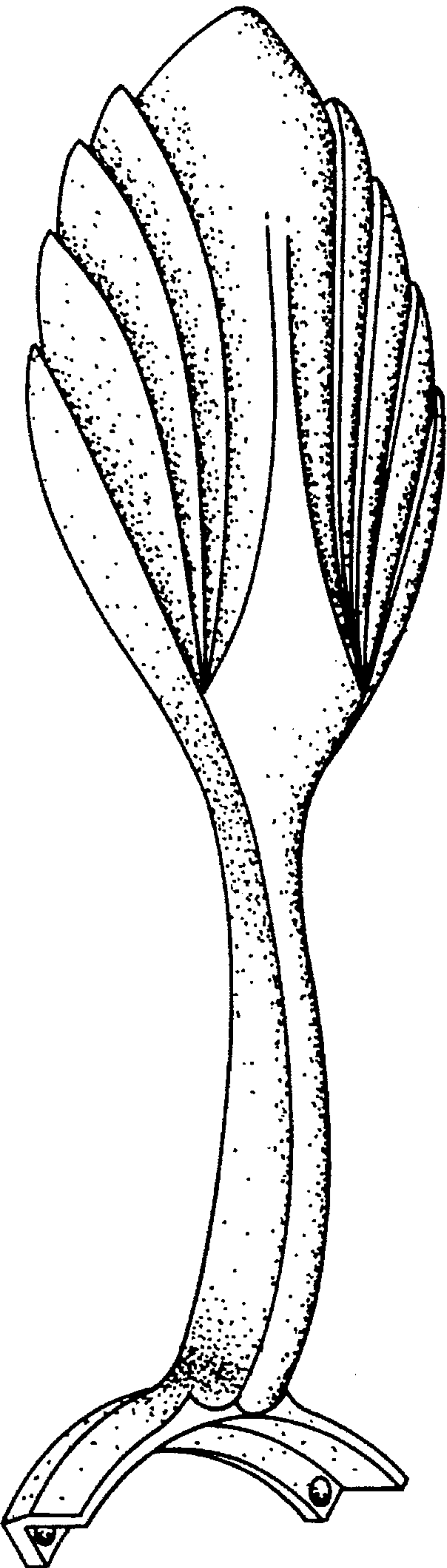
FIG. 5 is a front view thereof; and,

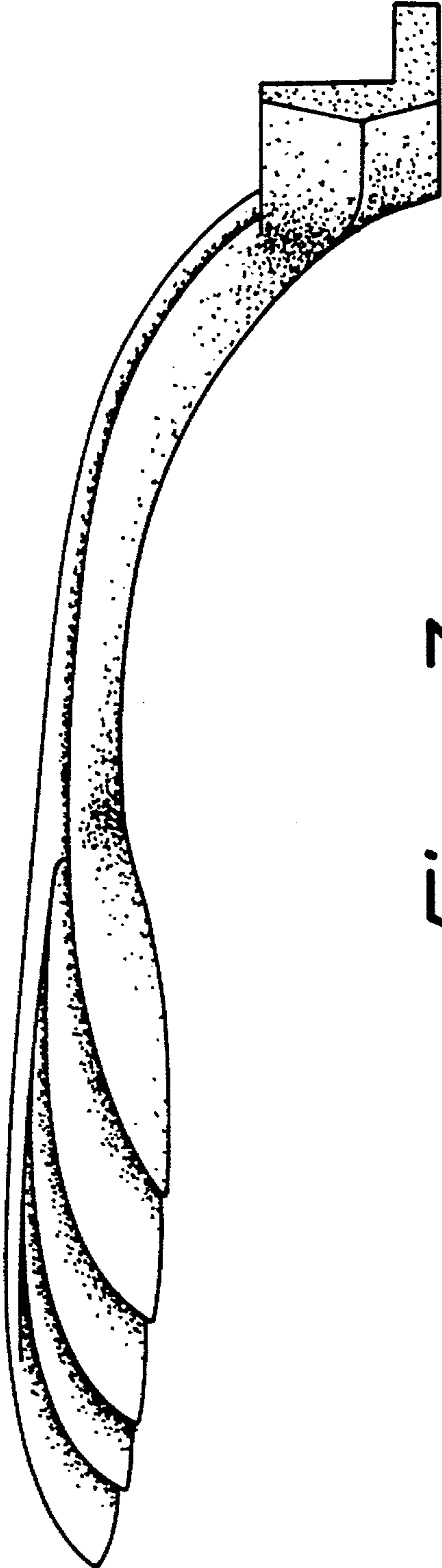

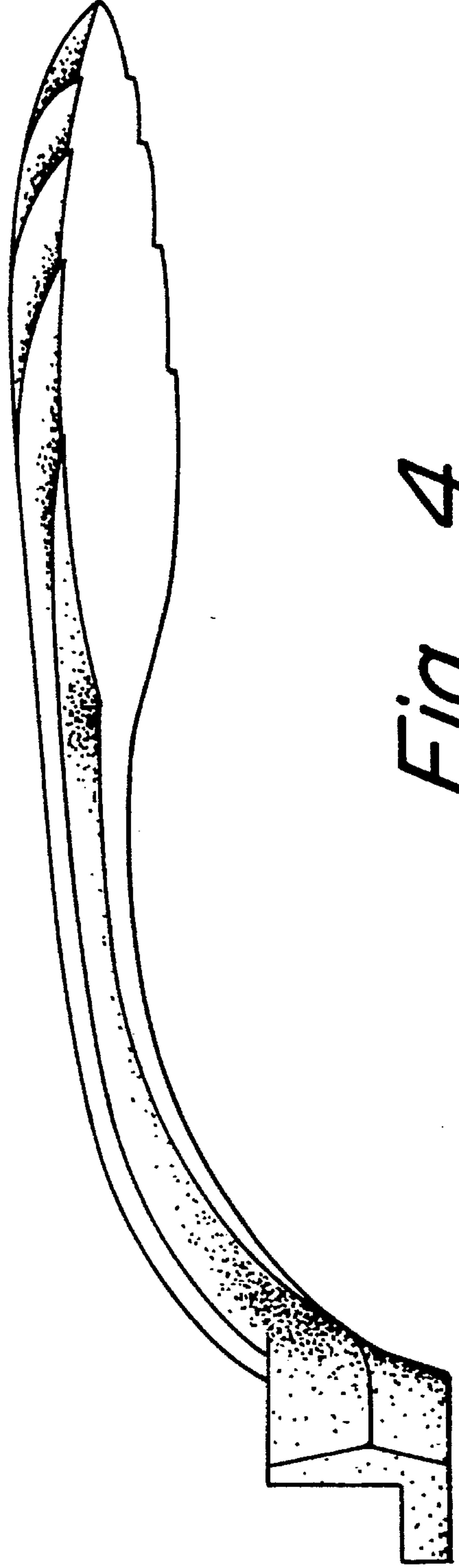

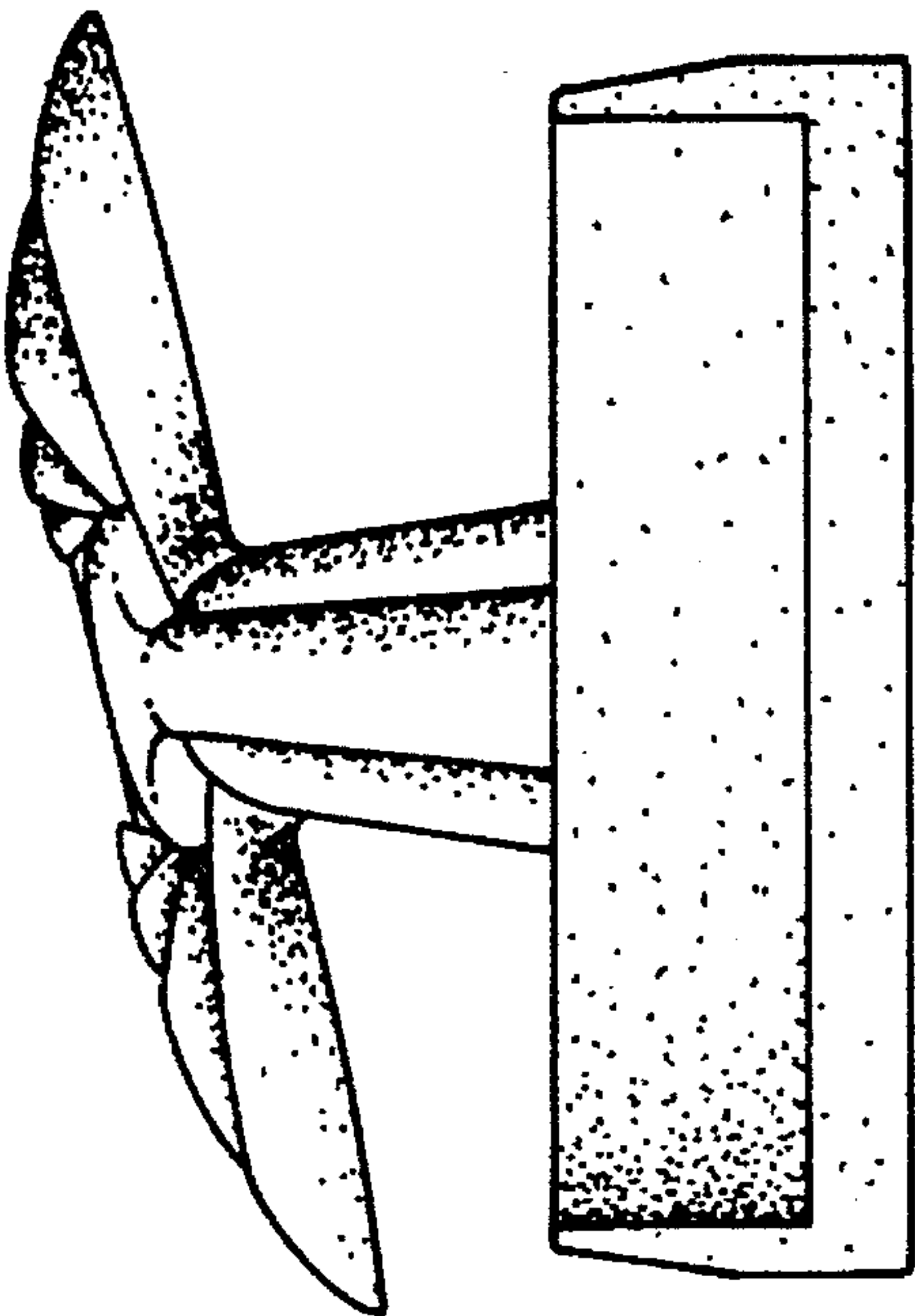

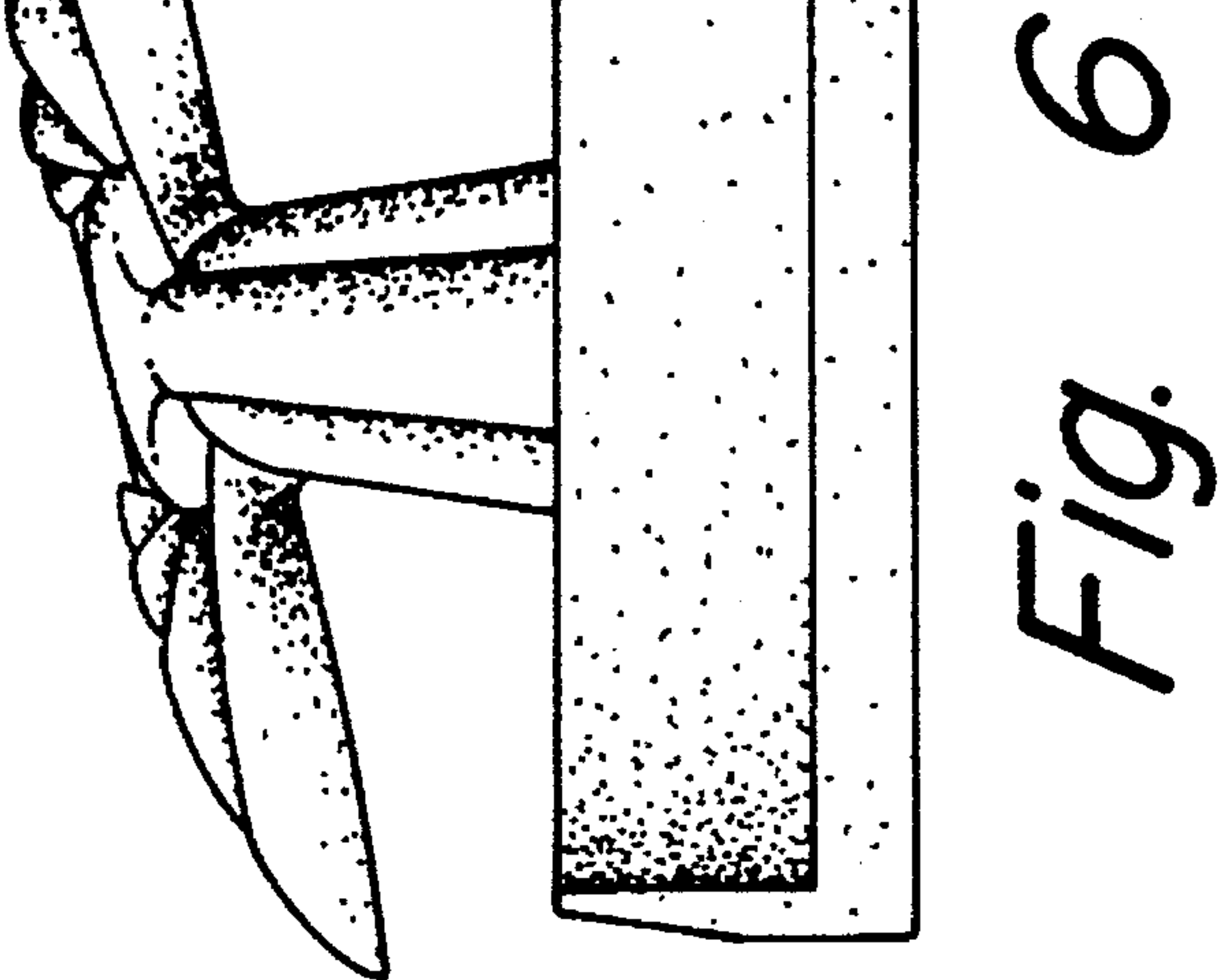
