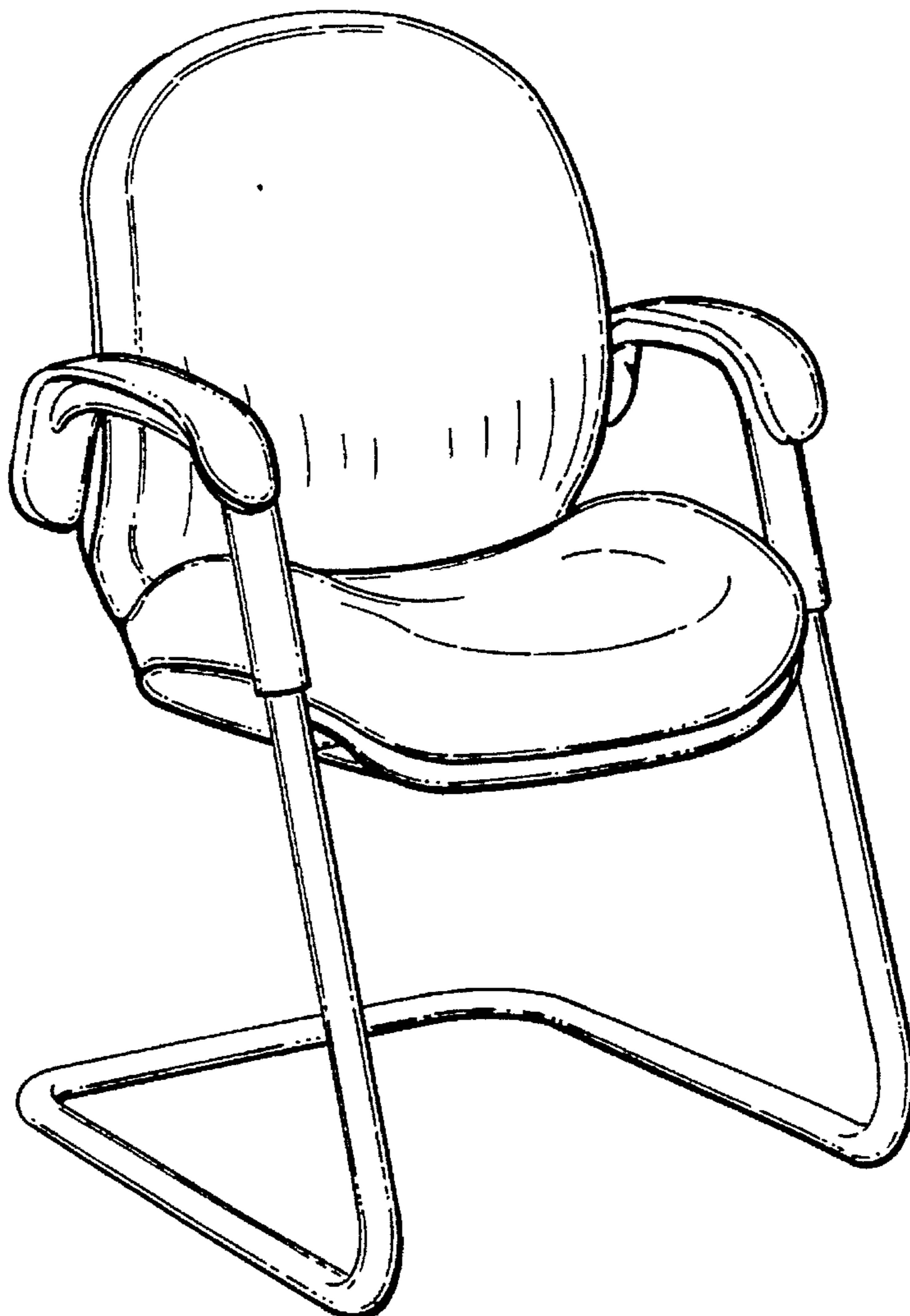
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a prospective view from the front and to one side of the chair;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the chair of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the chair of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the chair of FIG. 1; and,

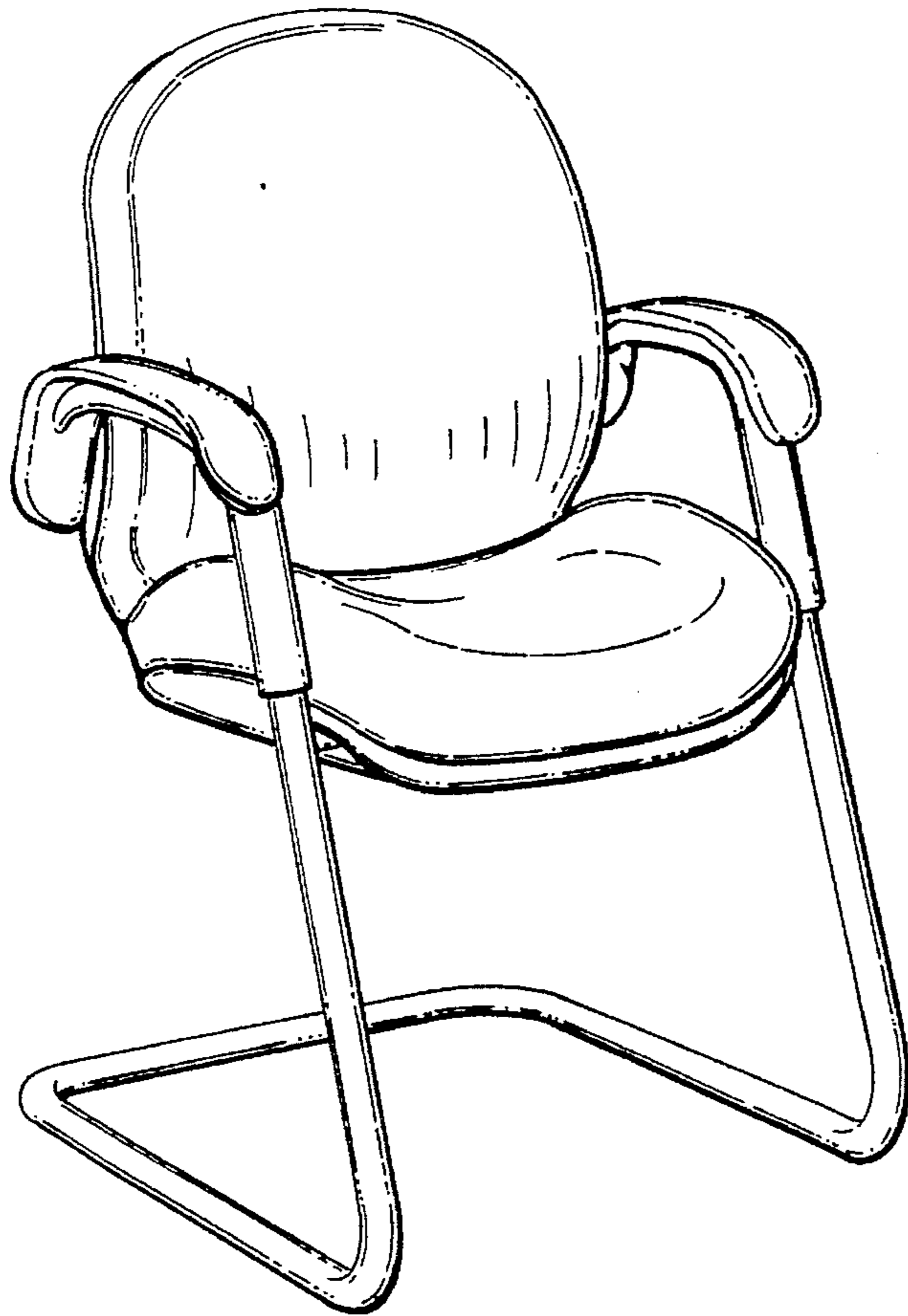

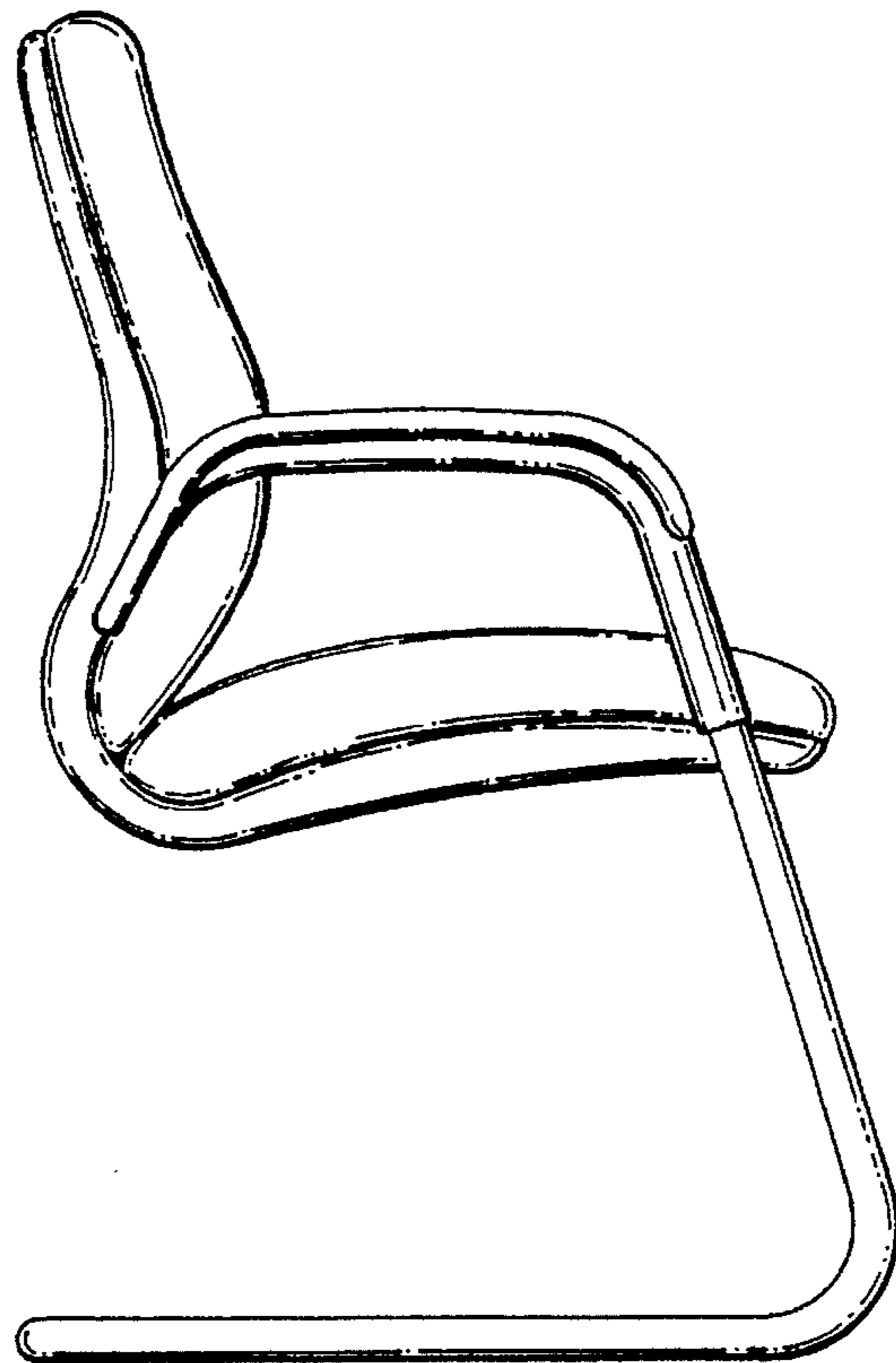

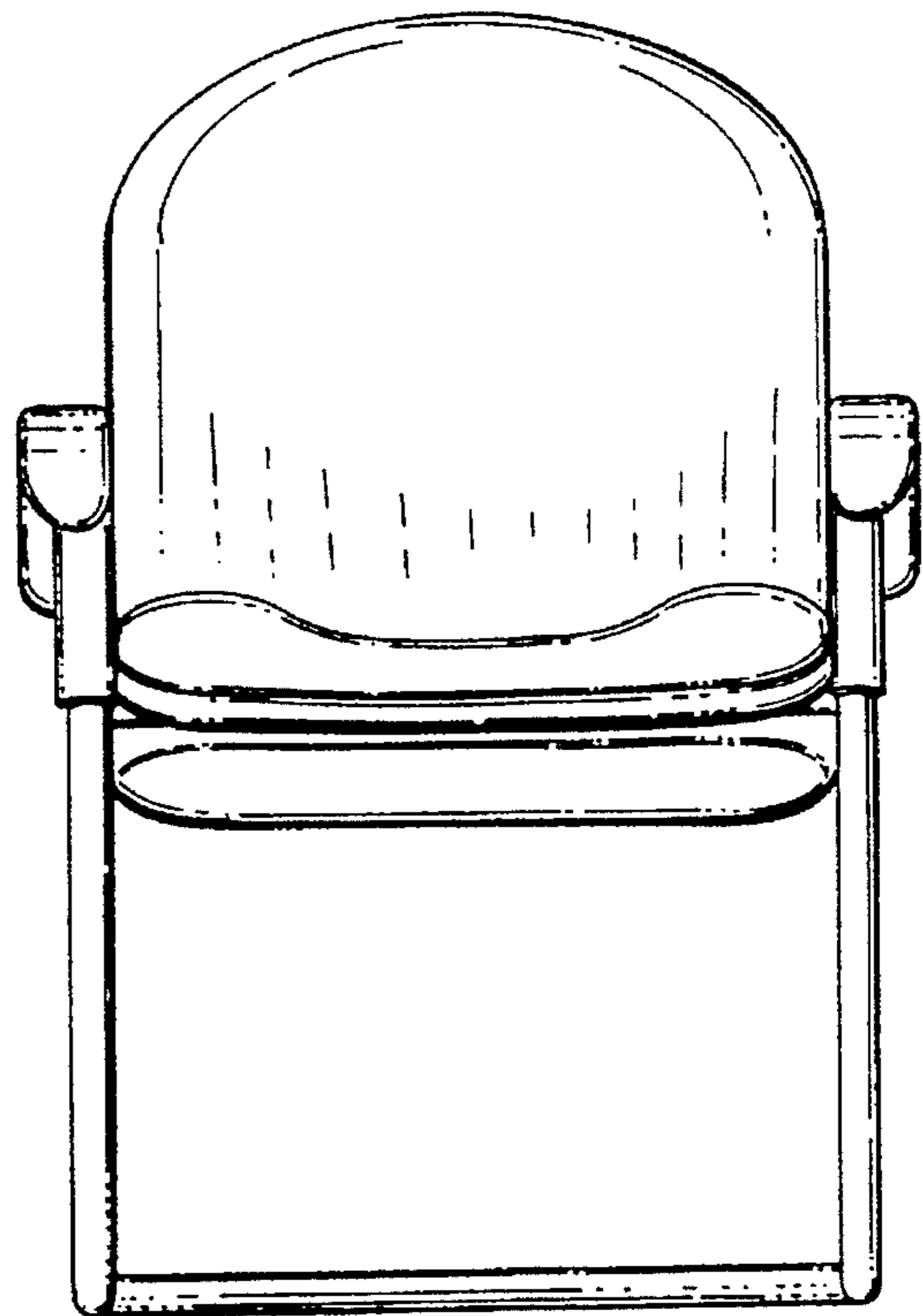

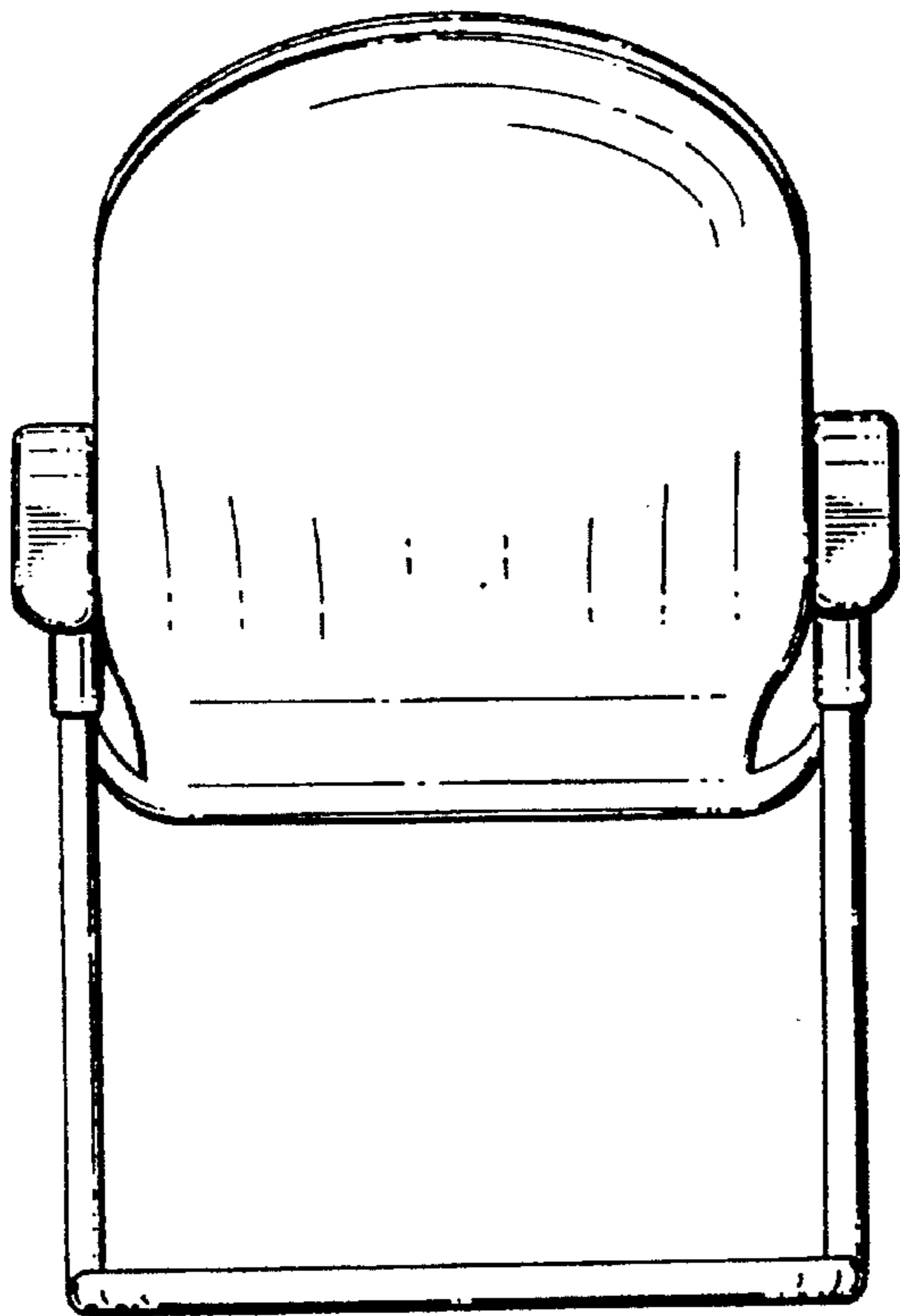

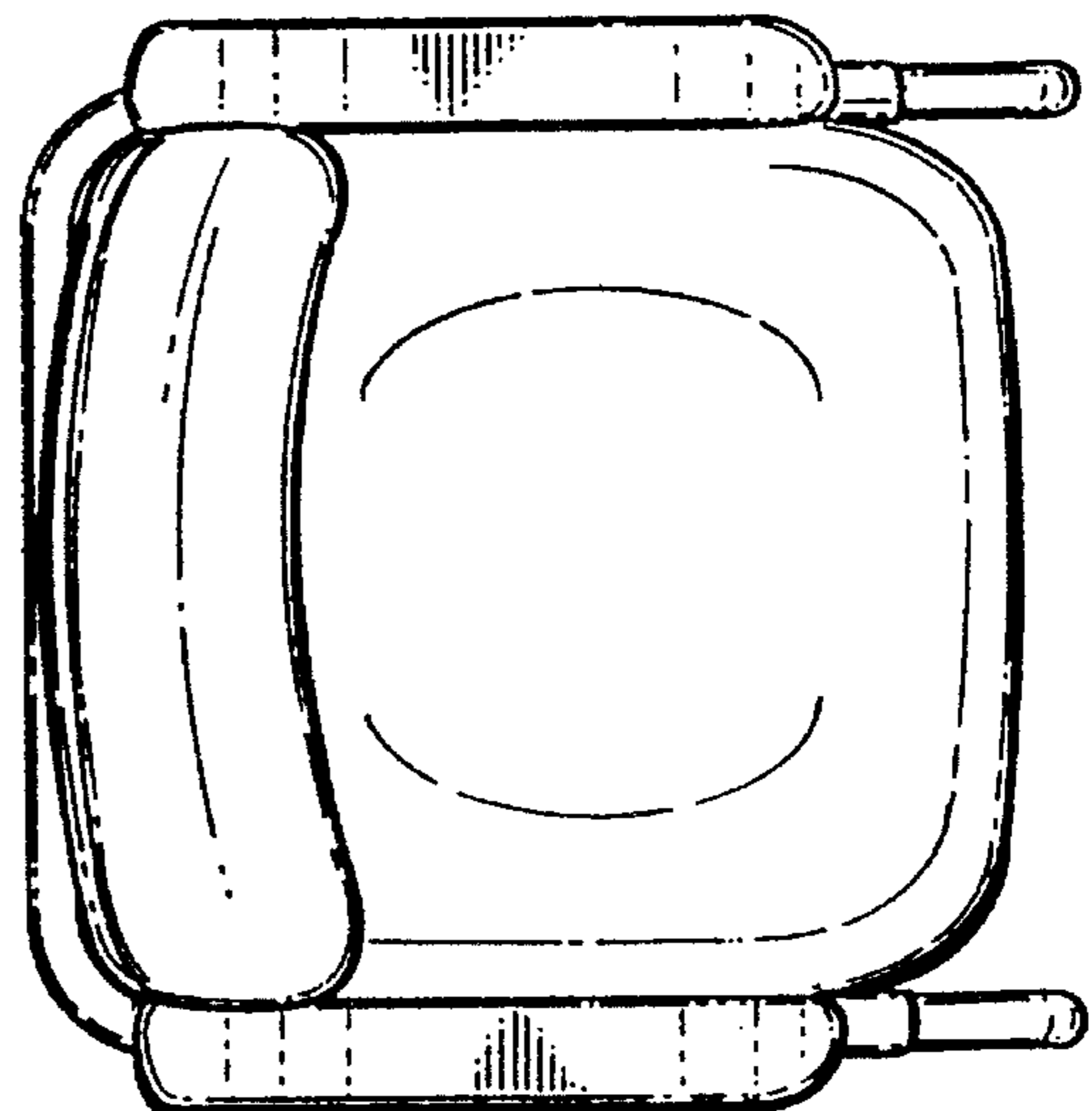
