FIG. 9 is a sectional view taken along line 9—9 of FIG. 3;

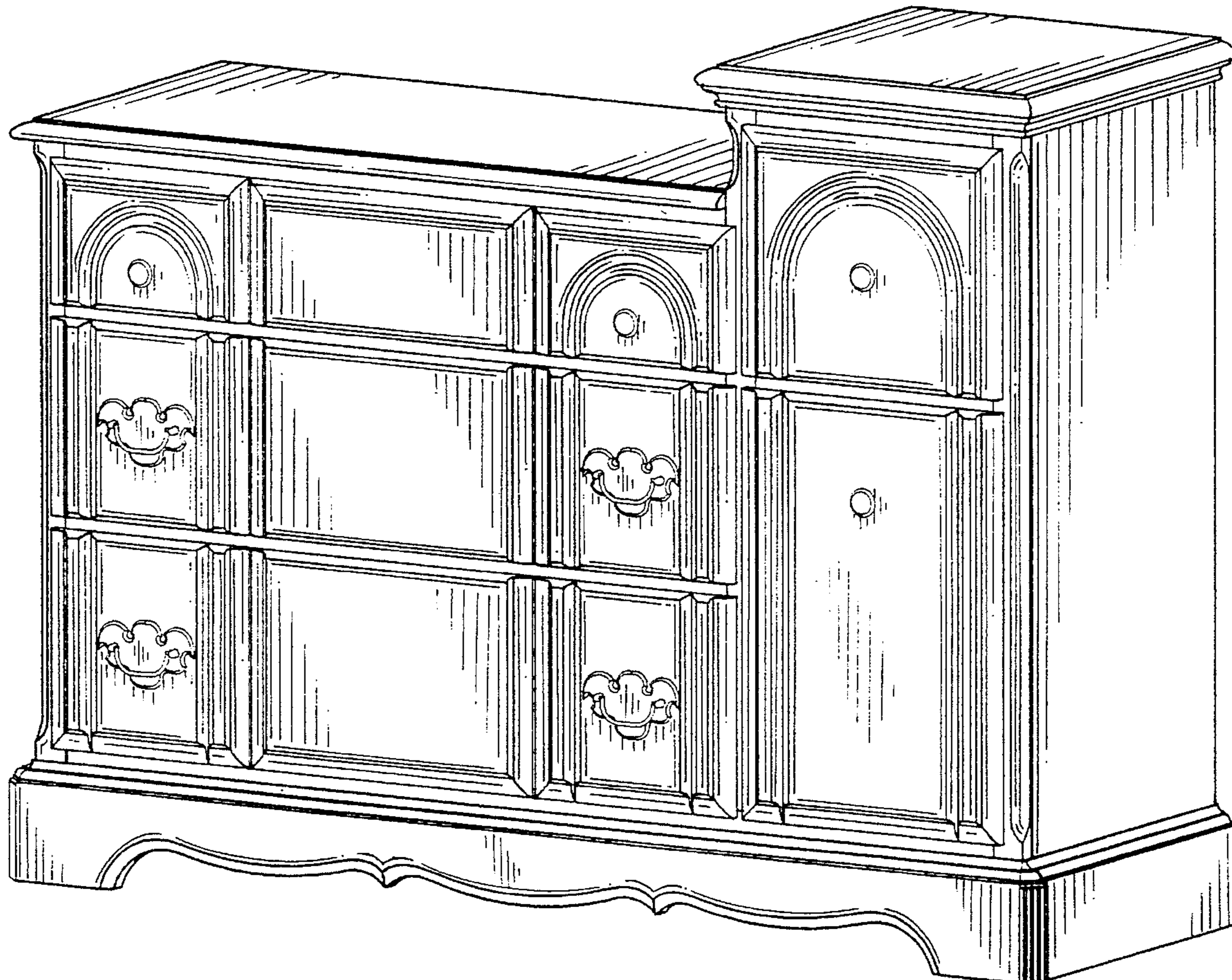
FIG. 10 is a sectional view taken along line 10—10 of FIG. 3; and,

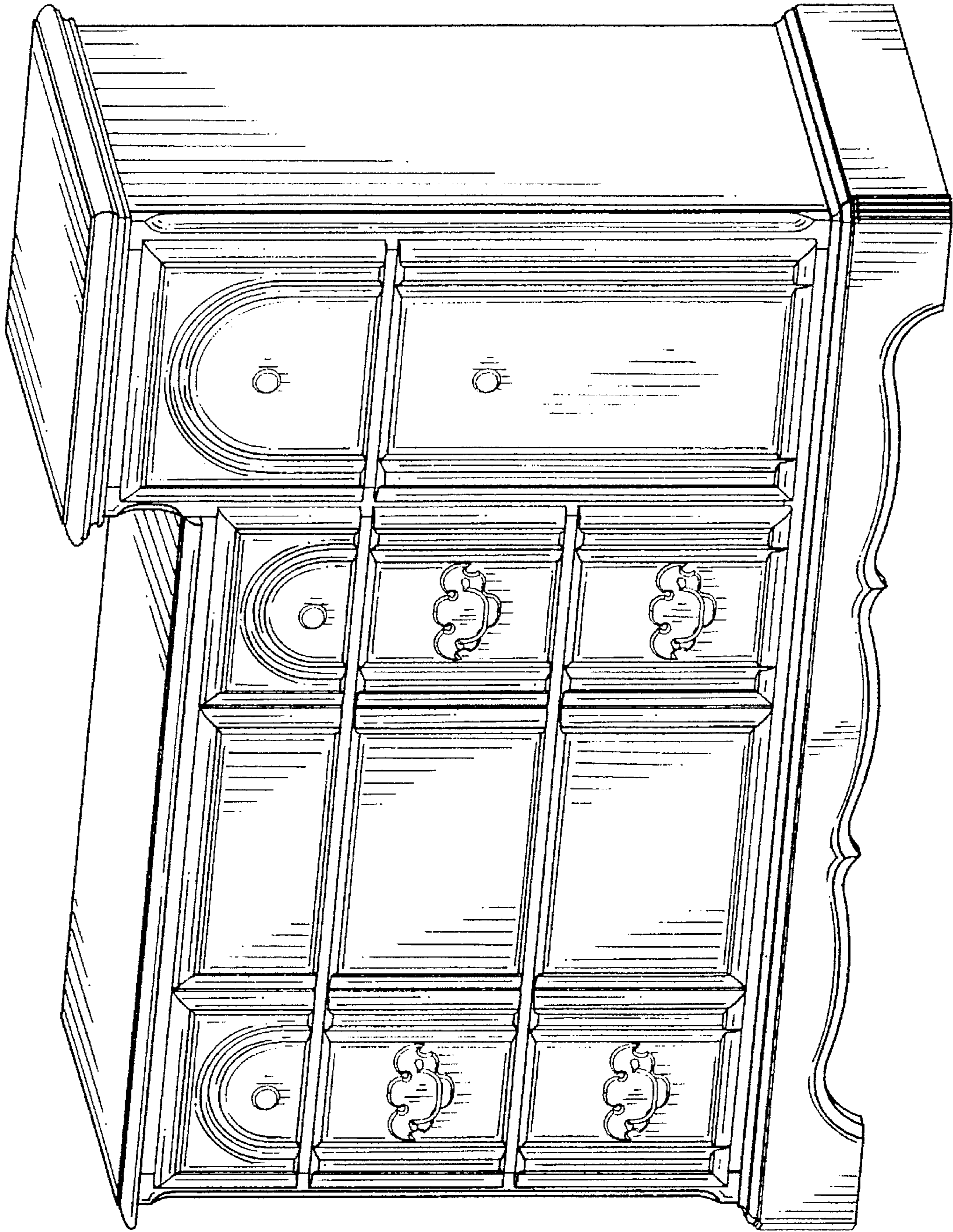

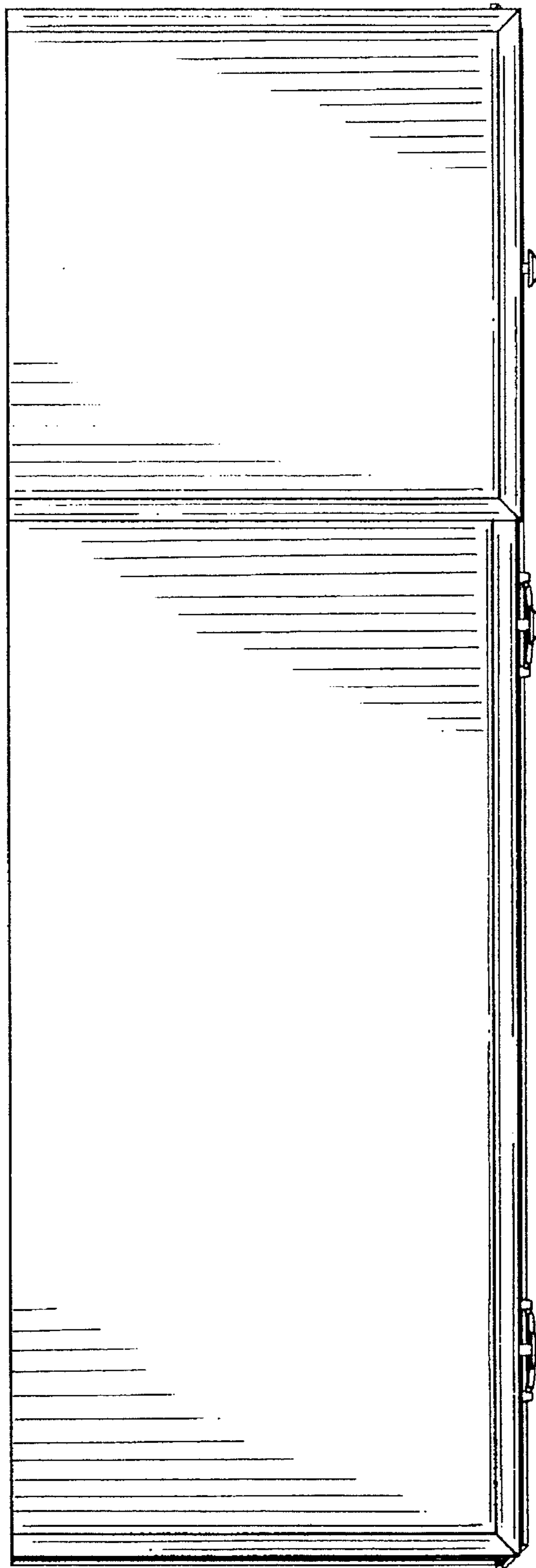

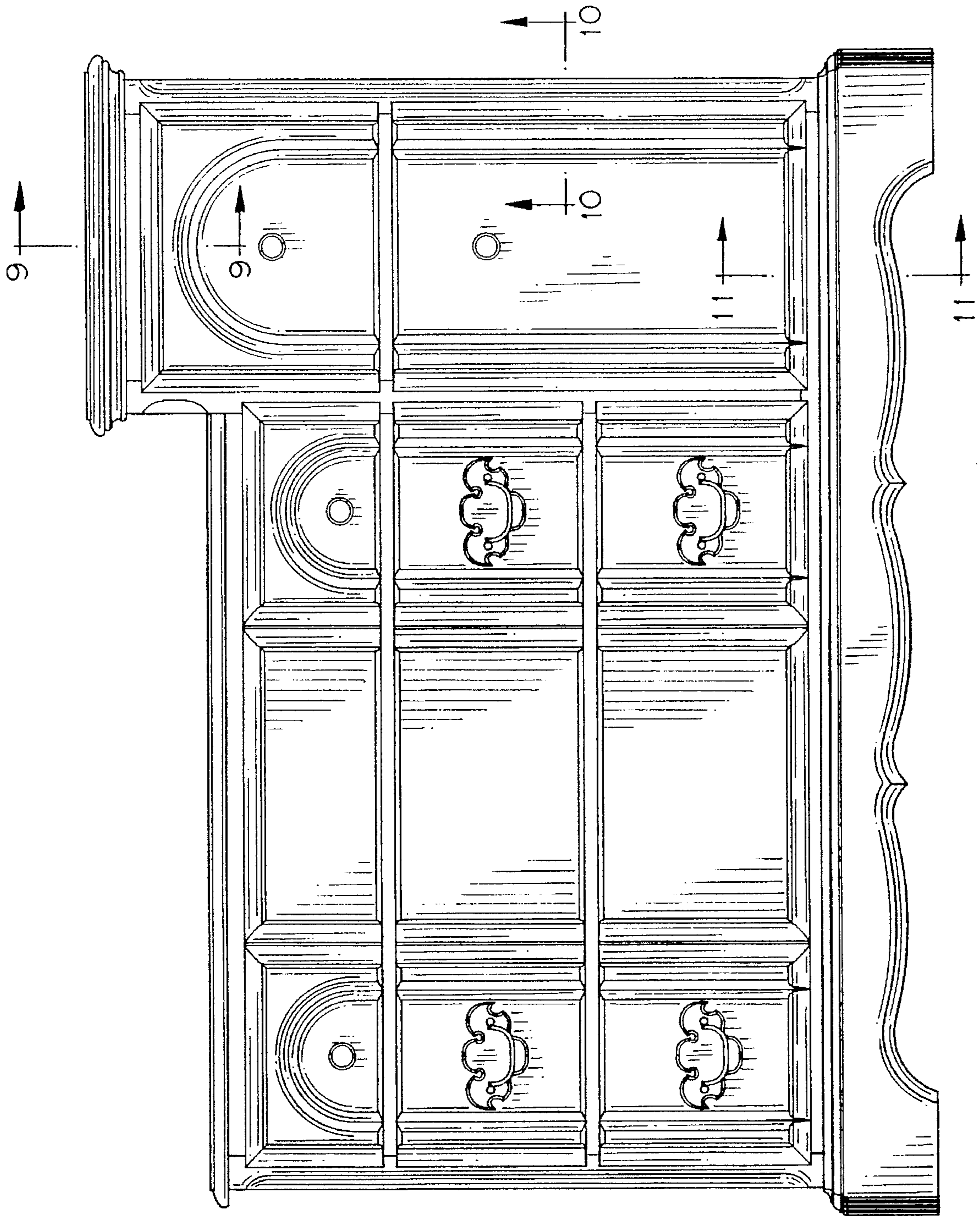

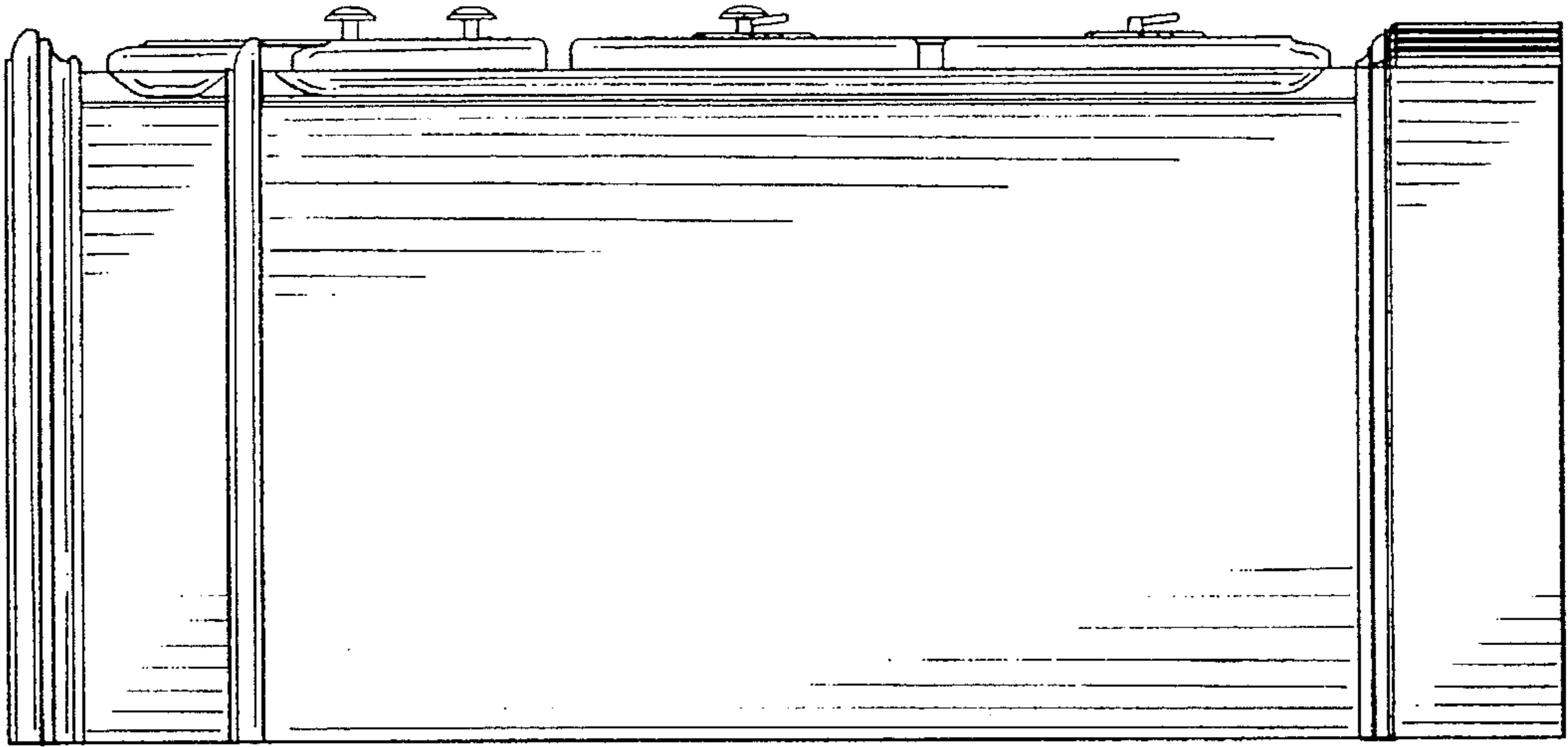
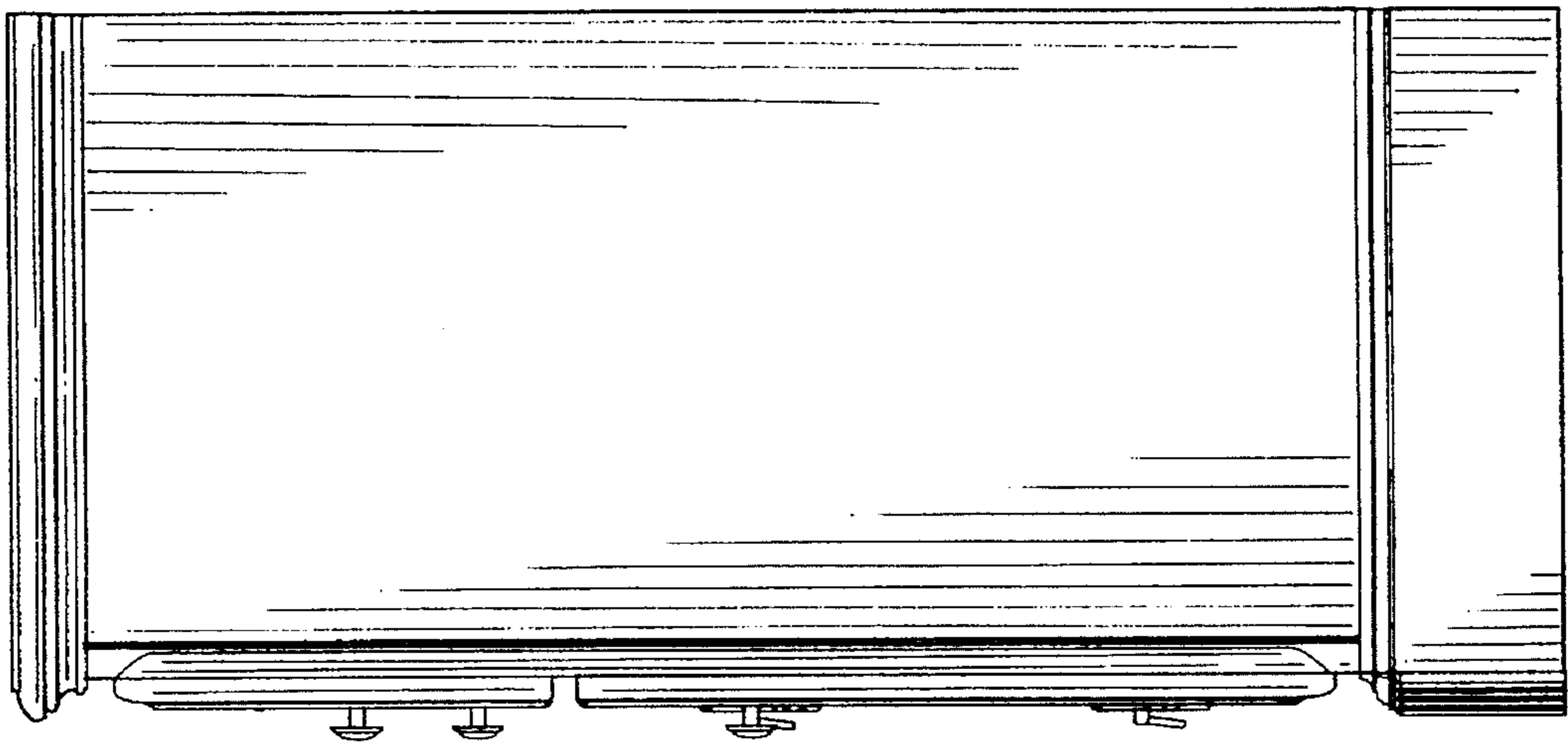

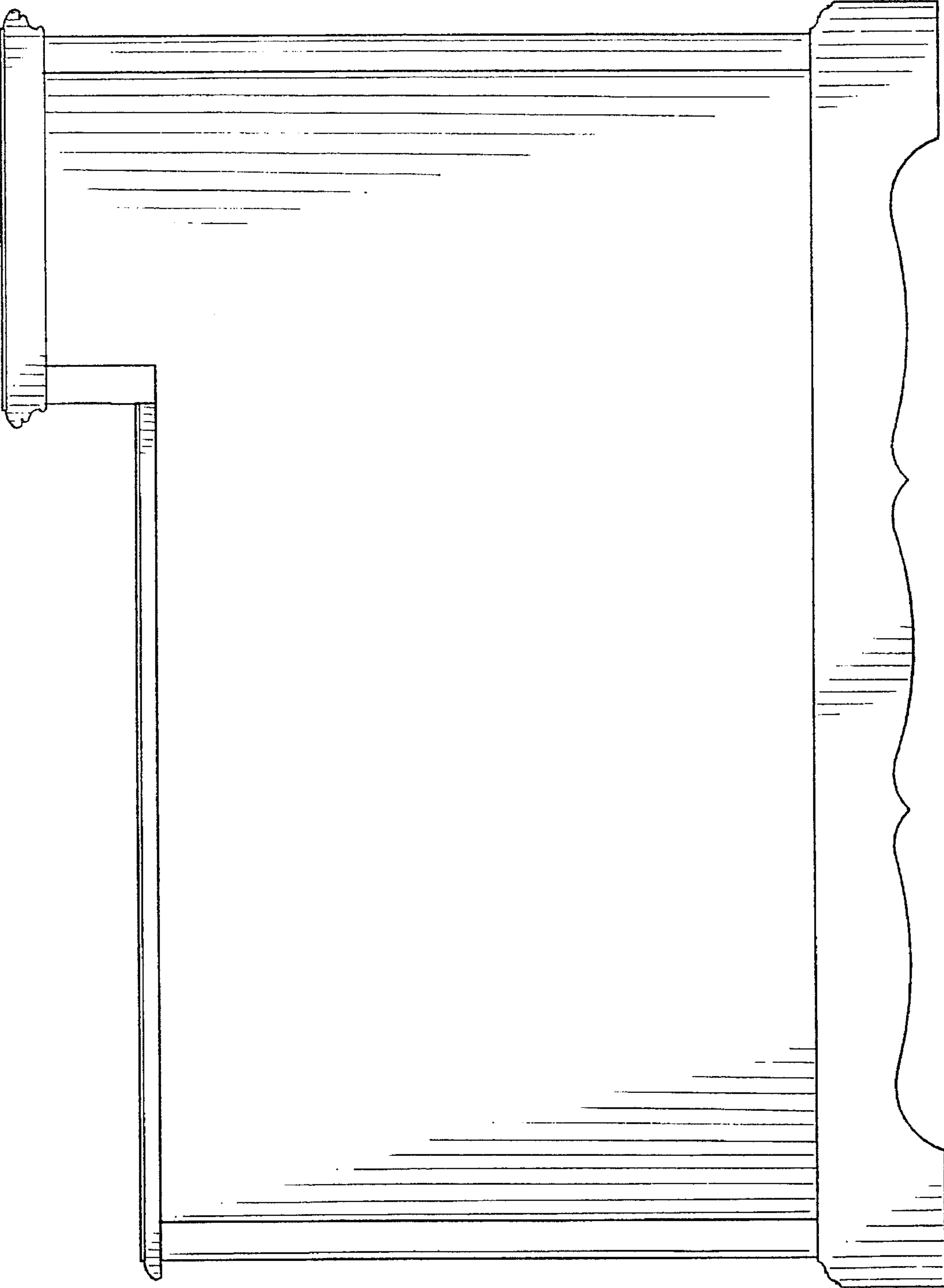
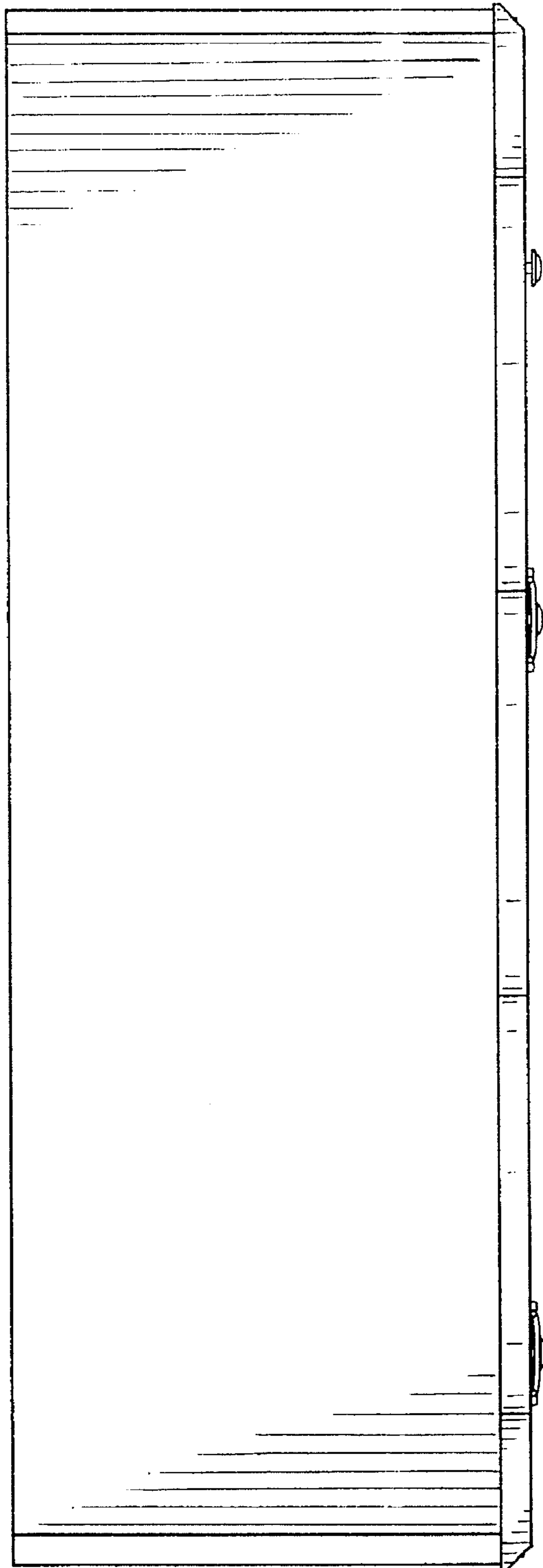

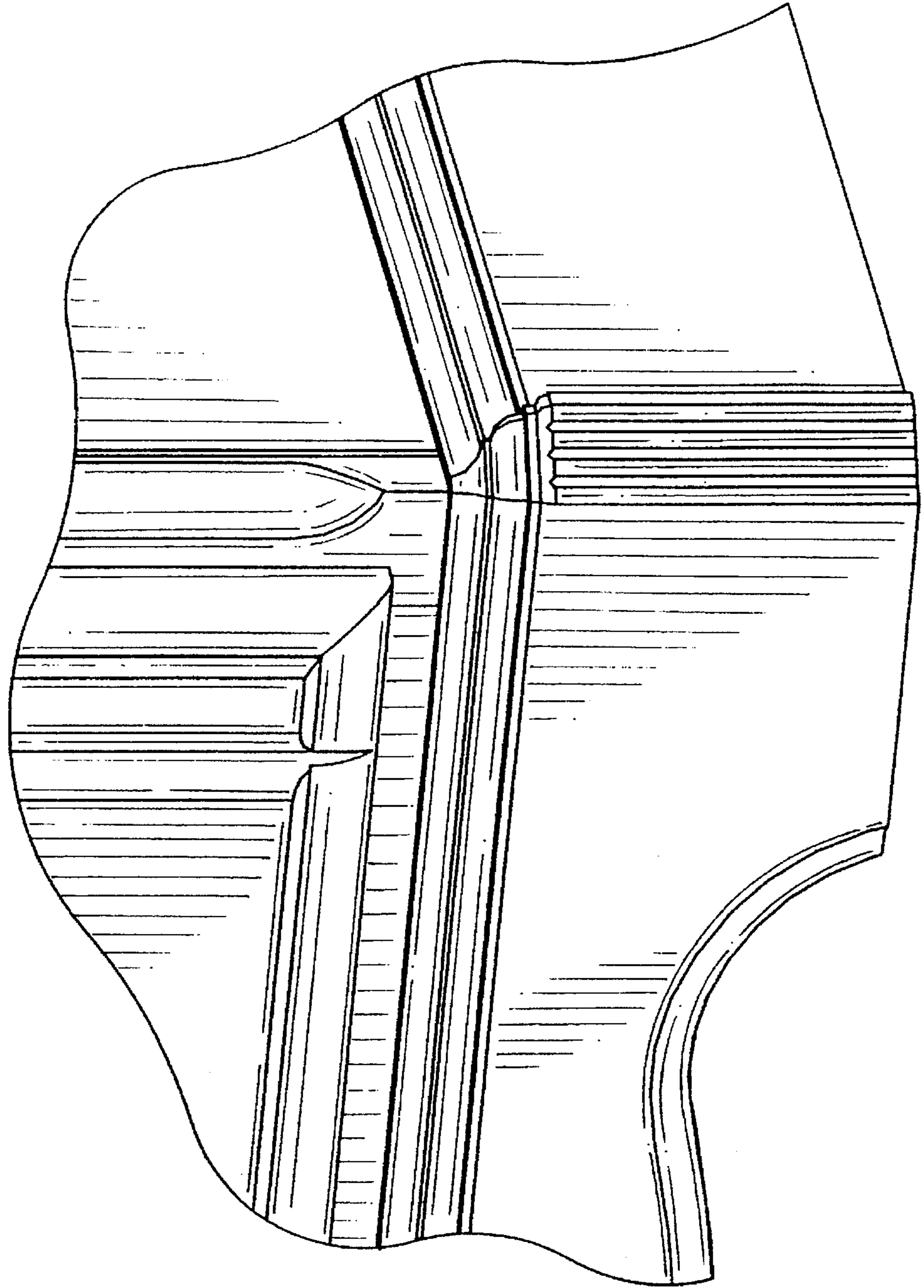

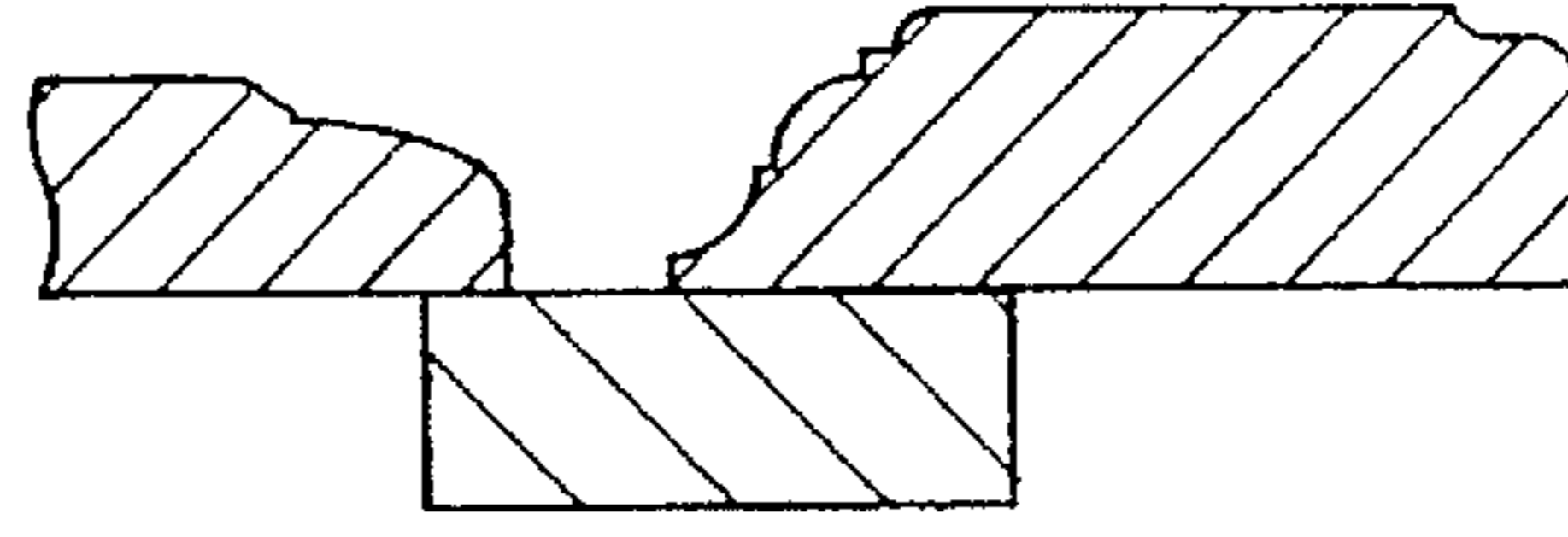

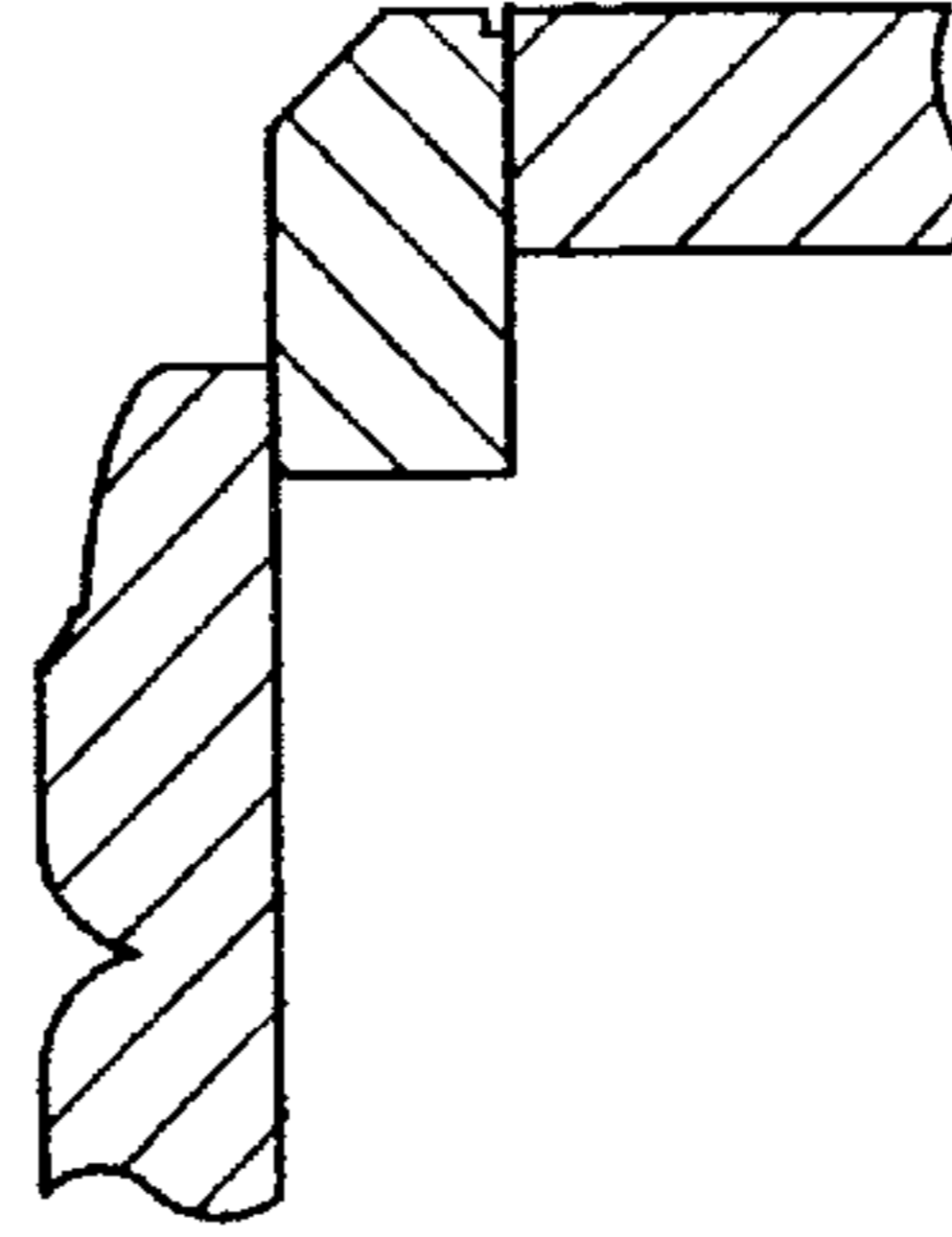
