FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 2 shown rotated 90 degrees in a clockwise direction, the broken line showing the show upper being for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

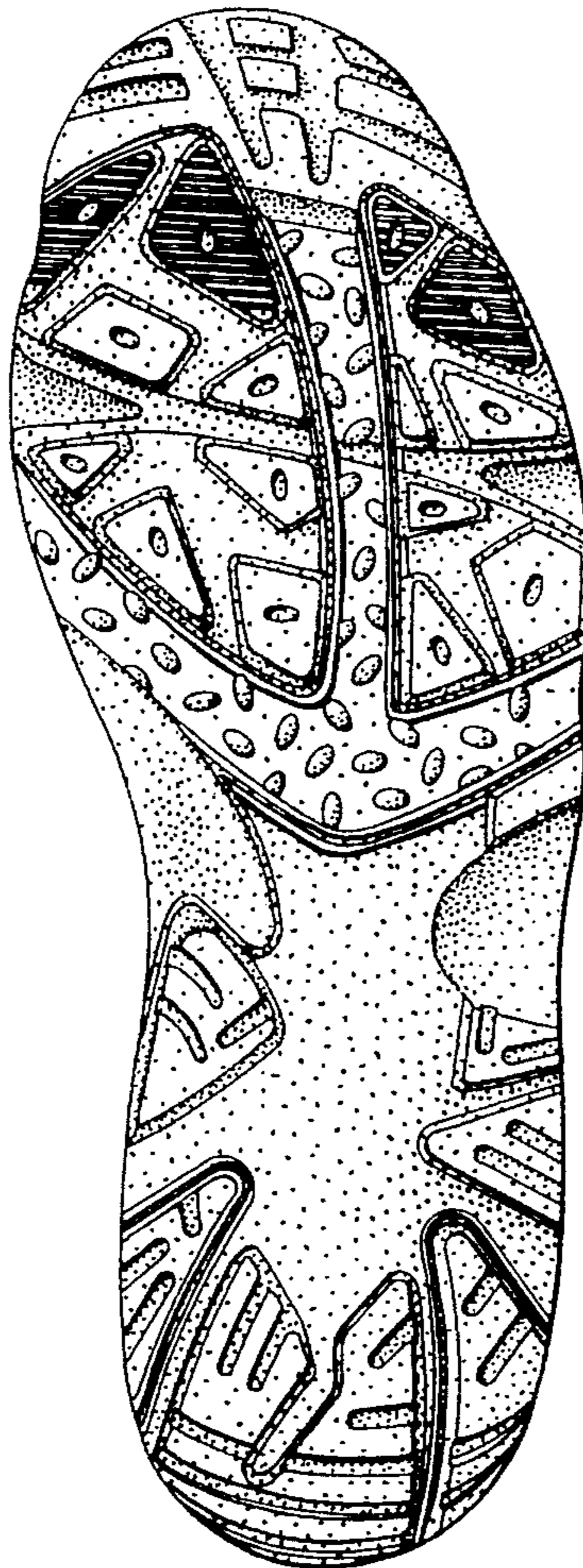

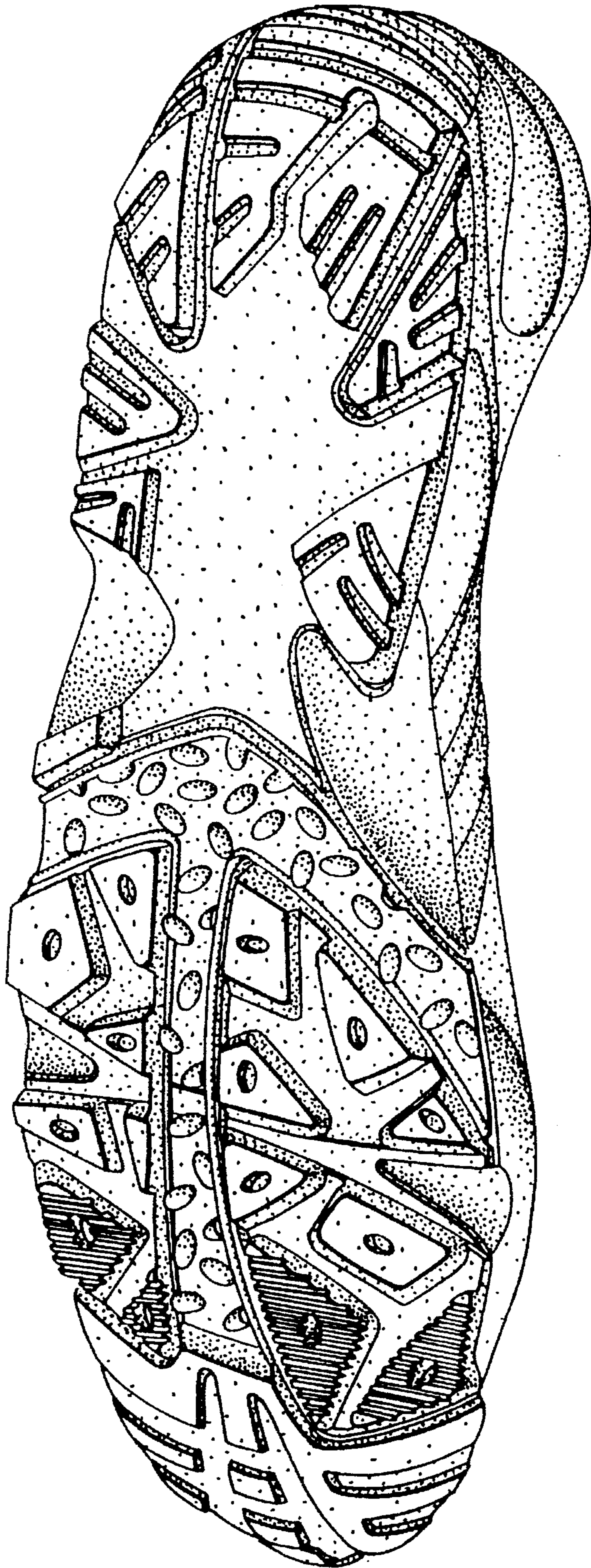

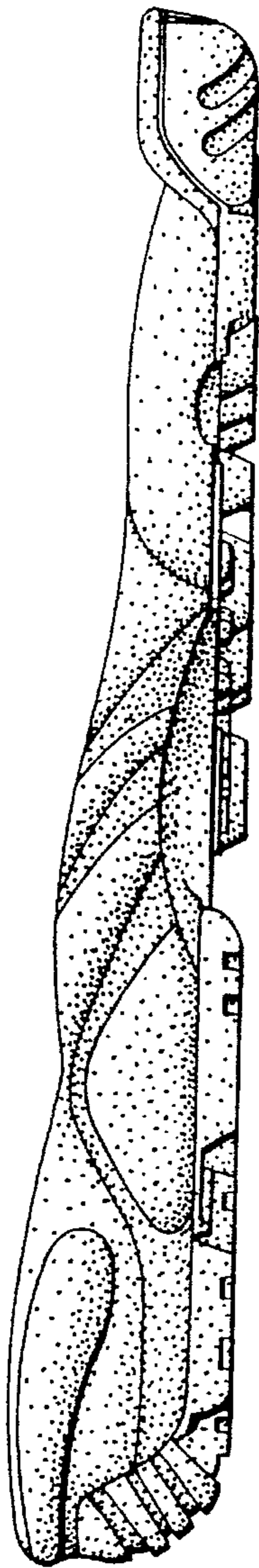

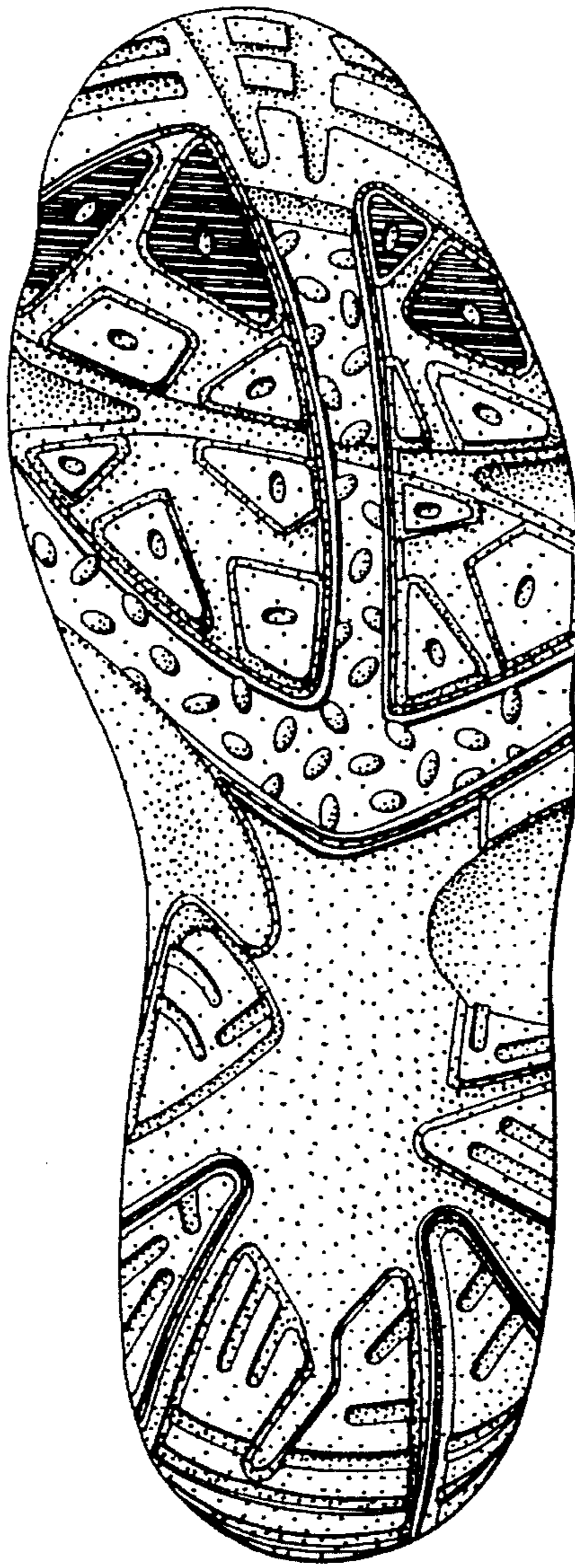

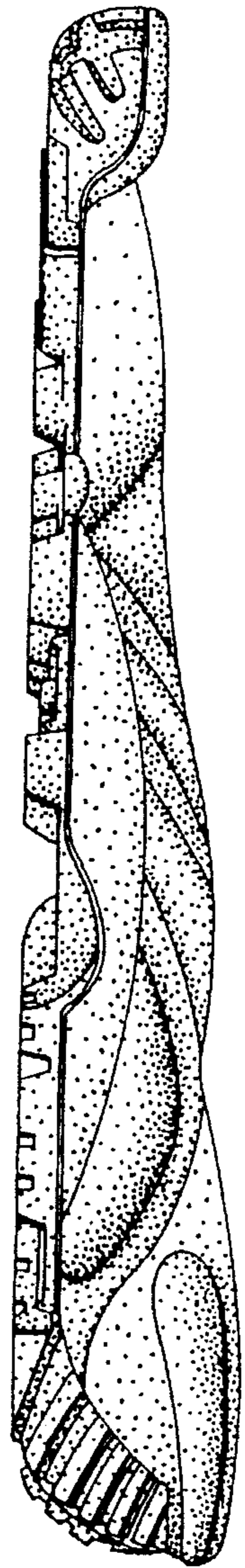

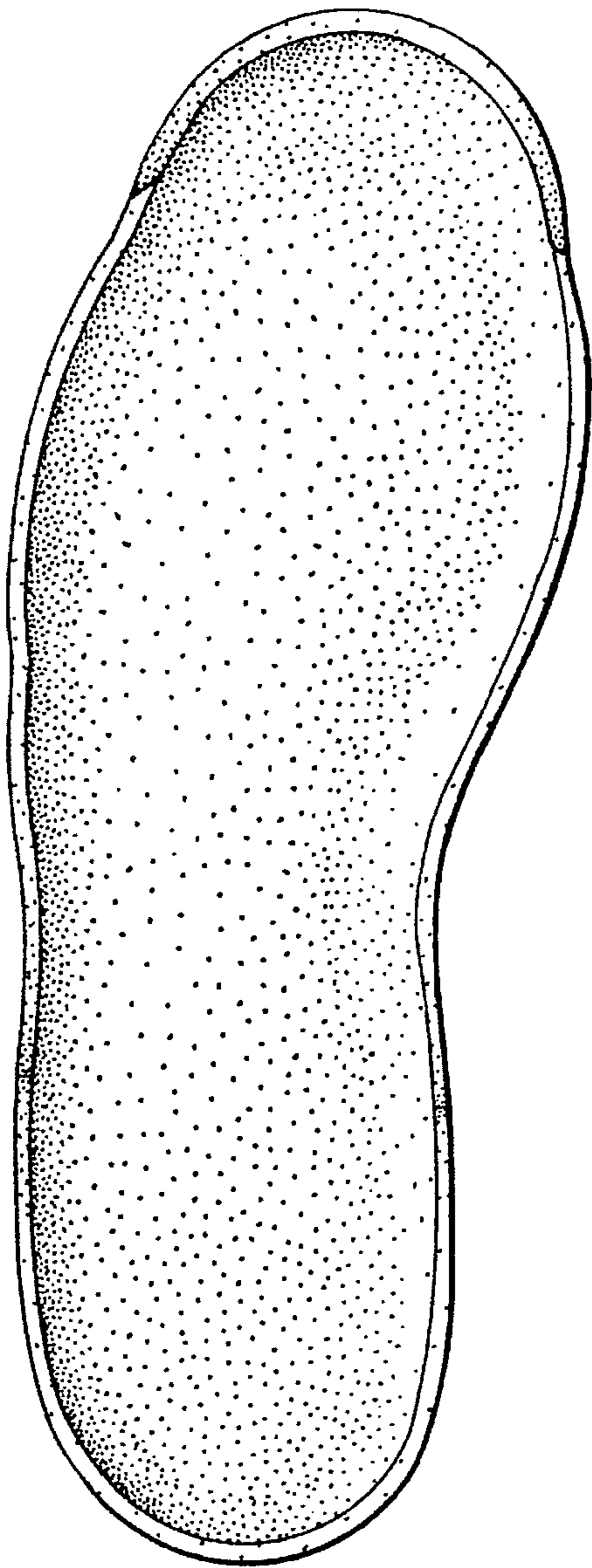

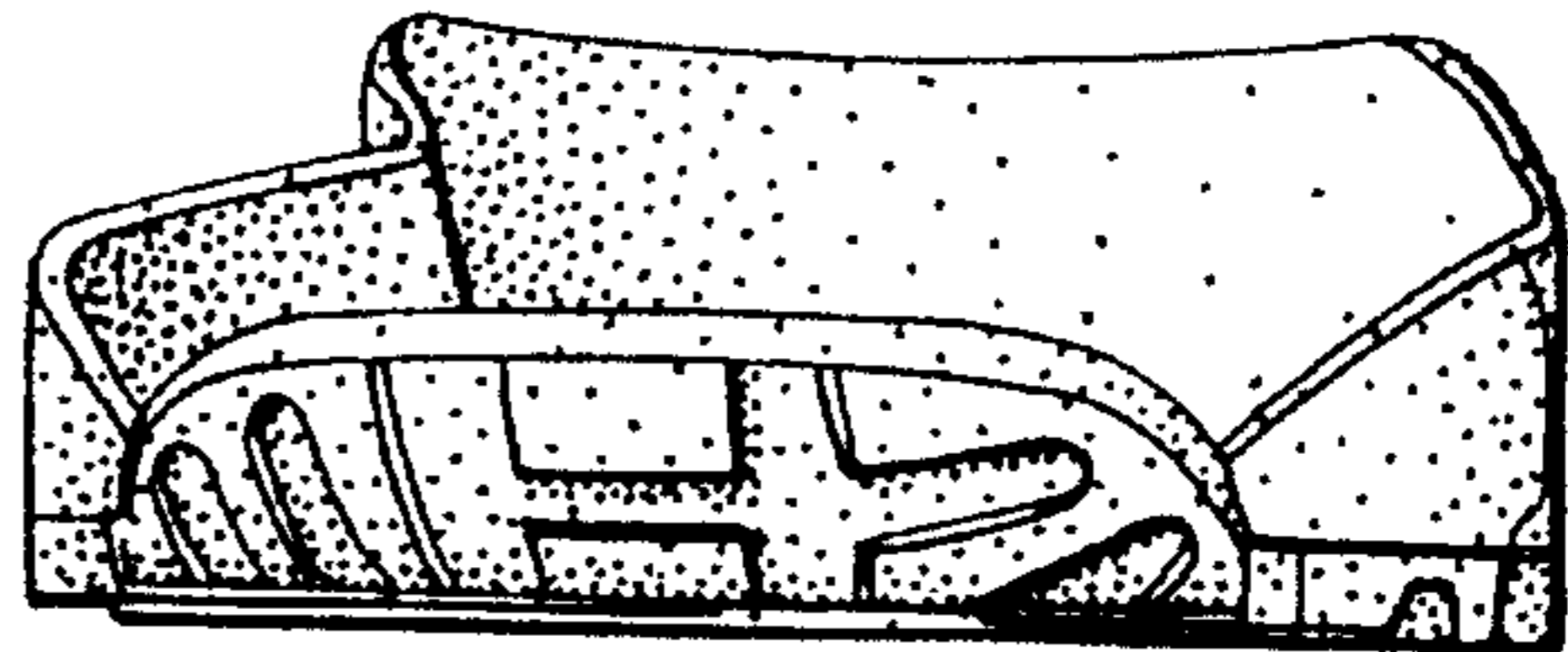

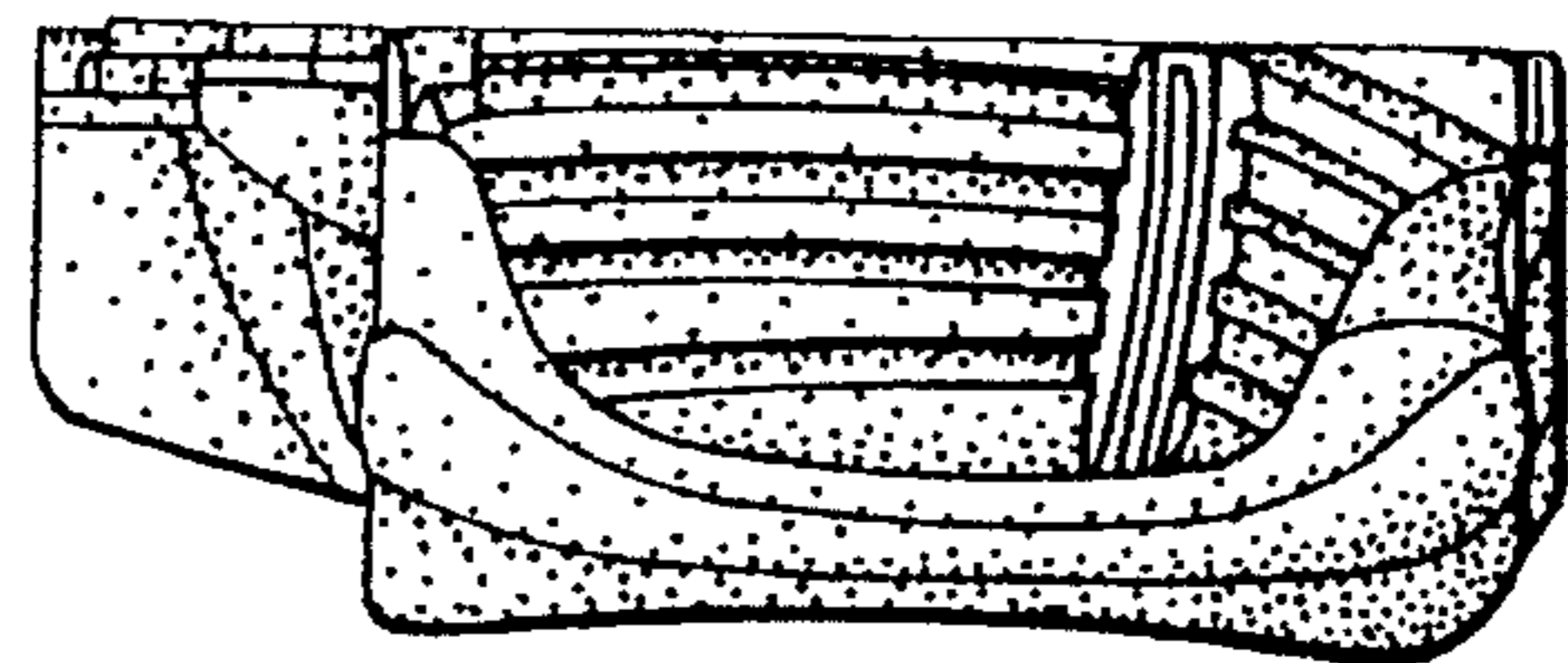
