DESCRIPTION

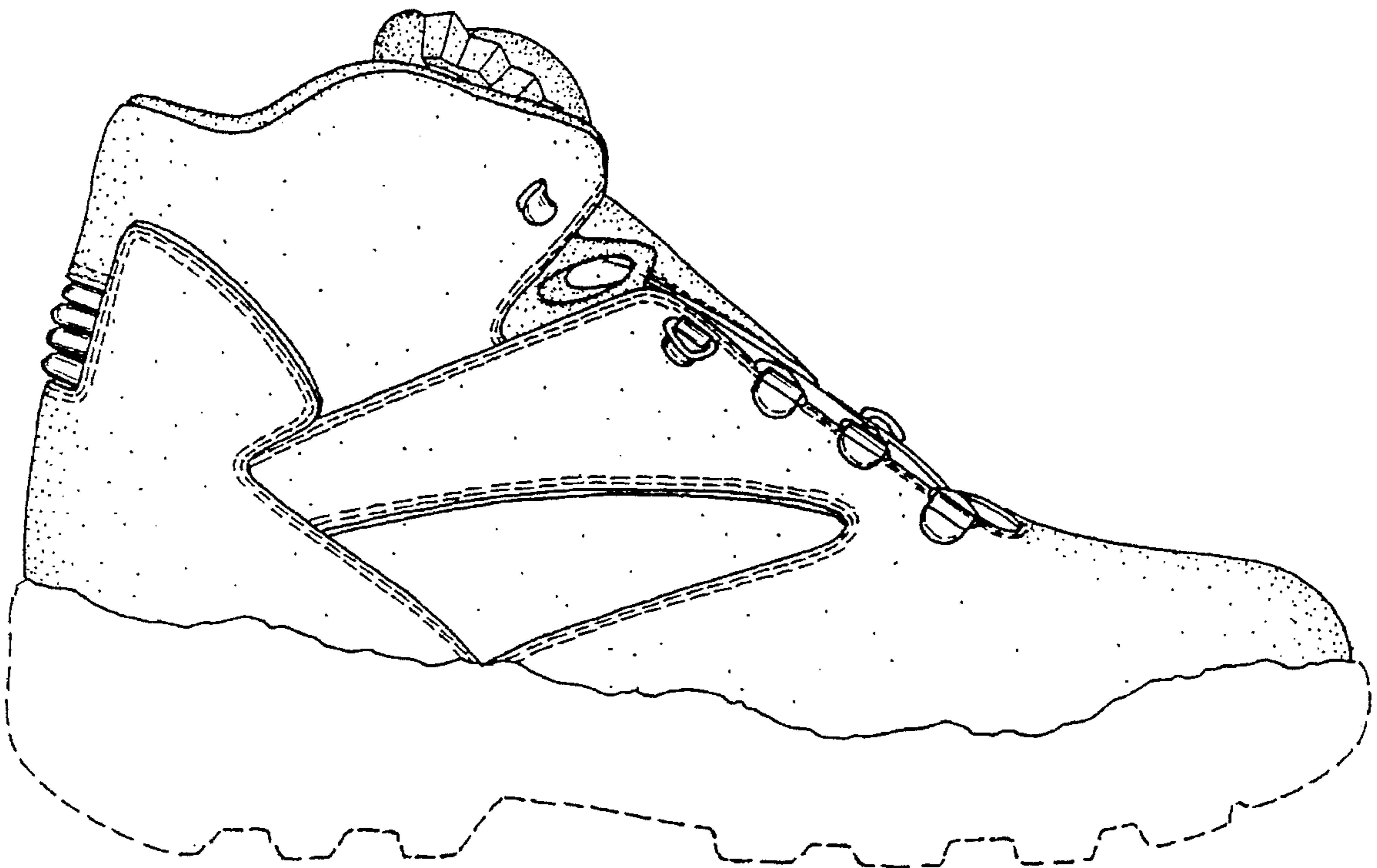
FIG. 1 is left side elevational view of a shoe upper showing my new design;

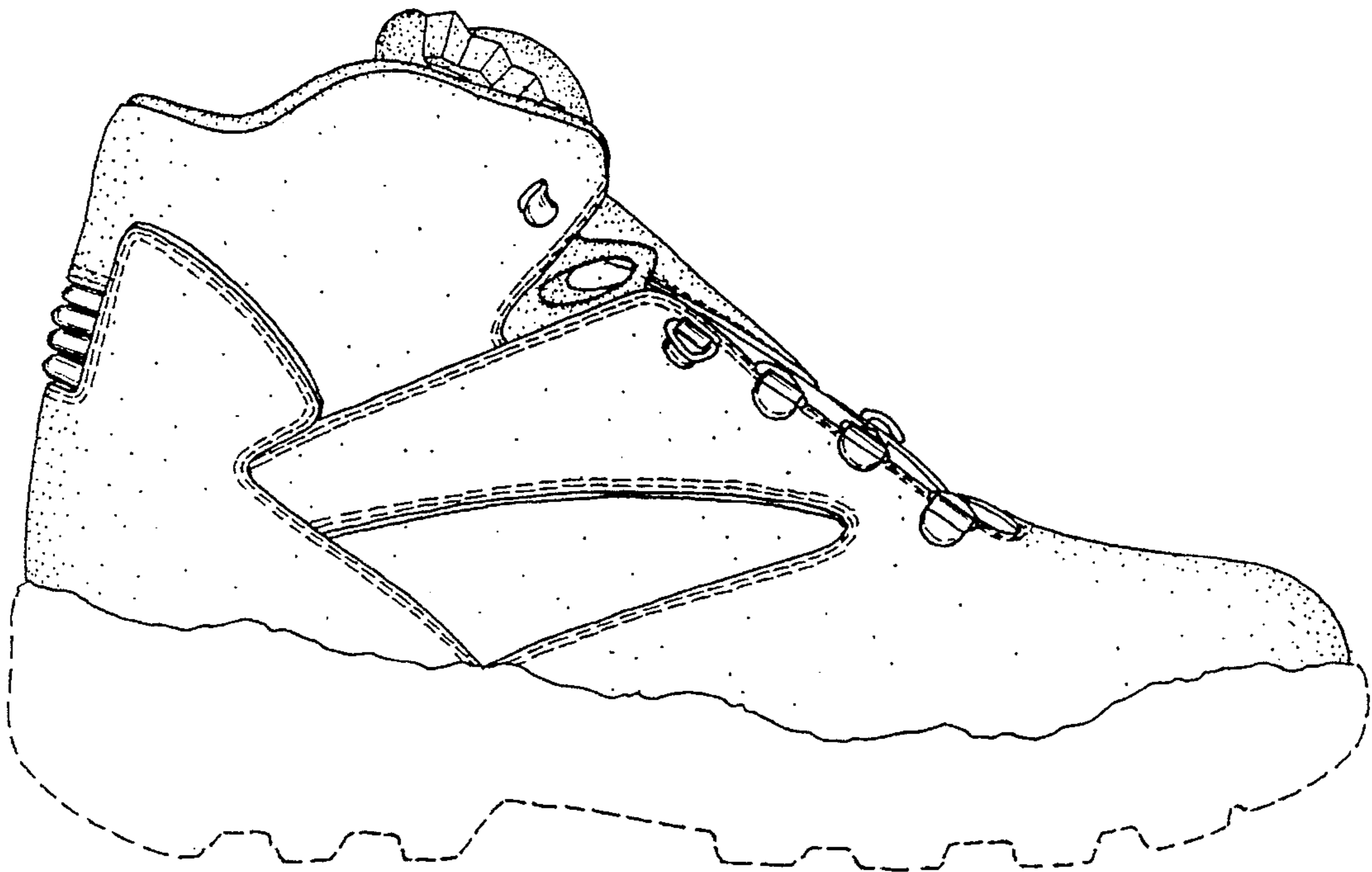

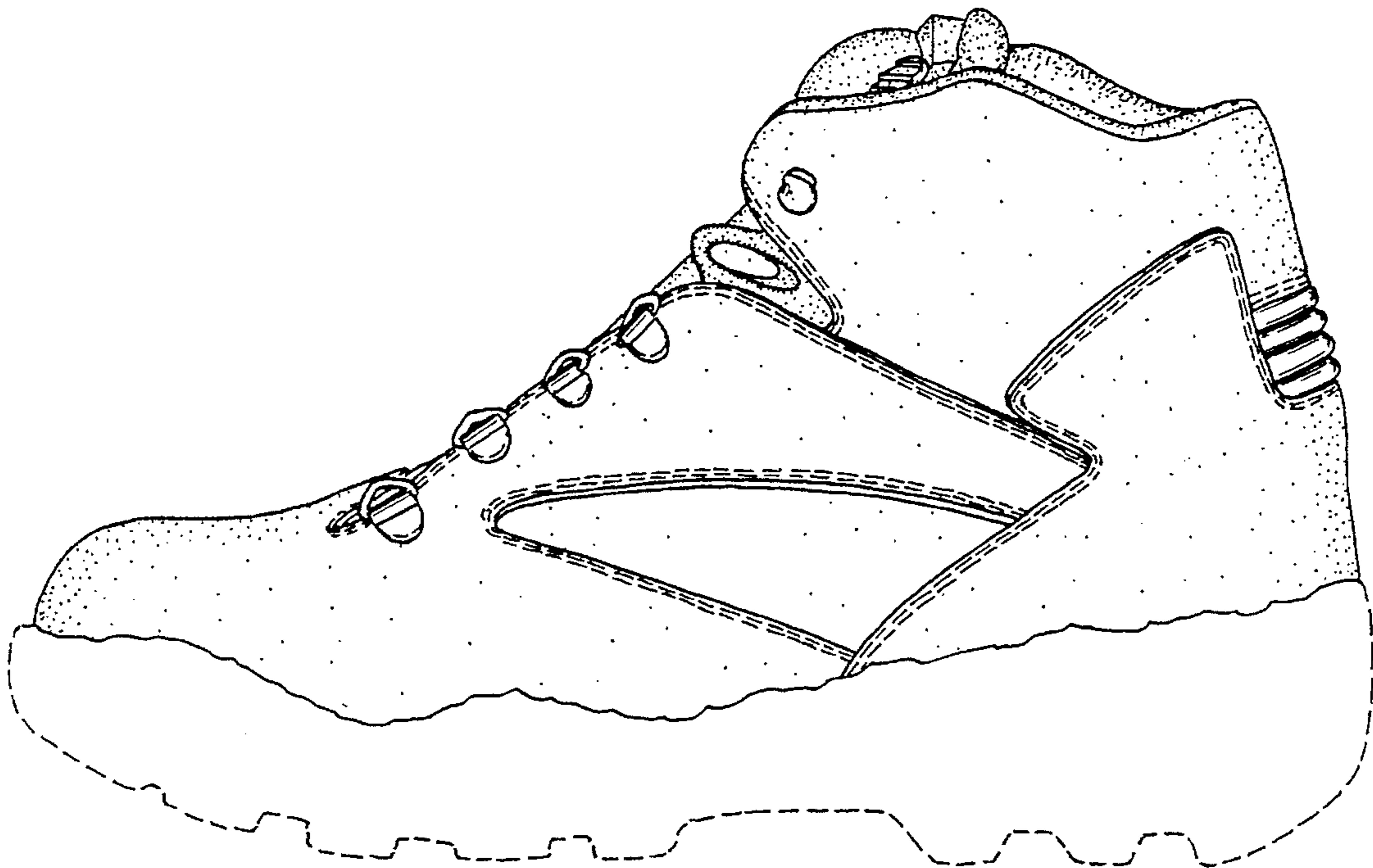

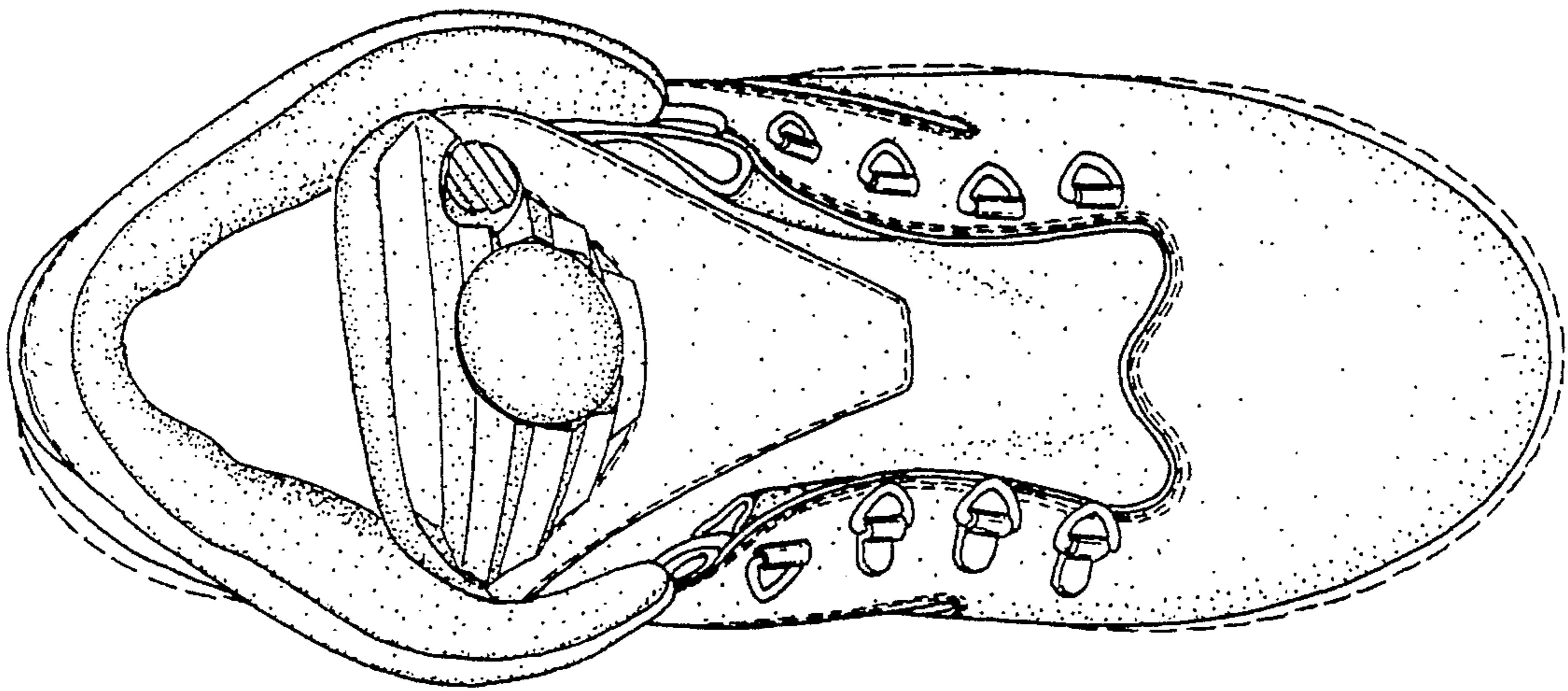

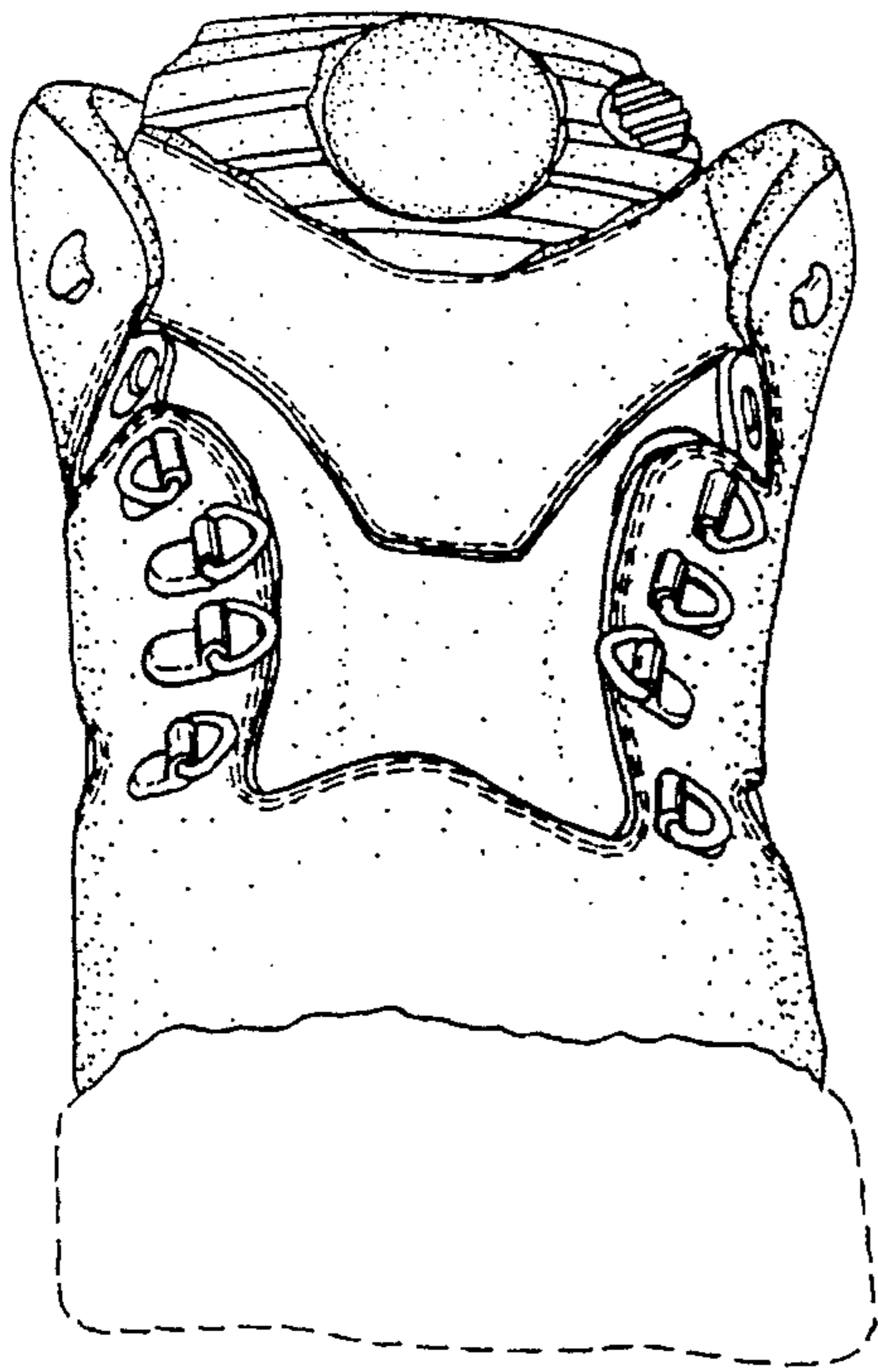

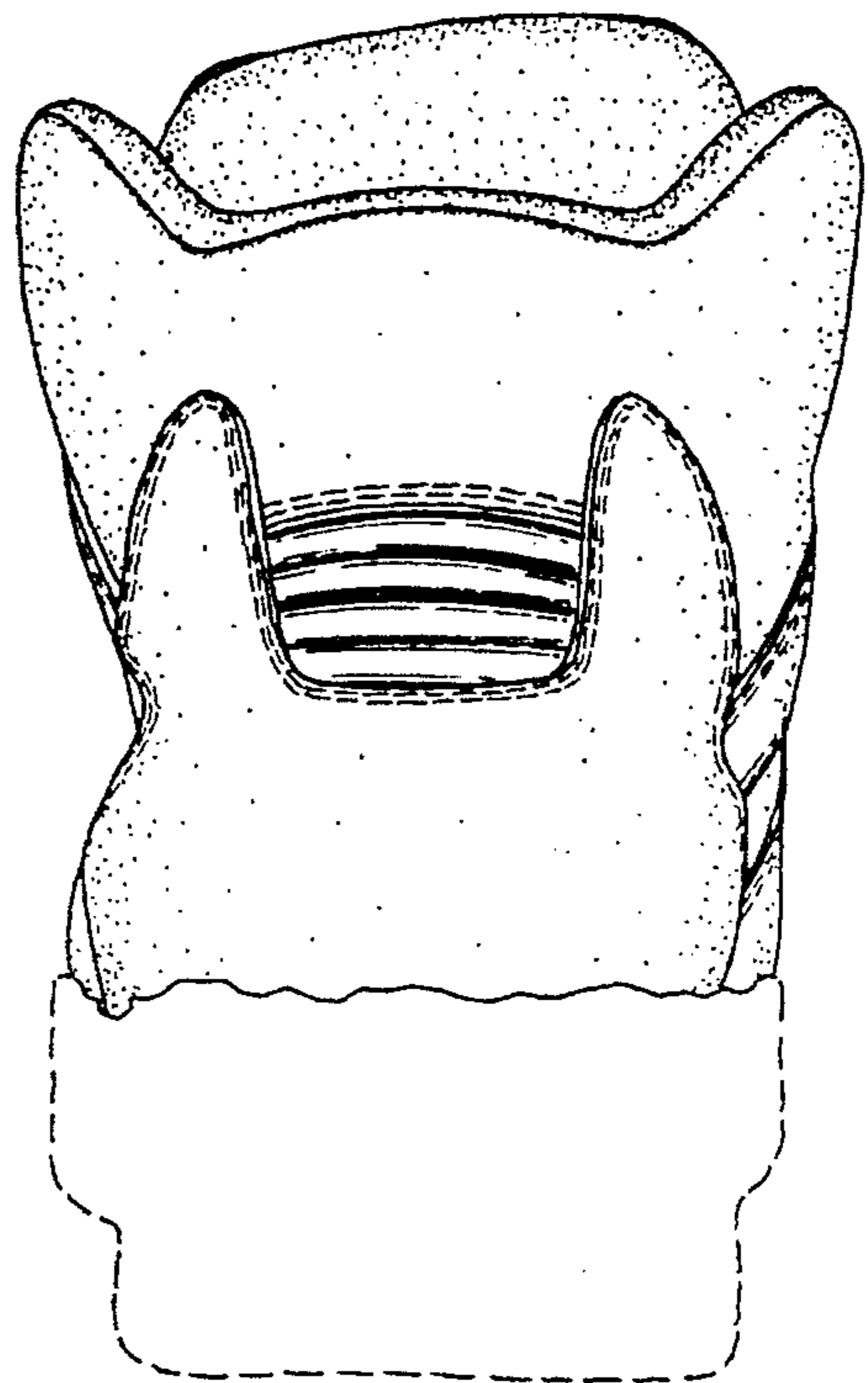
