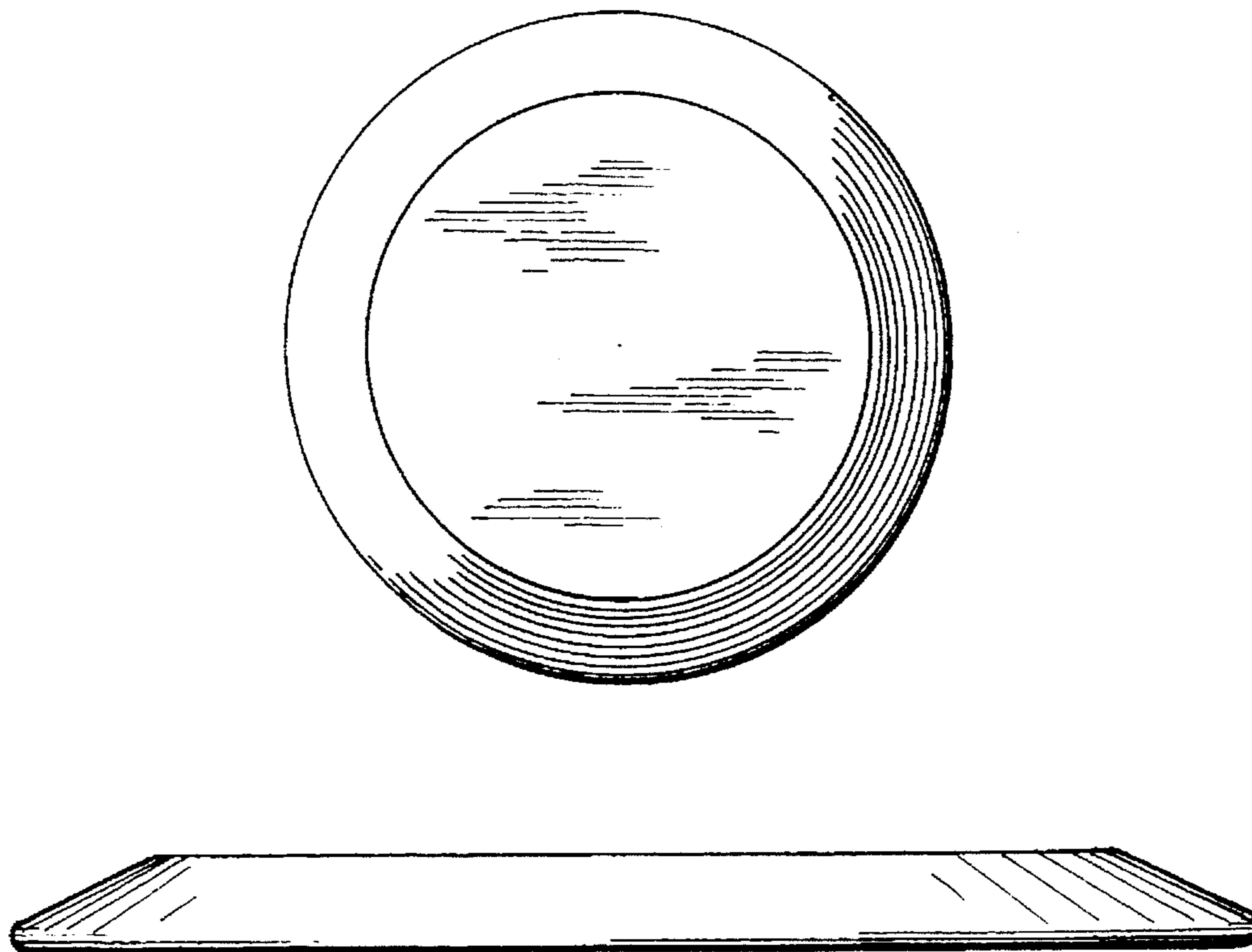
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an identification transponder tag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an identification tag showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, with the opposite sides being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a second embodiment thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a third embodiment thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

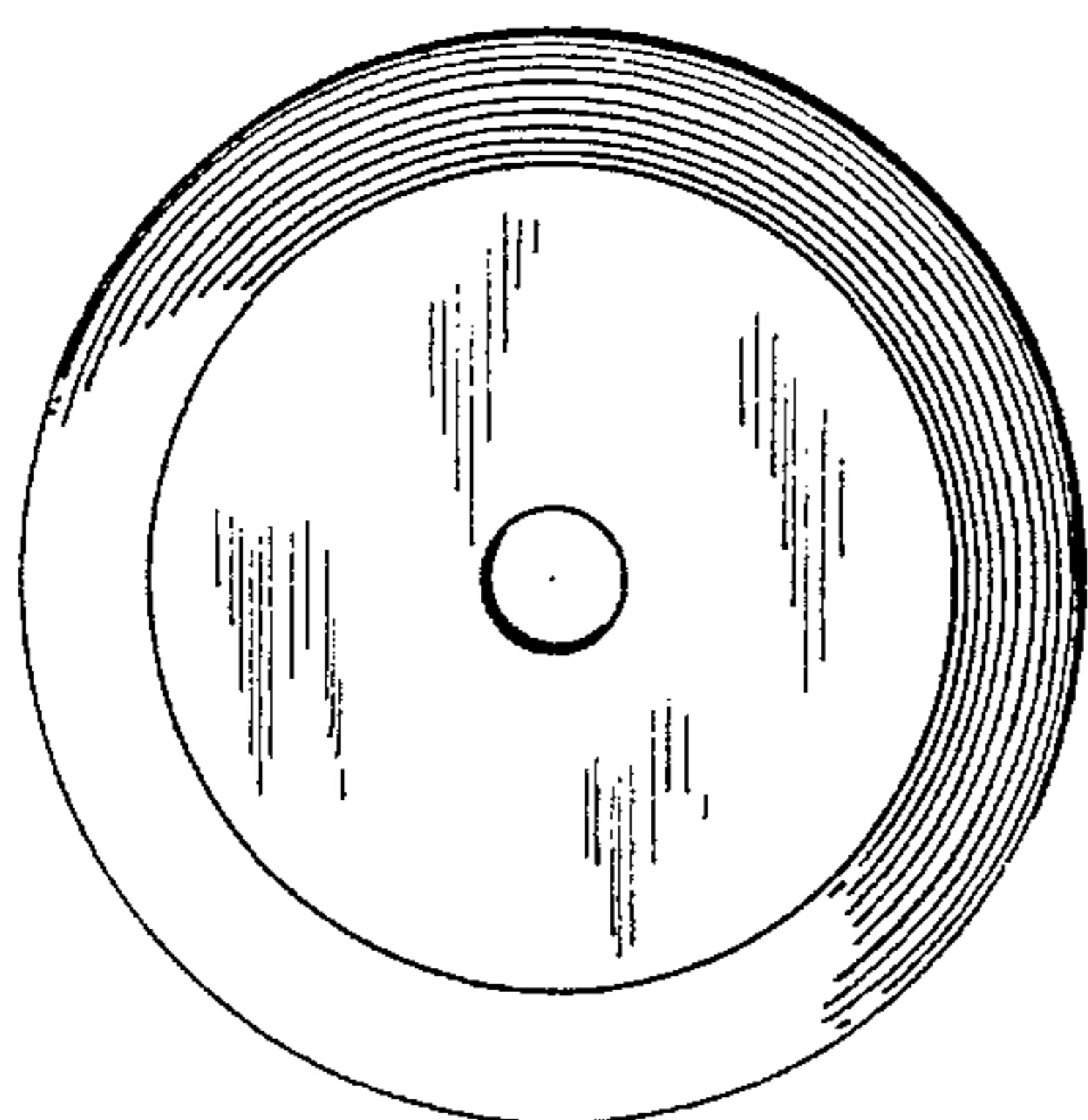

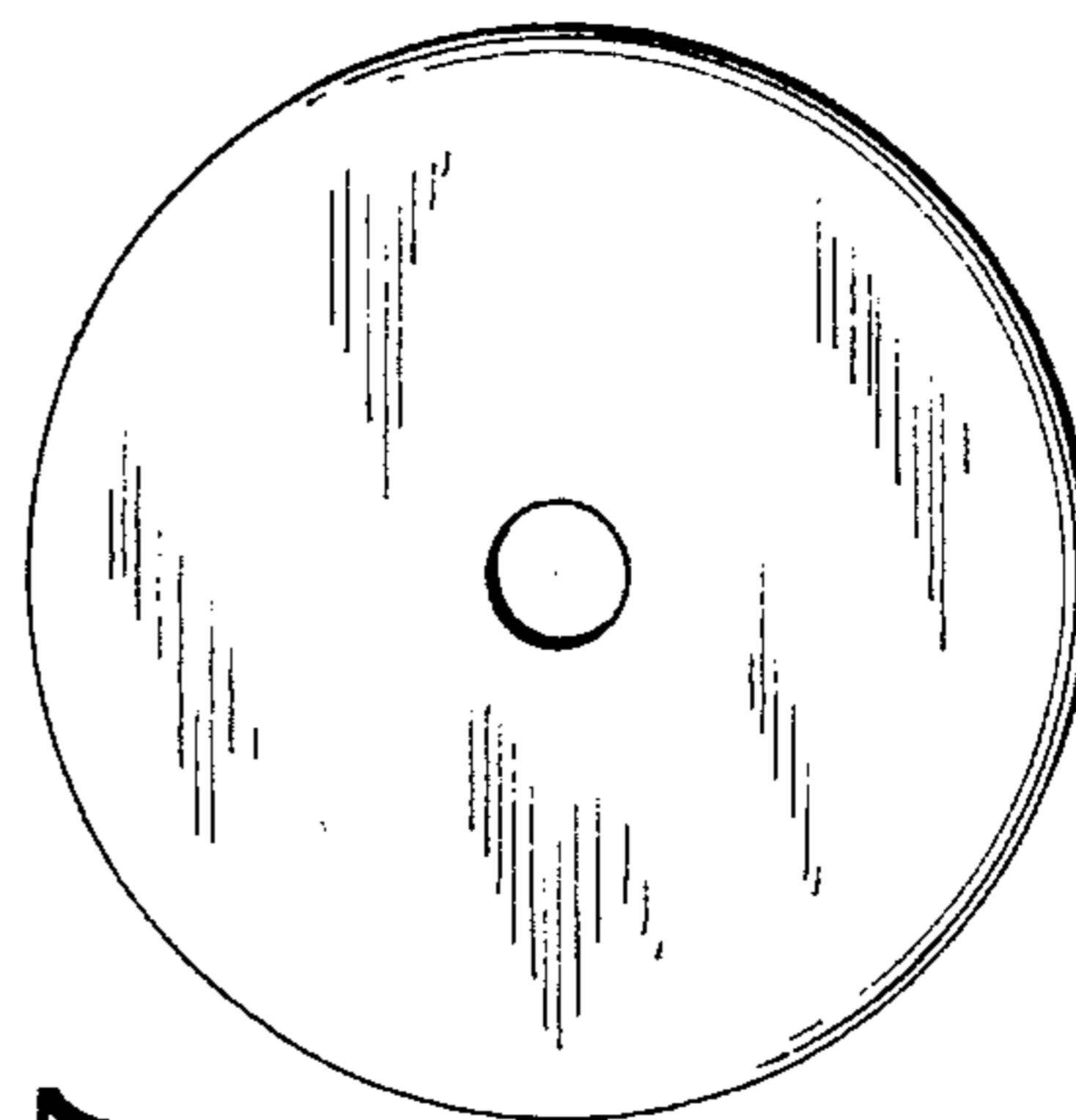

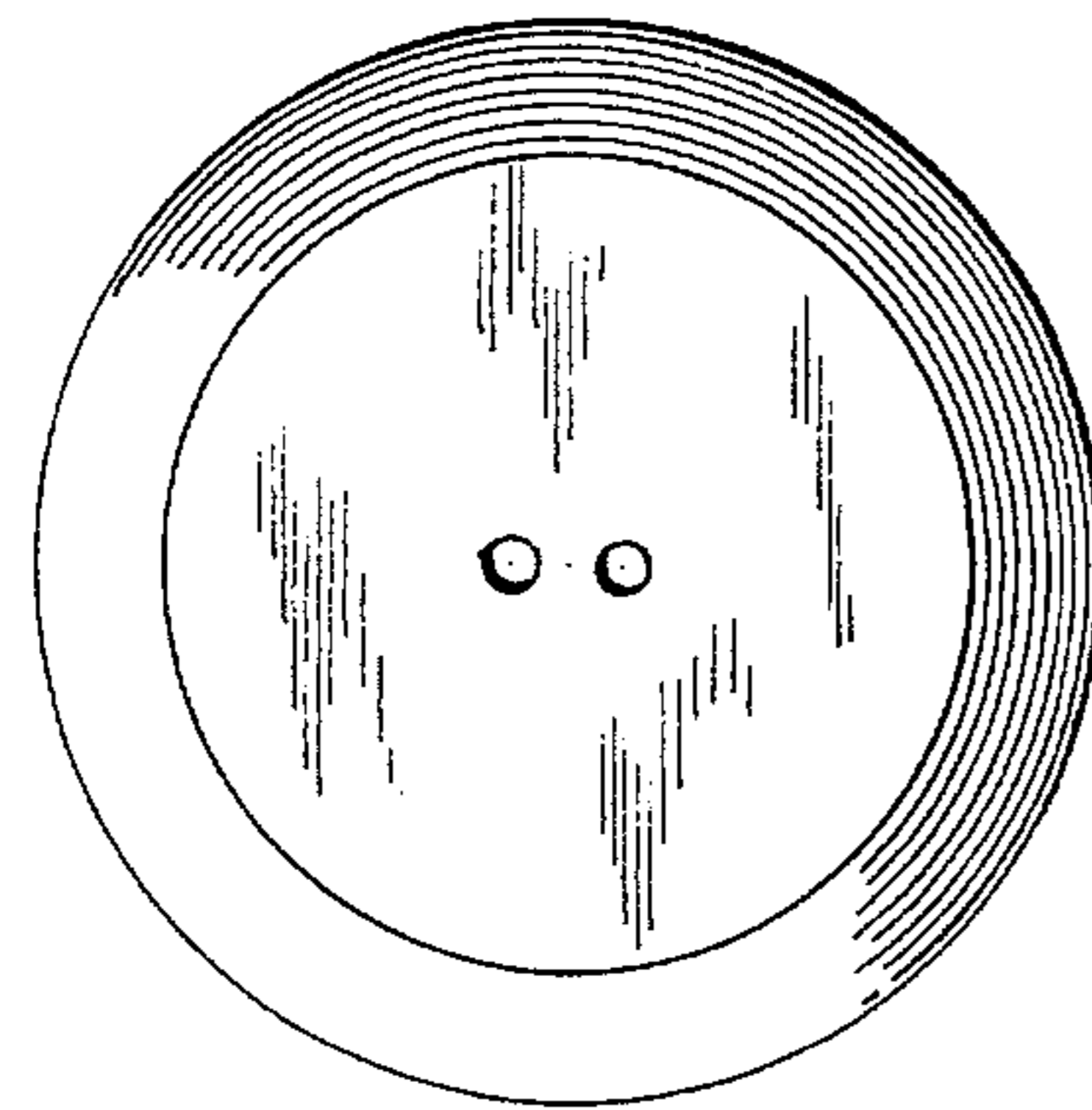

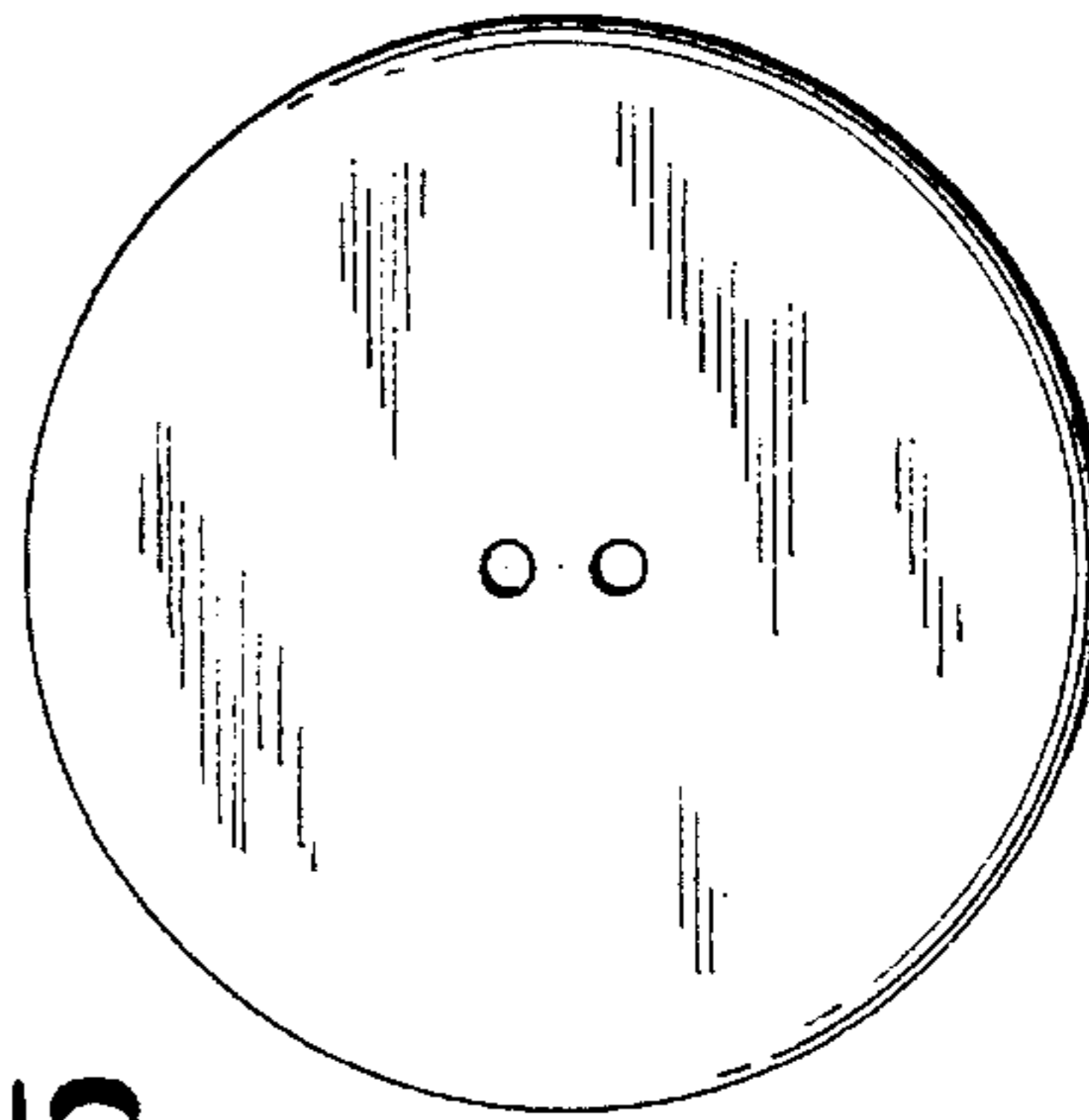

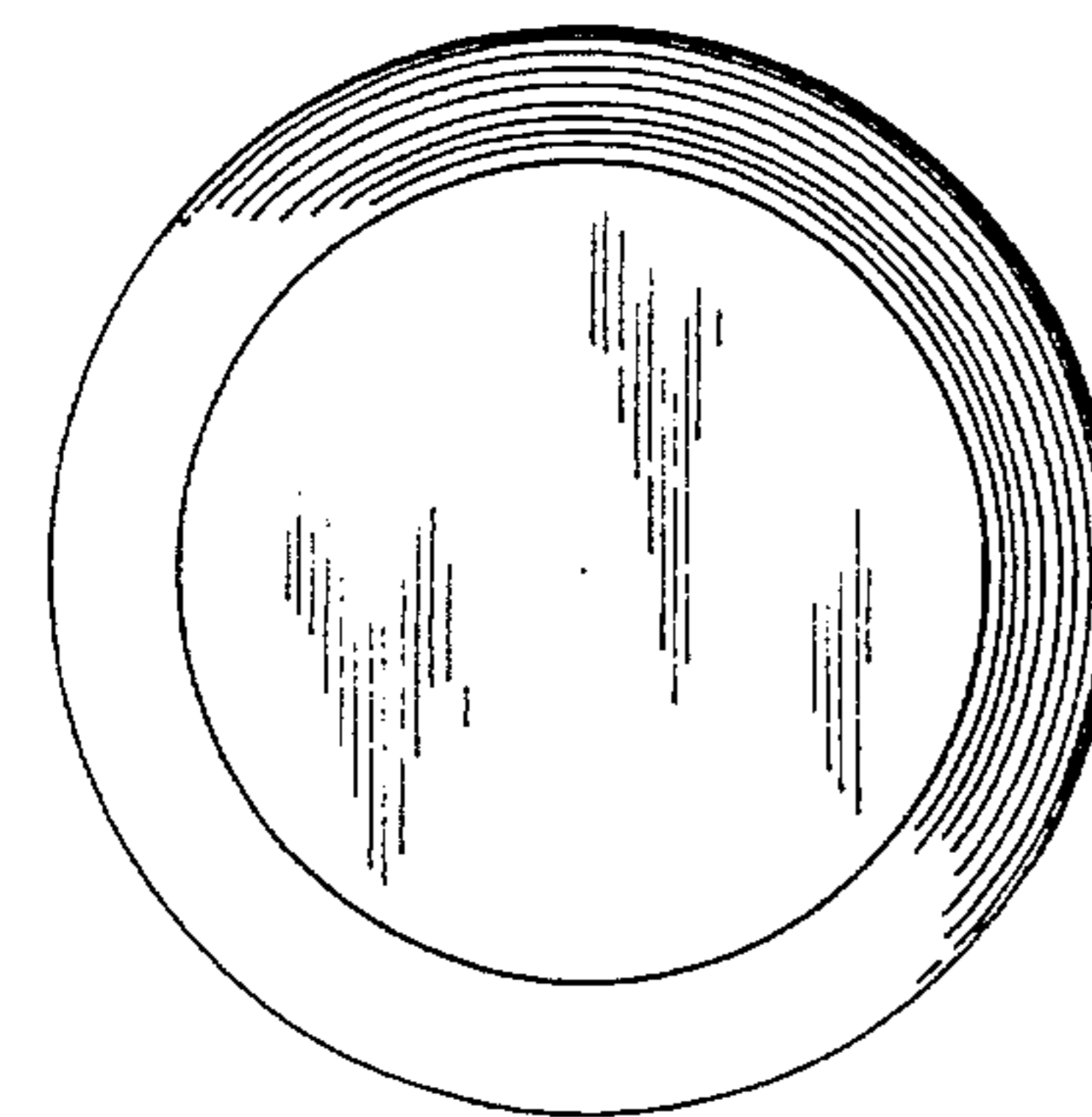

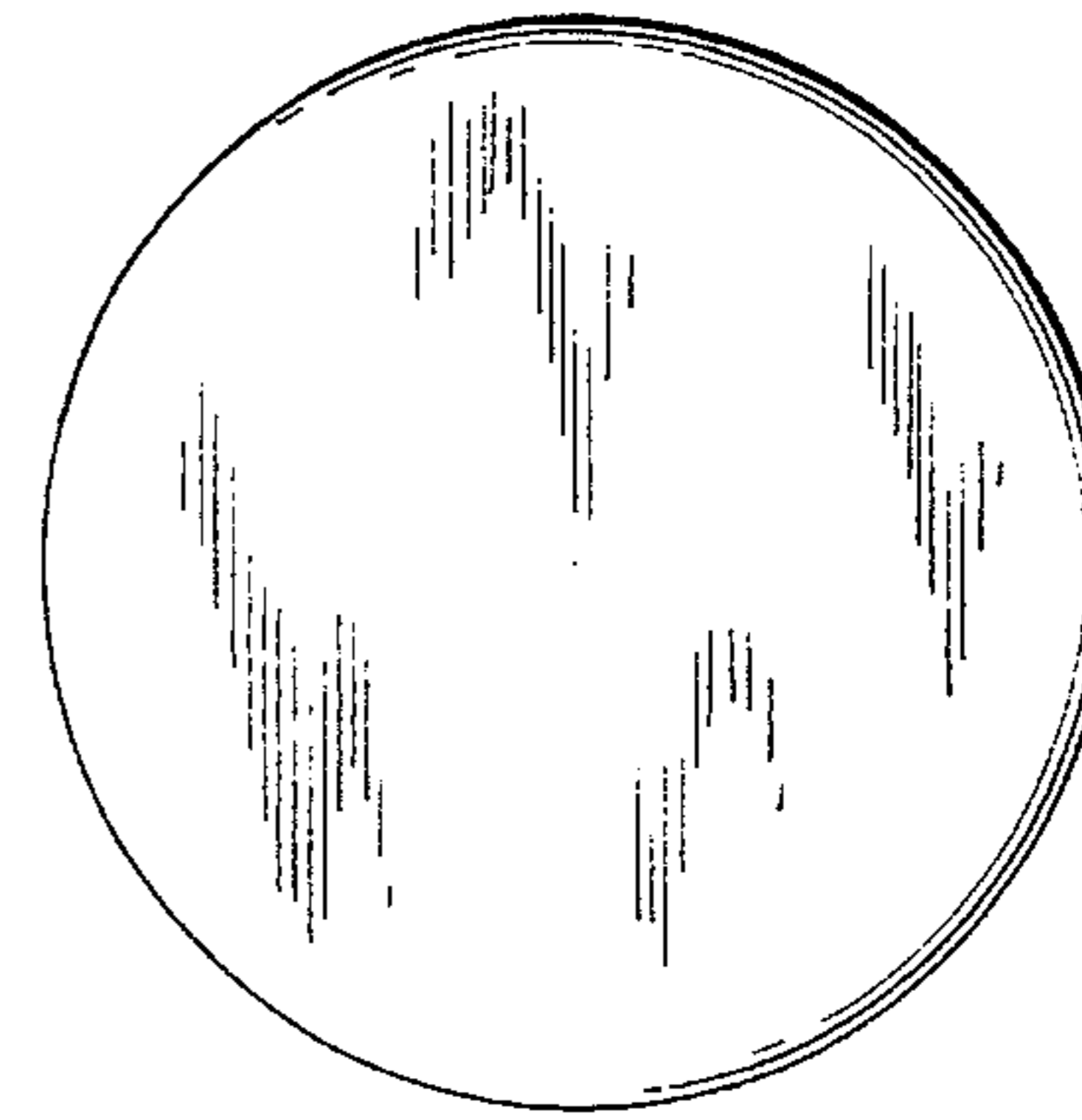
