[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the tool pouch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of the tool pouch comprising my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image;

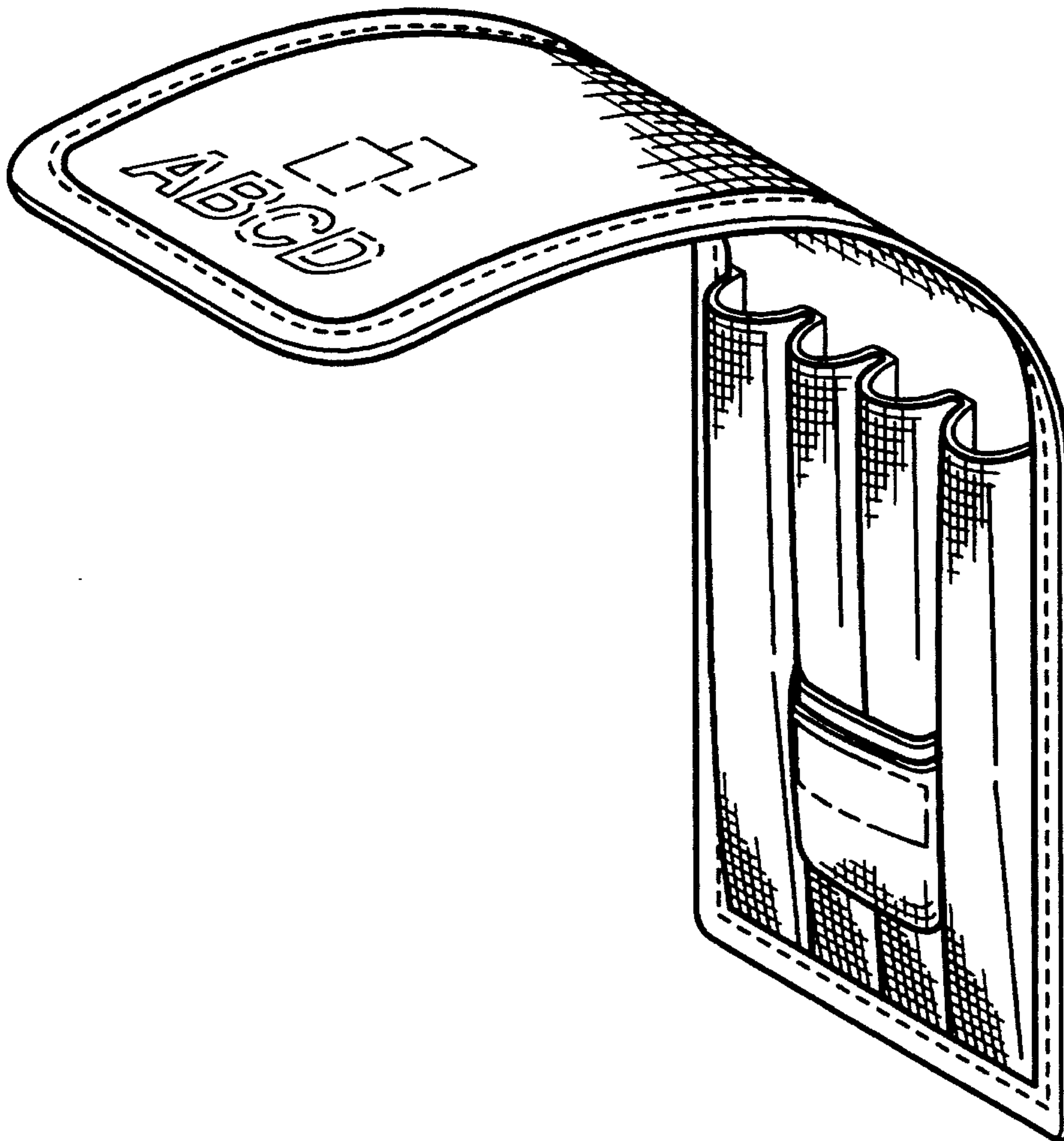
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof, shown in an open state; and,

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment thereof, which is the same as the embodiment depicted in FIGS. 1–5 with the exception of the rear loop.

The letters and squares which appear in broken lines on the flap of the pouch in FIGS. 2 and 5, and the closure of the pouch which appears in broken lines in FIGS. 3 and 5 are shown for environmental purposes only, and form no part of the claimed design.

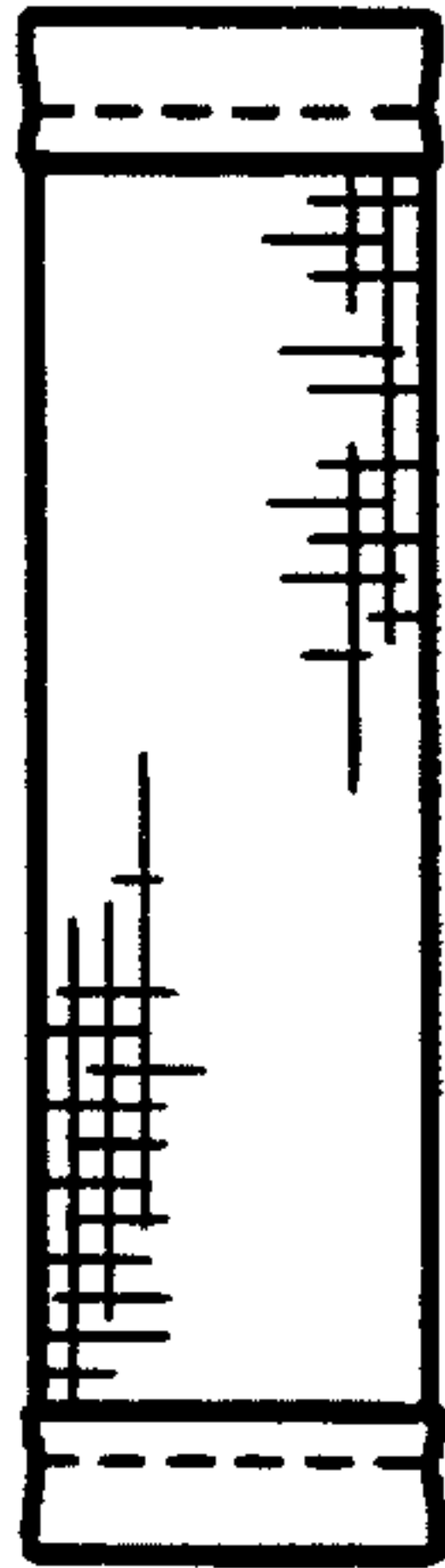

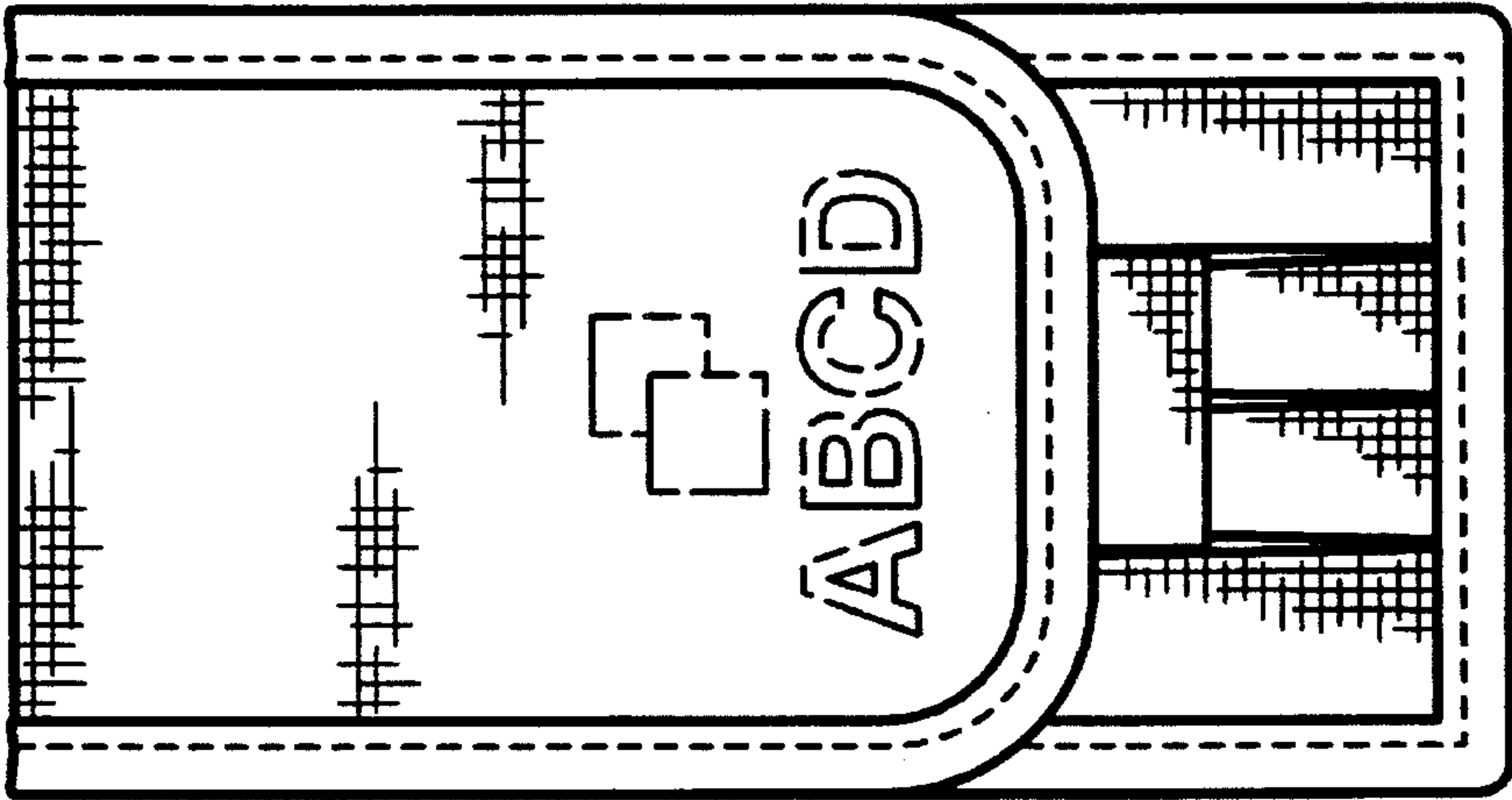

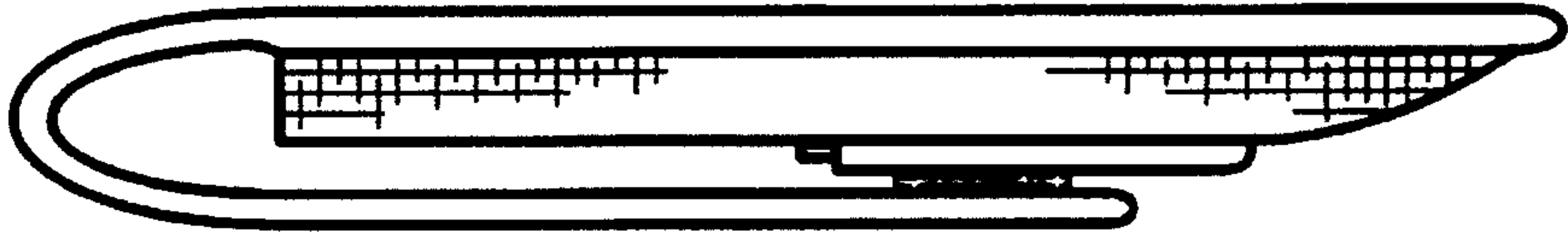
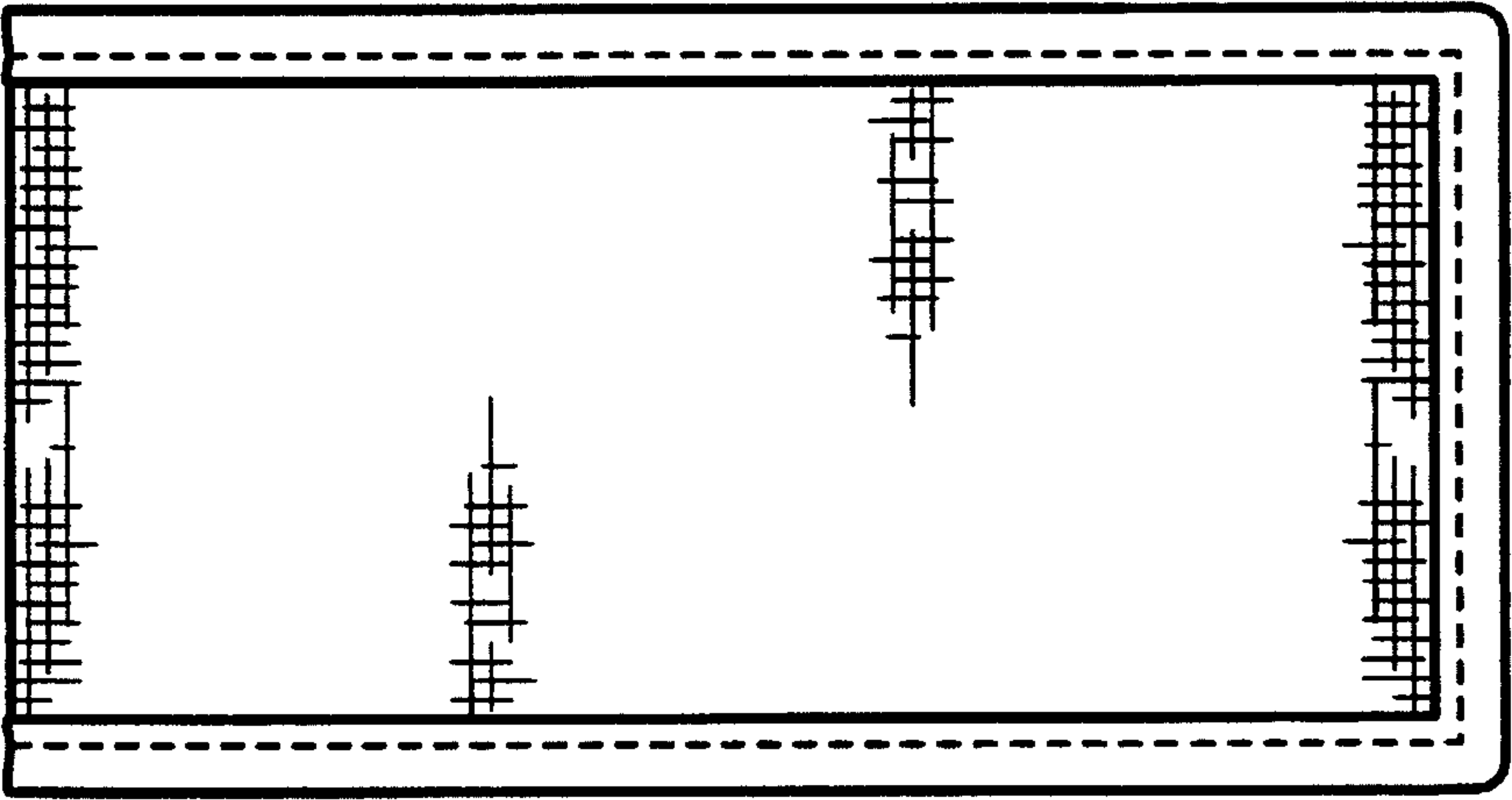

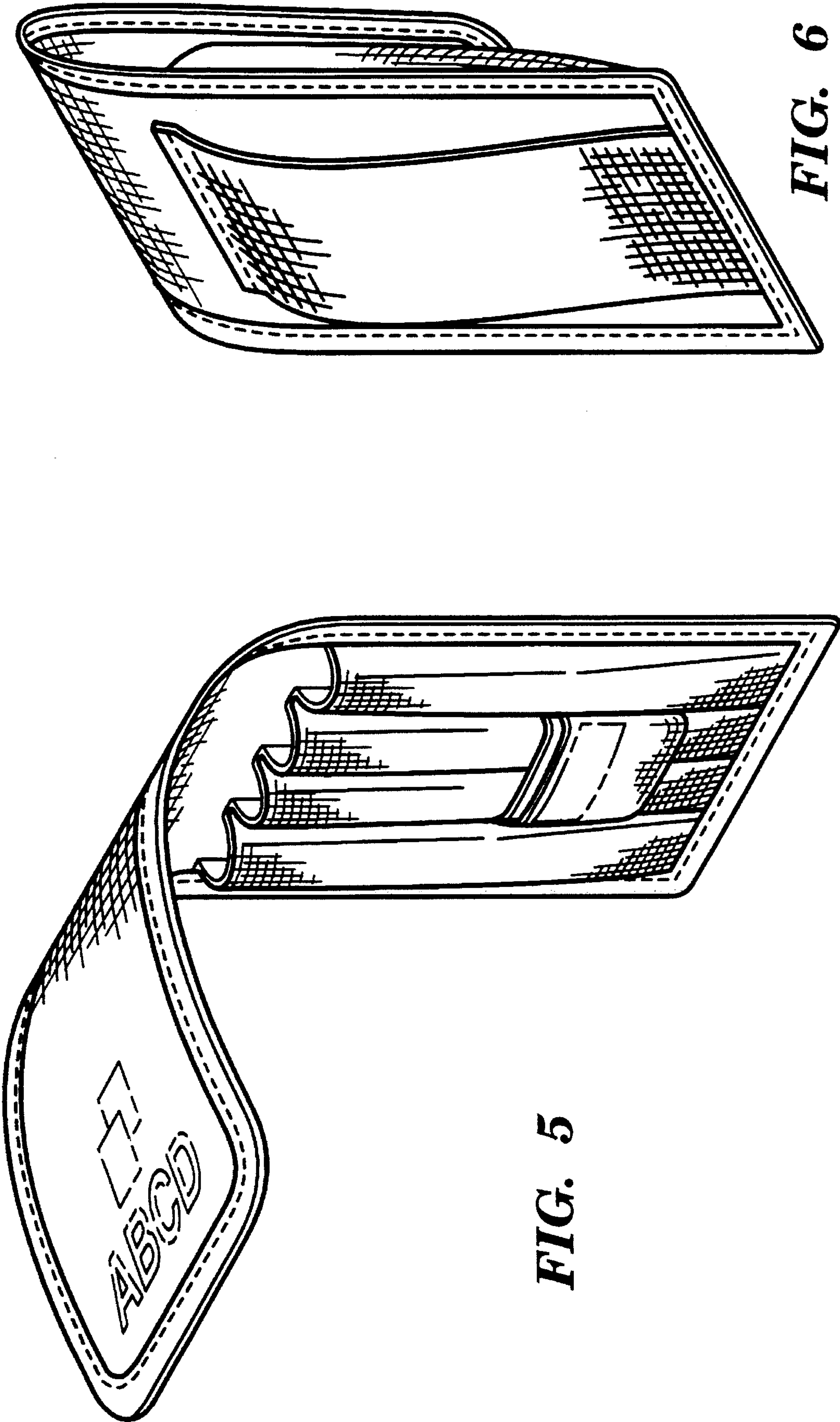
