
### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chest, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chest showing our new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being identical thereto;  
 FIG. 4 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the chest shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; the sides being identical that shown in FIG. 3;  
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment of the chest shown in FIG. 1; and,  
 FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view, the left side being identical thereto.












