The ornamental design for a medal game machine, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a medal game machine showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

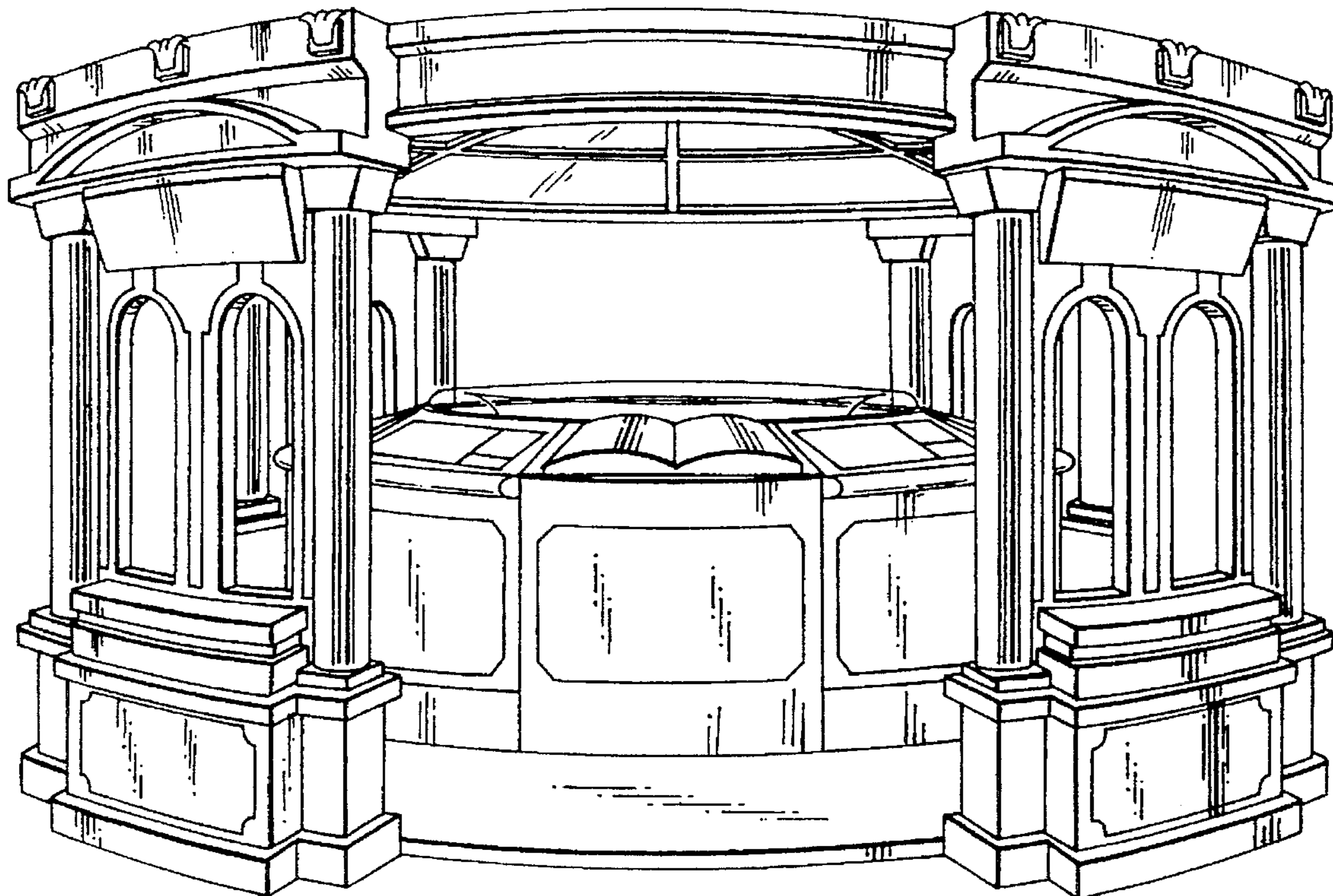

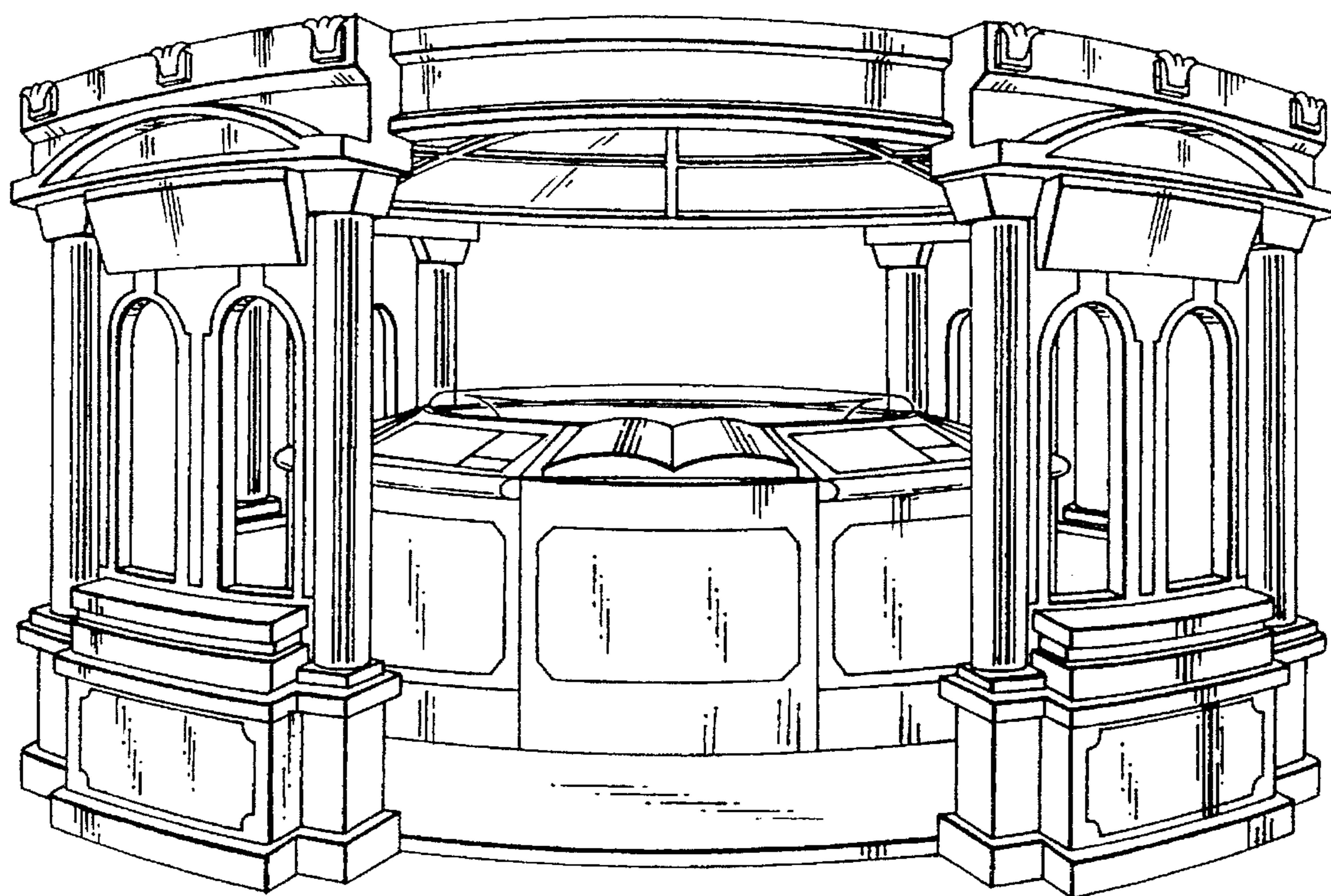

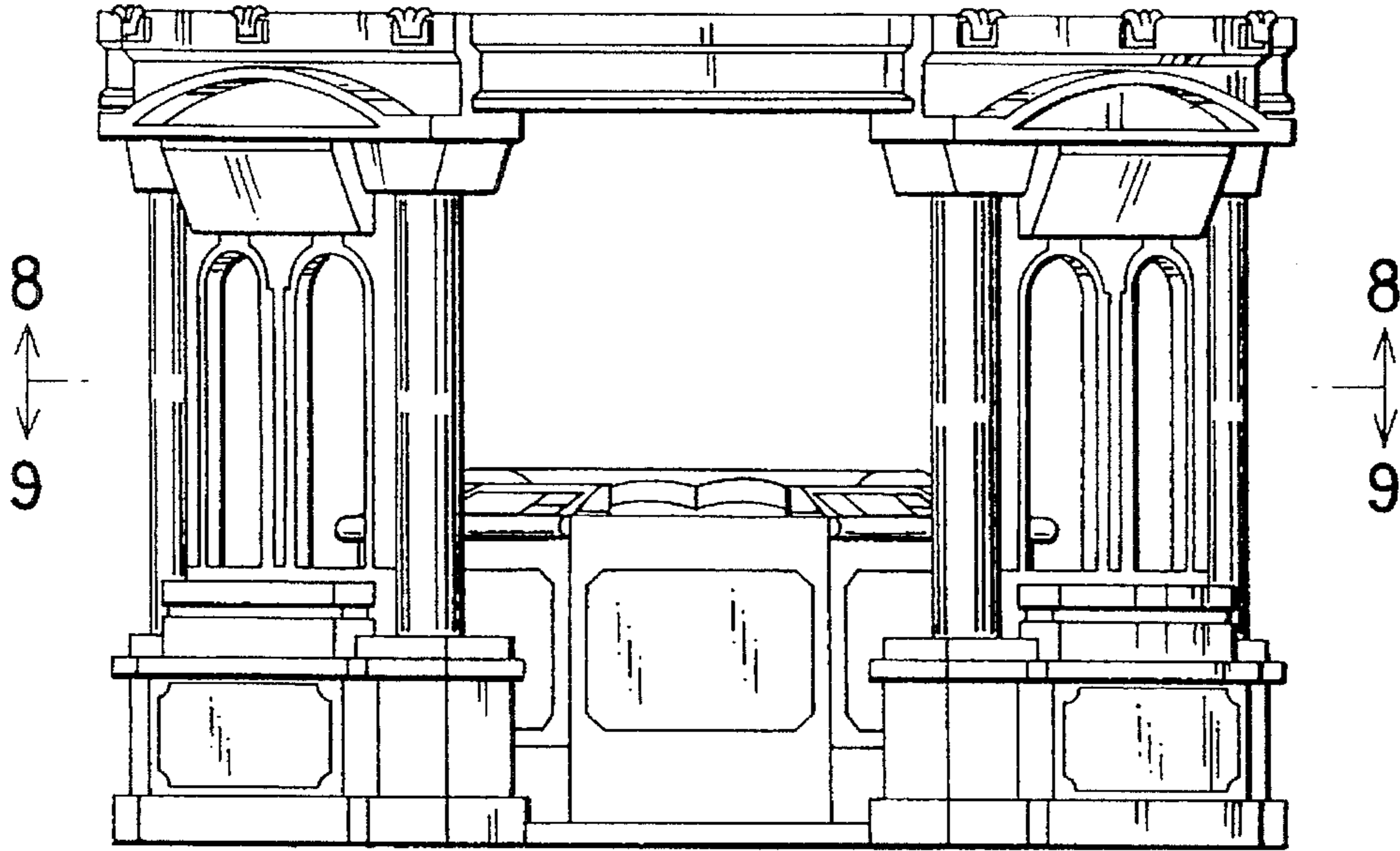

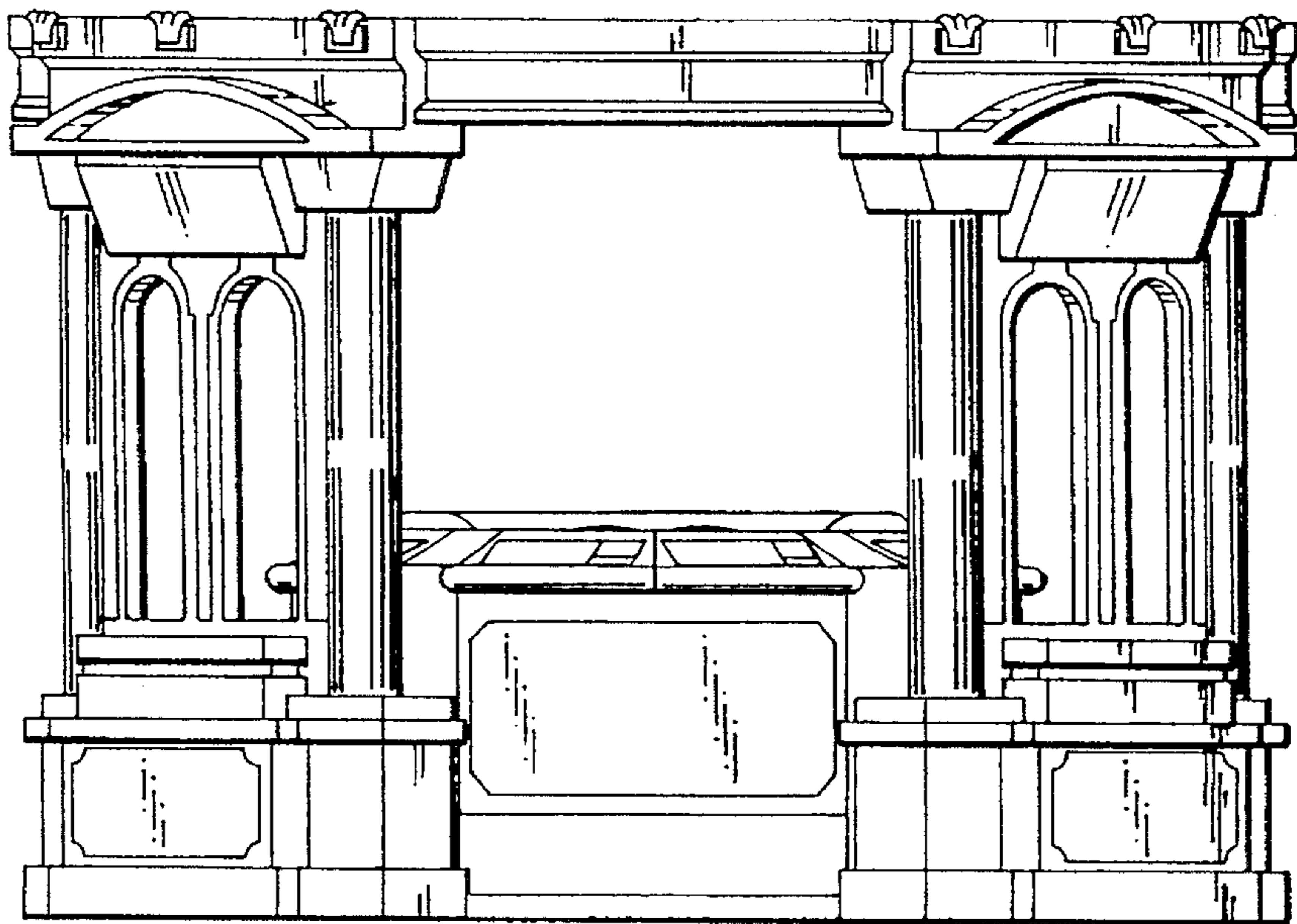

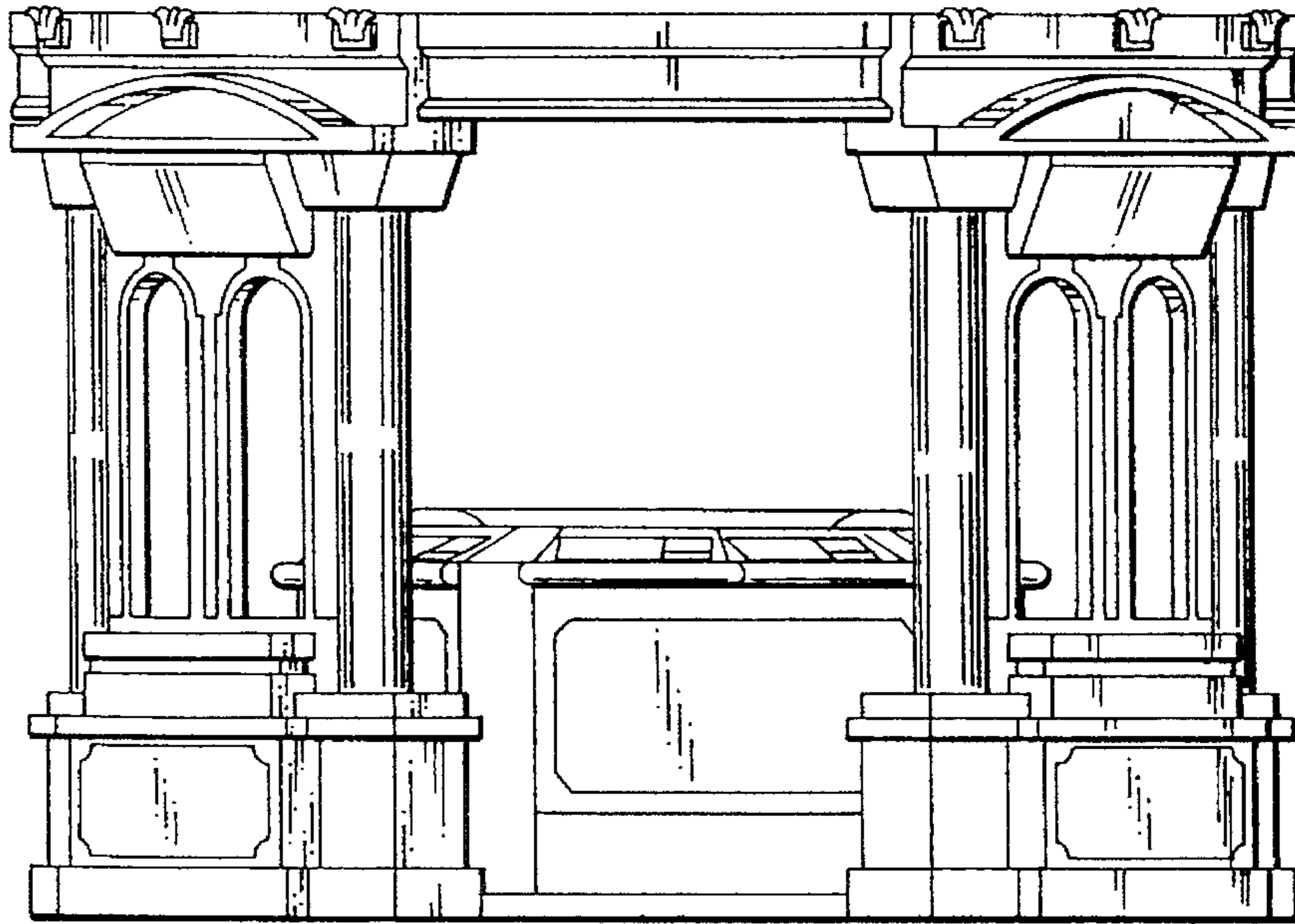

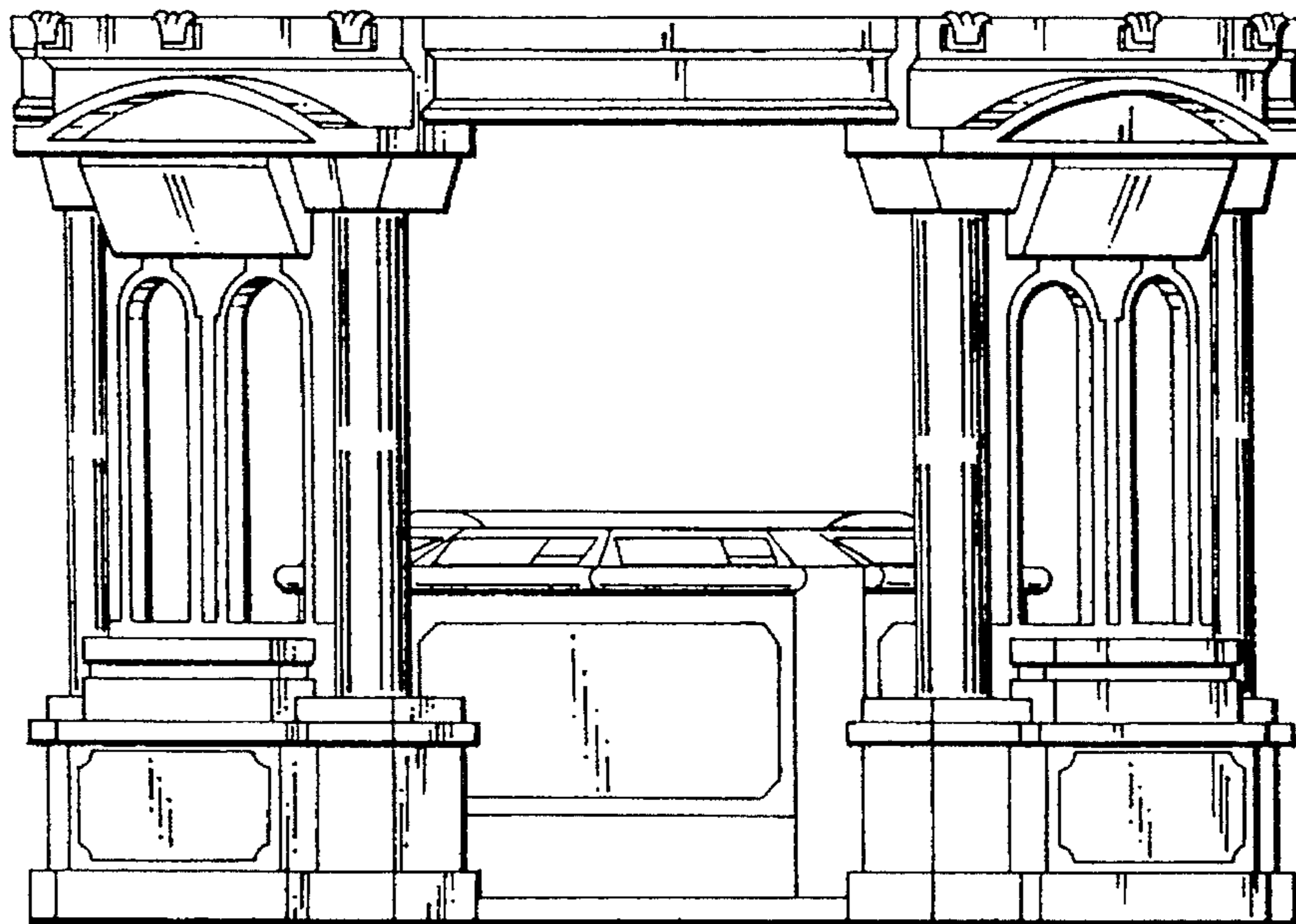

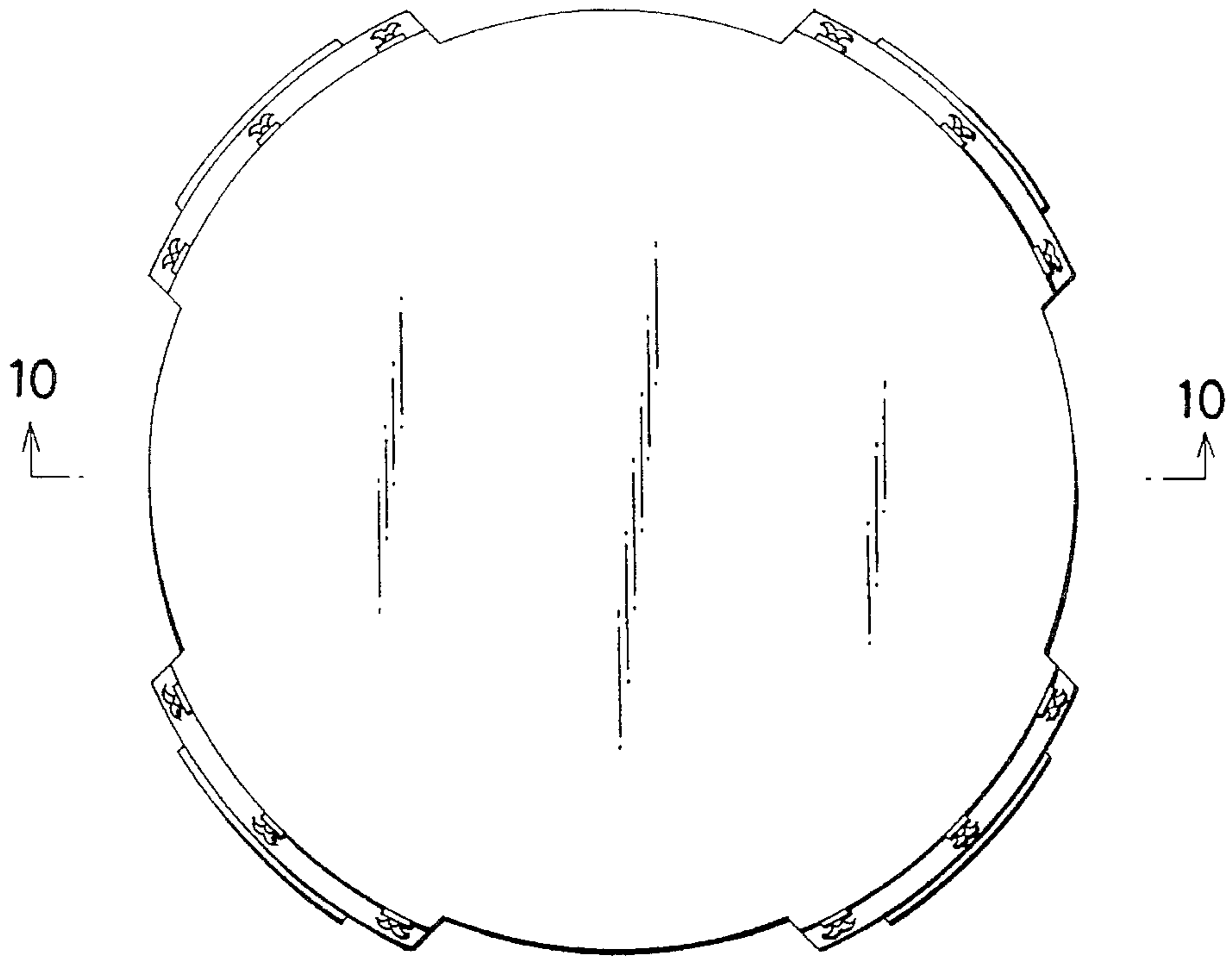

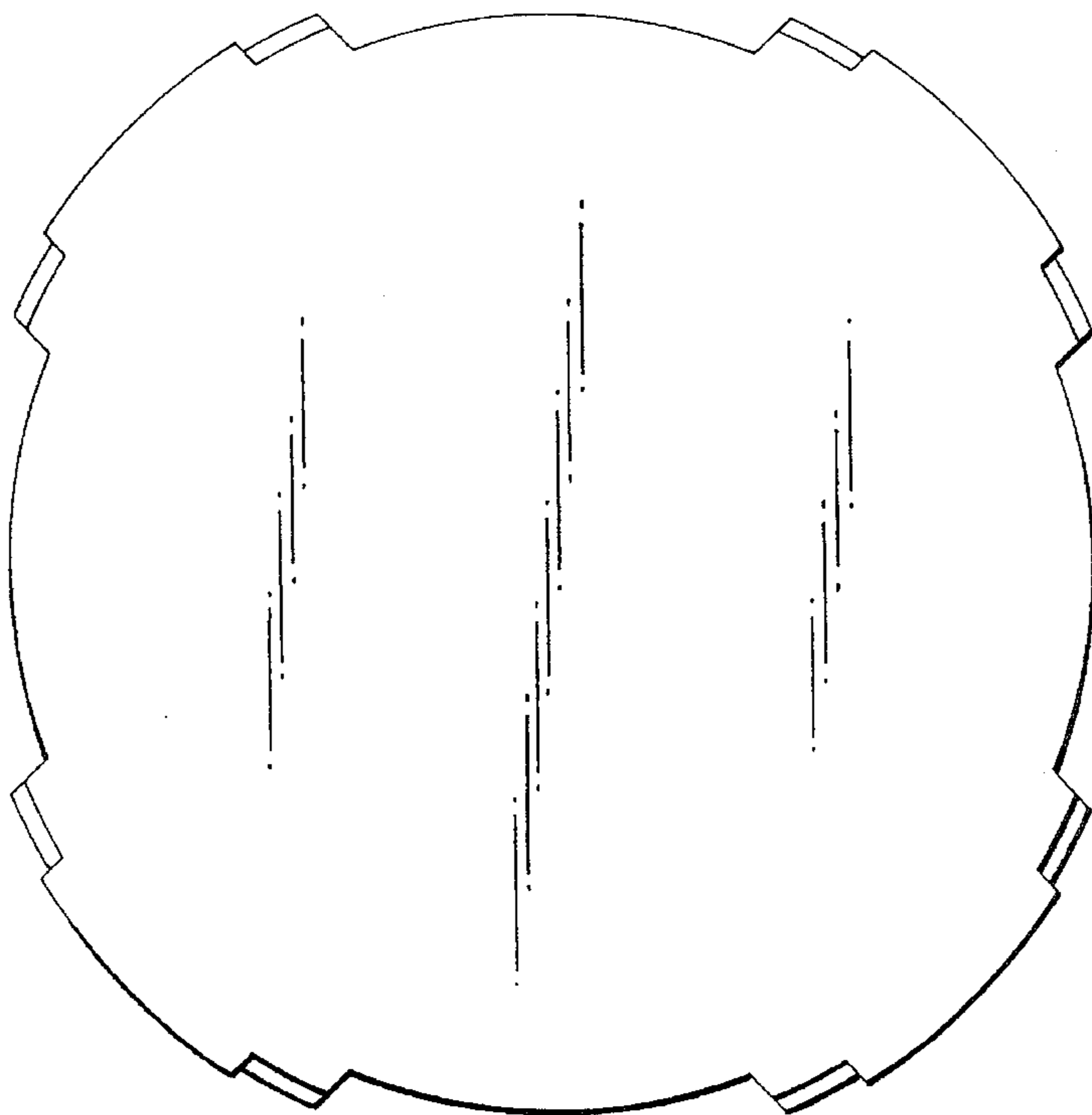

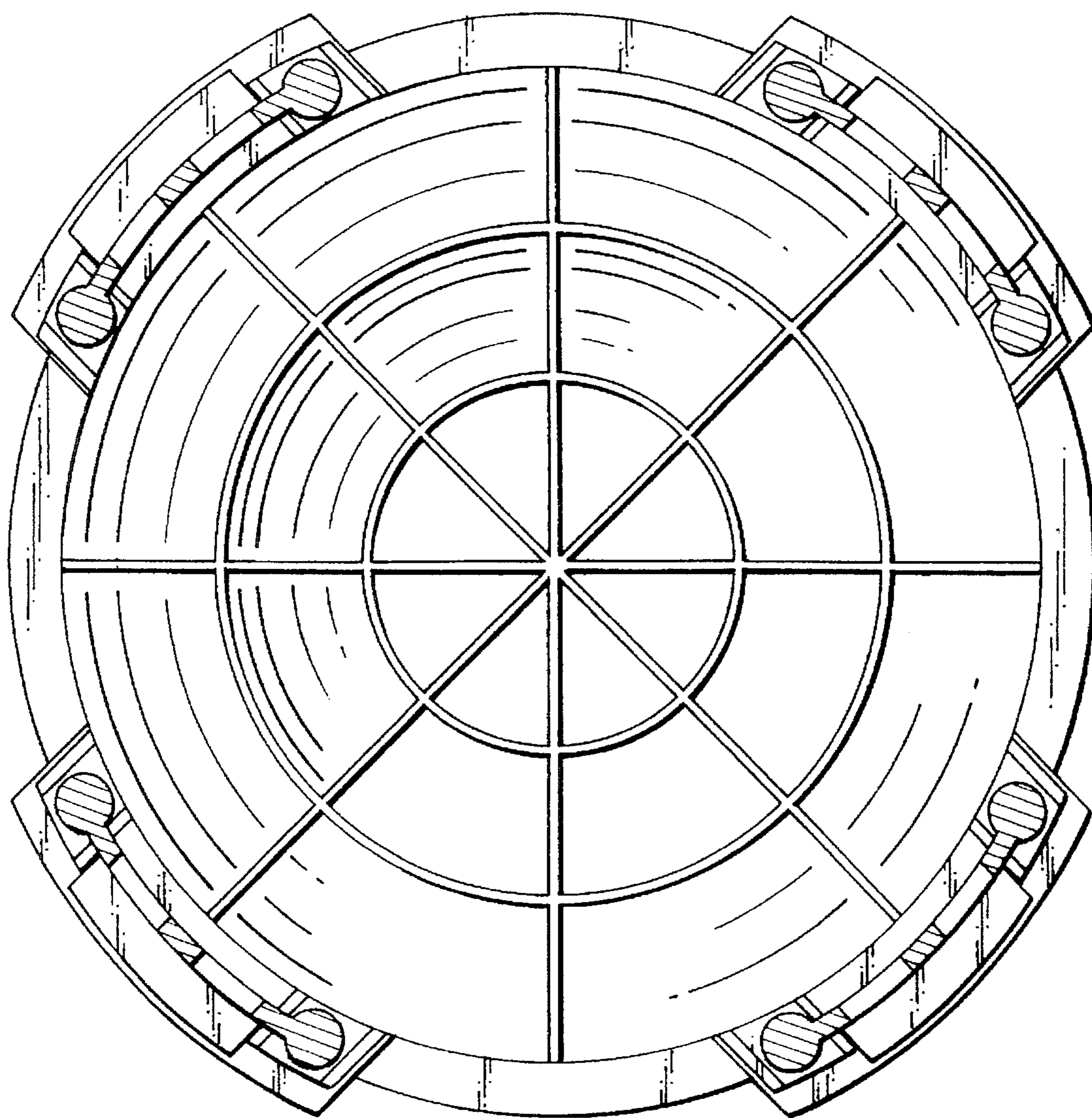

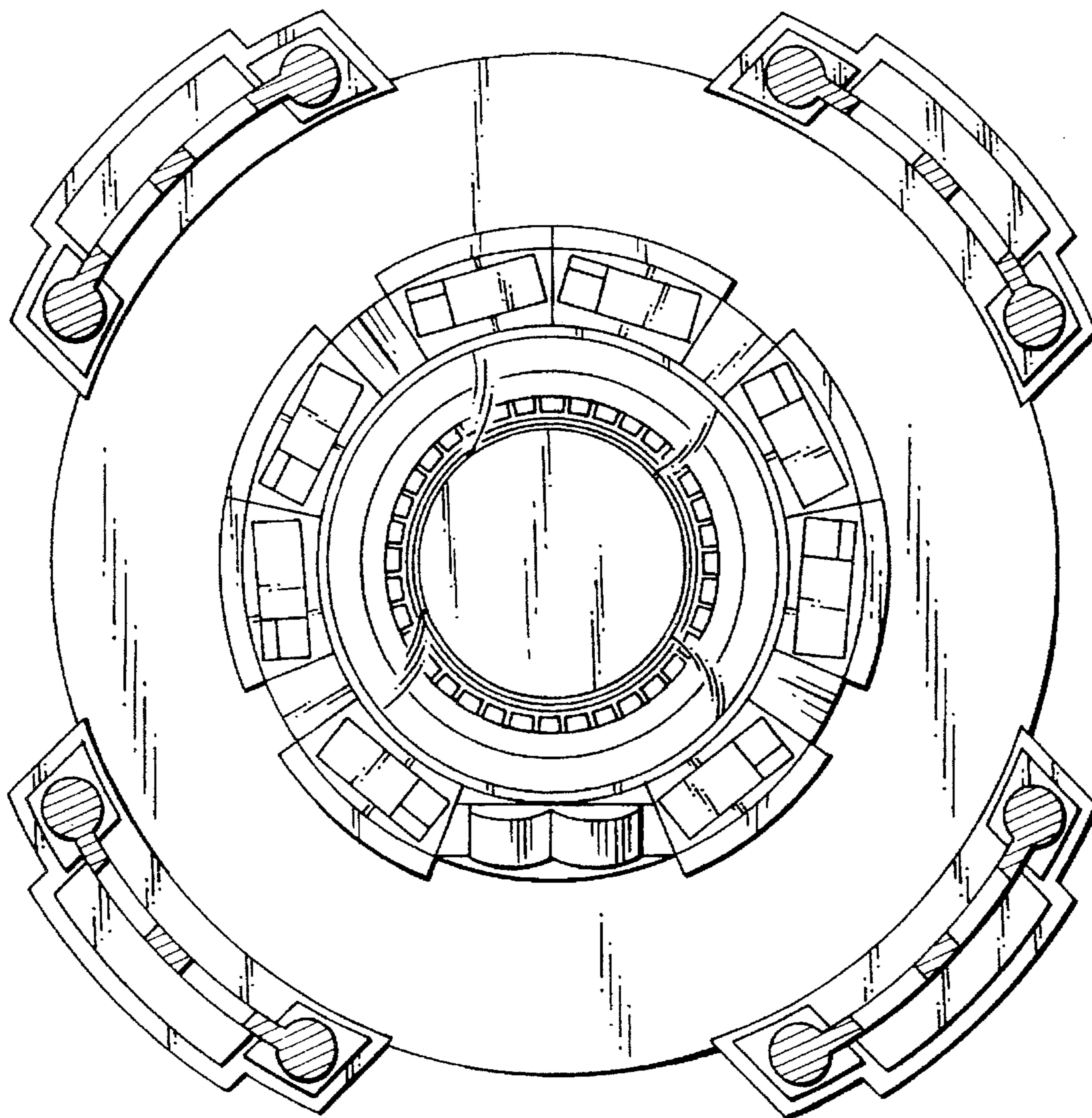
