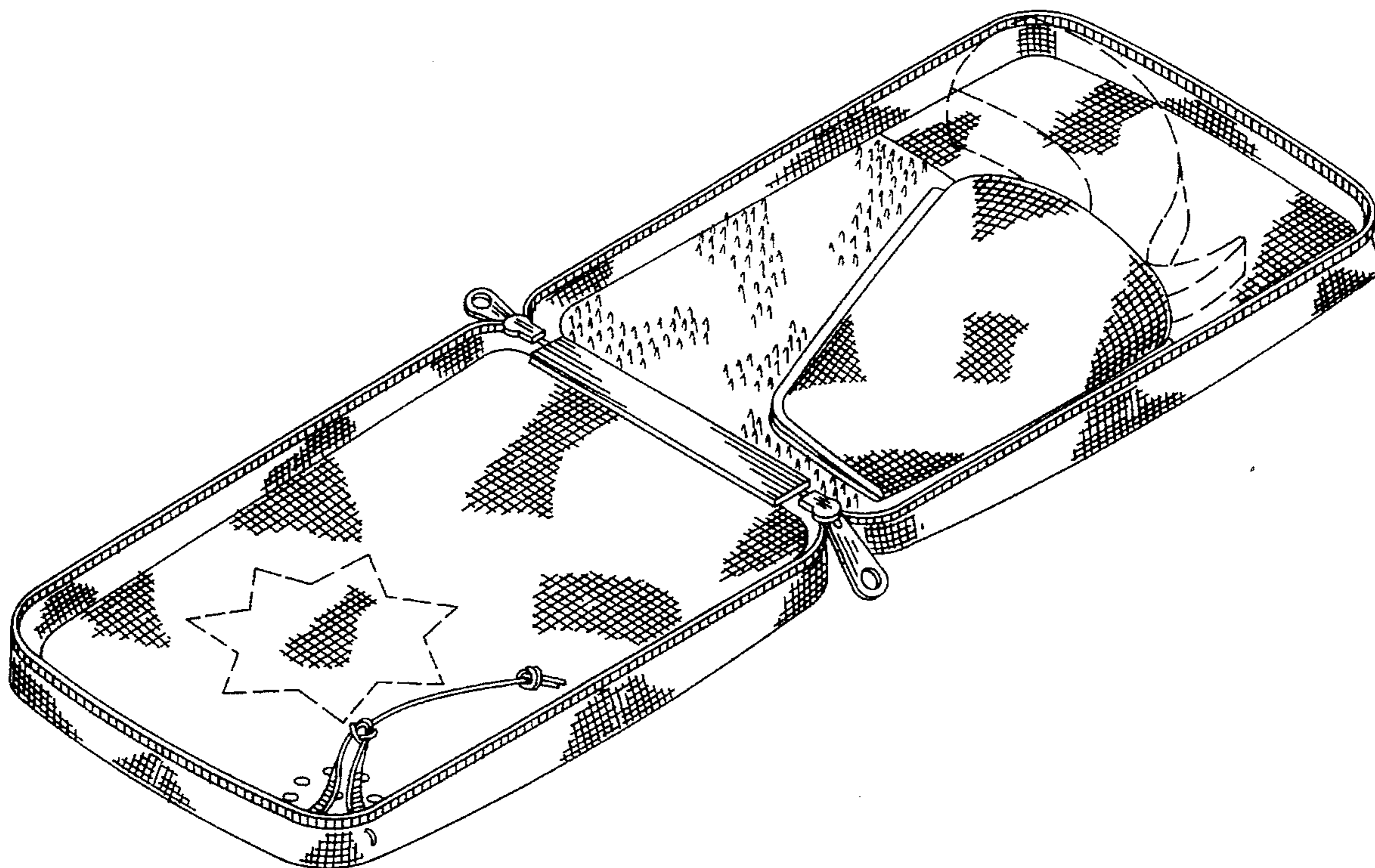
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a disguised weapon holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of disguised weapon holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 9 is a perspective view, shown in an open position with the lock removed. The broken line showing of a gun and star in FIG. 9, and a belt in FIGS. 1-8 being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design.

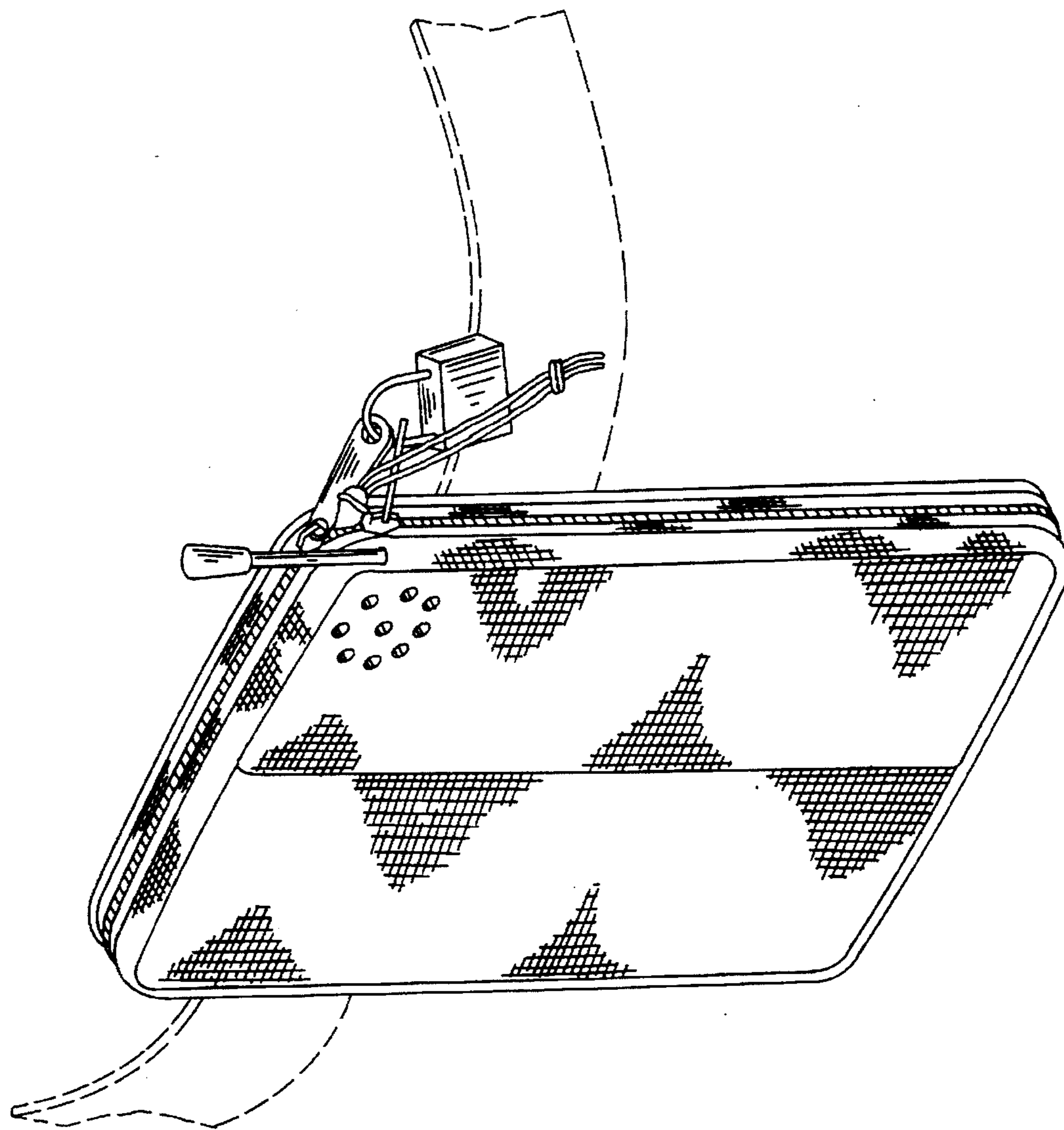

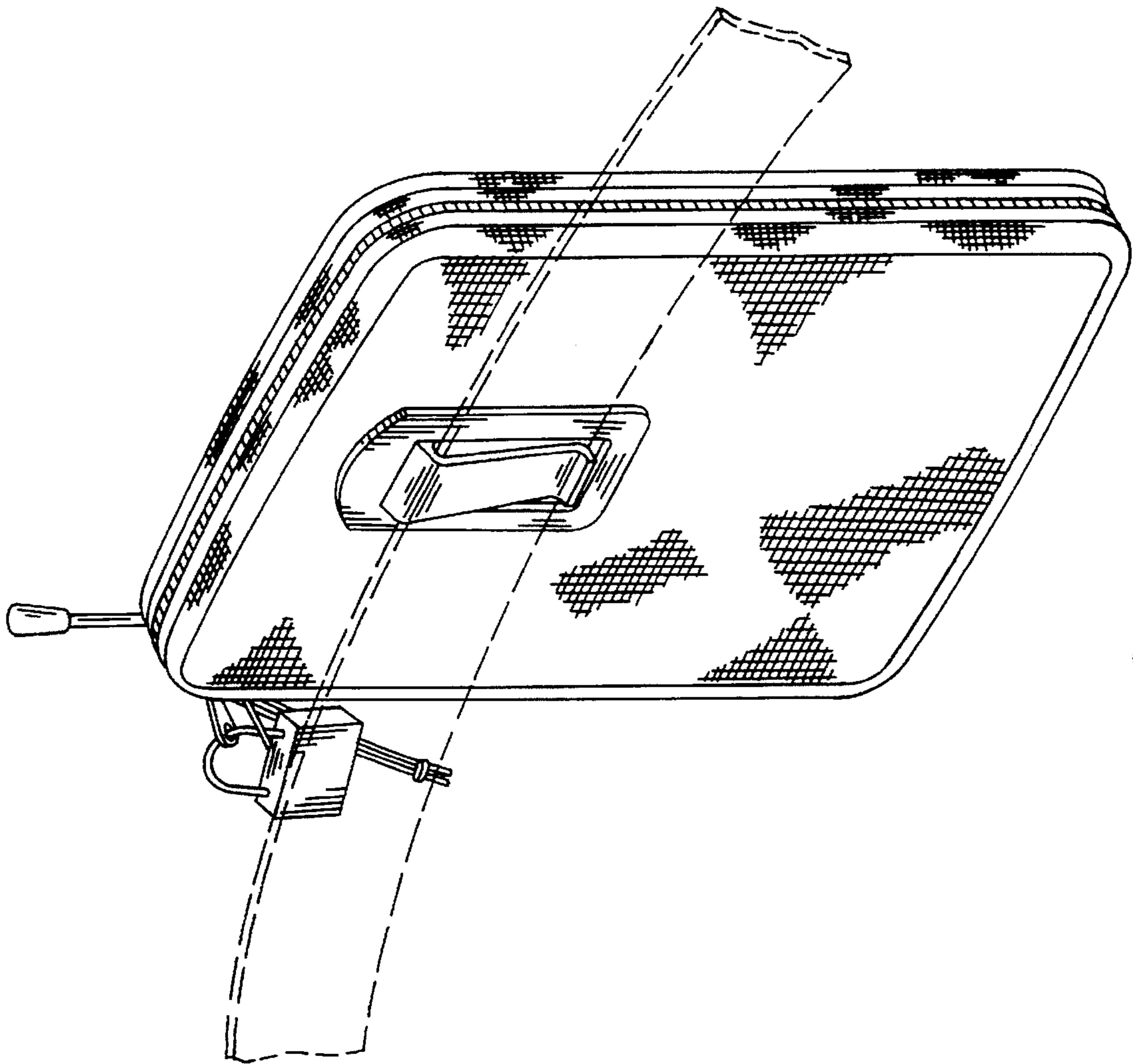

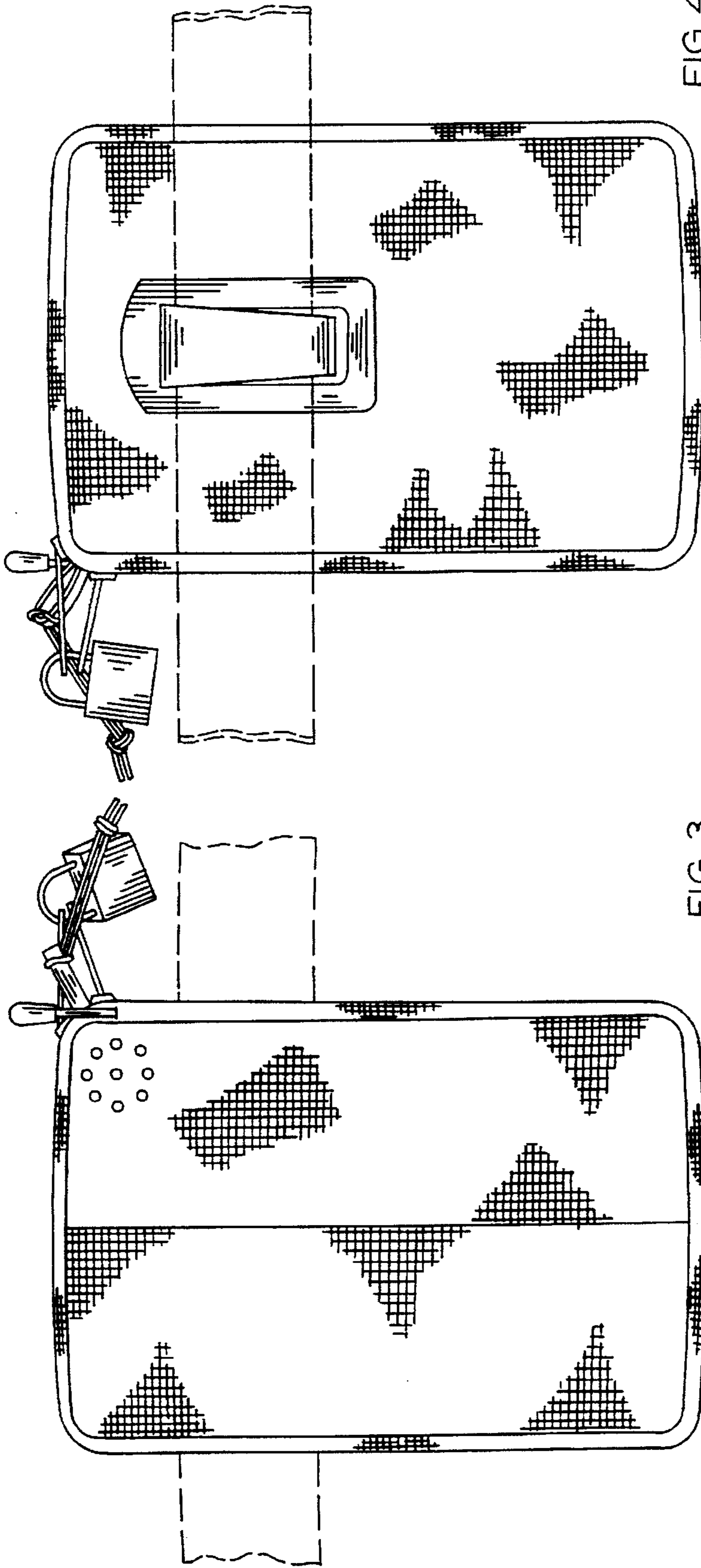

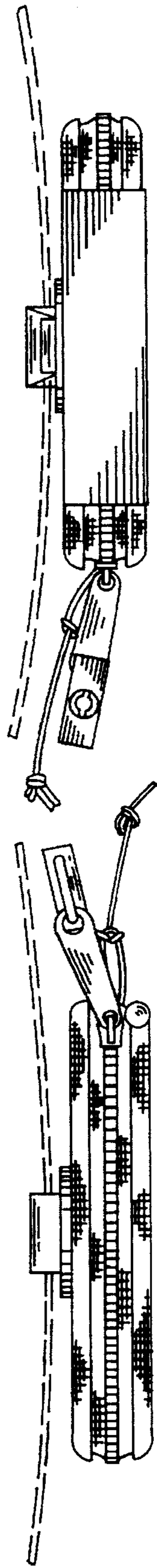

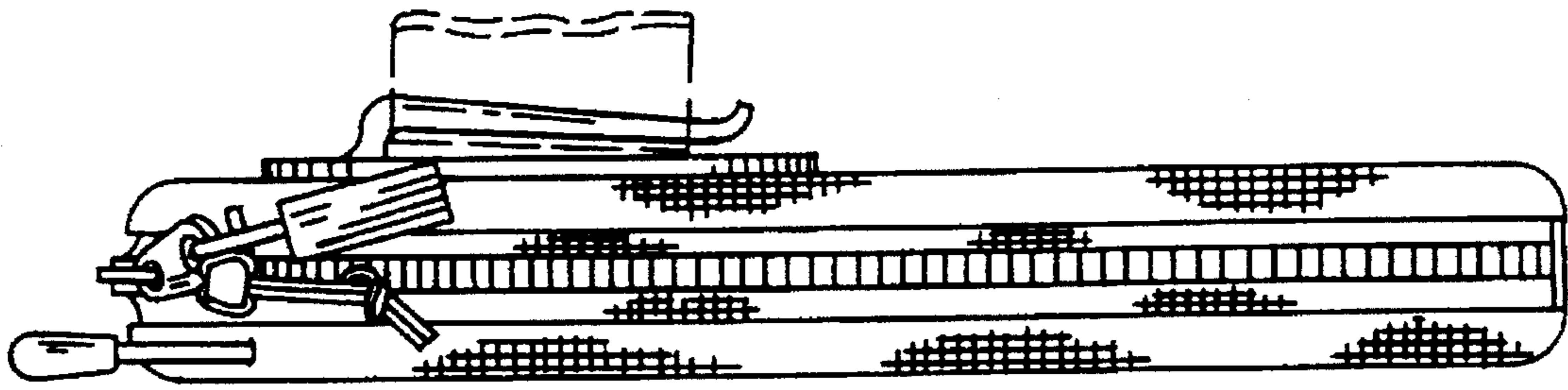
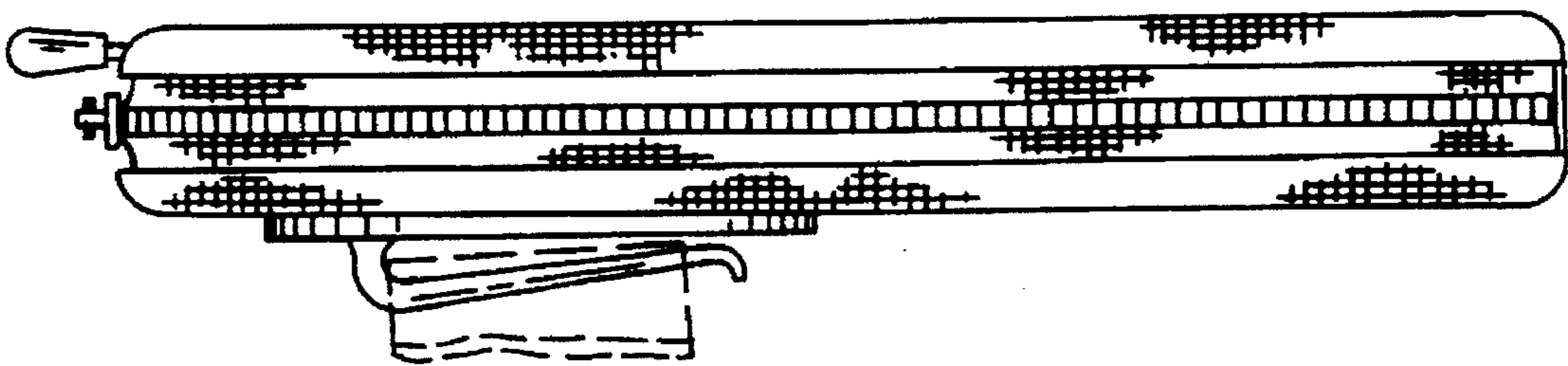

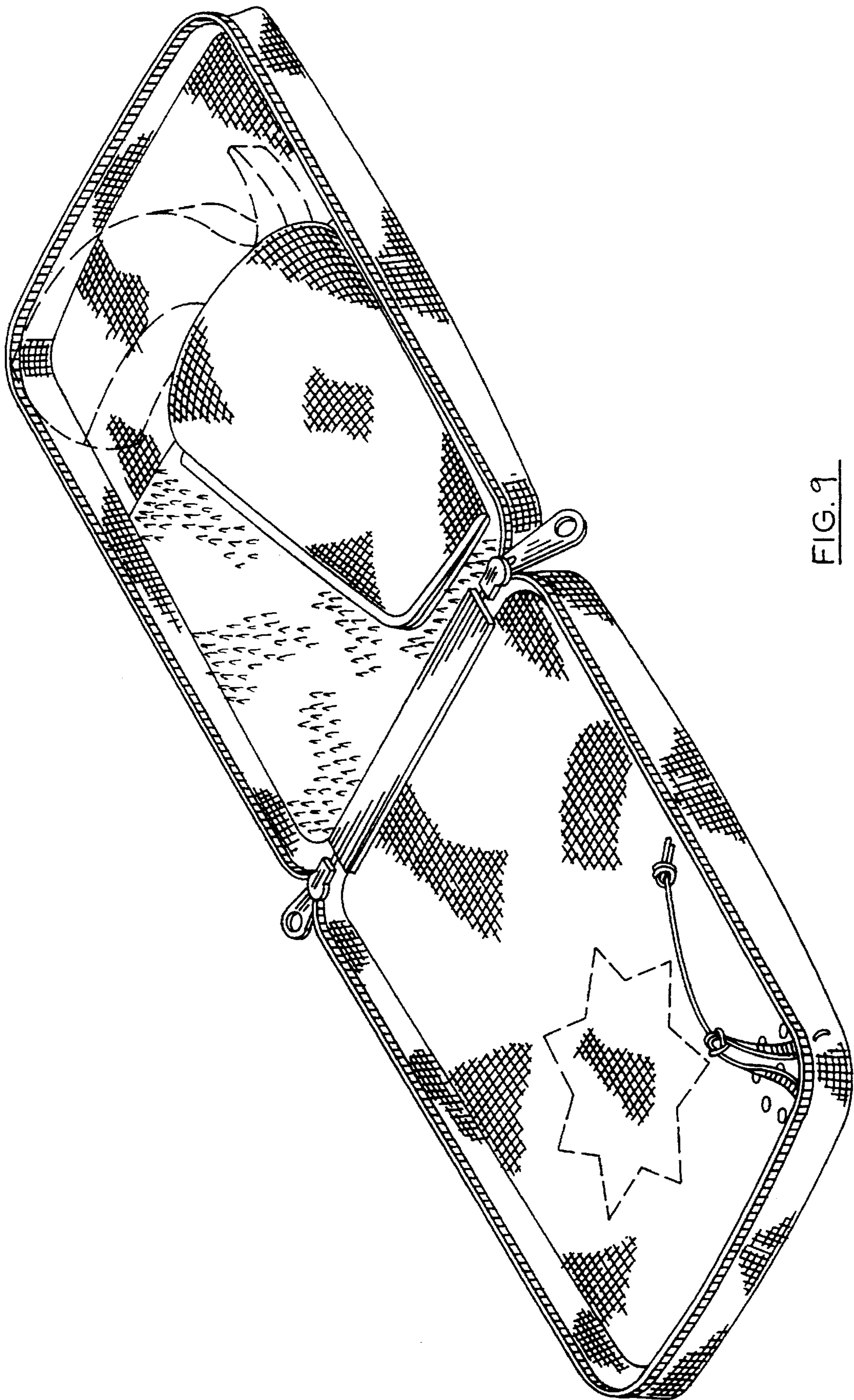
