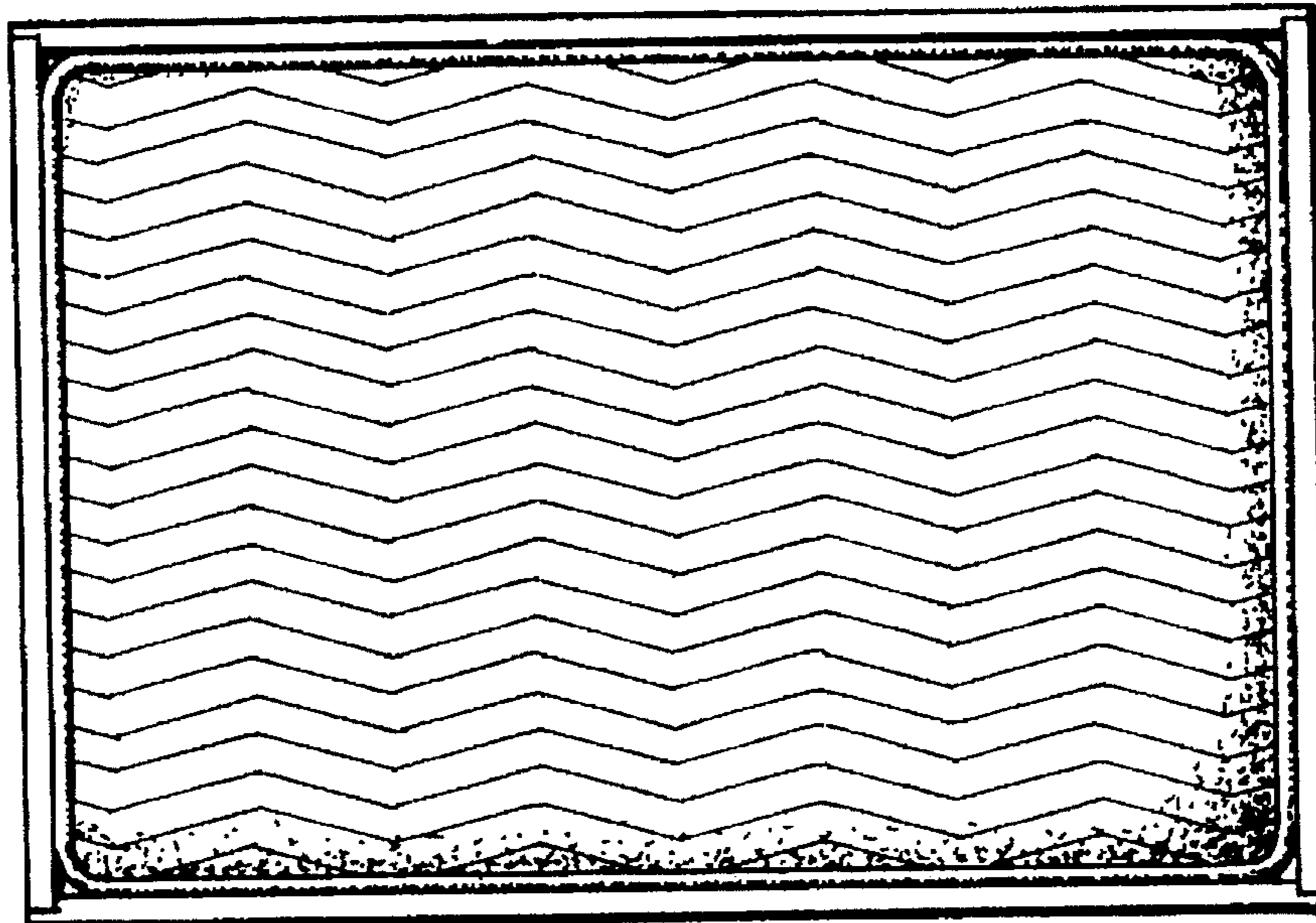
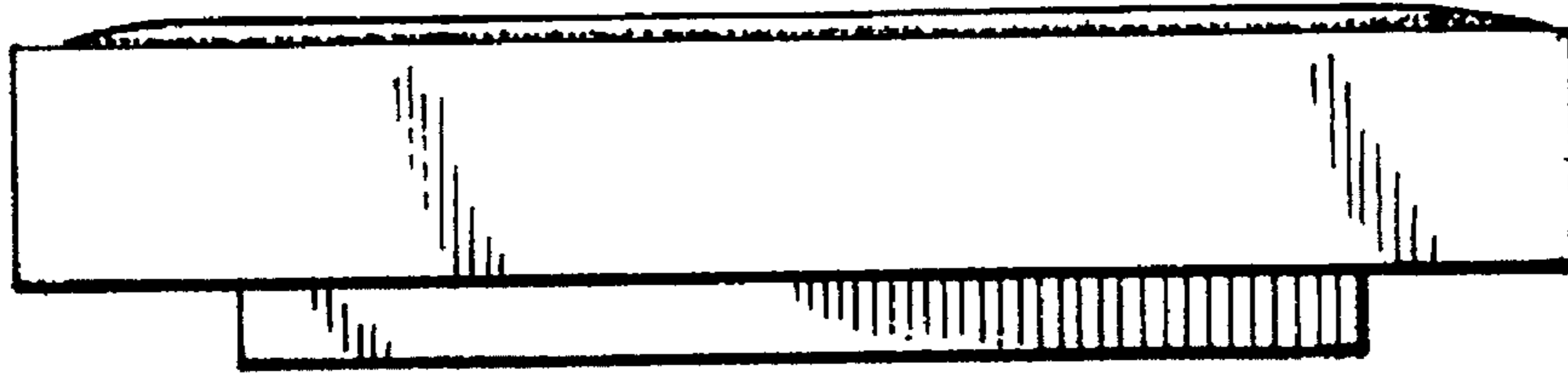
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a waterbed for a pet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the pet waterbed of the invention; the rear elevation being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view of FIG. 1; the left side being a mirror image thereof; and, FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the invention.

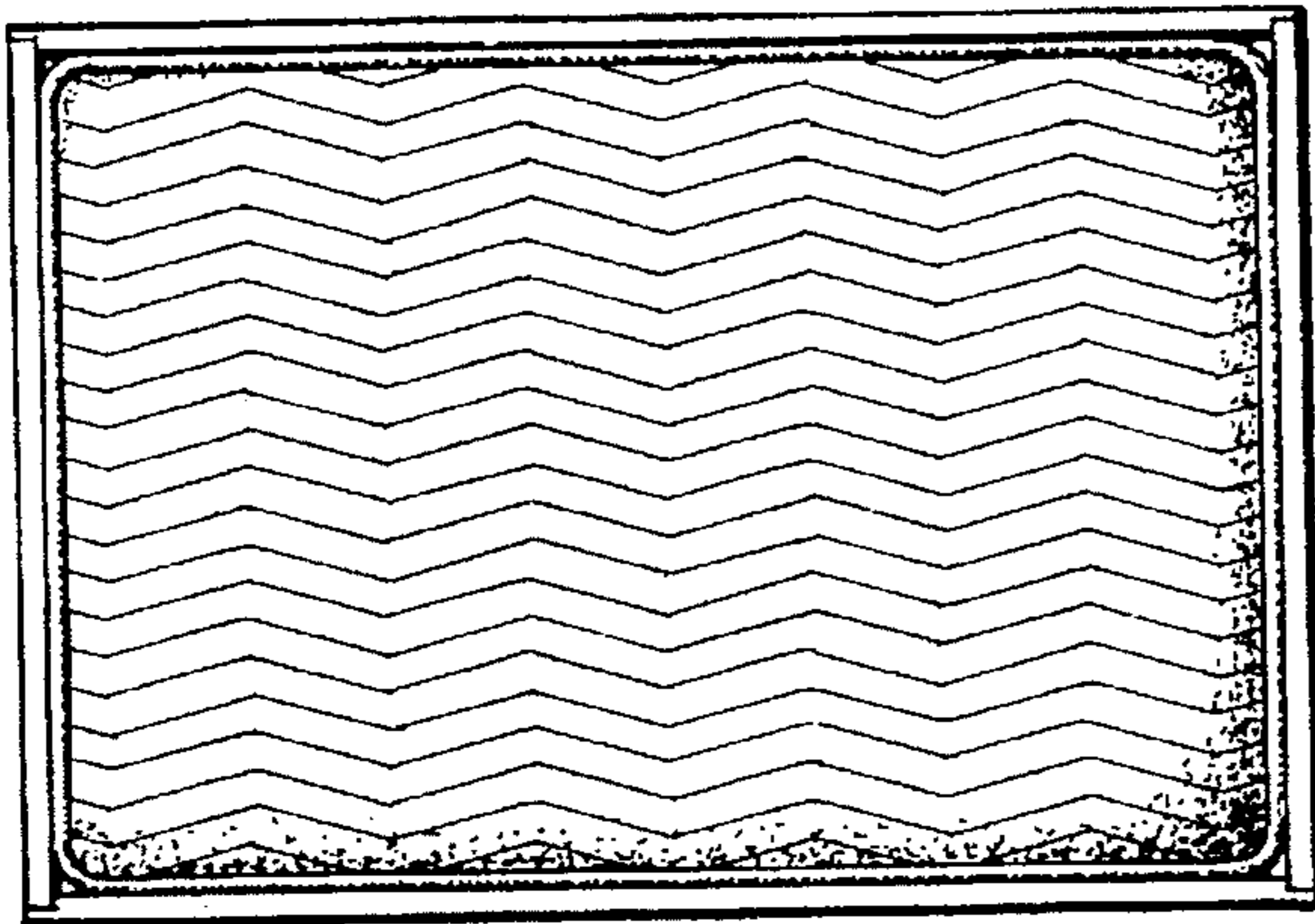

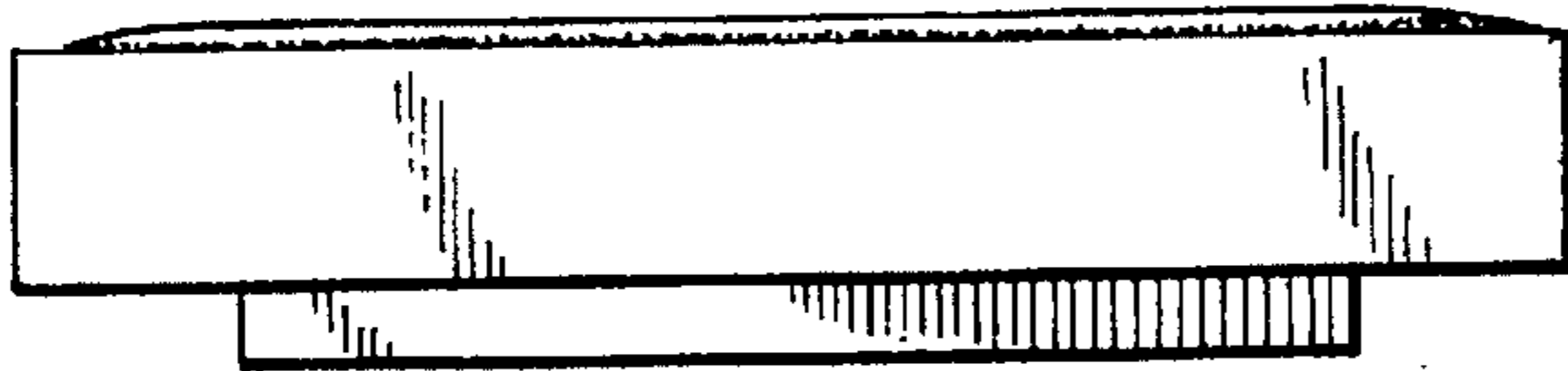

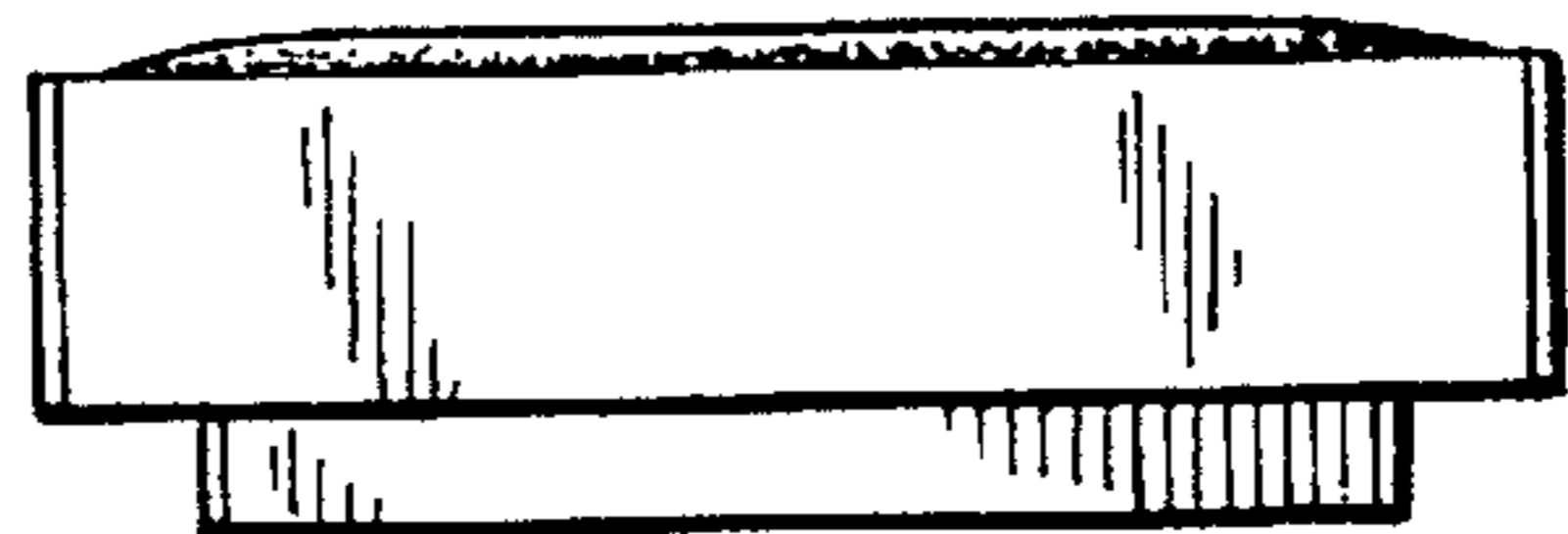
