The ornamental design for a bow playable, electric bass guitar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bow playable, electric bass guitar showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

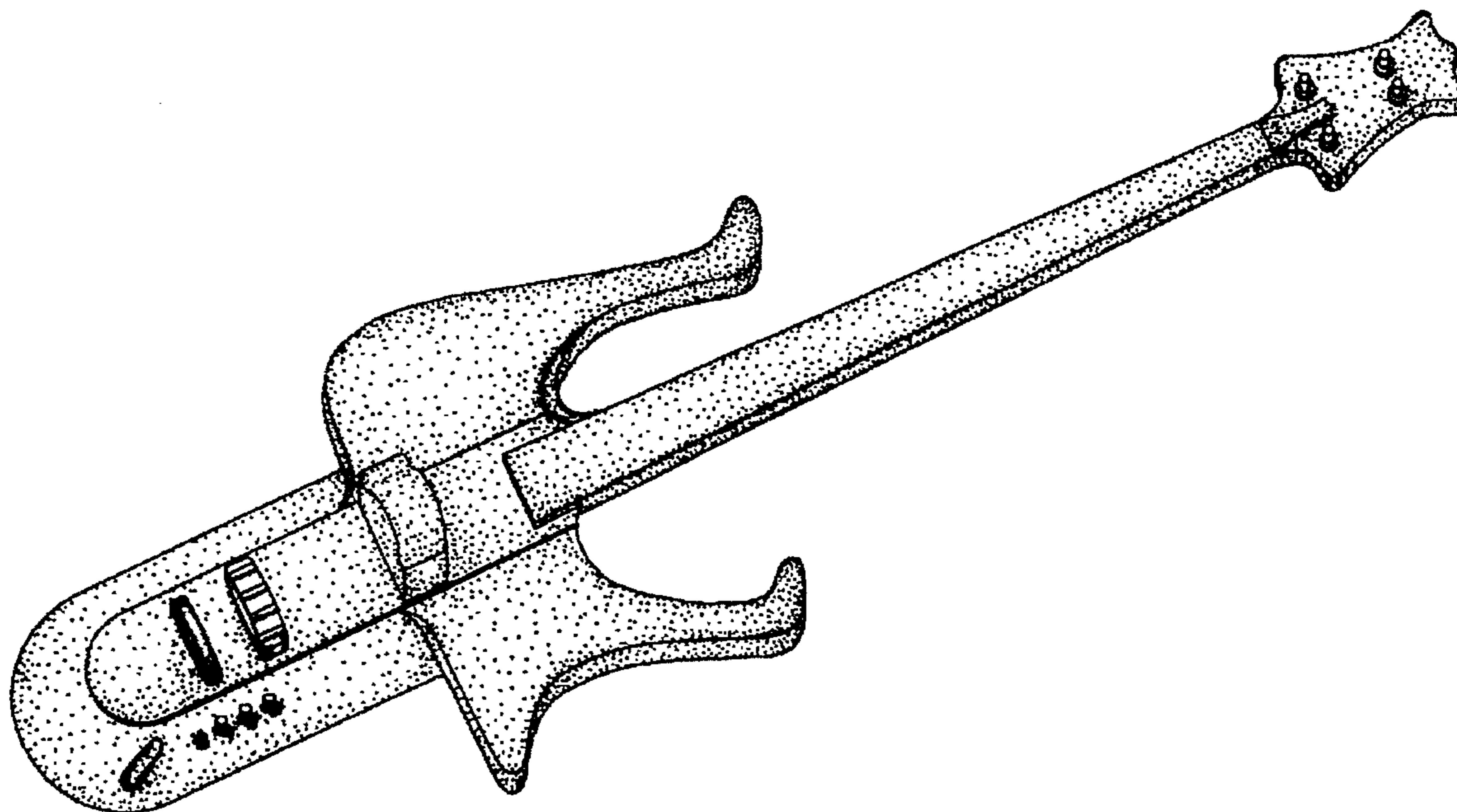

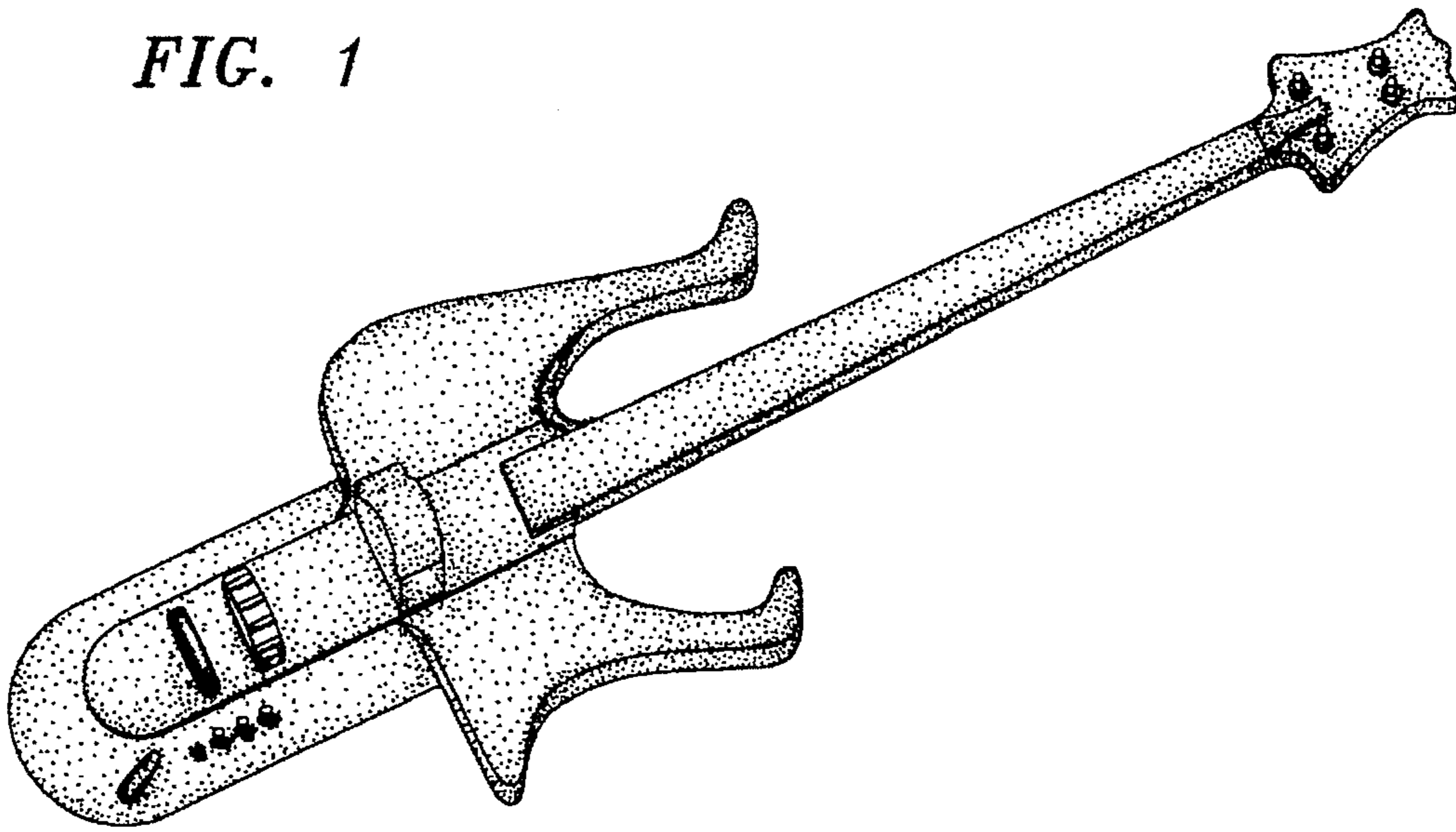

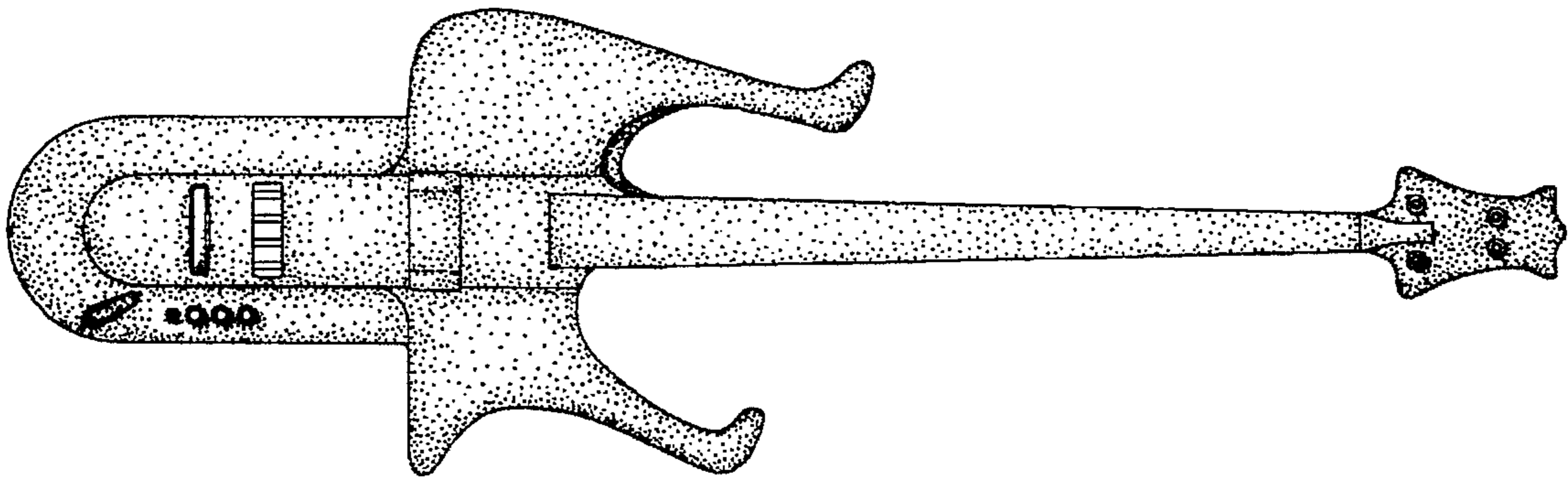

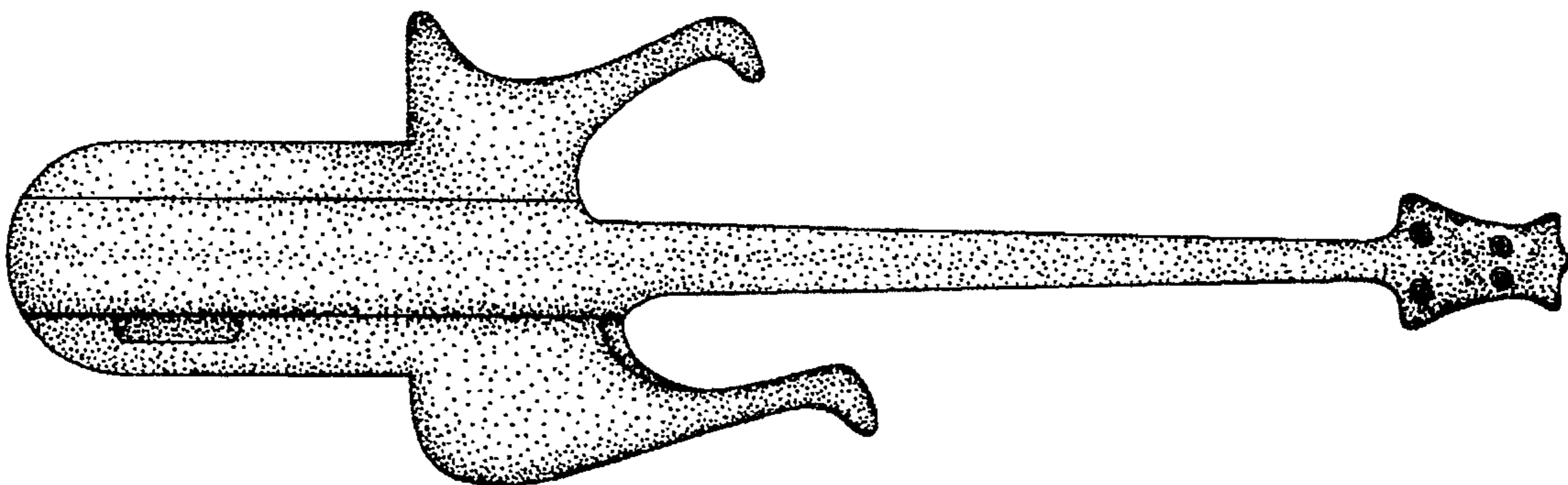
