DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the metalwood golf club head according to the invention taken from the toe end; FIG. 2 is a front elevation of the metalwood golf club head according to the invention; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the metalwood golf club head according to the invention; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the metalwood golf club head according to the invention; FIG. 5 is a rear elevation of the metalwood golf club head according to the invention;
