The ornamental design for a golf club grip, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf club grip showing the new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the invention as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a lower end elevational view of the invention as shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 4 is a top end elevational view of the invention as shown in FIG. 1.

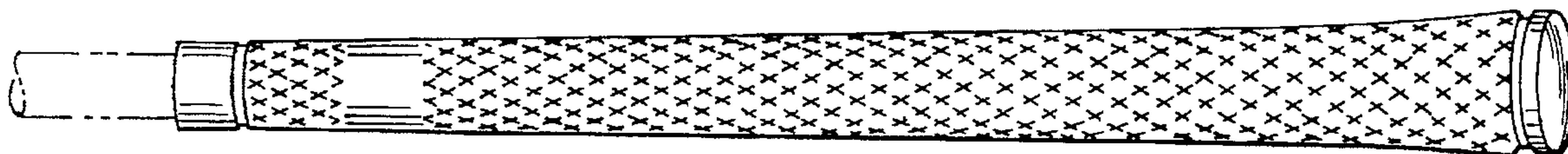

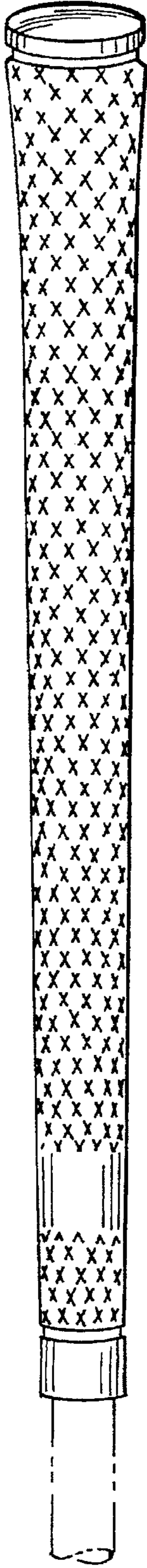

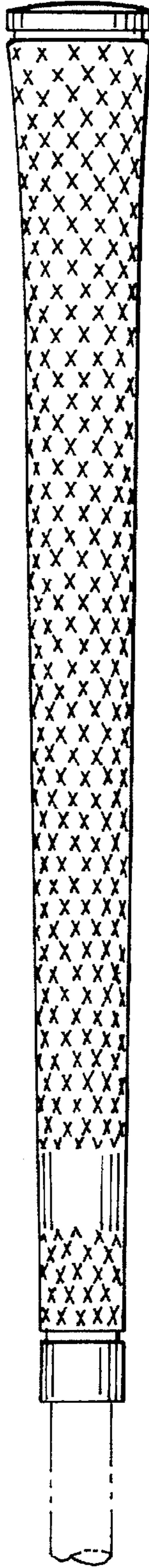

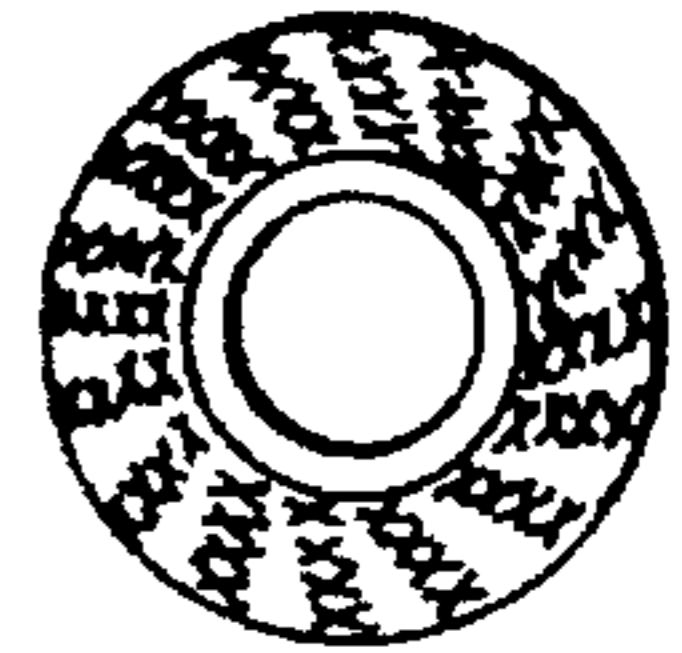
