[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electric space heater for mounting on a ceiling or wall, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG.1 is an isometric view of an electric space heater for mounting on a ceiling or wall showing our new design, as seen from the top, front and left side;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view thereof looking perpendicularly to the front of the main housing;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof looking from the left side of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof looking from the right side of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view thereof looking perpendicularly to the rear of the main housing;

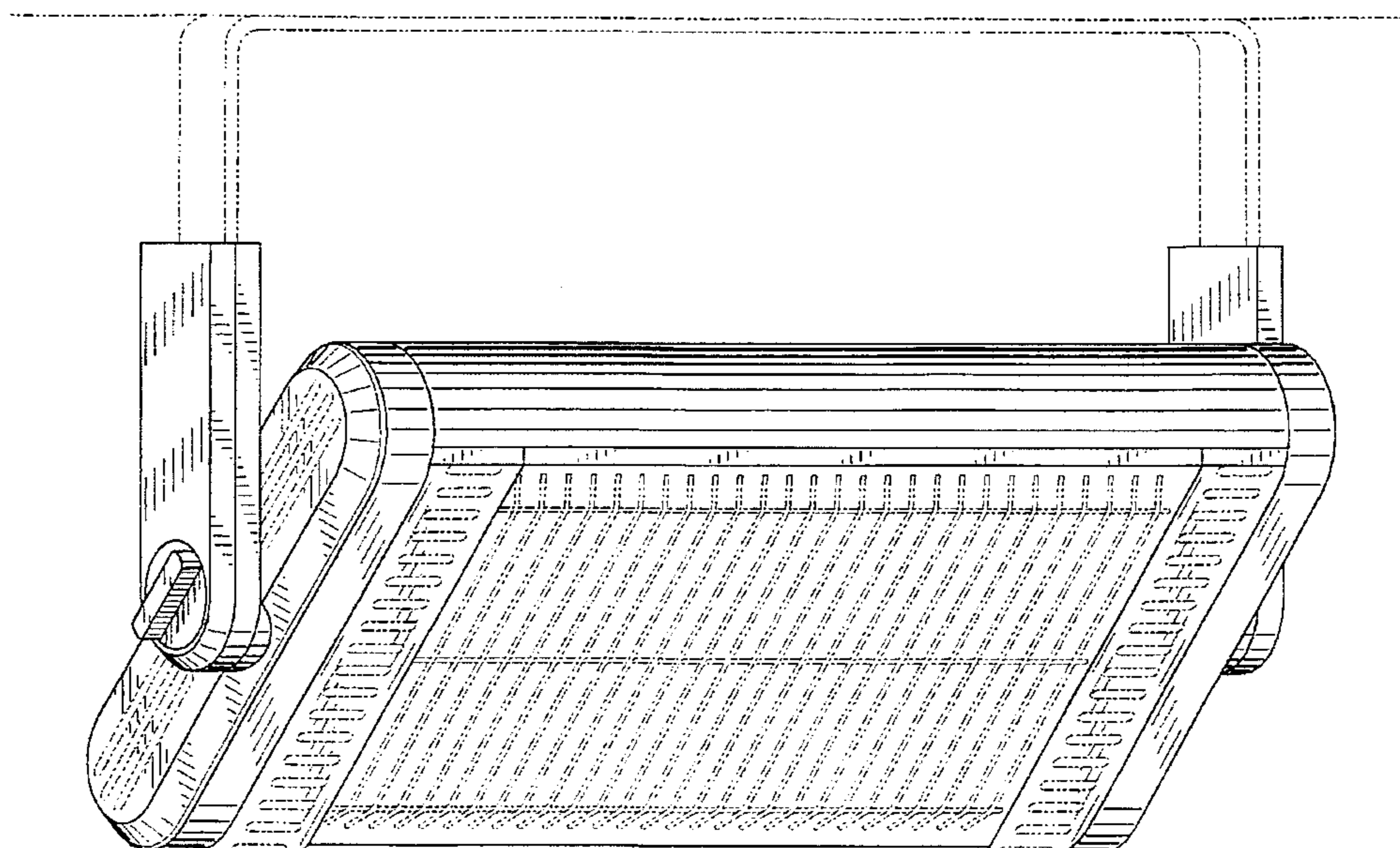
FIG. 6 is a plan view thereof looking downwardly from the top of FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 7 is a plan view thereof looking upwardly from the bottom of FIG. 2.

The broken lines showing a mounting bracket and a ceiling in FIG. 1, showing a grill in FIGS. 1 and 2, showing sockets in the support arms for receiving the mounting bracket in FIGS. 5 and 6, and showing several vents in FIGS. 1 through 7, are used for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

In all of FIGS. 1 through 7, the main housing of the heater is shown pivoted relative to the support arms at the same angle, but it shall be understood that the main housing of the heater may be pivoted to different angles relative to the support arms.

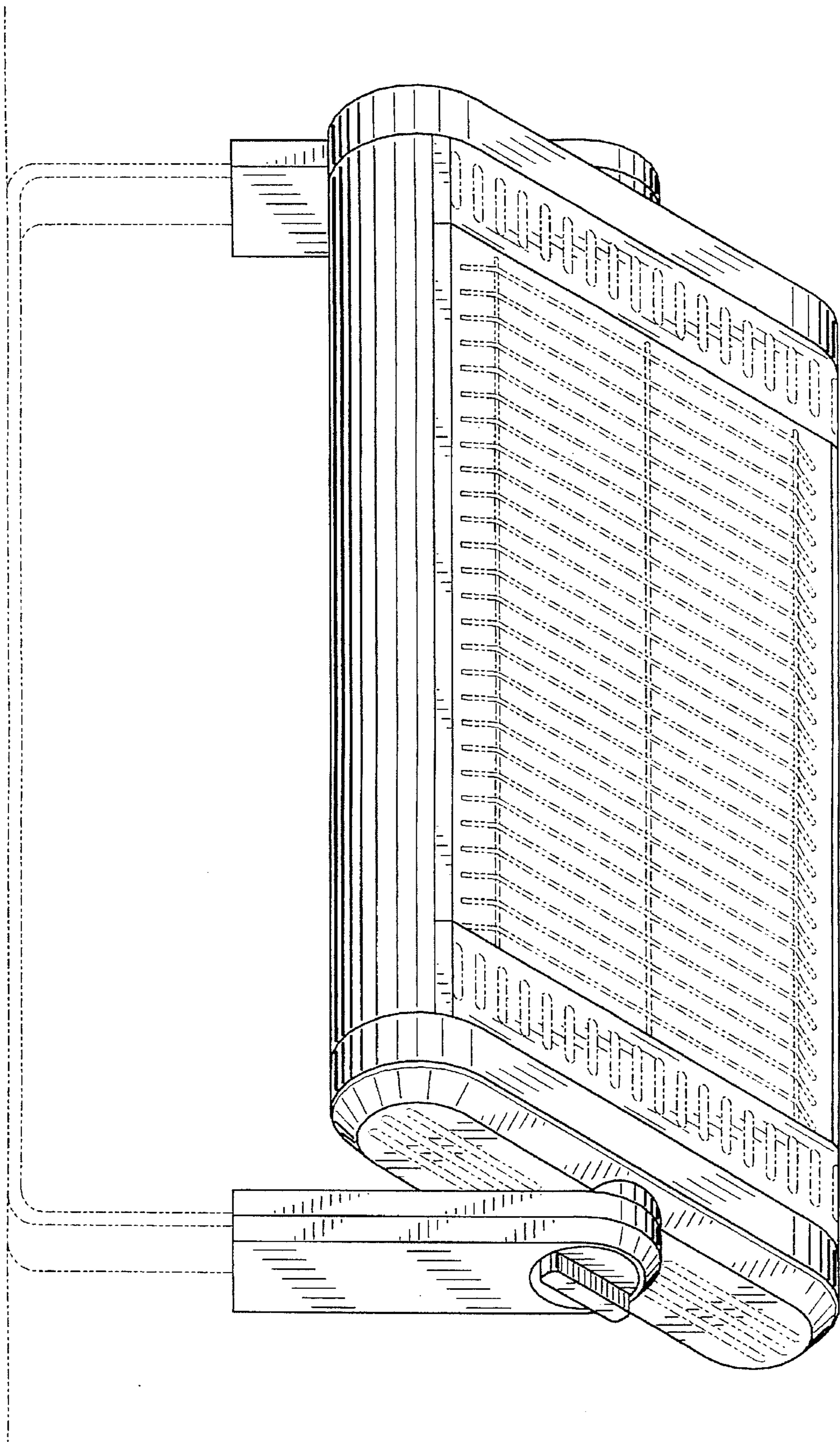

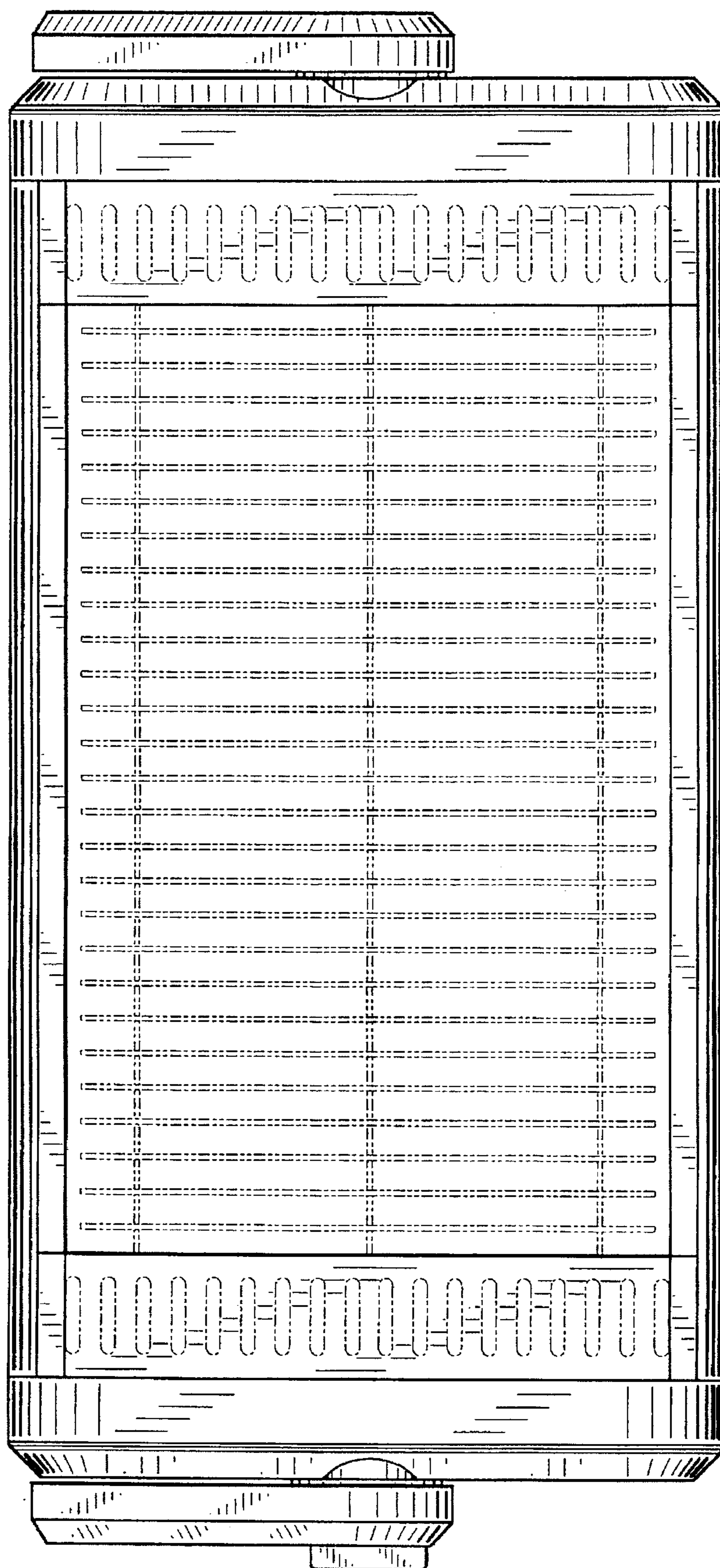

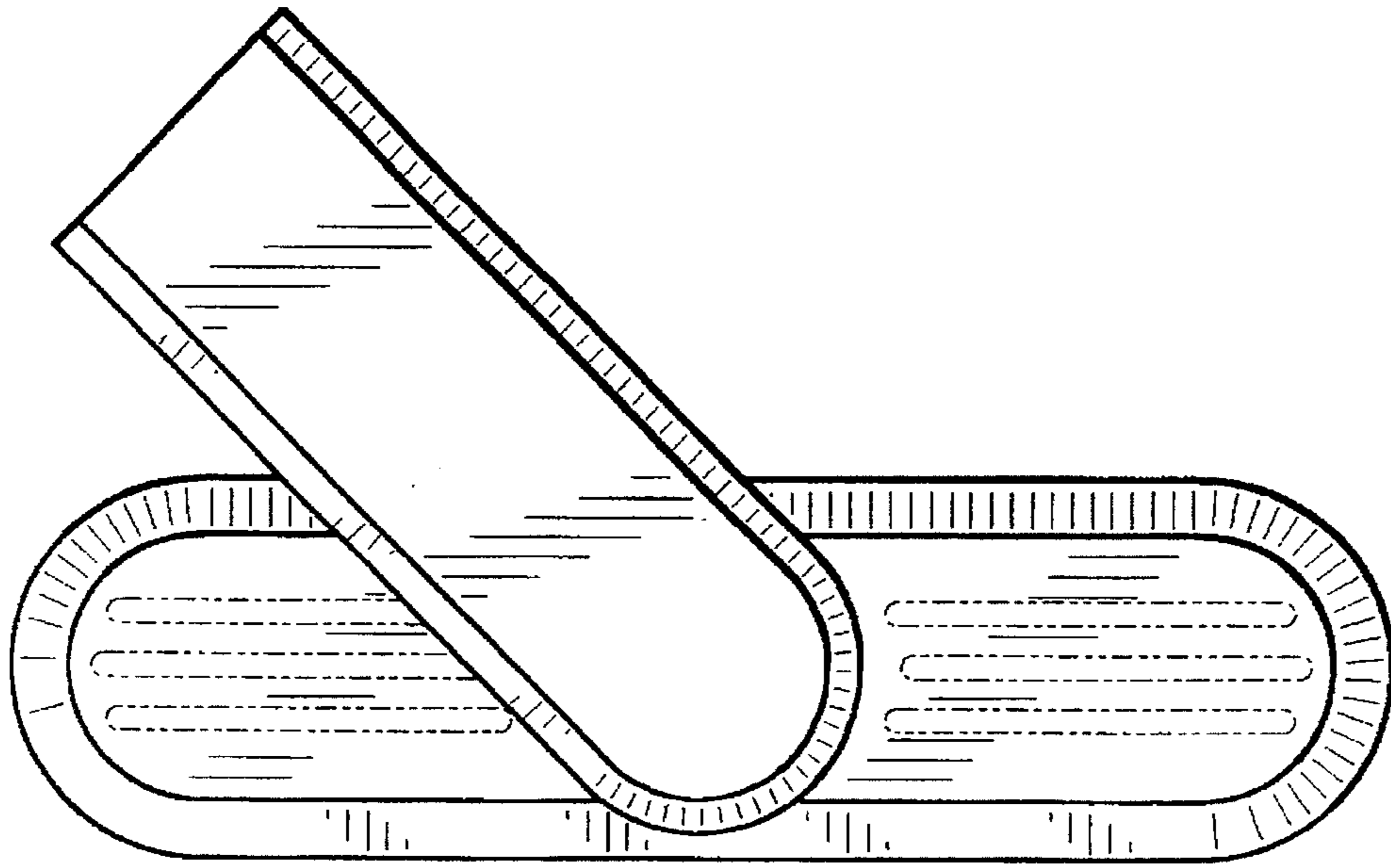

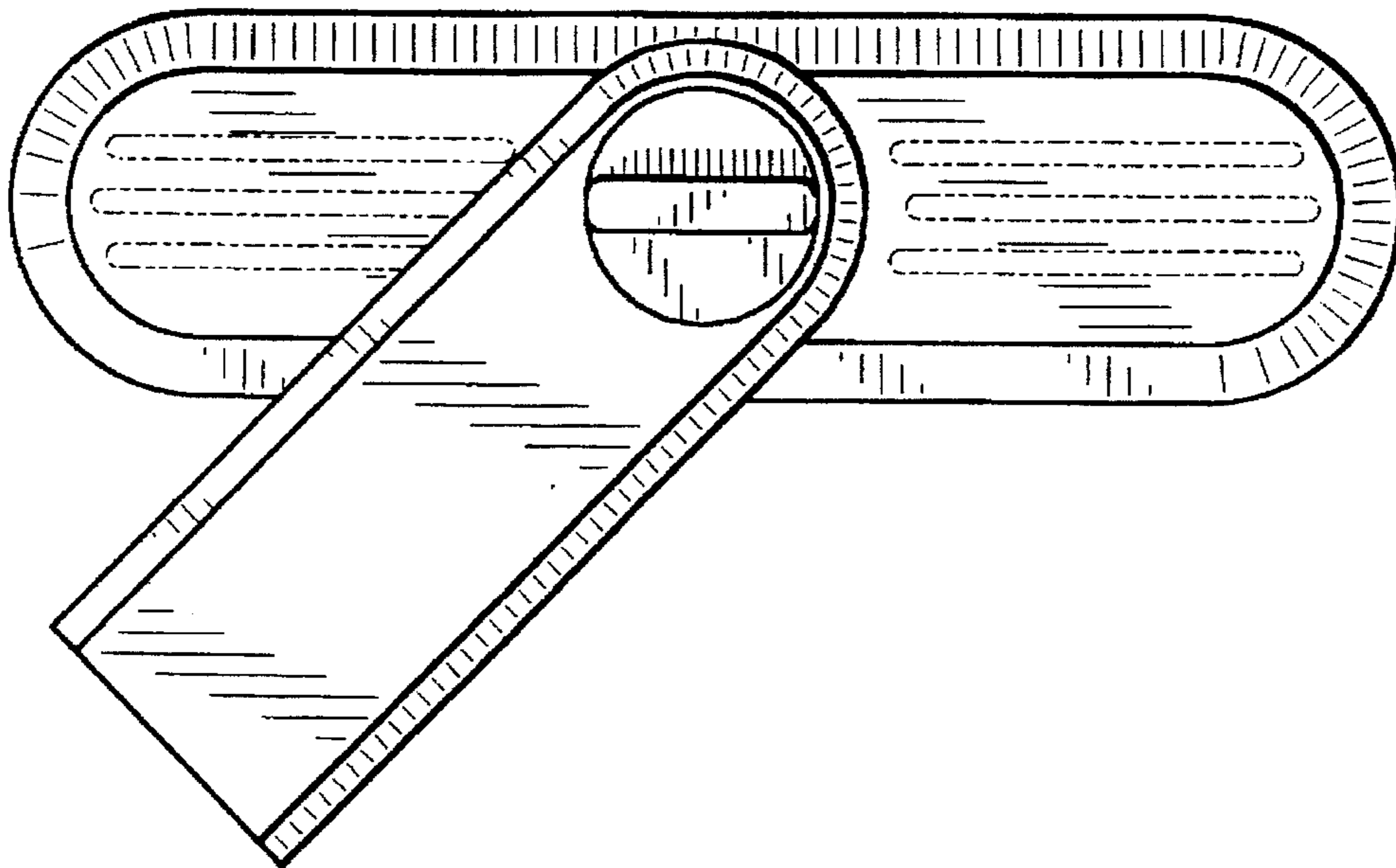

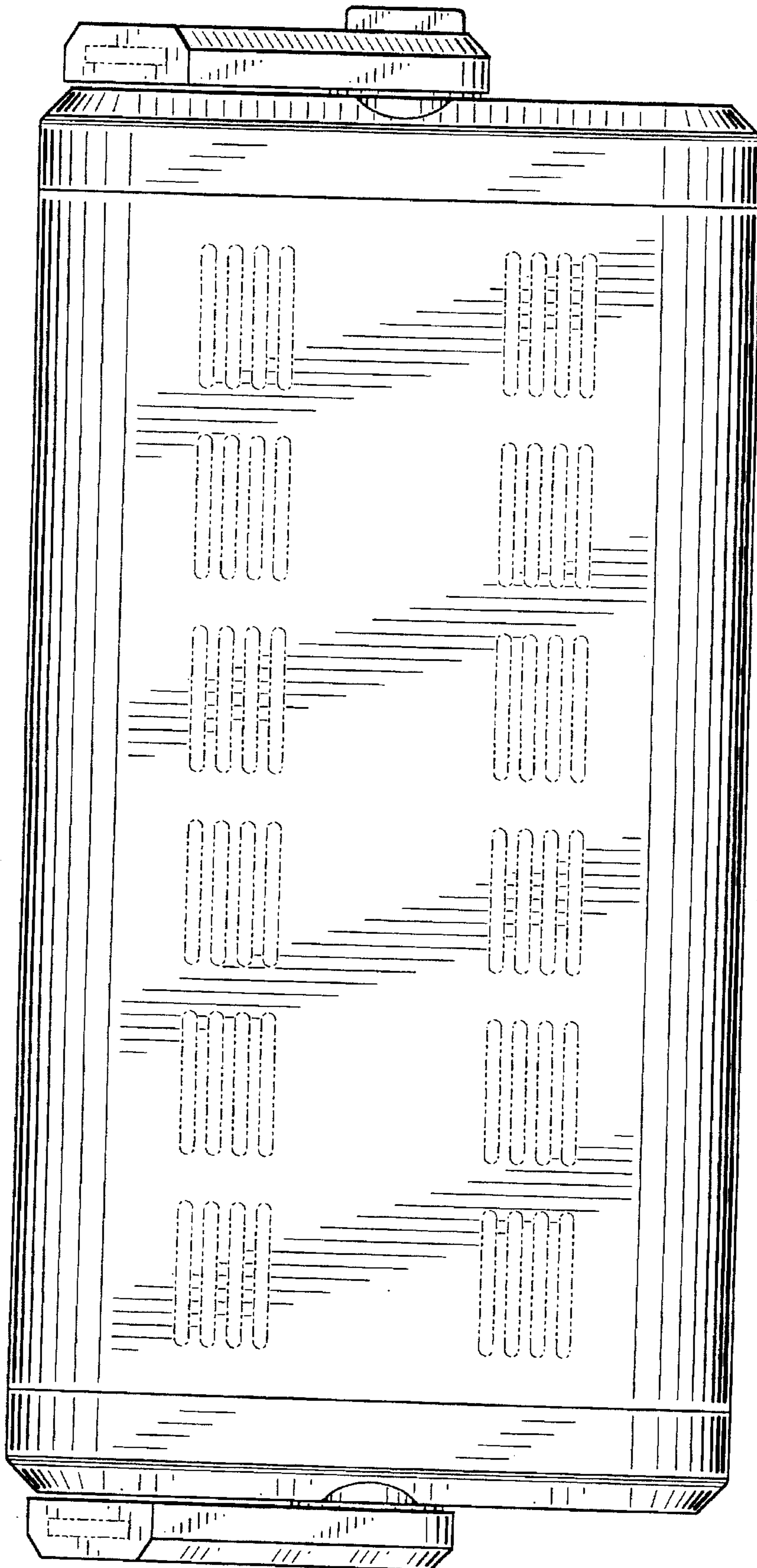

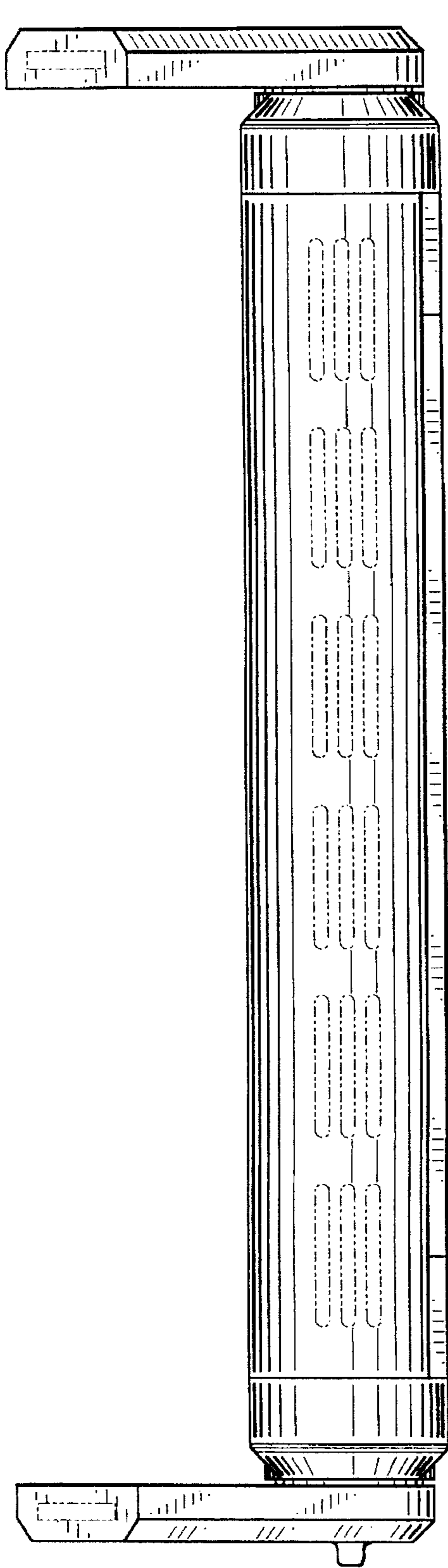

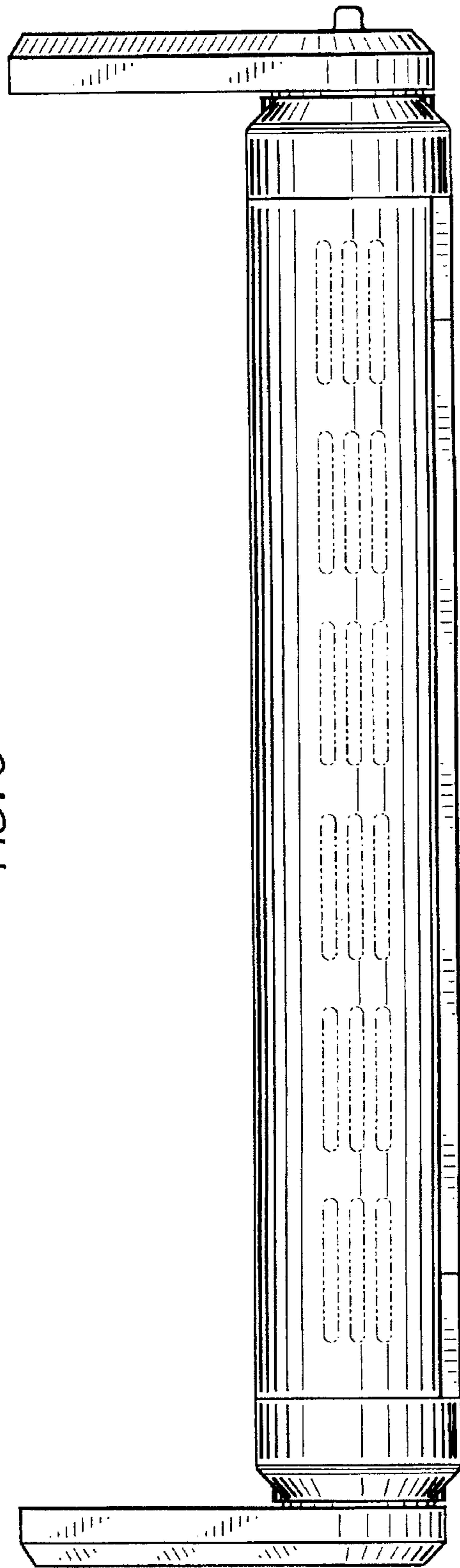
