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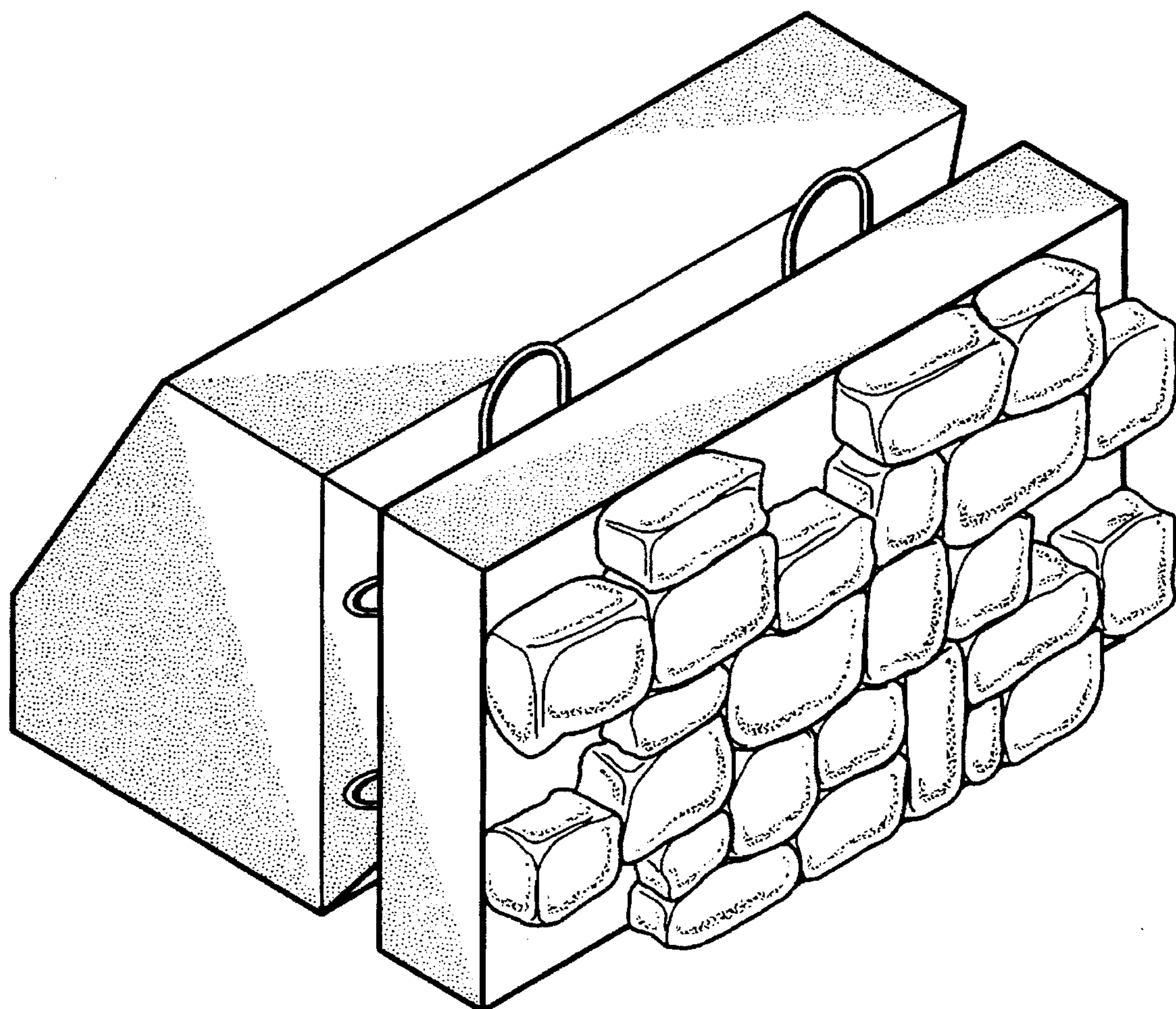
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stackable unit for a retaining wall having irregular stonework, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a stackable unit for a retaining wall having irregular stonework showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is an isometric view thereof.

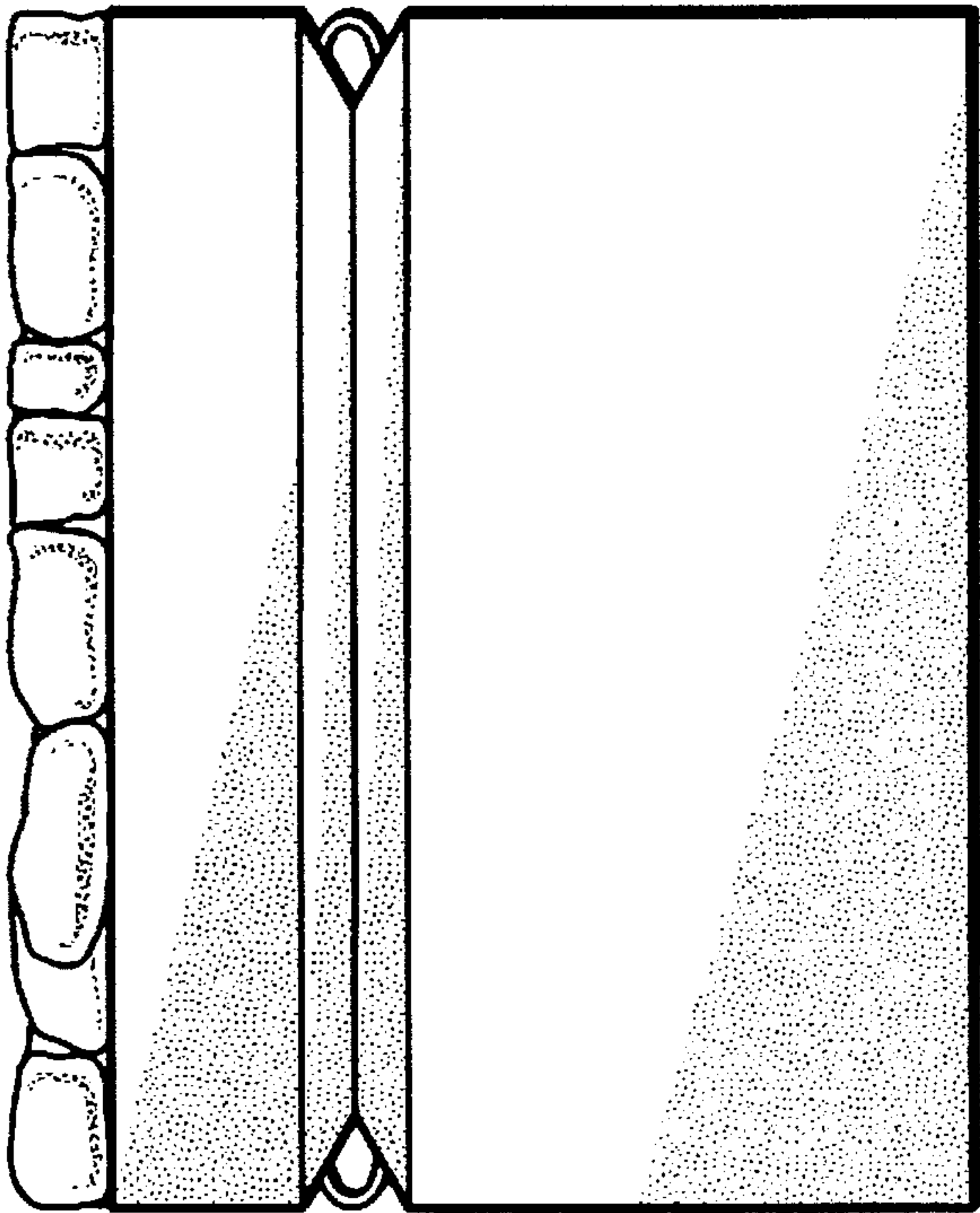

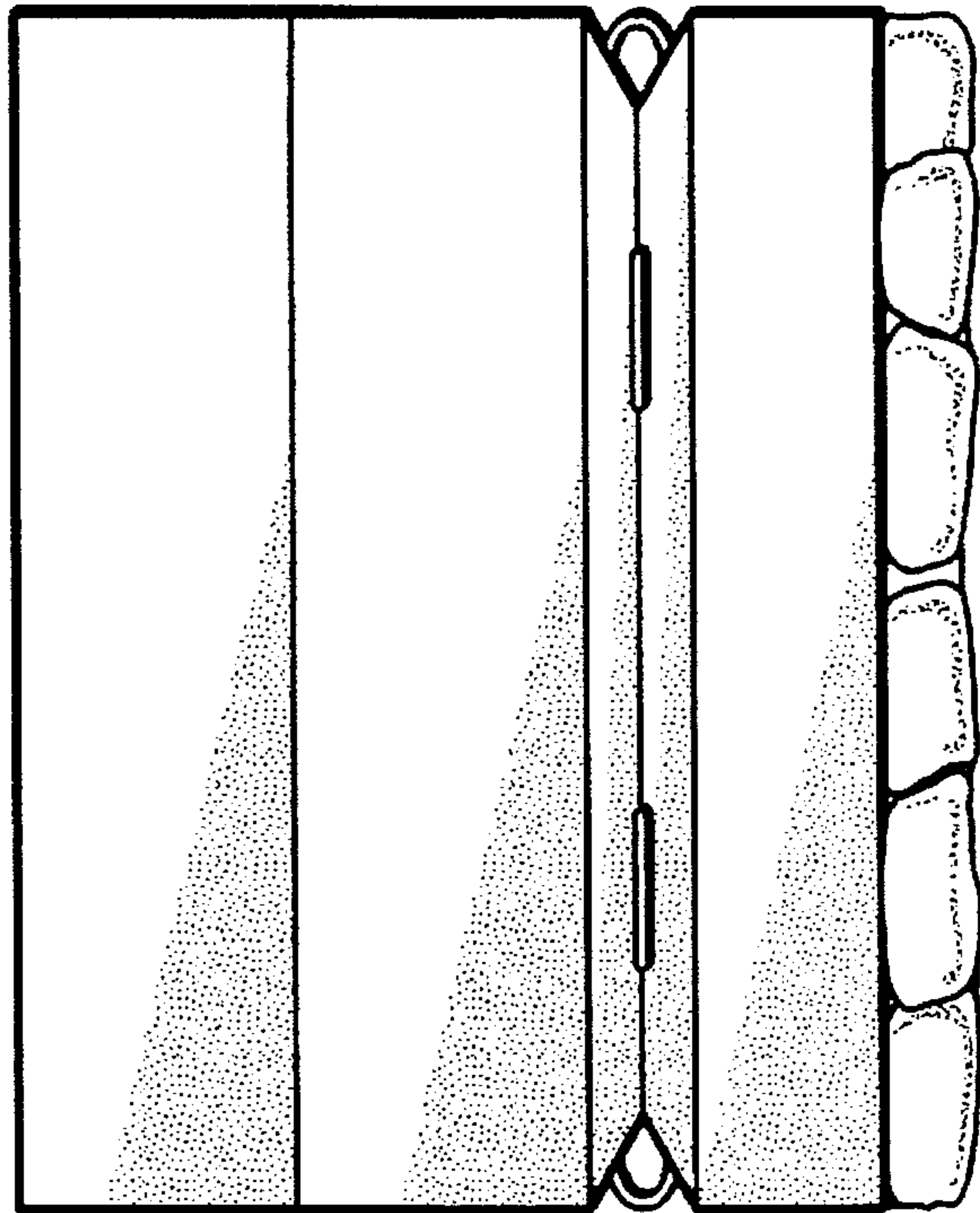

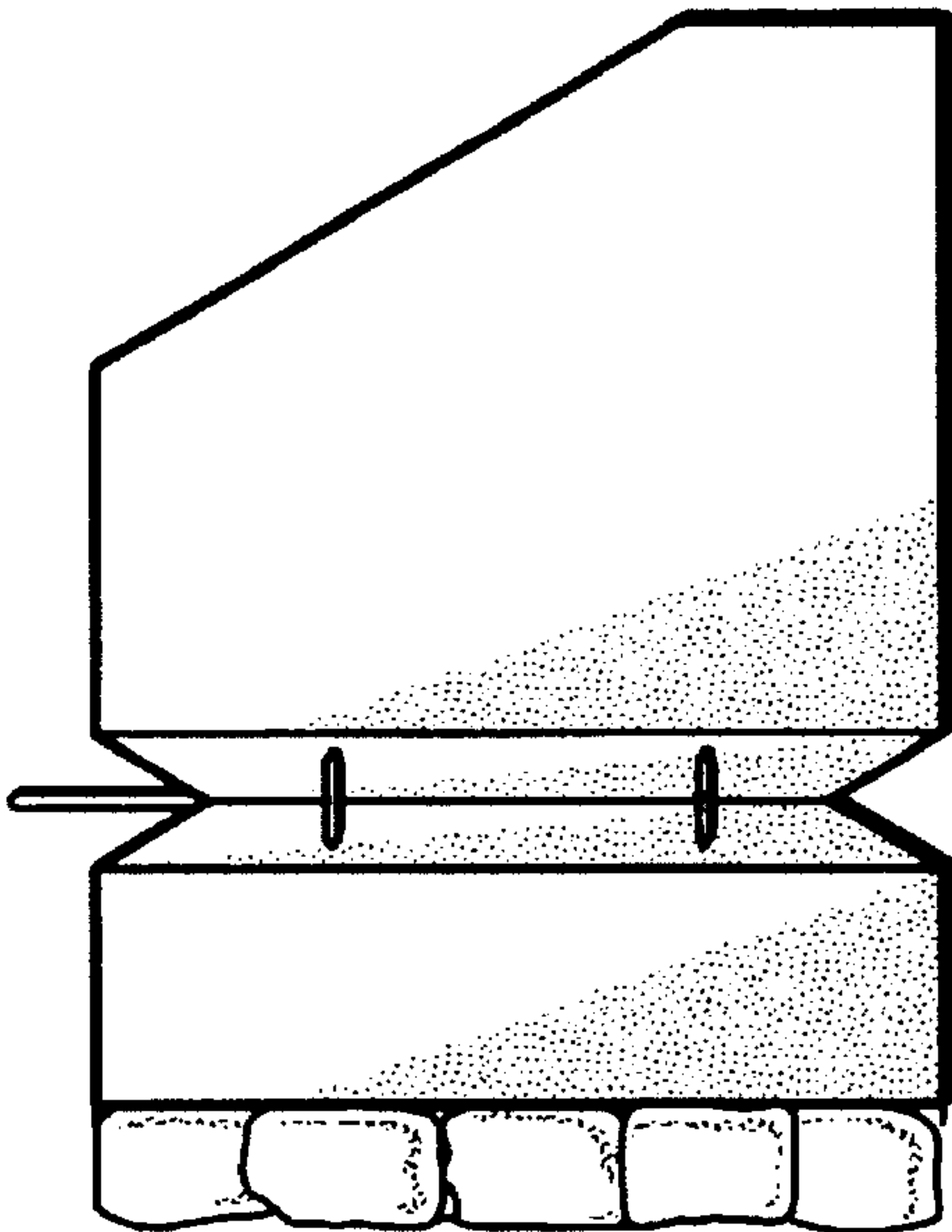

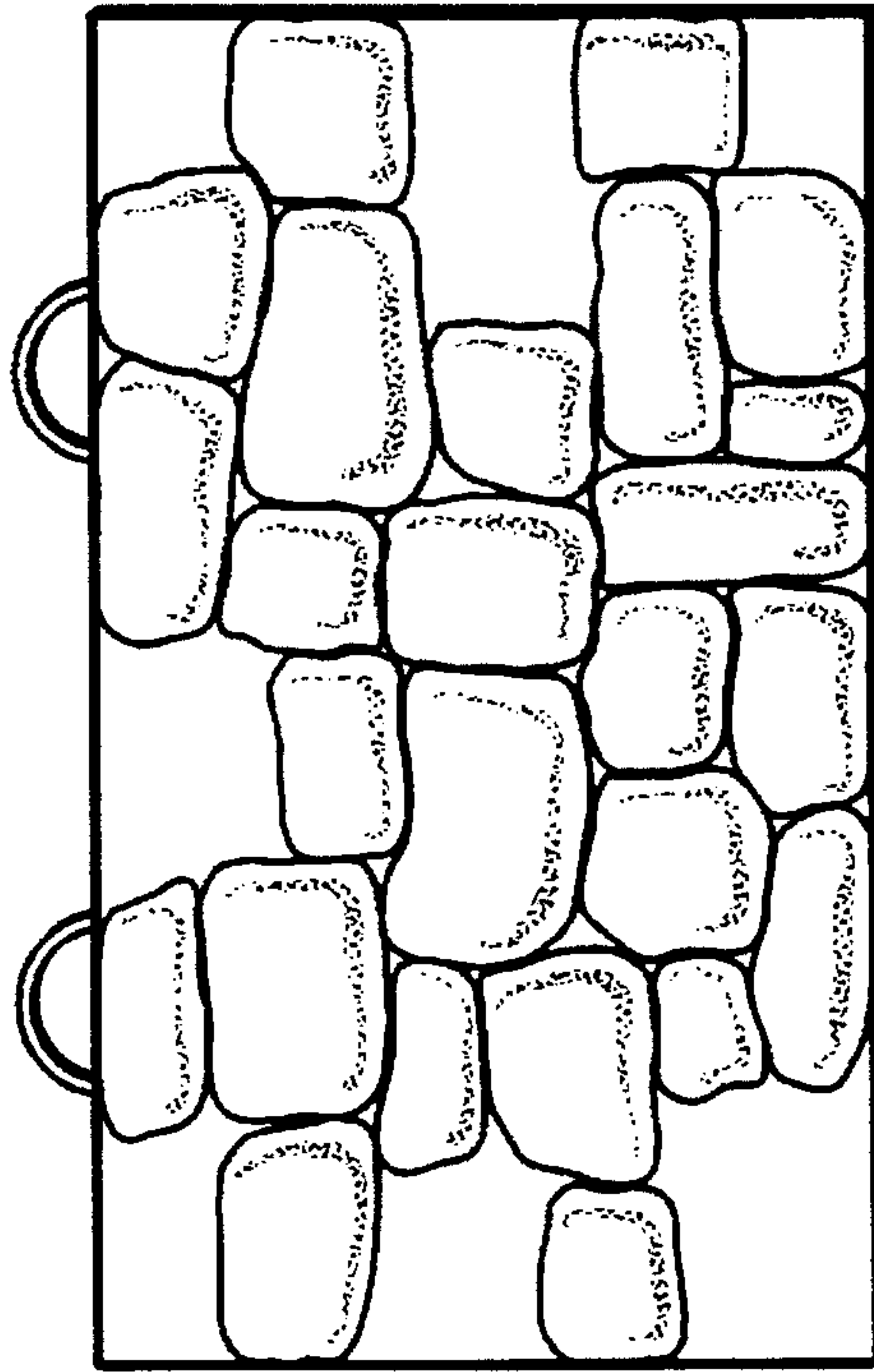

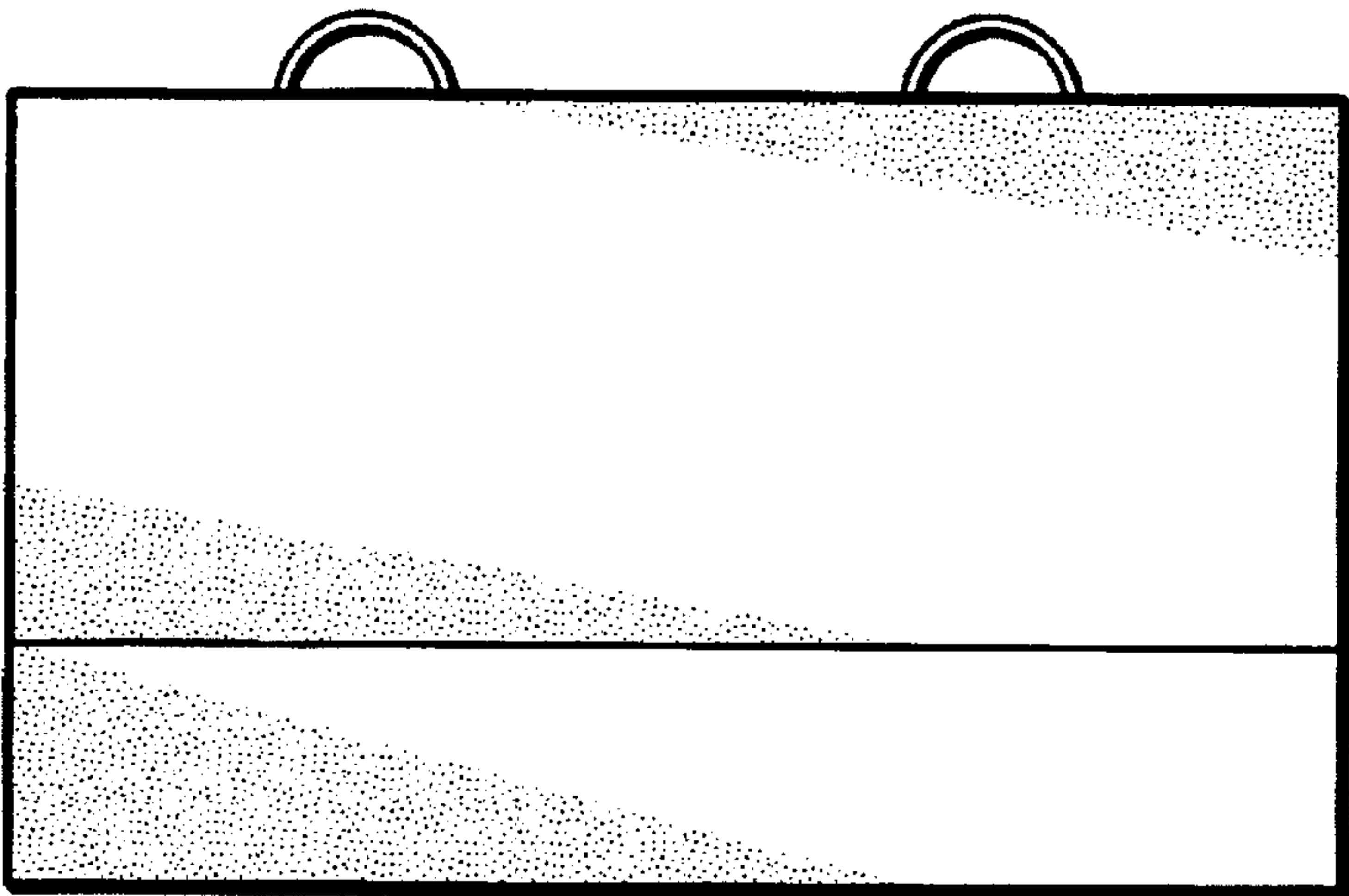
