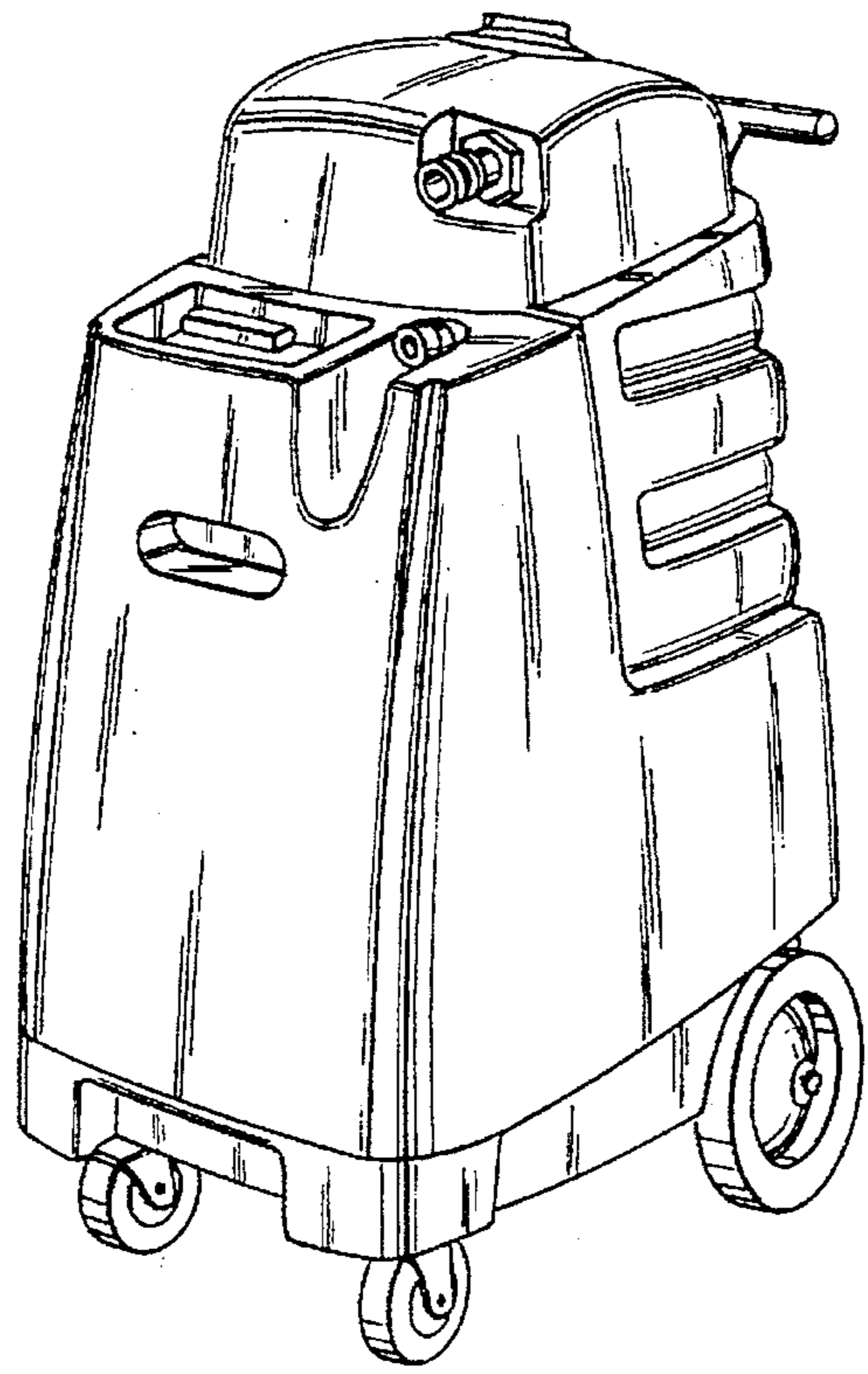
[57] CLAIM

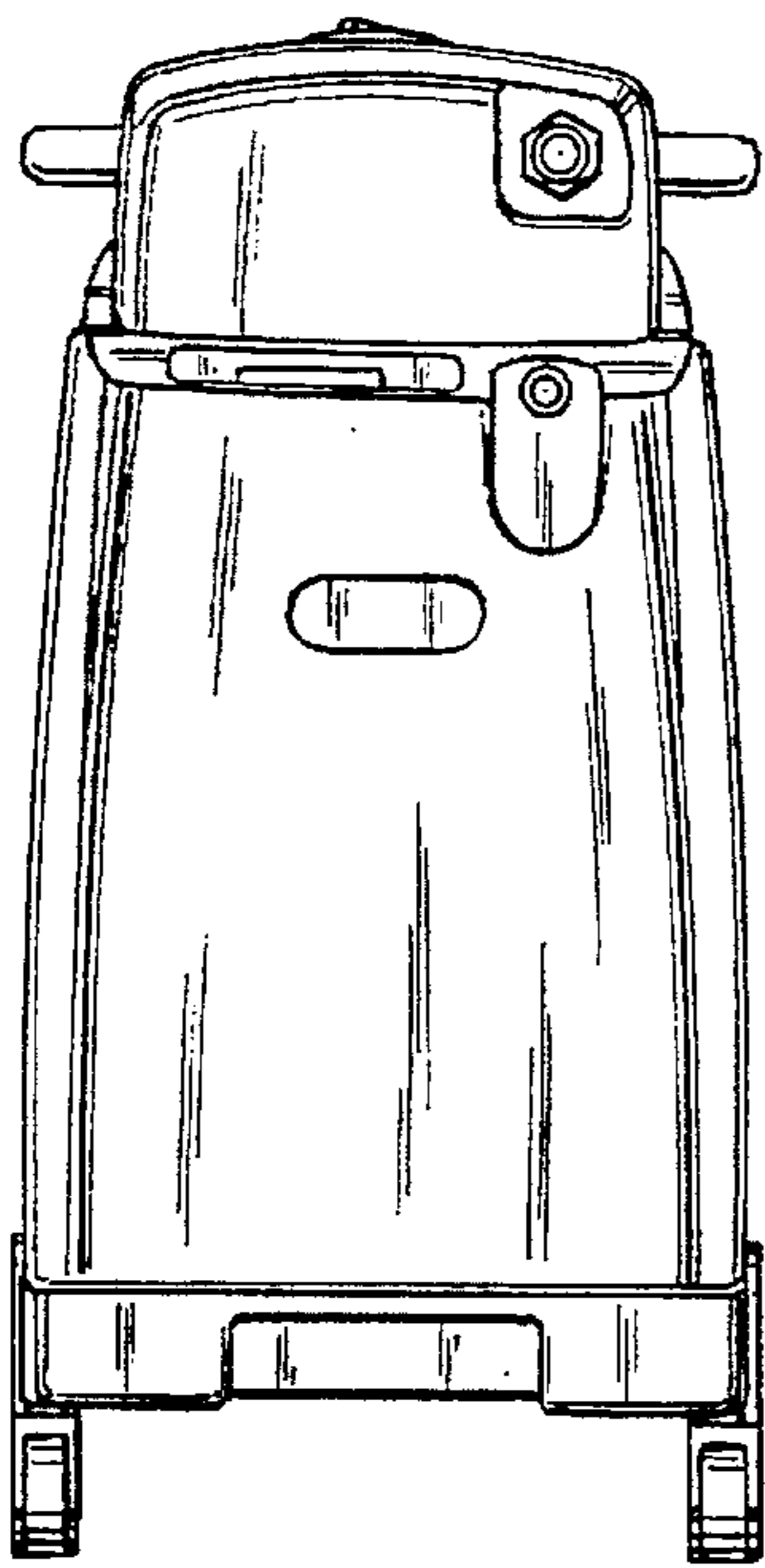

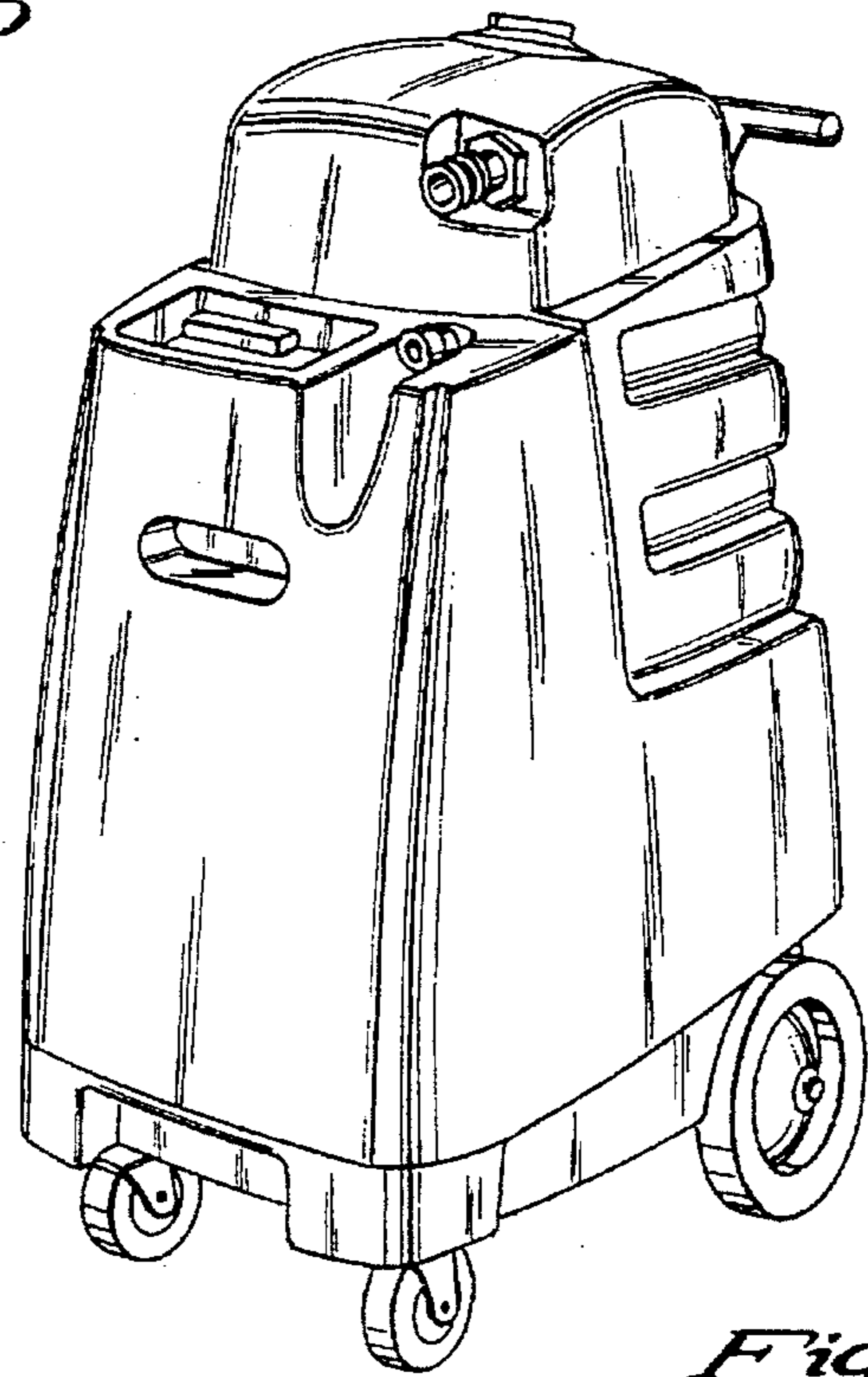

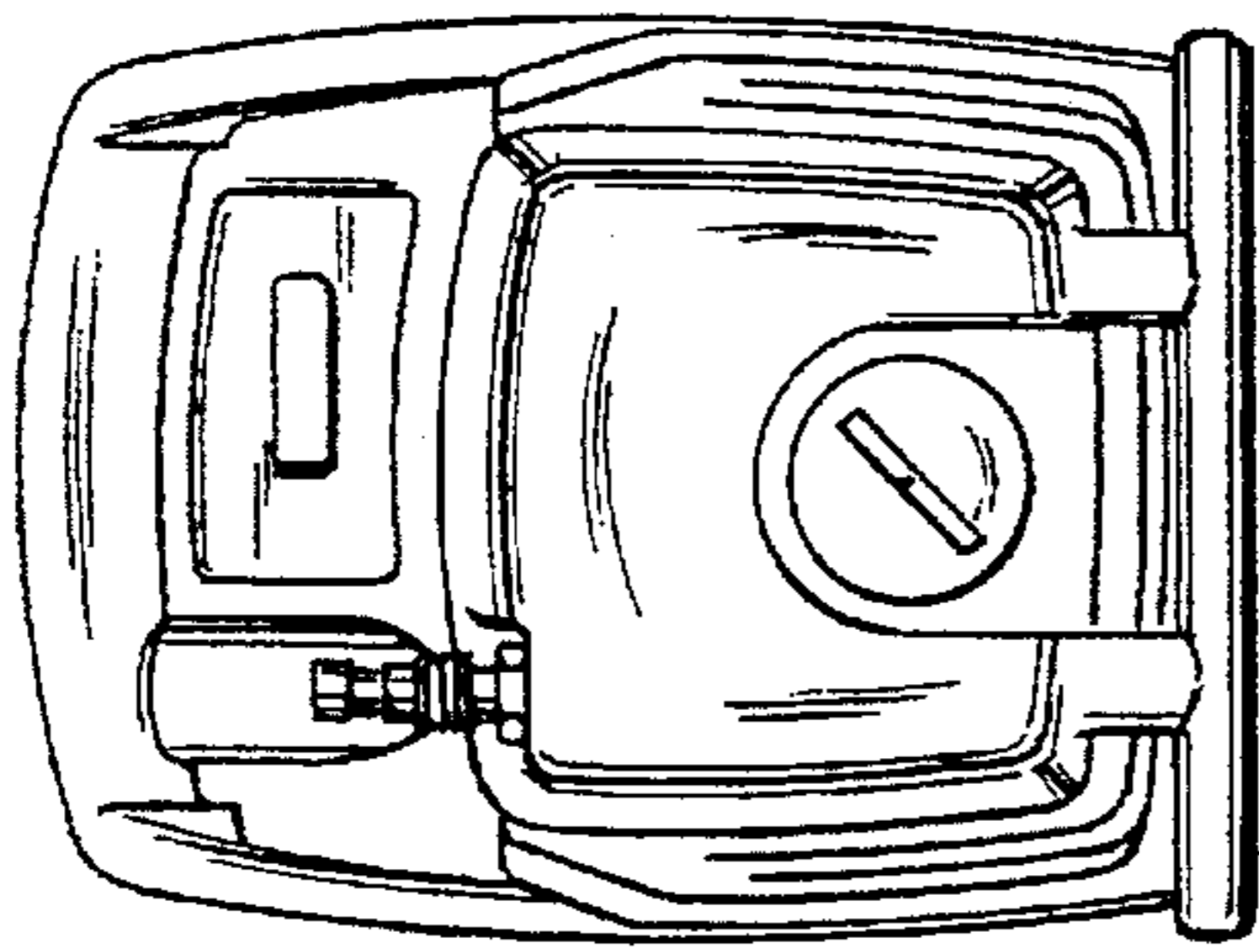

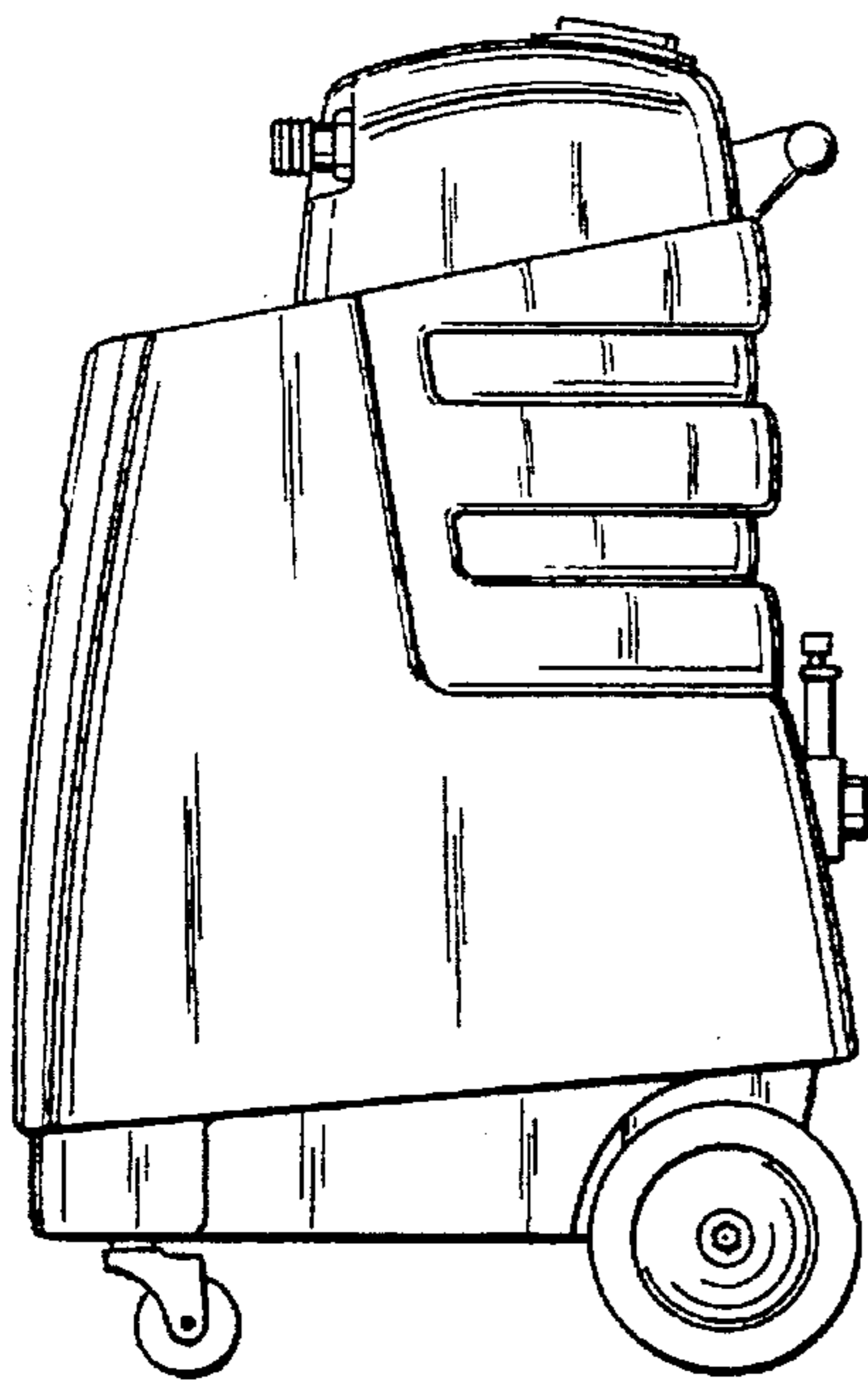

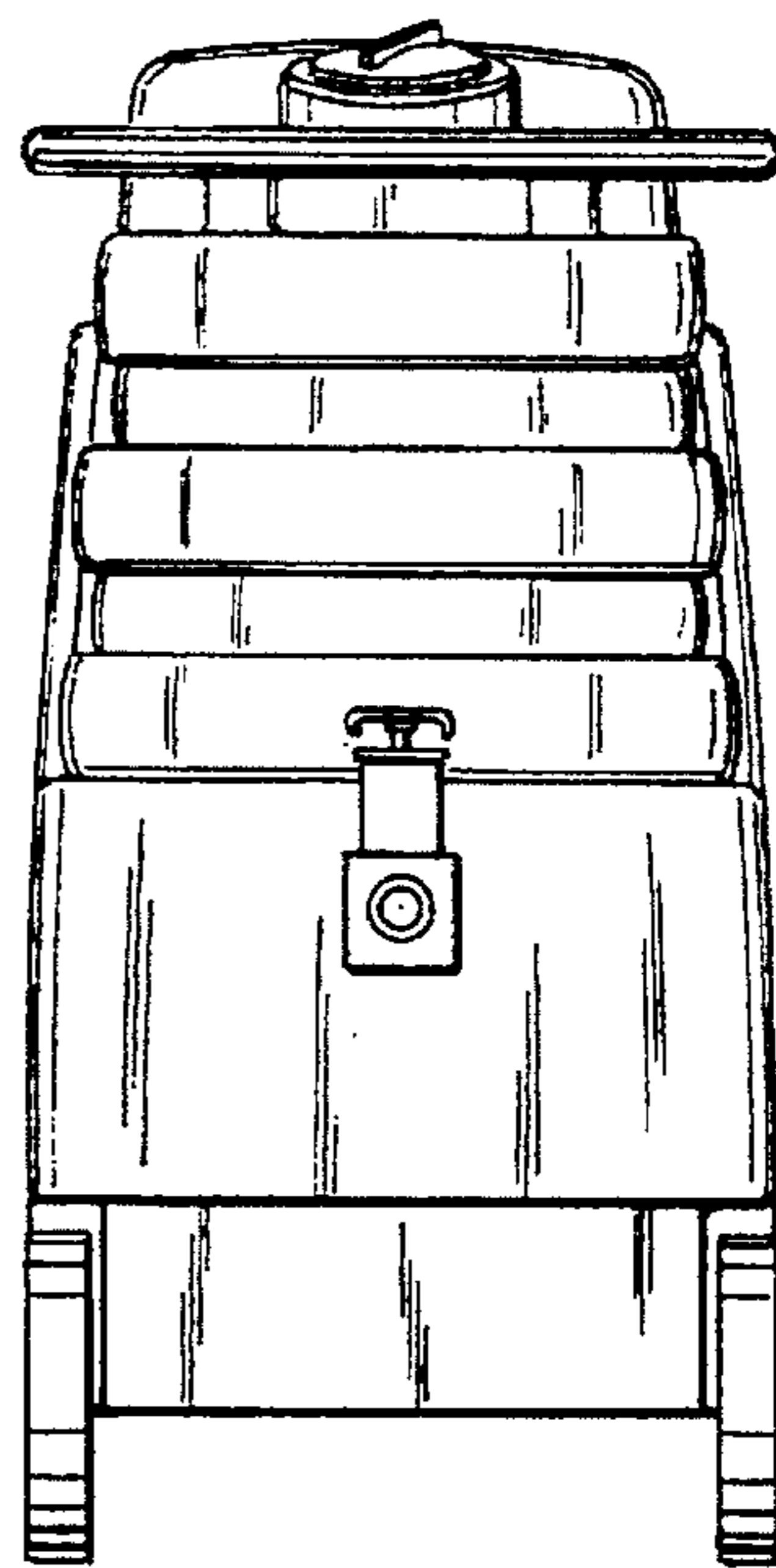
