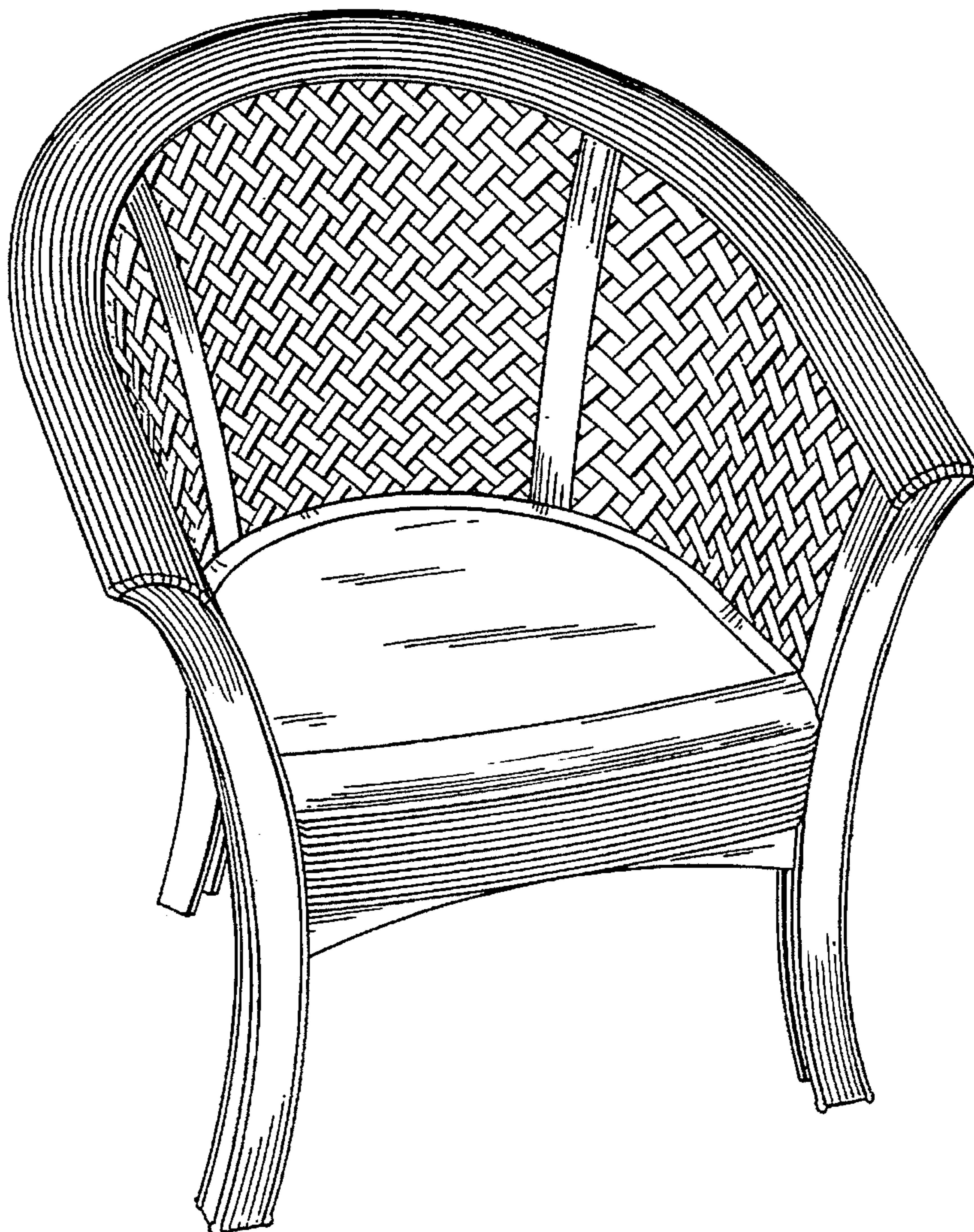
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a chair showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.
FIGS. 2 through 5 have been shown on an enlarged scale.

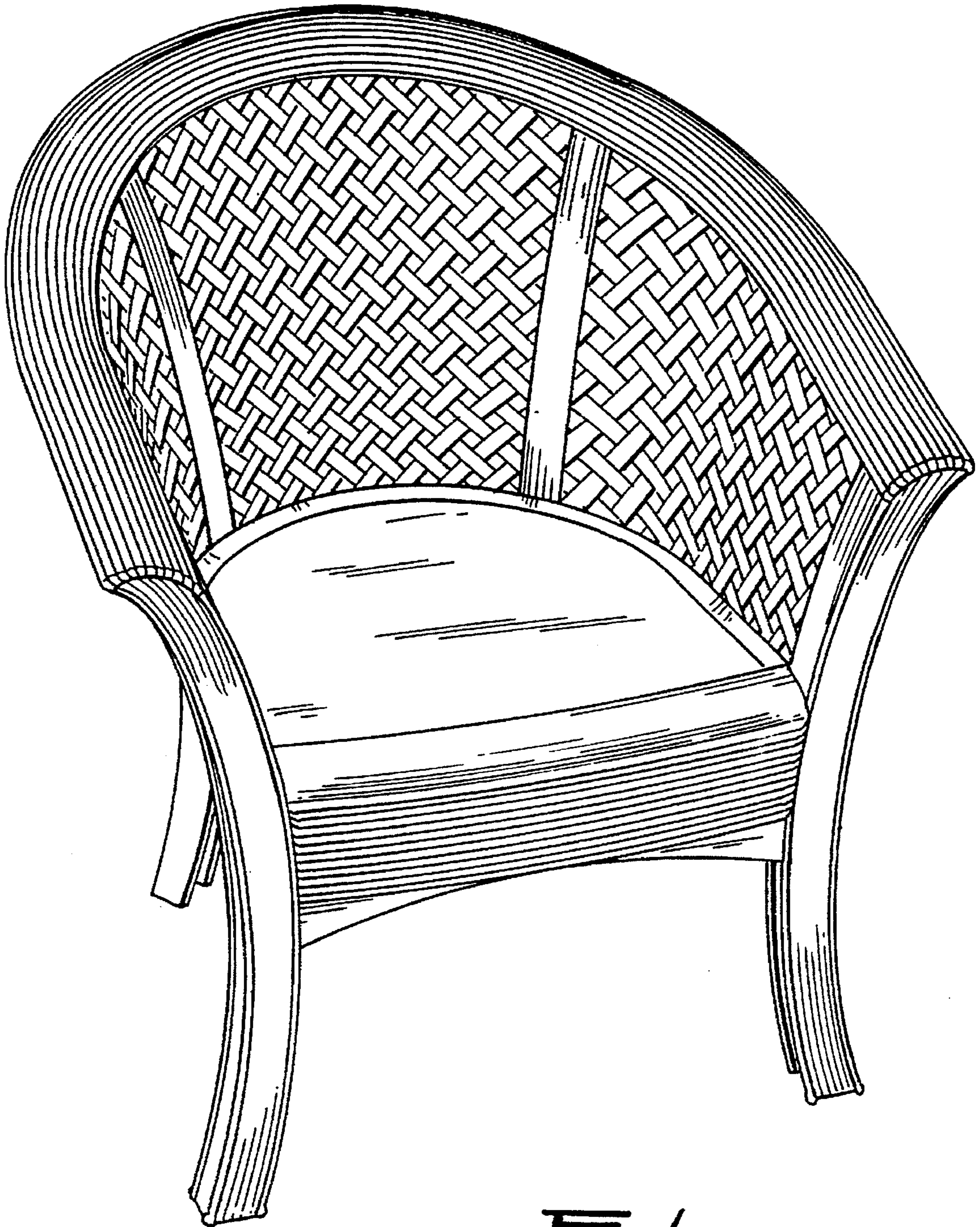

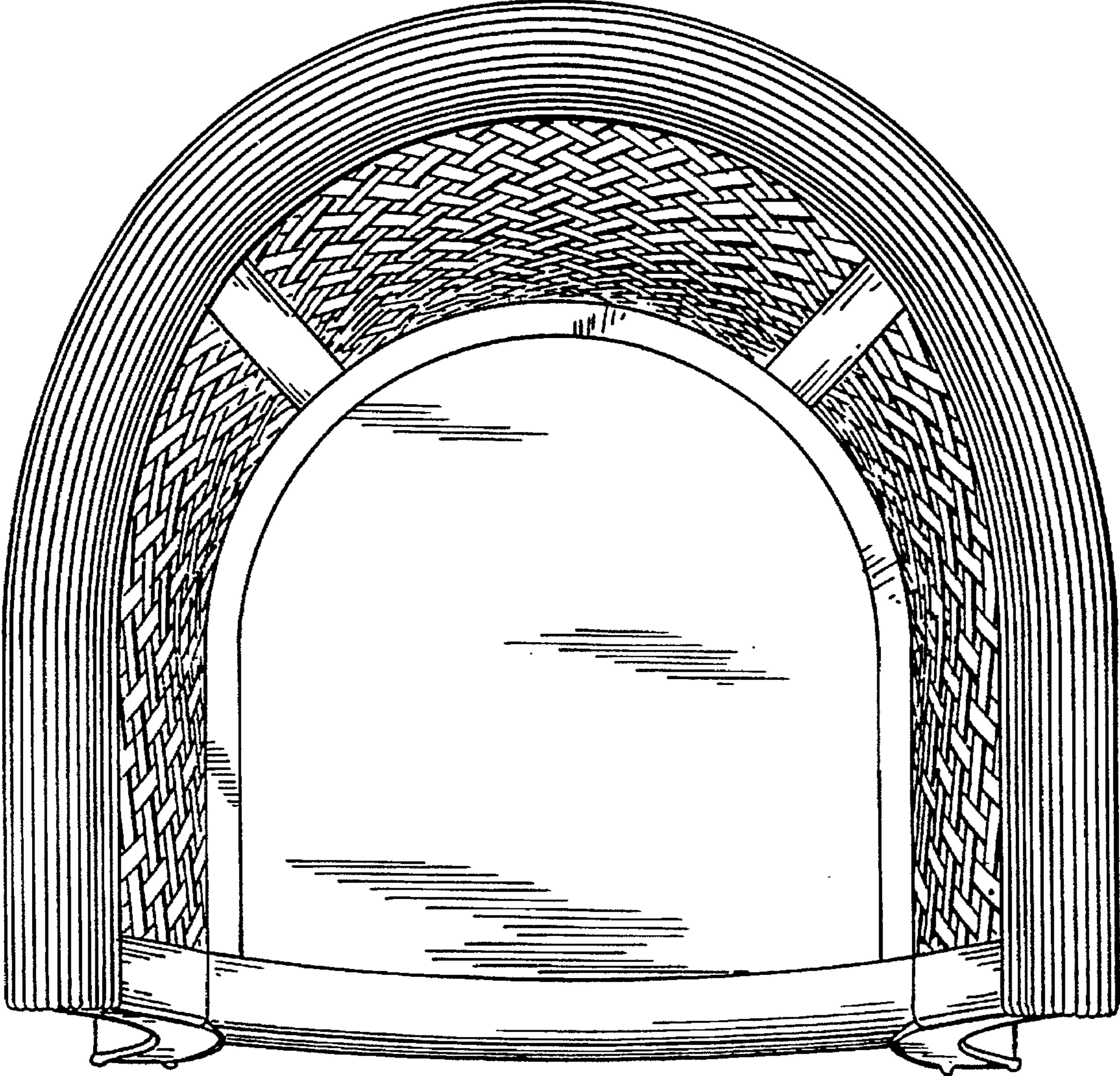

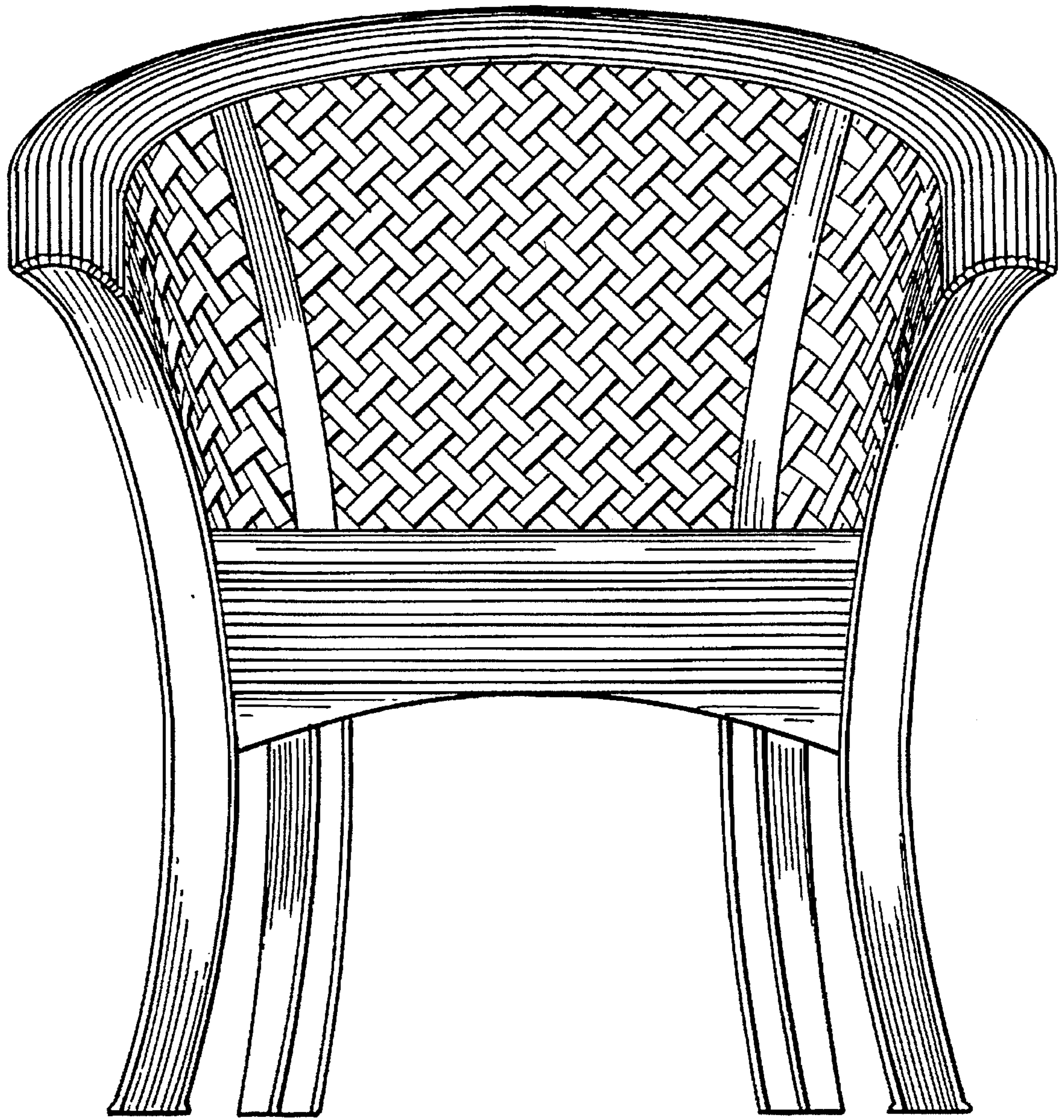

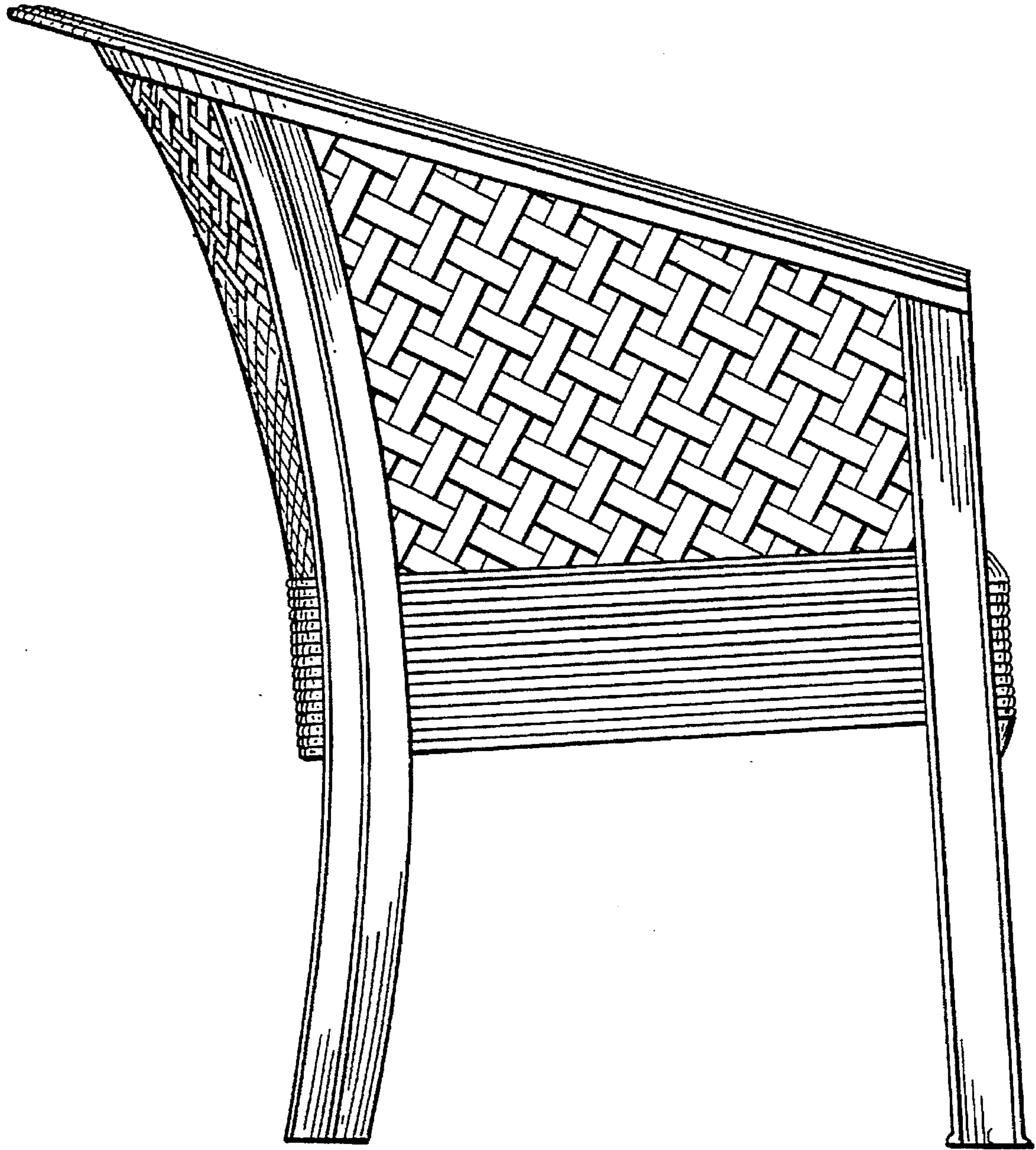
