**DESCRIPTION**

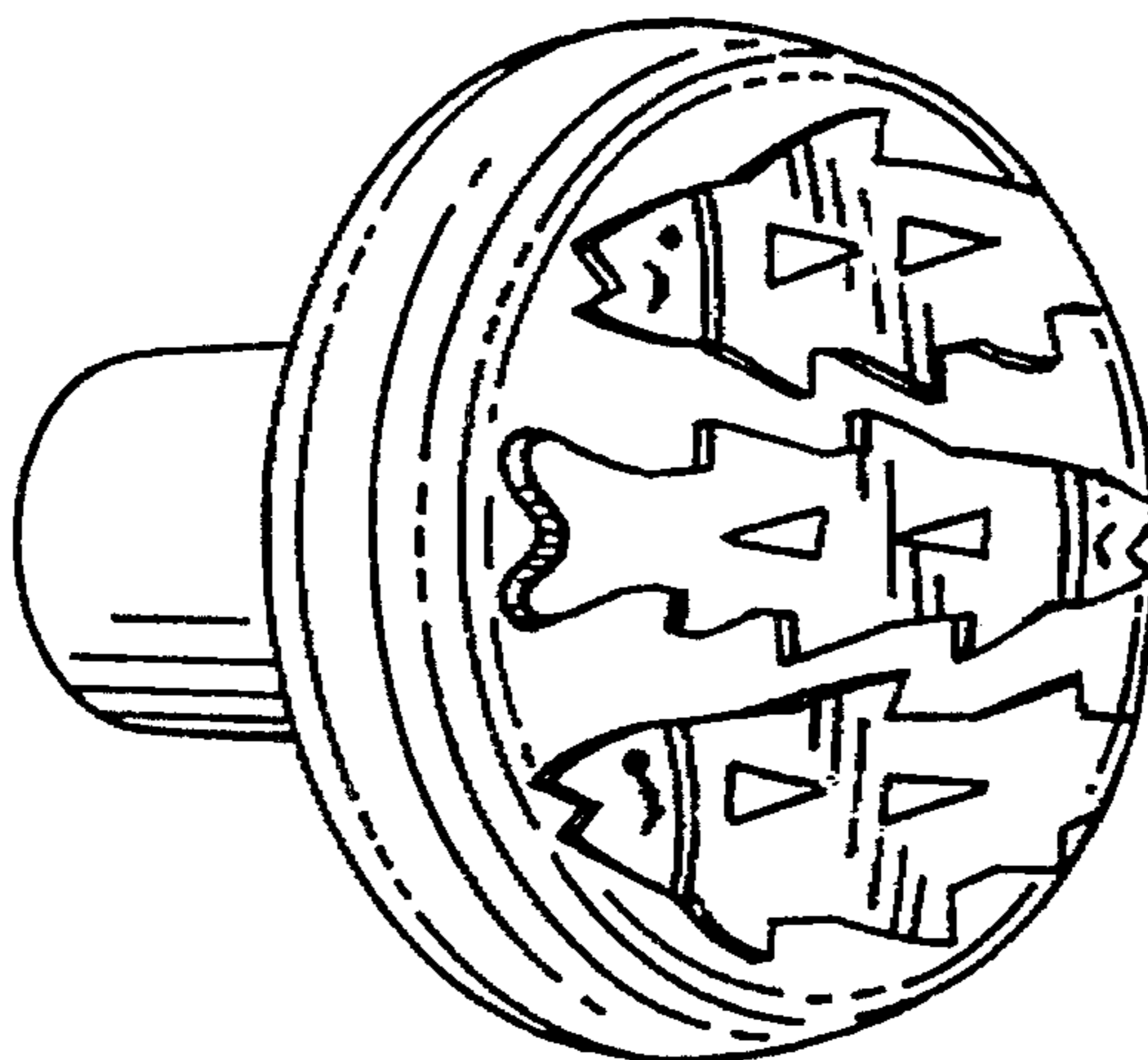
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the pull of the present invention;

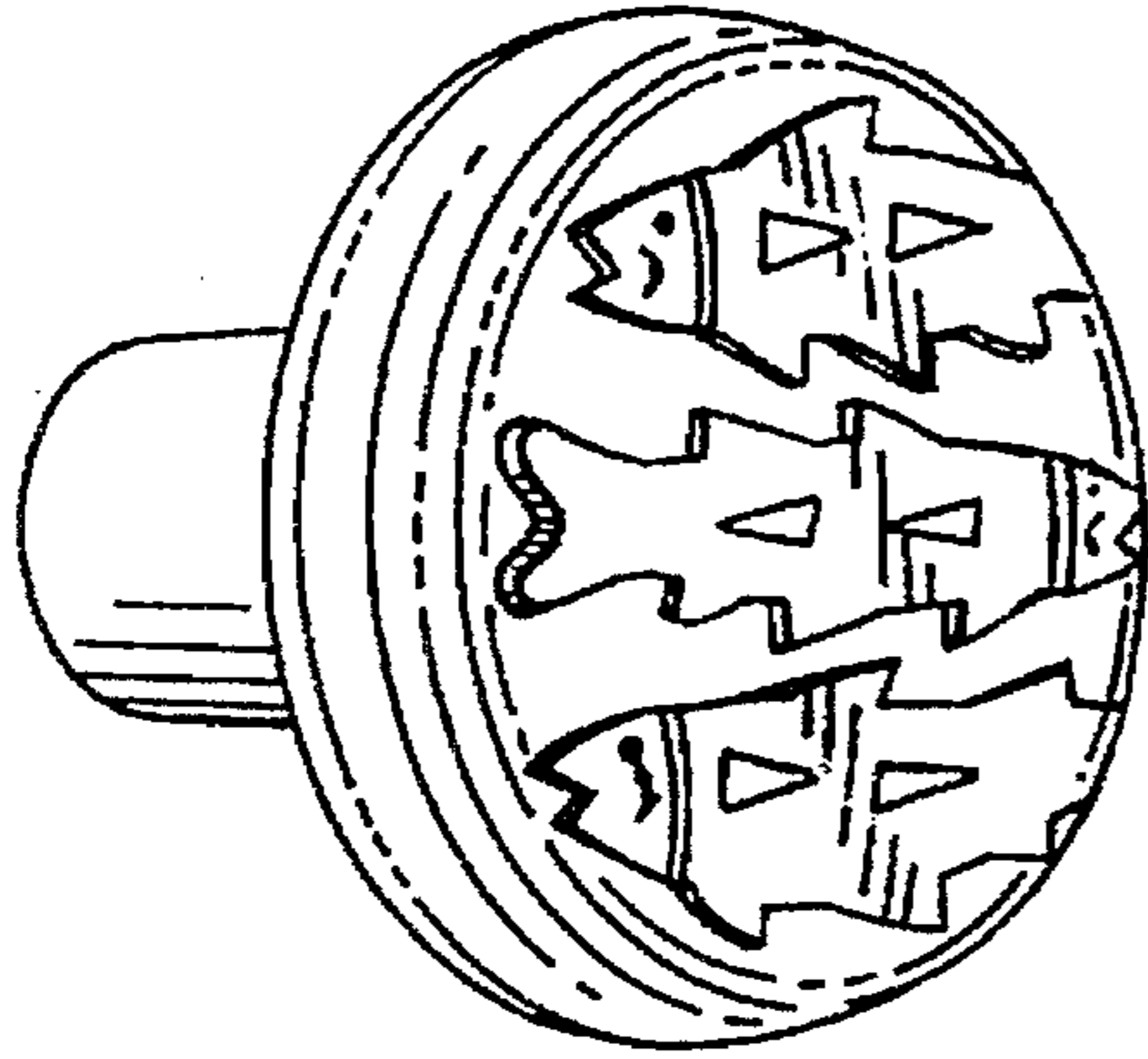

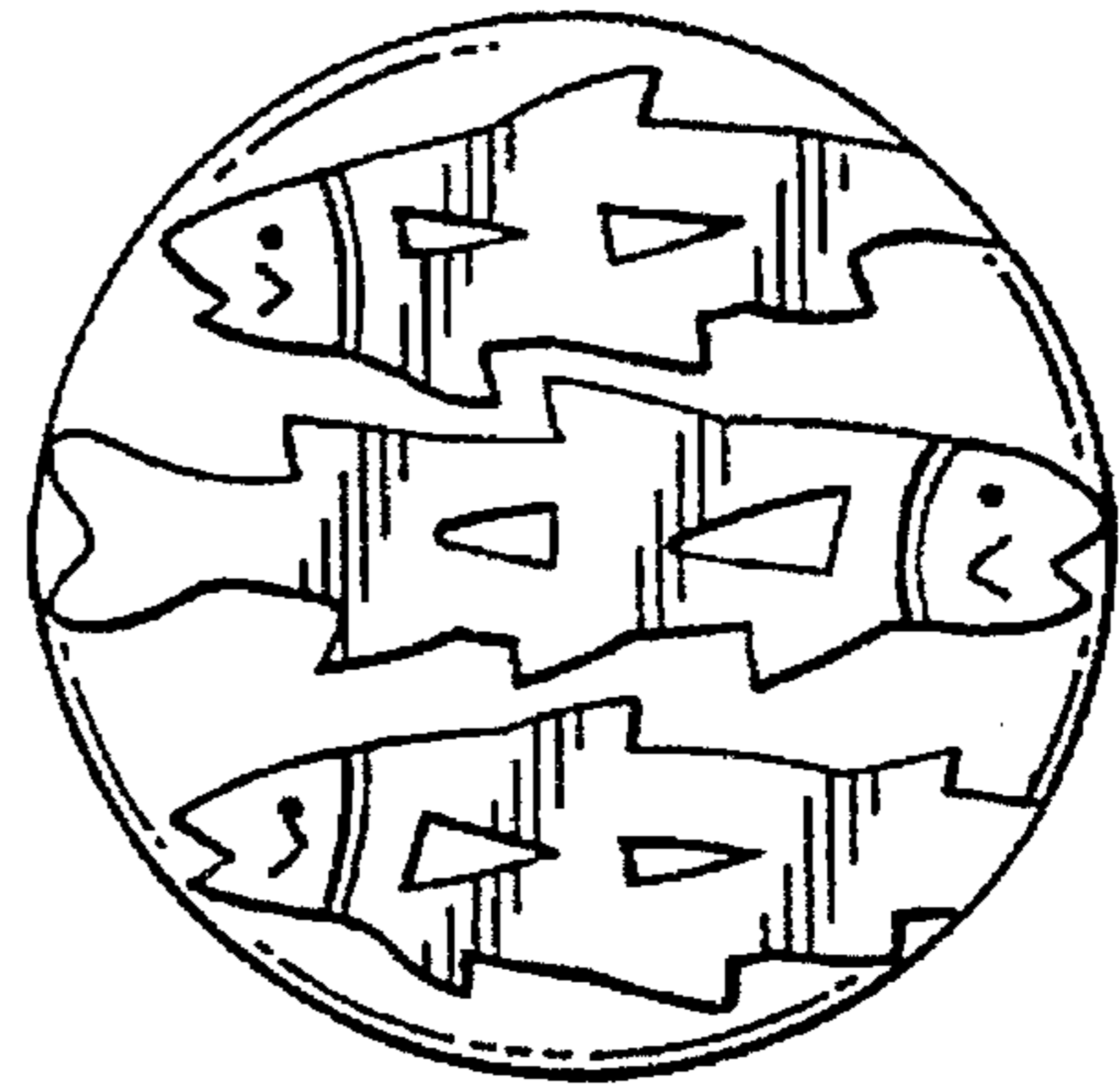

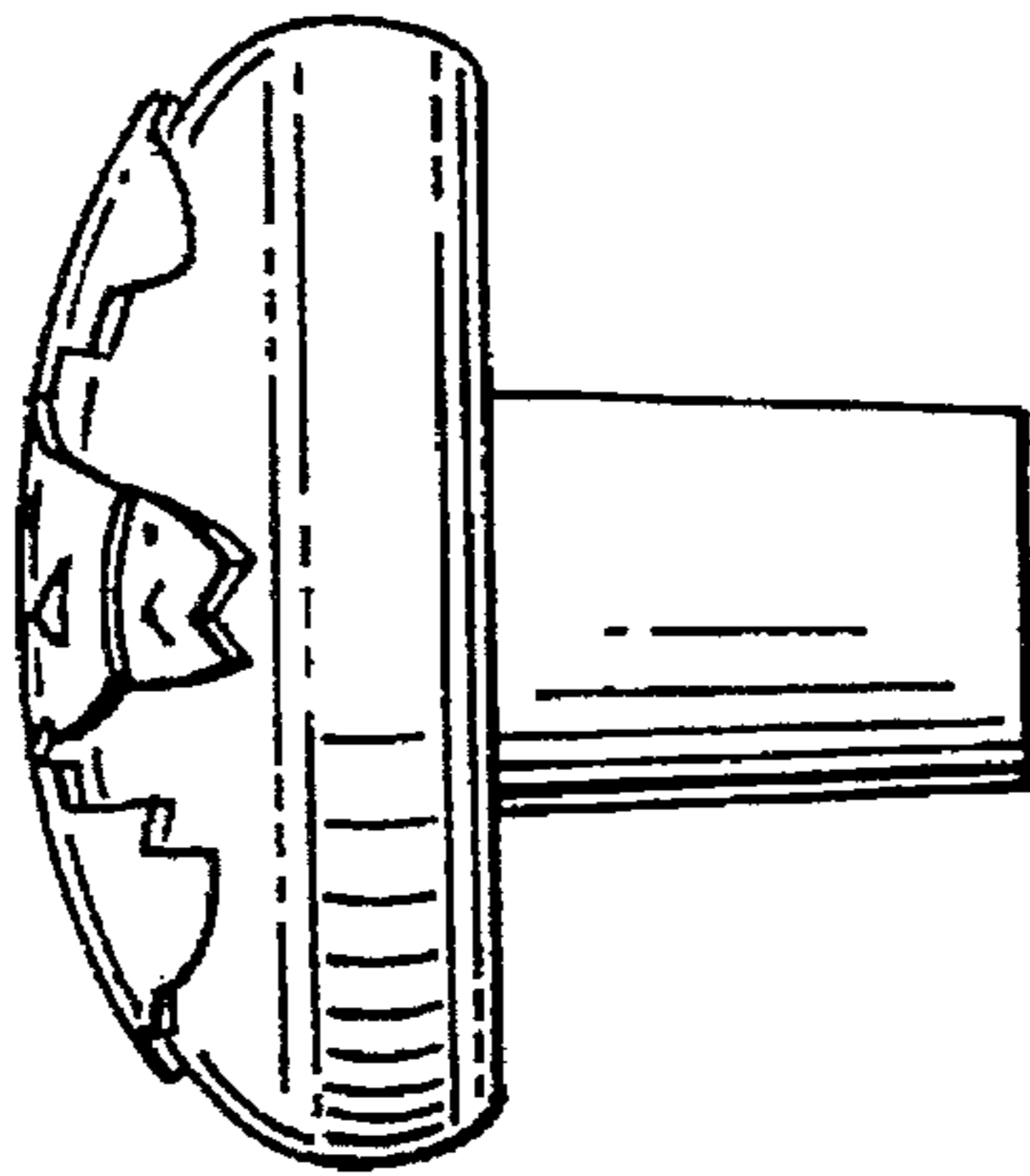
