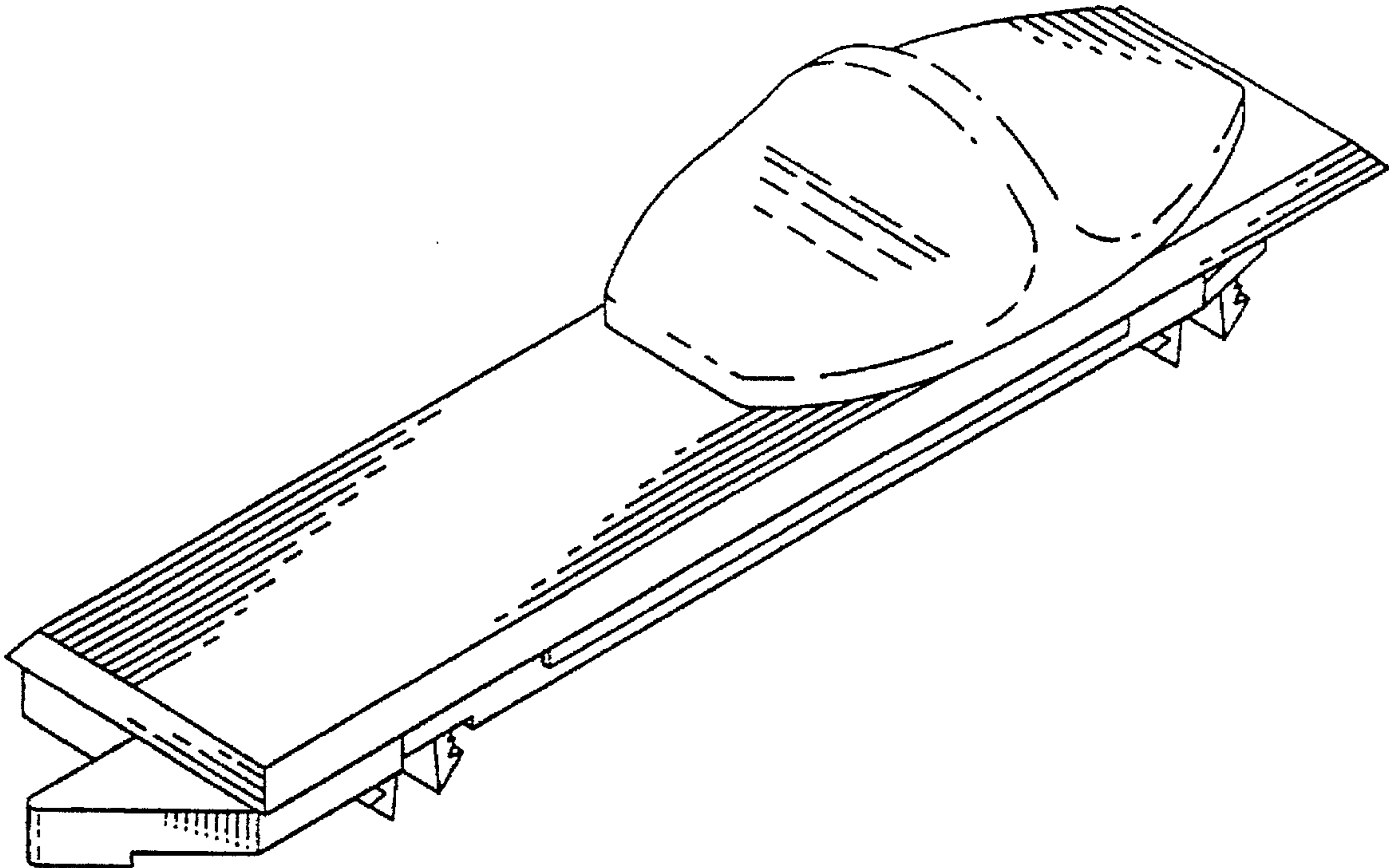
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a latch for securing tiltable window panels and sashes to a window frame, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1: is a front perspective view of a latch for securing tiltable window panels and sashes to a window frame showing our new design;

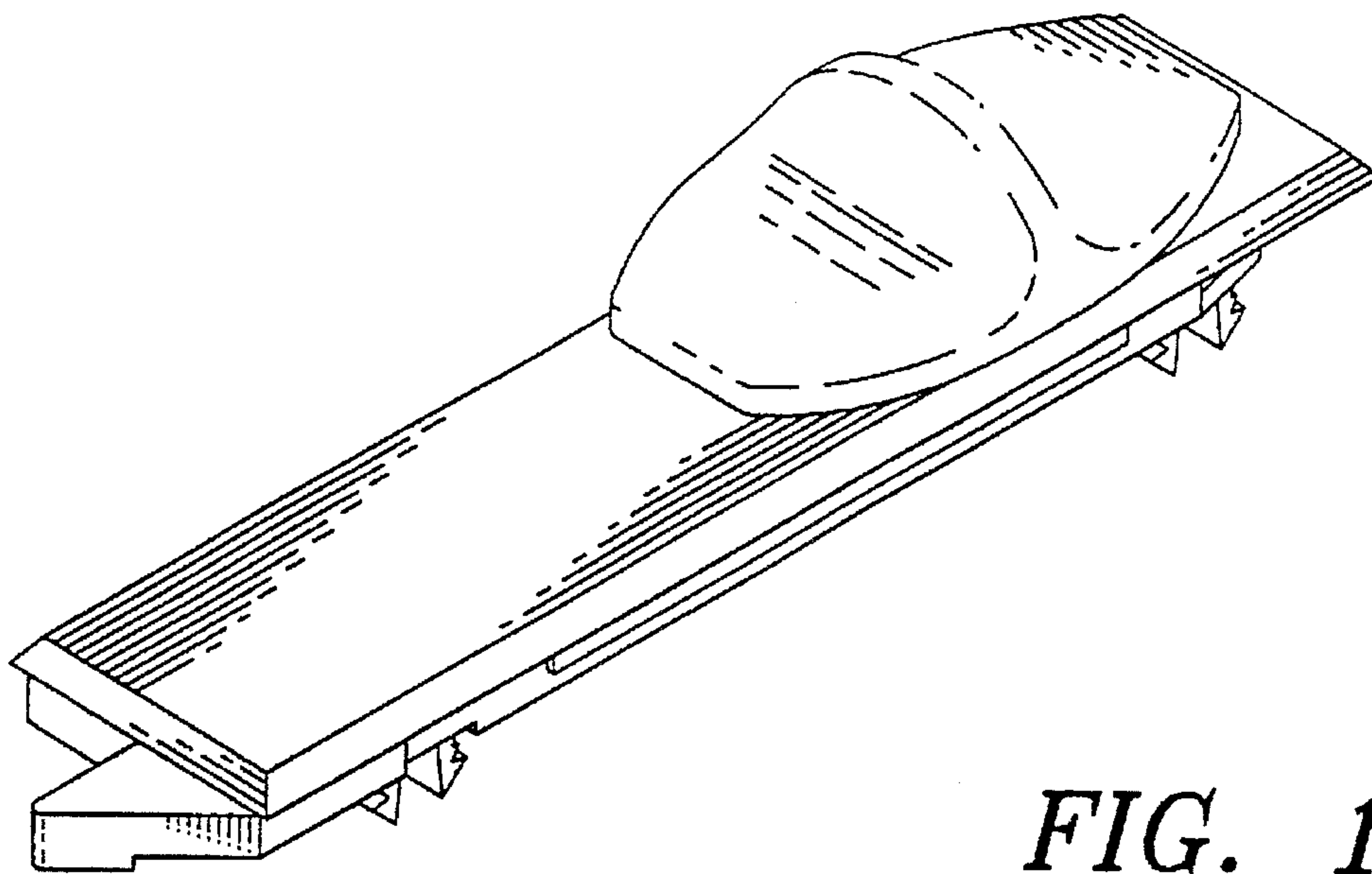

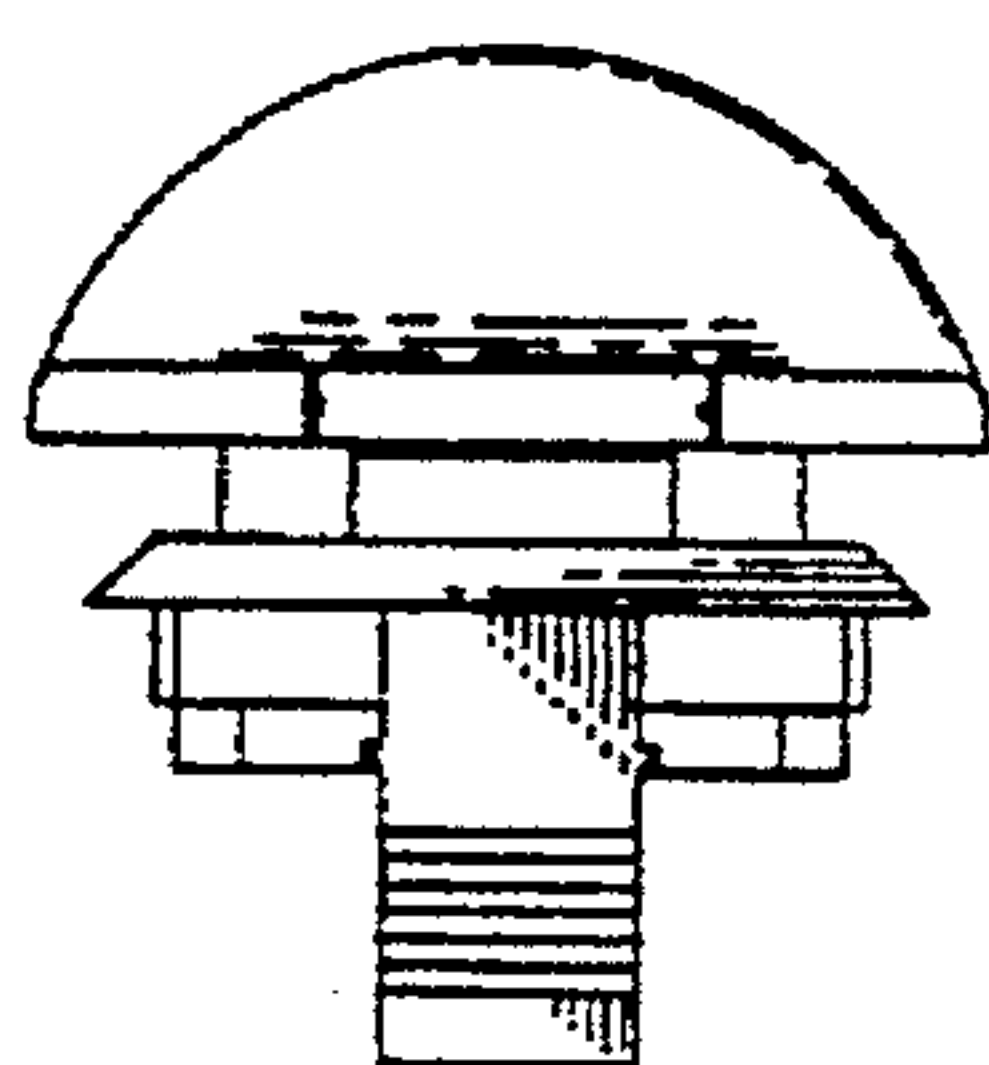

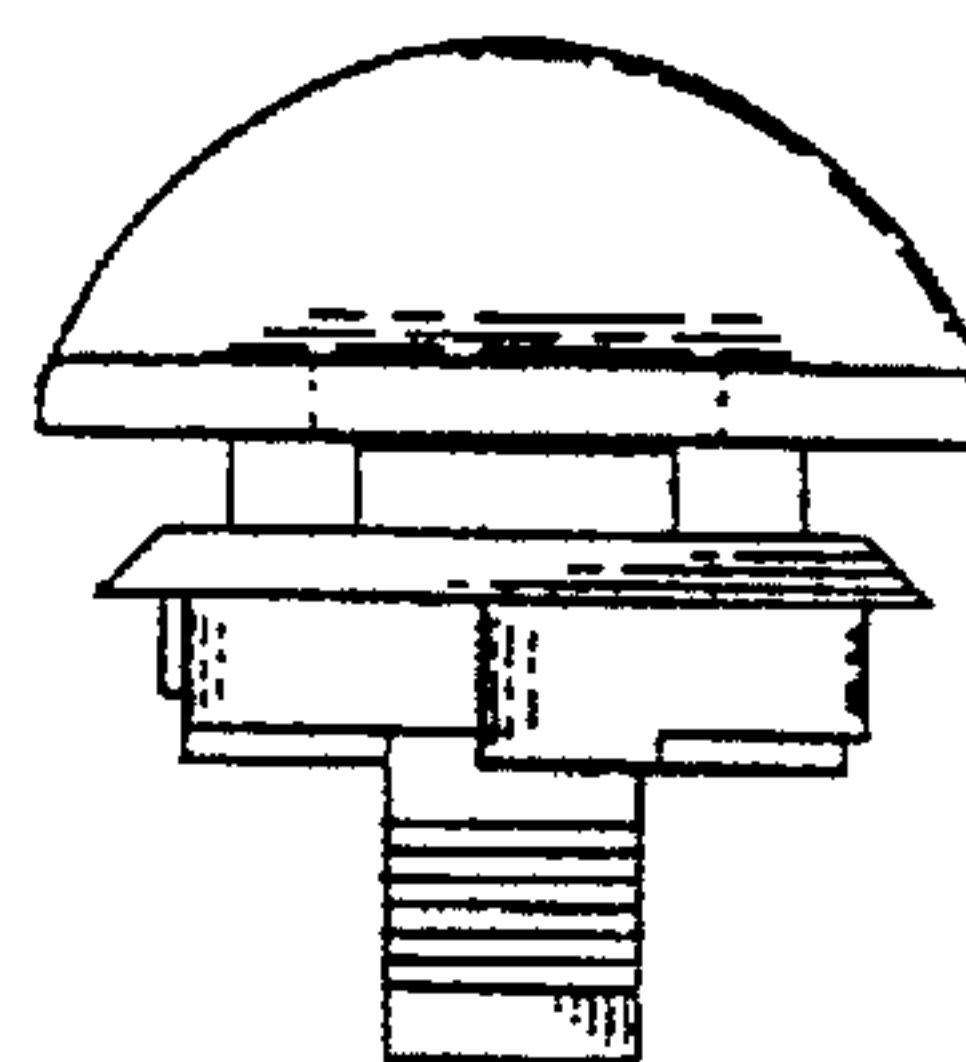

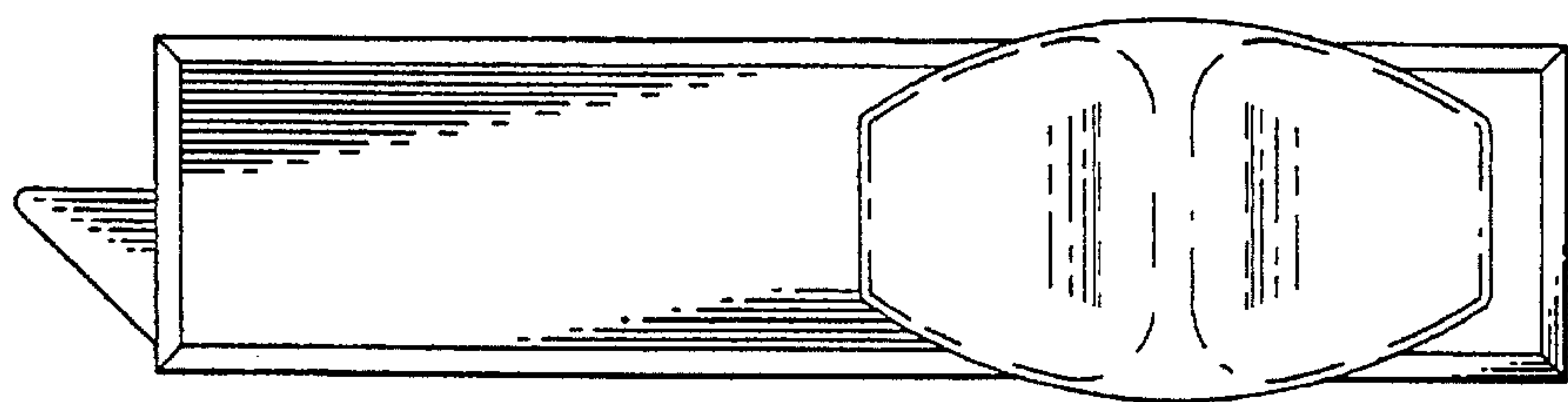

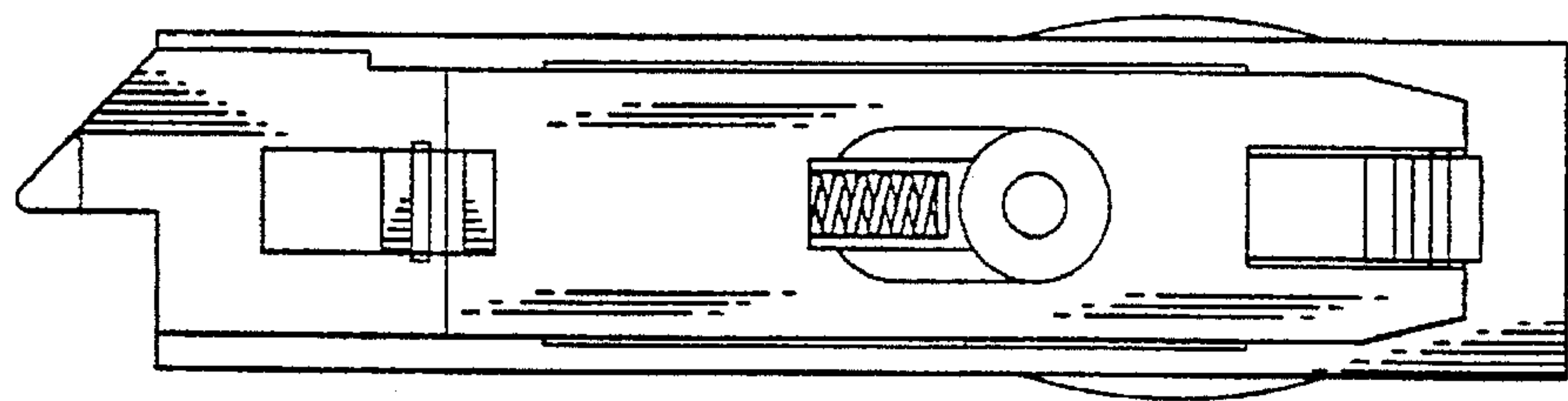

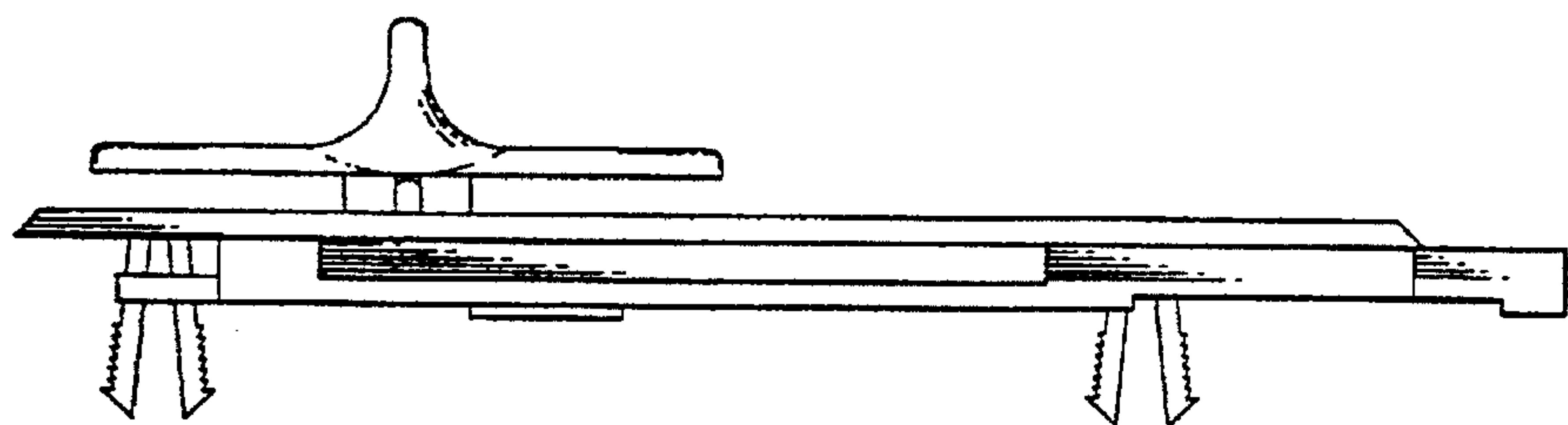

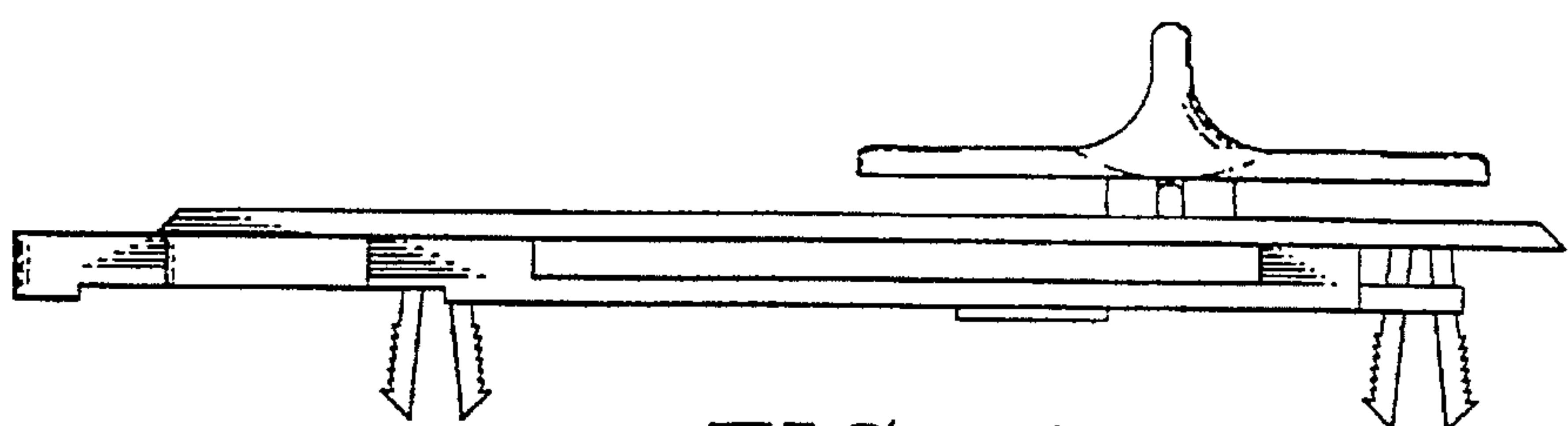
