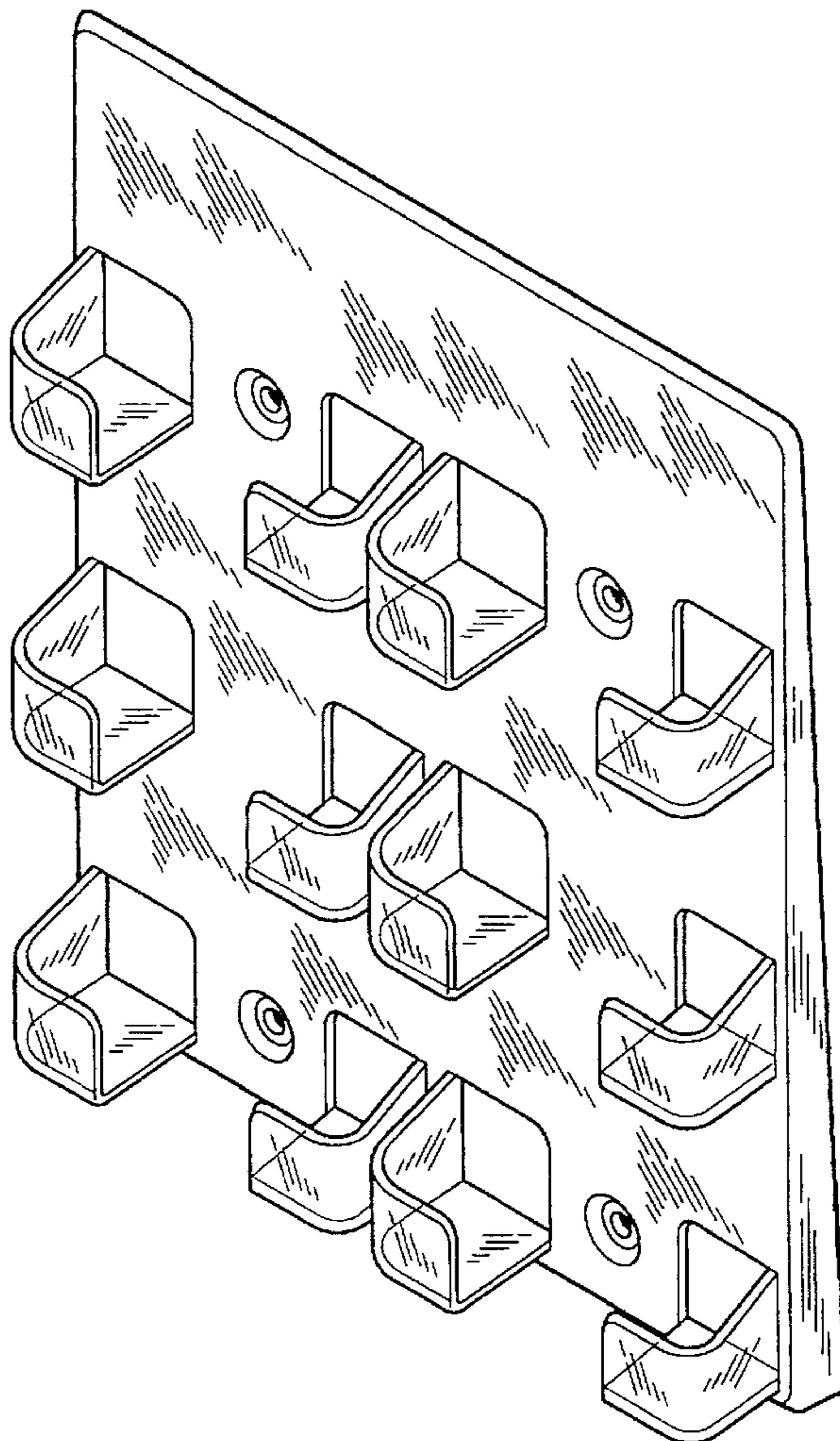
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a business card holder with multiple card-support portions, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a business card holder with multiple card-support portions showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof, the opposite end having the same appearance;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image; and,
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

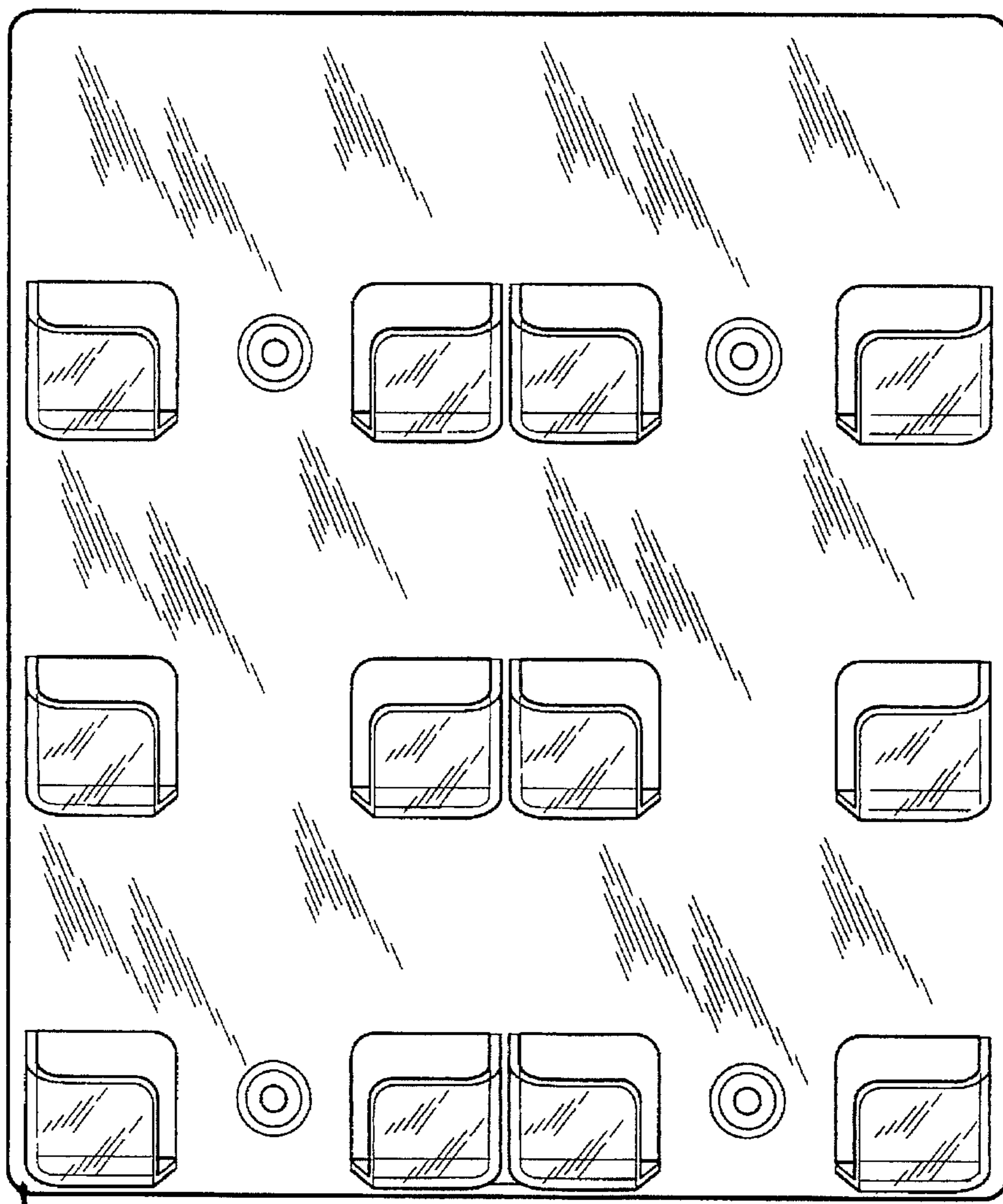

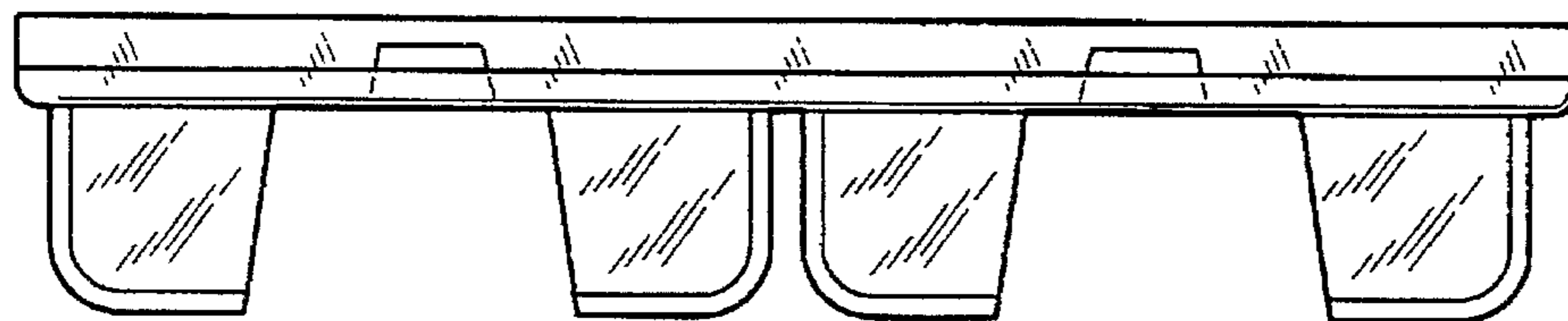

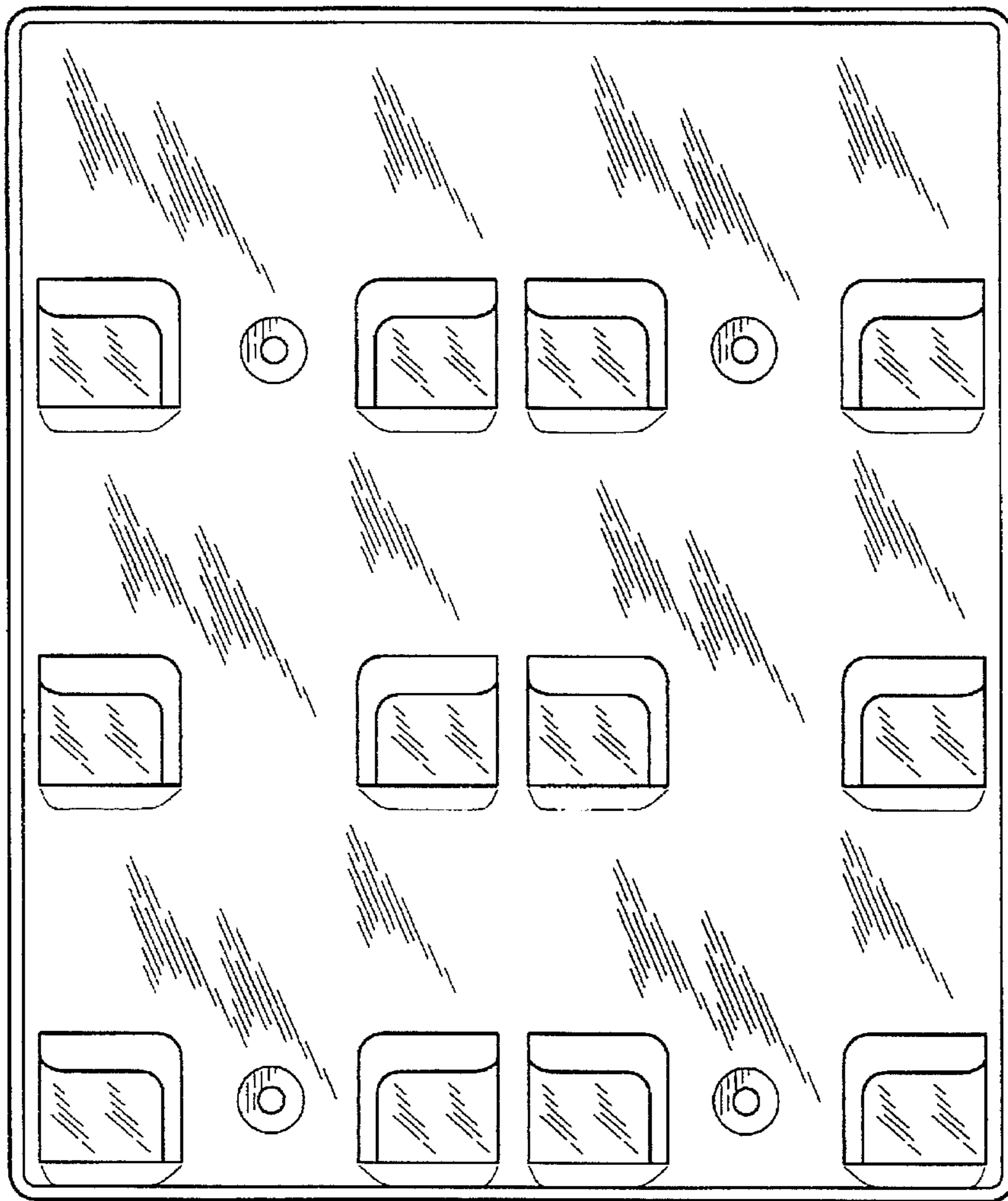

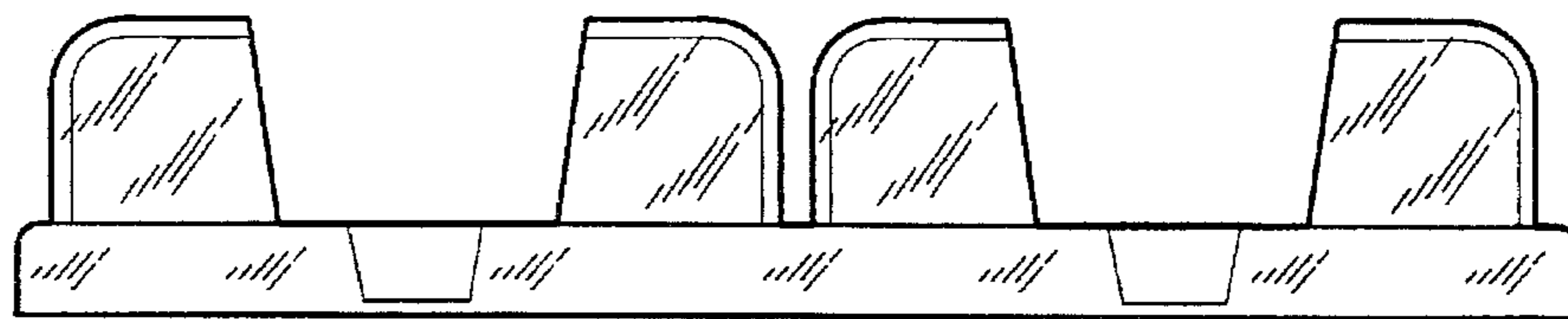

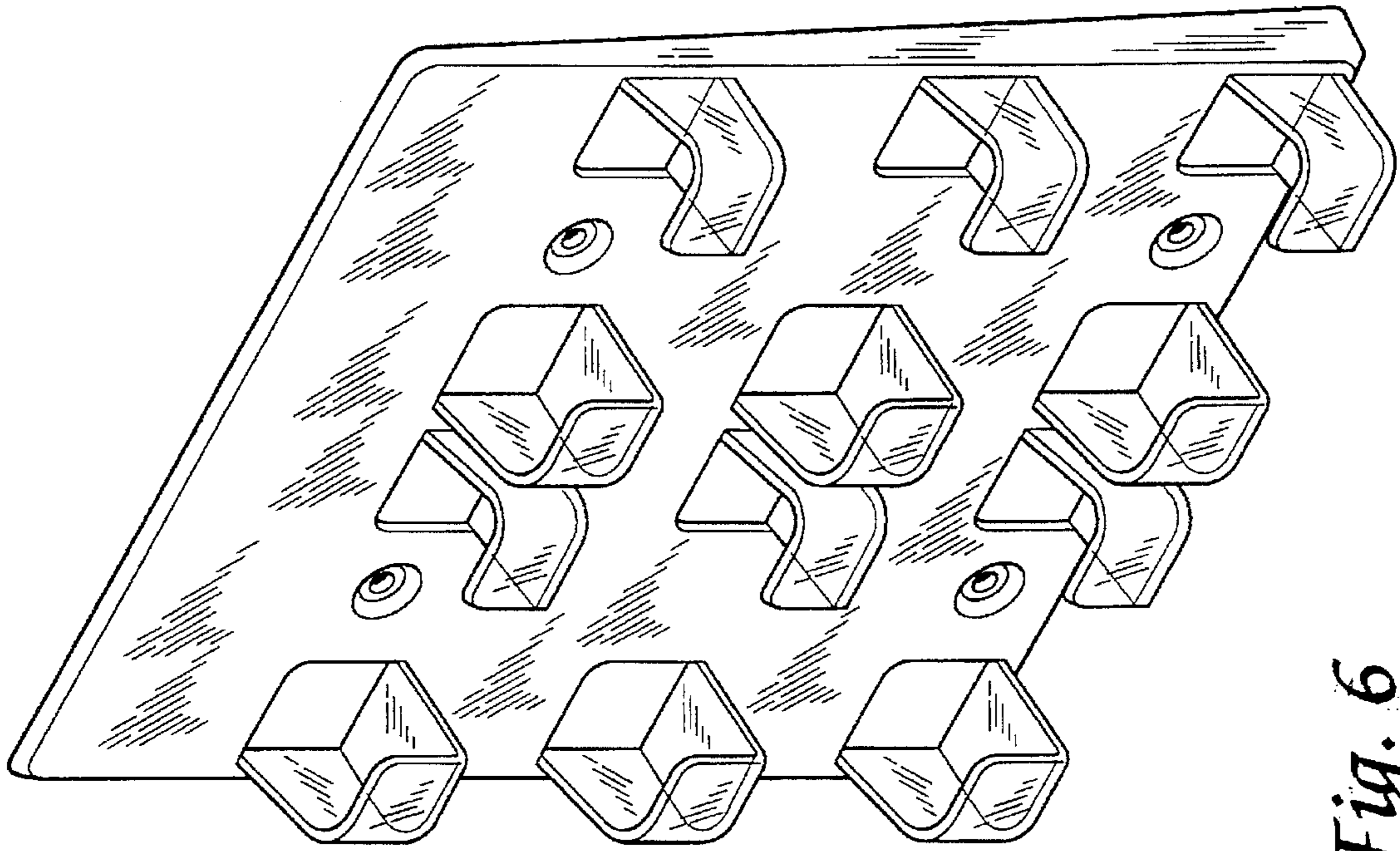

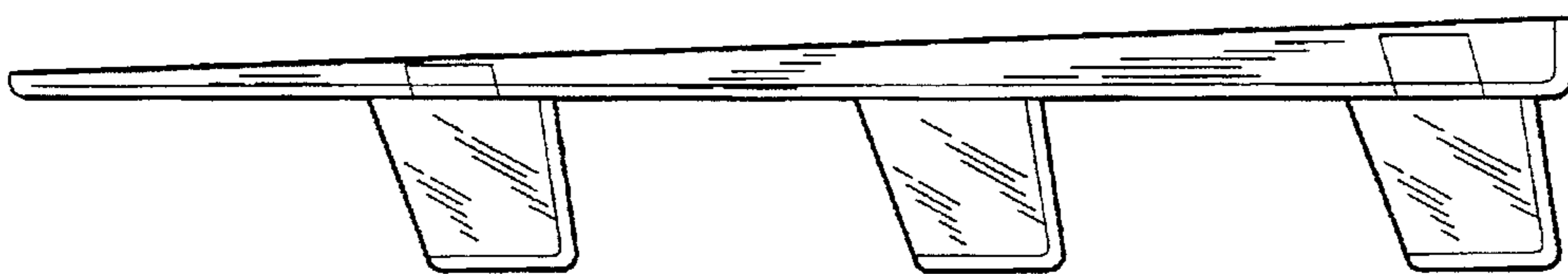
