**DESCRIPTION**

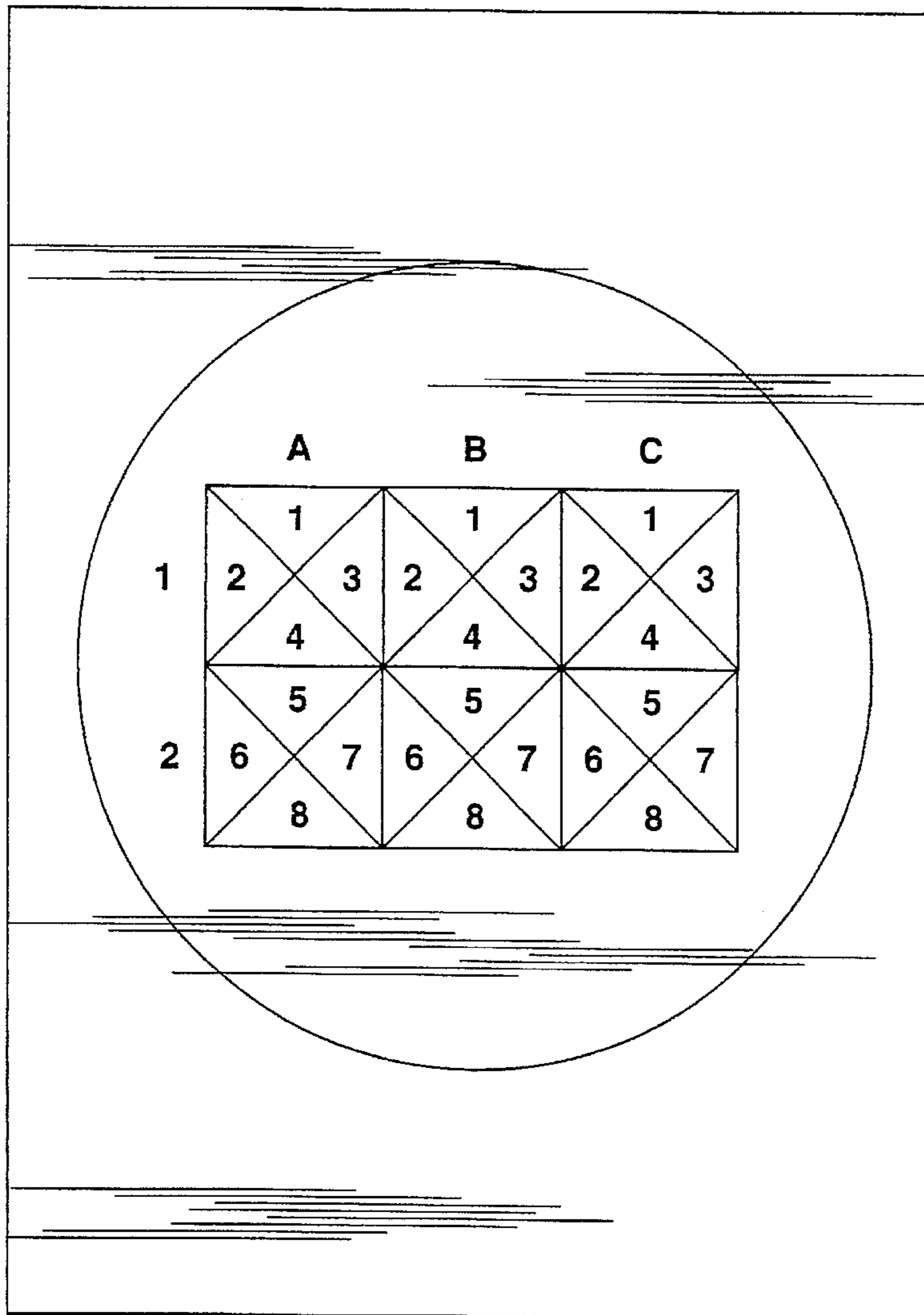
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a game board showing my new design, the bottom being plain and unornamental;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the rear elevational view being identical thereto.

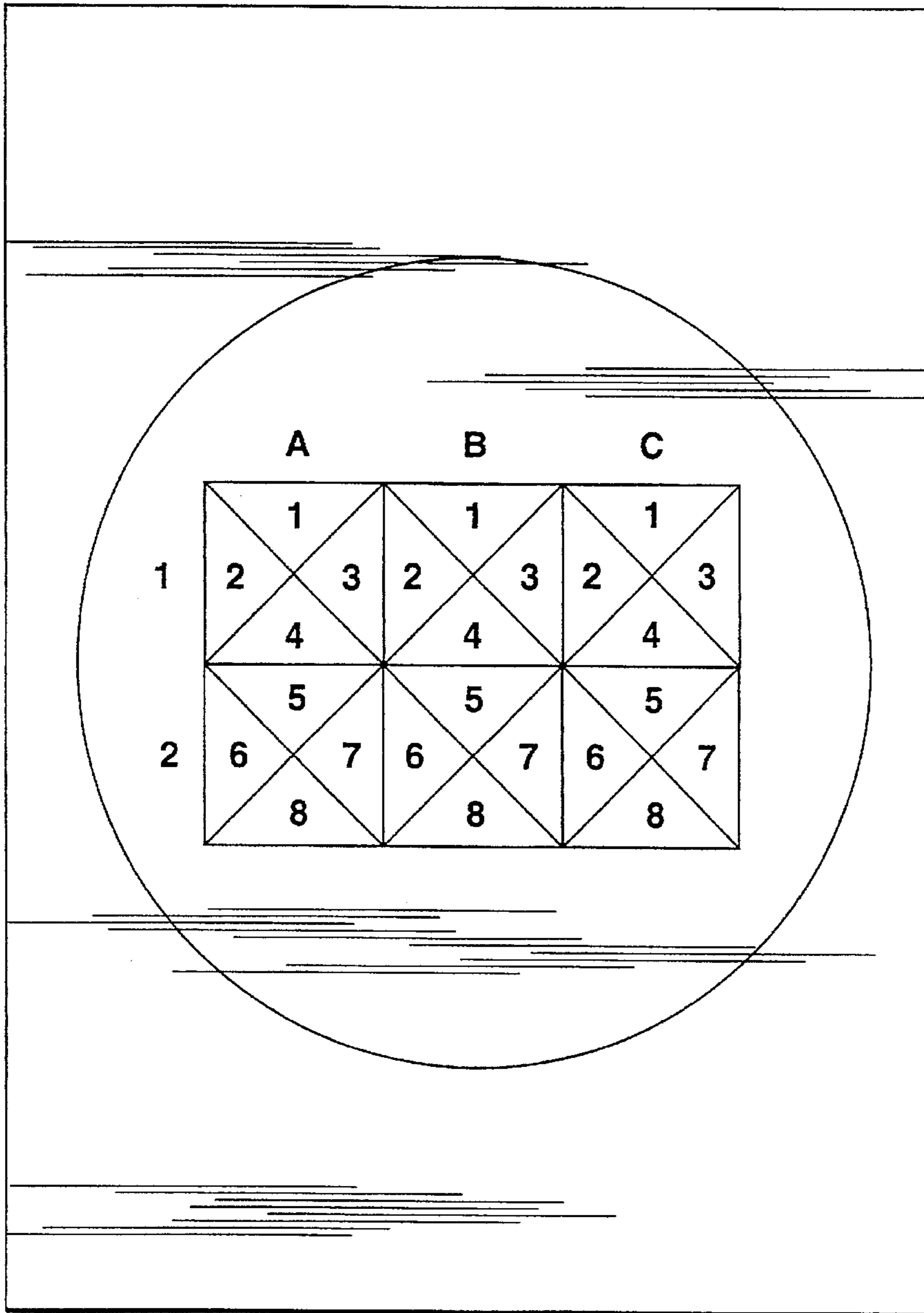

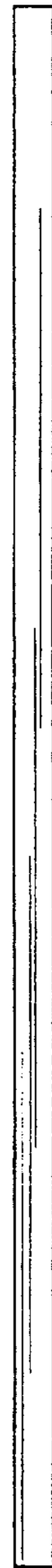

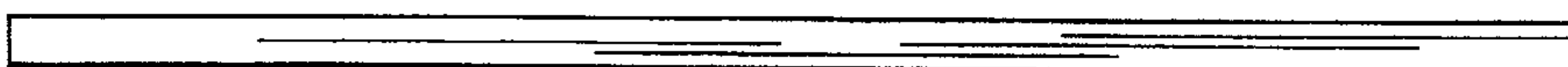
