DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe upper showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

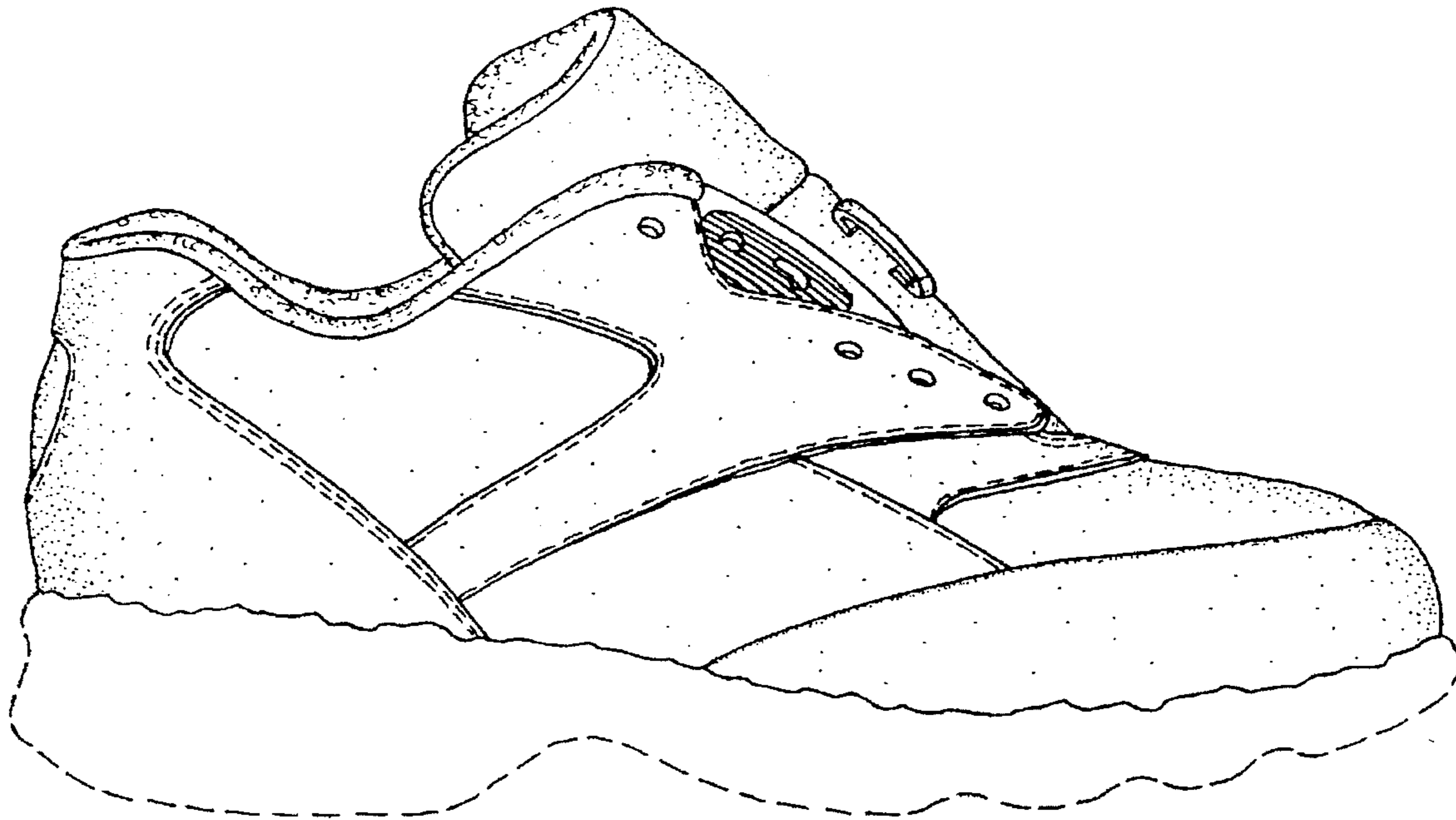
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

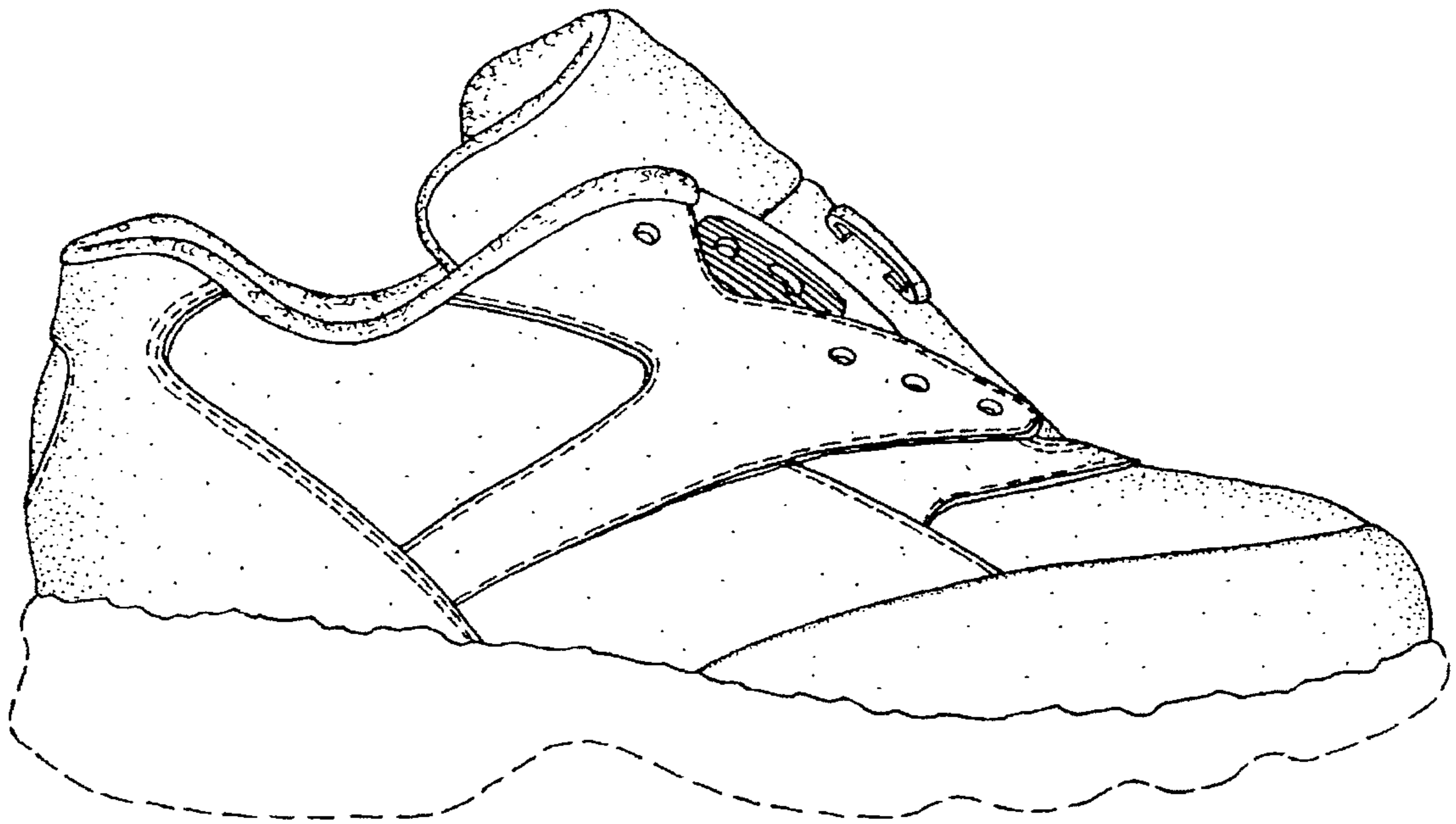

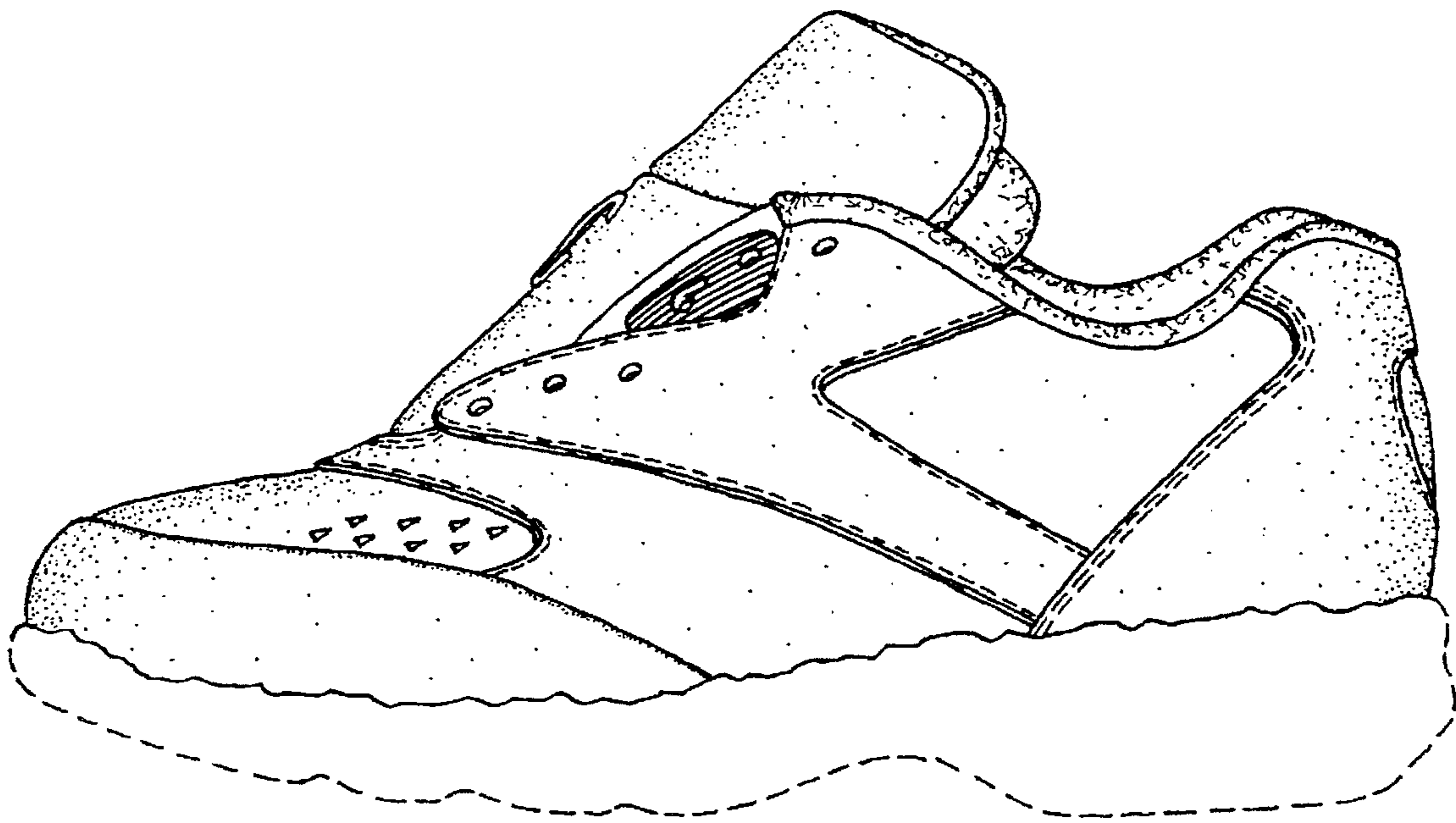

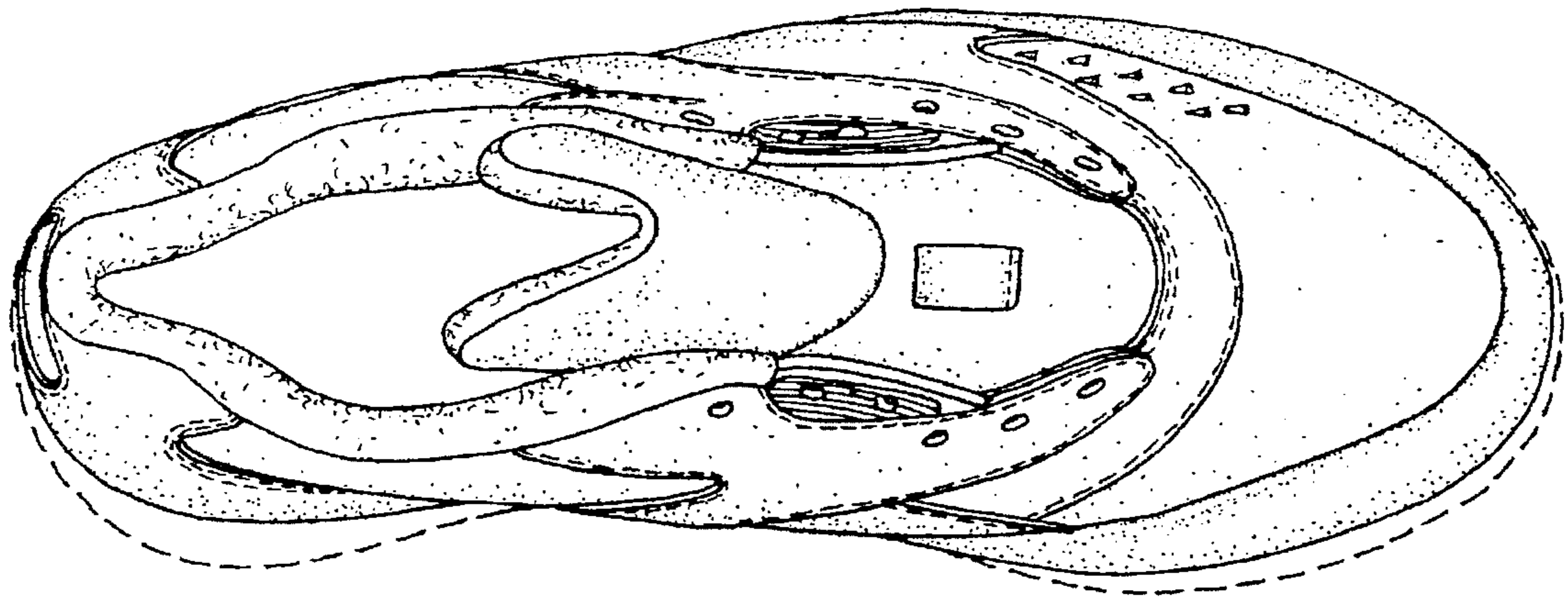

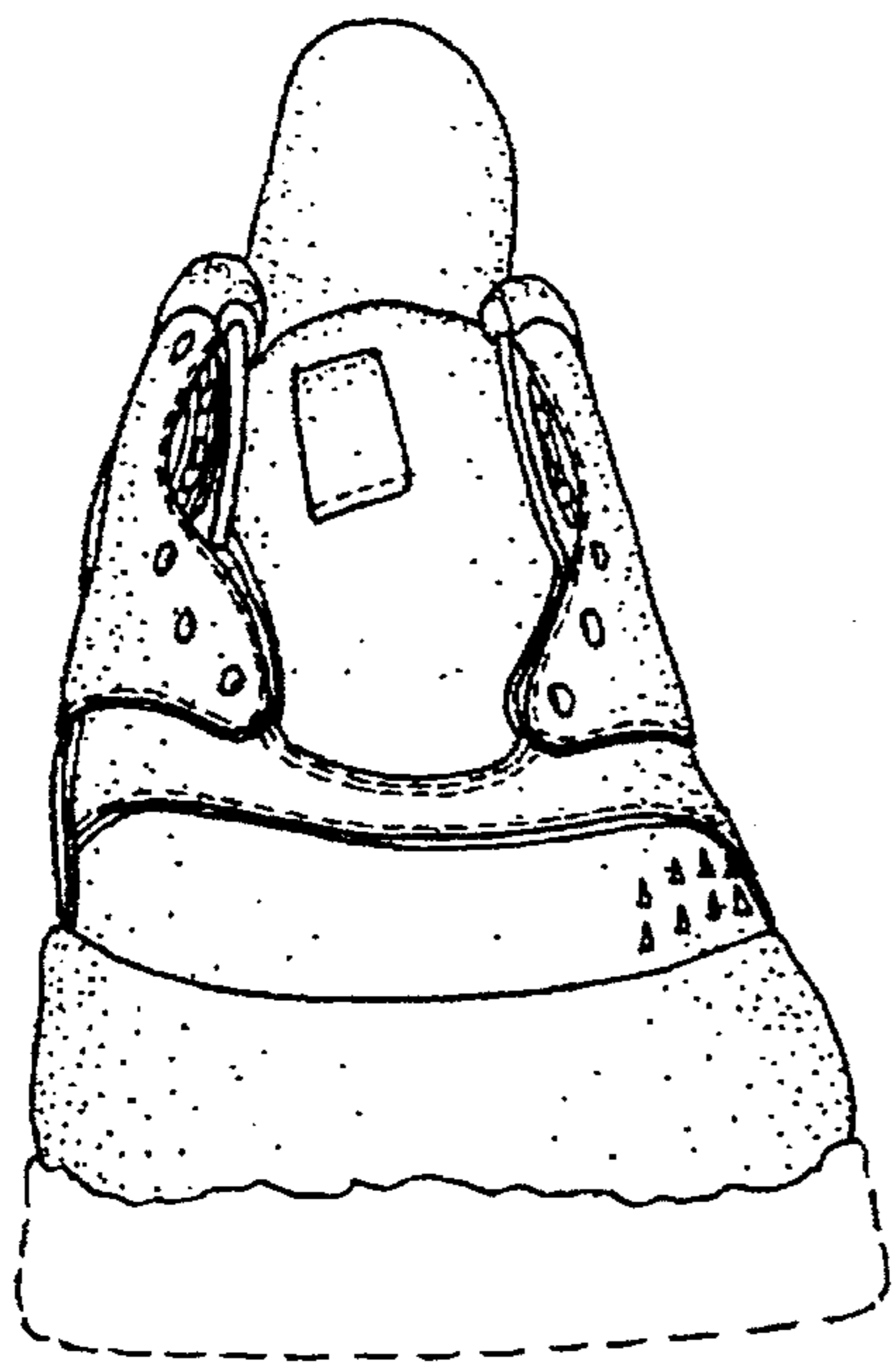

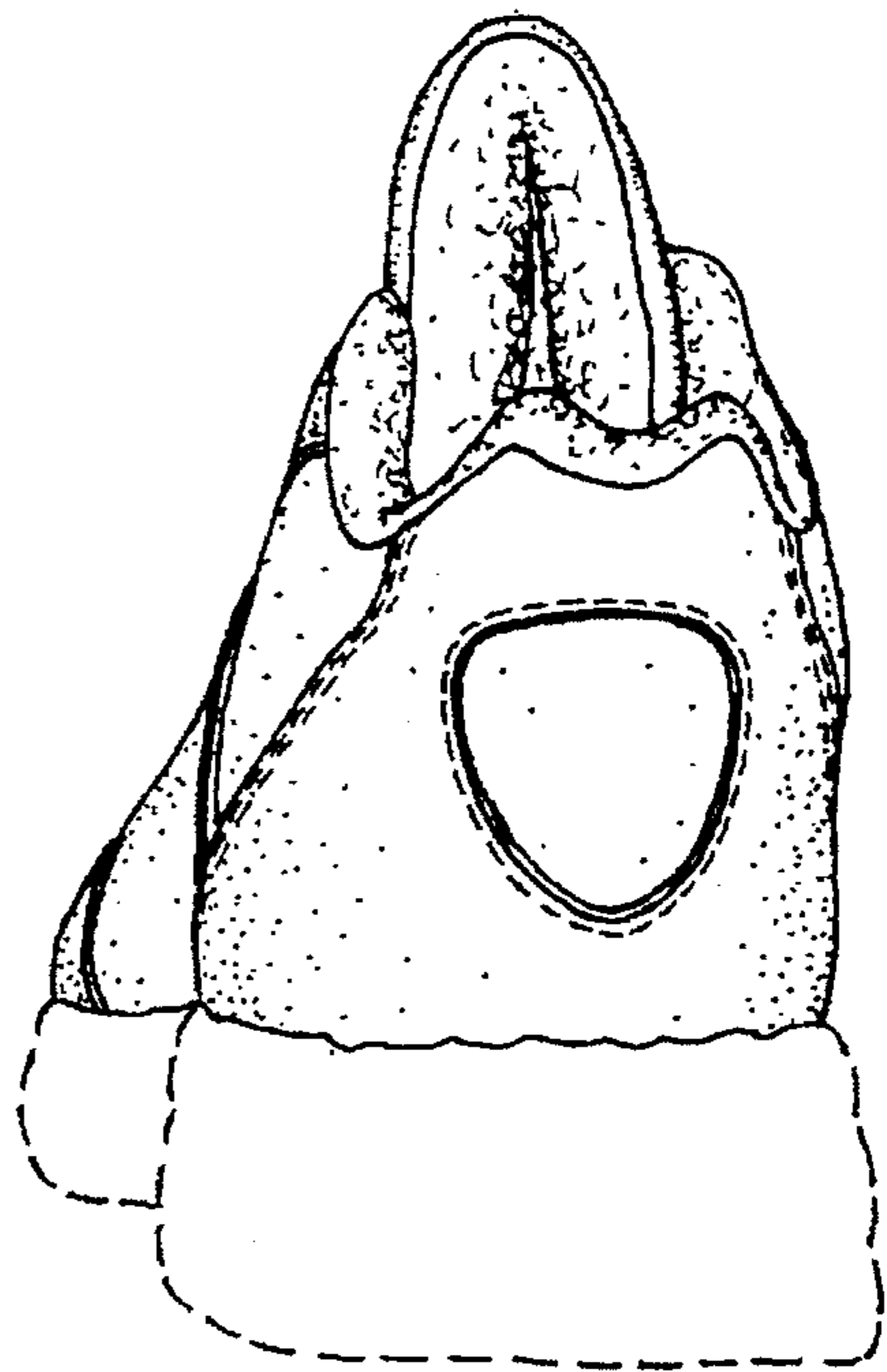
