FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image of that shown;

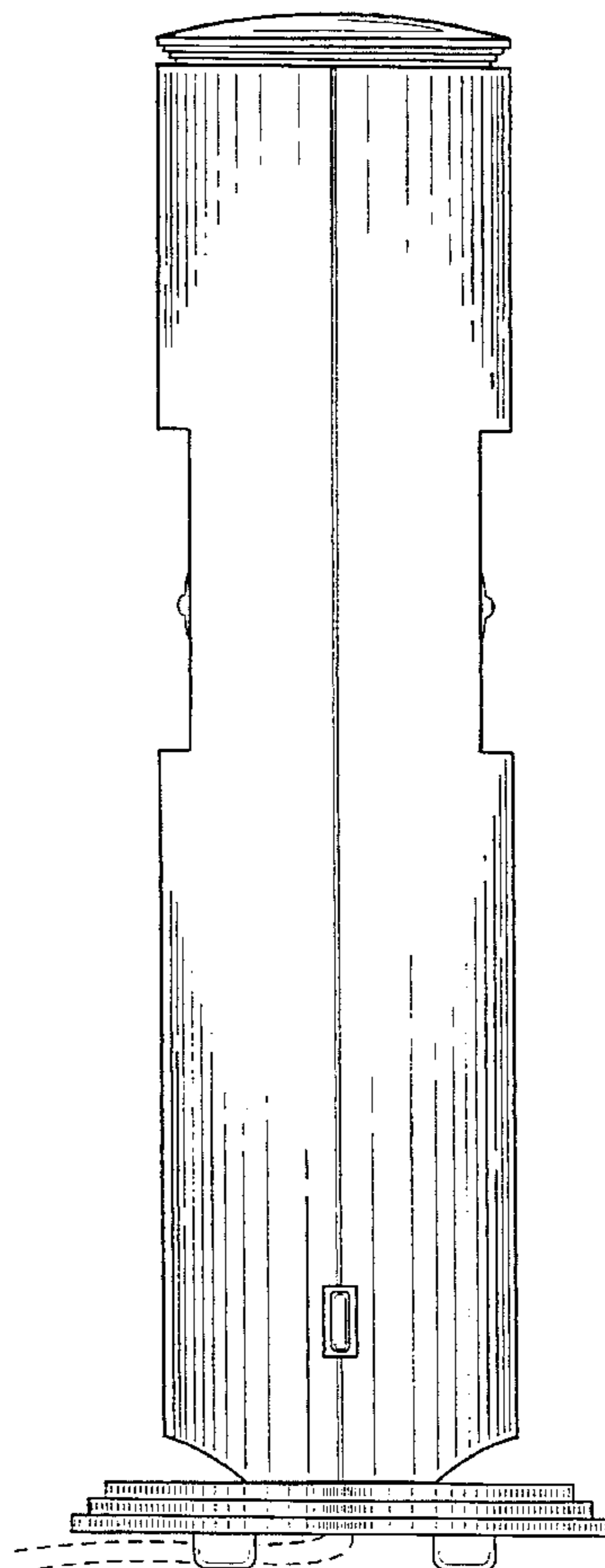
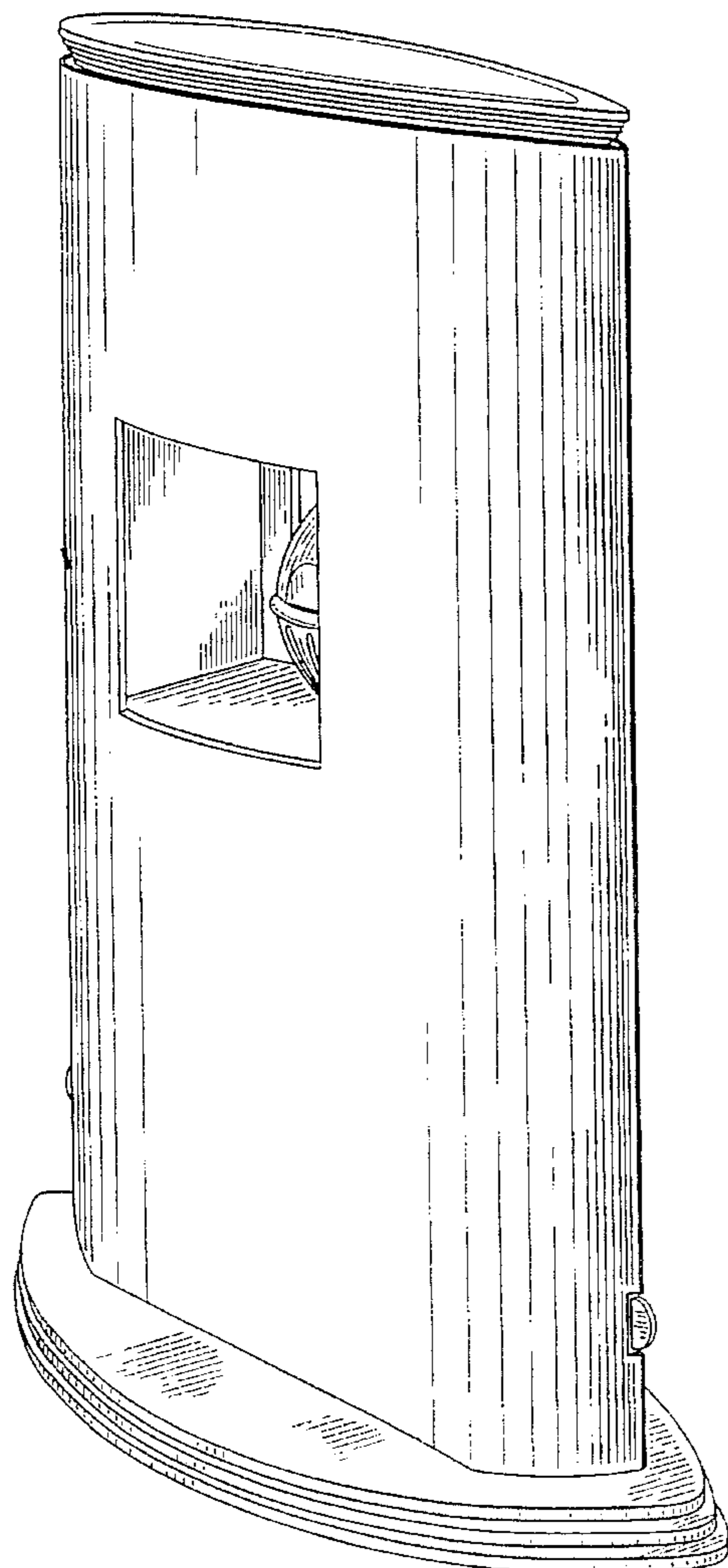
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of that shown;

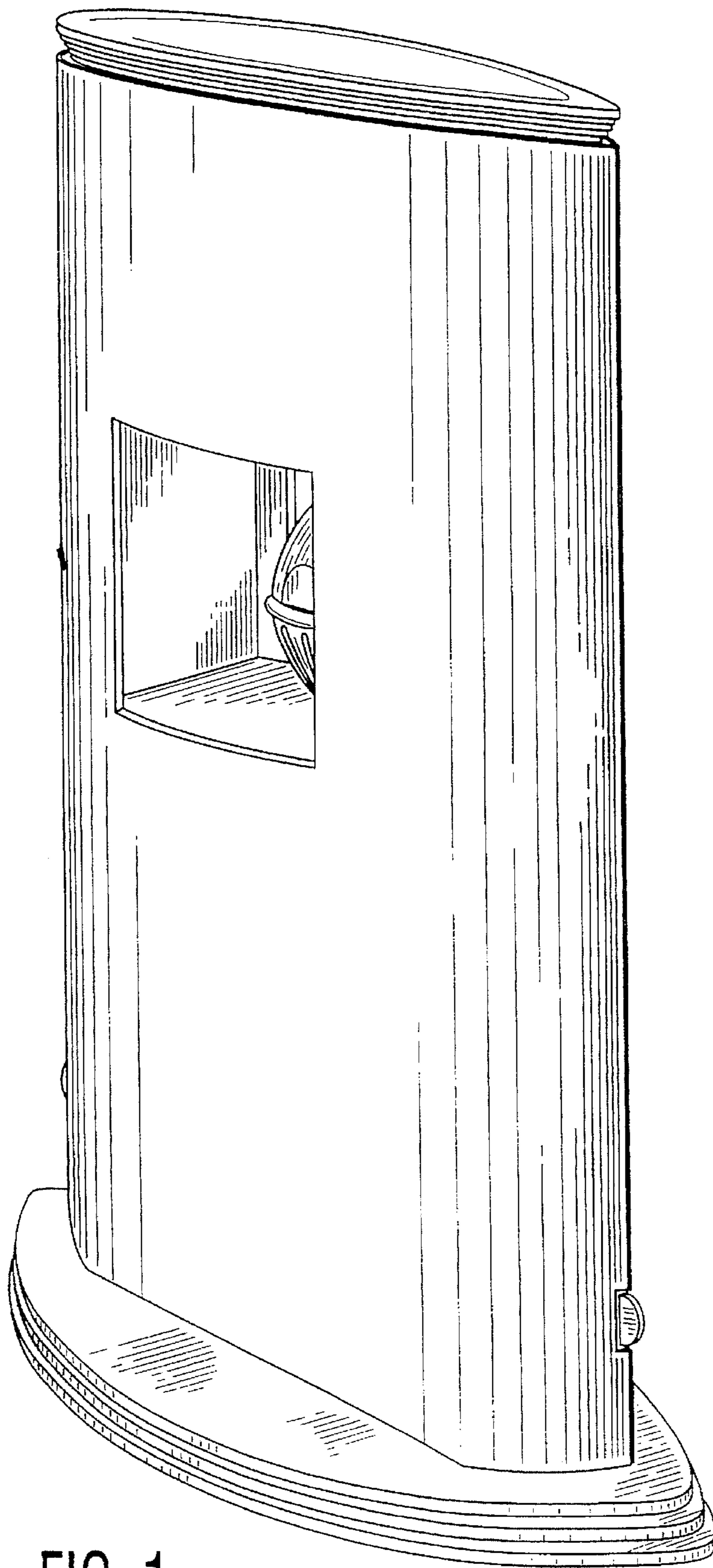

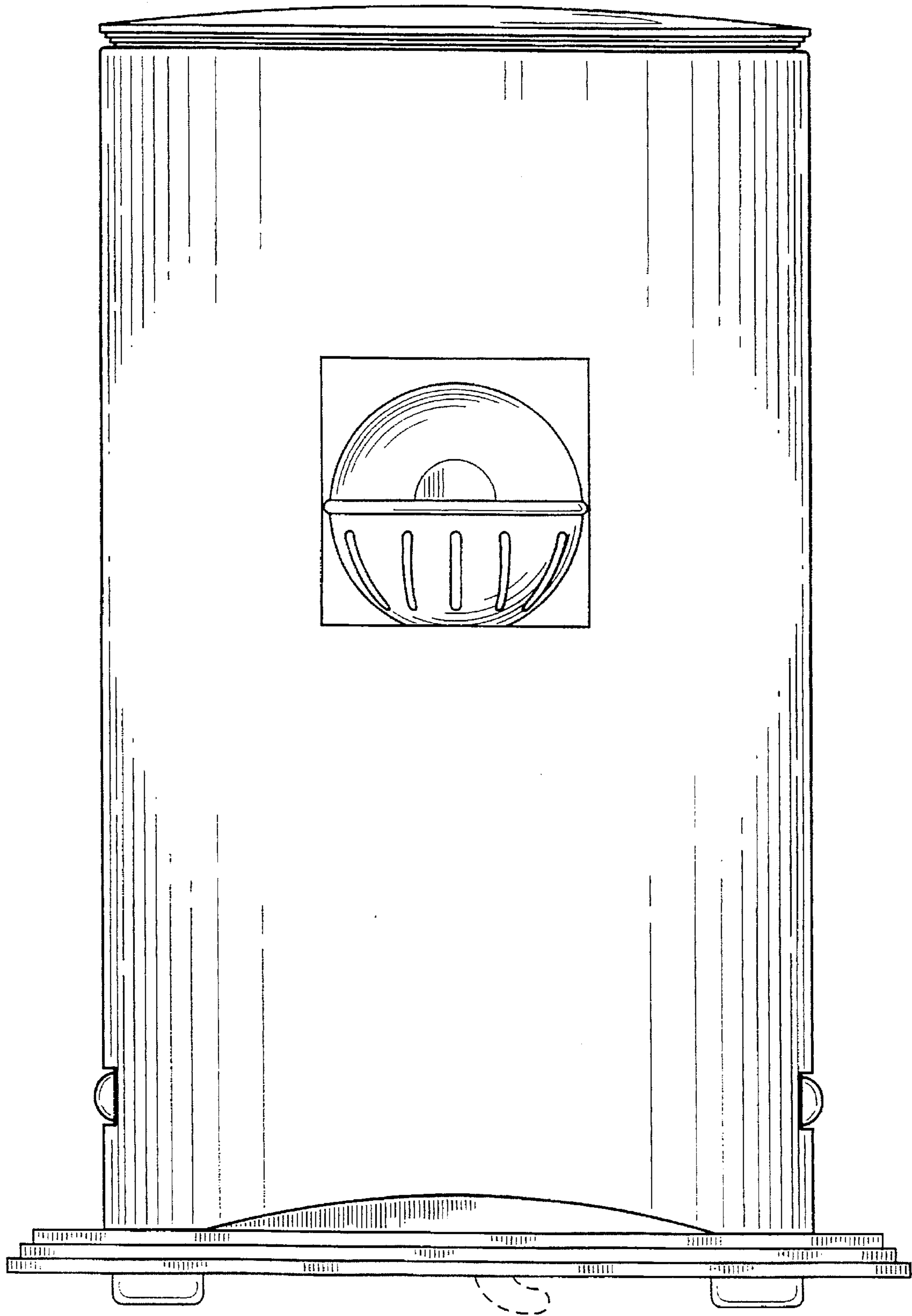

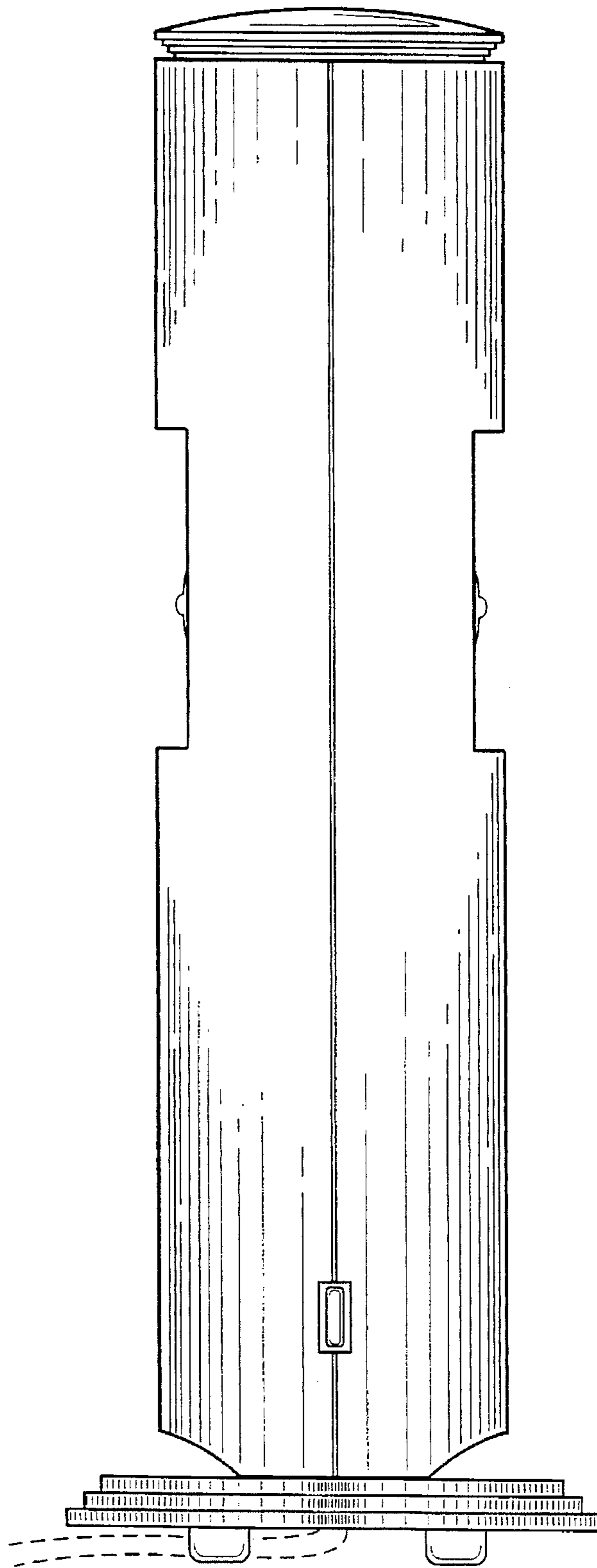

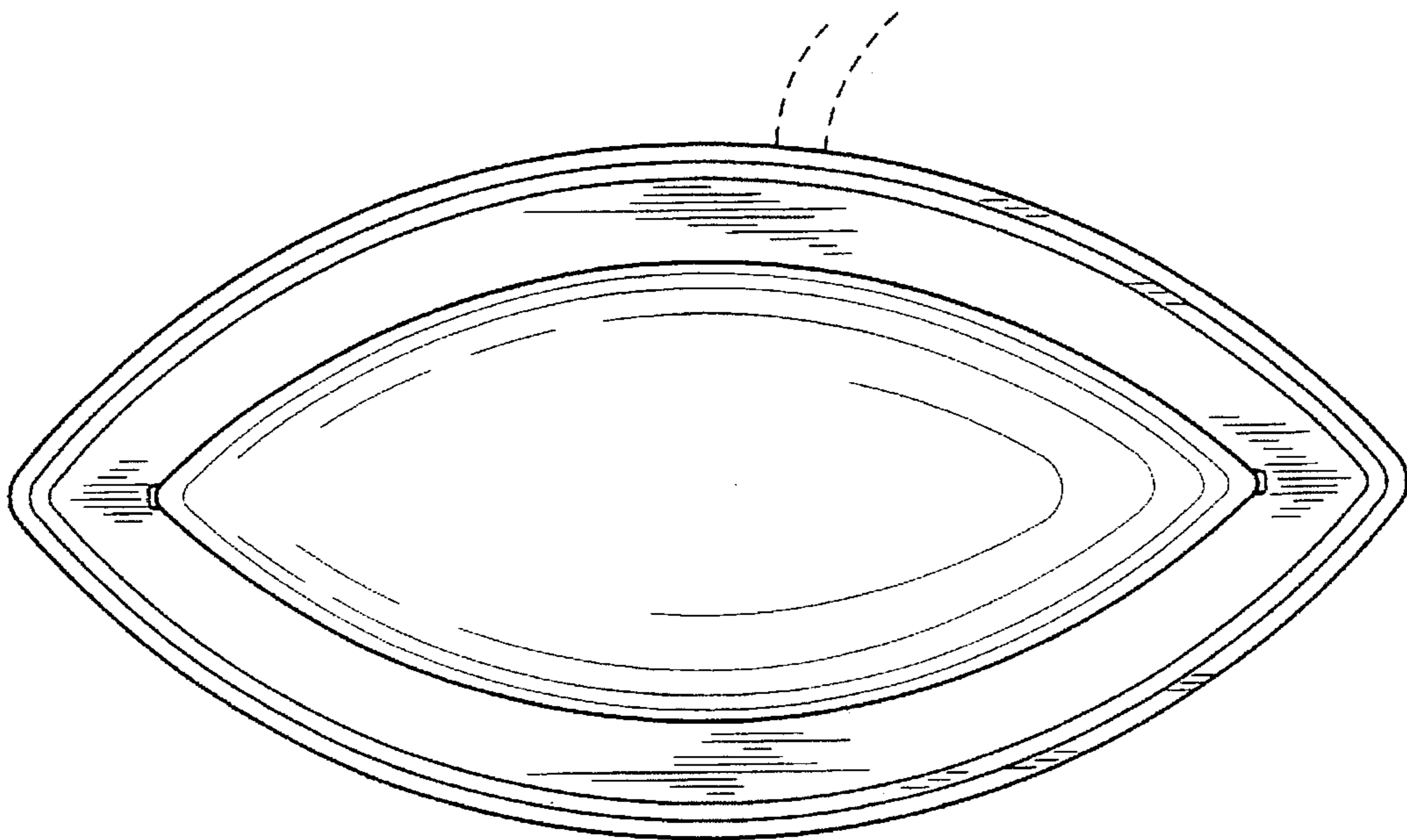

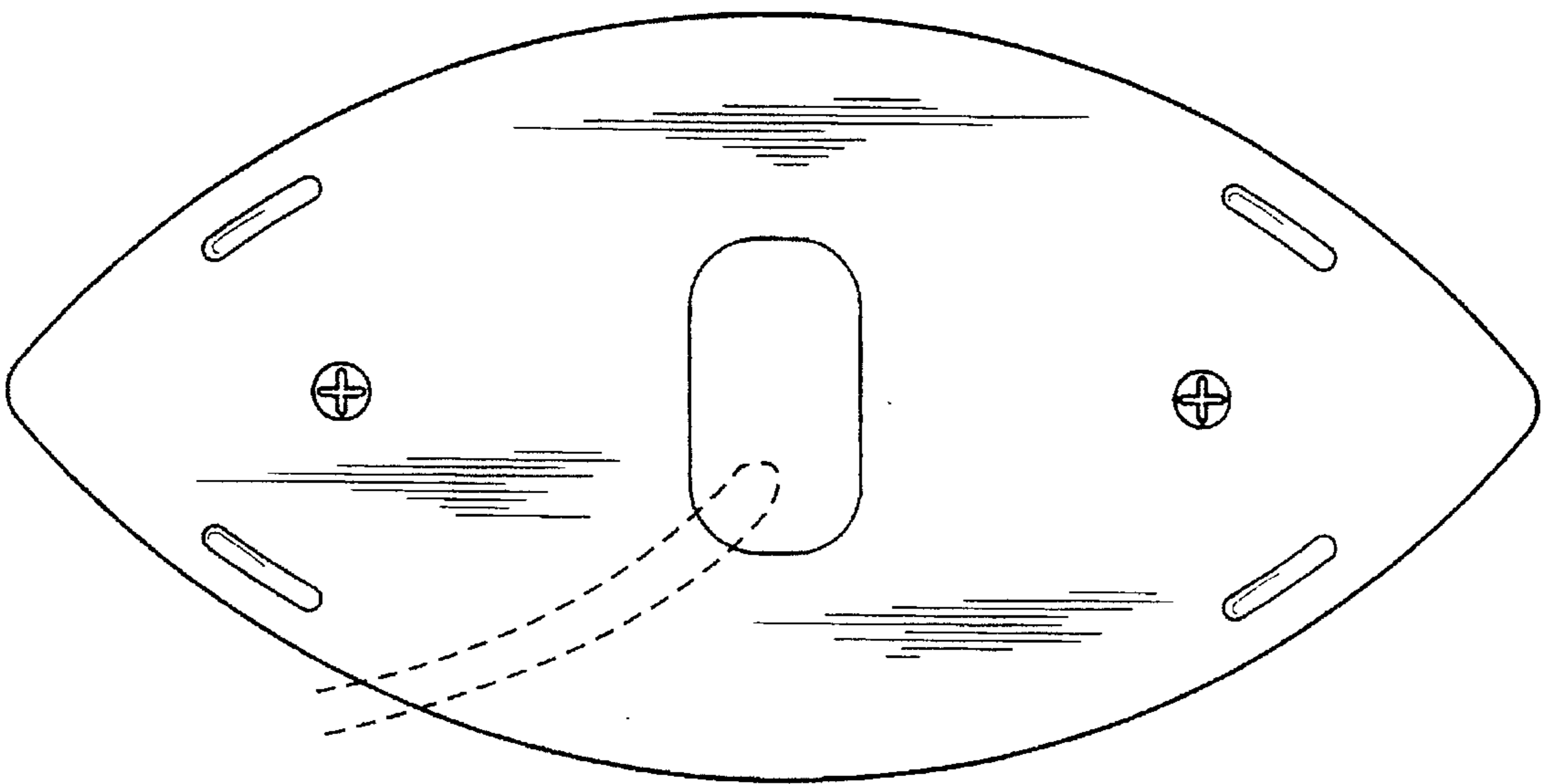
