[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an endoscopic curette with extensible tip, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of an endoscopic curette with extensible tip showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof, the left side being identical;

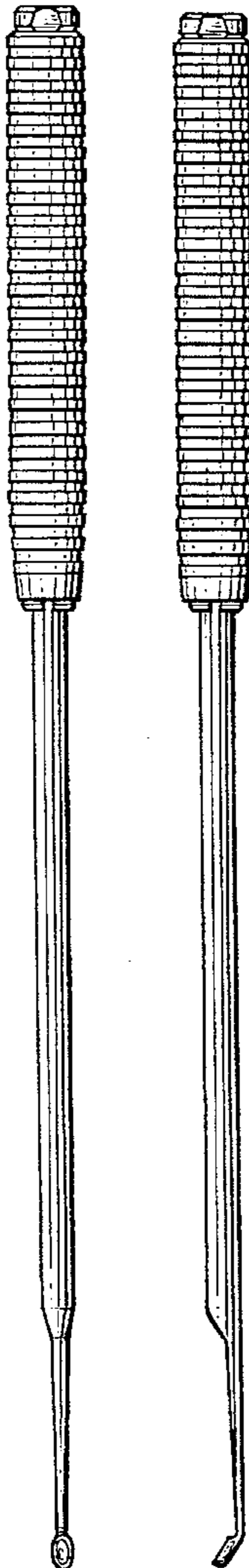
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

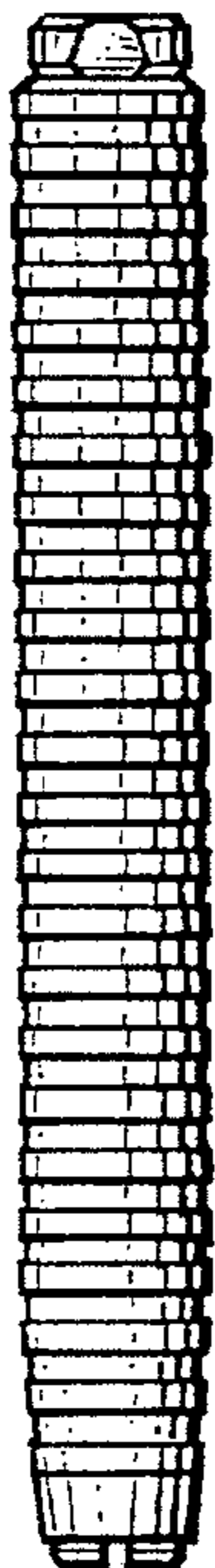
