FIG. 21 is a front elevational view of a fifth embodiment of my new design;

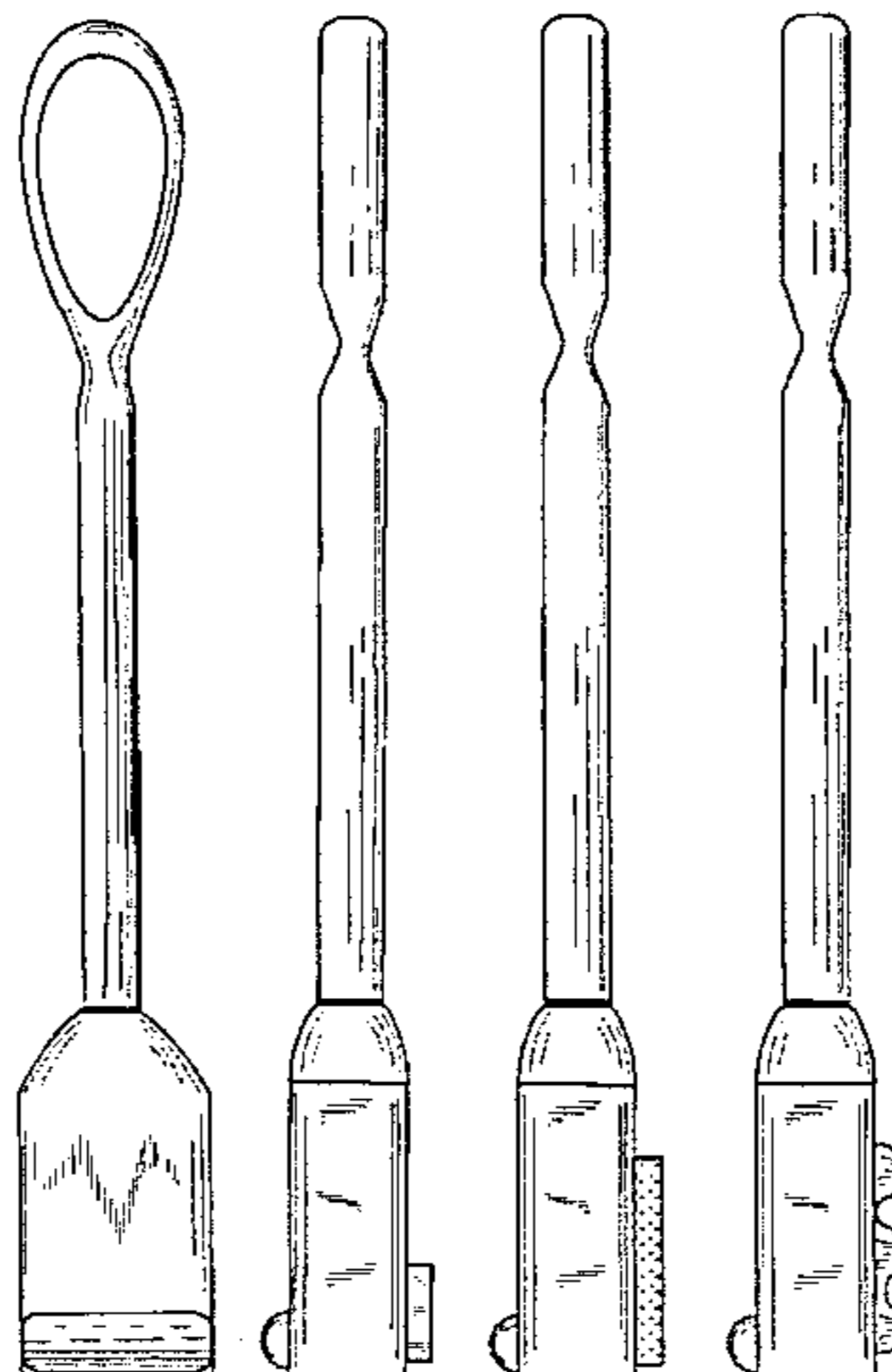
FIG. 22 is a rear elevational view thereof;

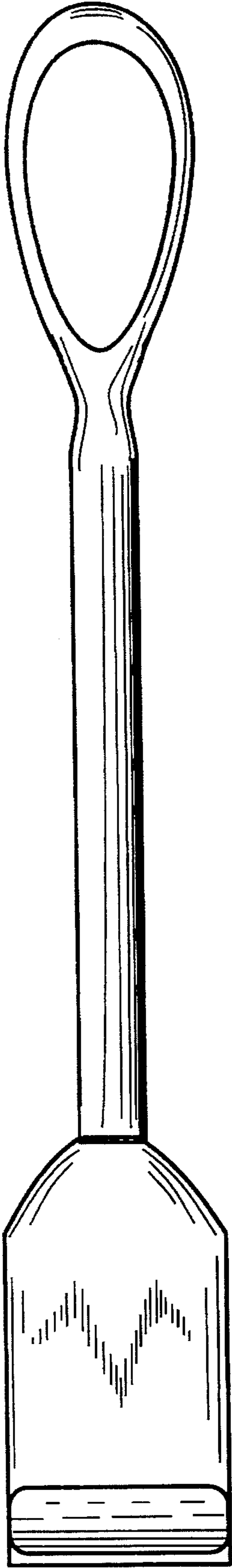

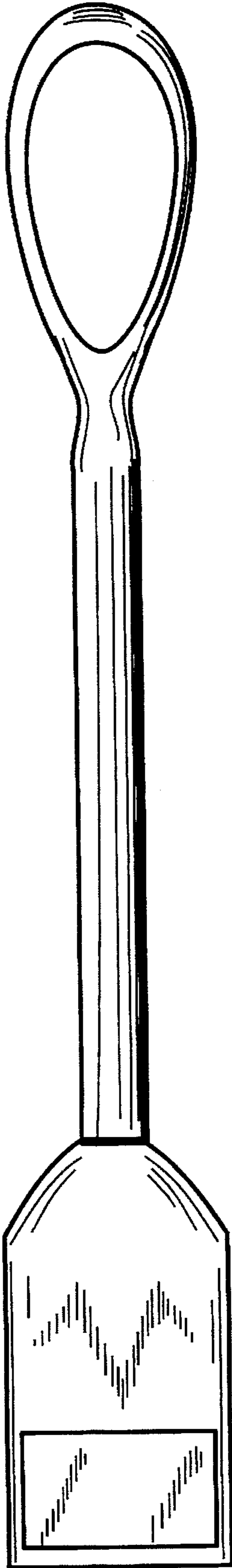

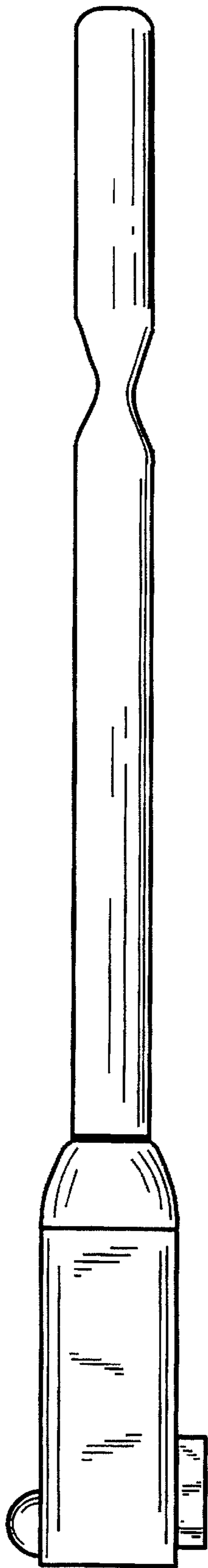

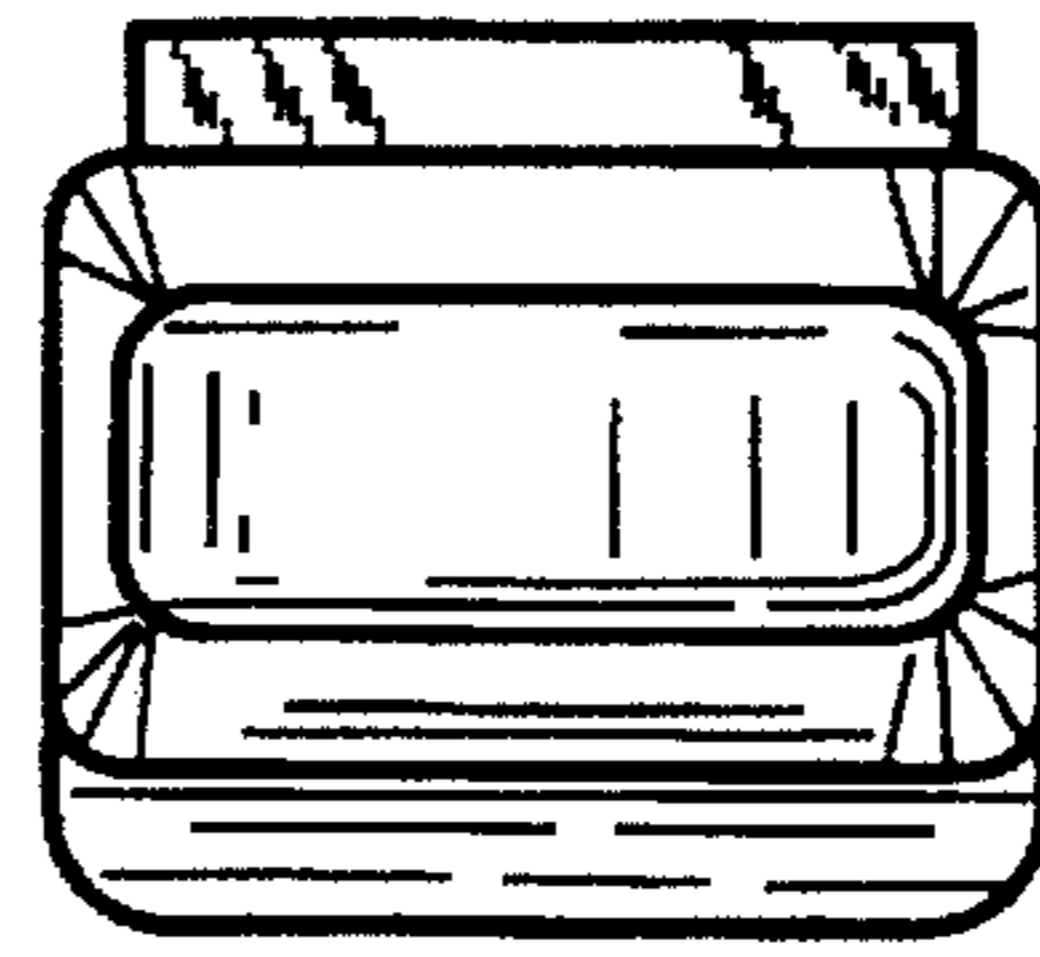

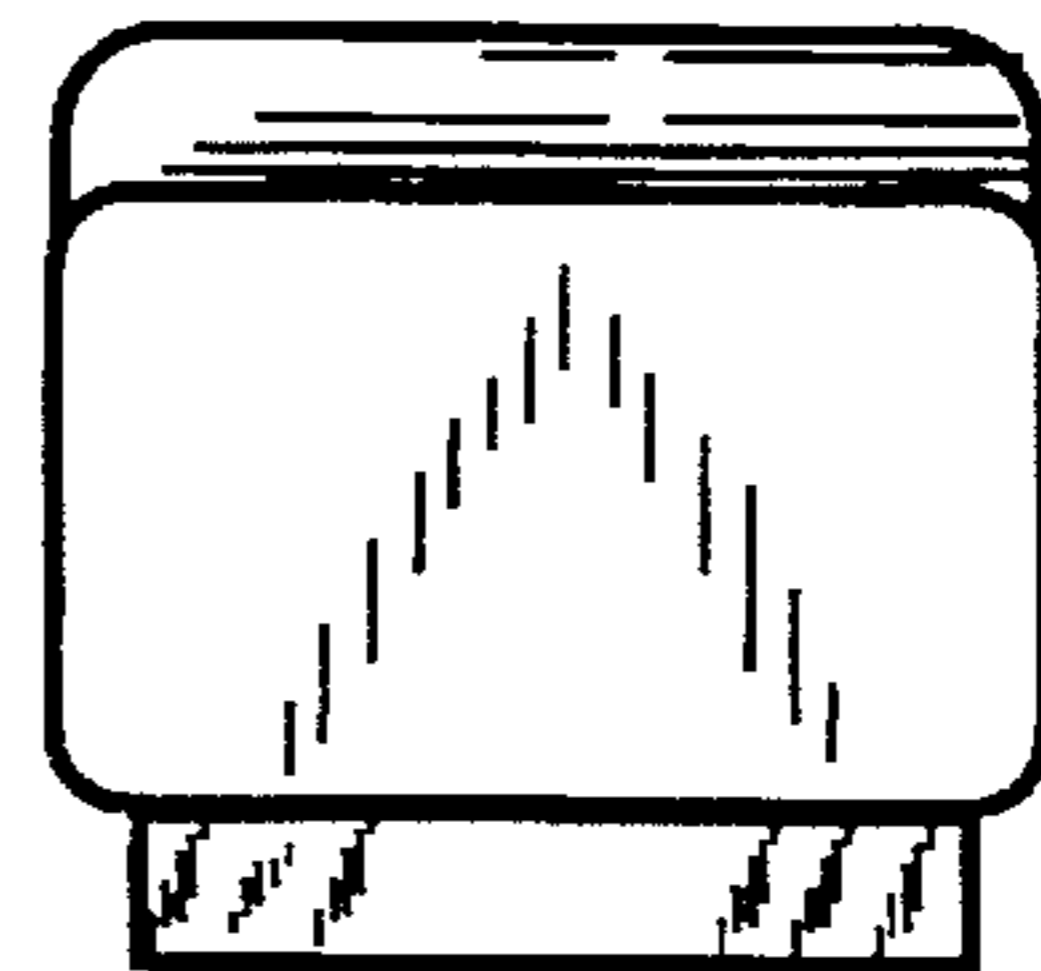

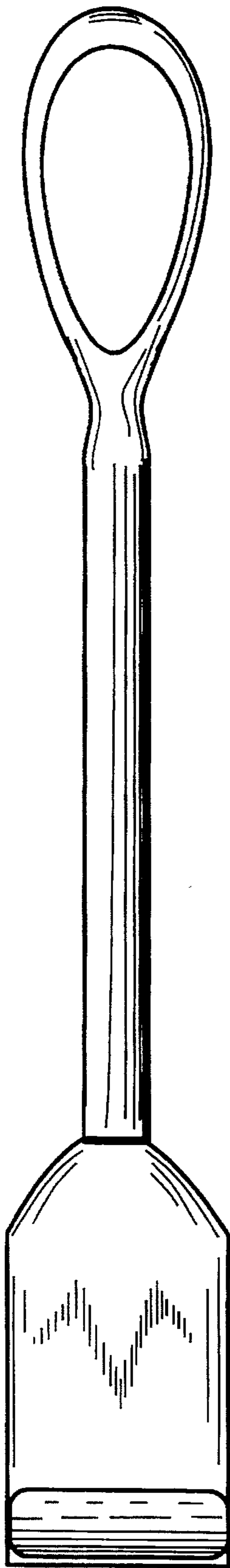

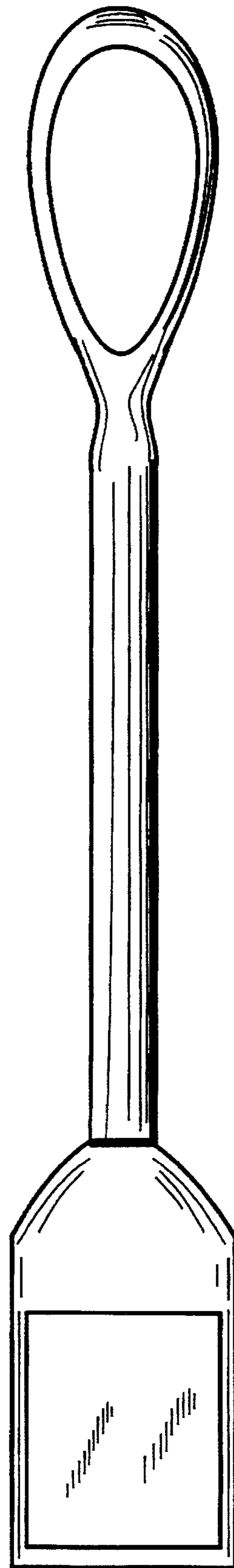

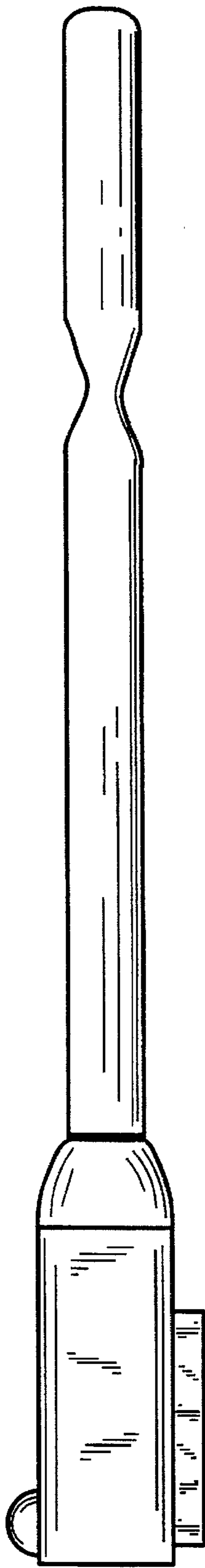

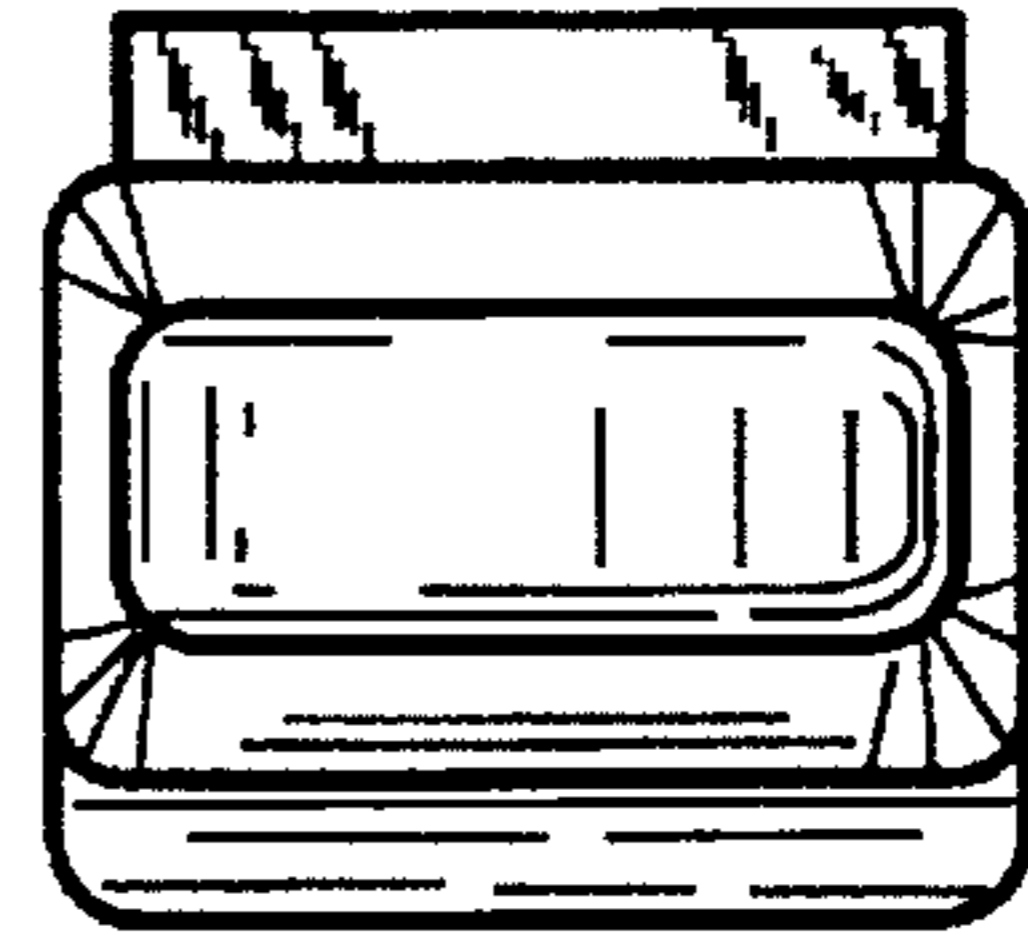

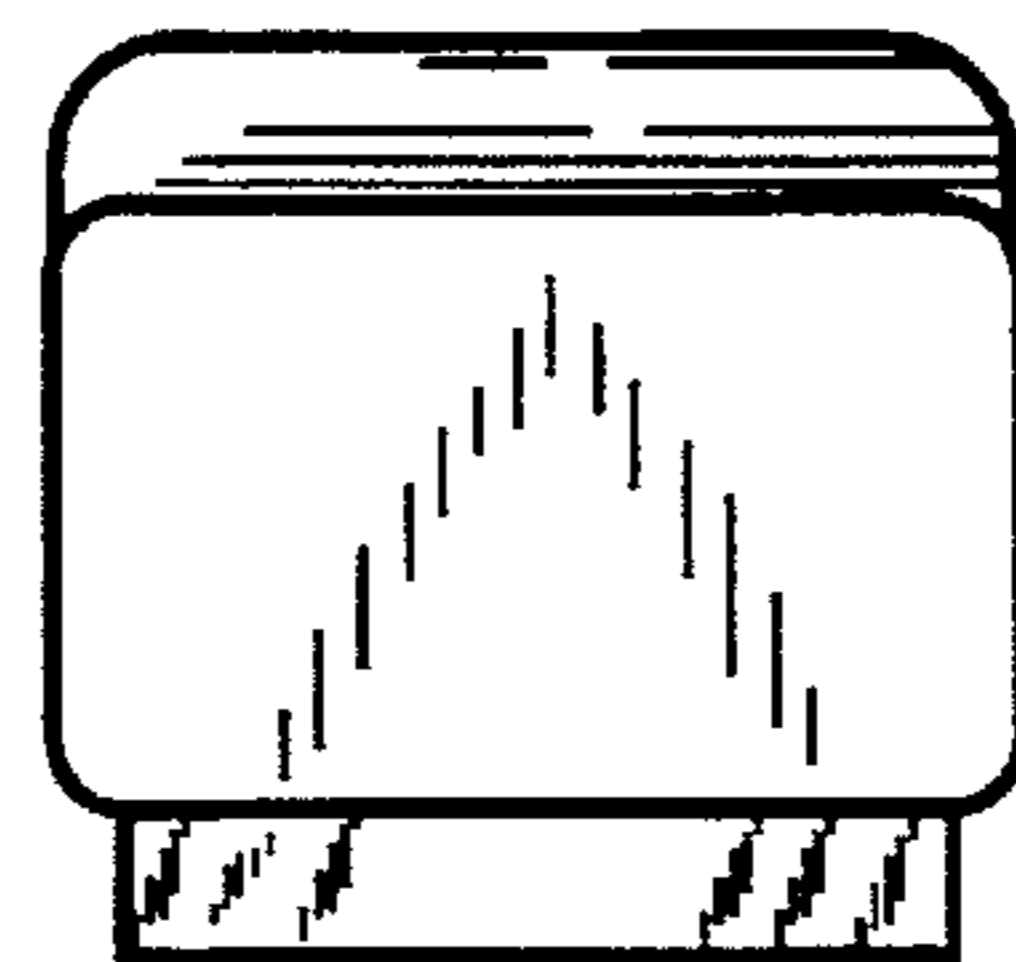

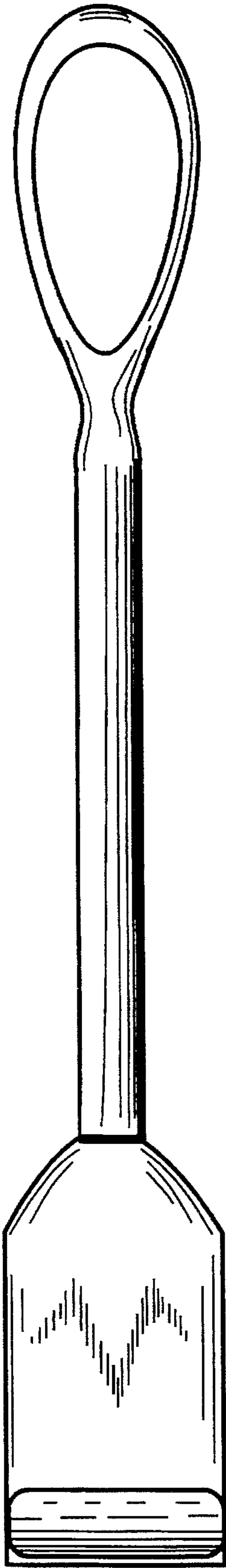

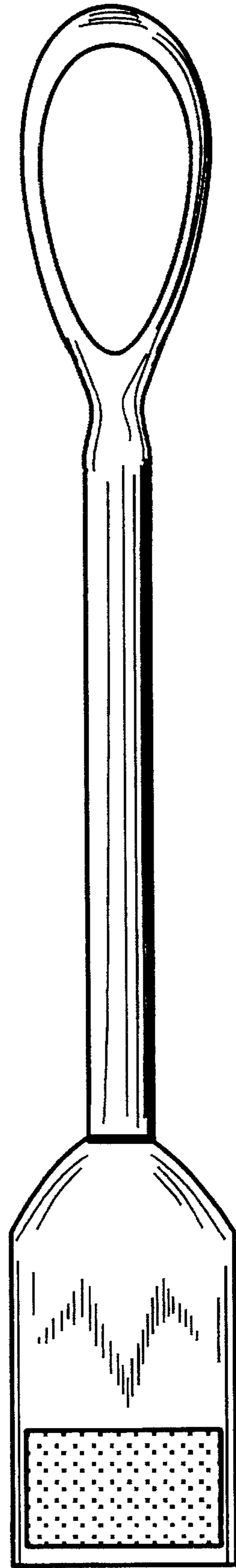

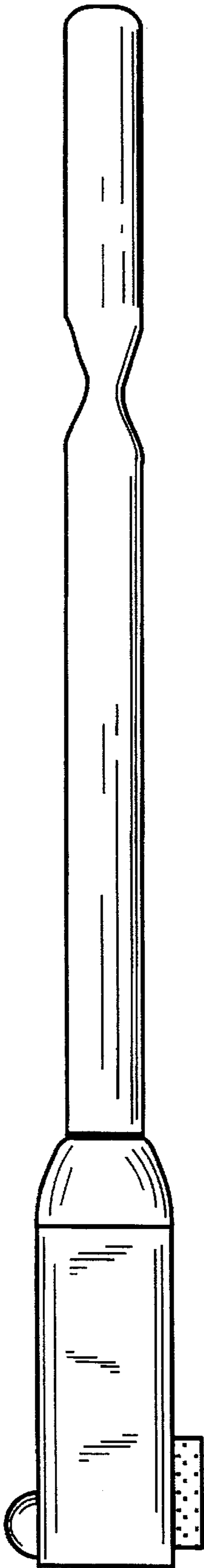

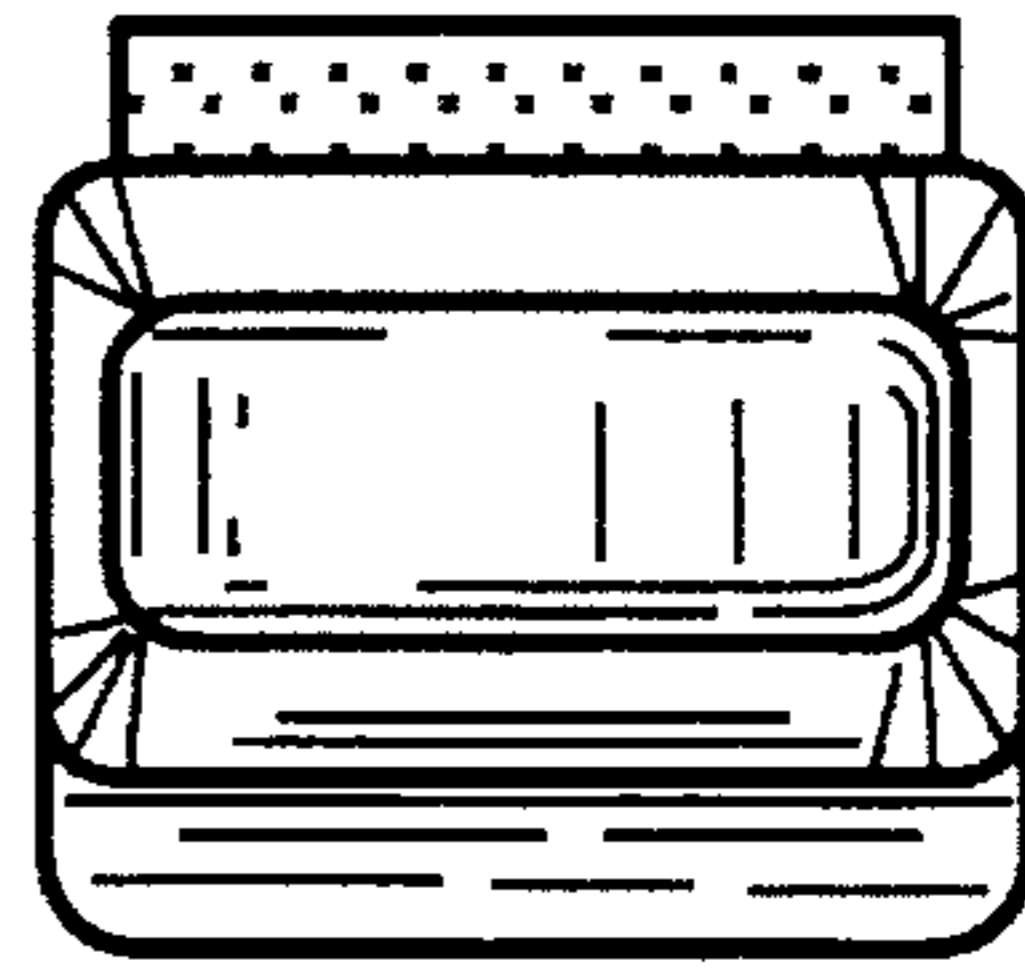

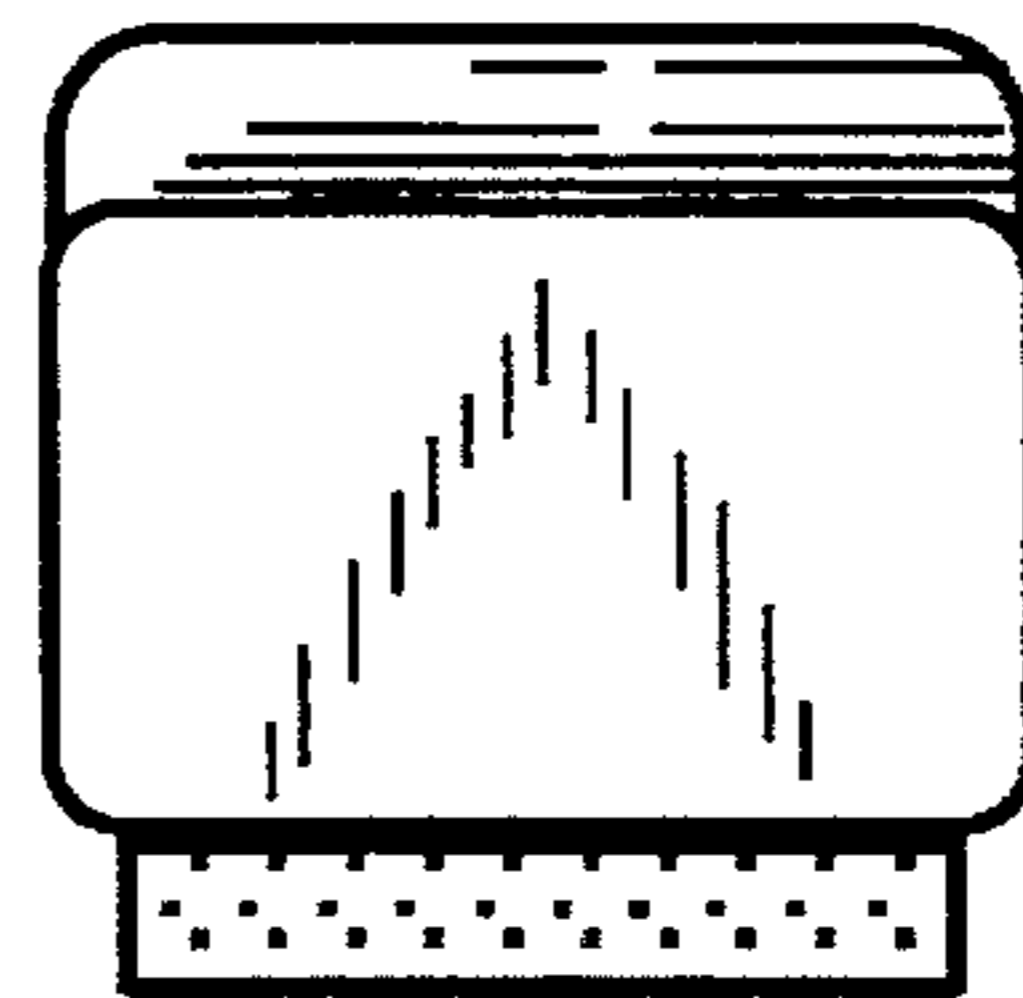

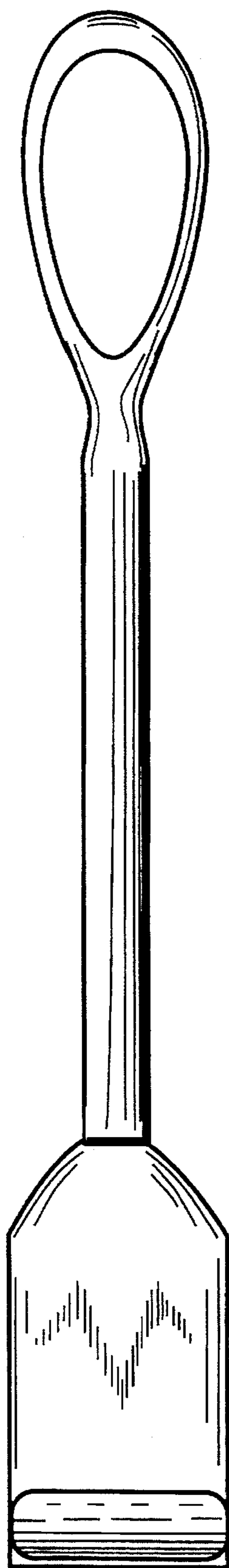

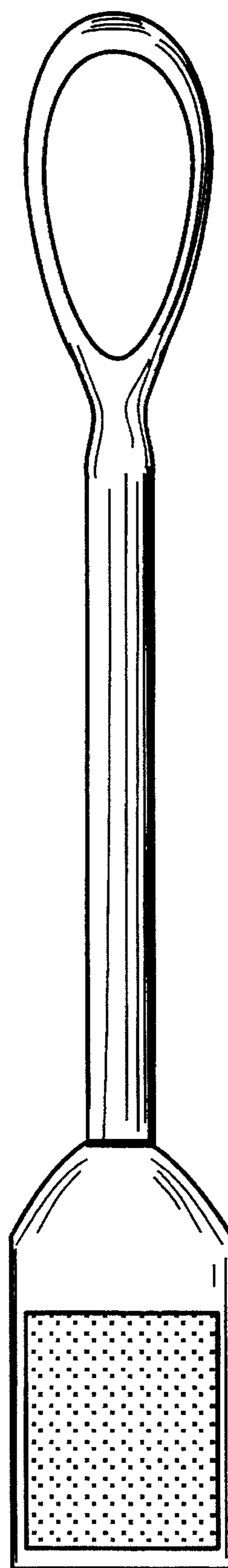

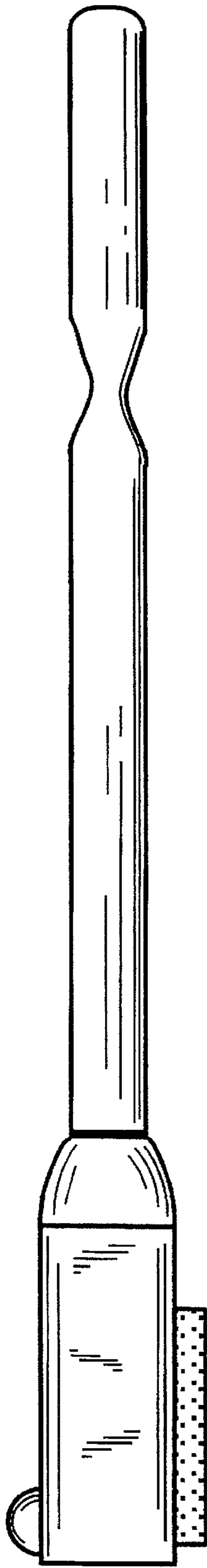

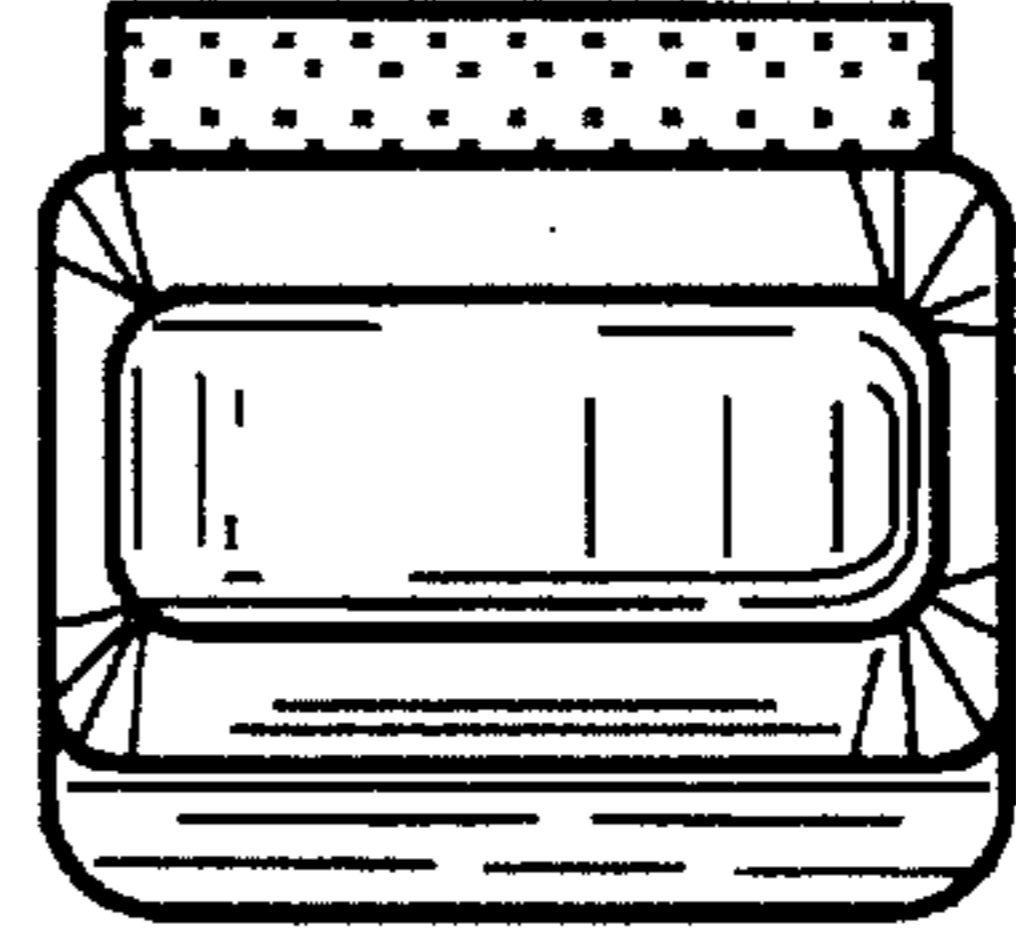

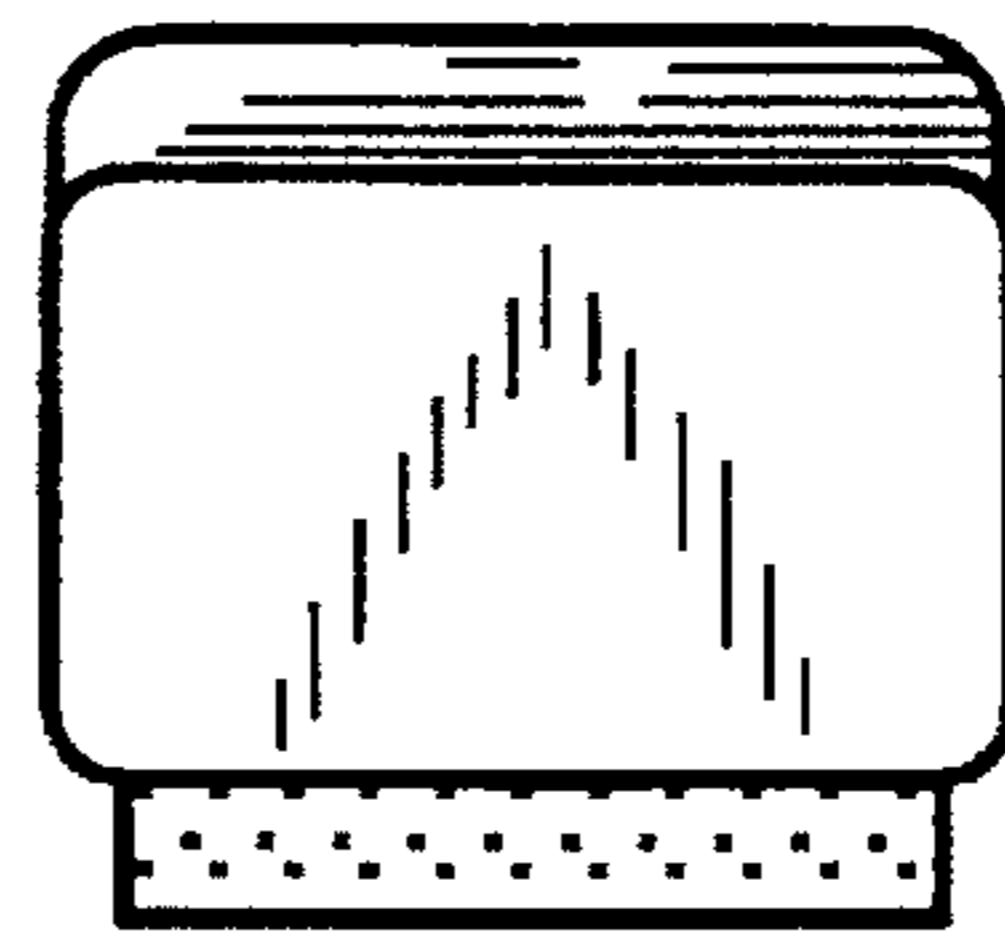

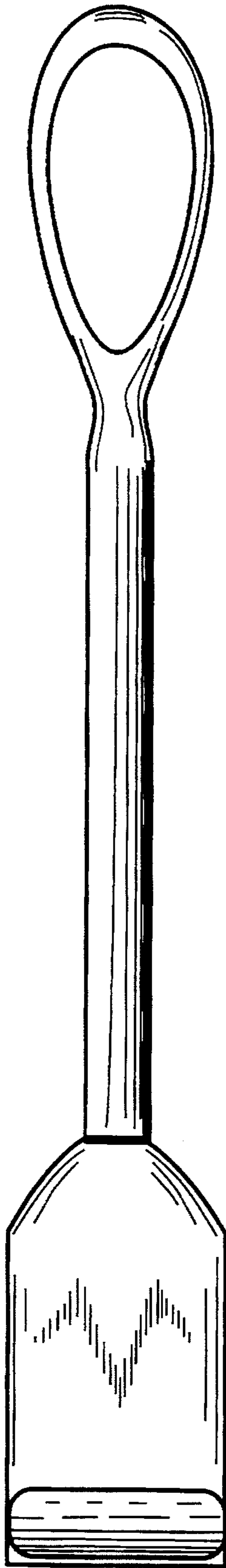

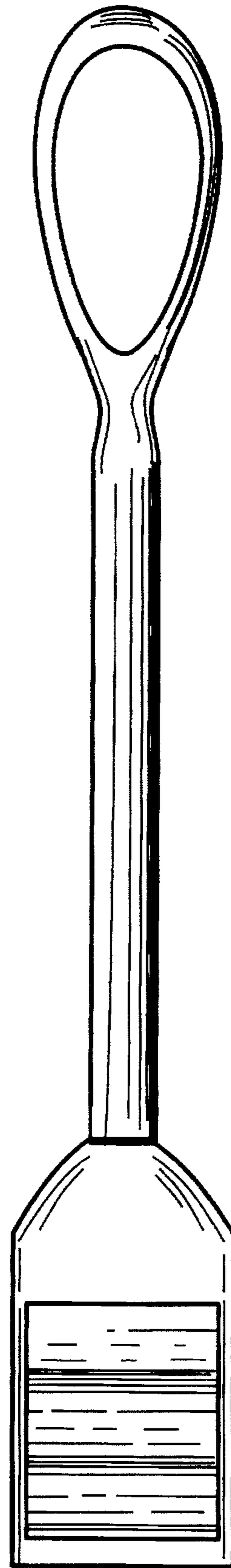

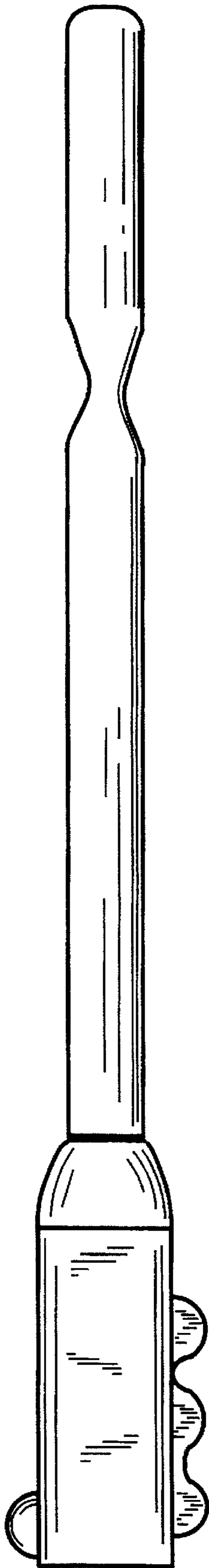

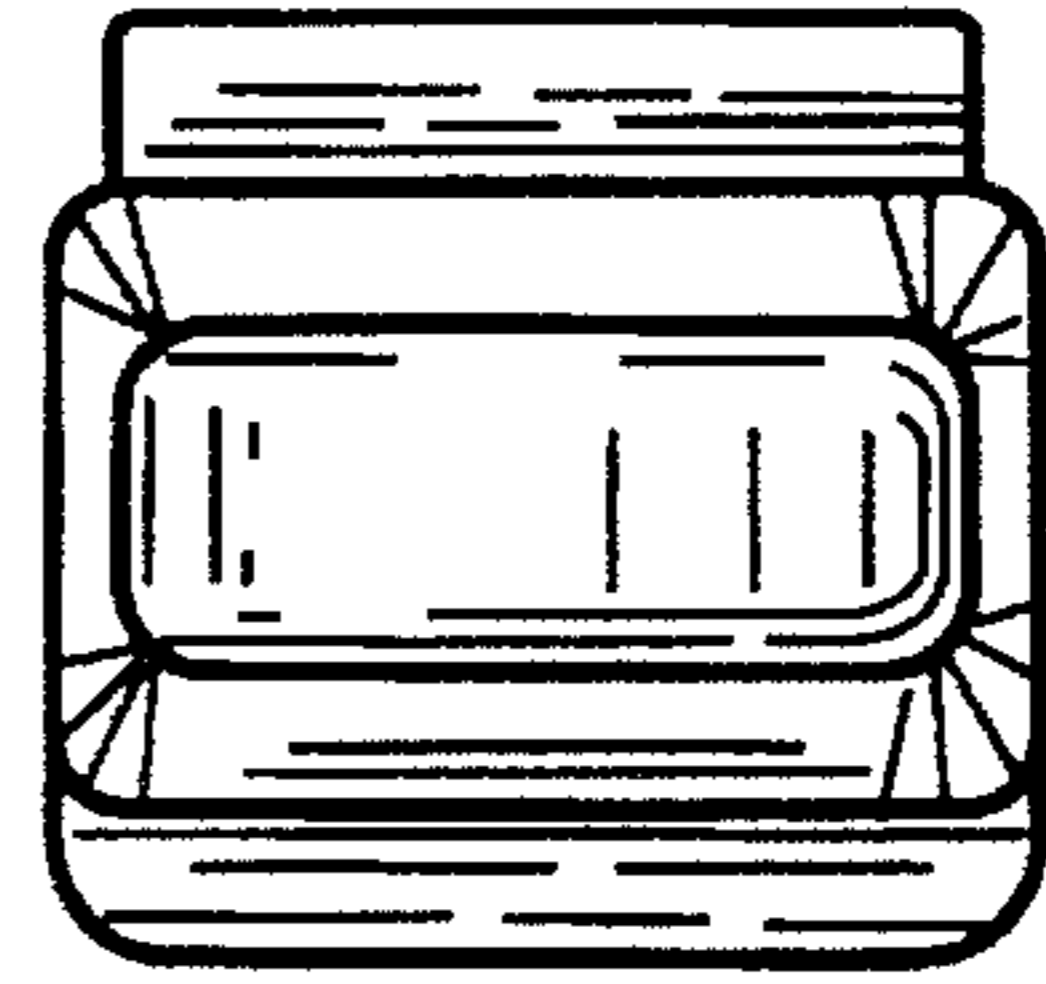

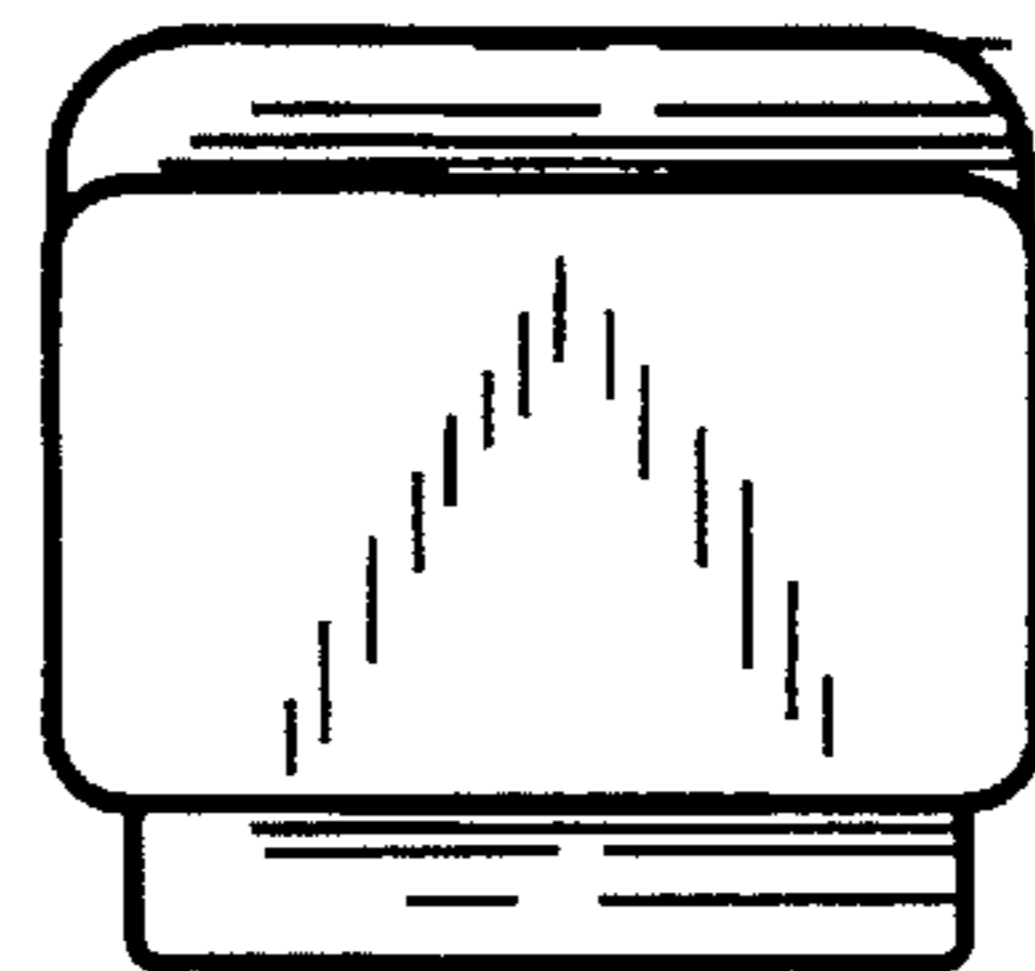
