FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

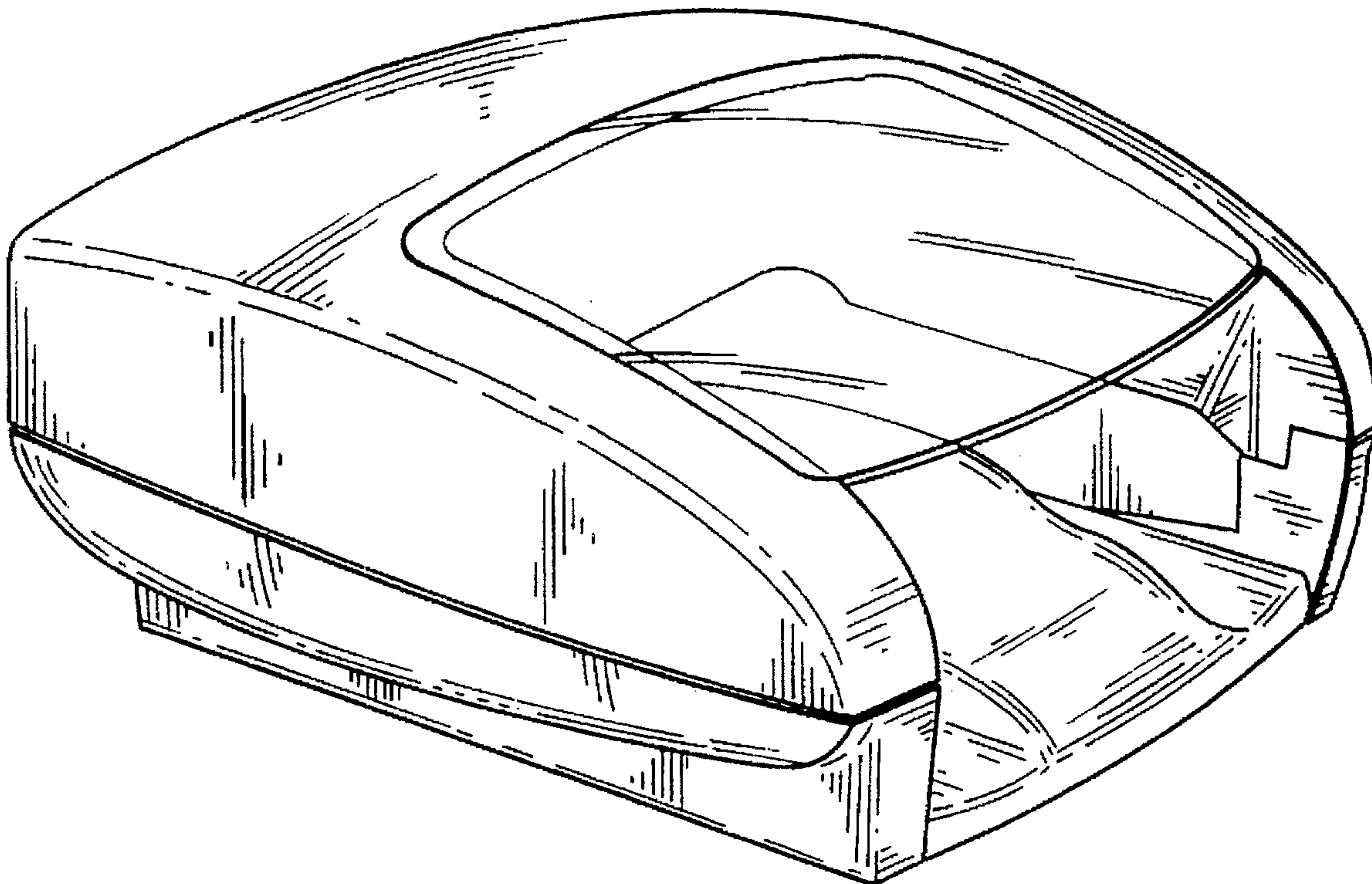
FIG. 7 is a perspective view showing the removable tray

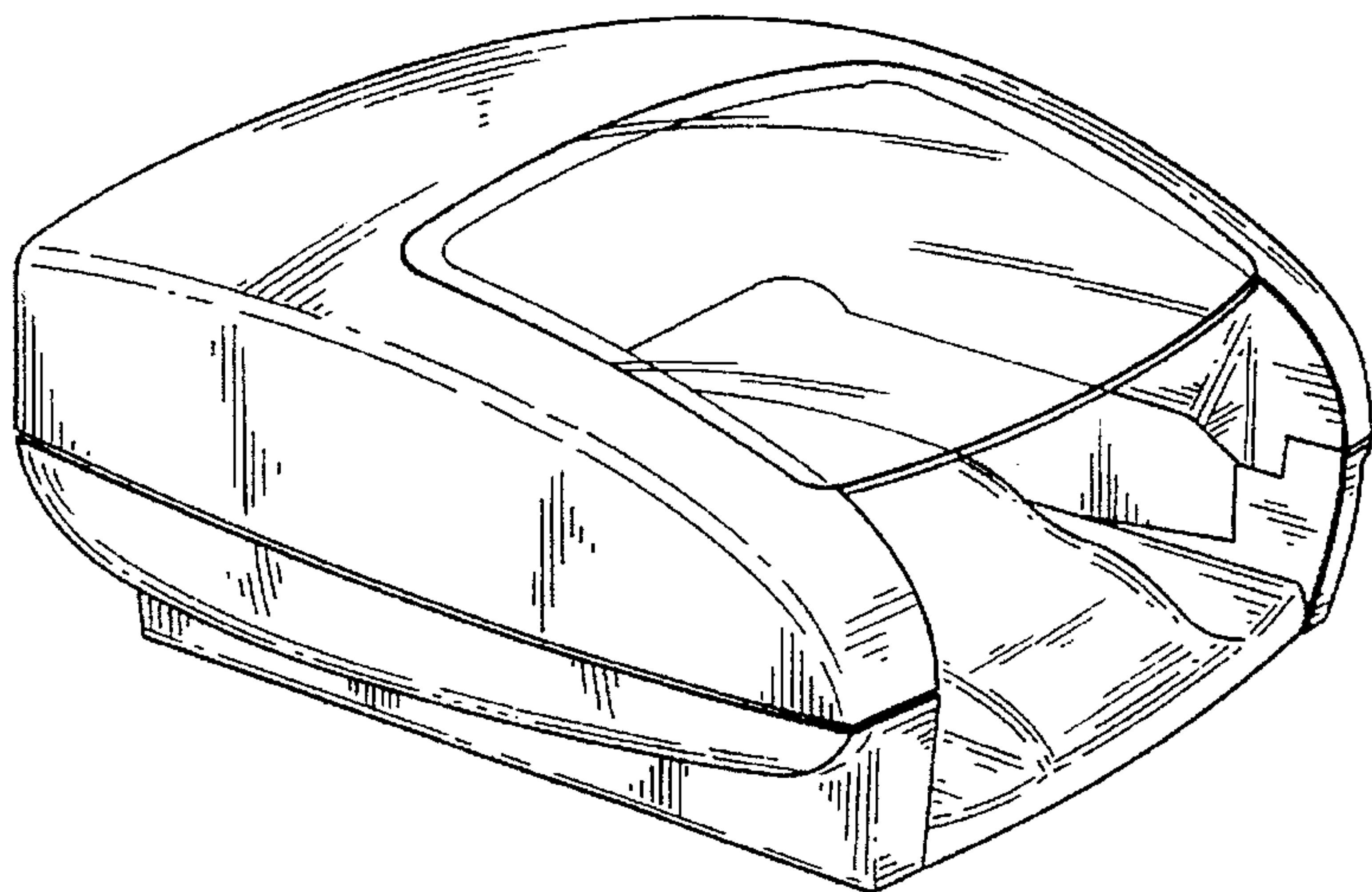

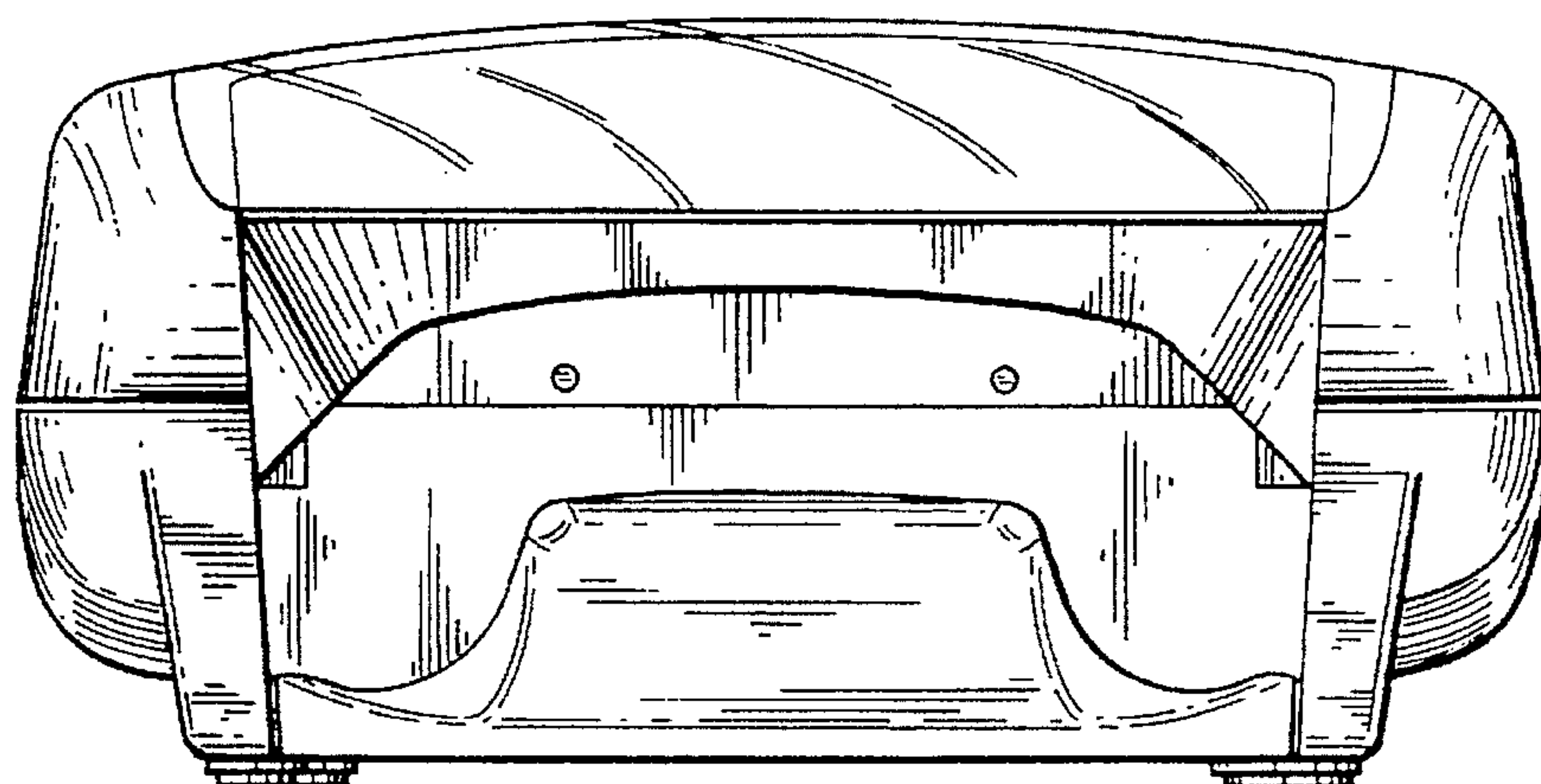

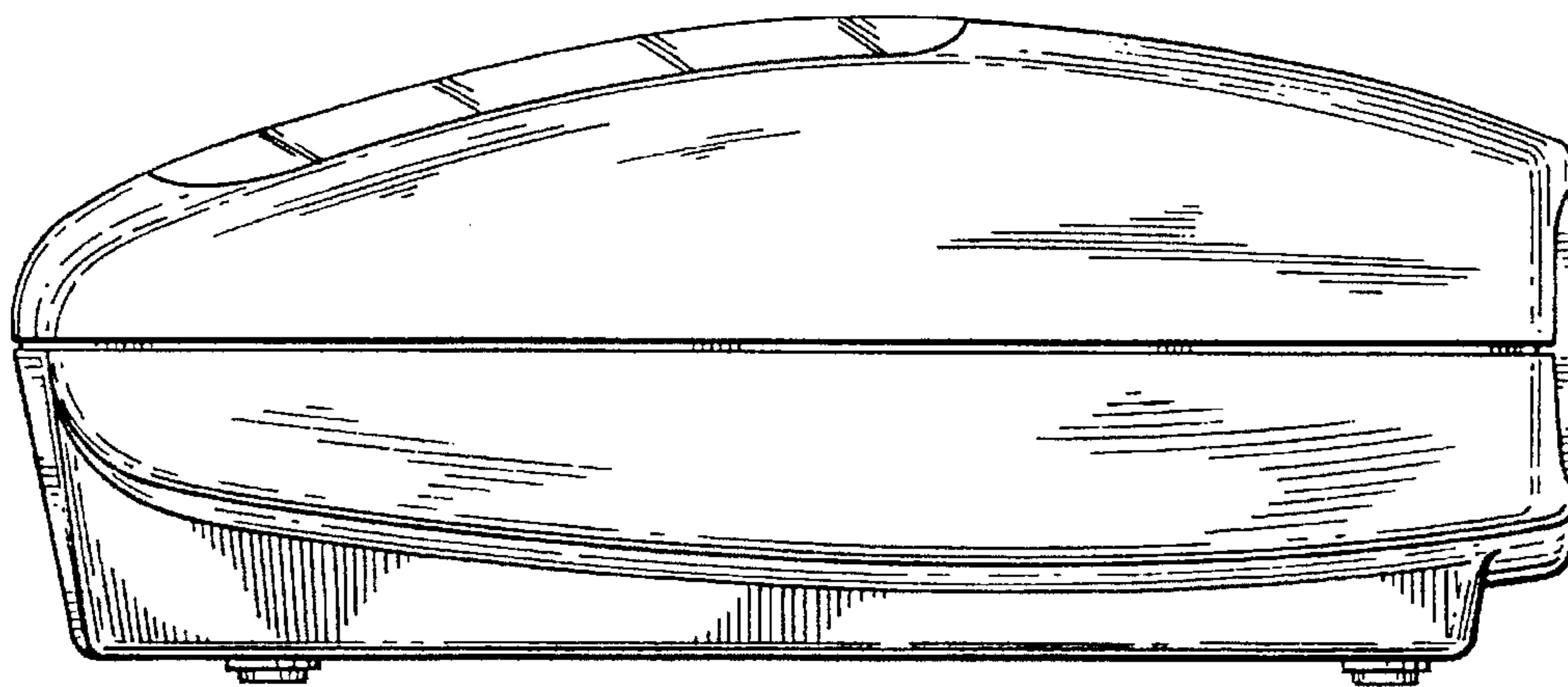

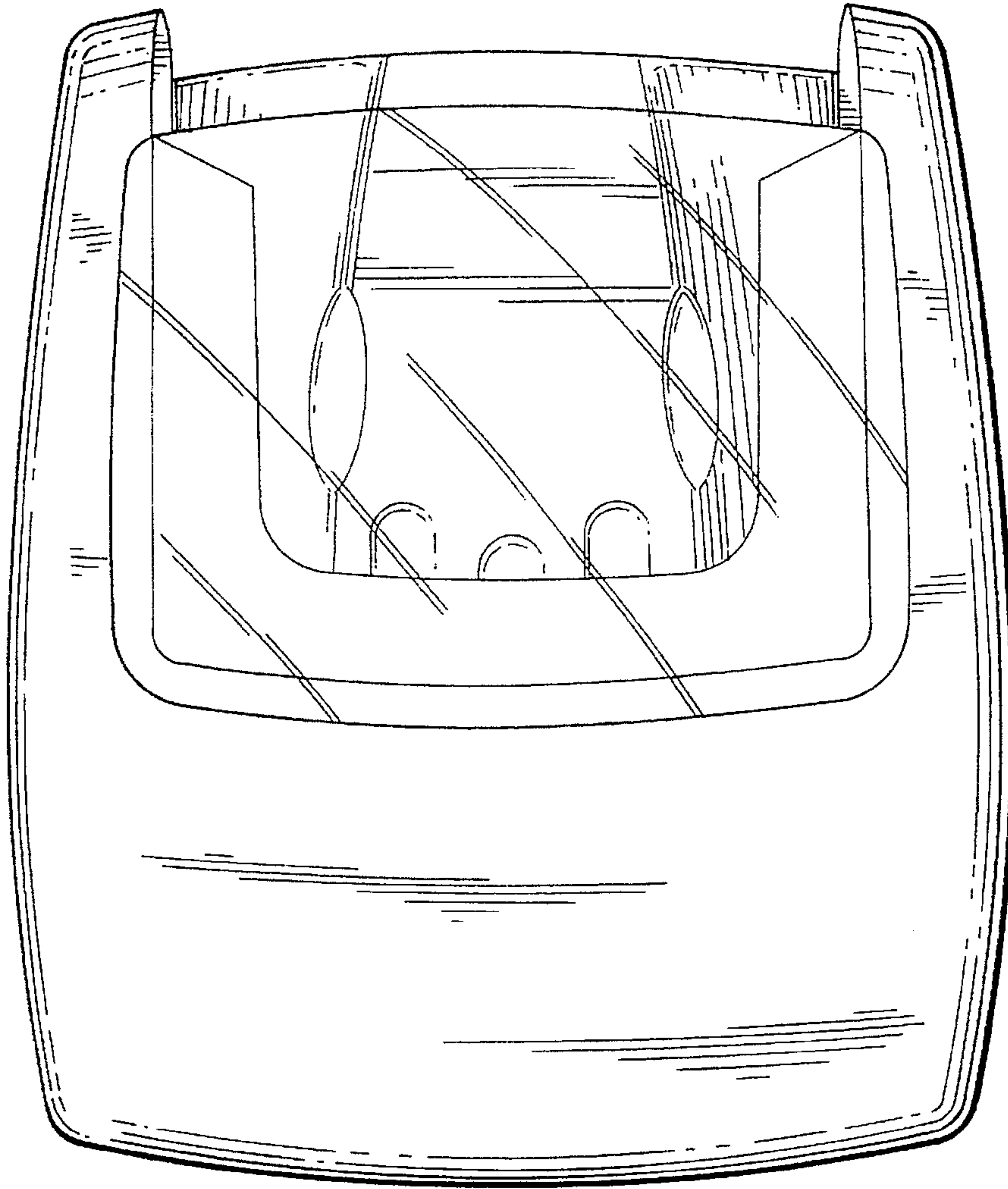
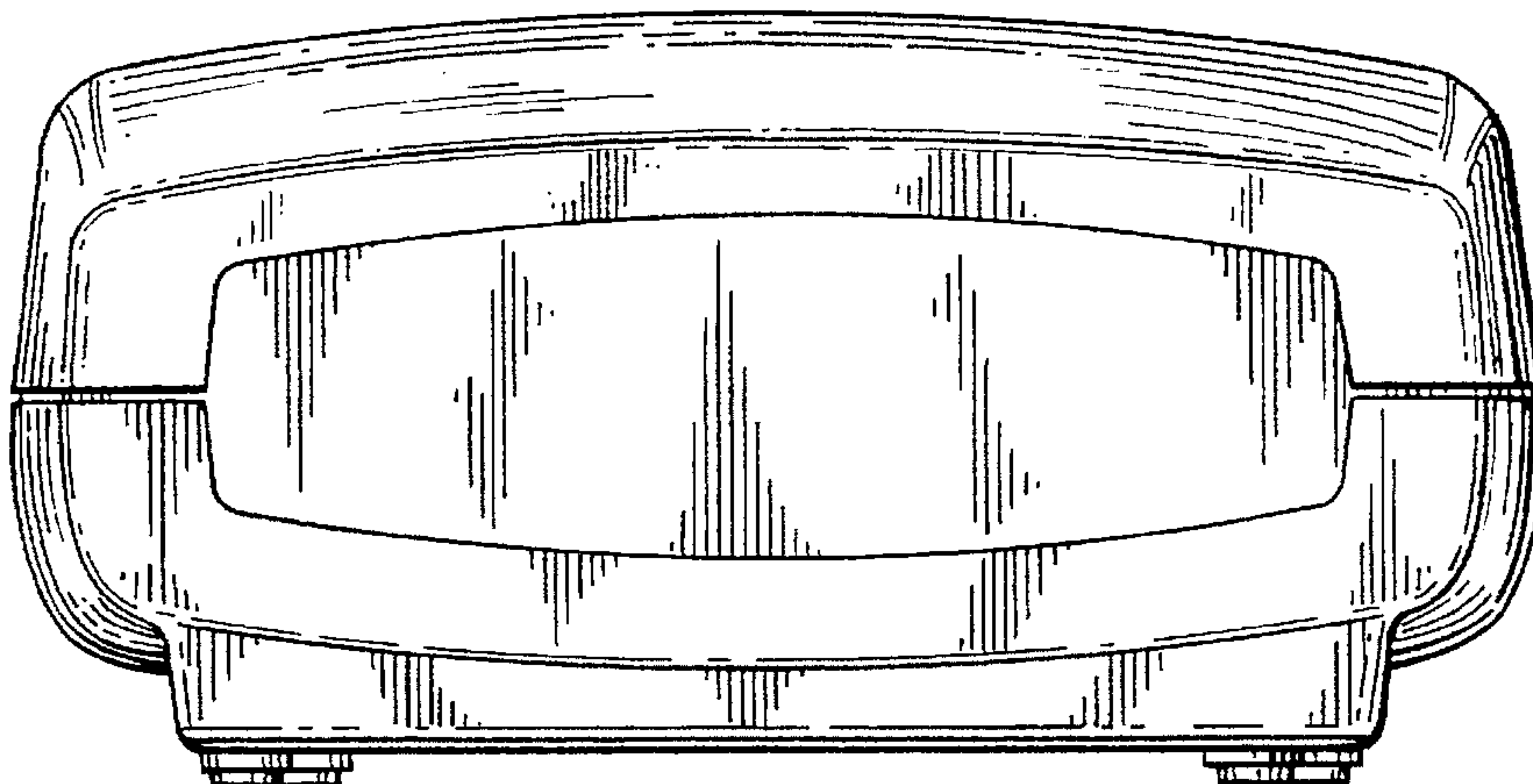

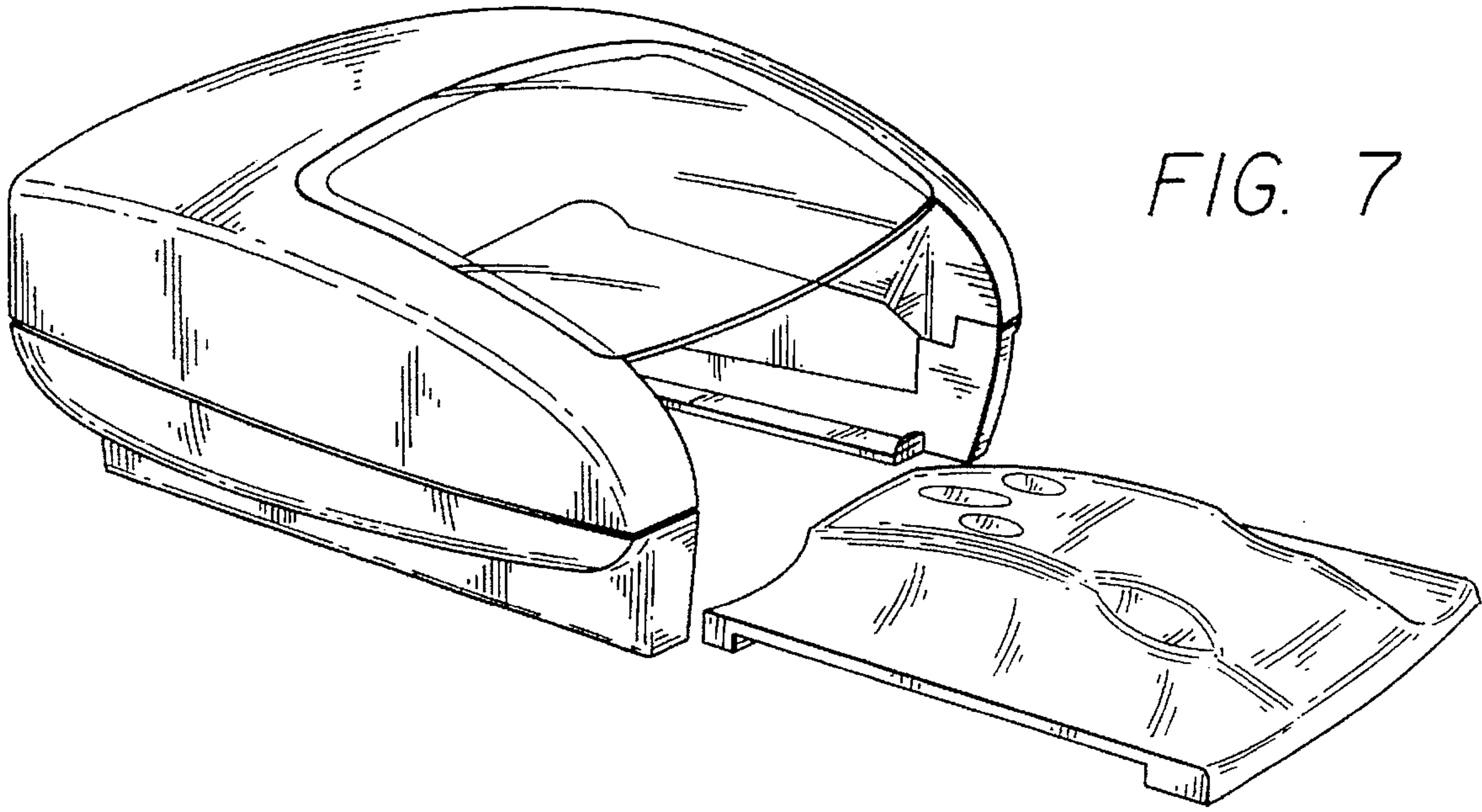
