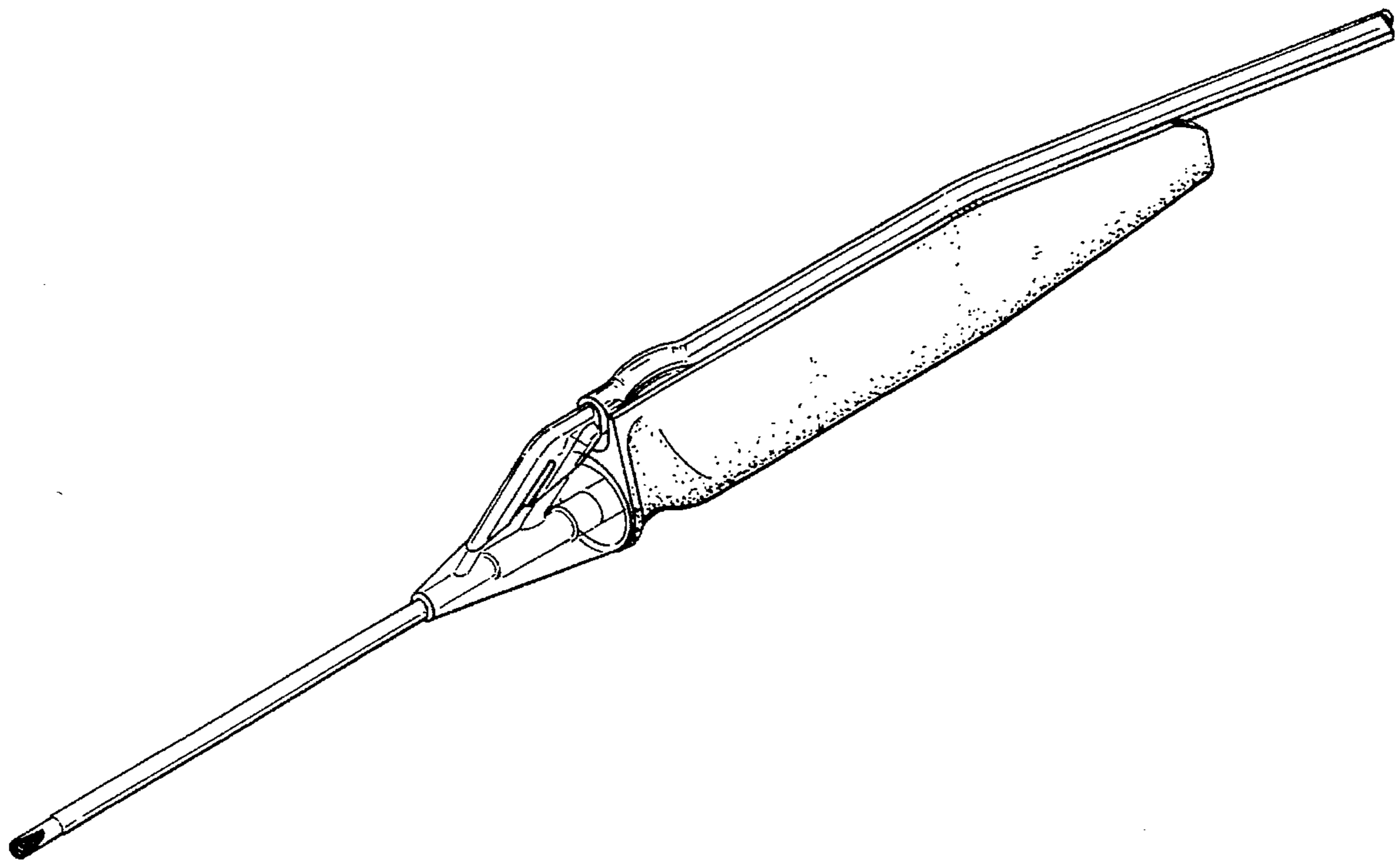

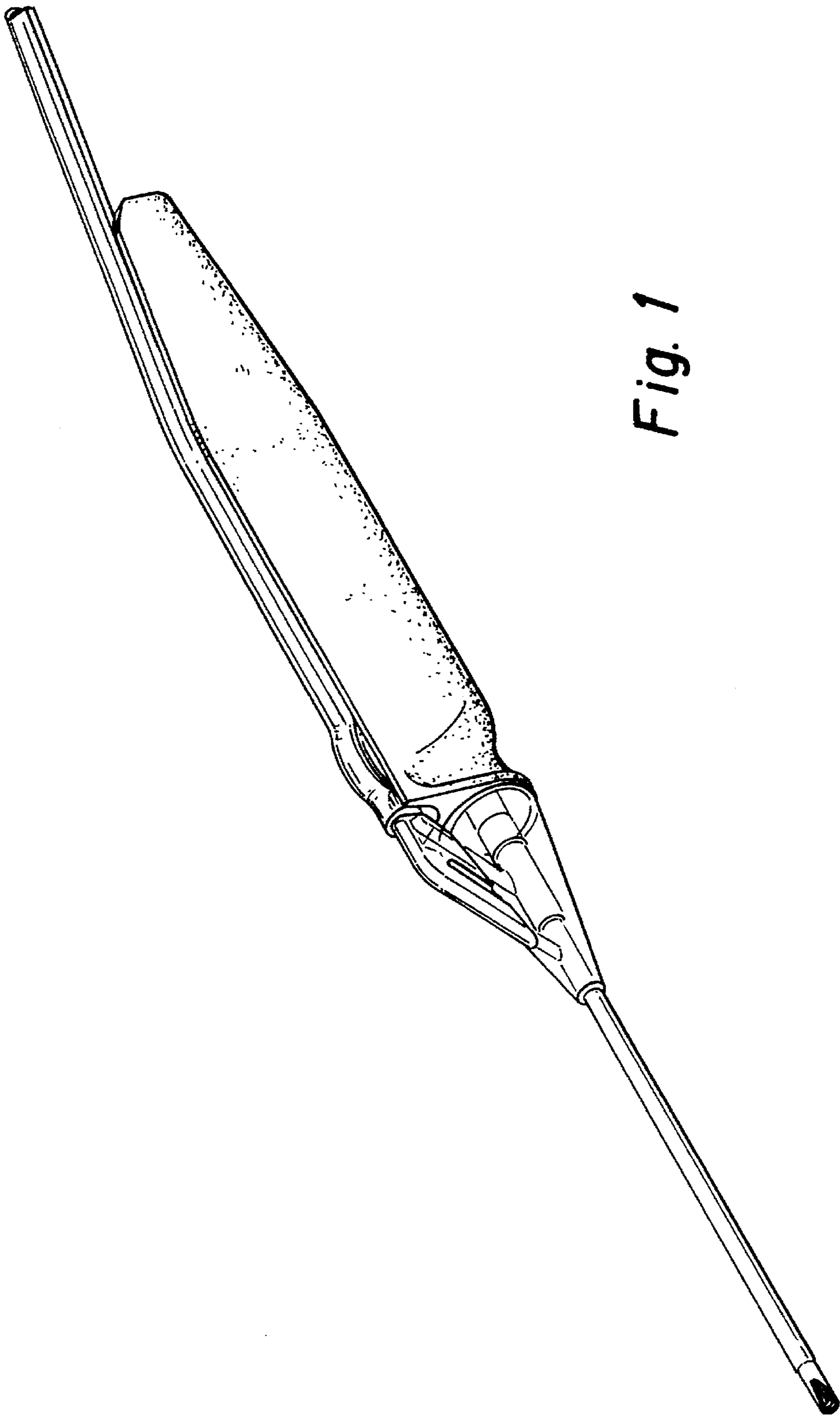
The ornamental design for a debrider instrument, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the debrider instrument; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the debrider instrument; FIG. 3 is the opposite side elevational view of the debrider instrument seen in FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the debrider instrument; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the debrider instrument; FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of the debrider instrument; and, FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of the debrider instrument. The proximal portion of the debrider instrument in FIGS. 2 through 5 is shown broken for ease of illustration.

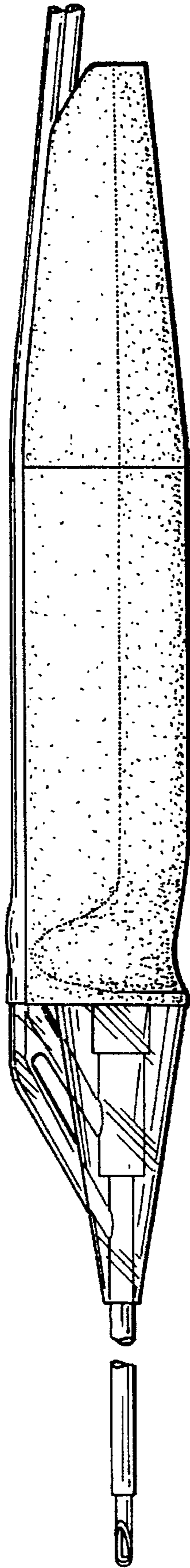

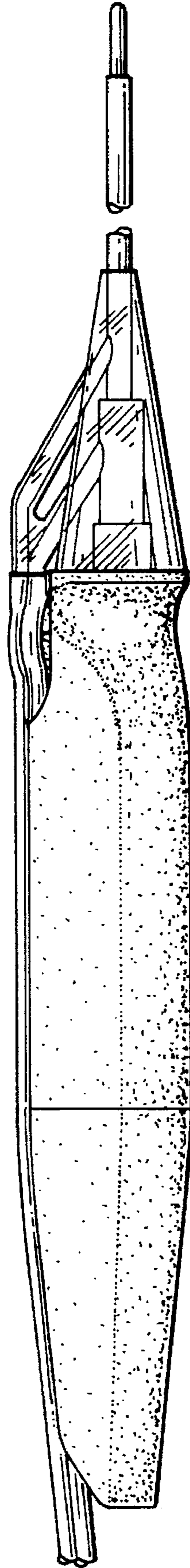

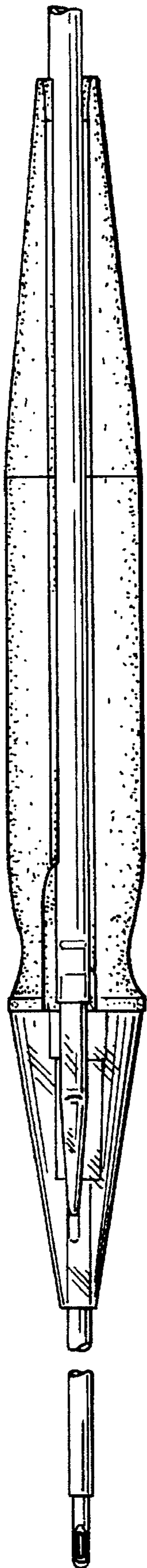

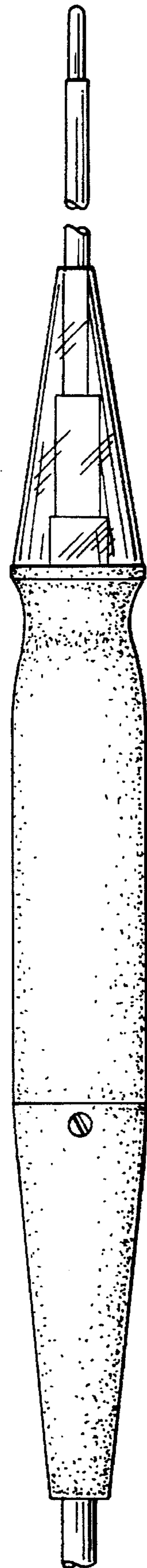

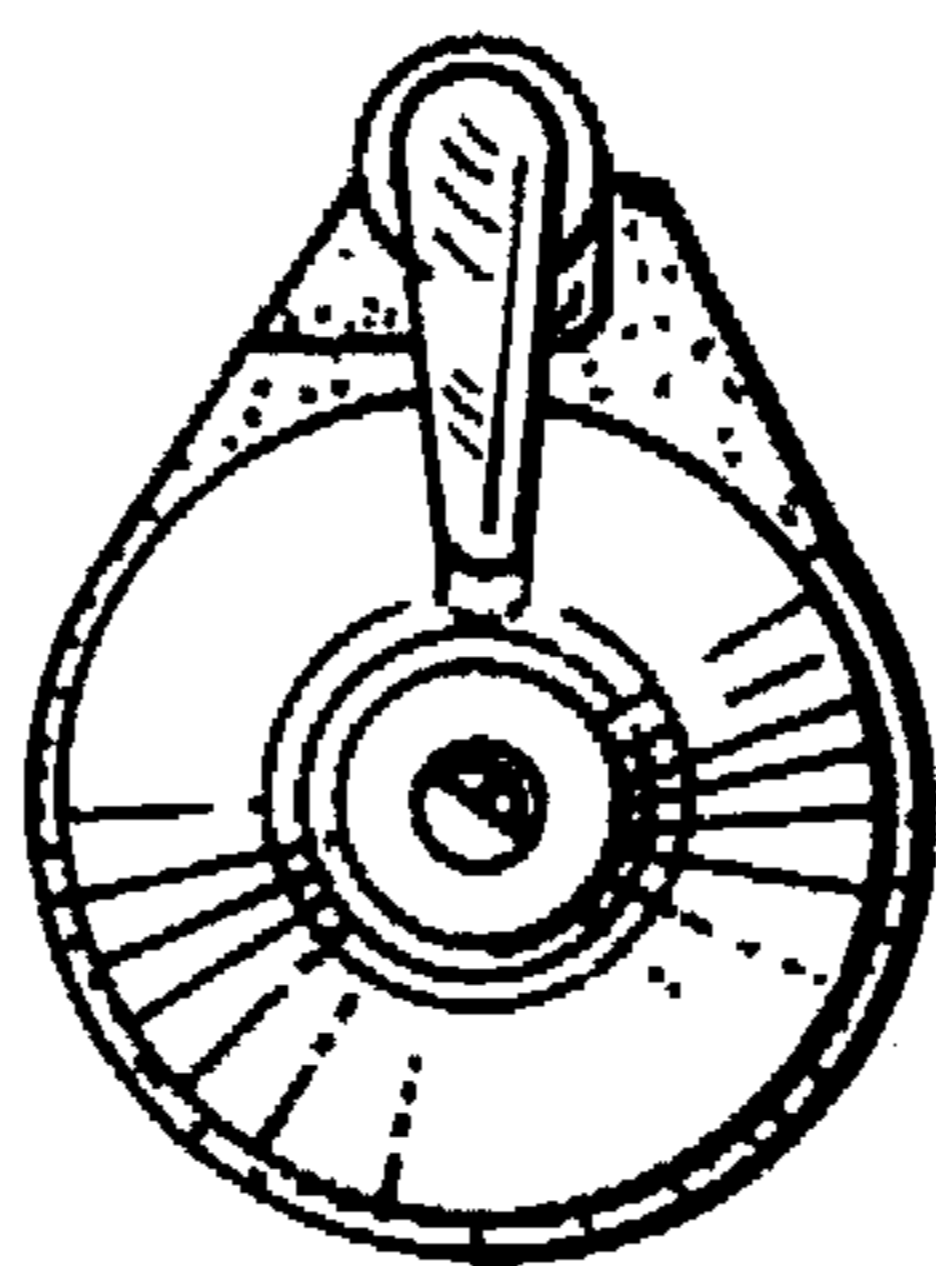
