[57] CLAIM

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the broken line showing of the film package is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;


FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, the broken line showing of the pamphlet is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design; and,






