#### [57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a rail tie down for vehicle, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the design mounted on a vehicle with the vehicle being shown in broken lines;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view of the design;


FIG. 3 is a still further enlarged perspective view of the design, with the center section of the design being removed for ease of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the design shown in FIG. 3.

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view the design shown in FIG.

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the design shown in FIG. 3. FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the design shown in FIG. 3. The broken line showing of vehicle is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
