The ornamental design for a protective cover for a removable battery of a radiotelephone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, left, front, perspective view of a protective cover for a removable battery of a radiotelephone;

FIG. 2 is a top, right, rear, perspective view of a protective cover for a removable battery of a radiotelephone;

FIG. 3 is a top, left, front, perspective view of a protective cover for a removable battery of a radiotelephone with a removable battery inserted therein;


FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of a protective cover for a removable battery of a radiotelephone;


FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of a protective cover for a removable battery of a radiotelephone; and,


FIG. 6 is a left elevation view of a protective cover for a removable battery of a radiotelephone.

The broken line showing is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.




