FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof.

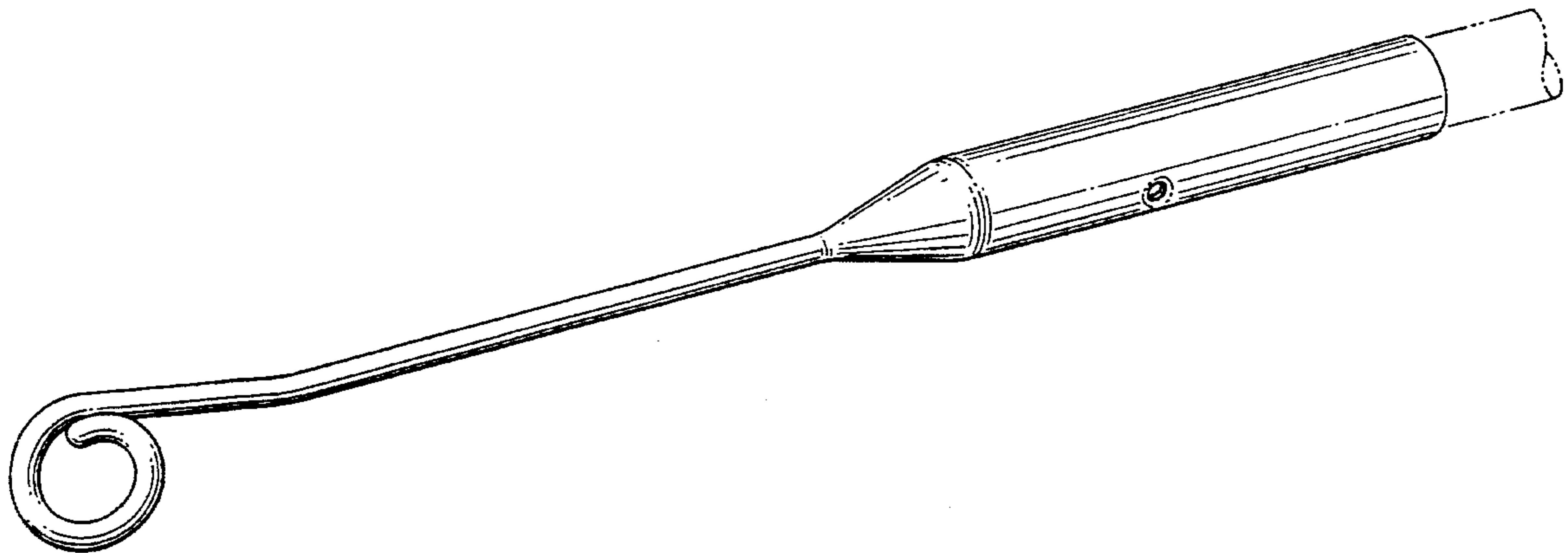
The broken-line disclosure of fishing lines, hooks and poles to which the present fishhook remover is attached is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the present design.

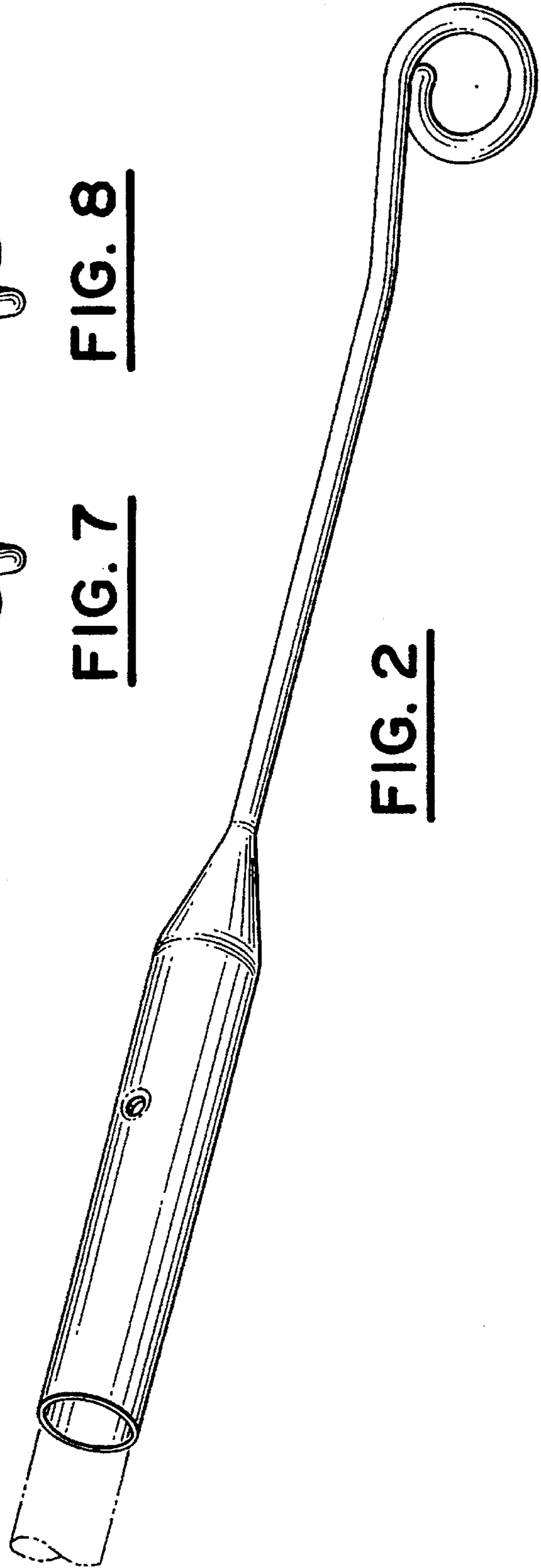
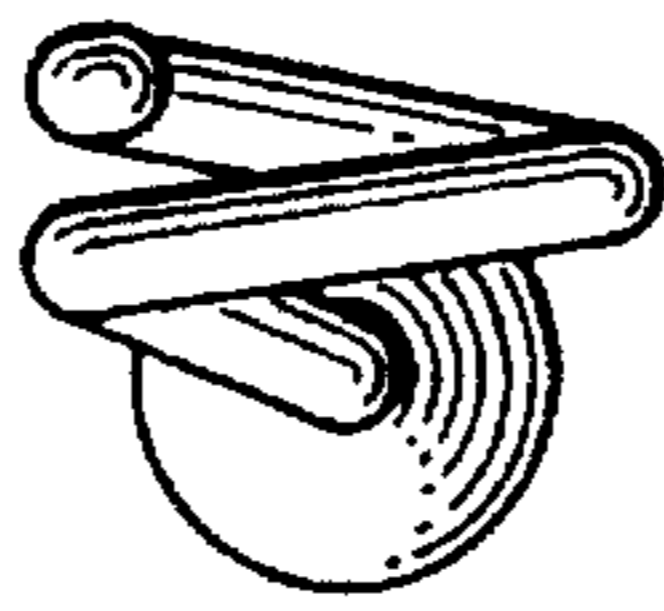
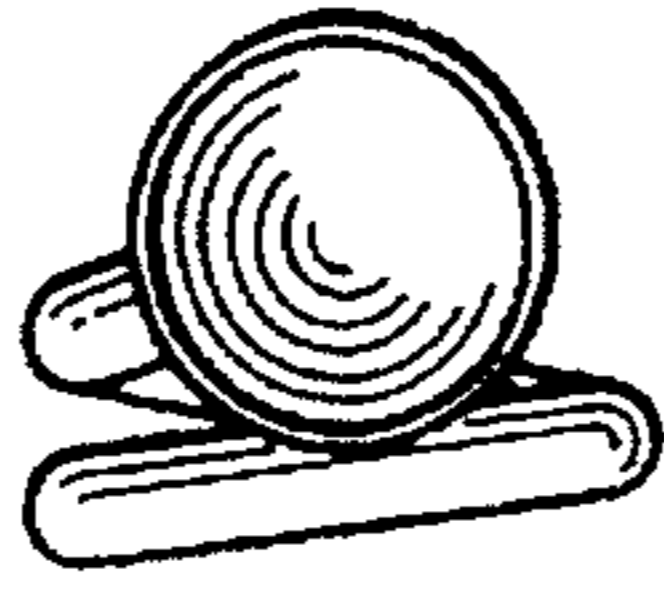
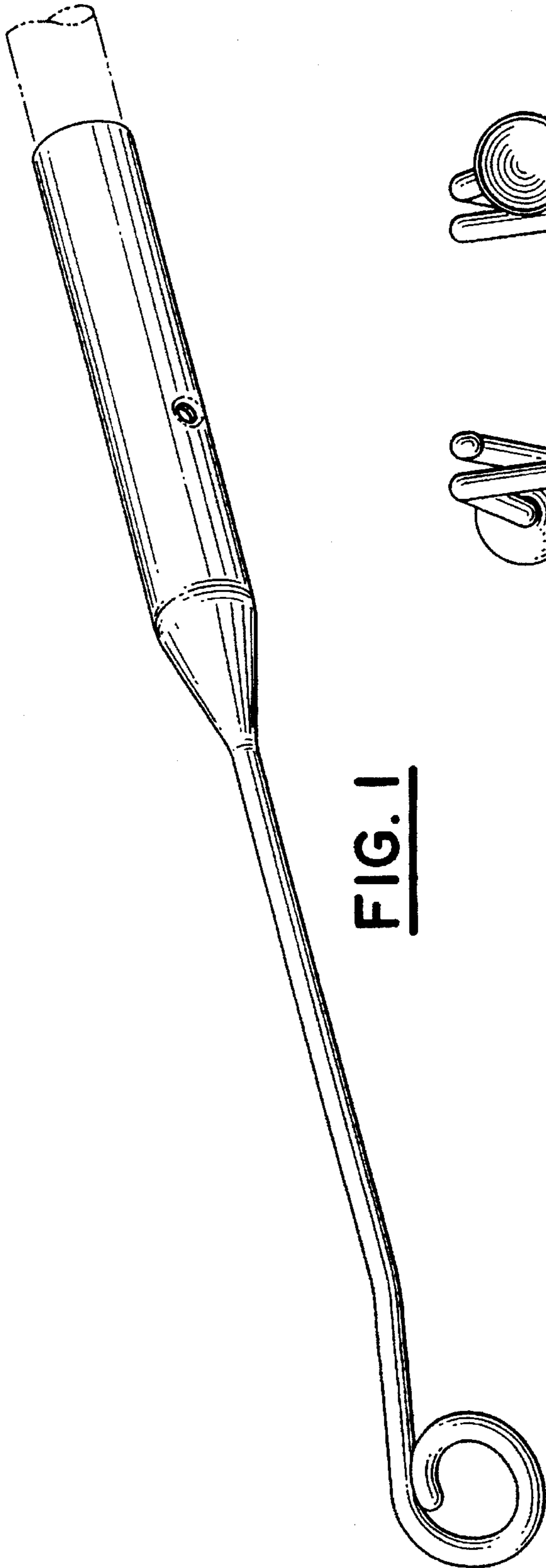

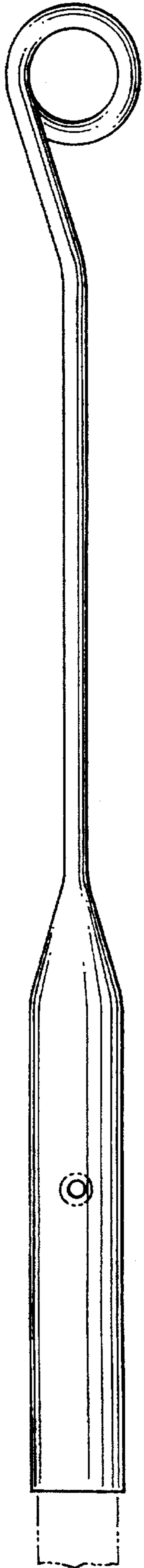

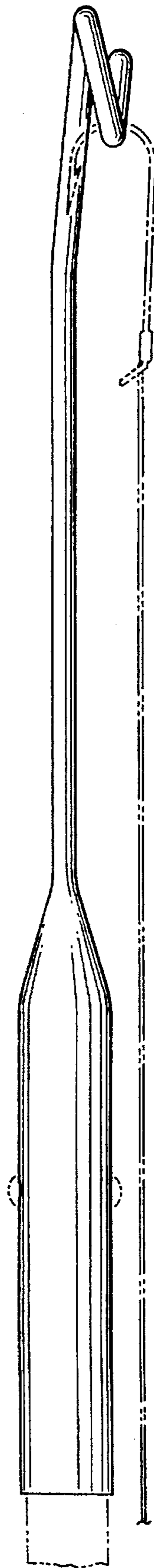

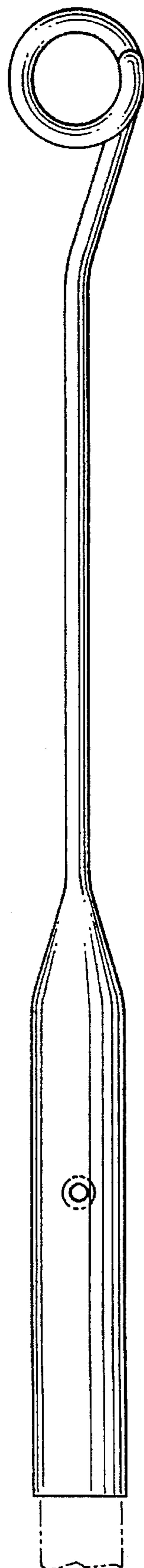

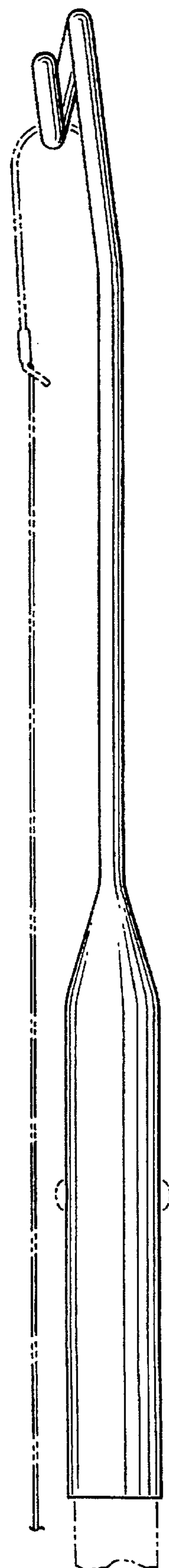
