DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is an end elevational view;

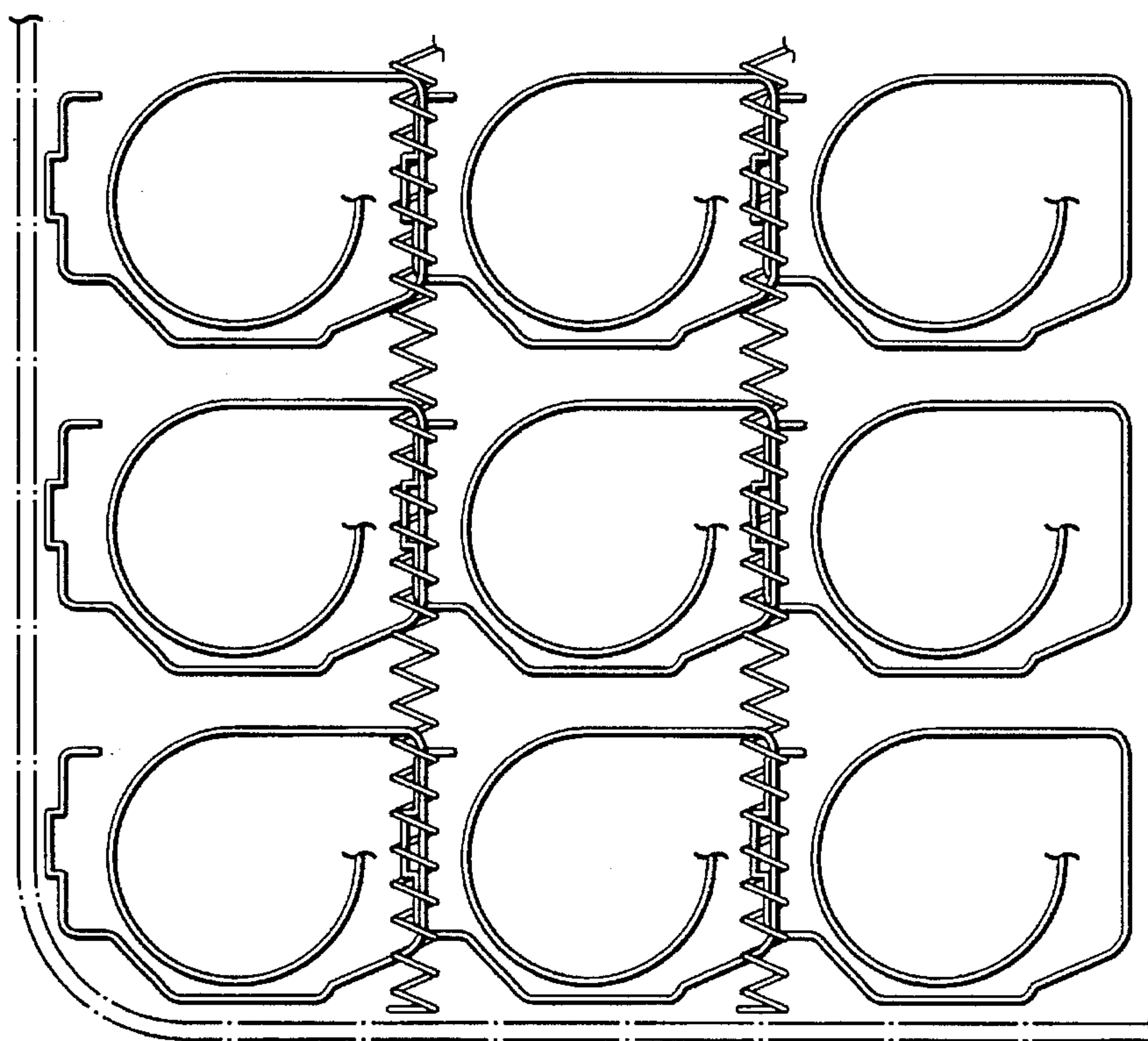
FIG. 8 is an enlarged view taken from section 8 of FIG. 7:

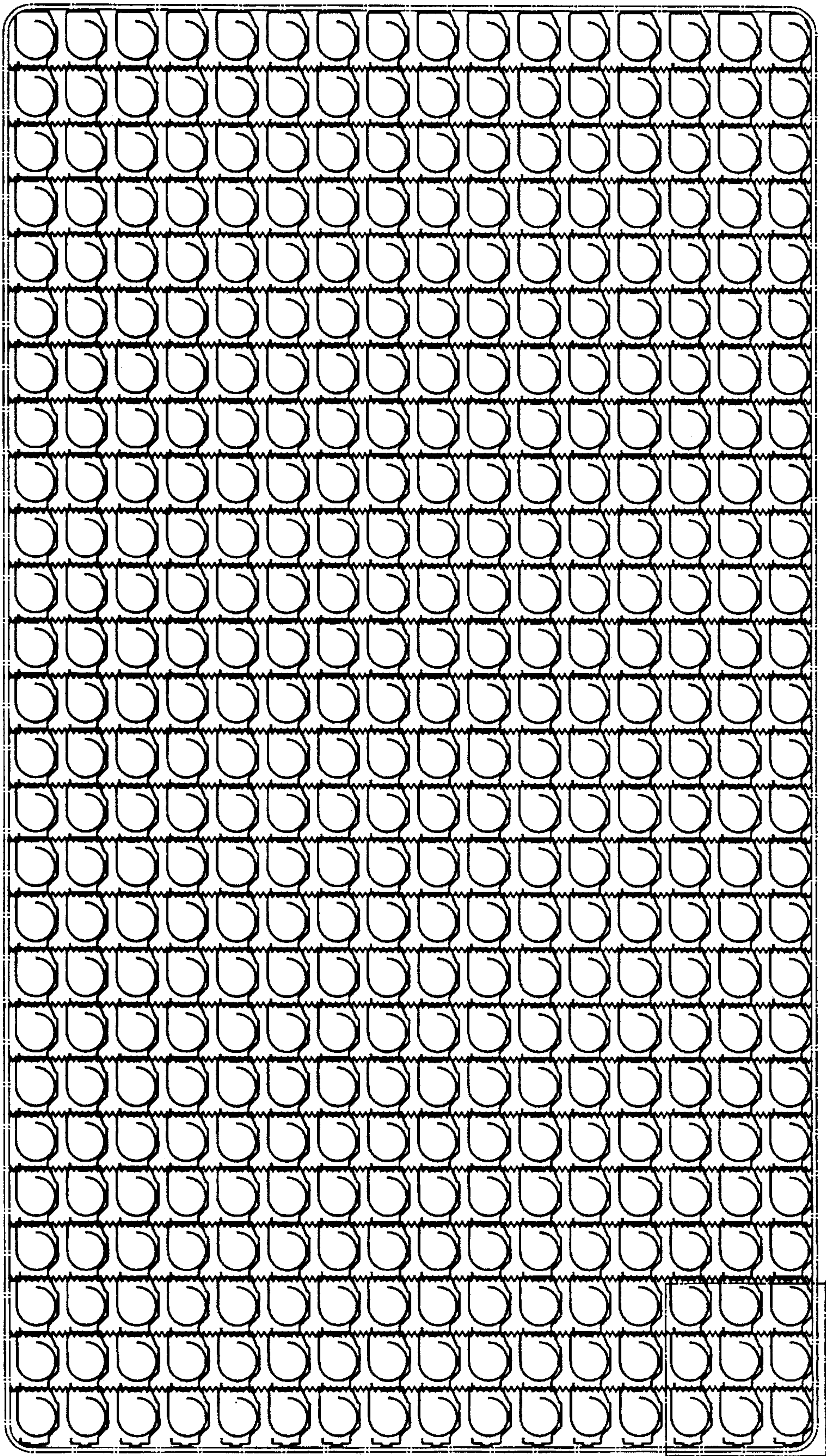

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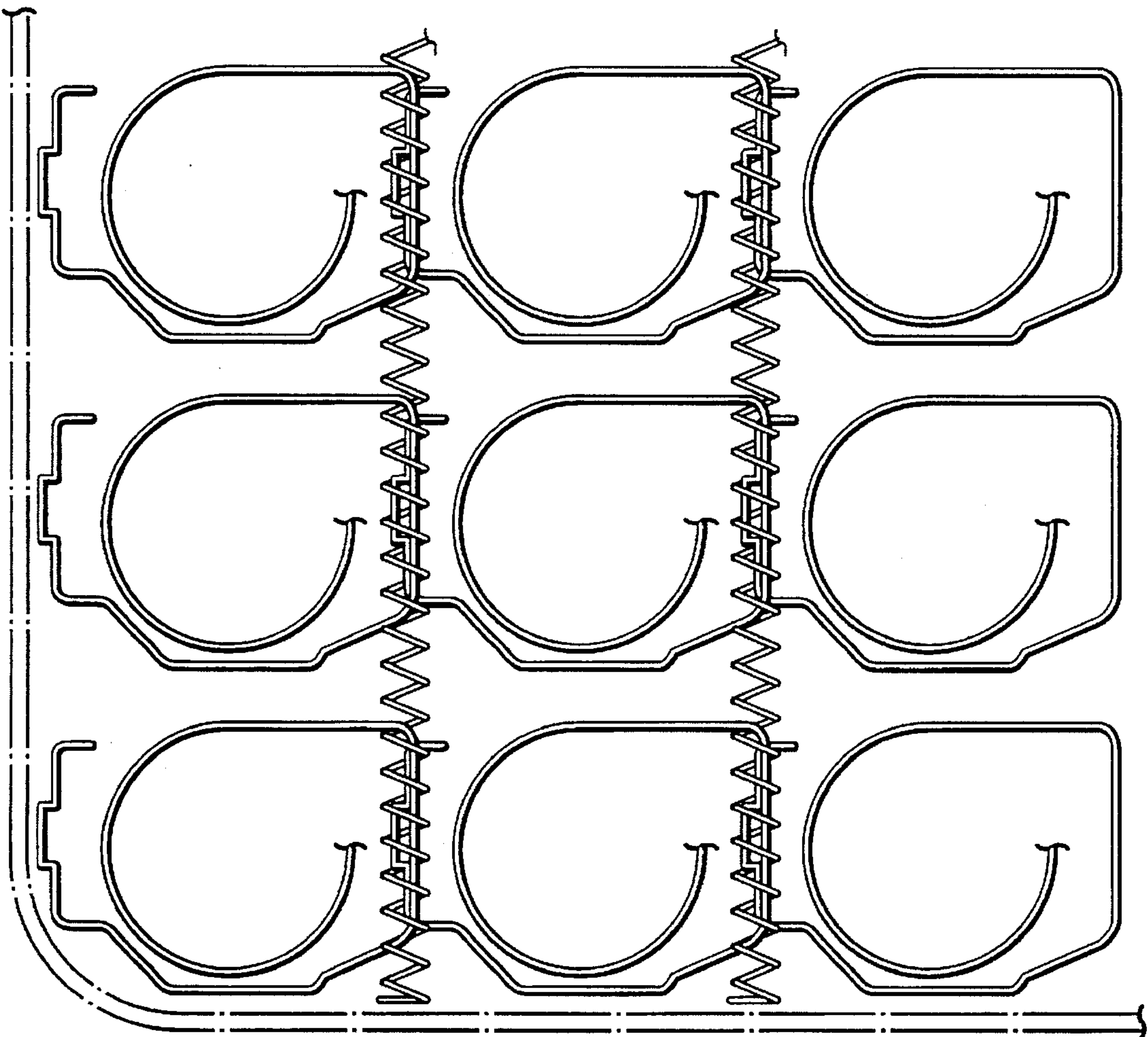

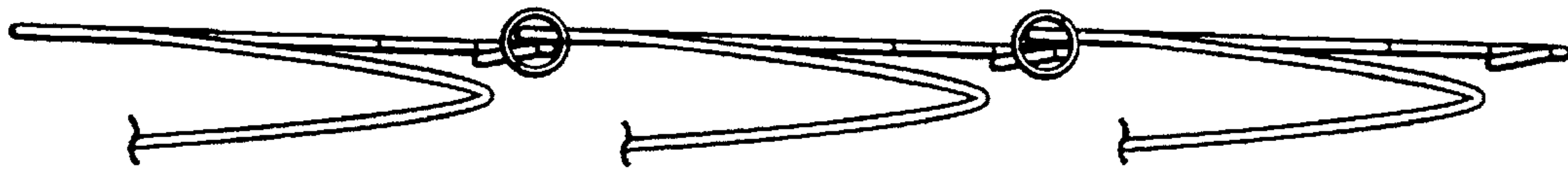
