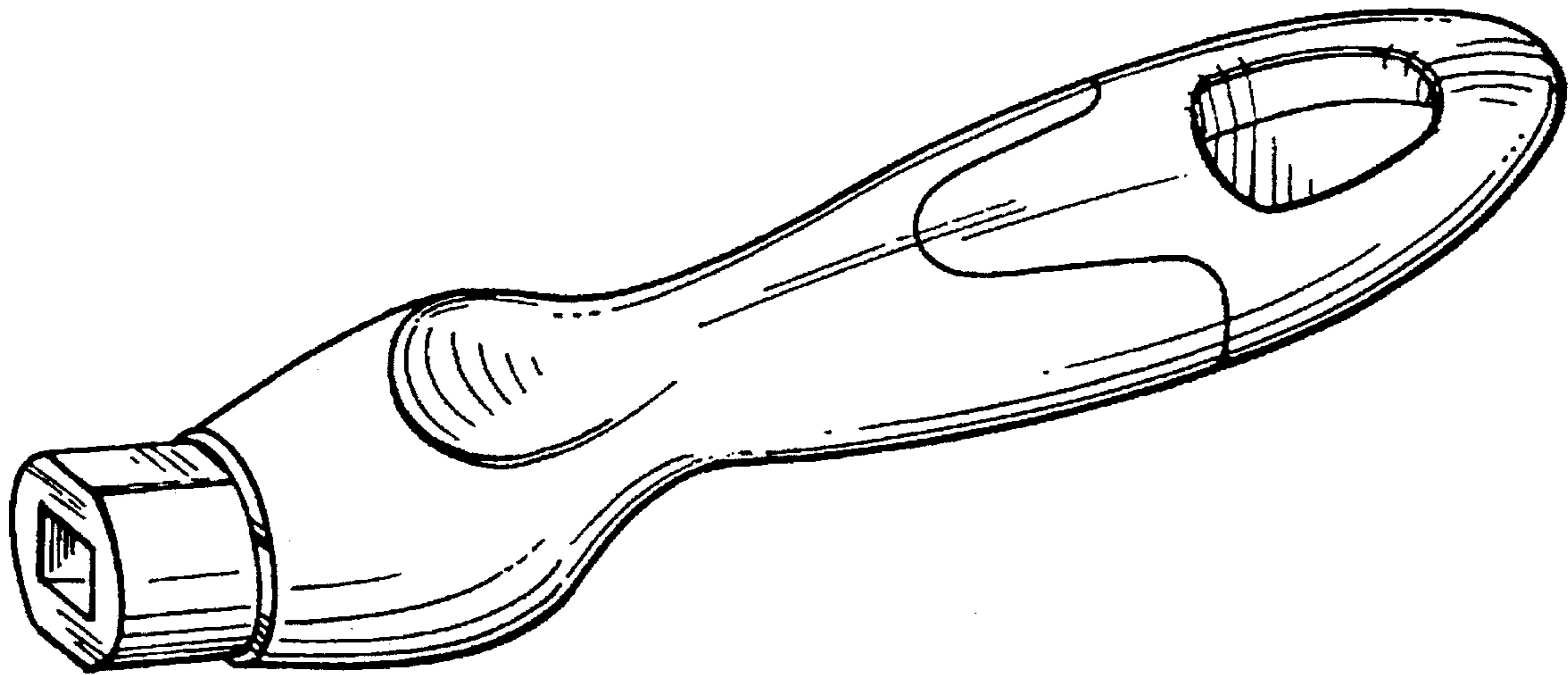
FIG. 6 is an enlarged rear end elevational view thereof.

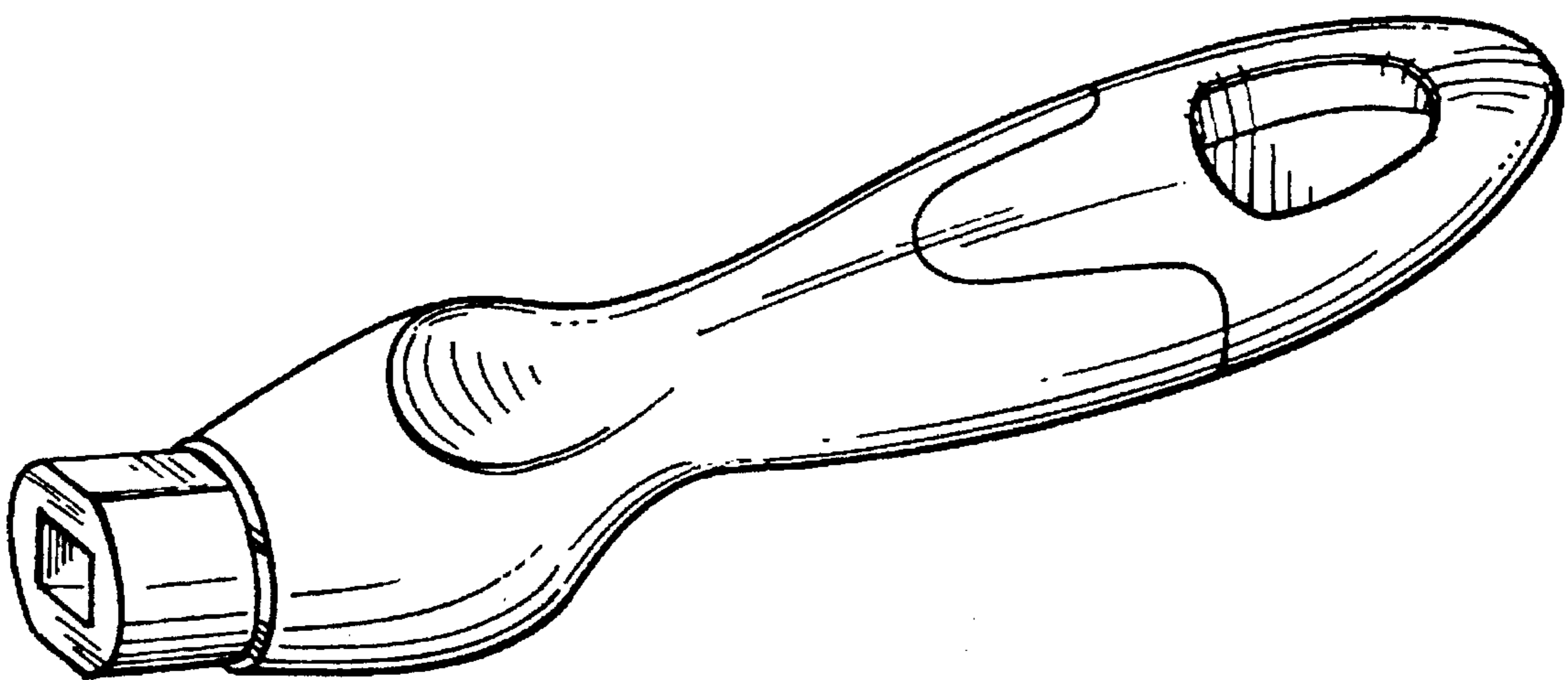

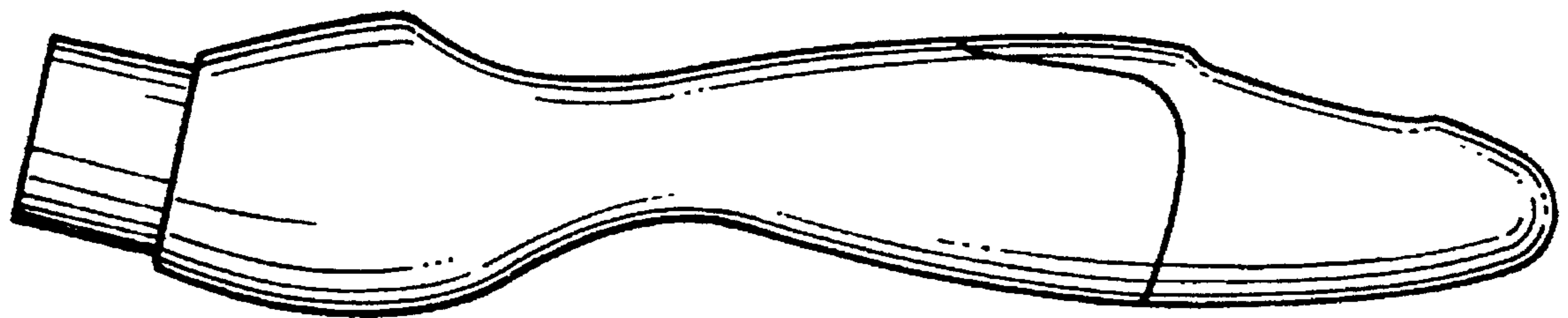

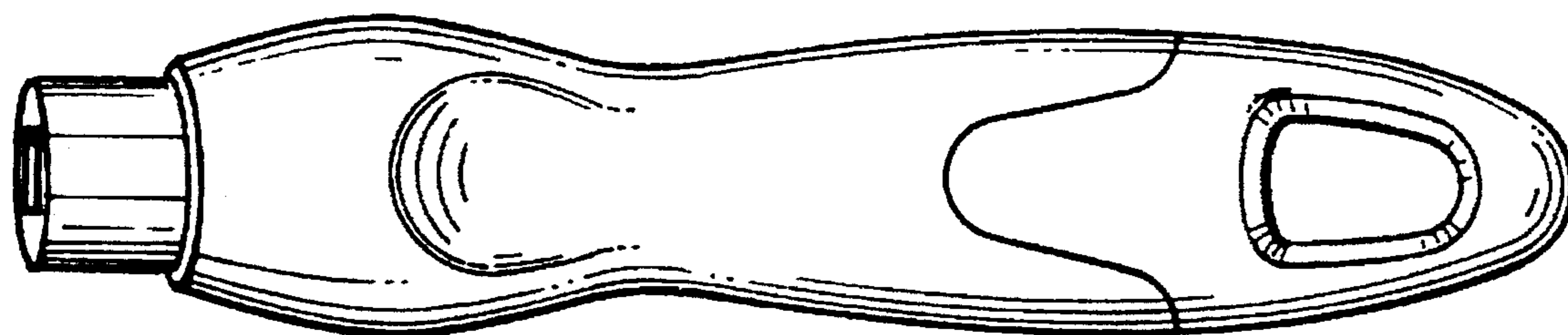

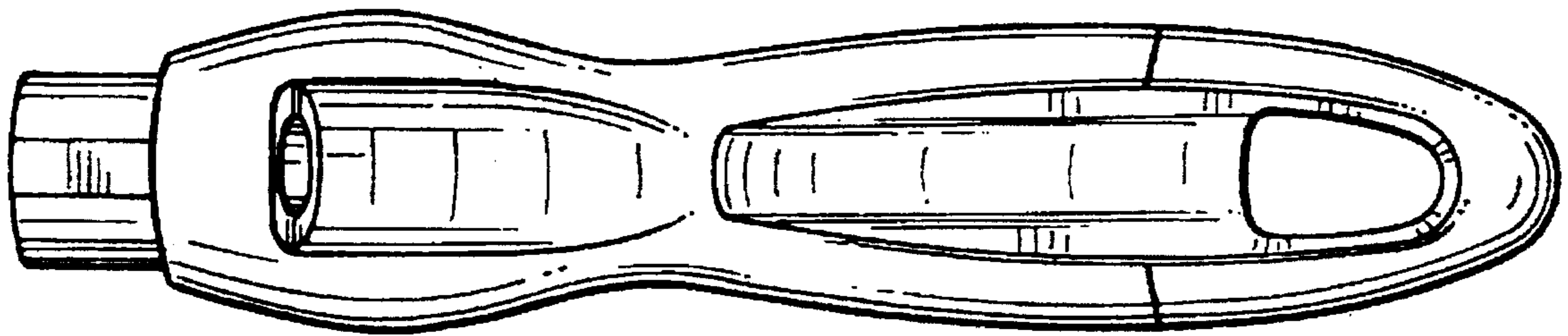

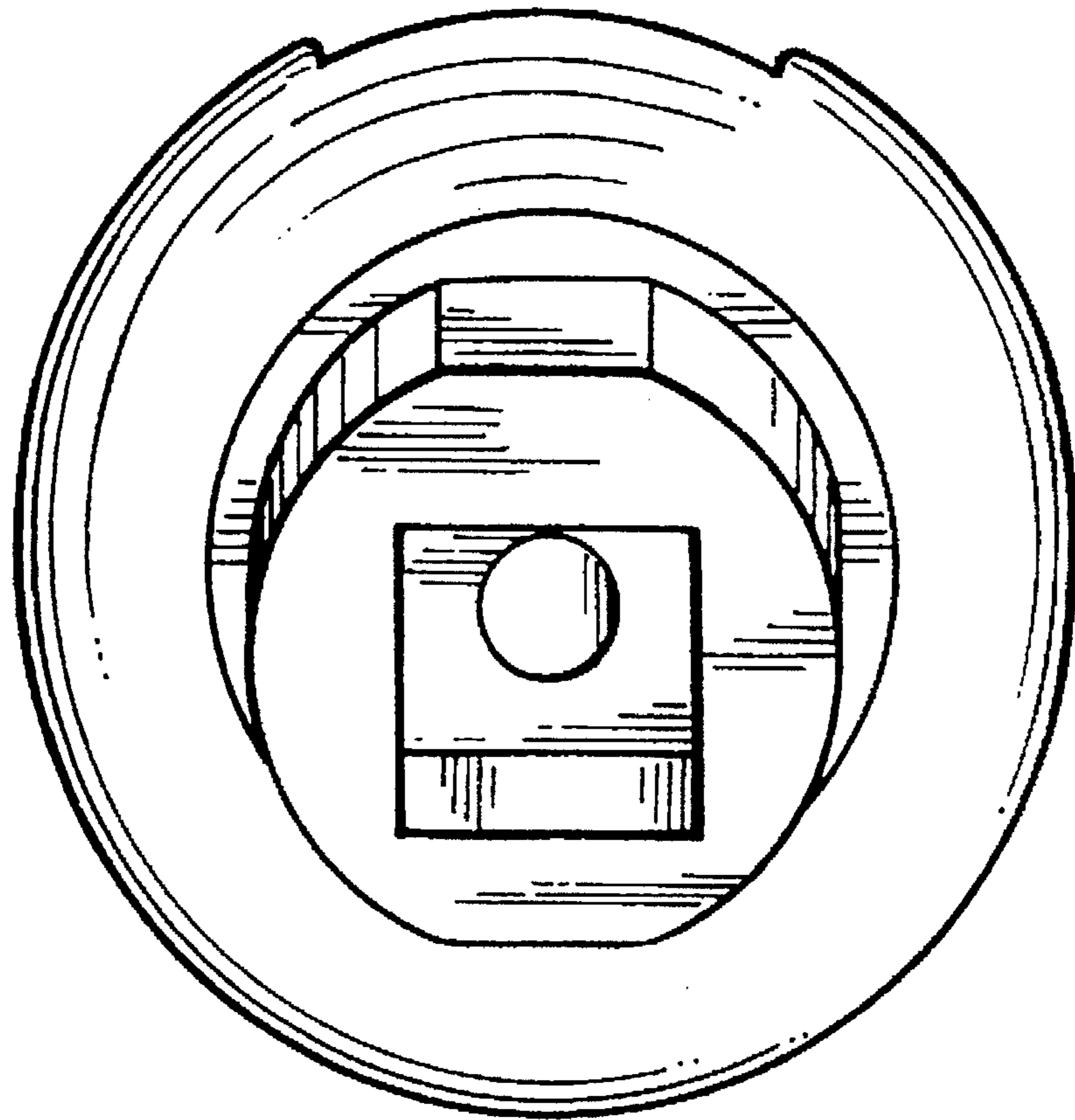

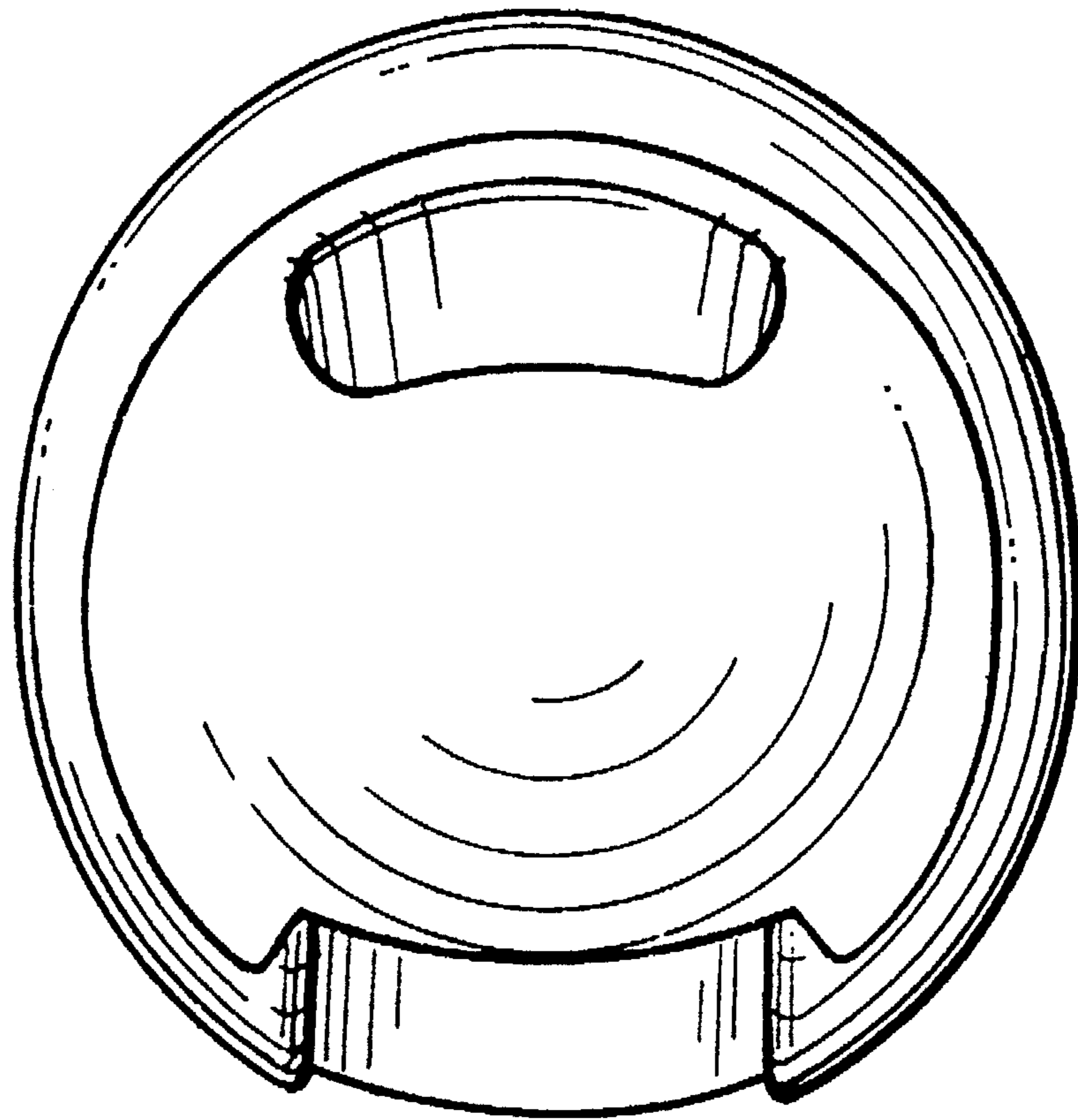
