FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a commemorative coin showing my new design;

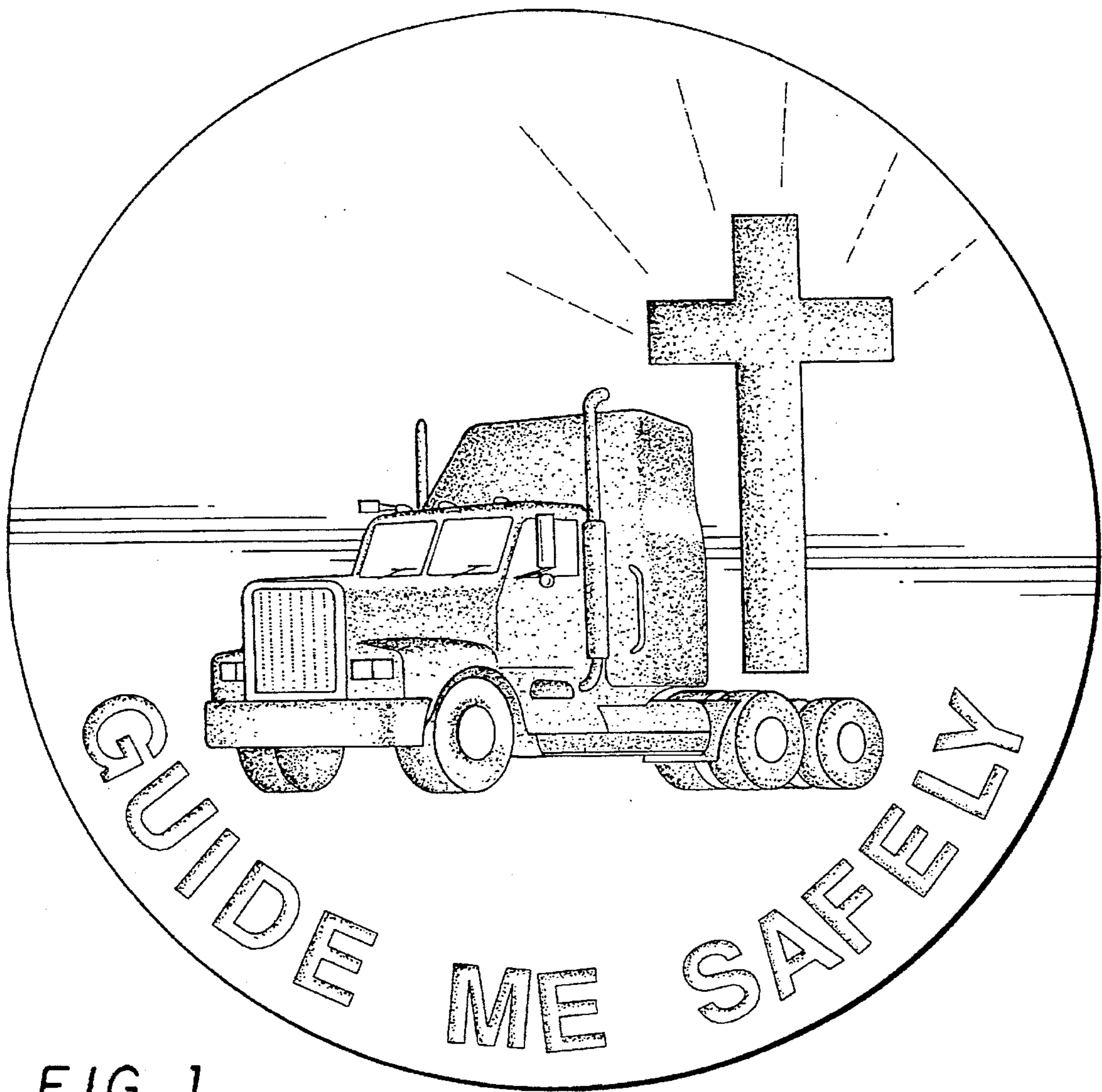

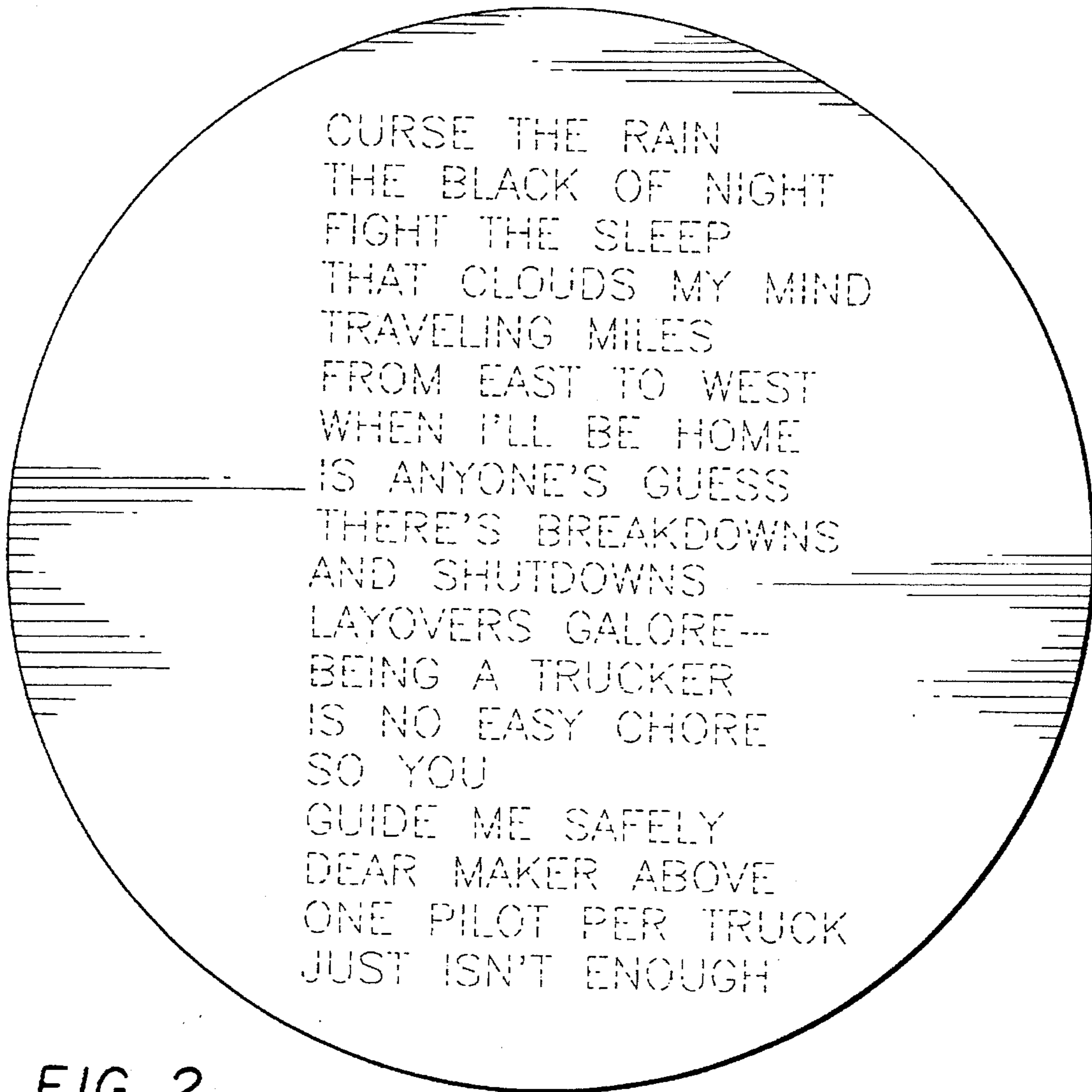
