#### CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sandal upper, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sandal upper showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view with the straps loosened;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view with the straps fastened;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of my second embodiment;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view with the straps loosened;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view with the straps fastened;

FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 12 is a right side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 13 is a front elevational view thereof; and,


FIG. 14 is a rear elevational view thereof.


The broken line showing of a sole in FIG. 1-14 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.




