[57] **CLAIM**

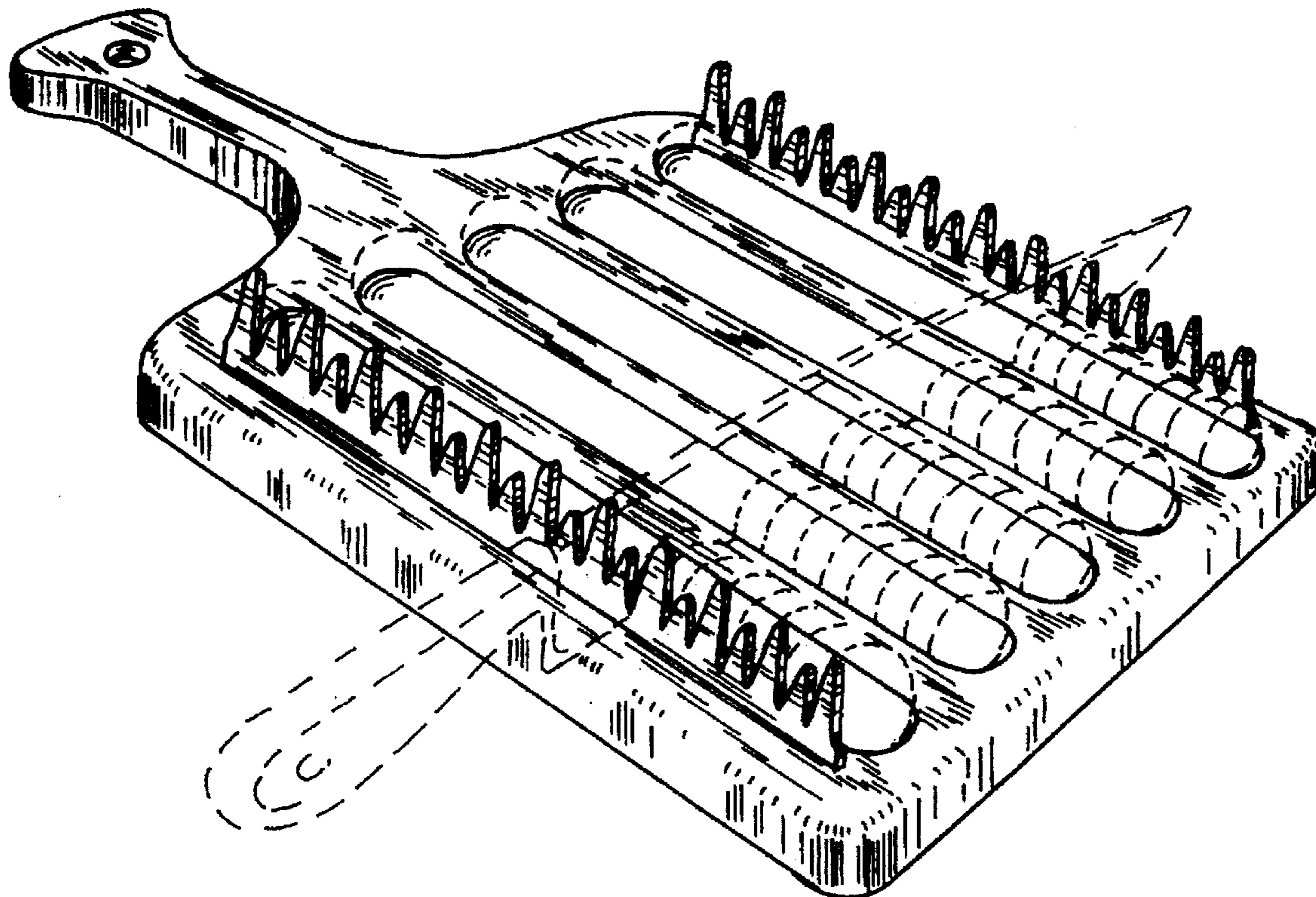
The ornamental design for a cutting board, as shown and

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a
cutting board showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an exploded top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

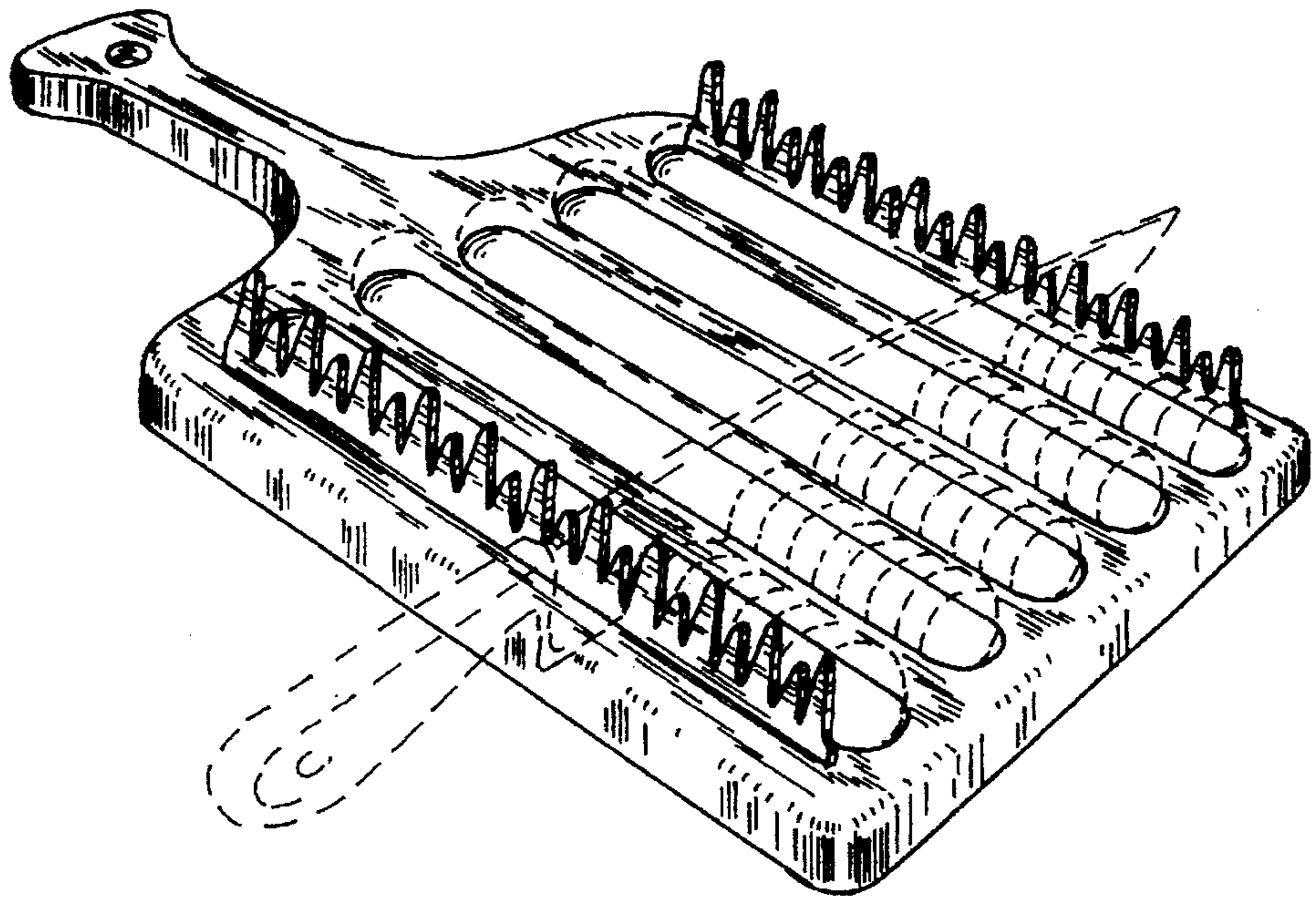

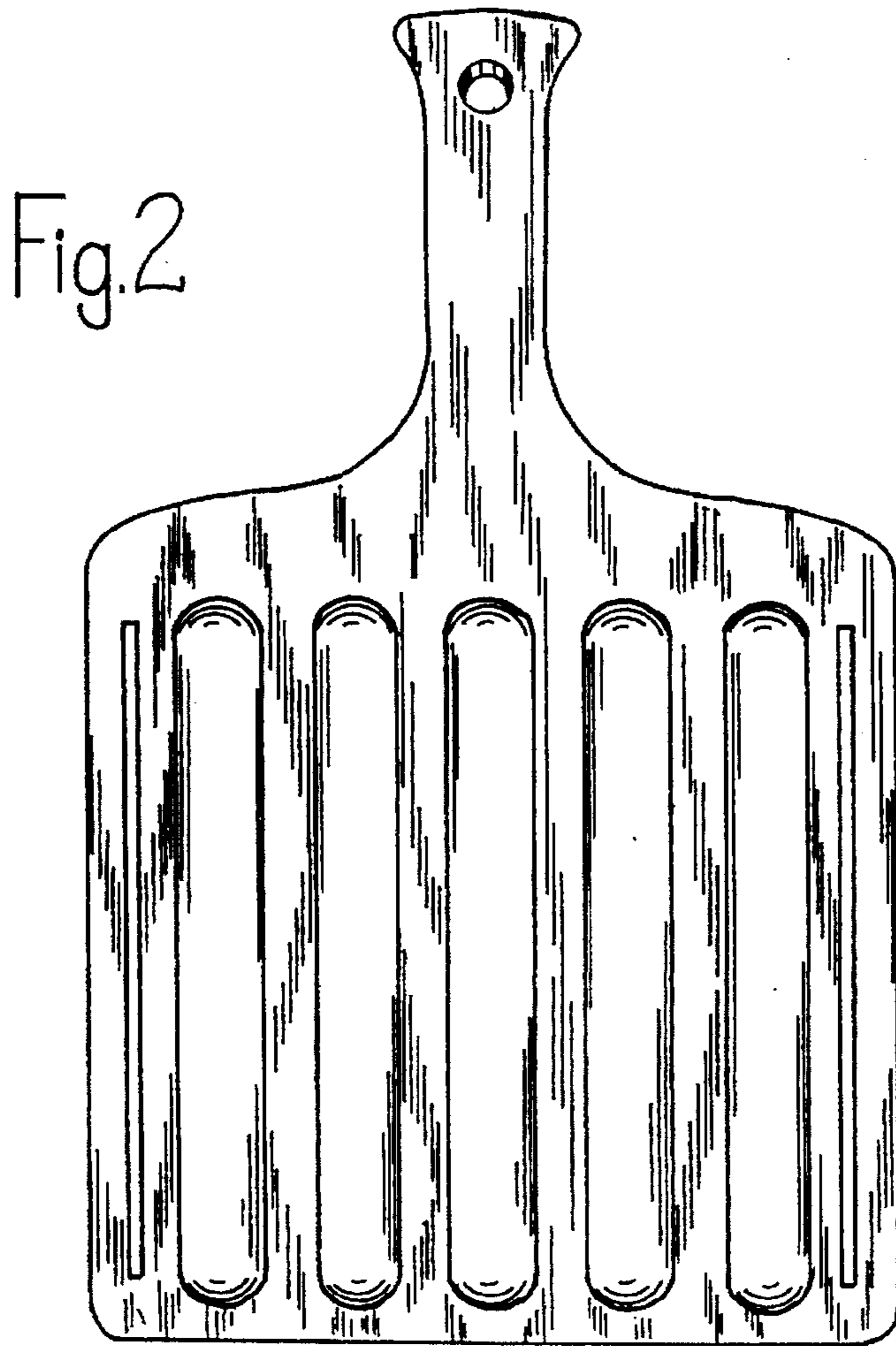

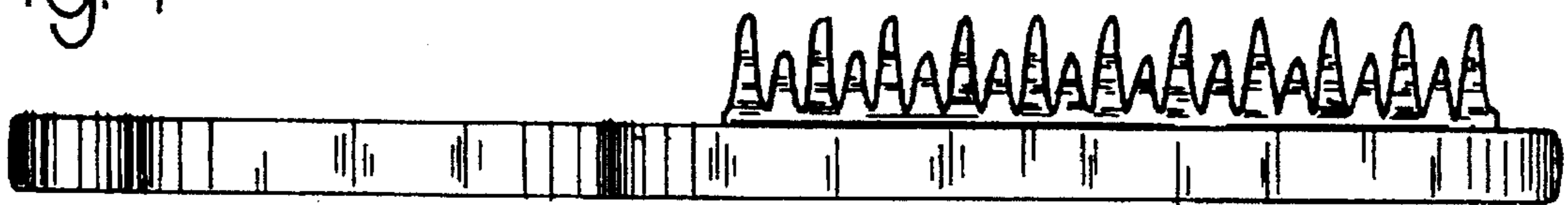

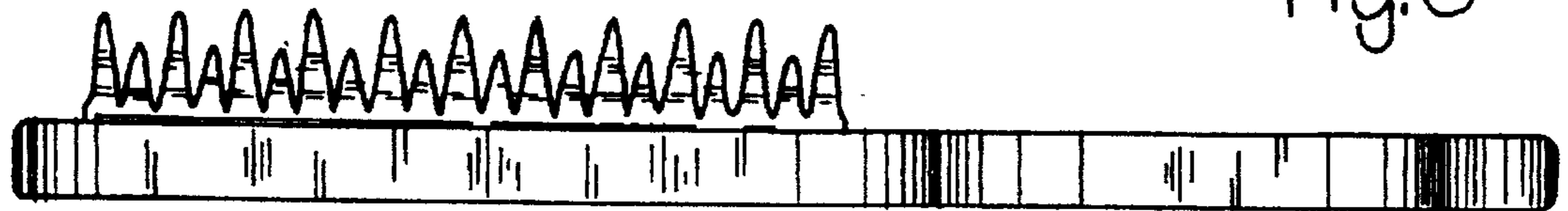
