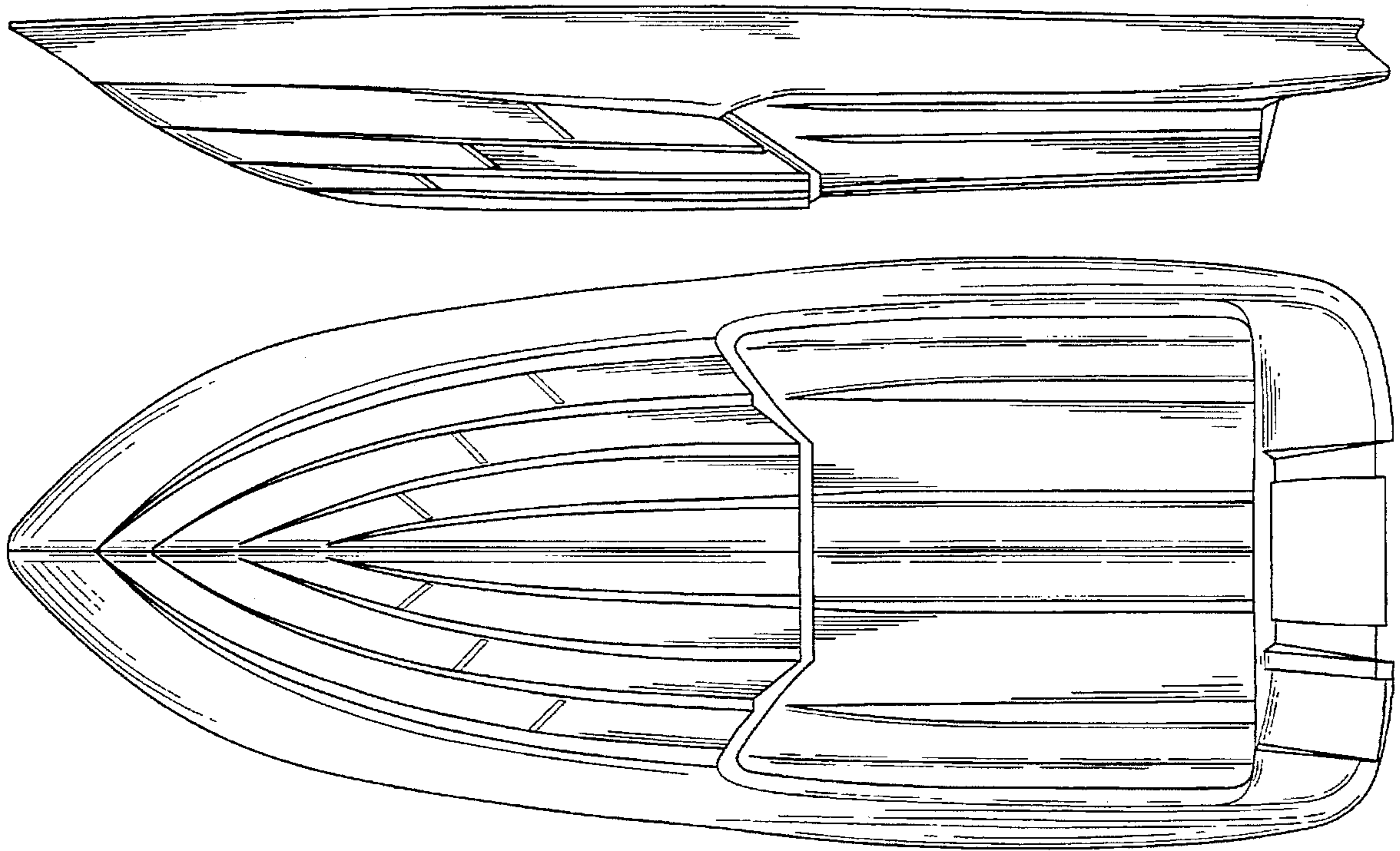
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a boat hull, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a boat hull in accordance with the invention;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the boat hull design;
FIG. 3 is a top view showing the hollow inside of the boat hull design;
FIG. 4 is a front view, showing the stem of the boat hull design;
FIG. 5 is a rear view, showing the stern of the boat hull design; and,
FIG. 6 is a perspective rear view, showing a stern end of the boat hull design.

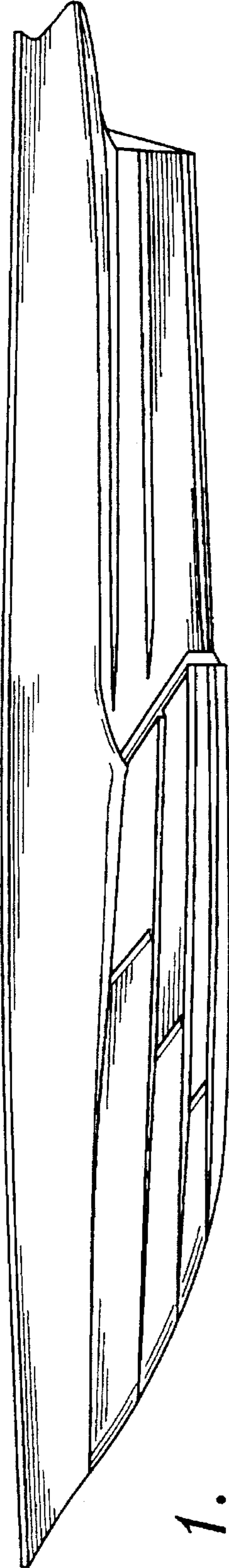

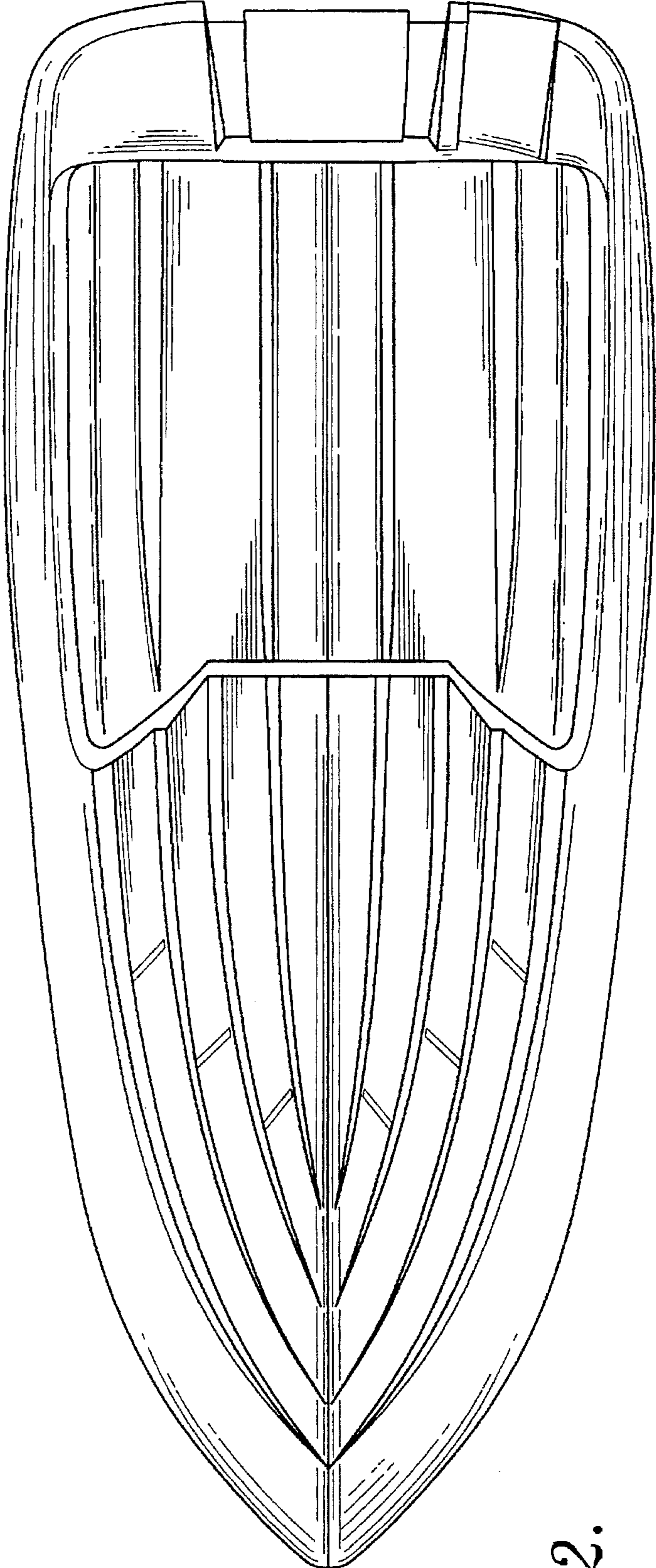

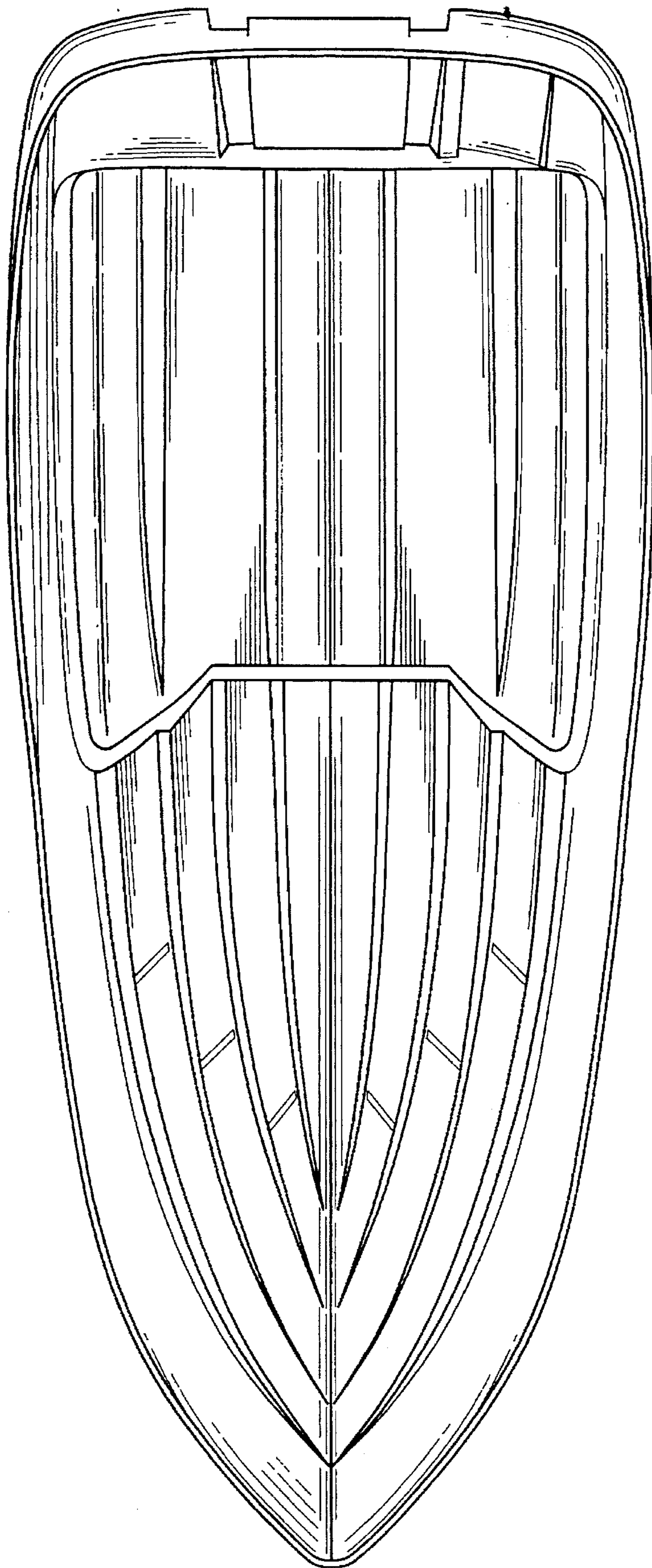

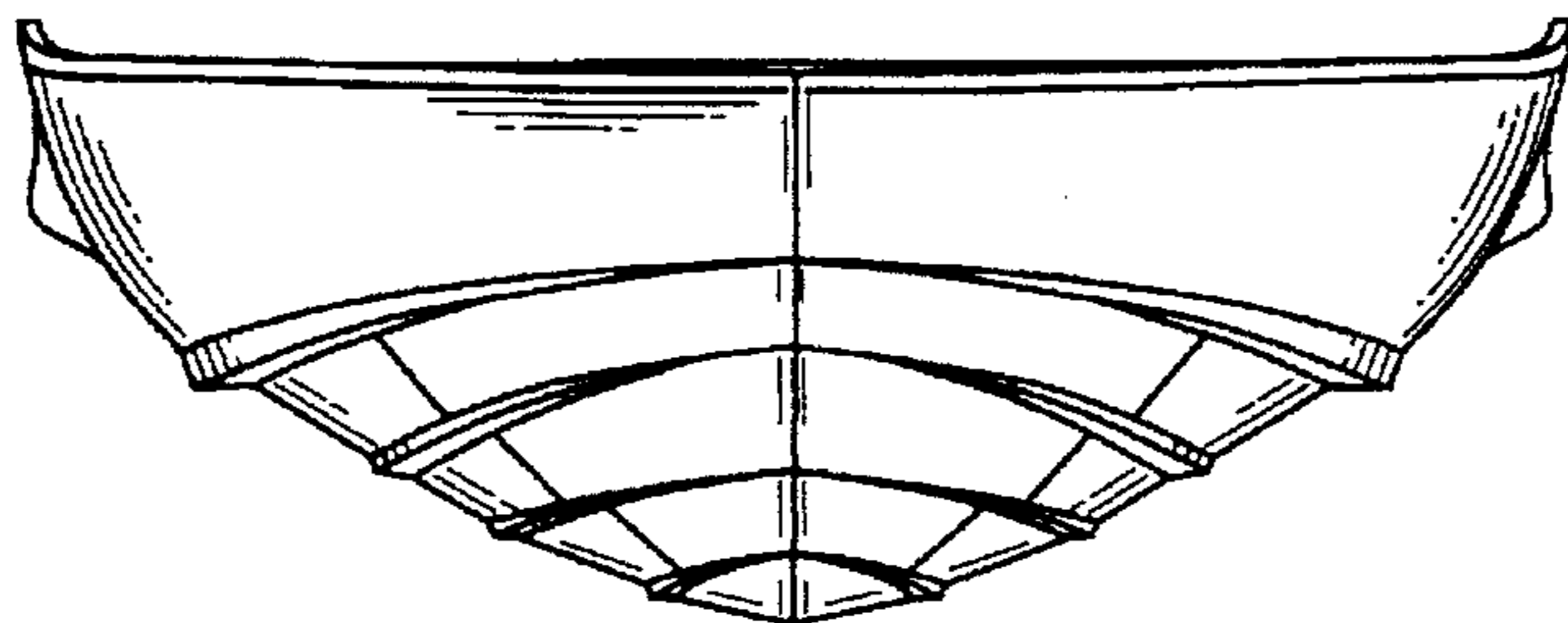

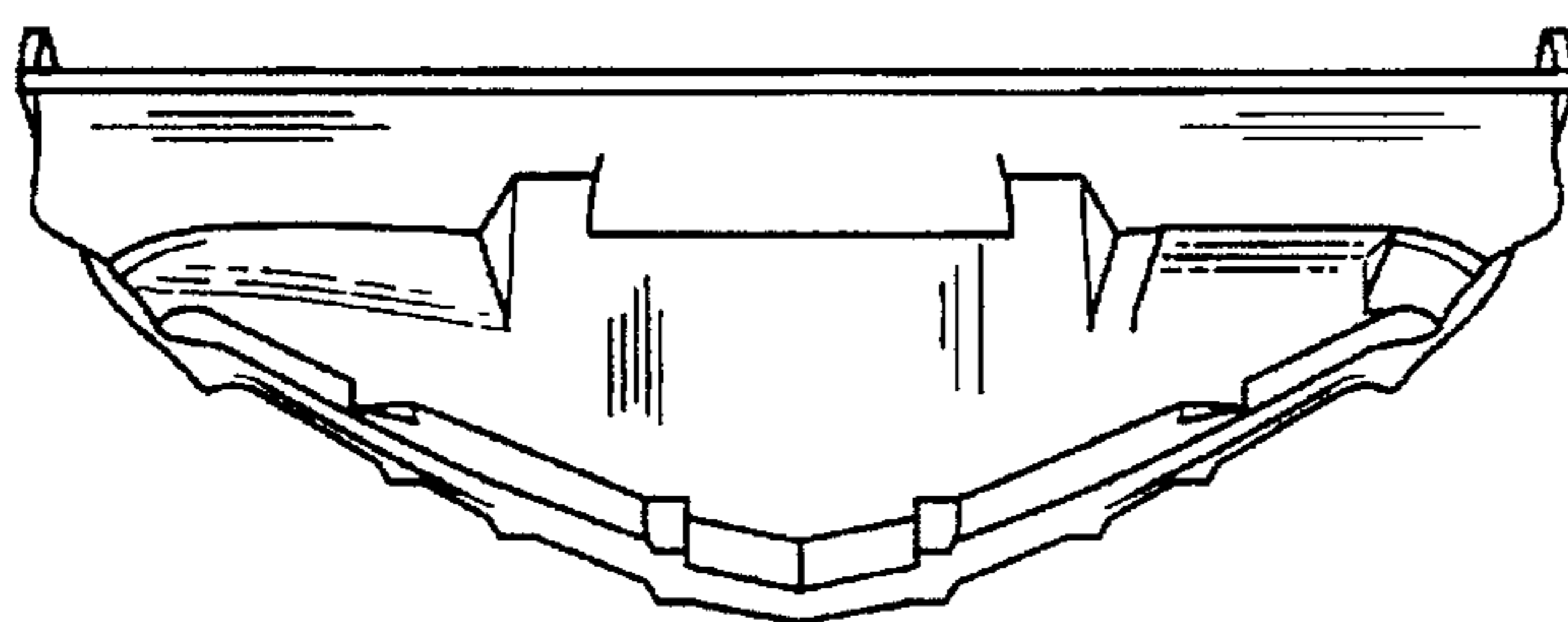

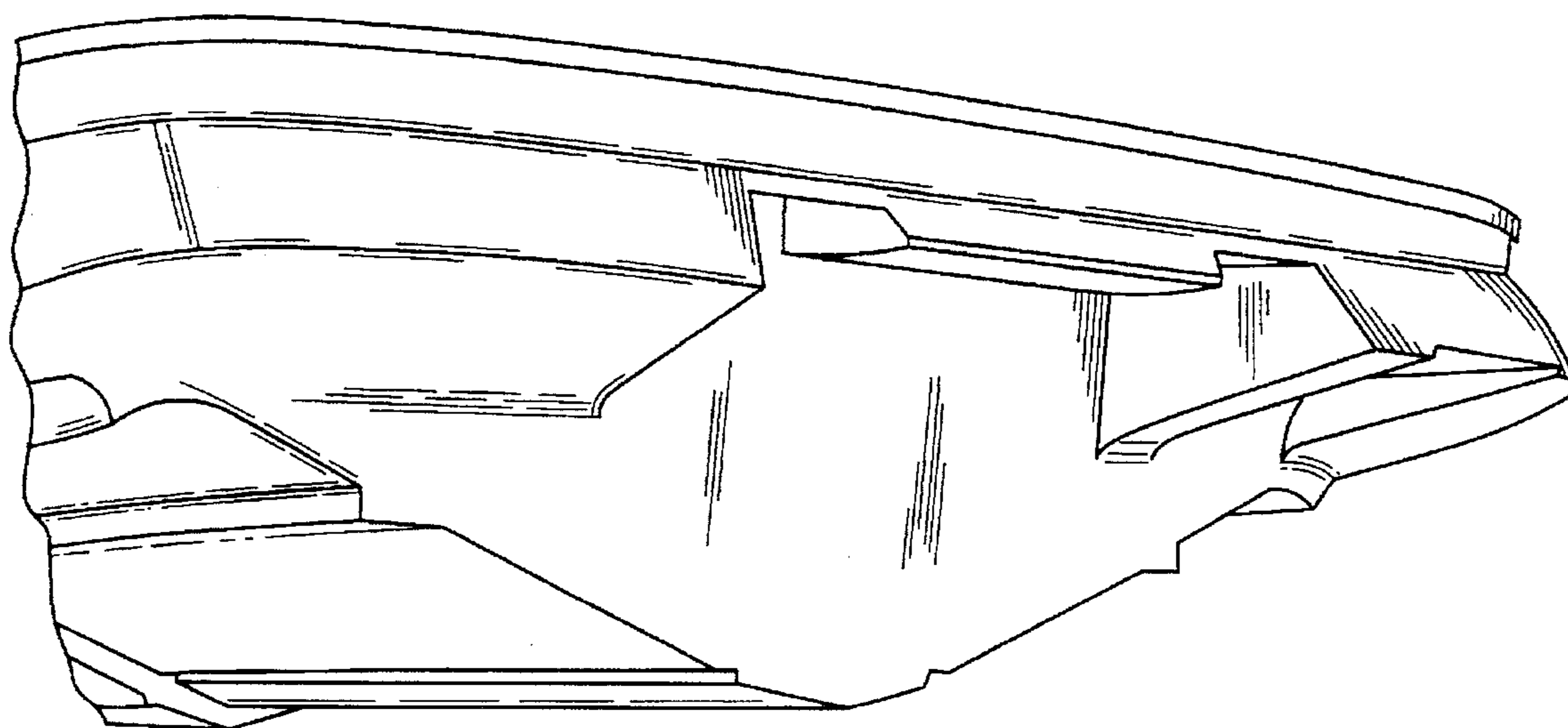
