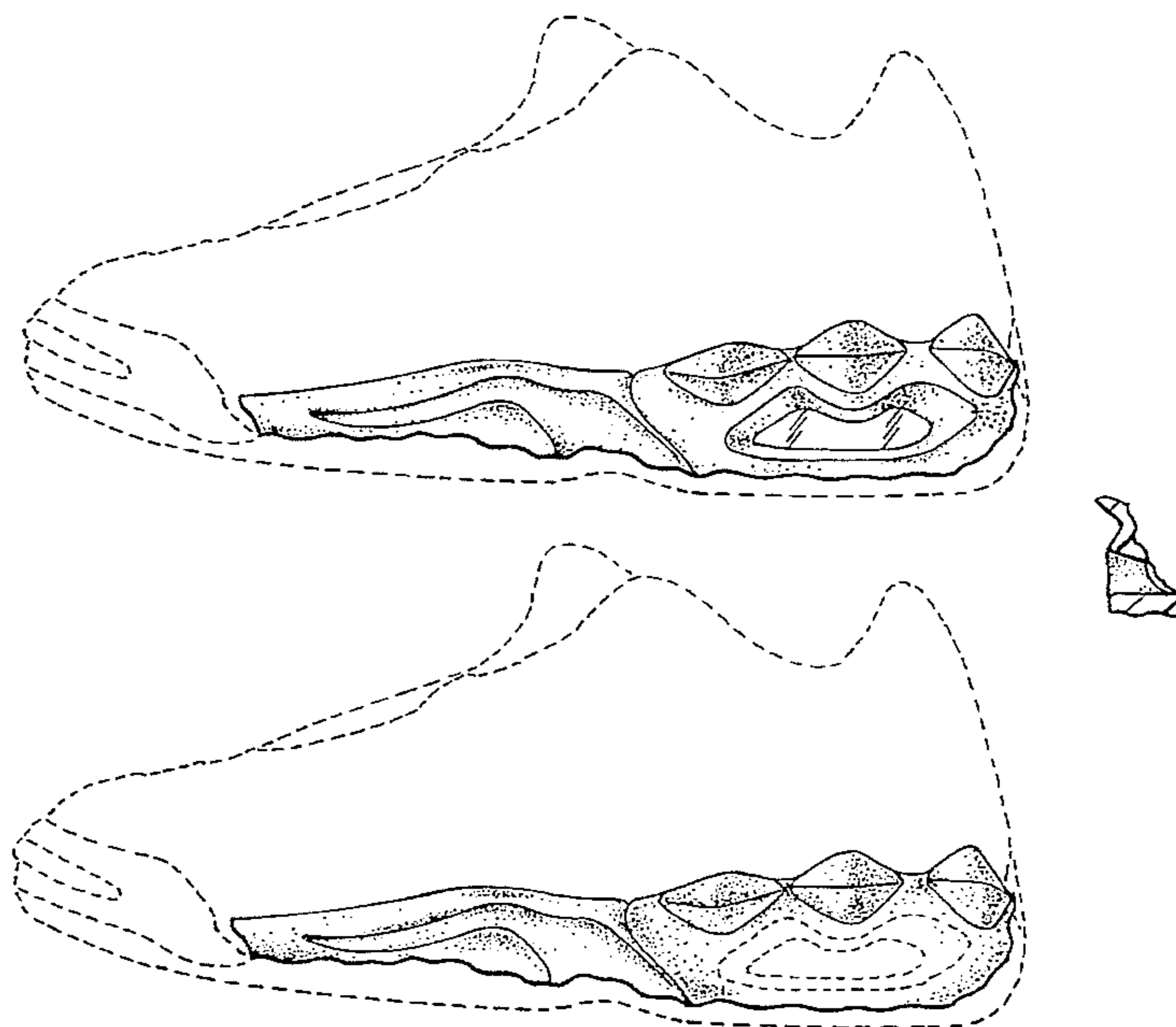
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an element of a shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an element of shoe sole showing a first embodiment of my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 4;
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 6—6 of FIG. 4;
FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment of my new design;
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof.
The broken line showing of a shoe in FIGS. 1-4 and 7-10 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

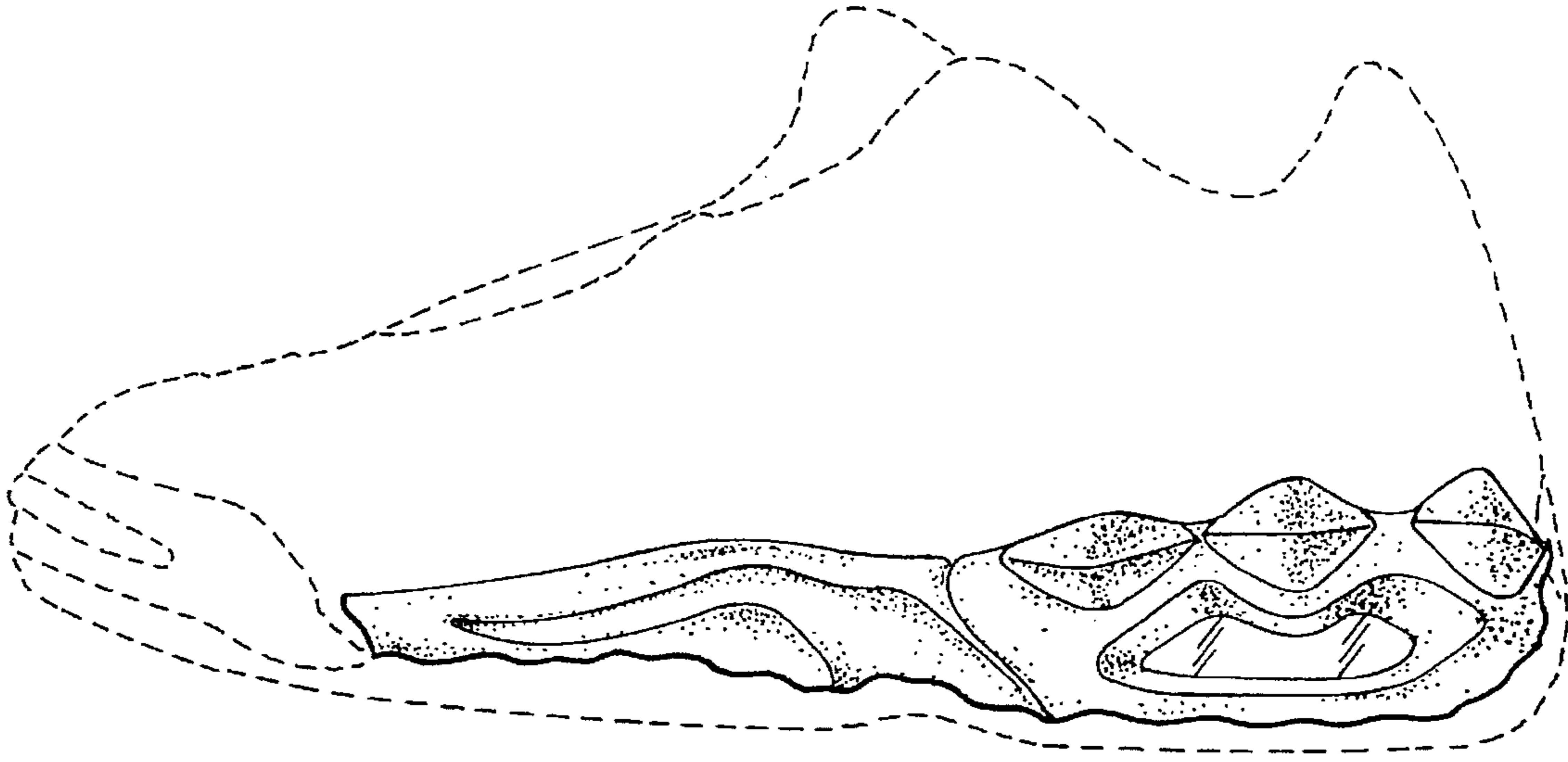

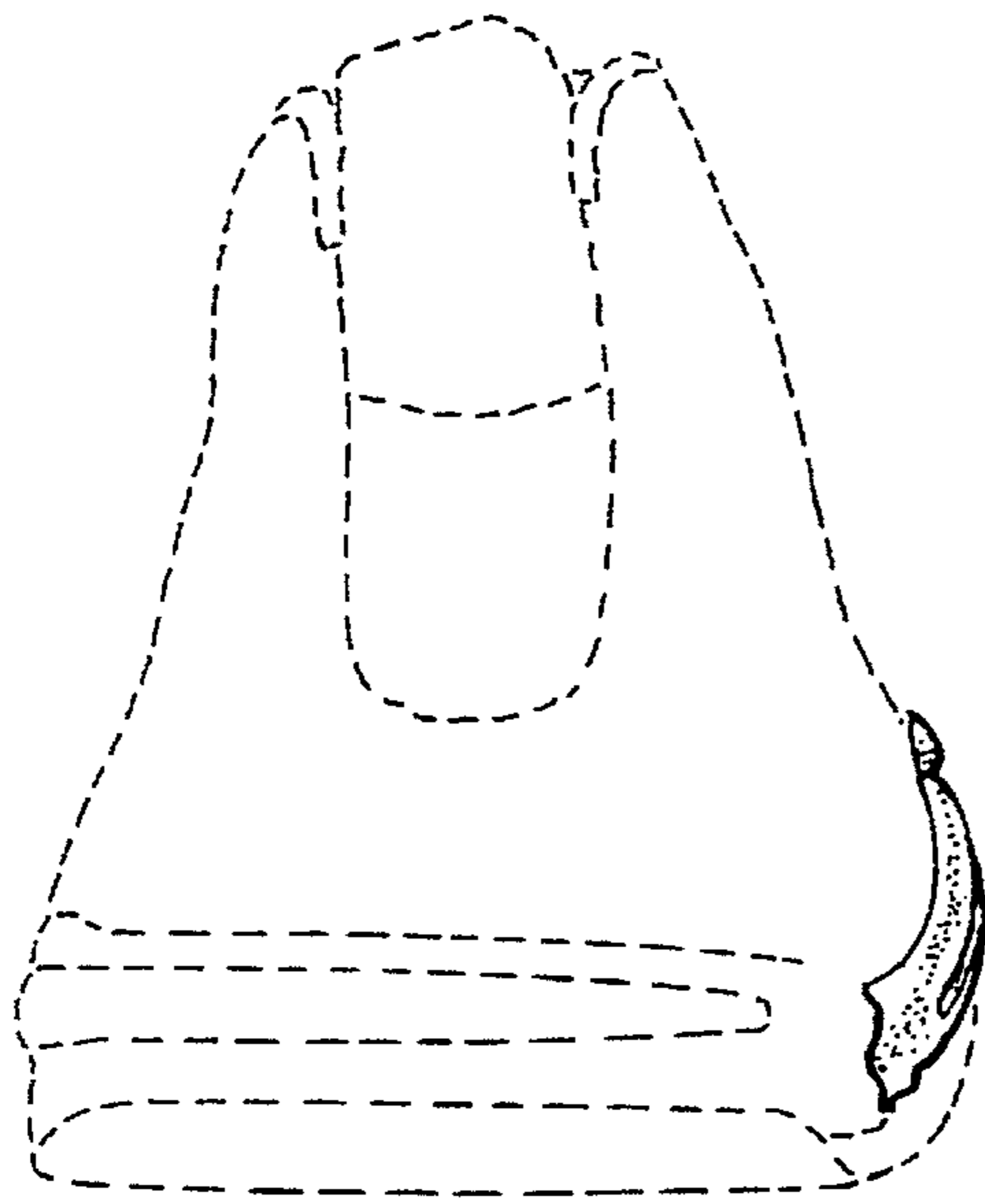

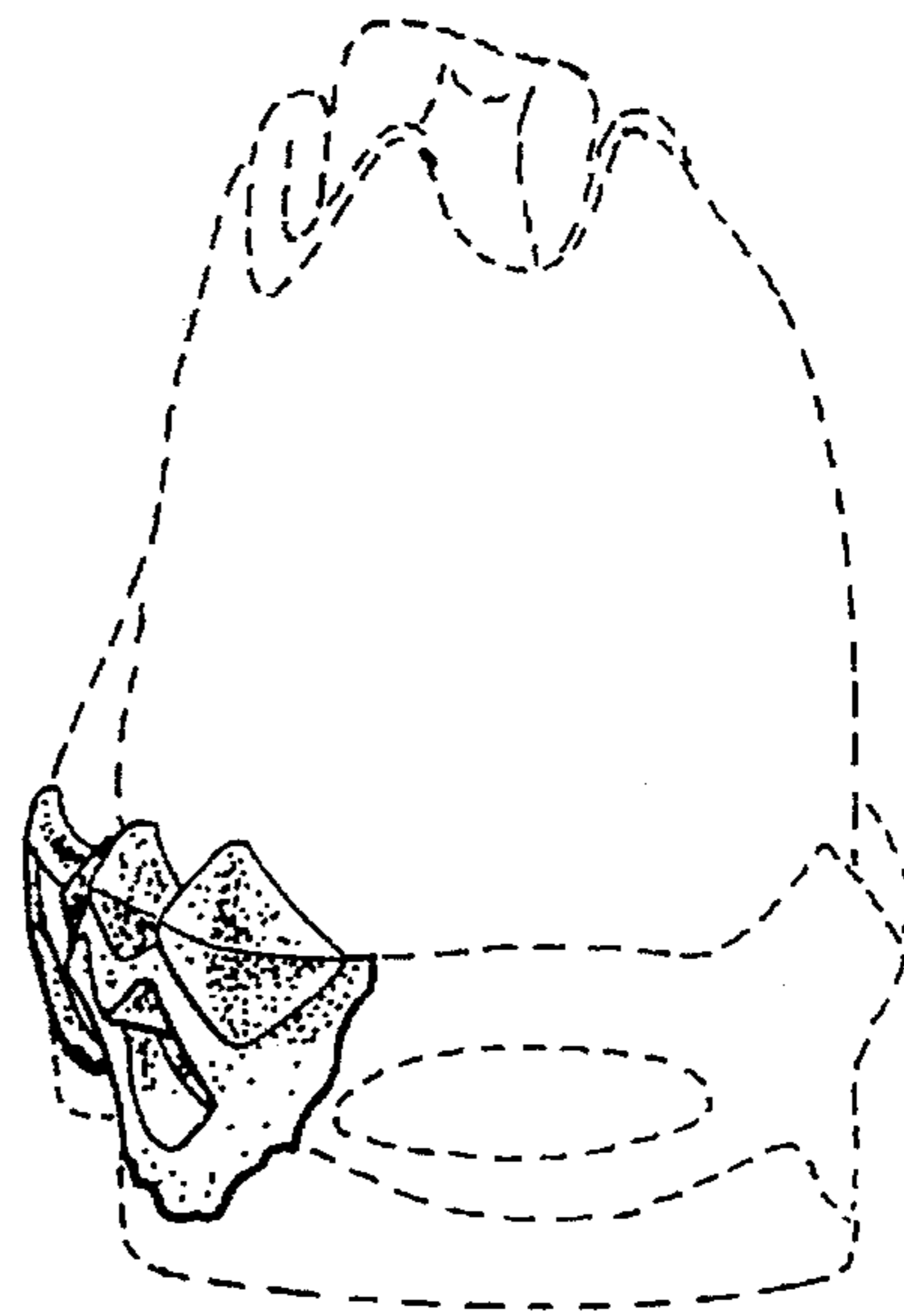

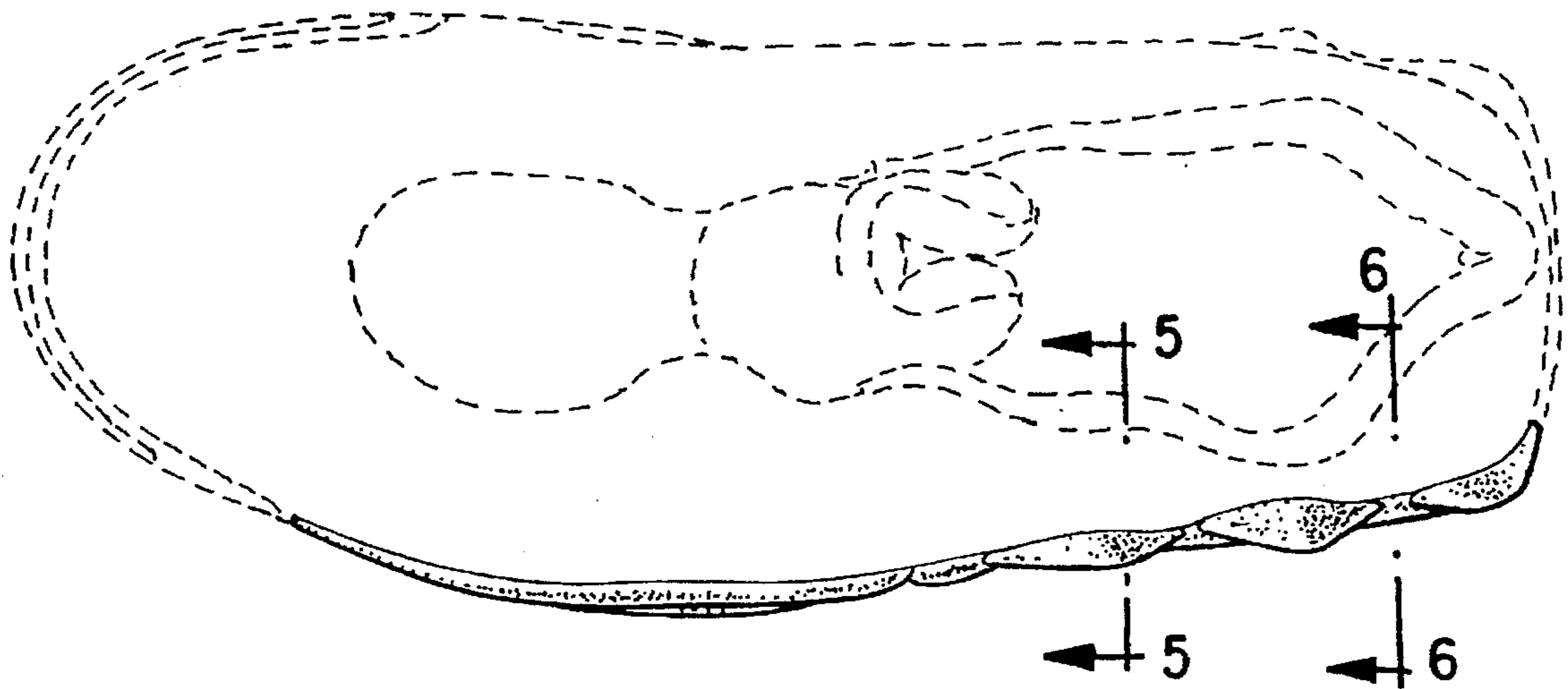

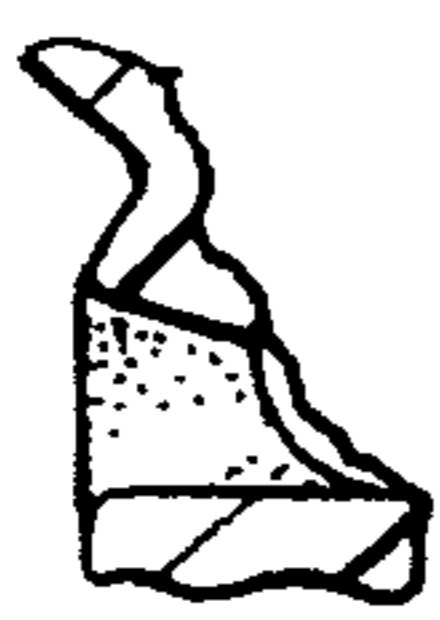

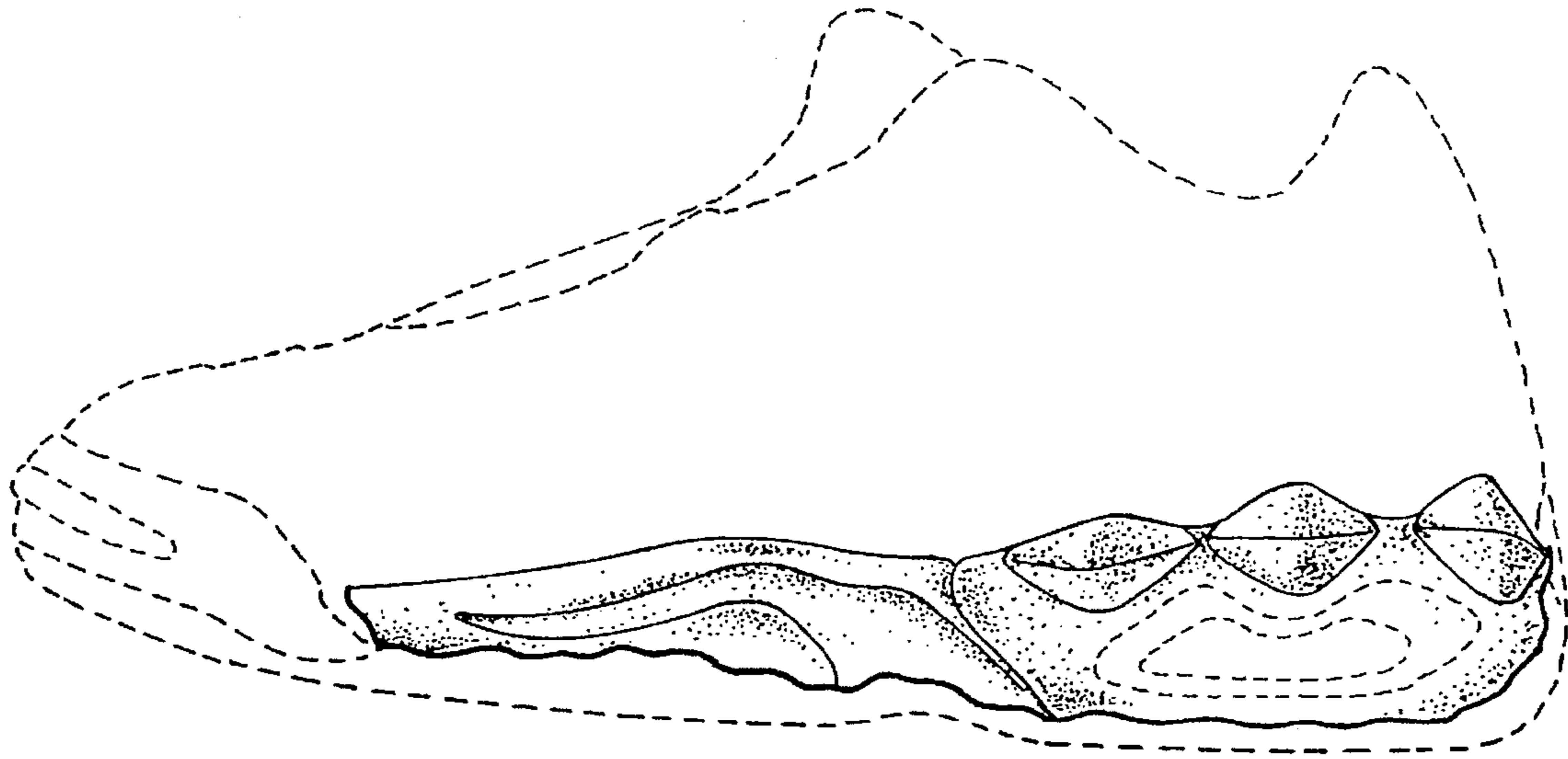

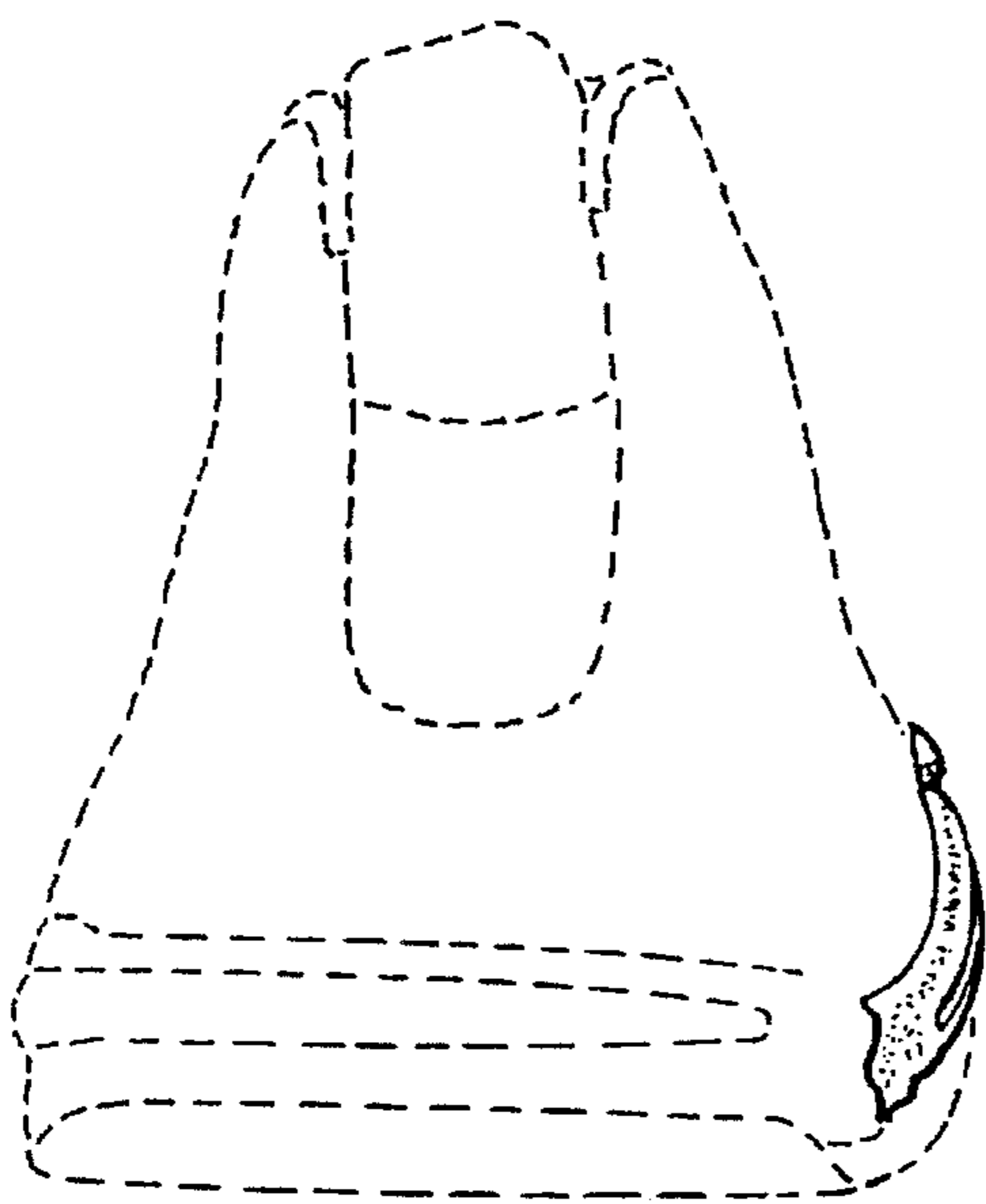

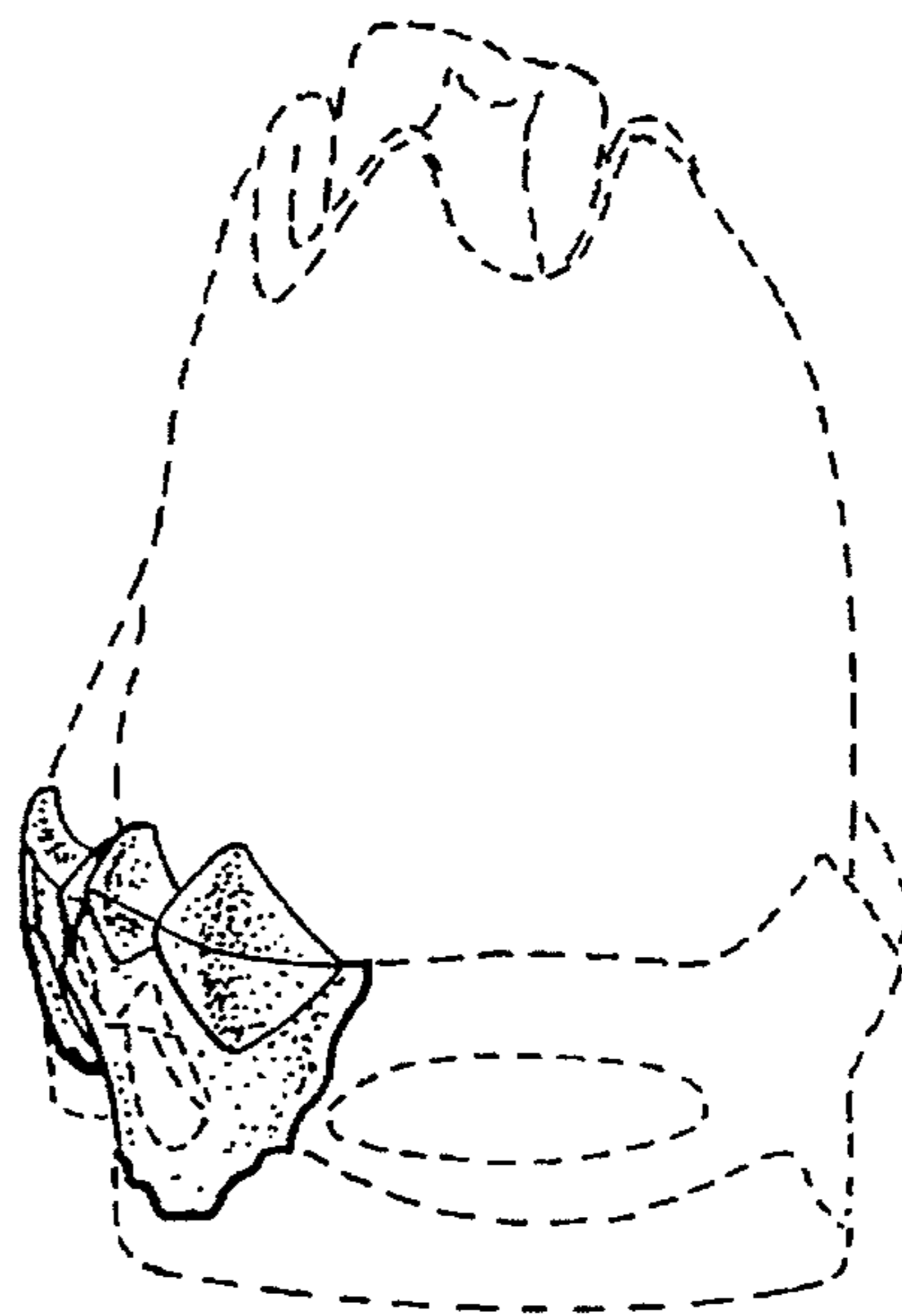

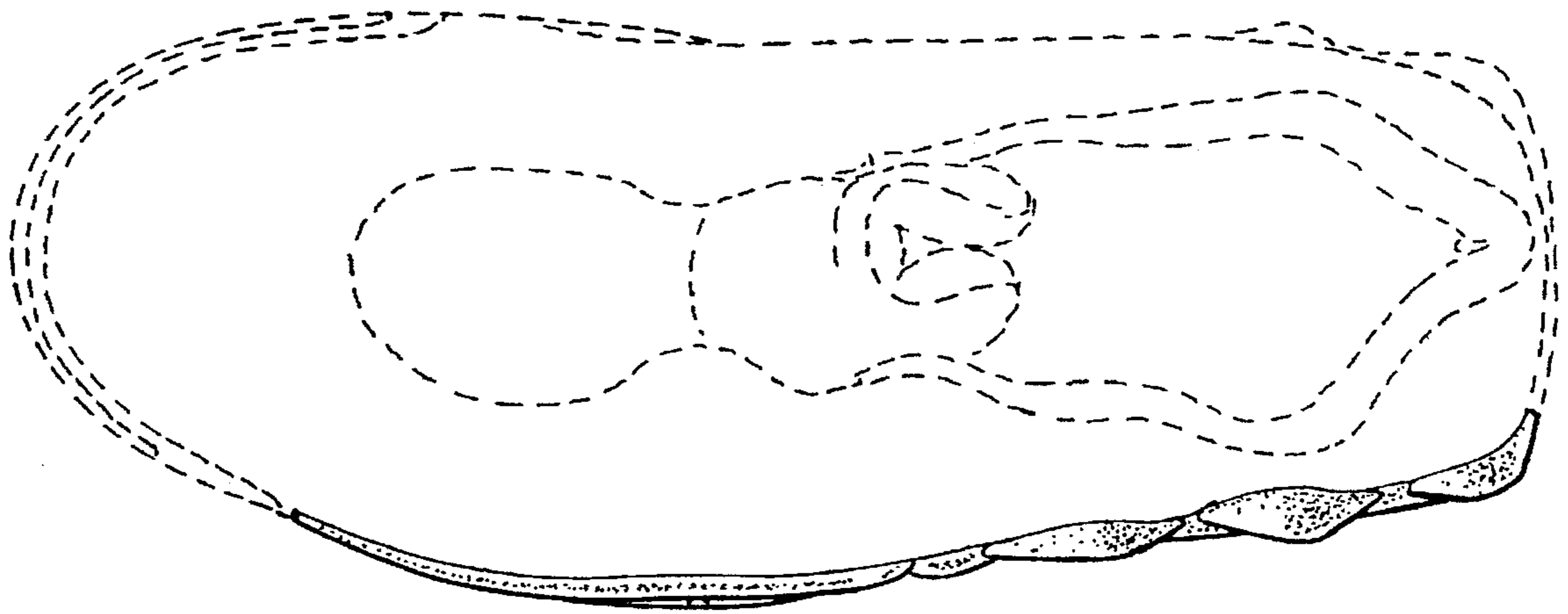
