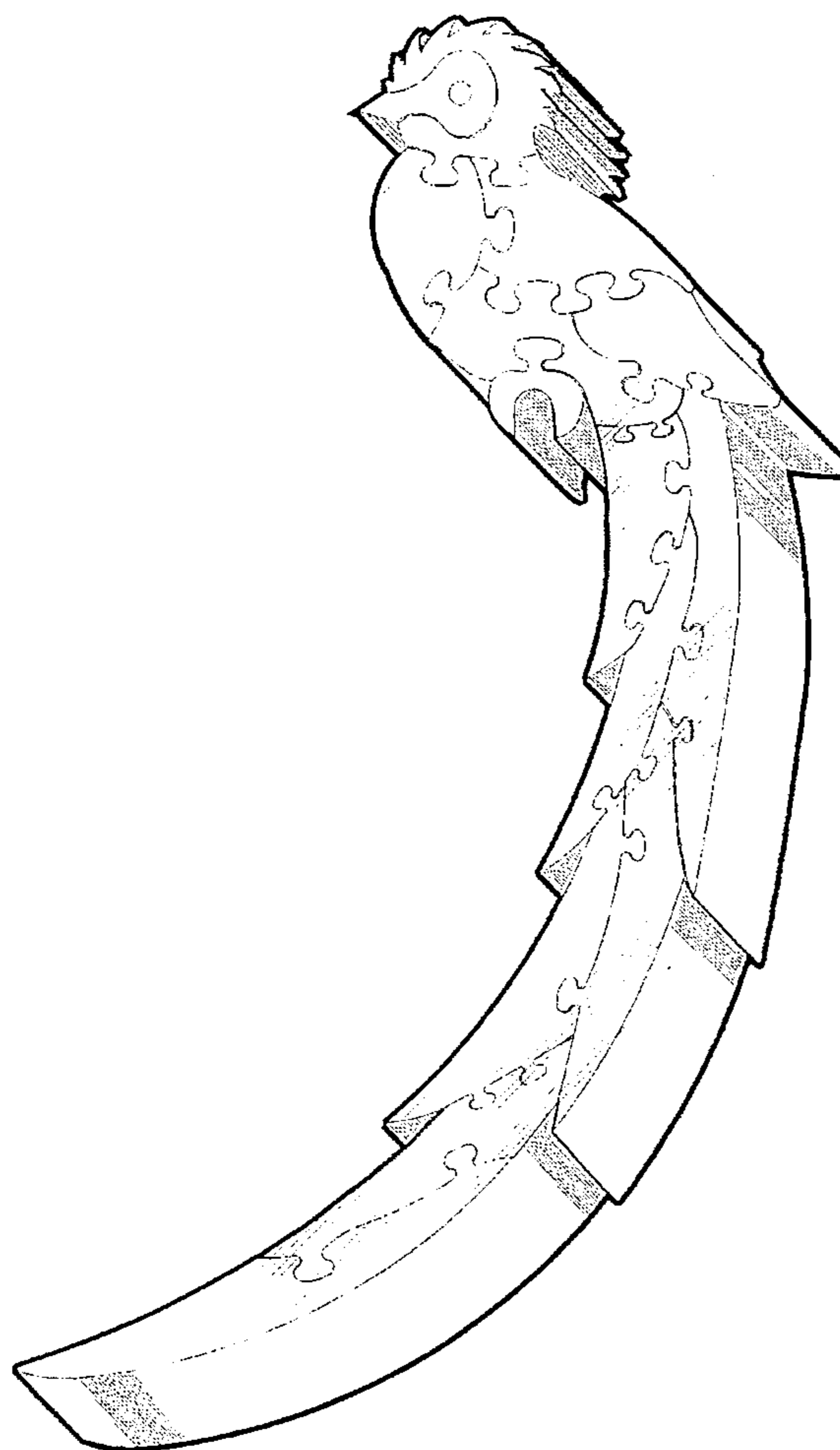
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a resplendent quetzal jigsaw puzzle sculpture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a resplendent quetzal jigsaw puzzle sculpture showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,
 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.

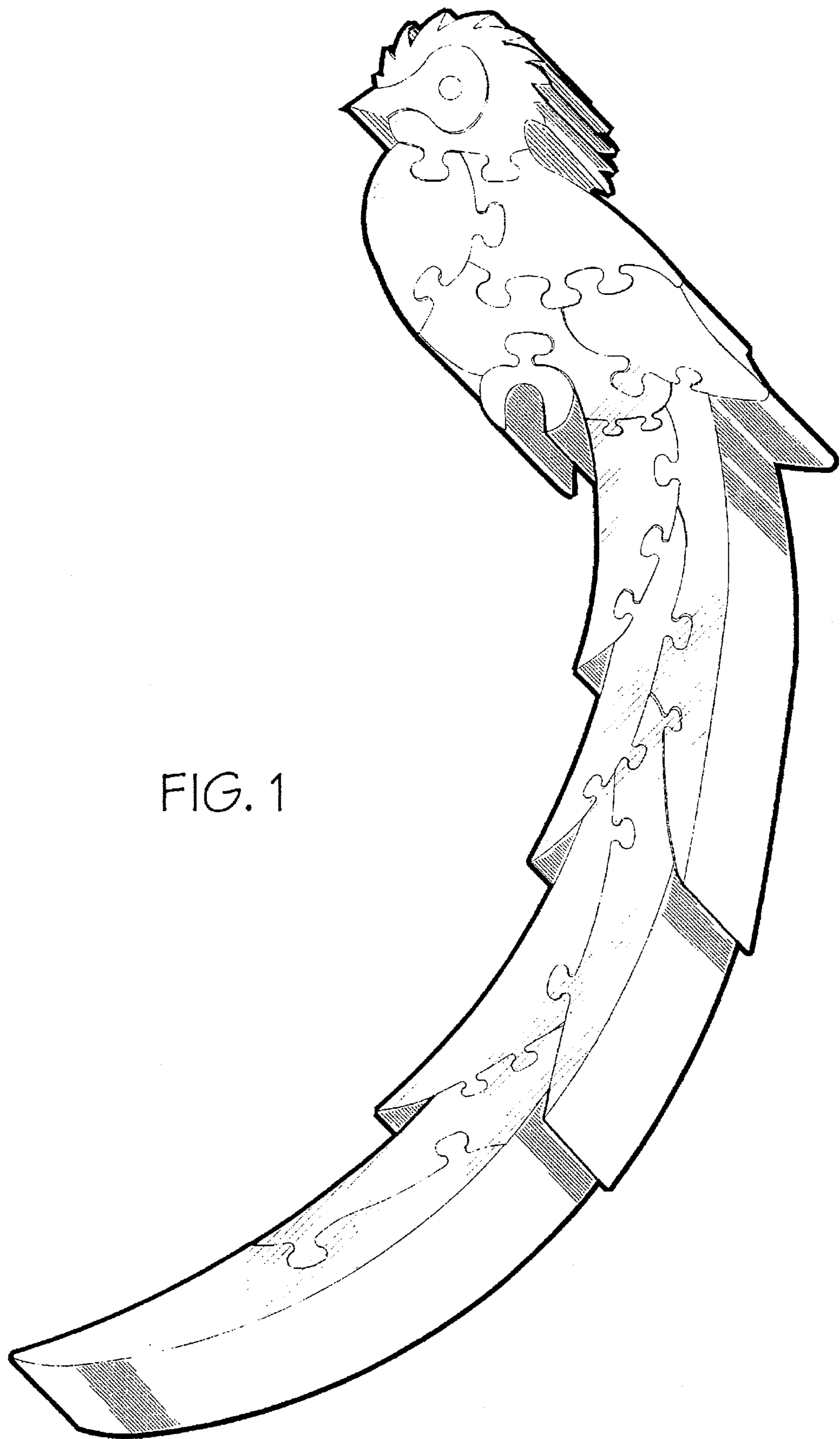

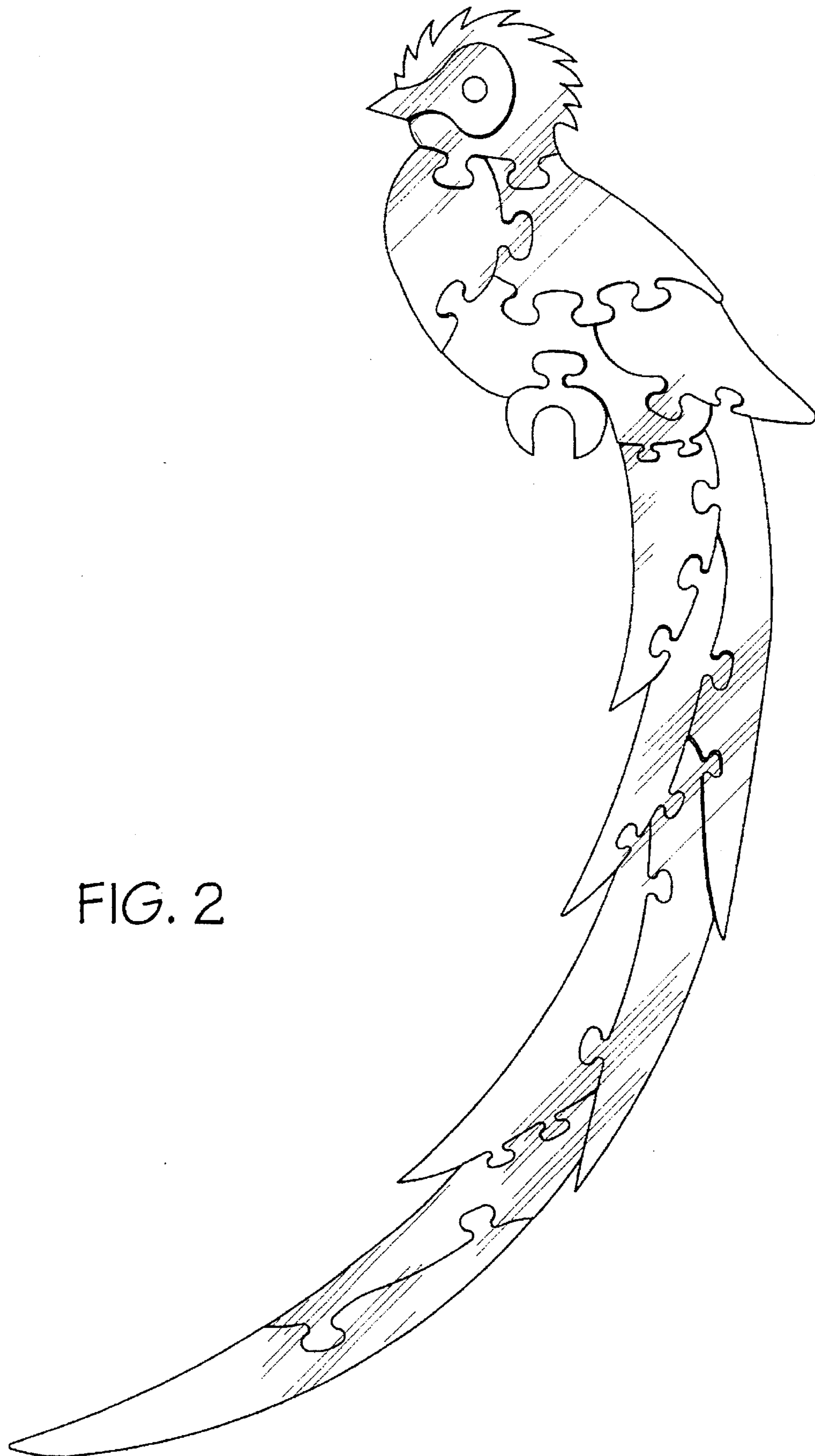

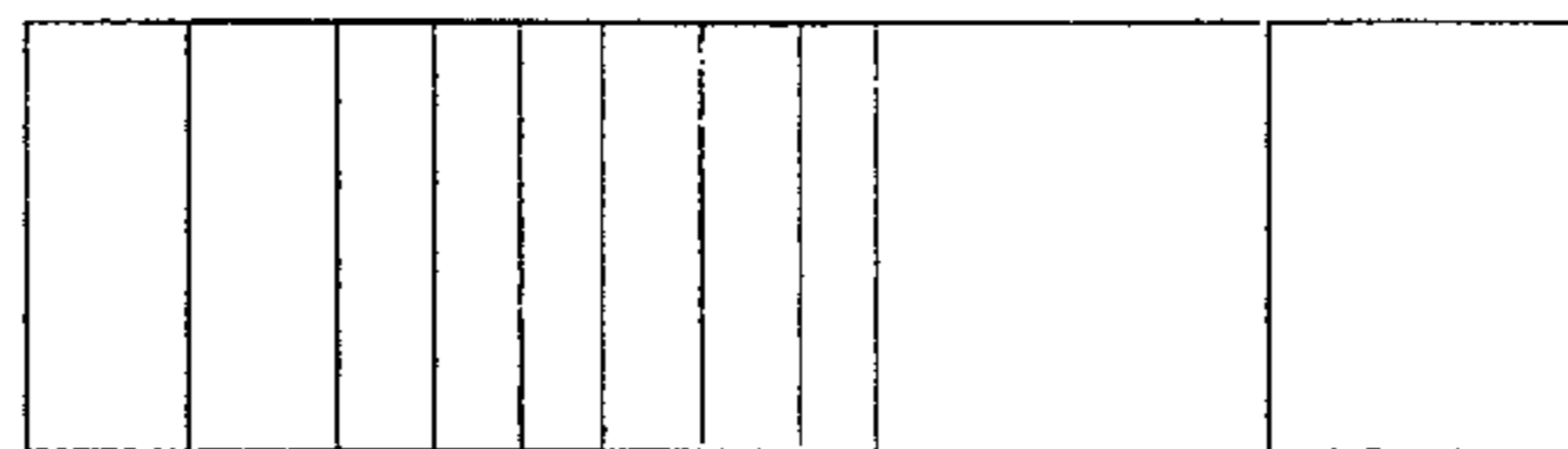
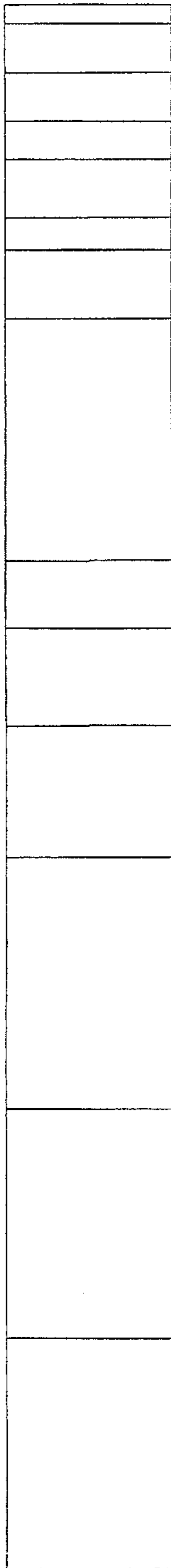

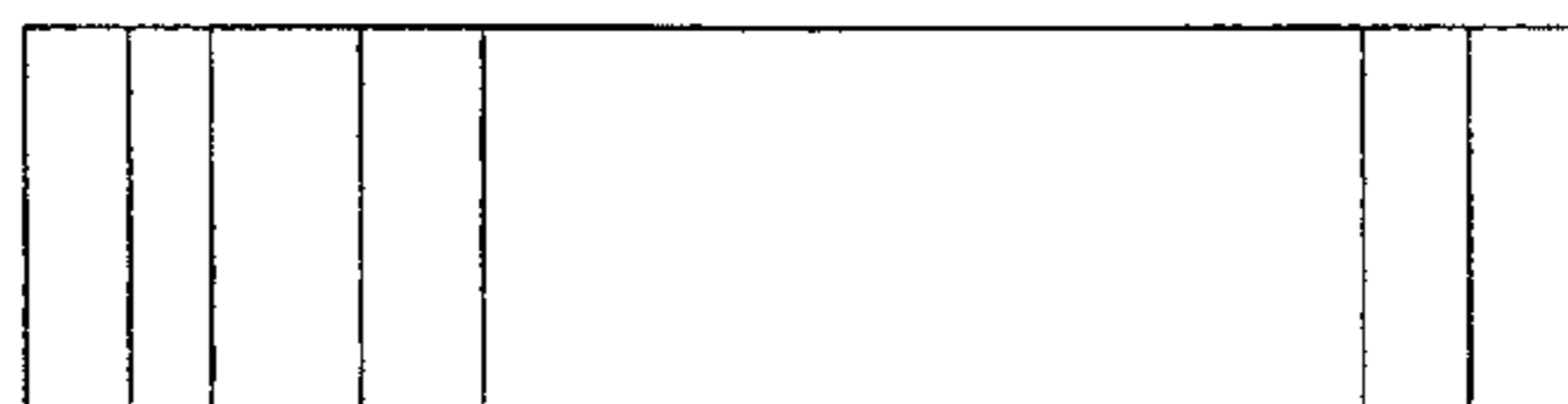
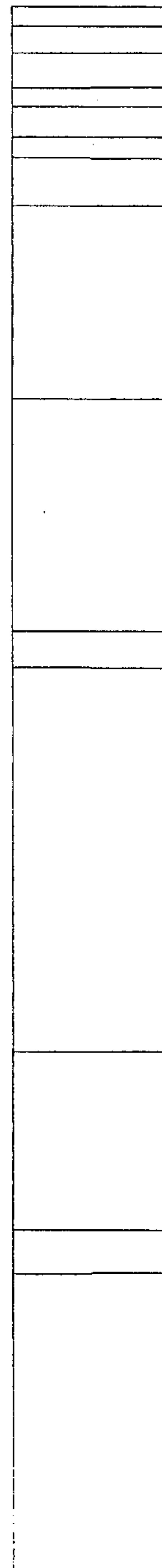
