#### CLAIM

The ornamental design for a heel wedge design for a skate, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a skate showing a new ornamental design for the heel wedge design for a skate;

FIG. 2 is a back elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of a skate showing use in association with an inline skate;

FIG. 10 is a back elevational view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,


FIG. 13 is a left side elevational view thereof.




