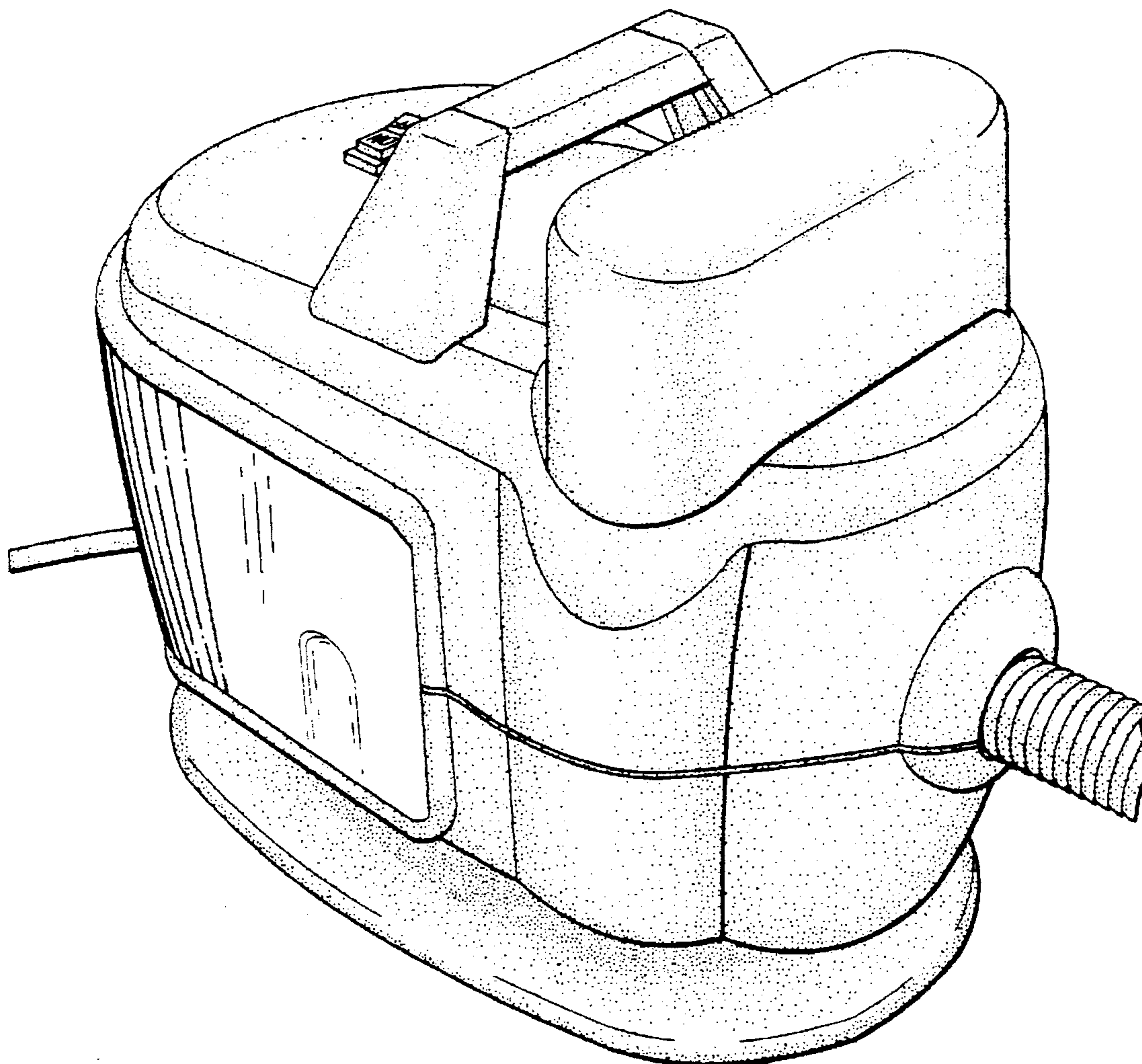
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a miniature spot cleaner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a miniature spot cleaner showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view; and, FIG. 7 is a front elevational view. The electric cord and hose shown in all views are understood to represent indeterminate length.

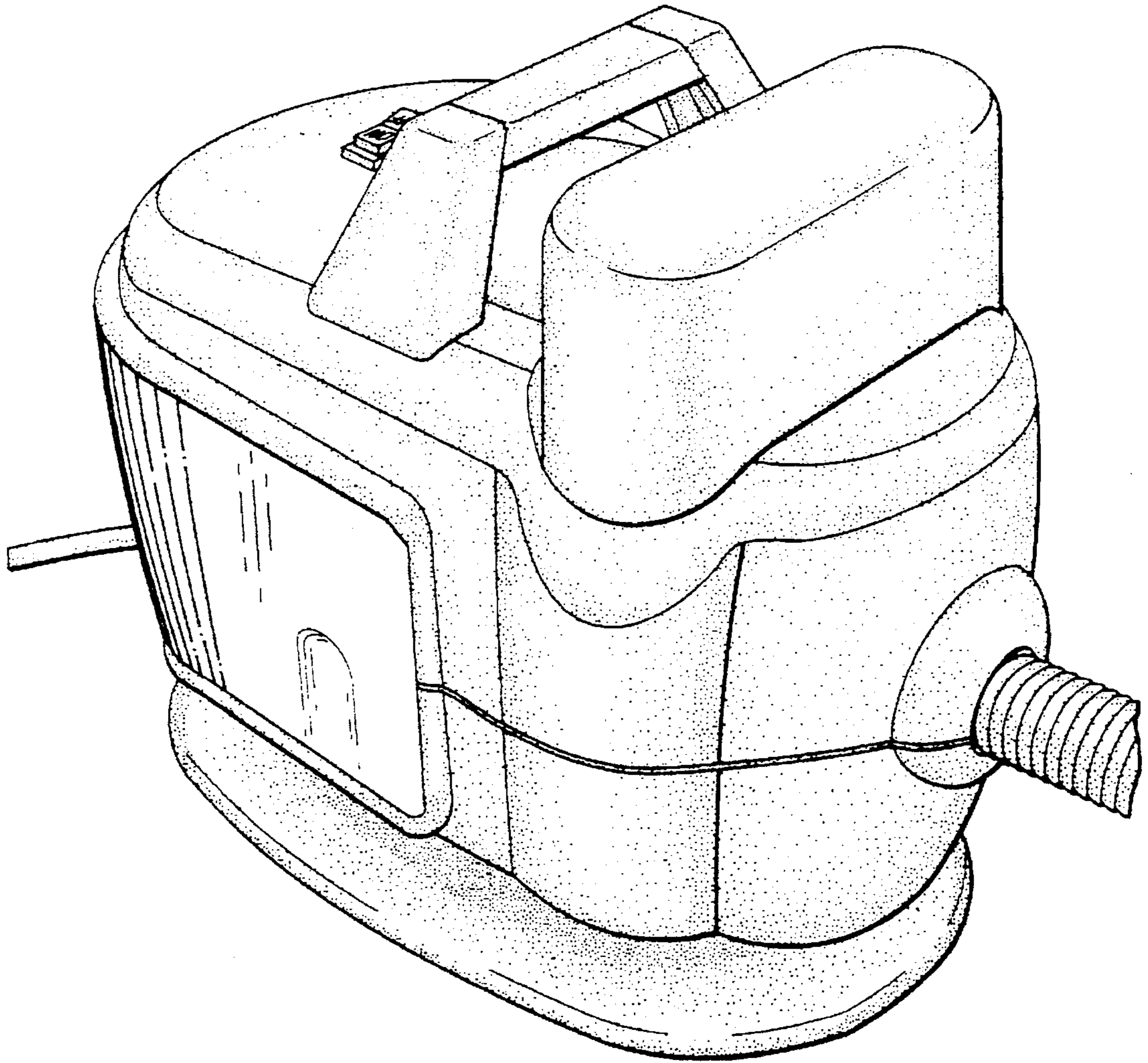

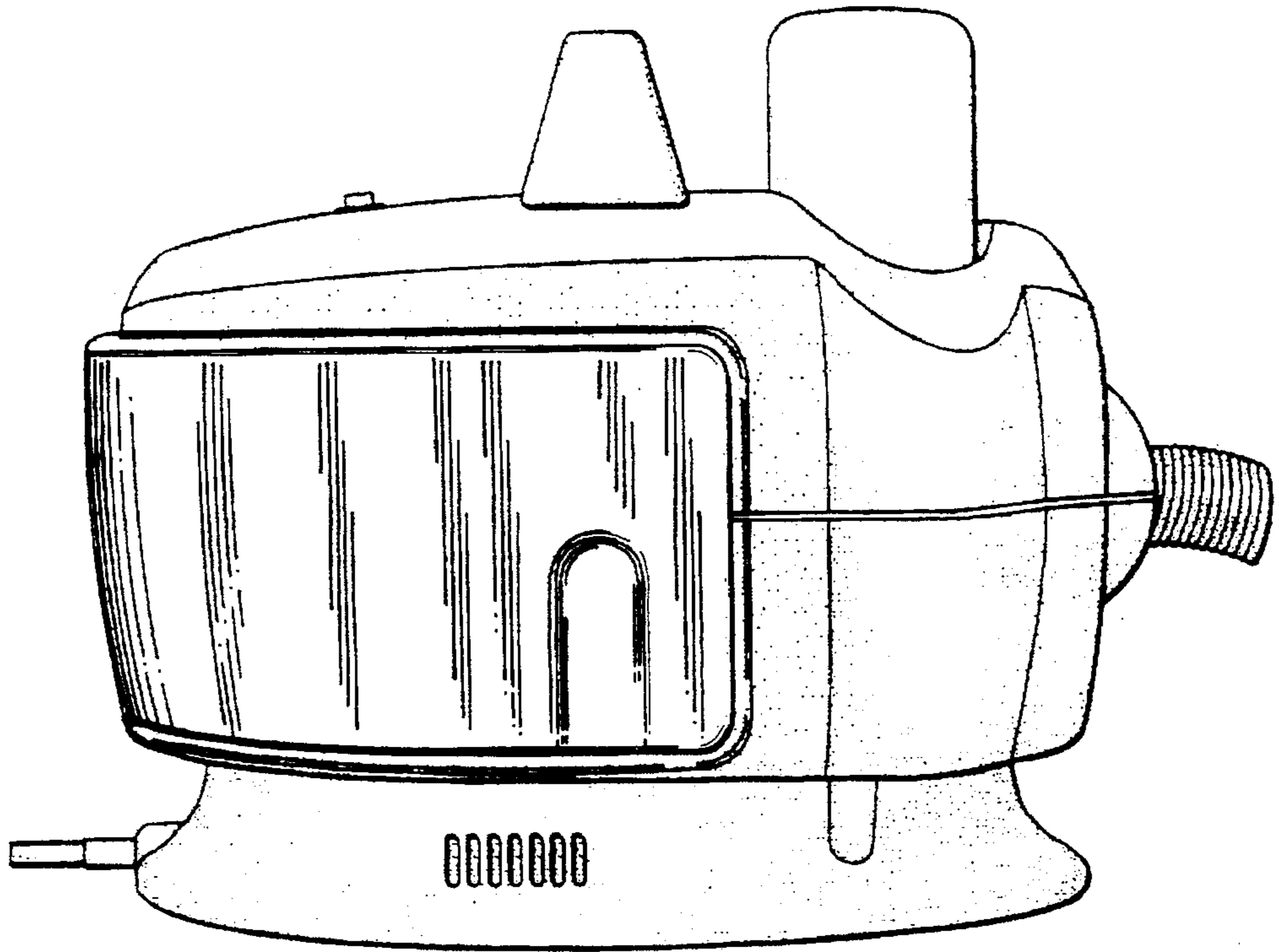

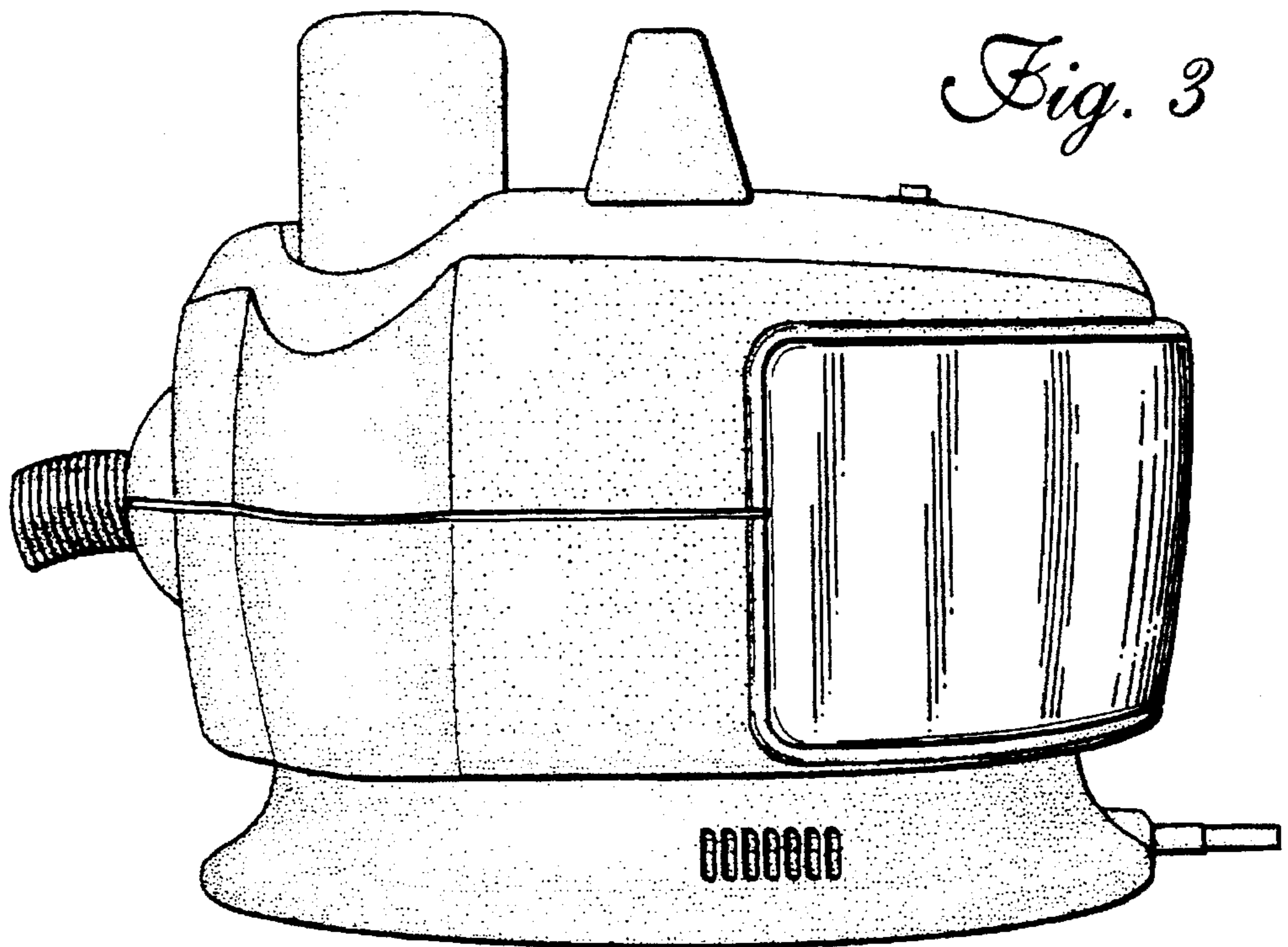

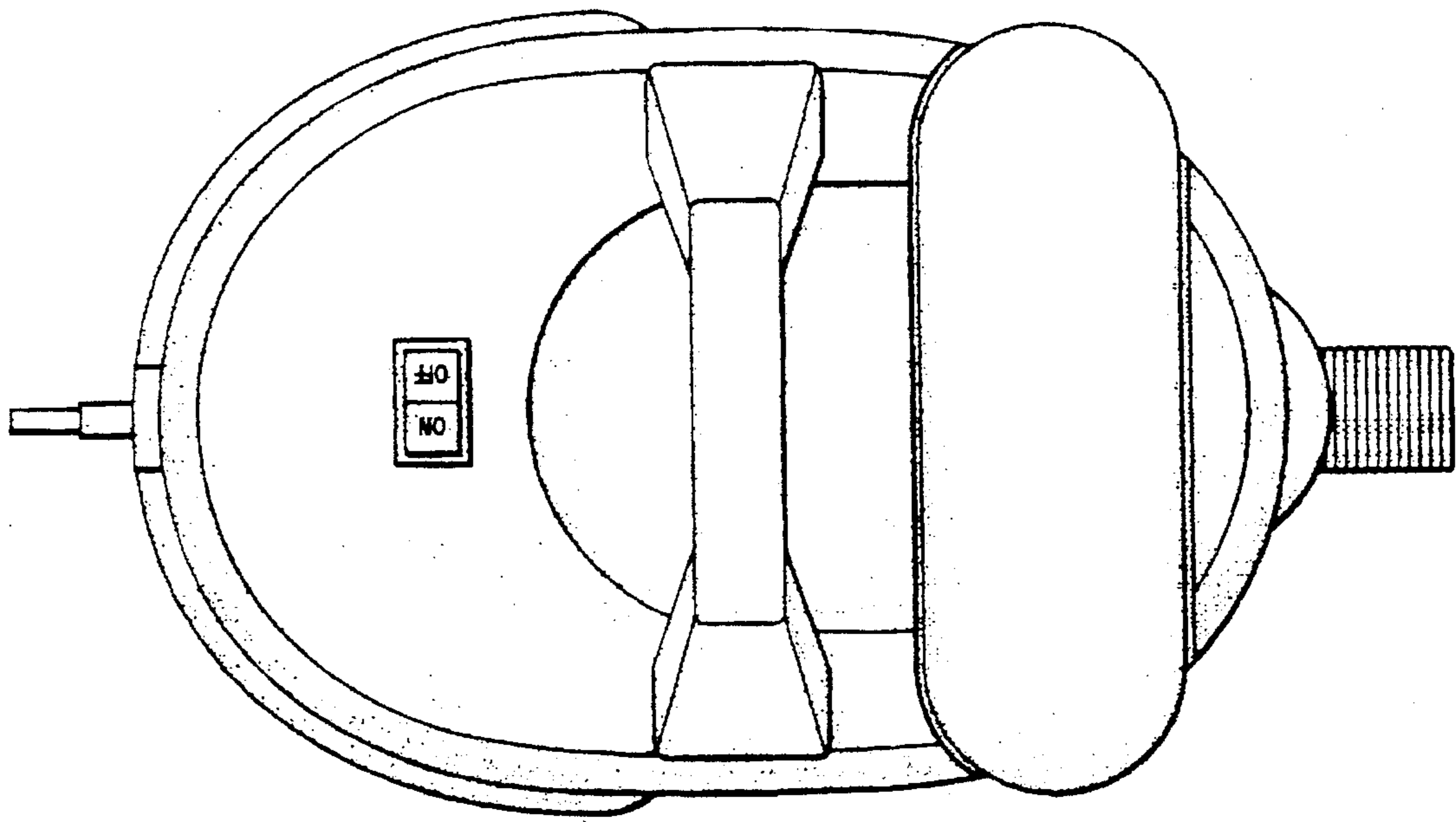

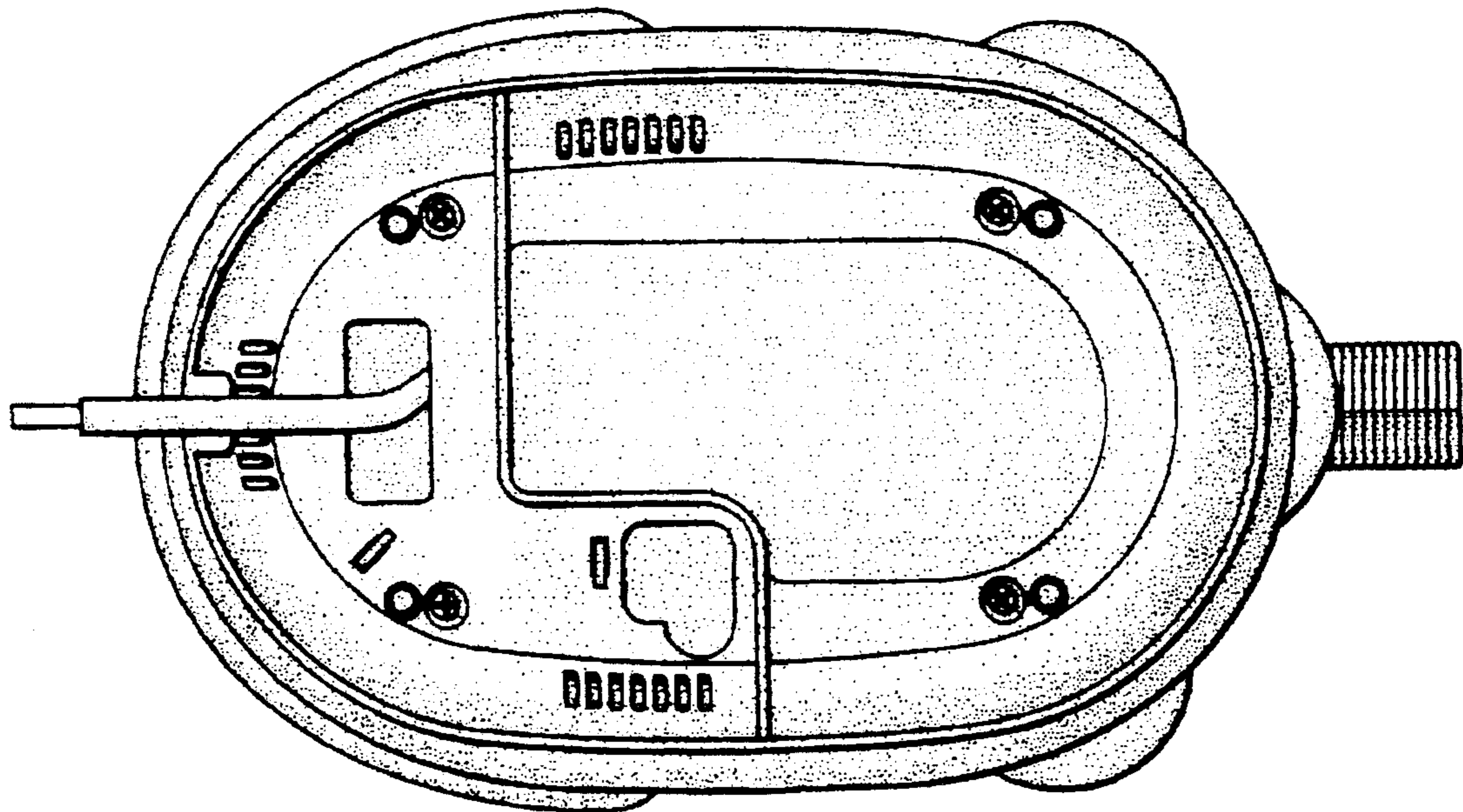

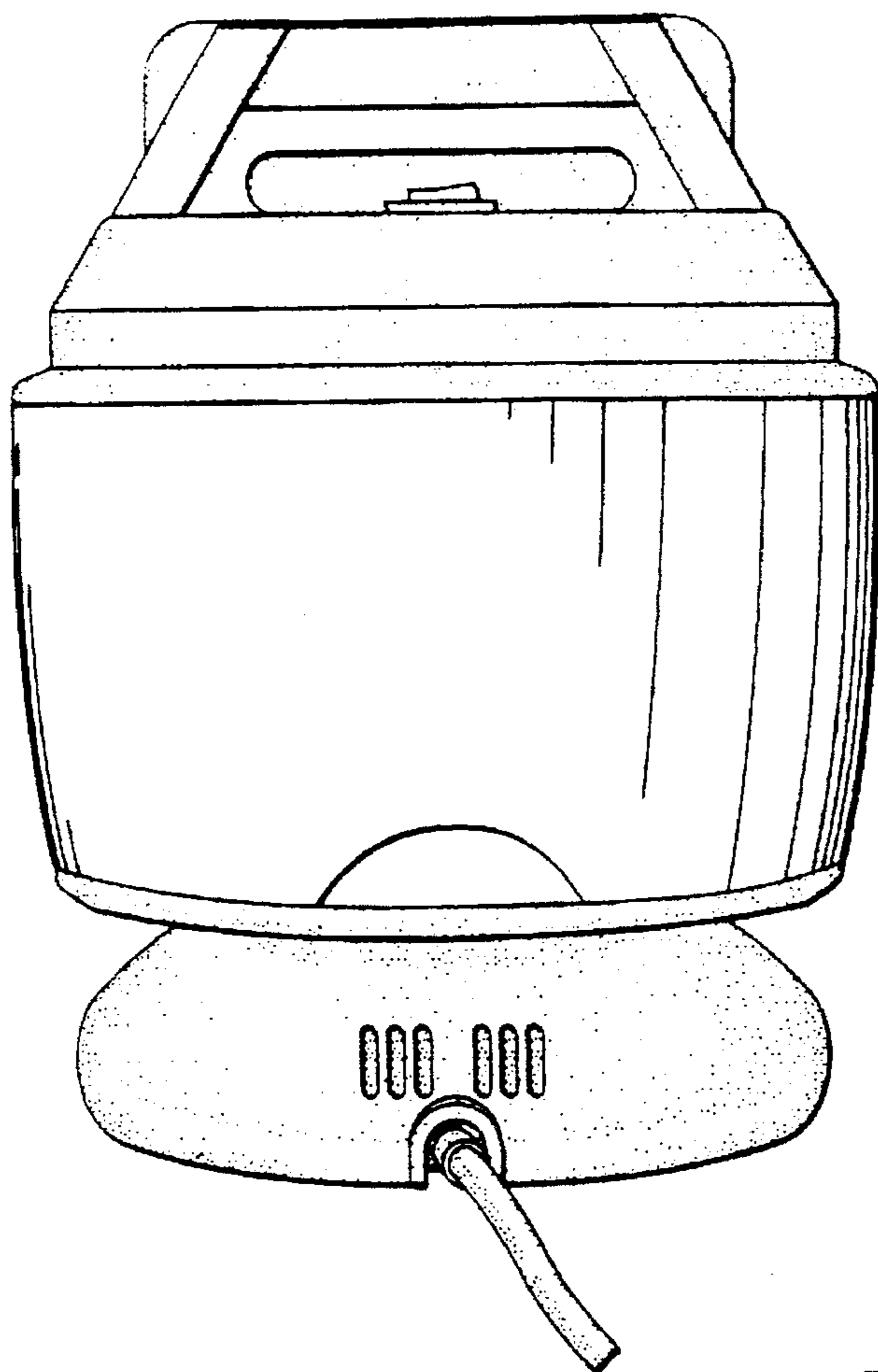
