DESCRIPTION

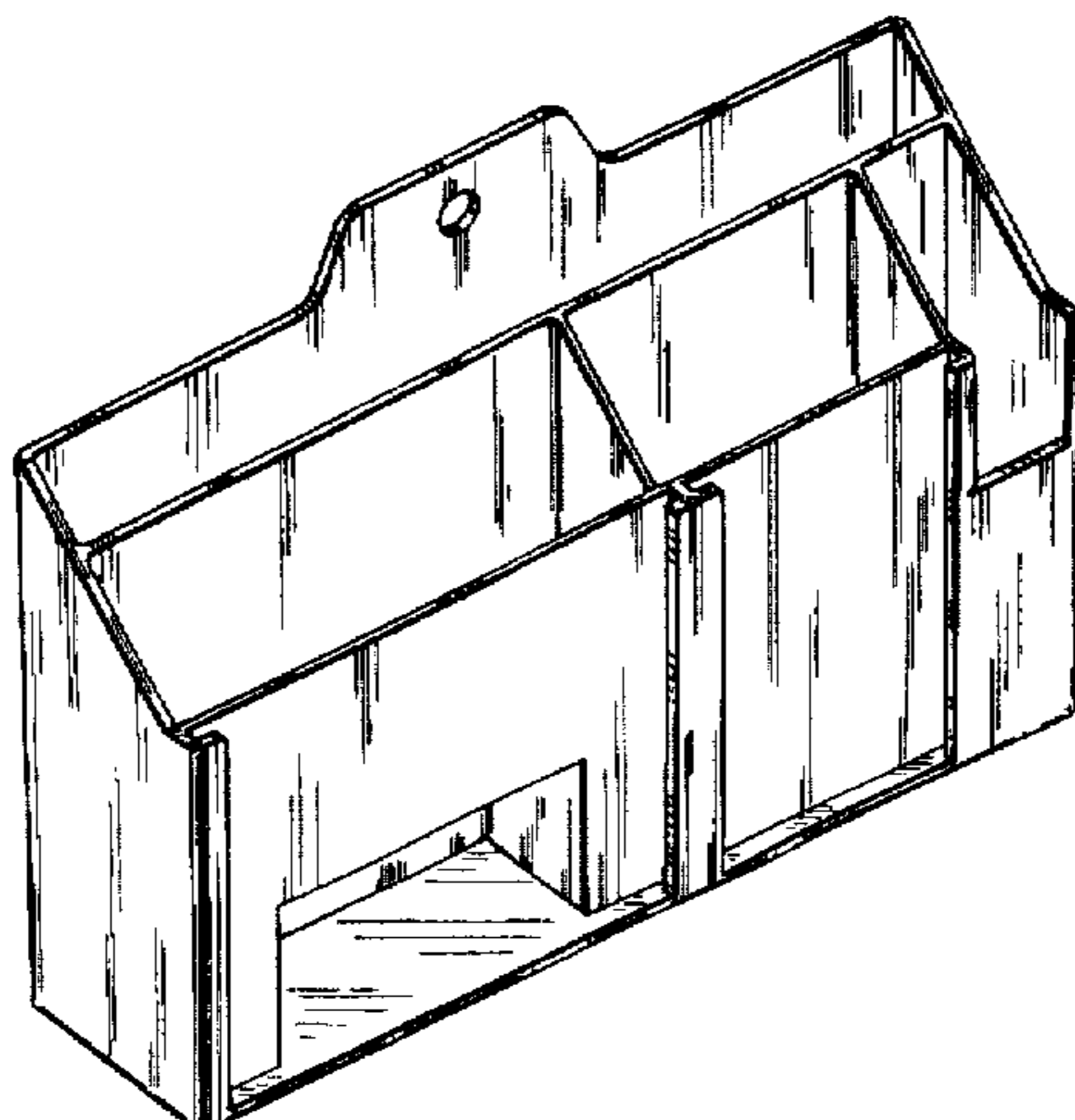
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the article holder of my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear view elevational thereof.

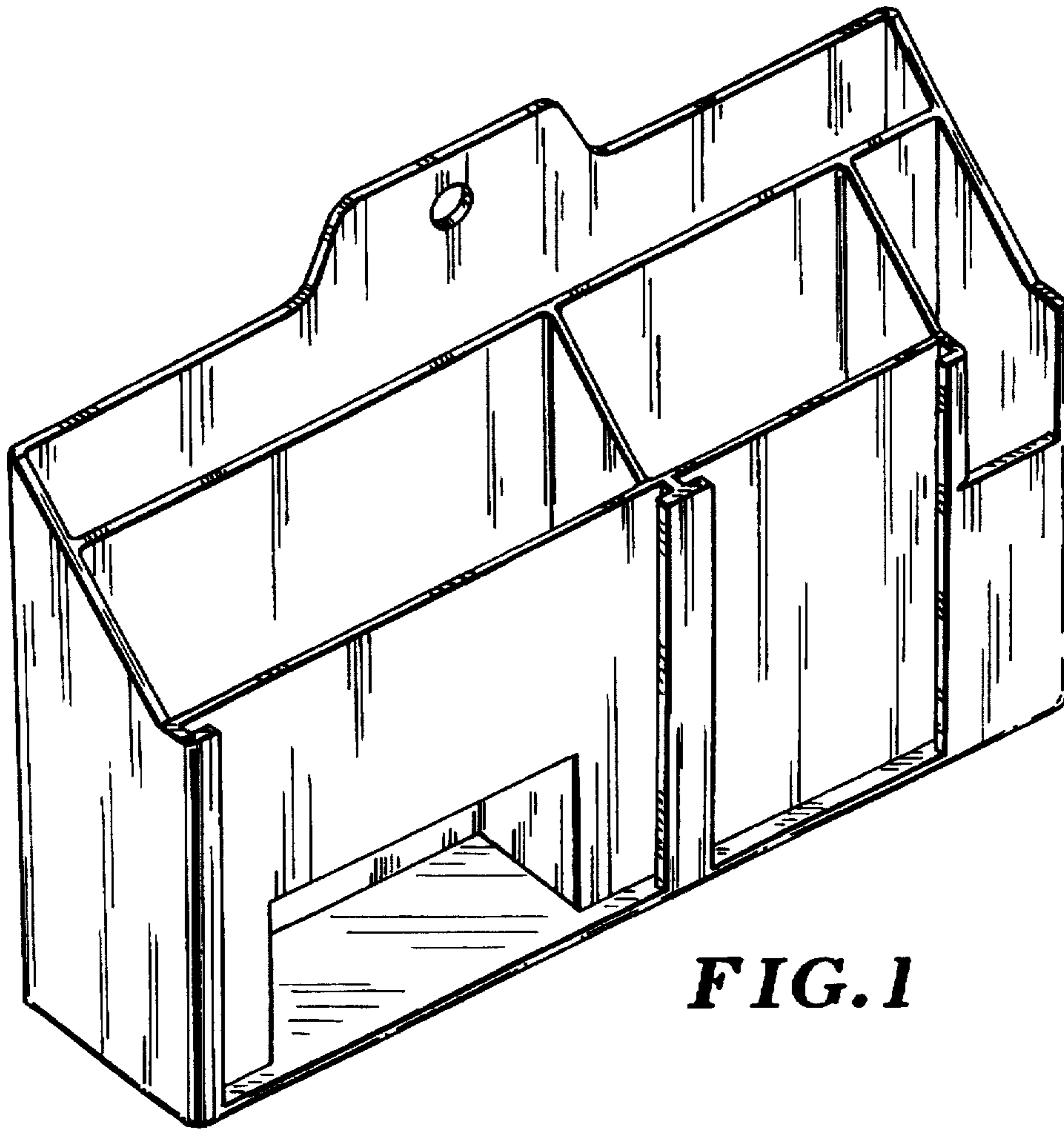

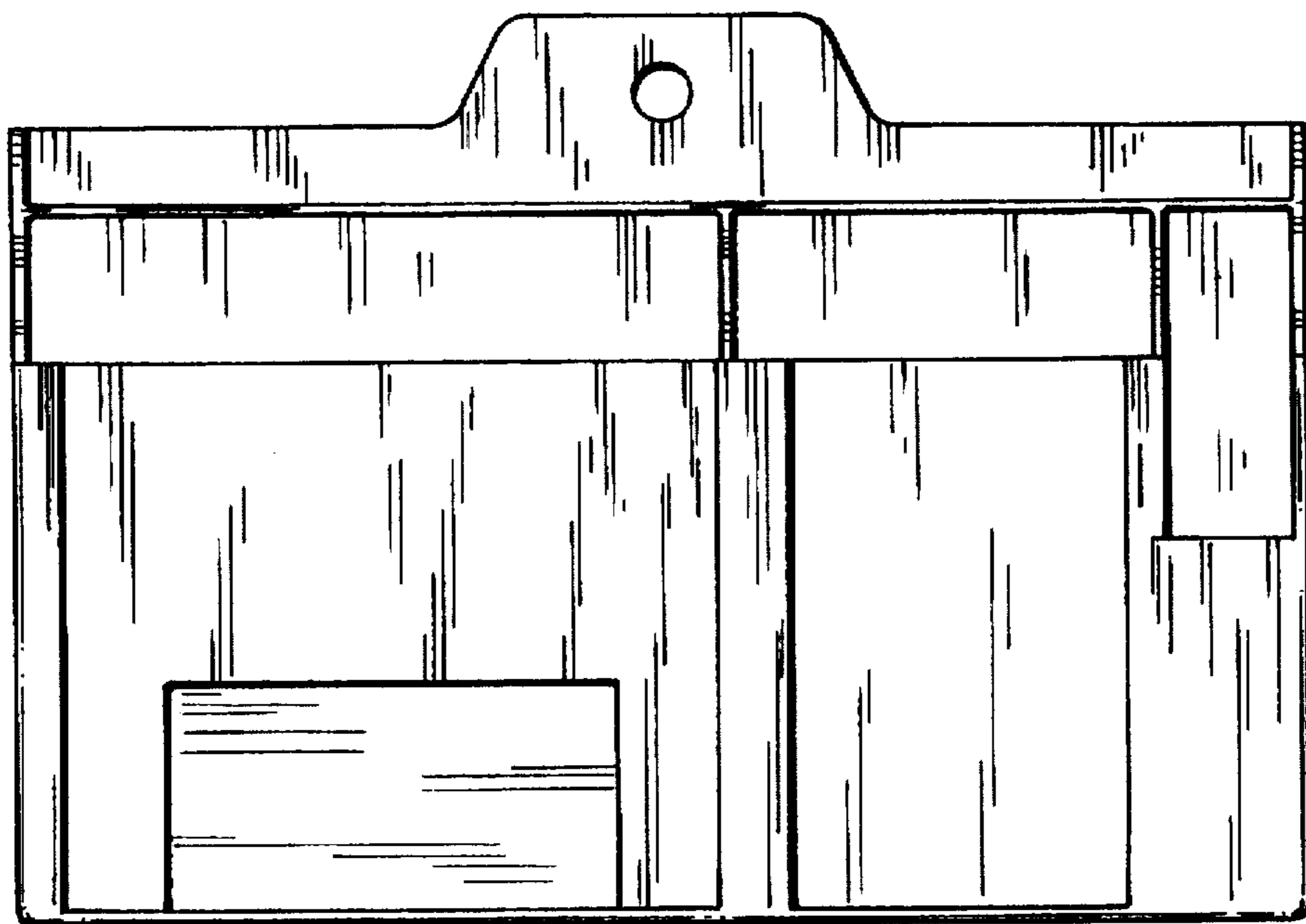

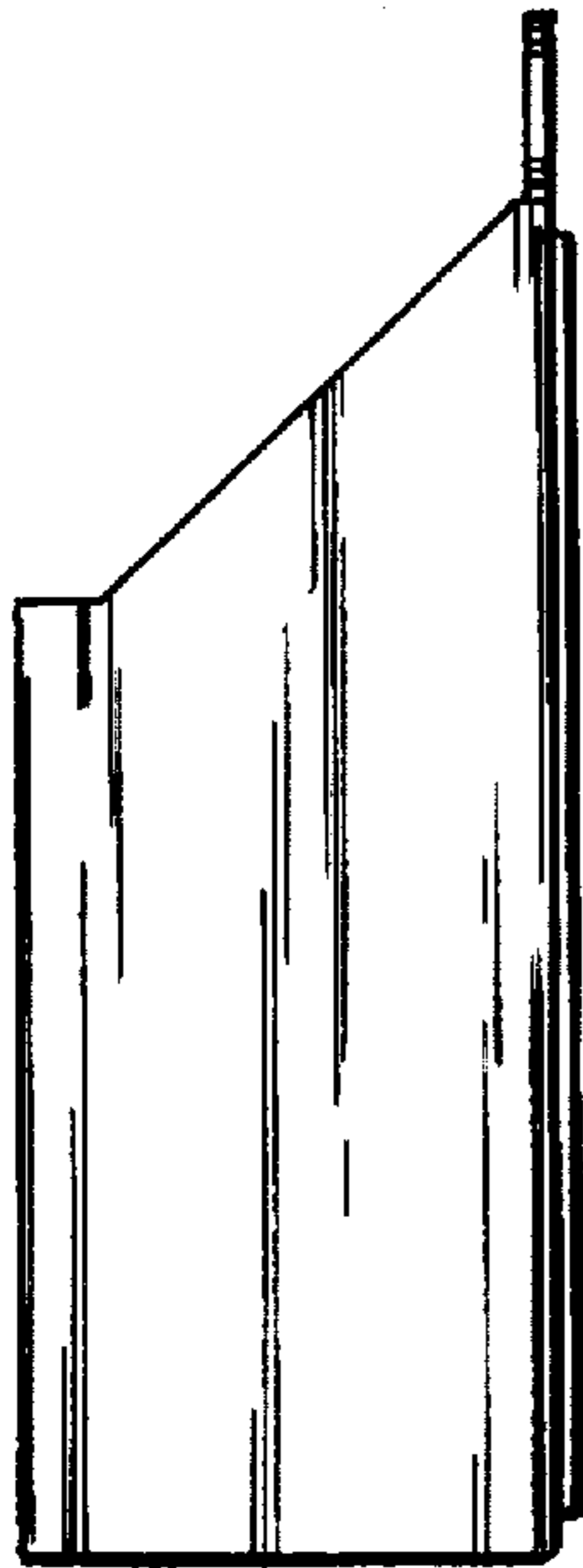

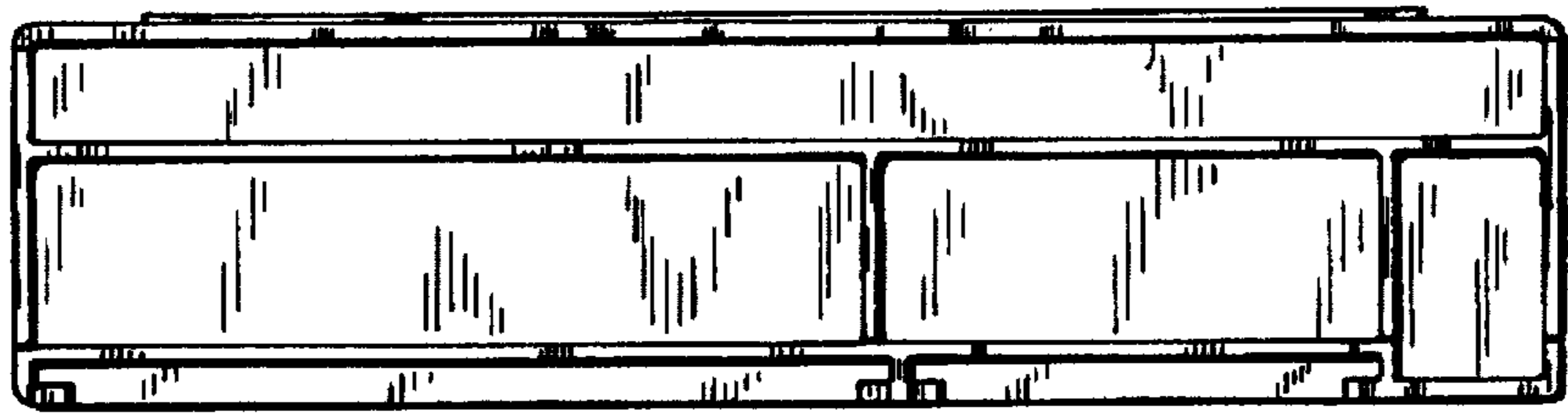

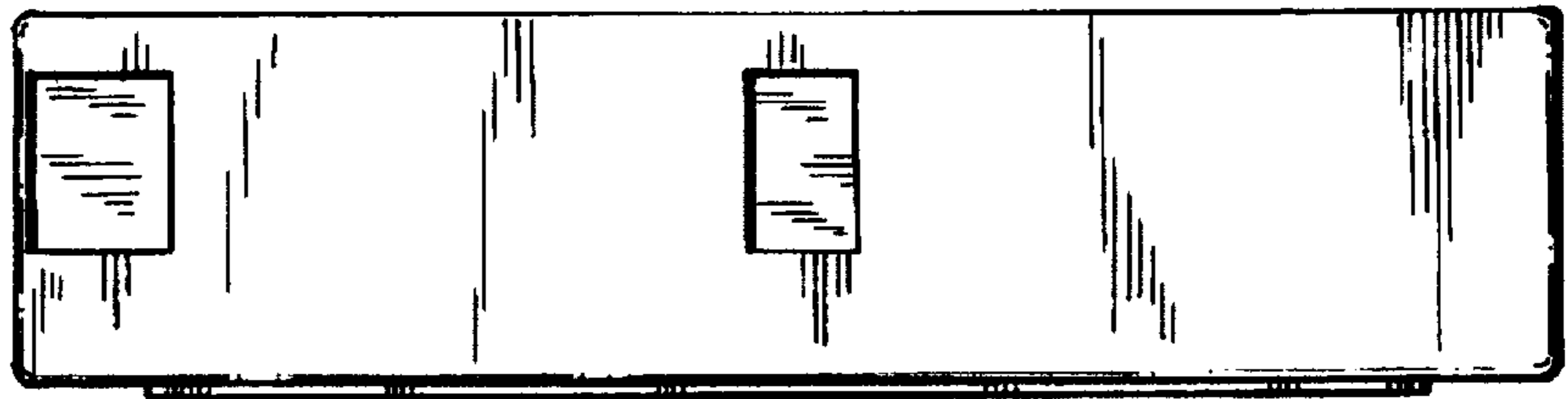

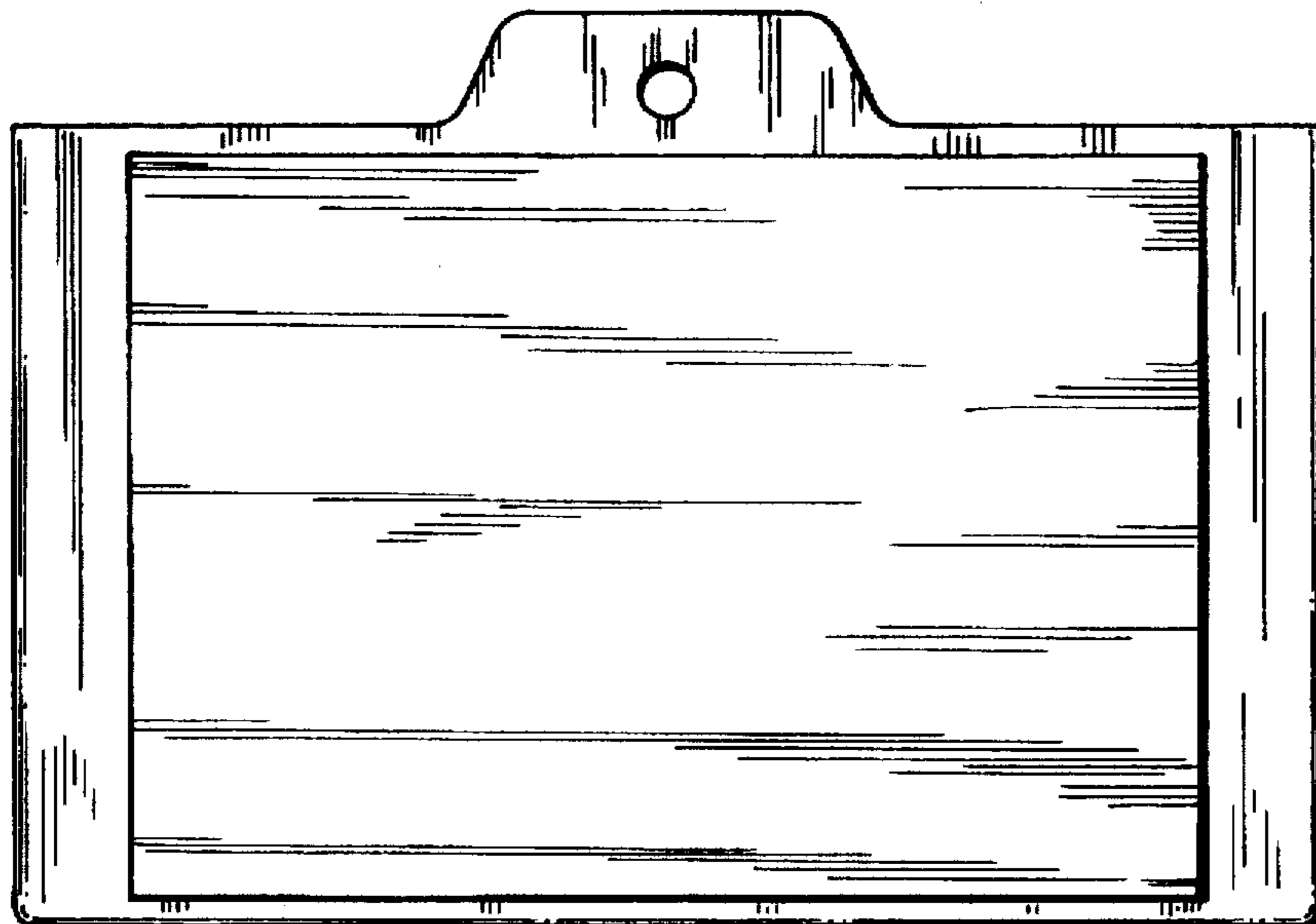
