[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a partial elevational view of the base portion taken from the right toward the left in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a partial elevational view of the base portion taken from the left toward the right in FIG. 1;

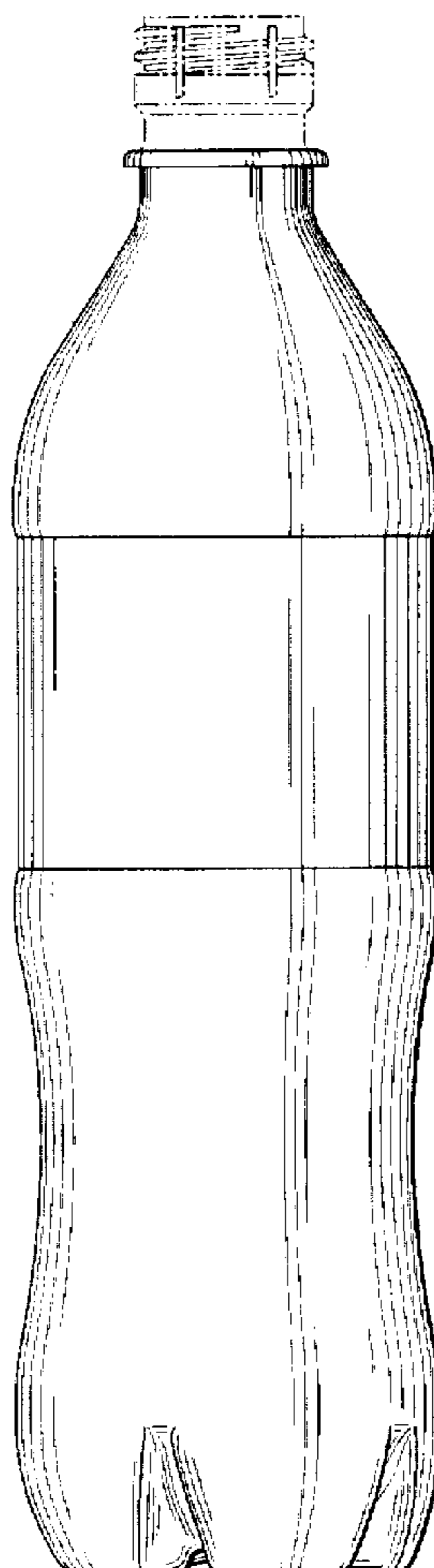
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof taken from above and to the right in FIG. 1.

The neck finish shown in broken lines in FIGS. 1, 4 and 6 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design; the opposite side of the side shown in FIG. 1 is the same as the side shown except for the lower base portion which is a mirror image thereof; and above the lower base portion shown in FIGS. 2 and 3 the bottle is the same as shown in FIG. 1.

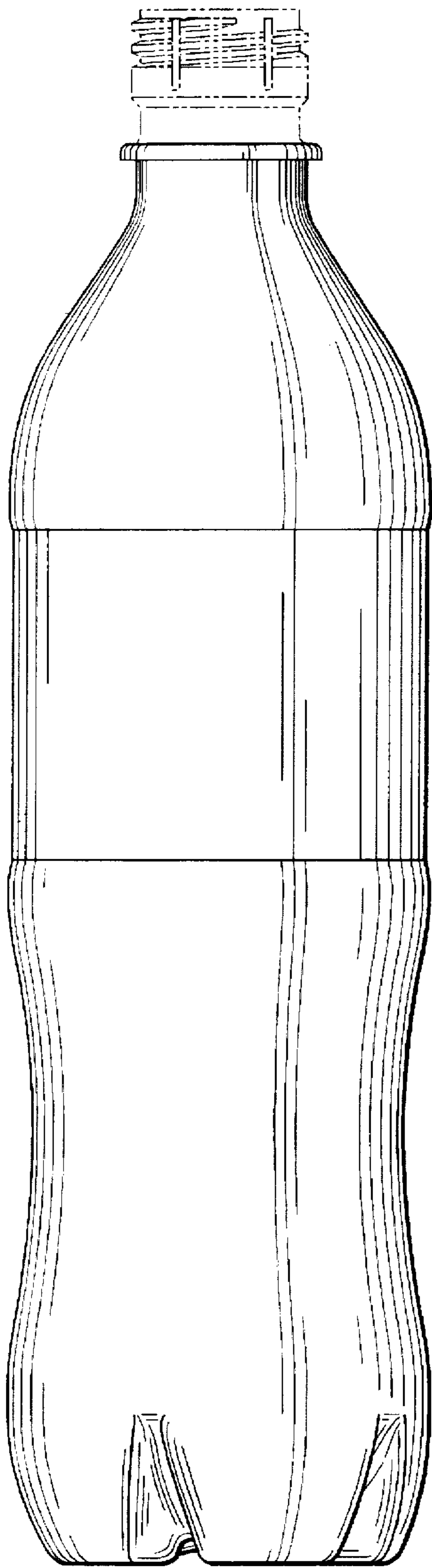

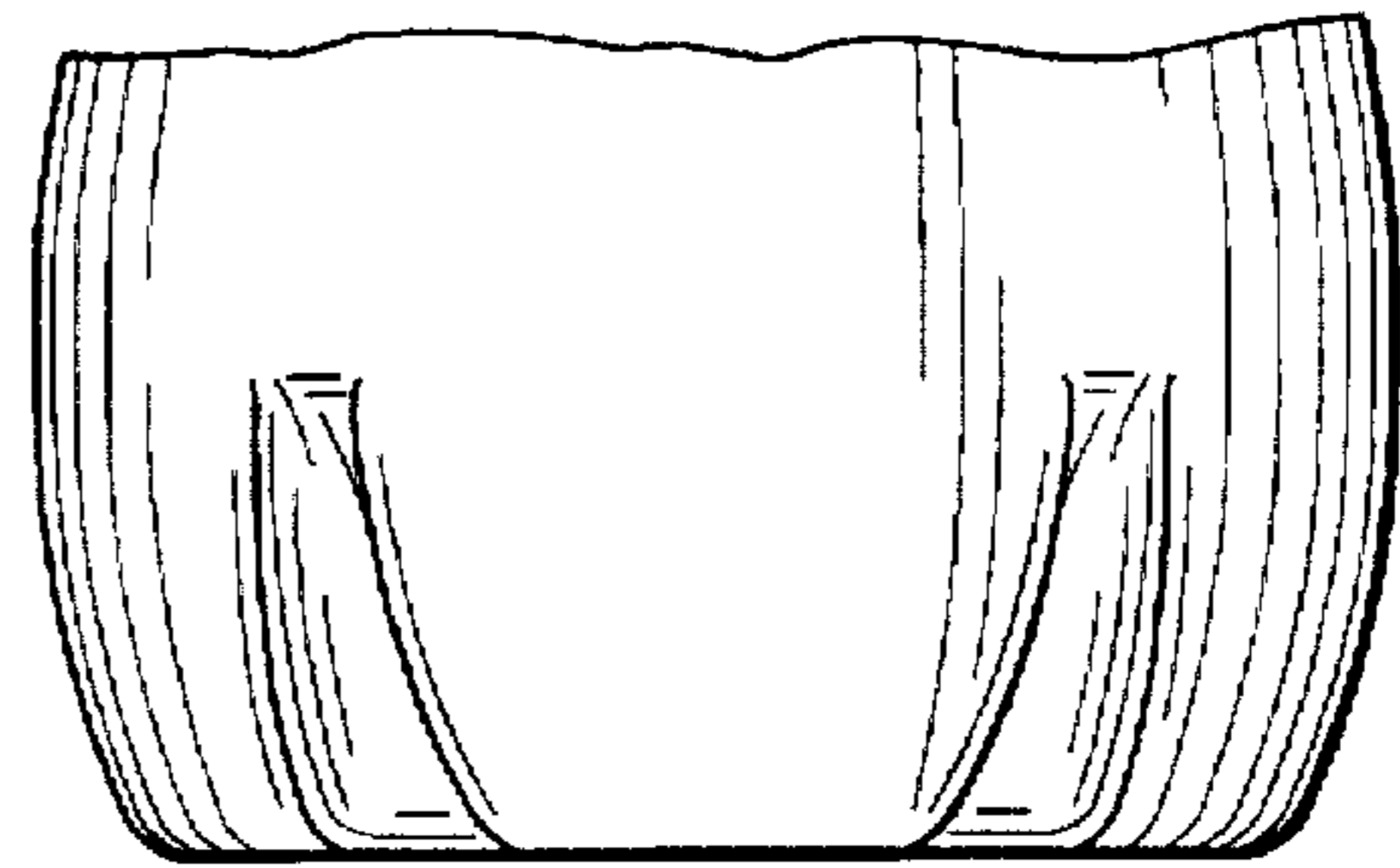

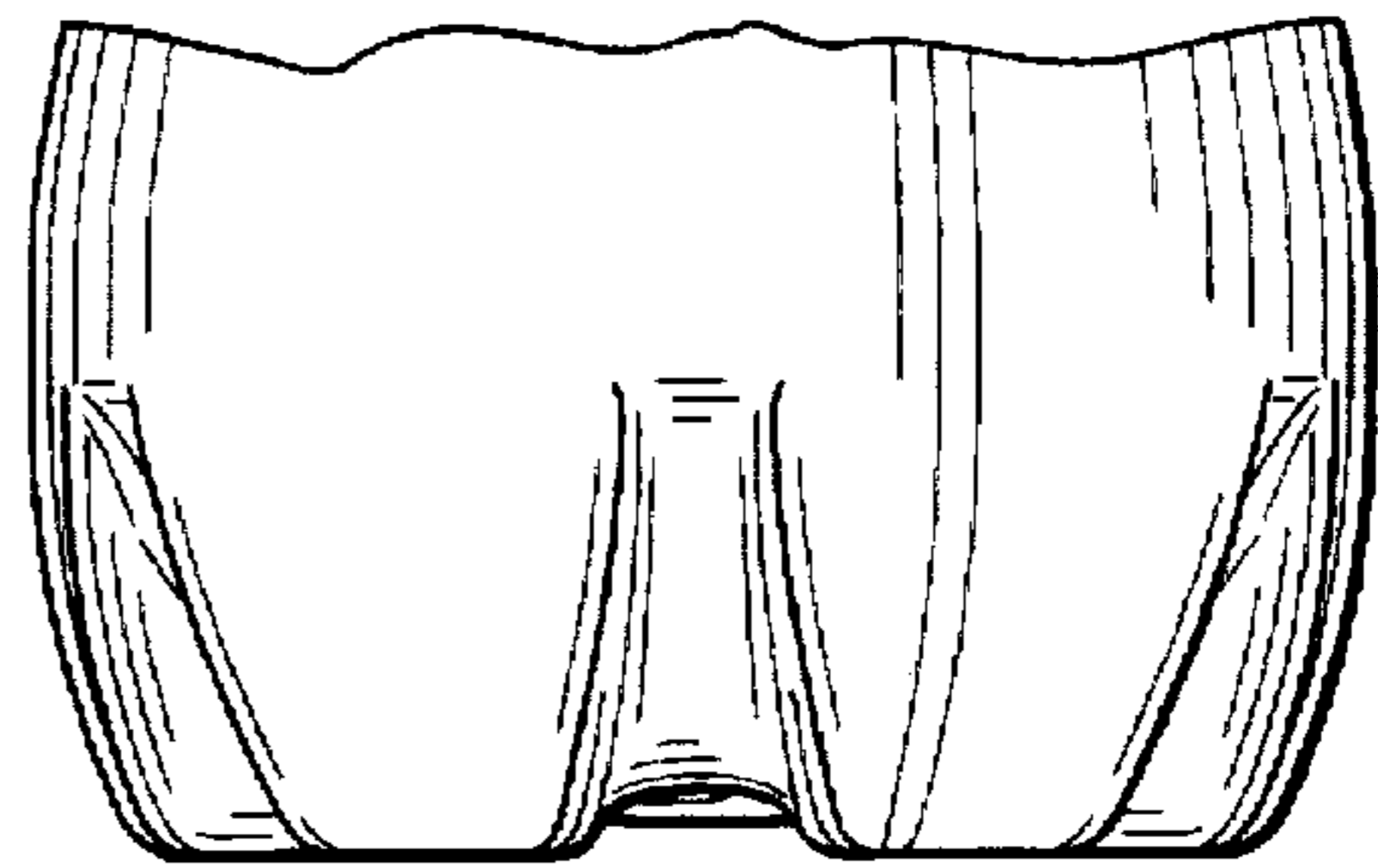

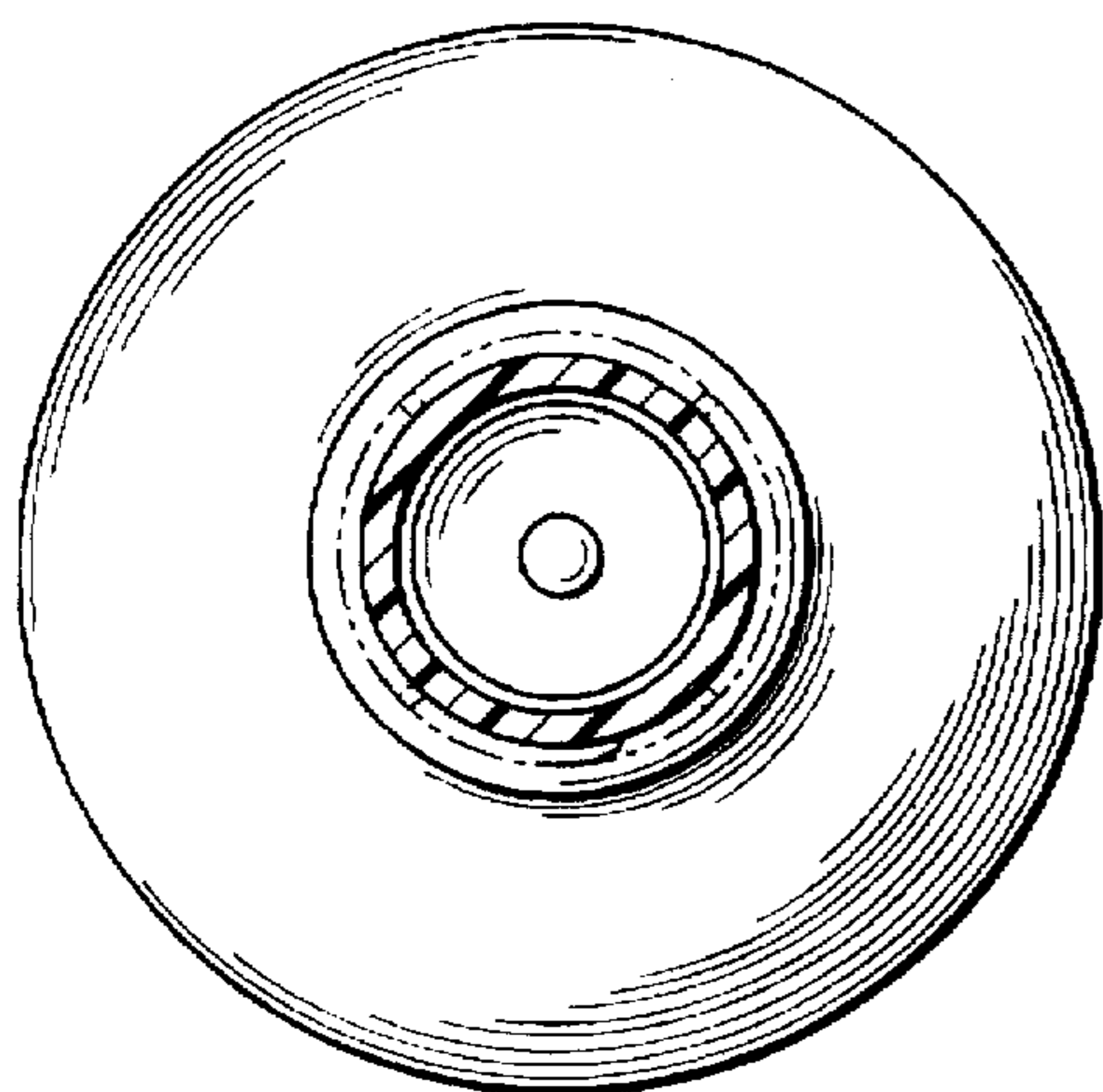

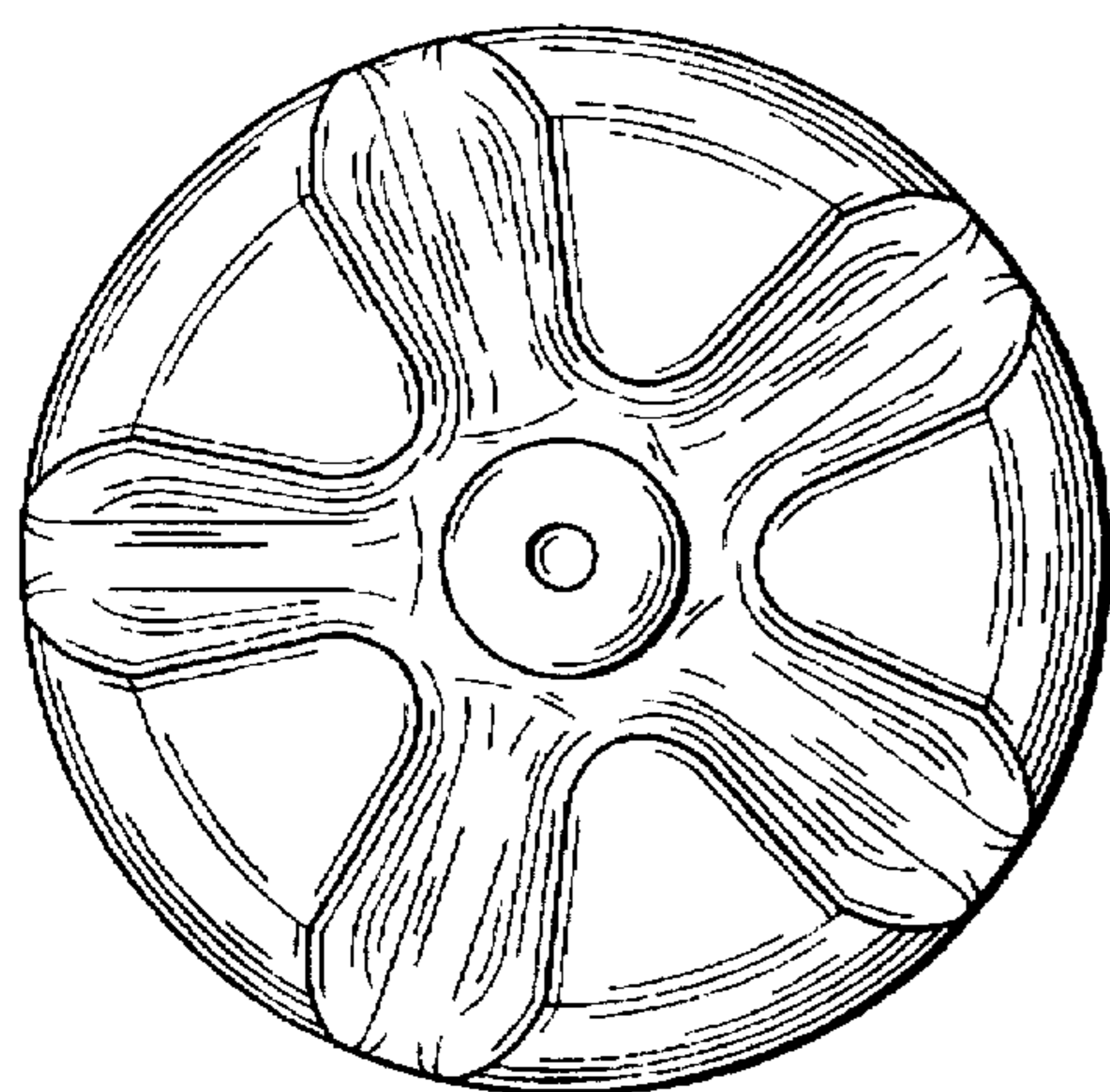

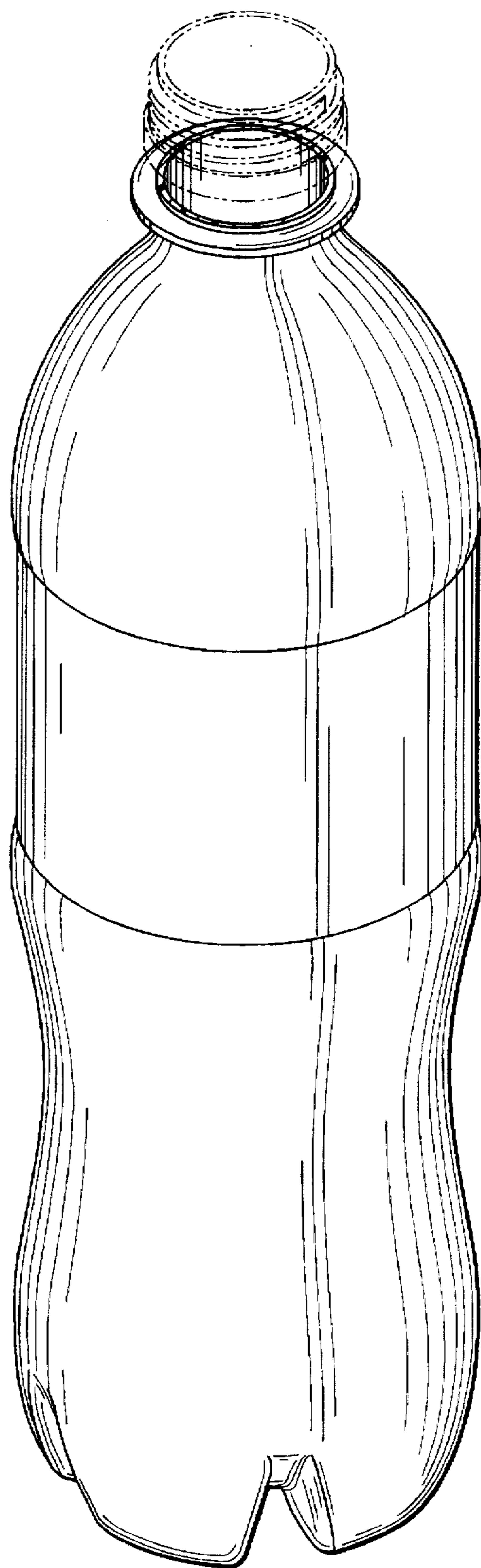
