DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a page turning device according to the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the page turning device of FIG. 1; and,

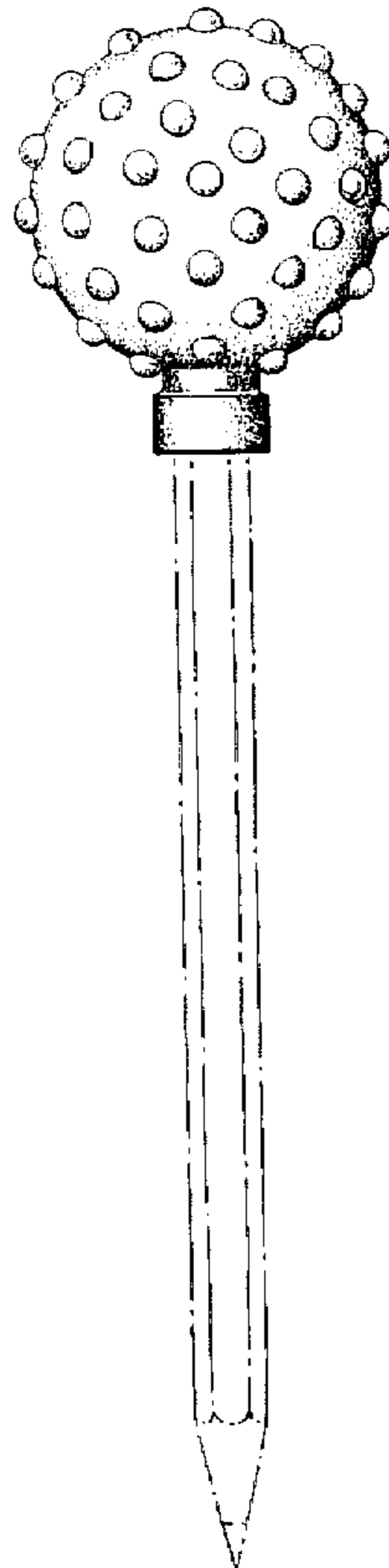

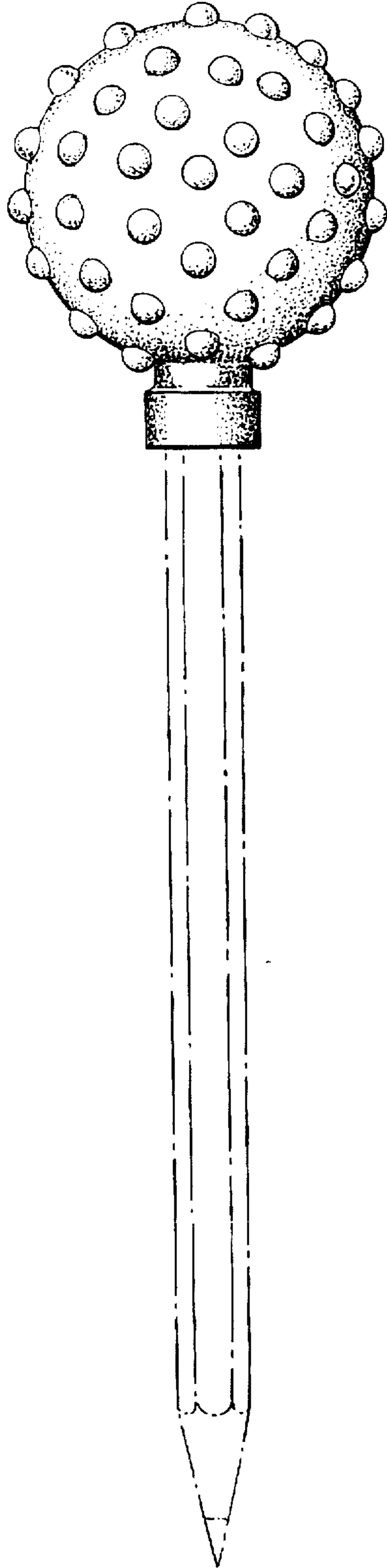

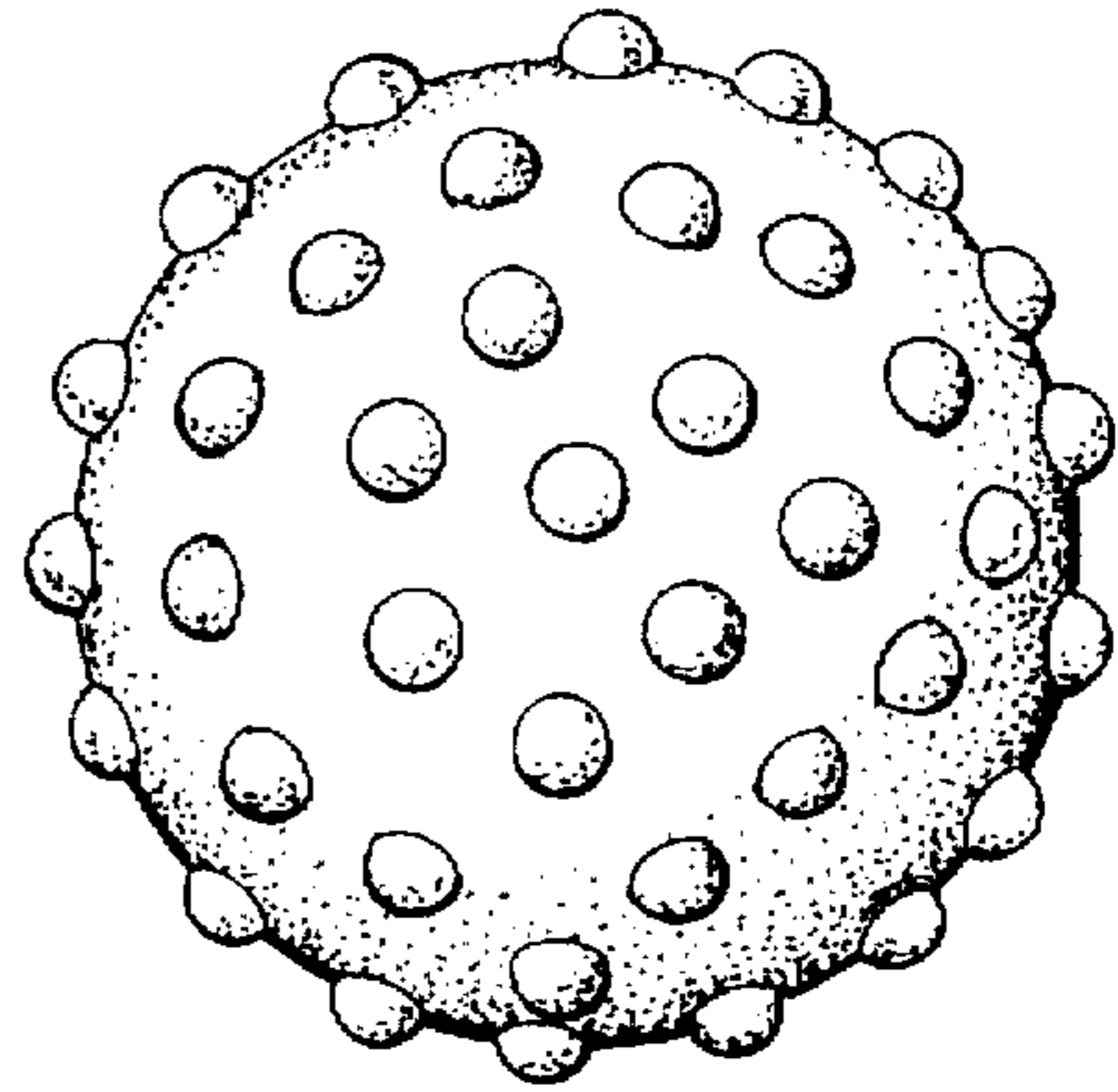
