DESCRIPTION

new design, the broken line showing of the necktie is for
illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed
design;

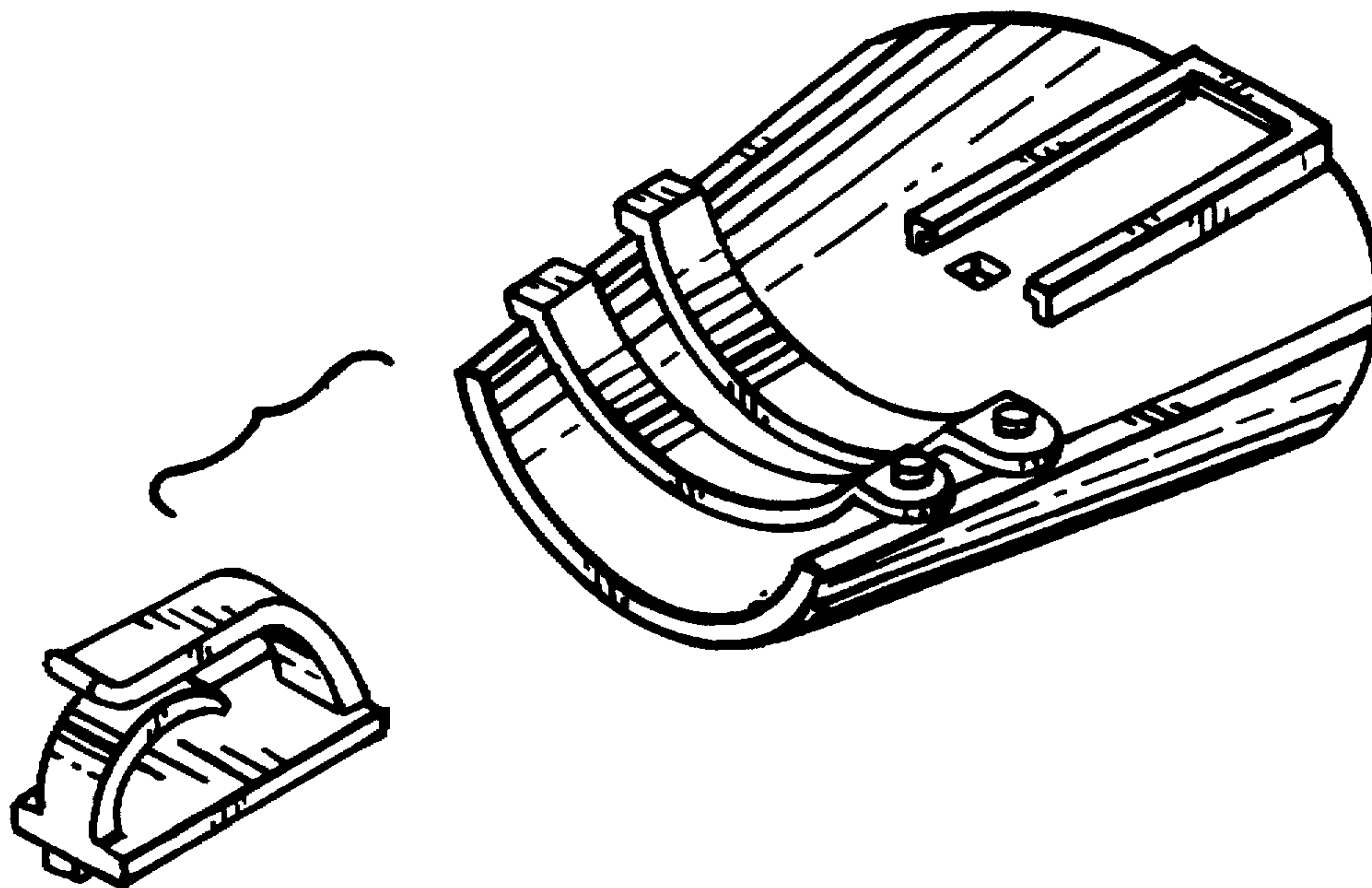

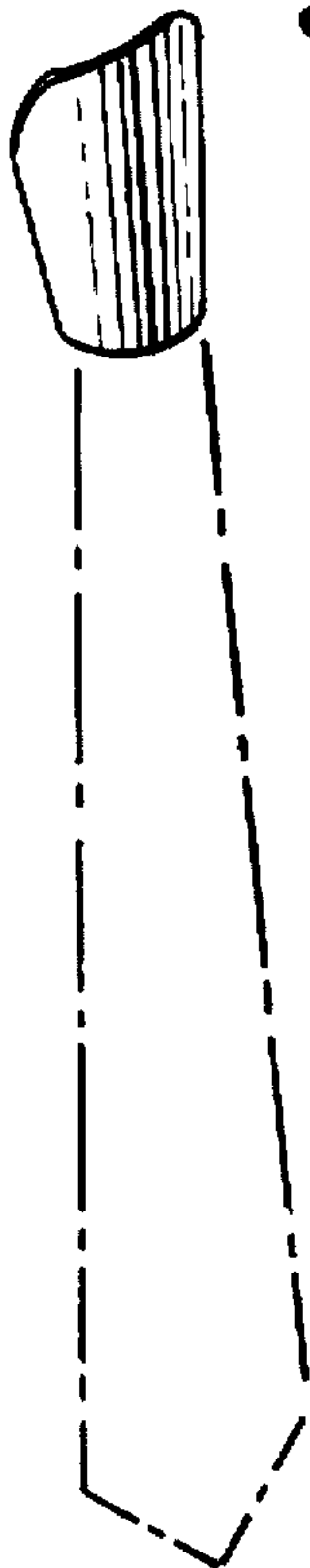

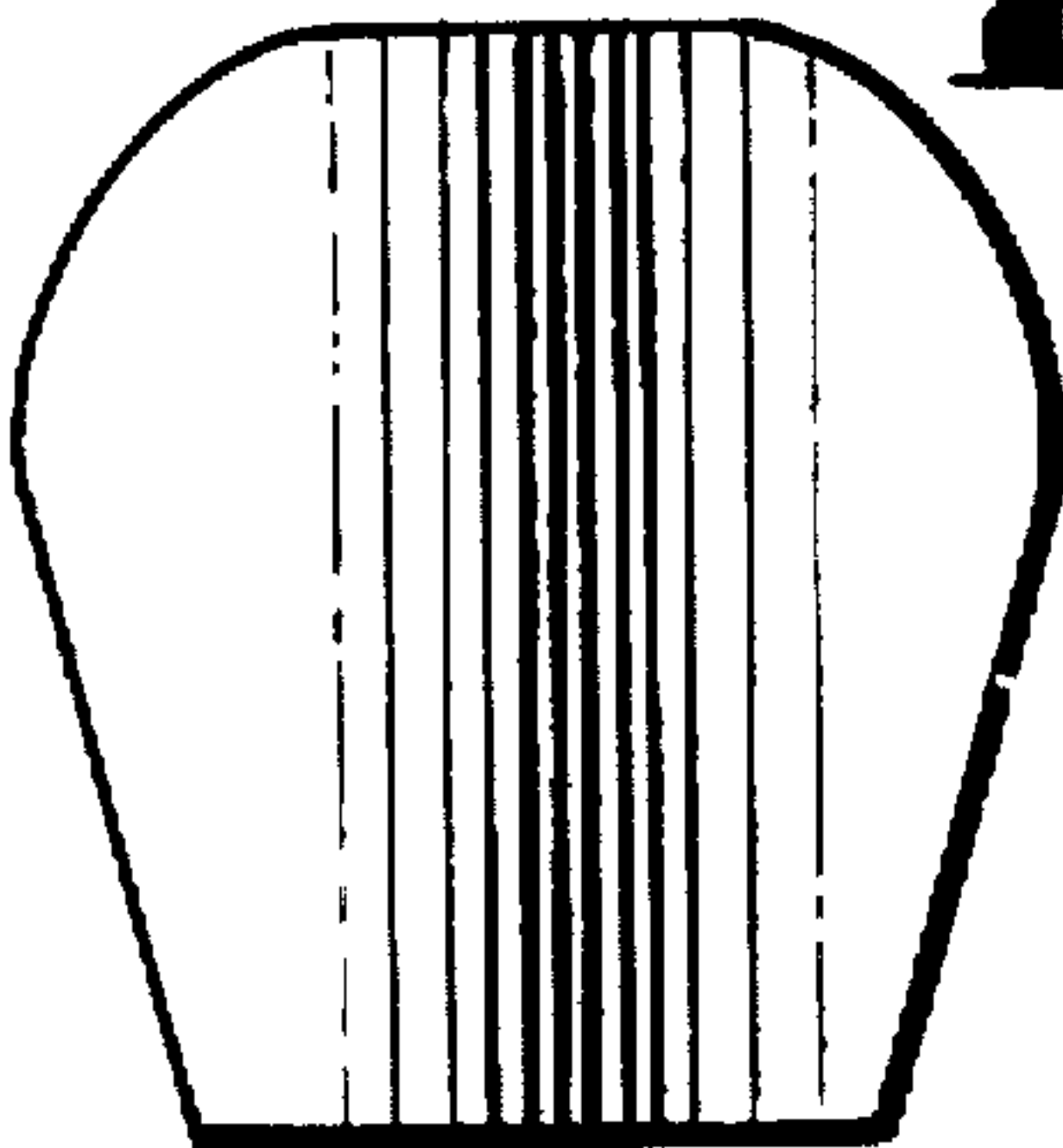

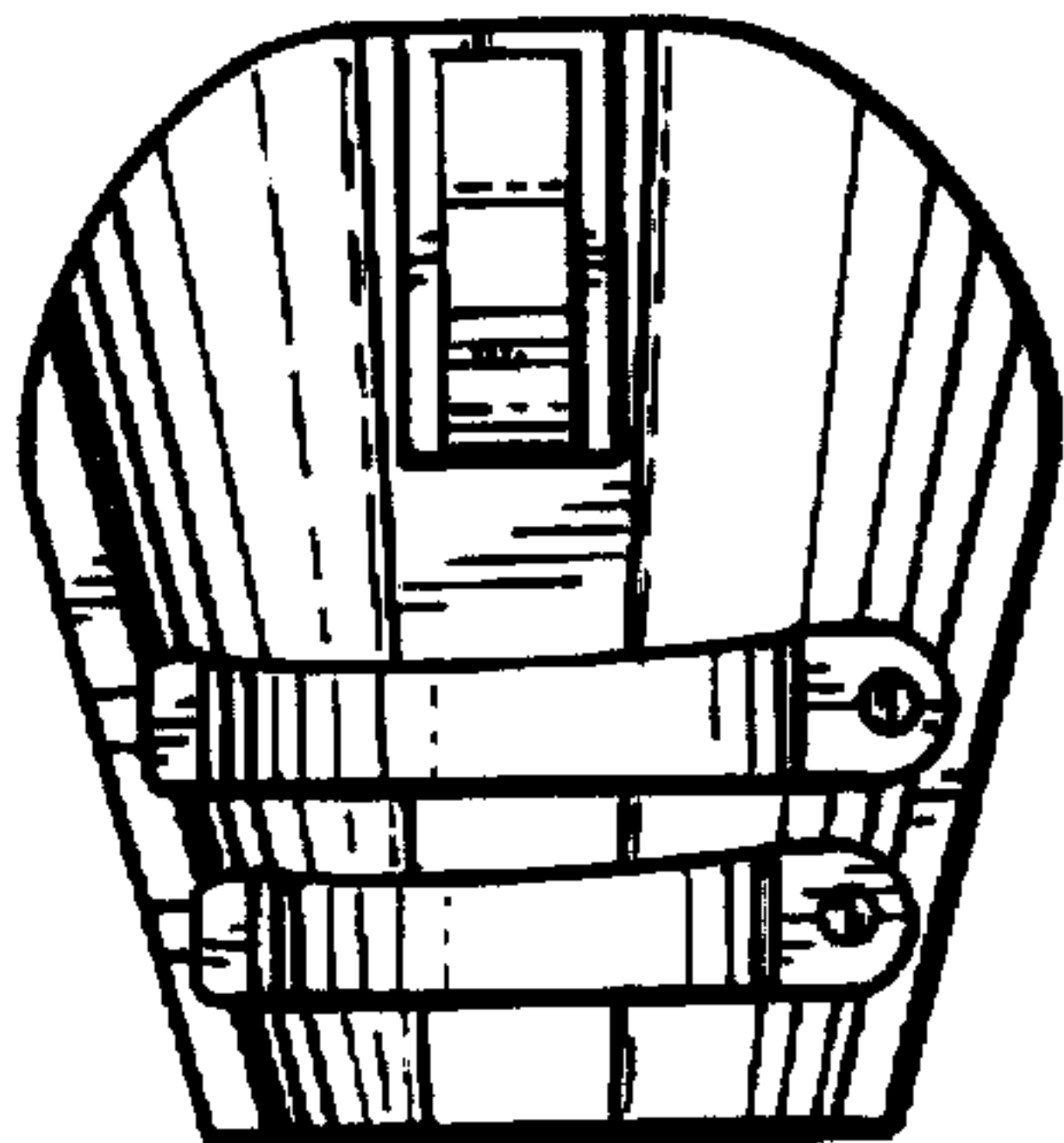

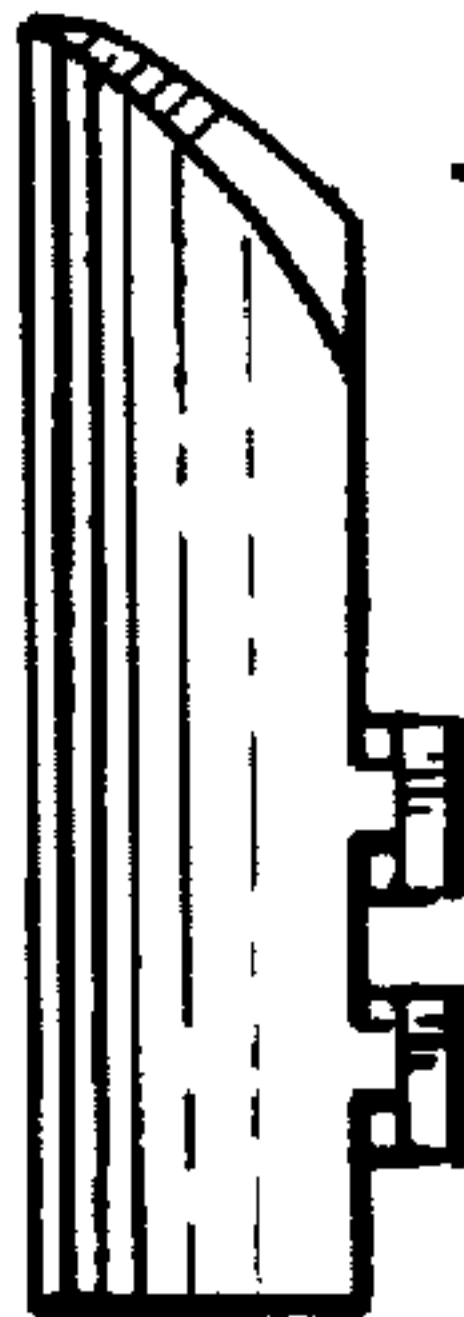

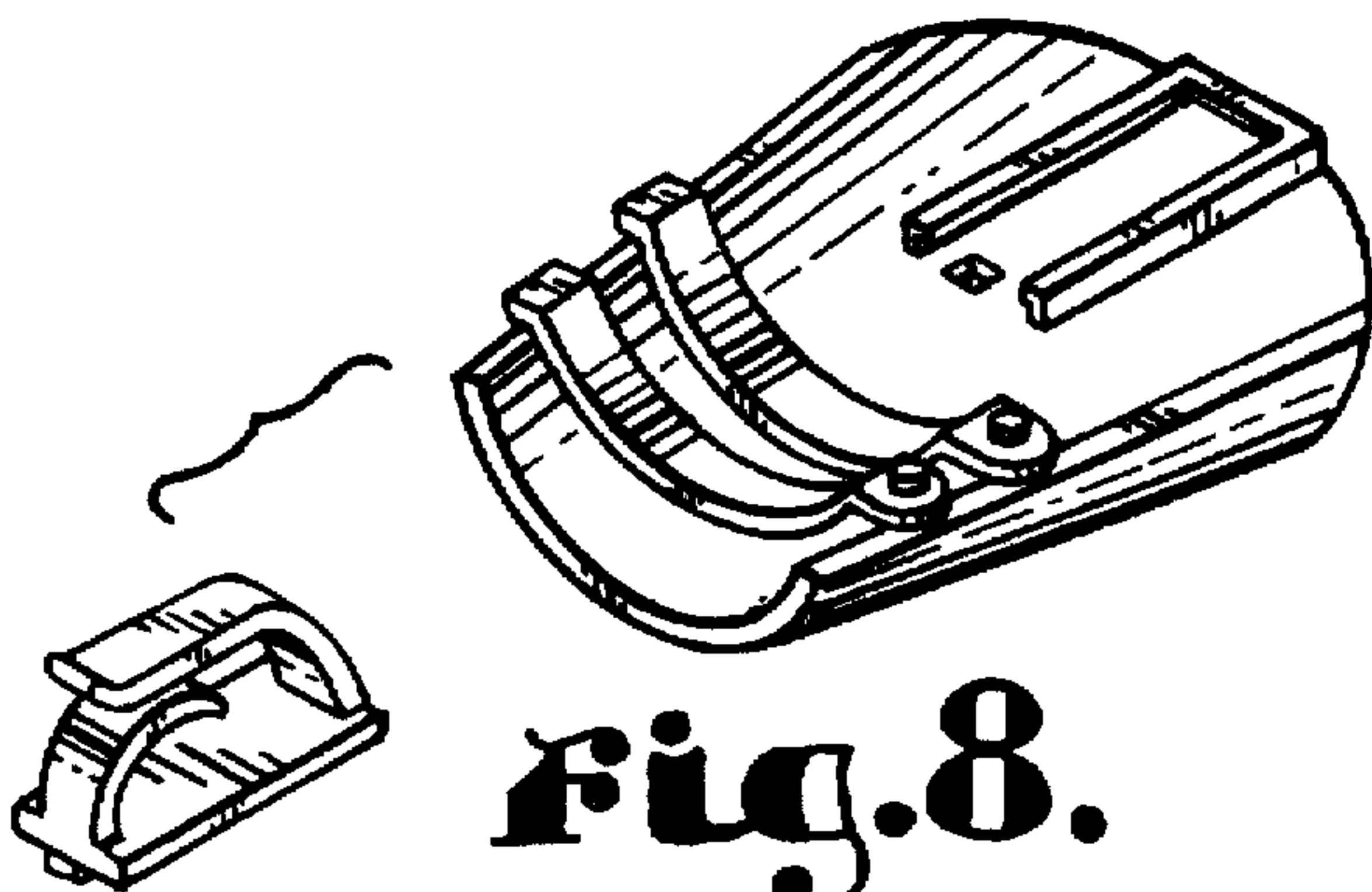
