The smaller broken line showing on the claimed design portion in all the figures denotes perforation which, when the end flap is pulled, creates a re-closable tab.

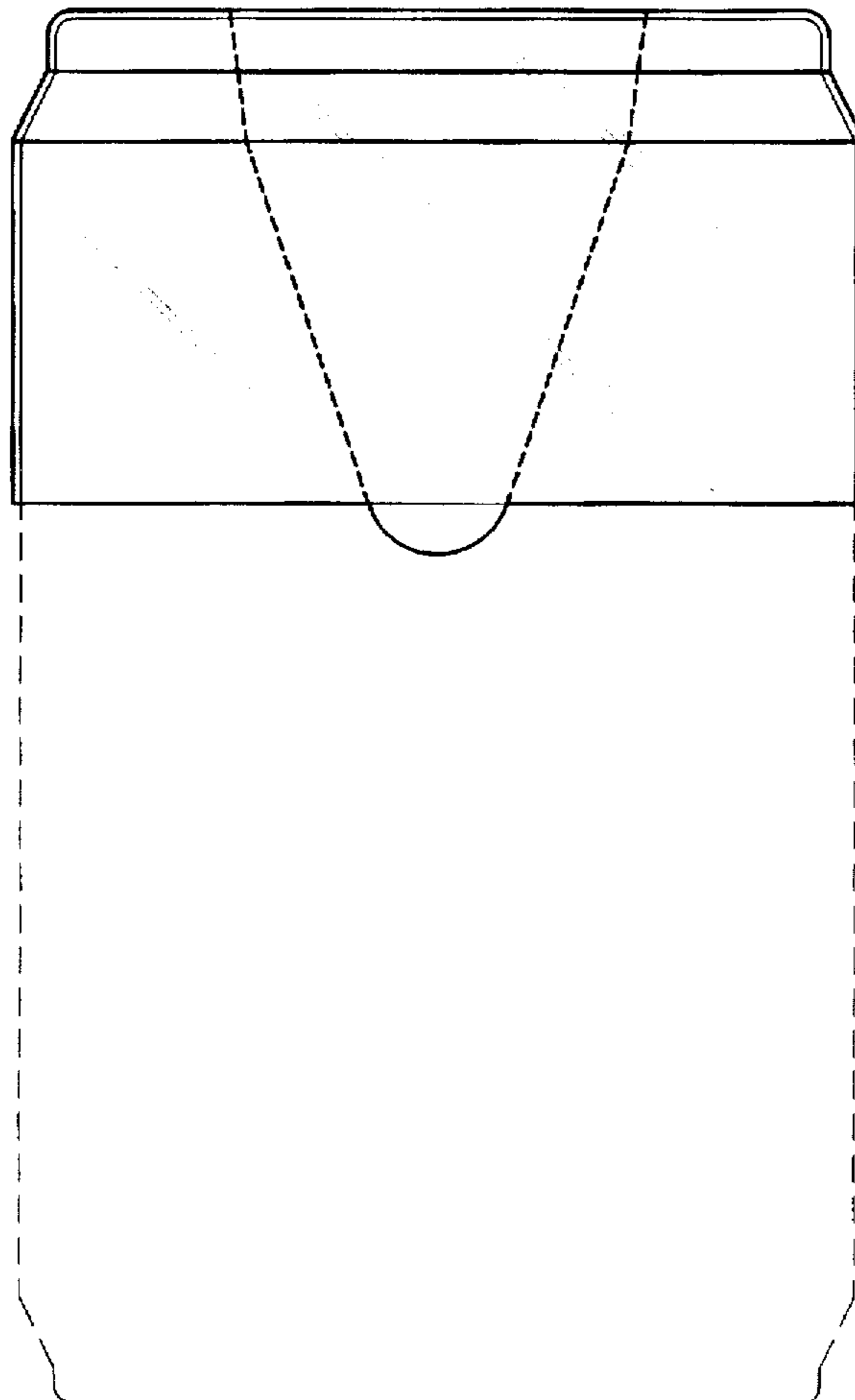

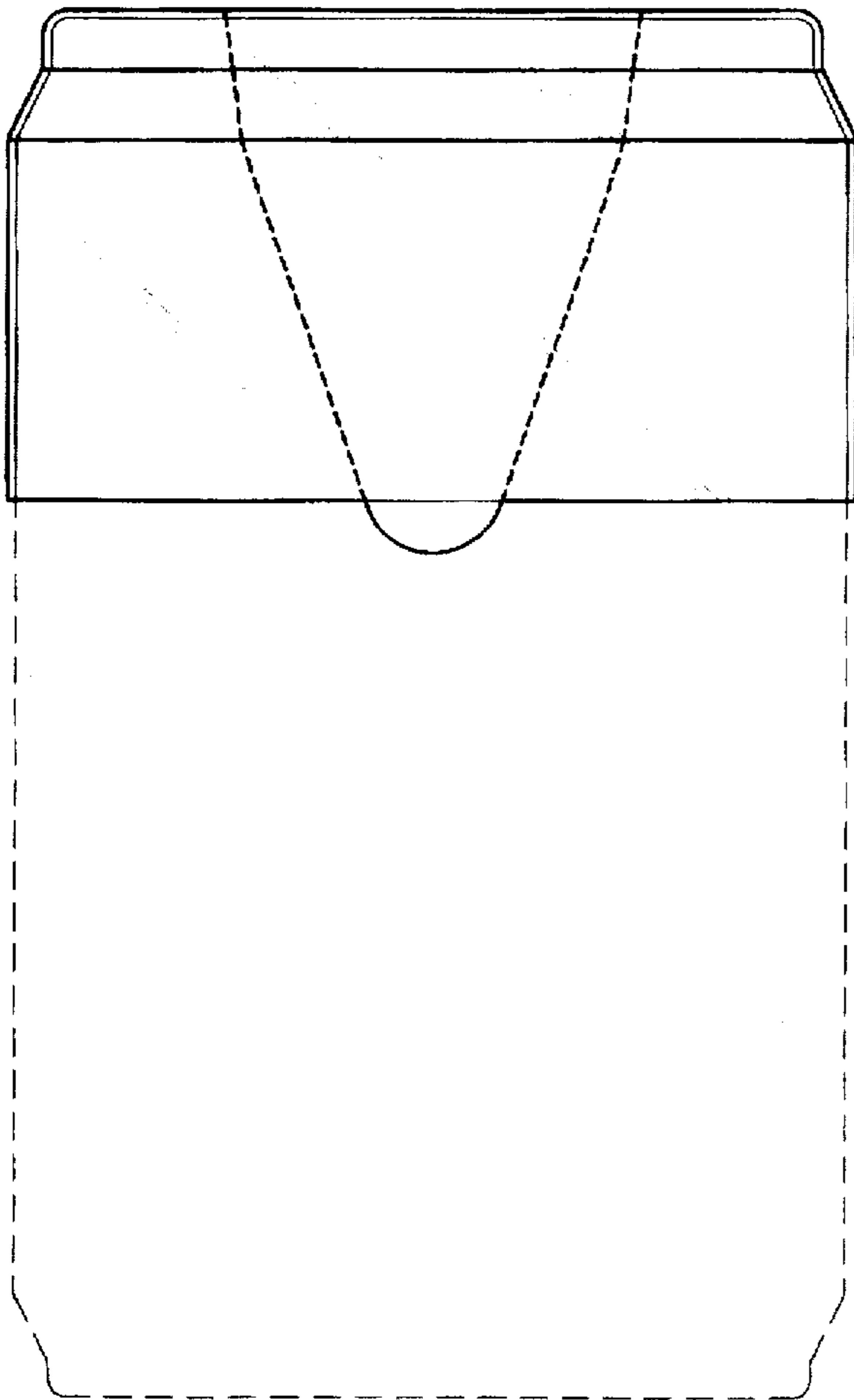

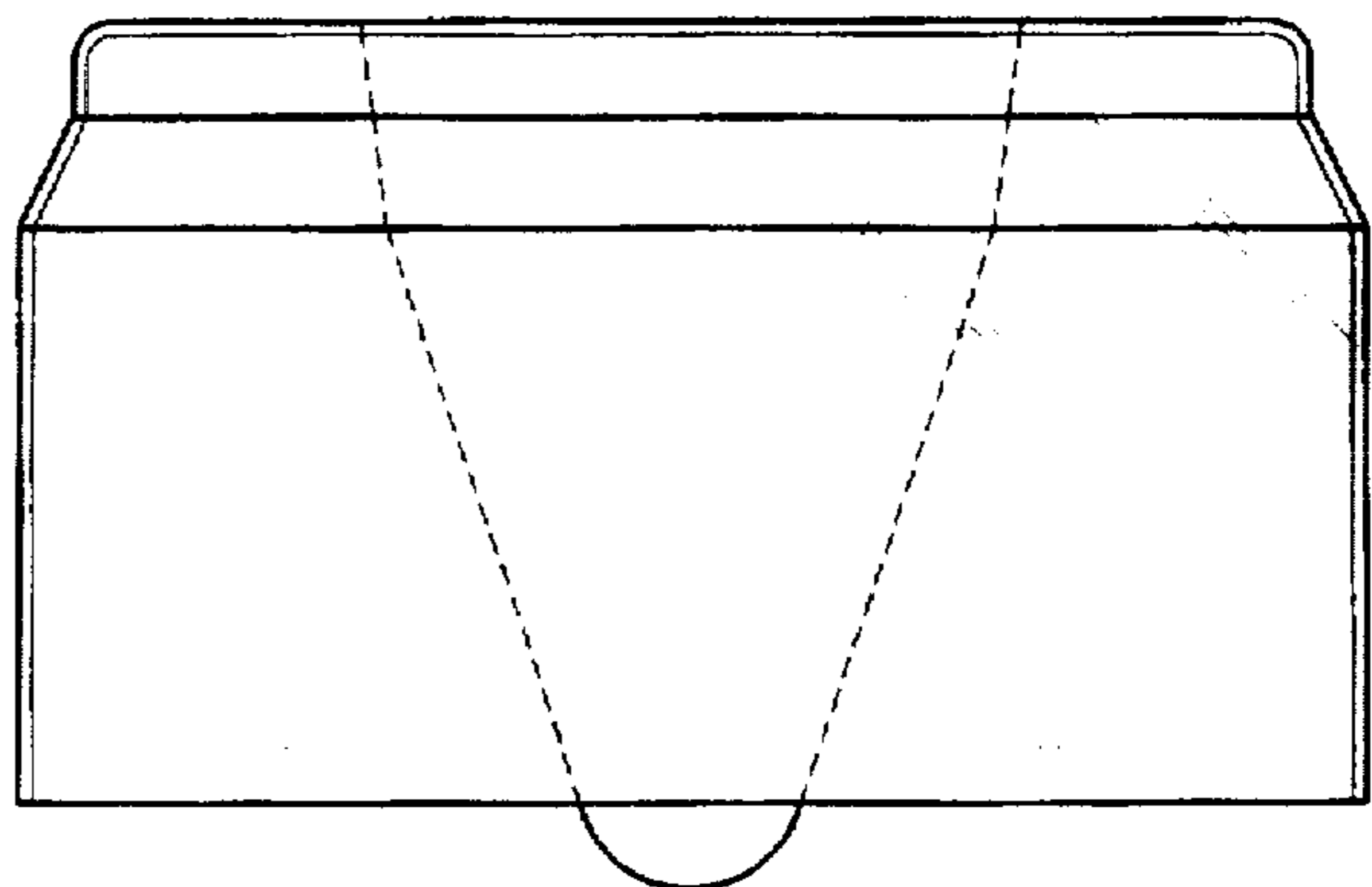

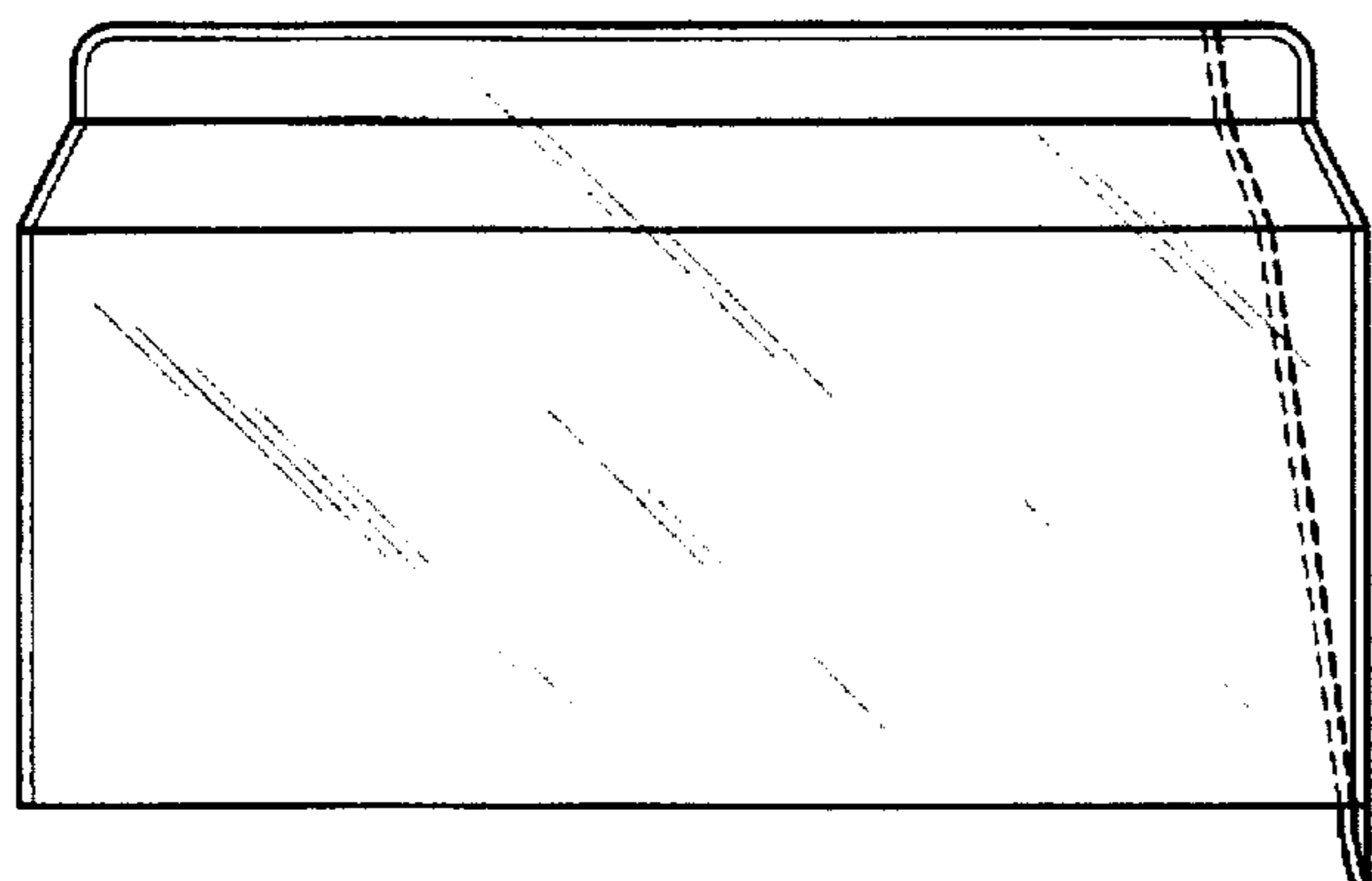

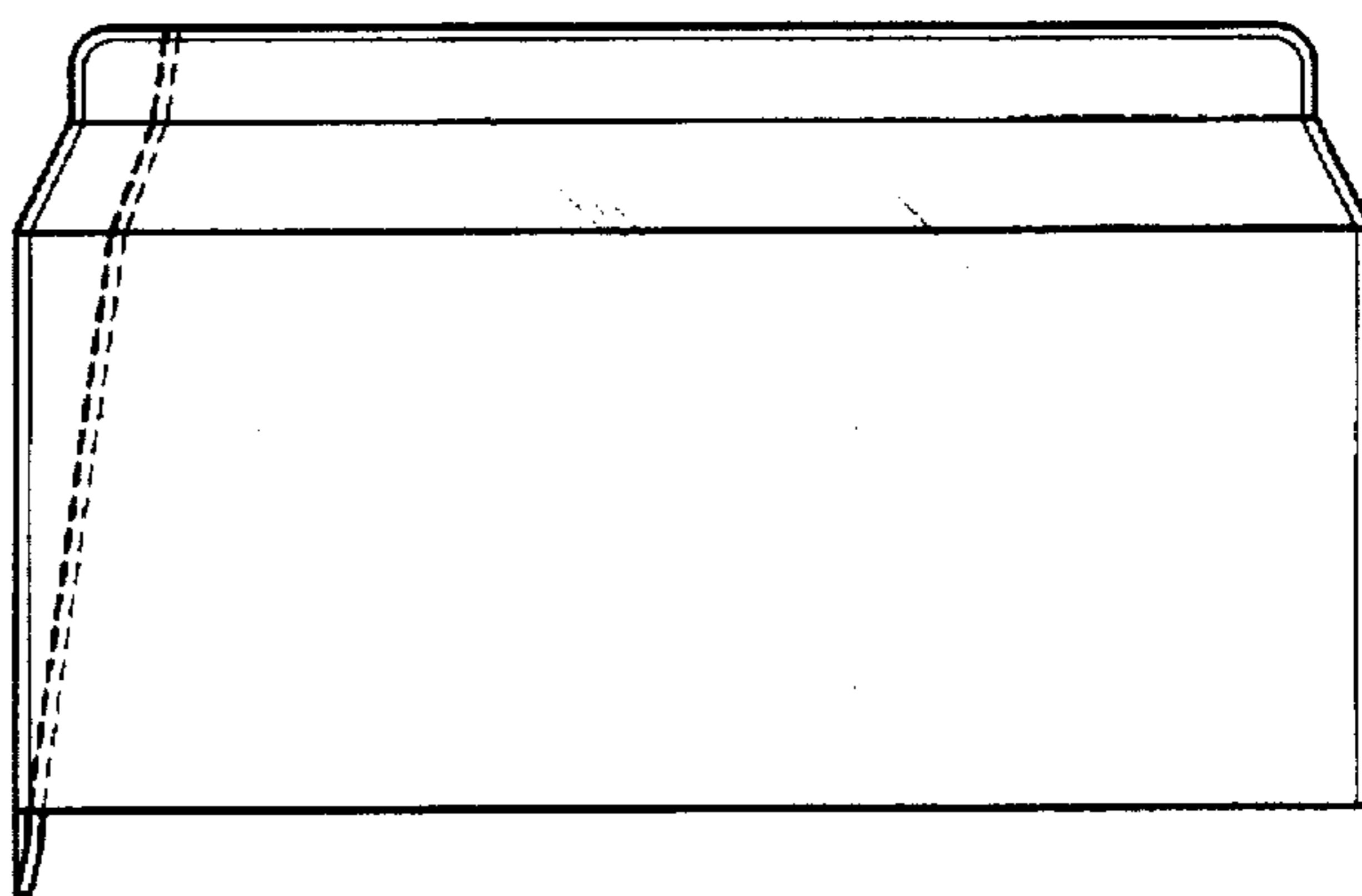

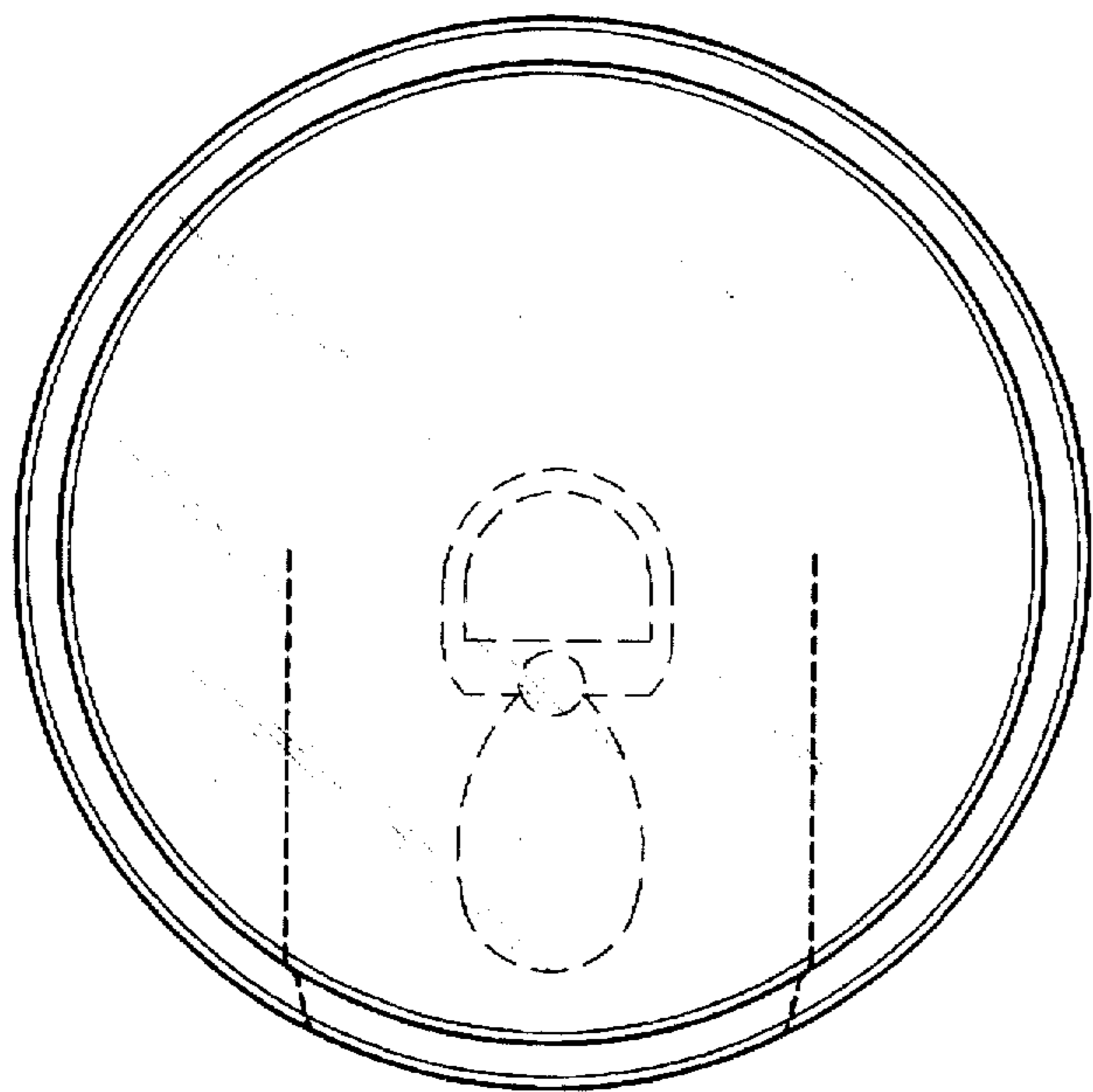
