[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a self-cleaning hair brush, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a first embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the first embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top view of the first embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side view of the first embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a rear view of the first embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the first embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a bottom perspective view of the first embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush, with the cleaning plate being shown in an alternate position;

FIG. 8 is a top perspective view of a second embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush;

FIG. 9 is a front view of the second embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush as shown in FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a top view of the second embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush as shown in FIG. 8;

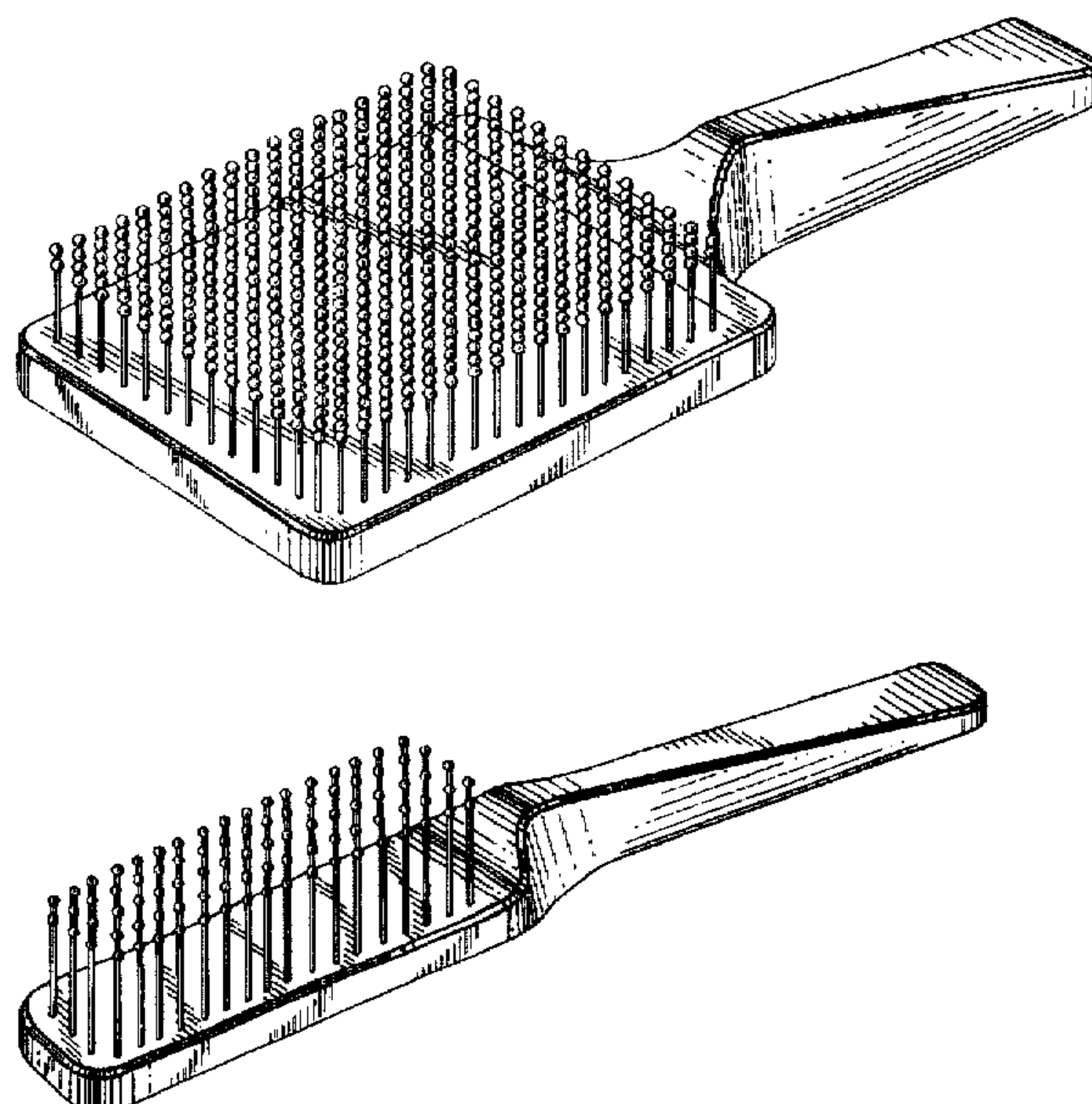
FIG. 11 is a side view of the second embodiment of the self-cleaning hair brush as shown in FIG. 8;

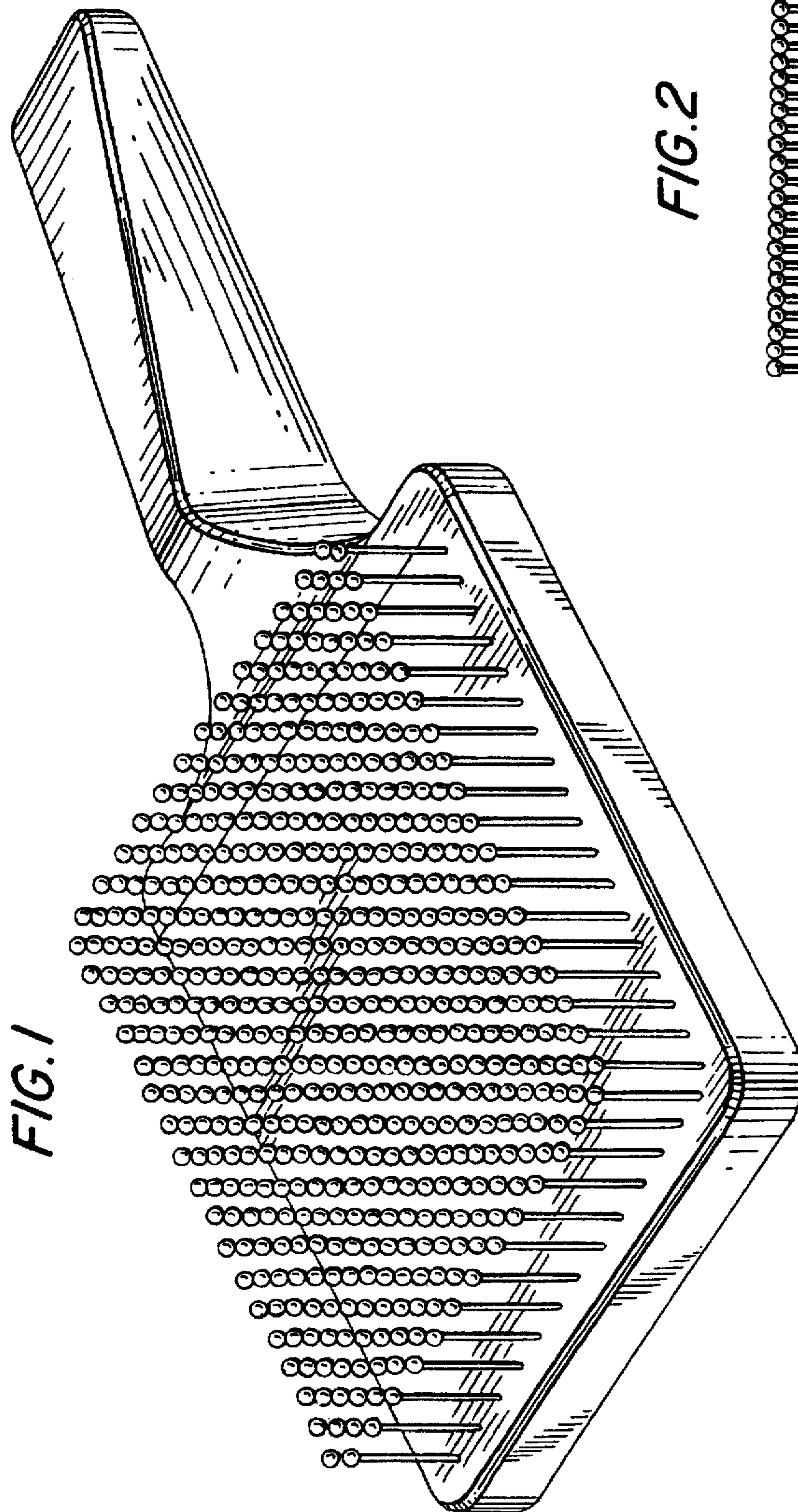
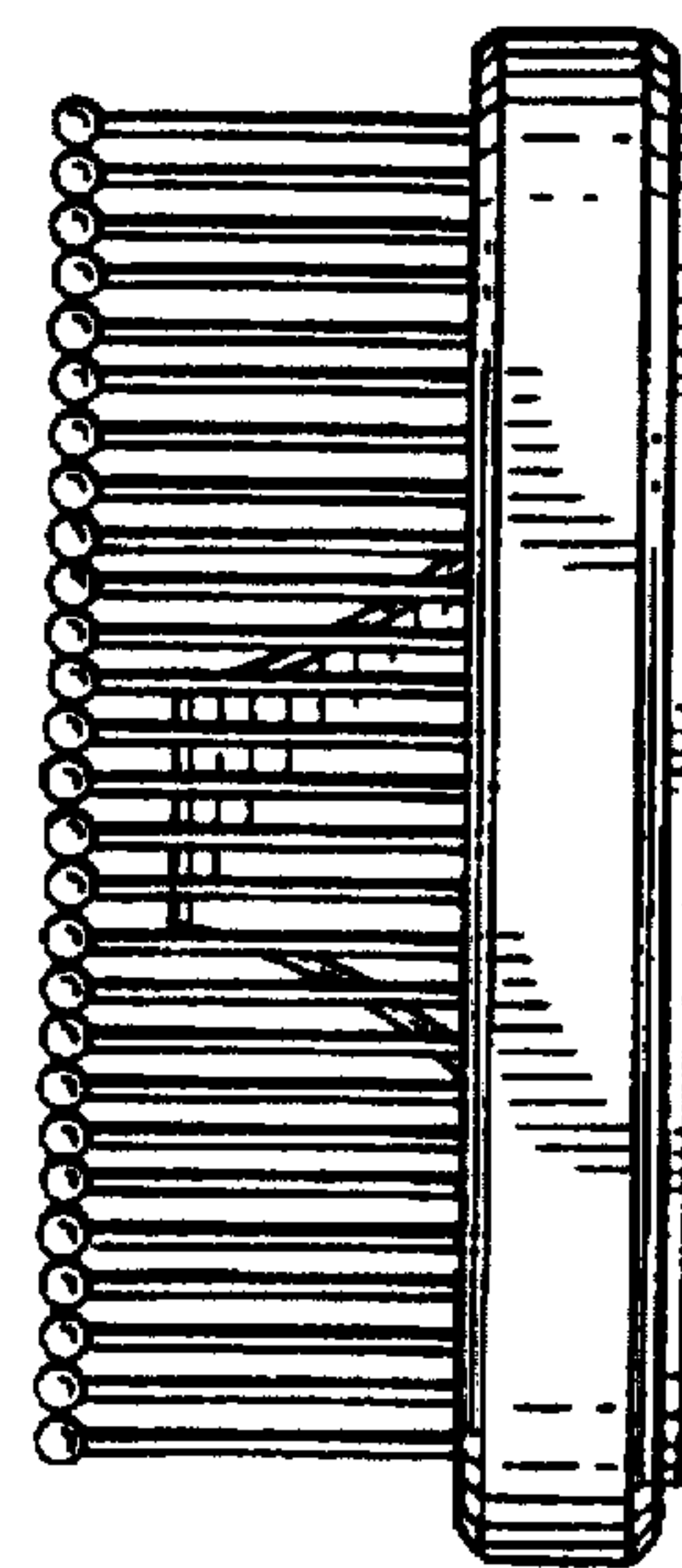

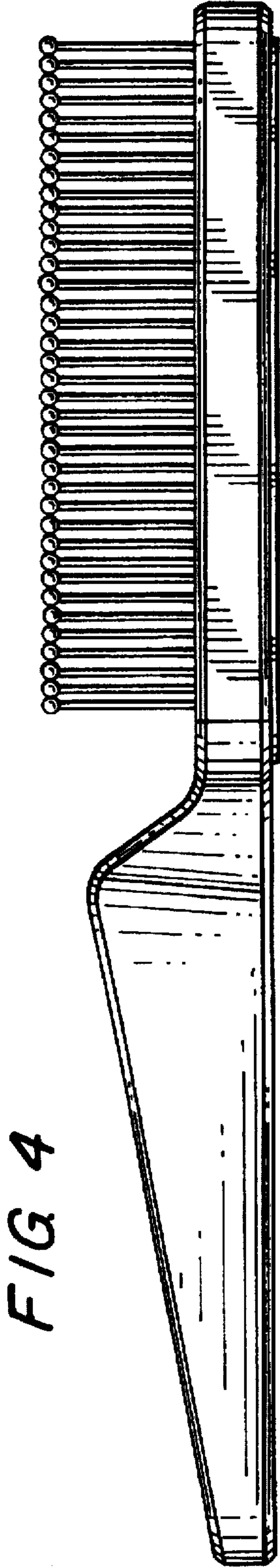
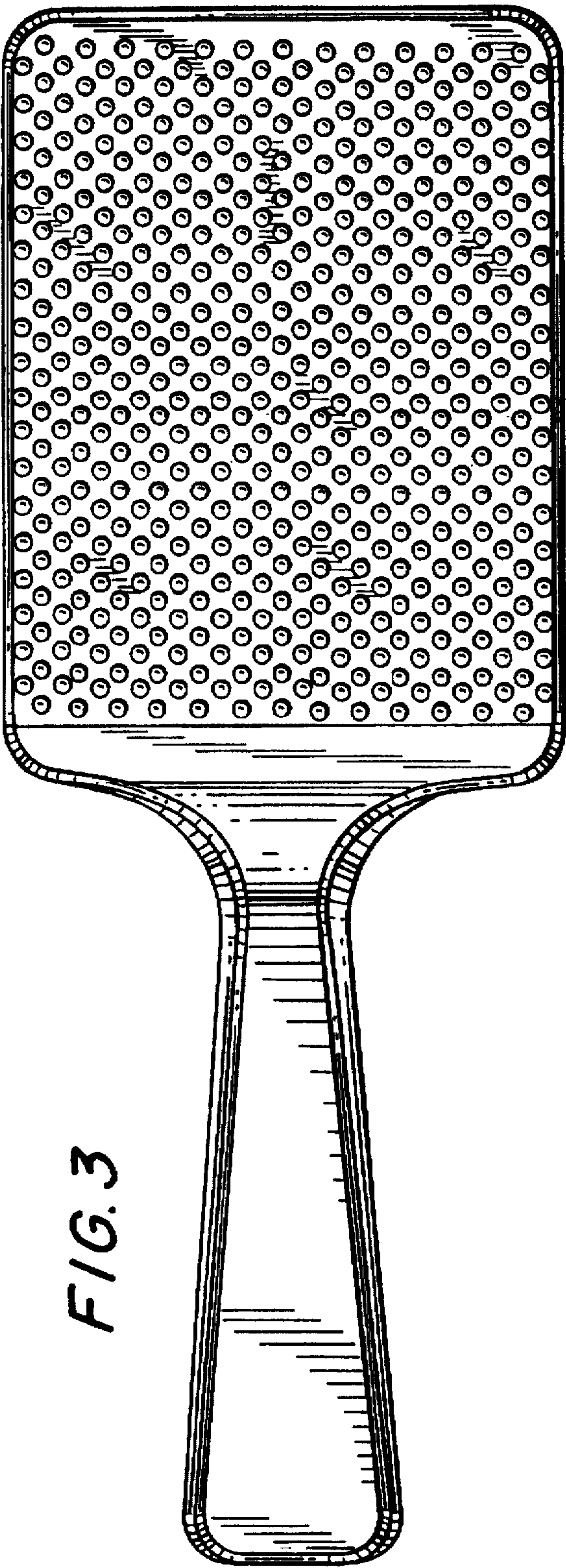

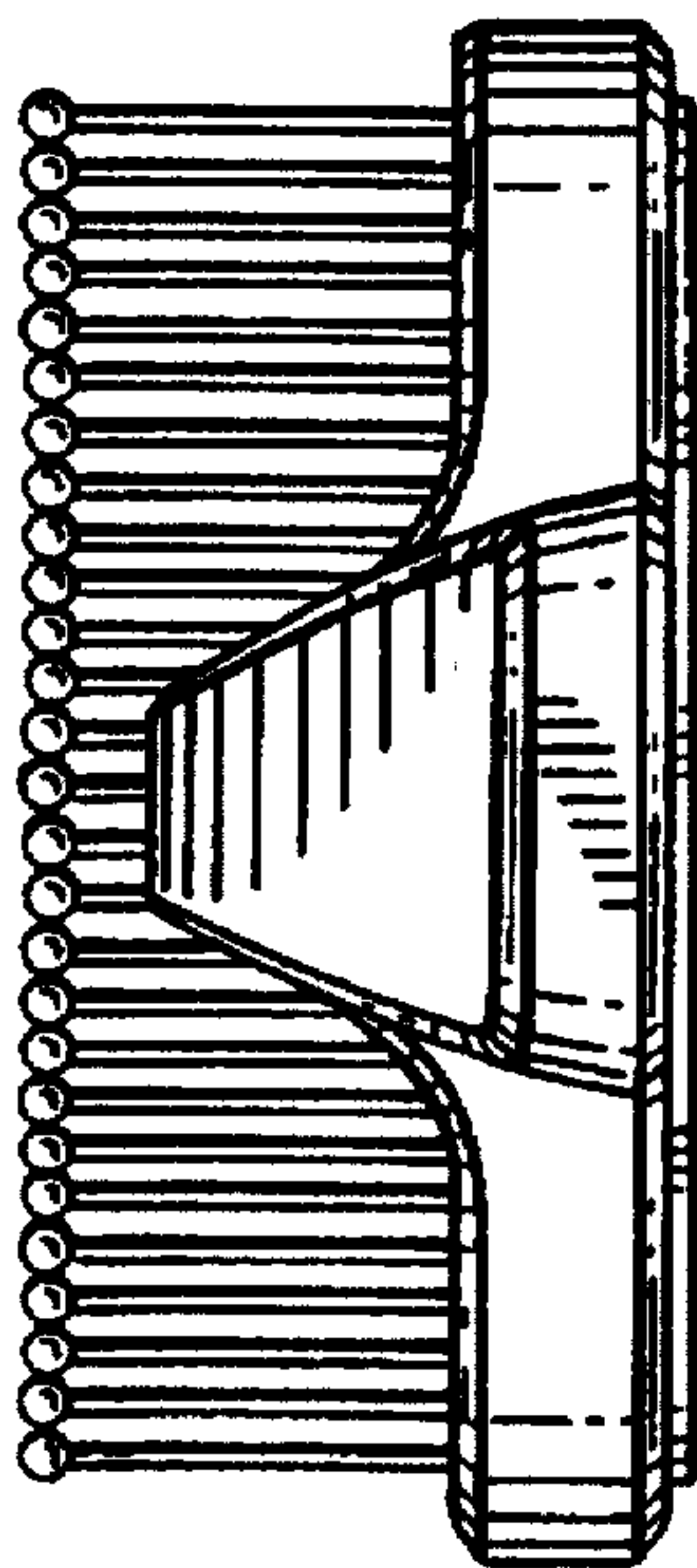
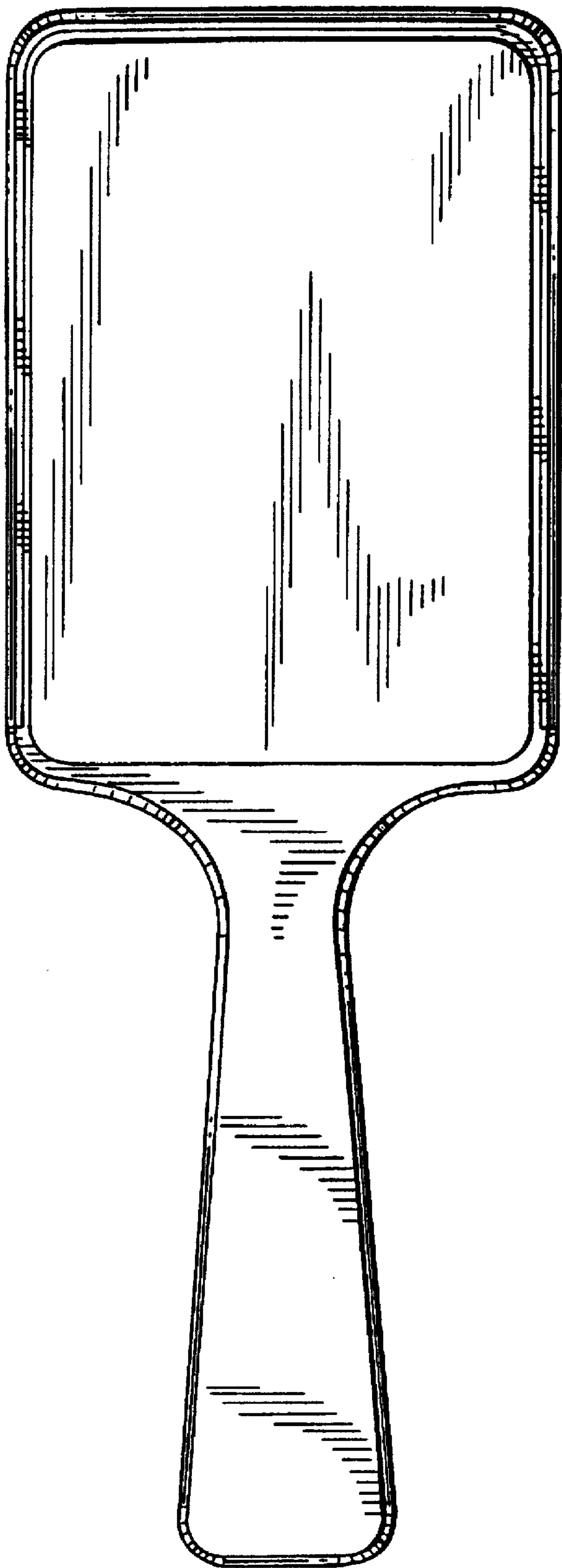

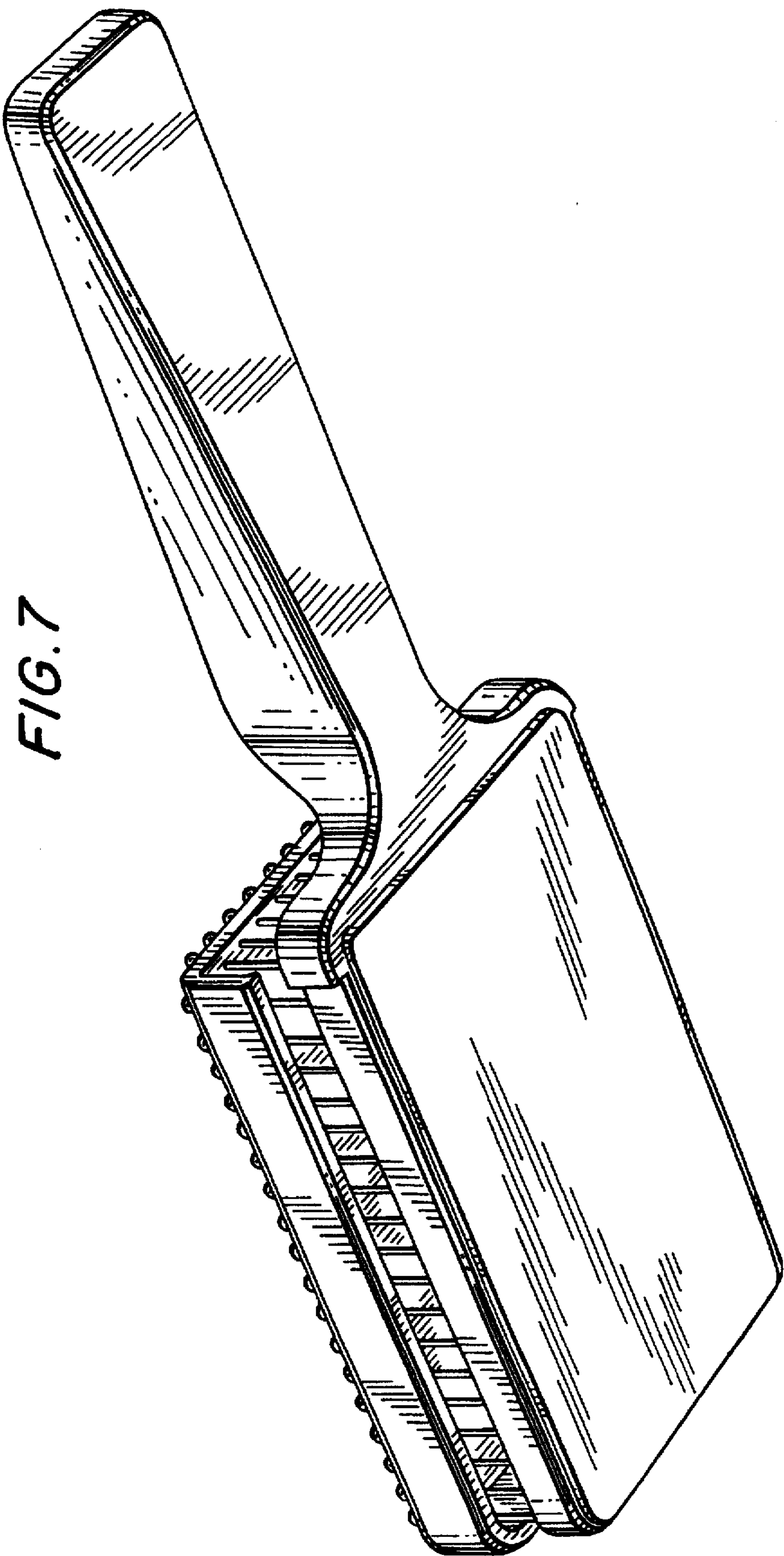
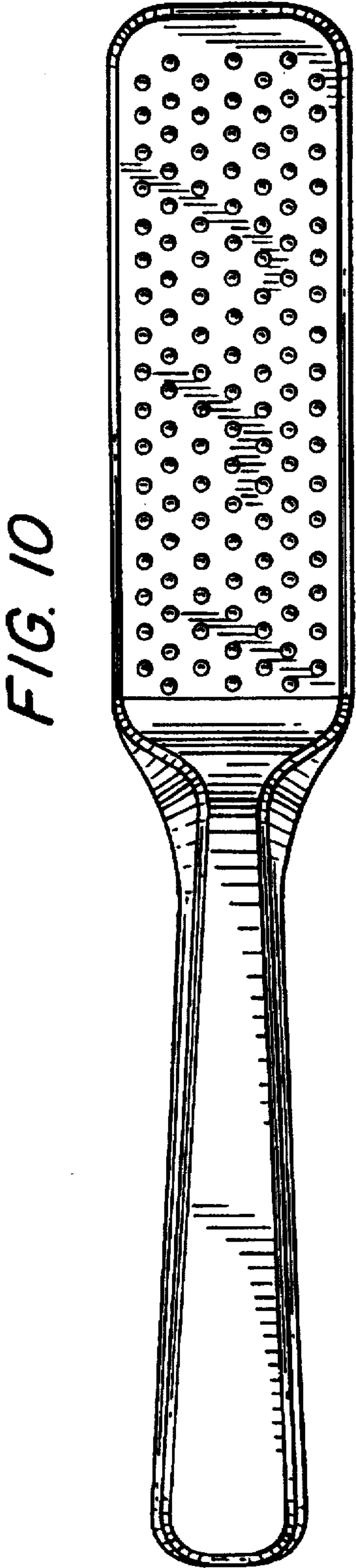
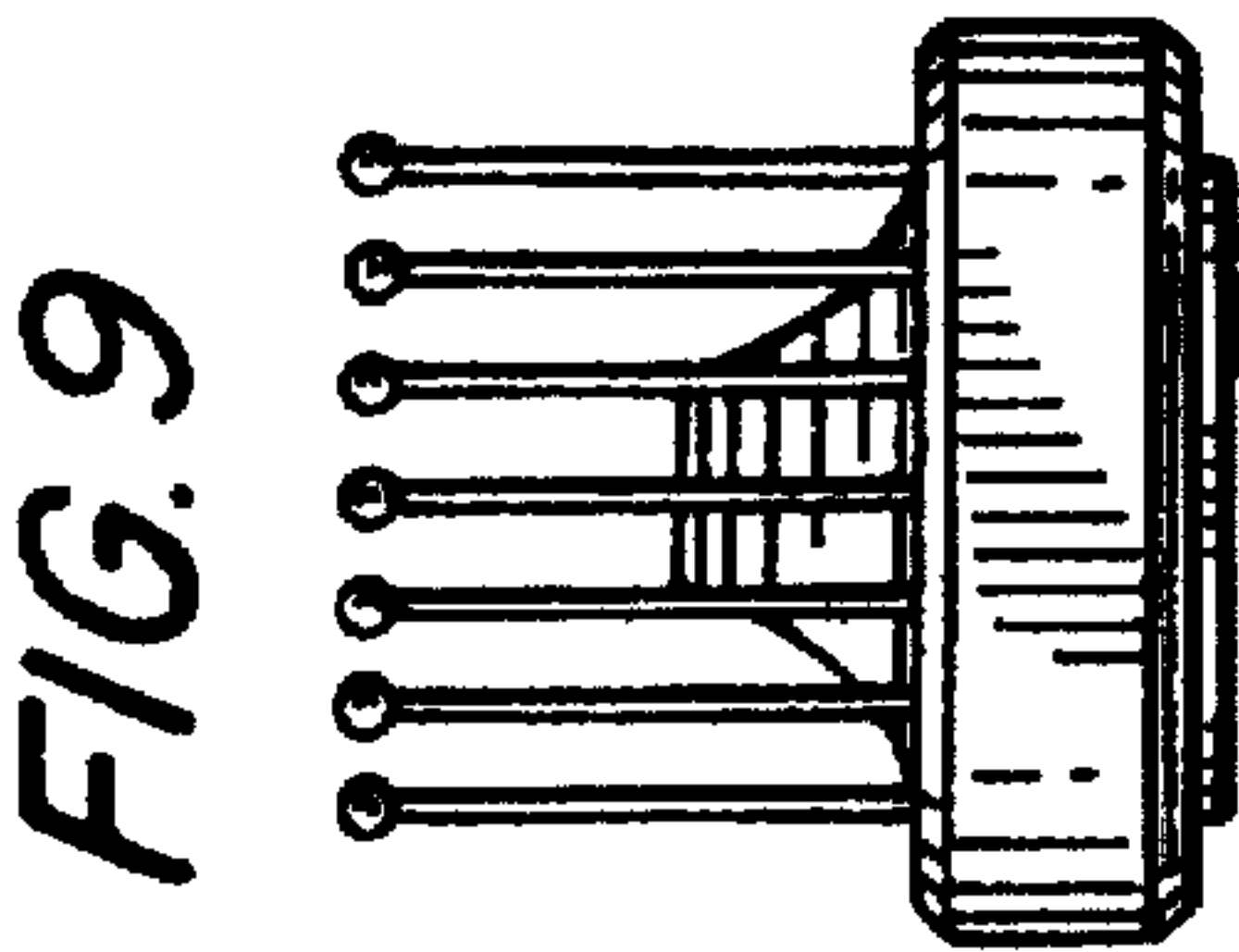
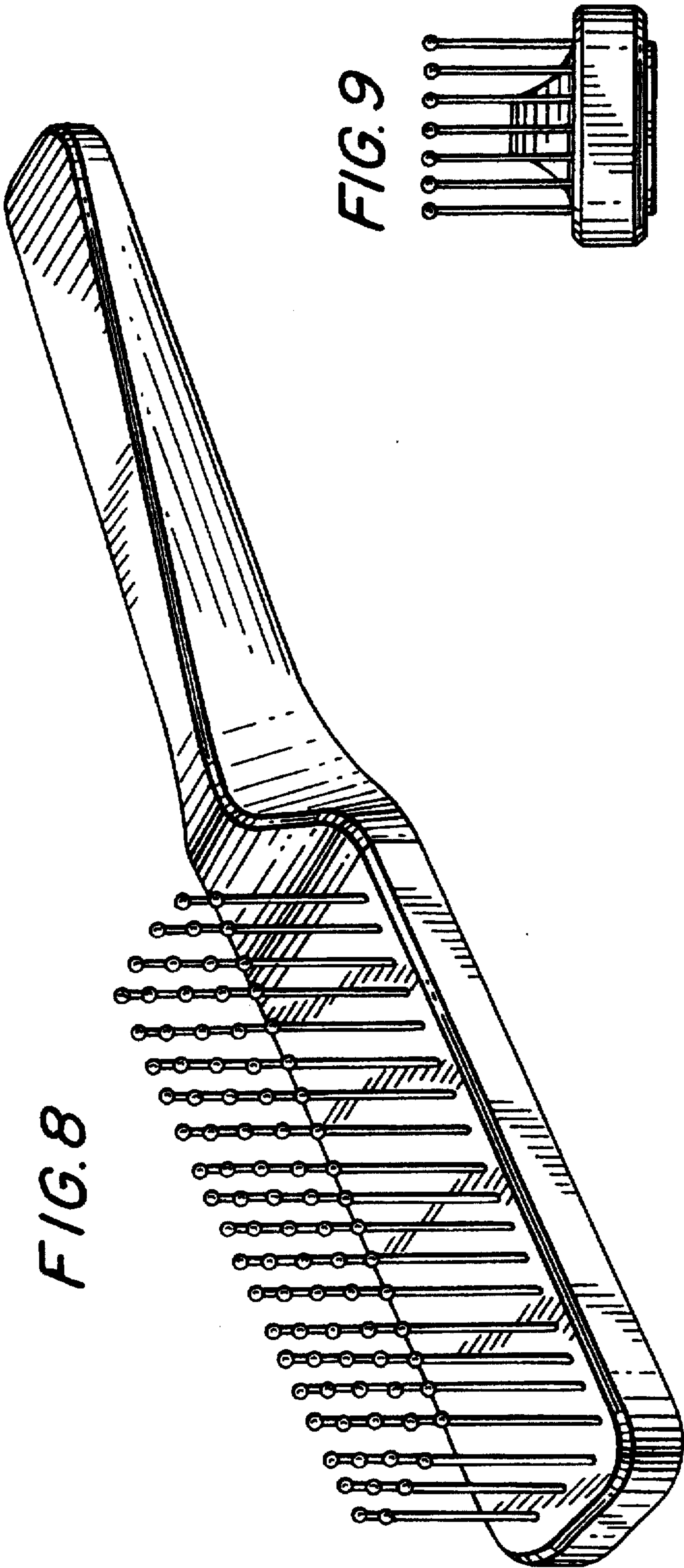

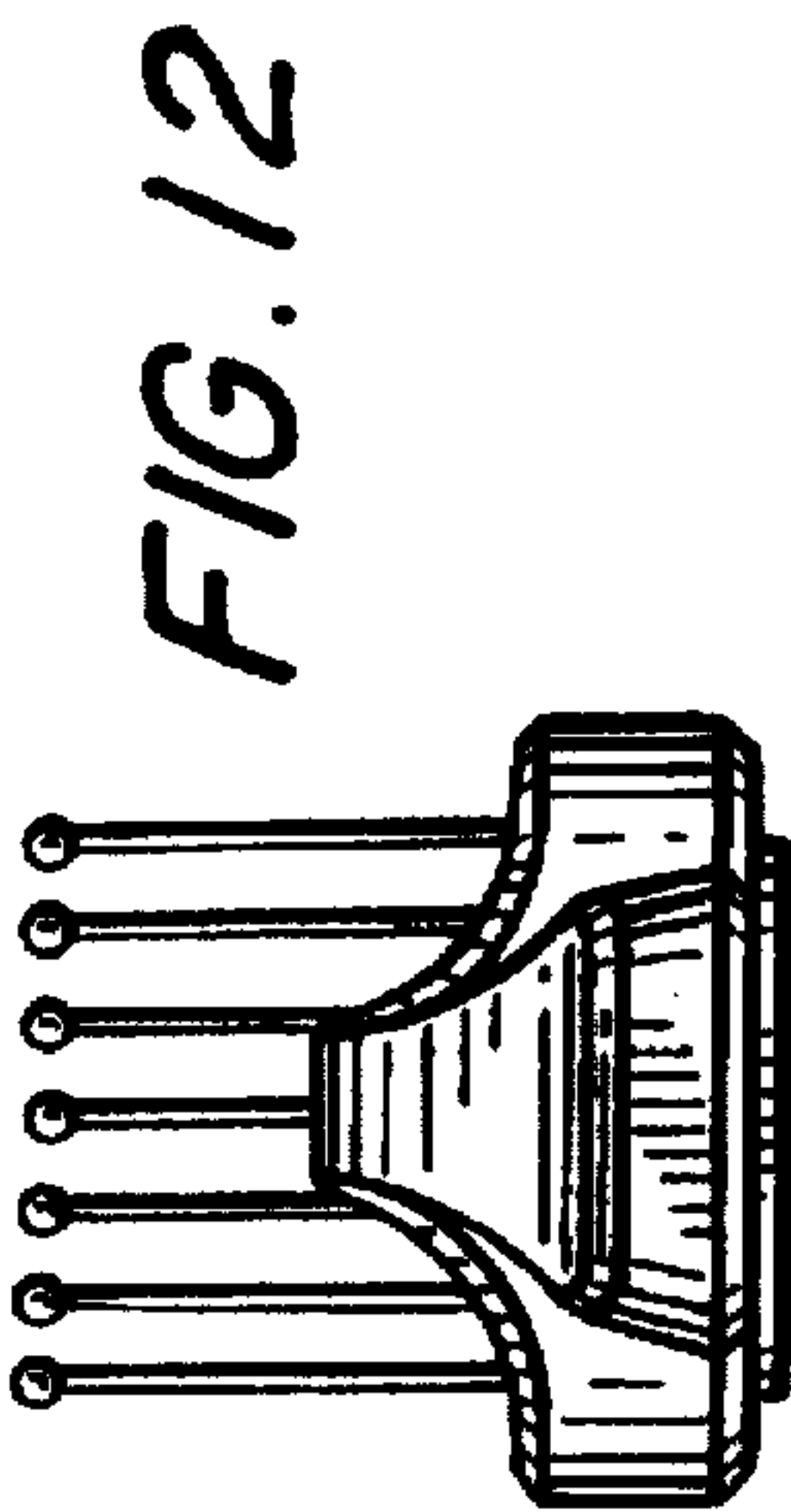
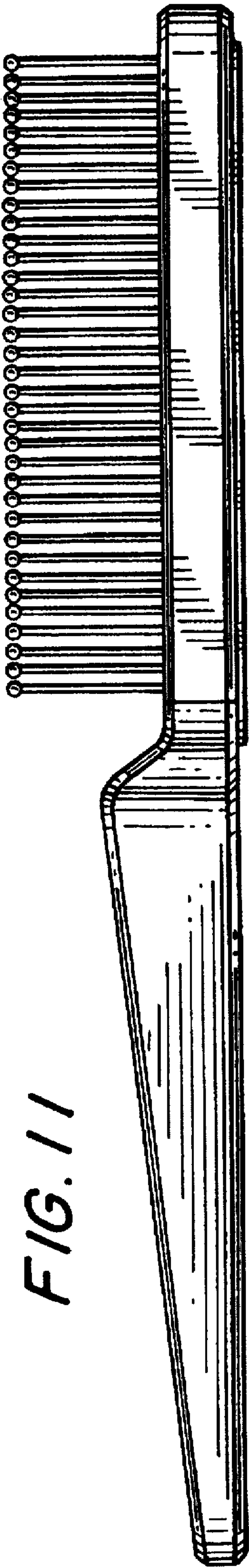
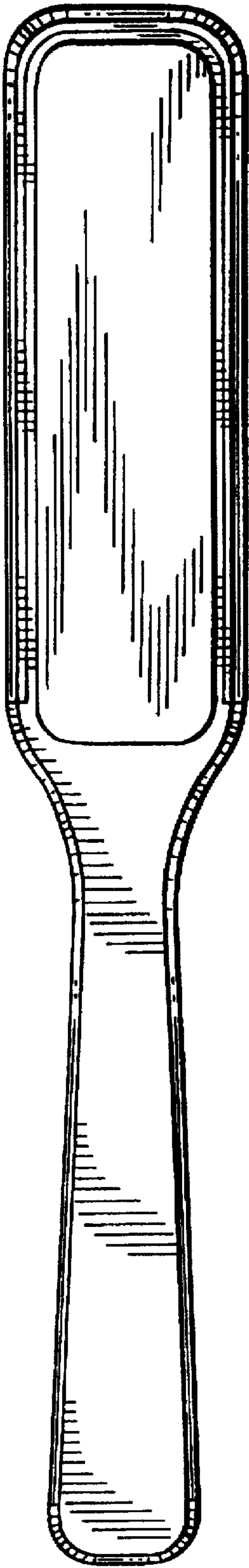

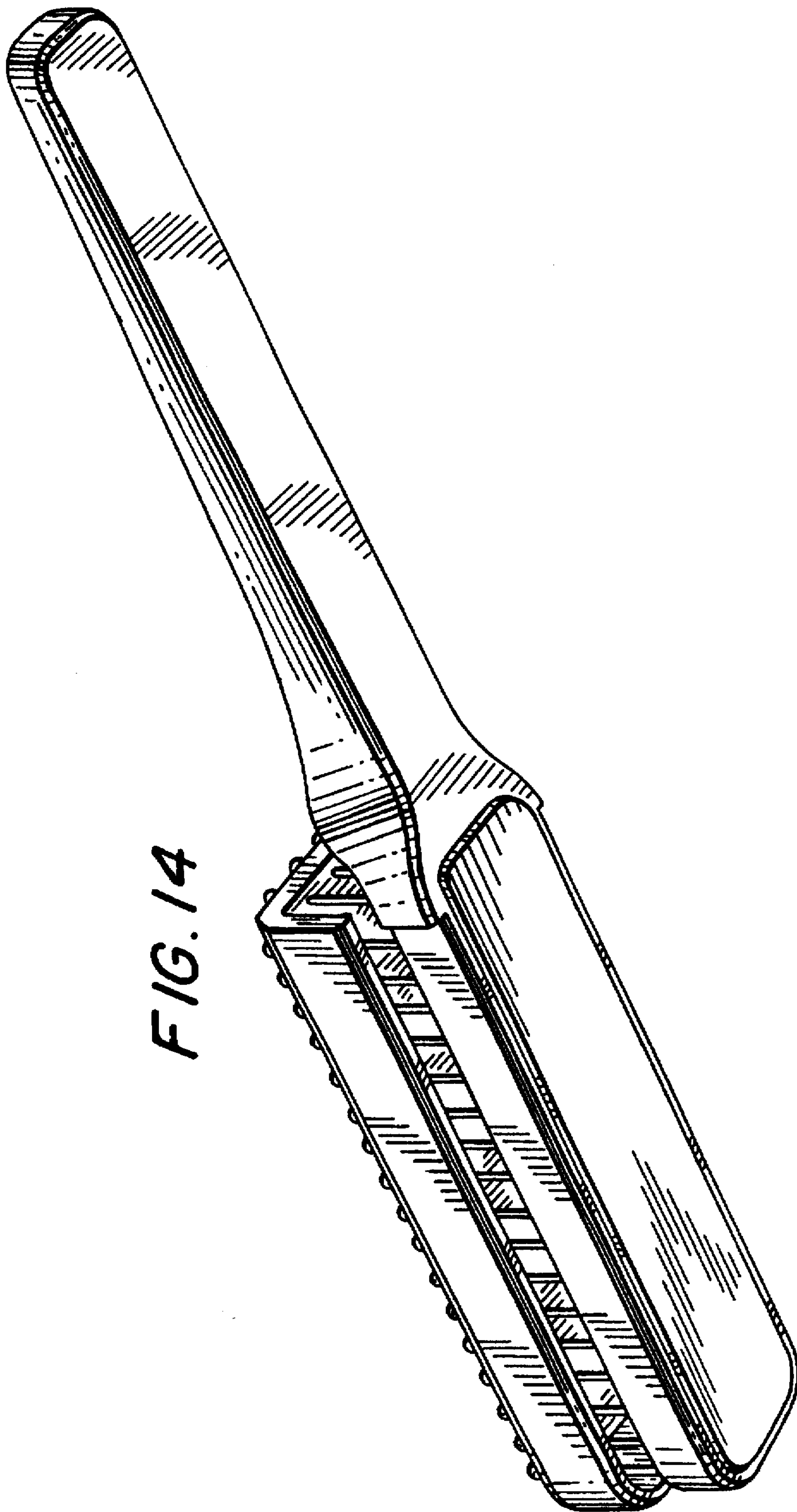
