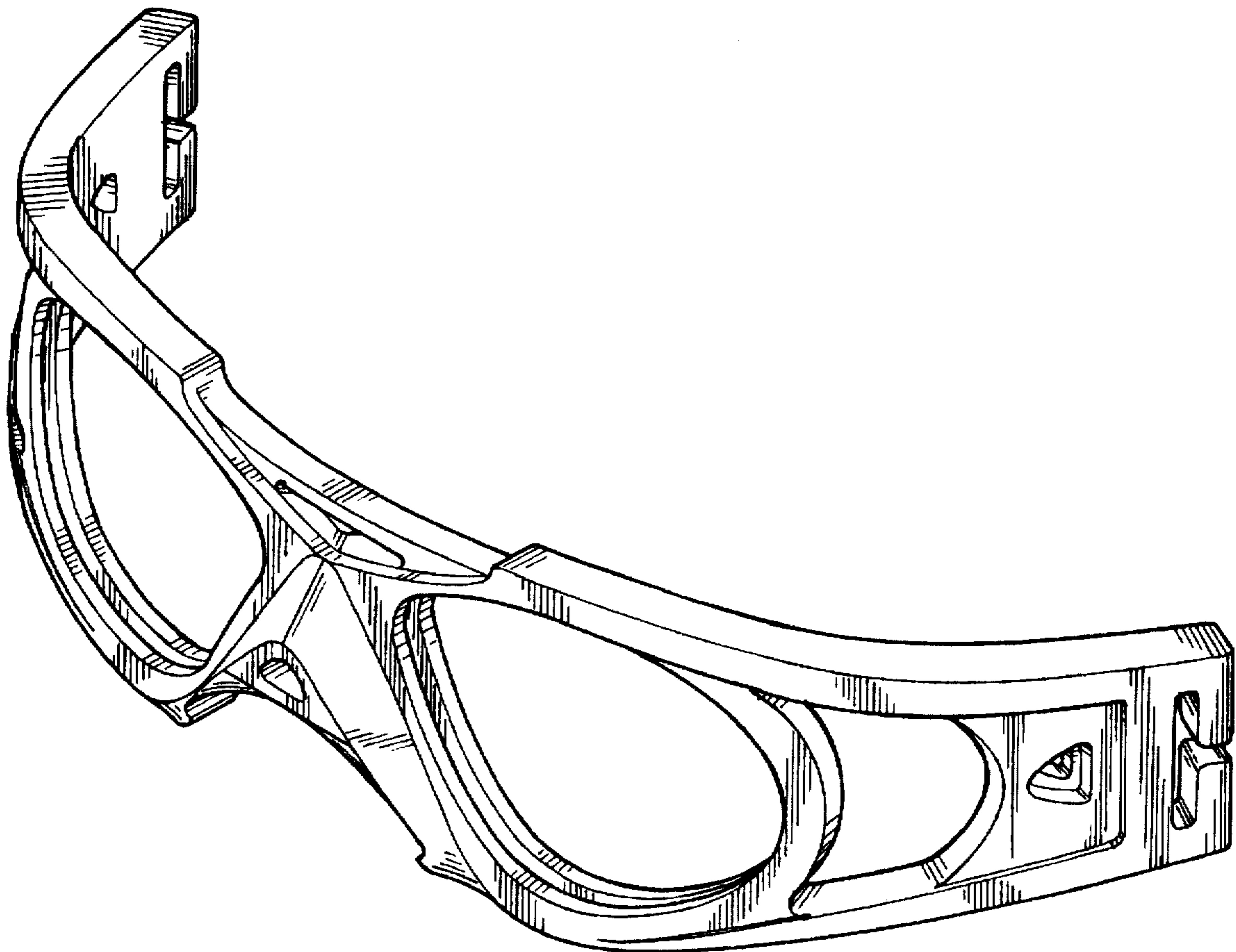
The ornamental design for a frame for spectacles, as shown and described.

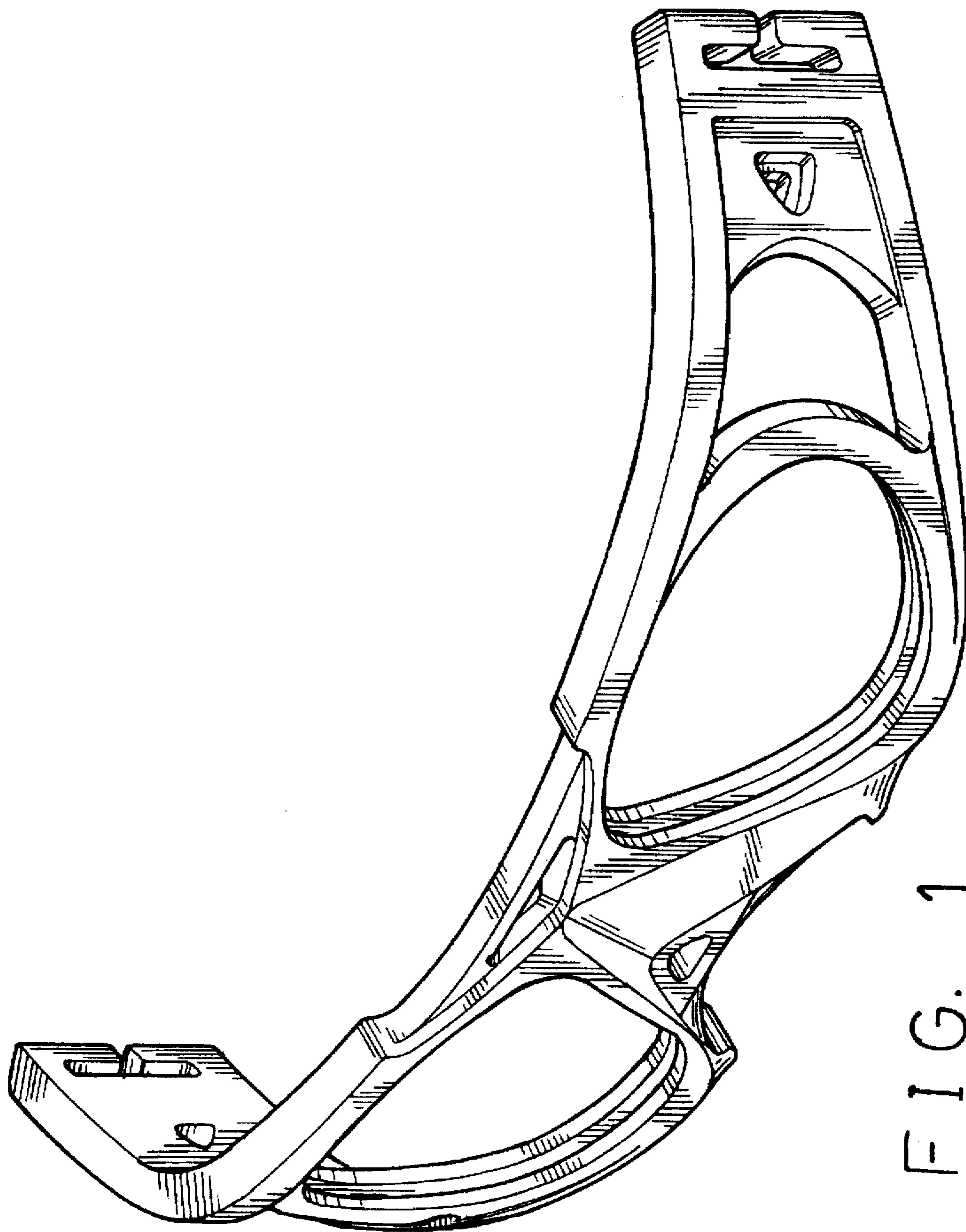

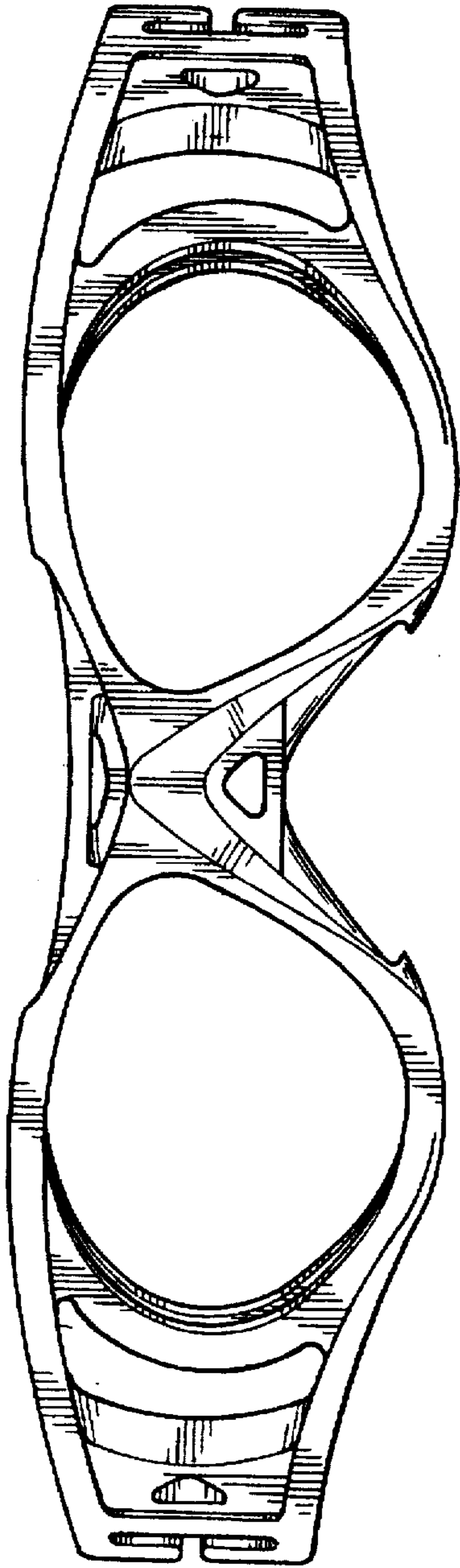

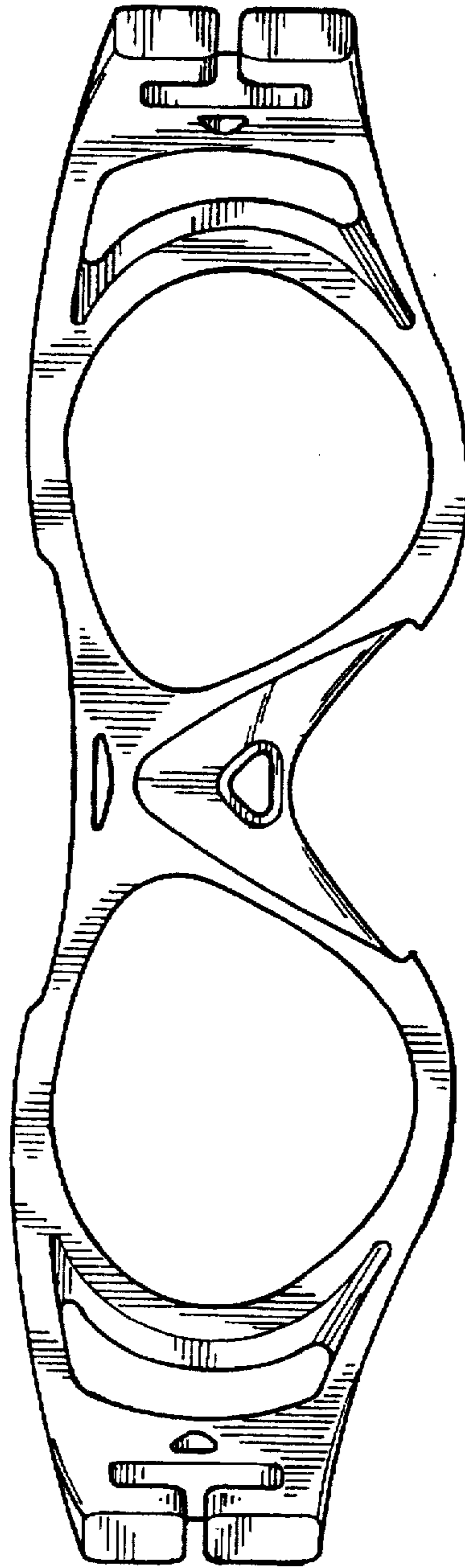

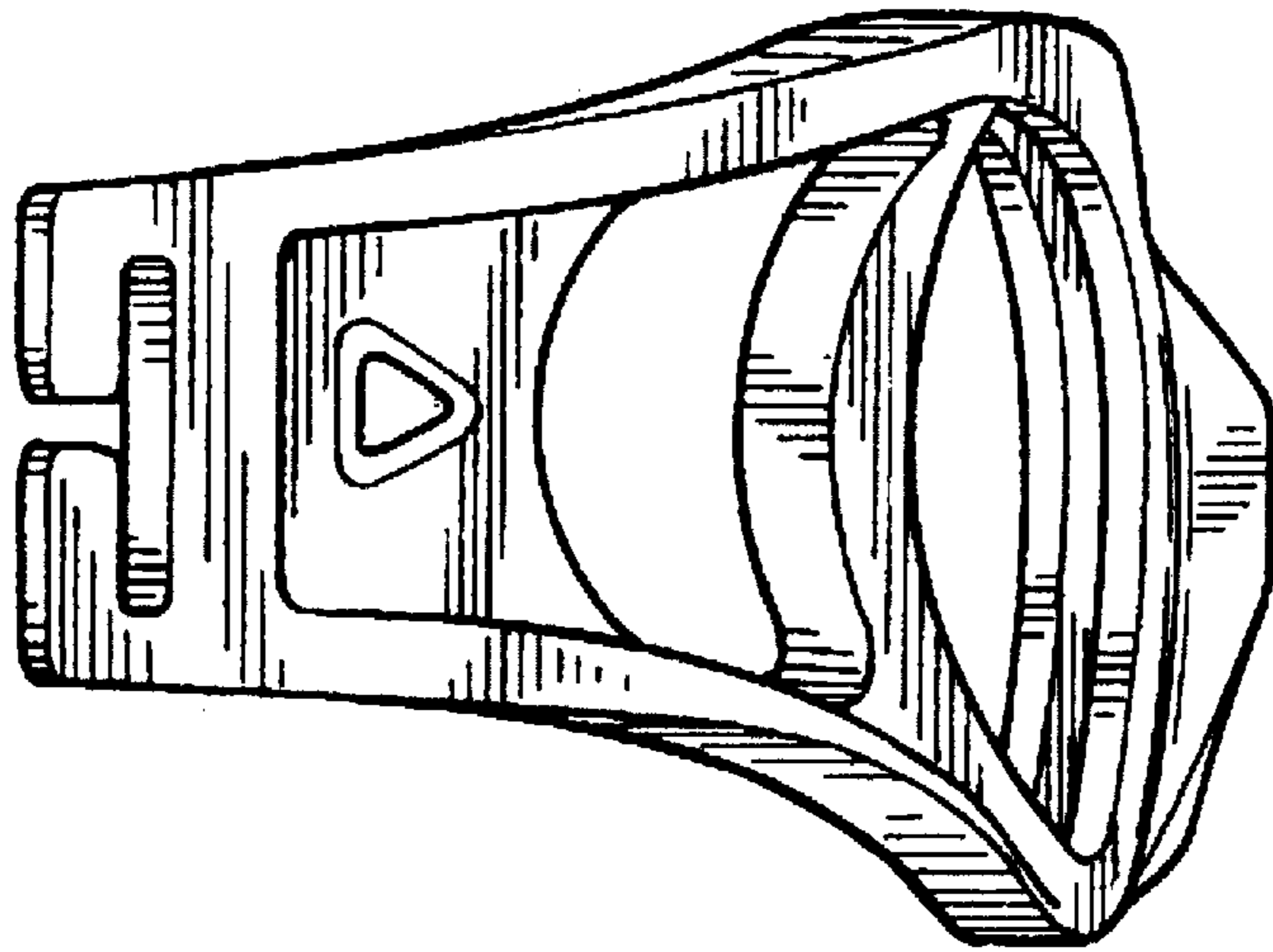

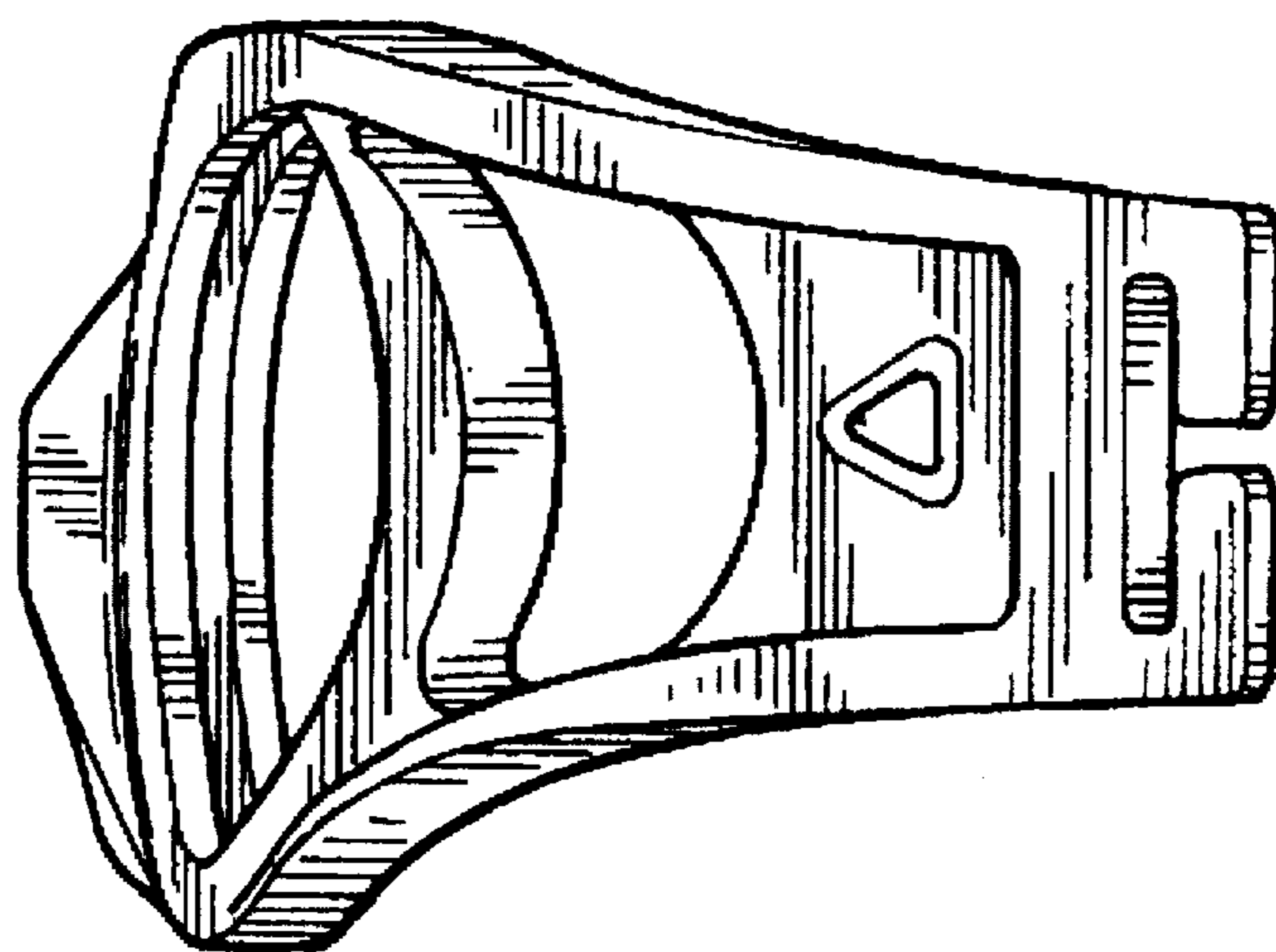

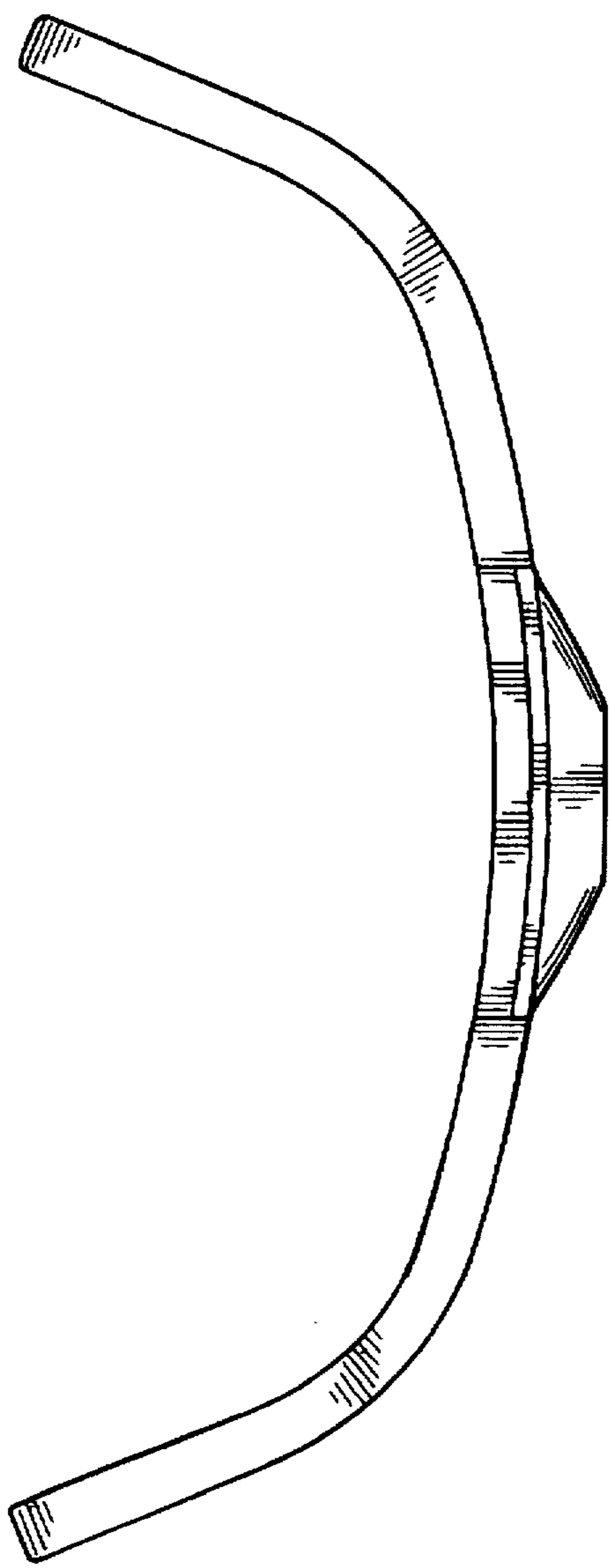

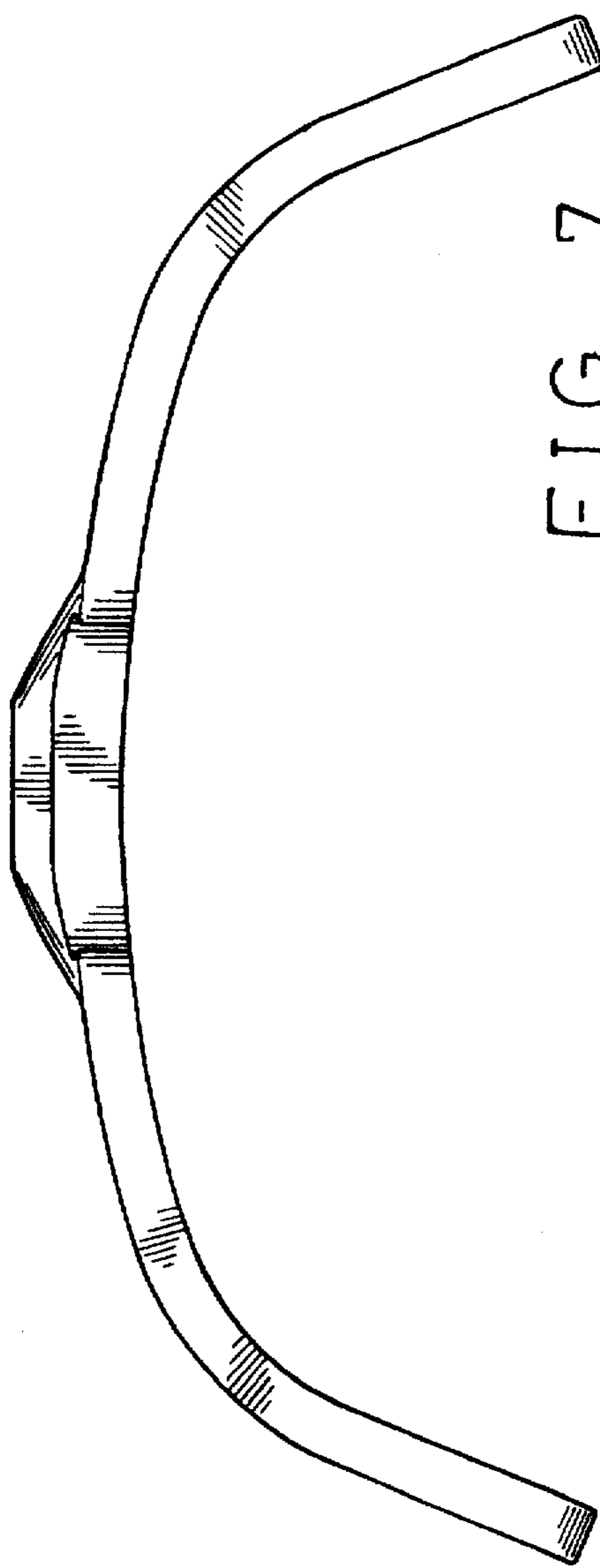
